(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a convertible seat cover with upper transparent section, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a convertible seat cover with upper transparent section;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right elevational view thereof, the left elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an isometric view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is an isometric view thereof, showing my design being used as a back sack/tote bag.

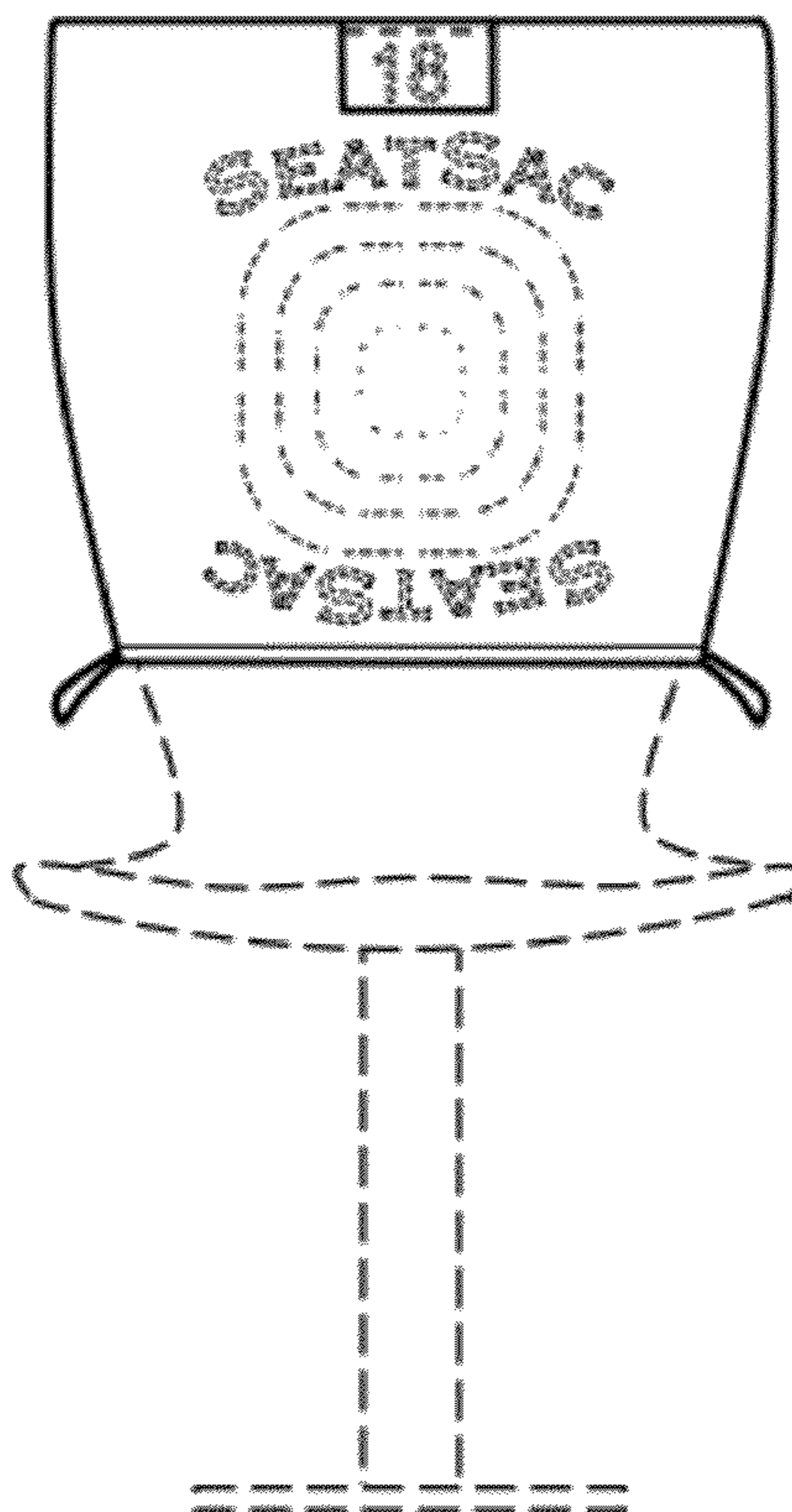

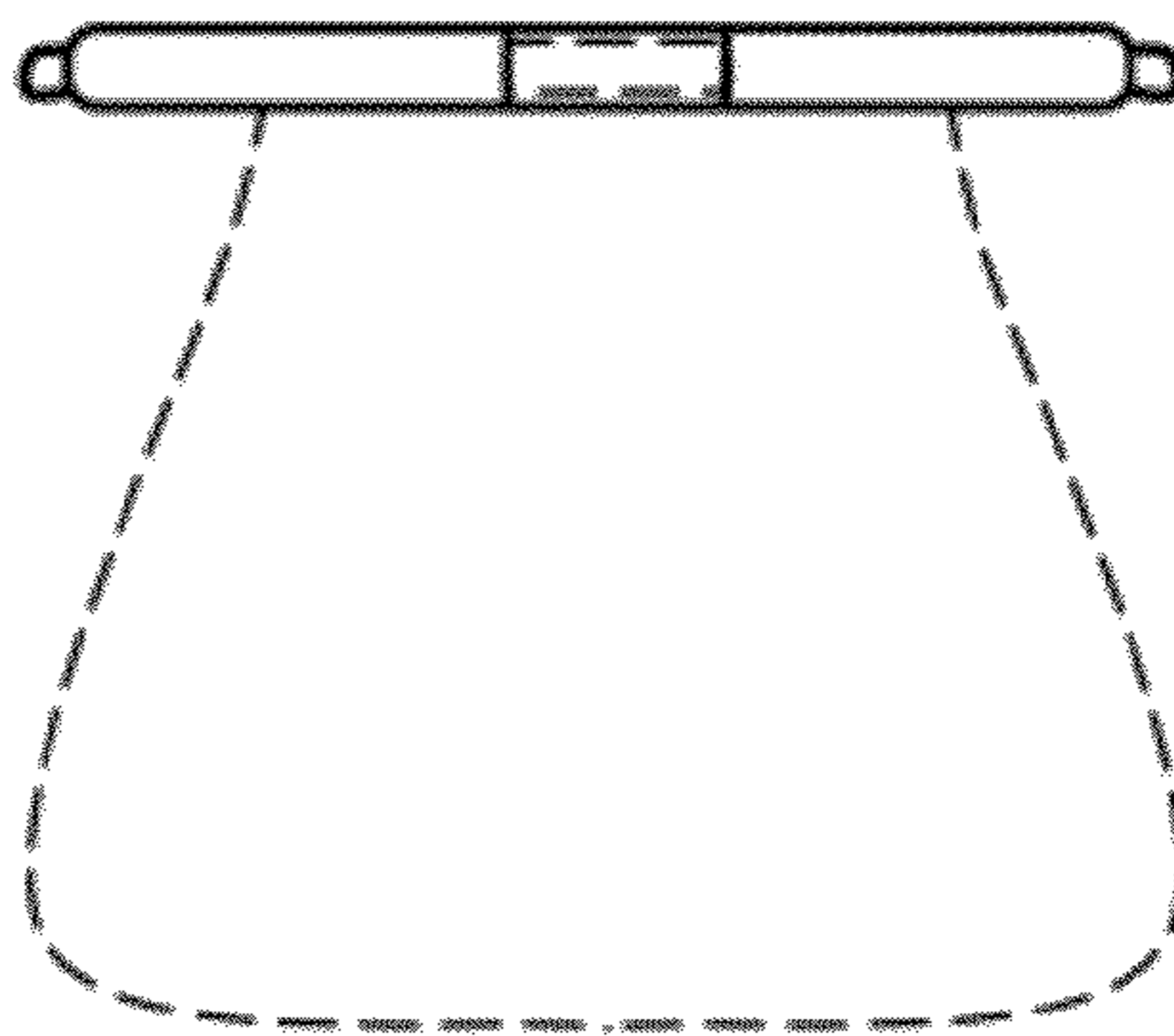

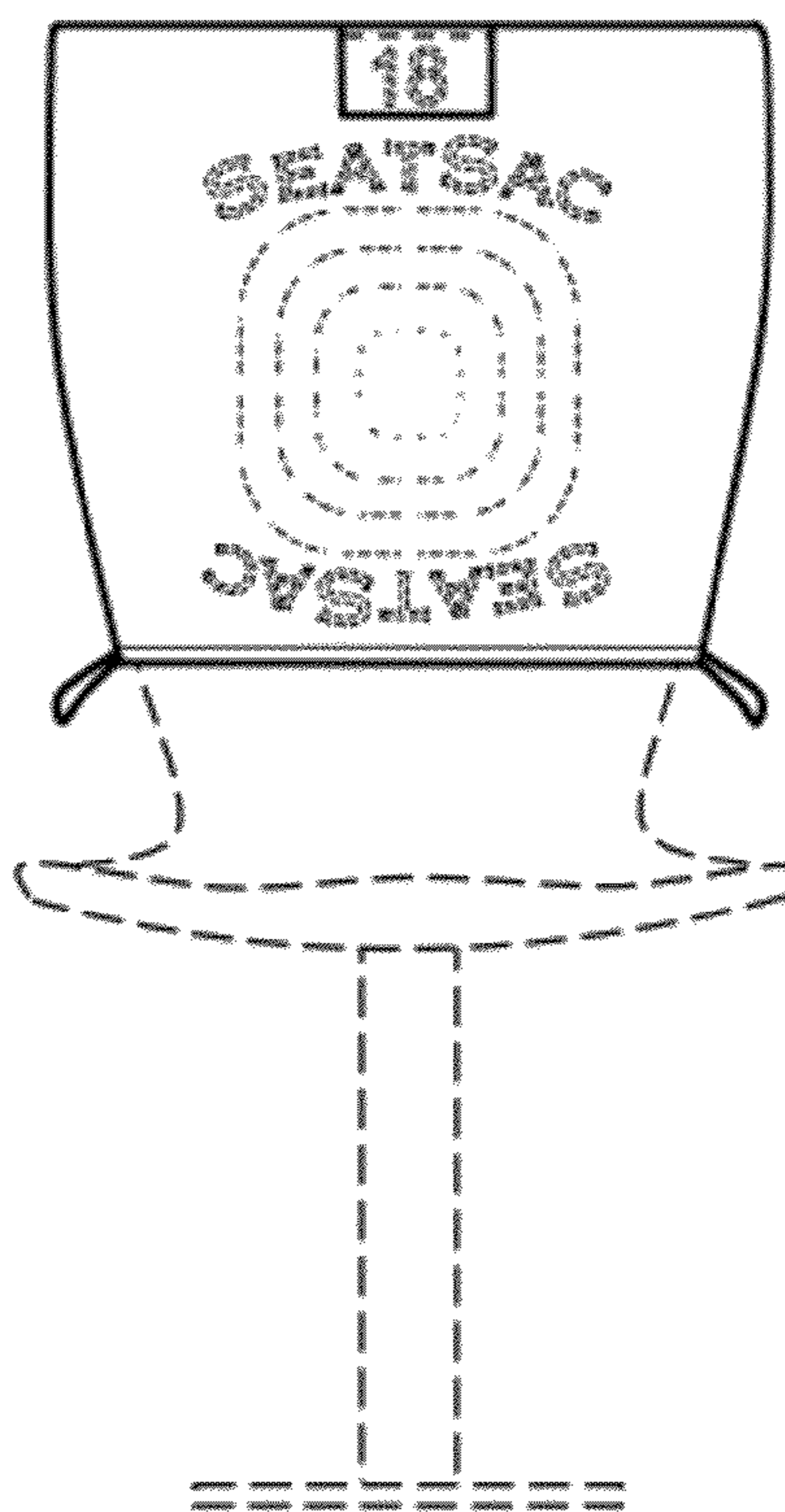

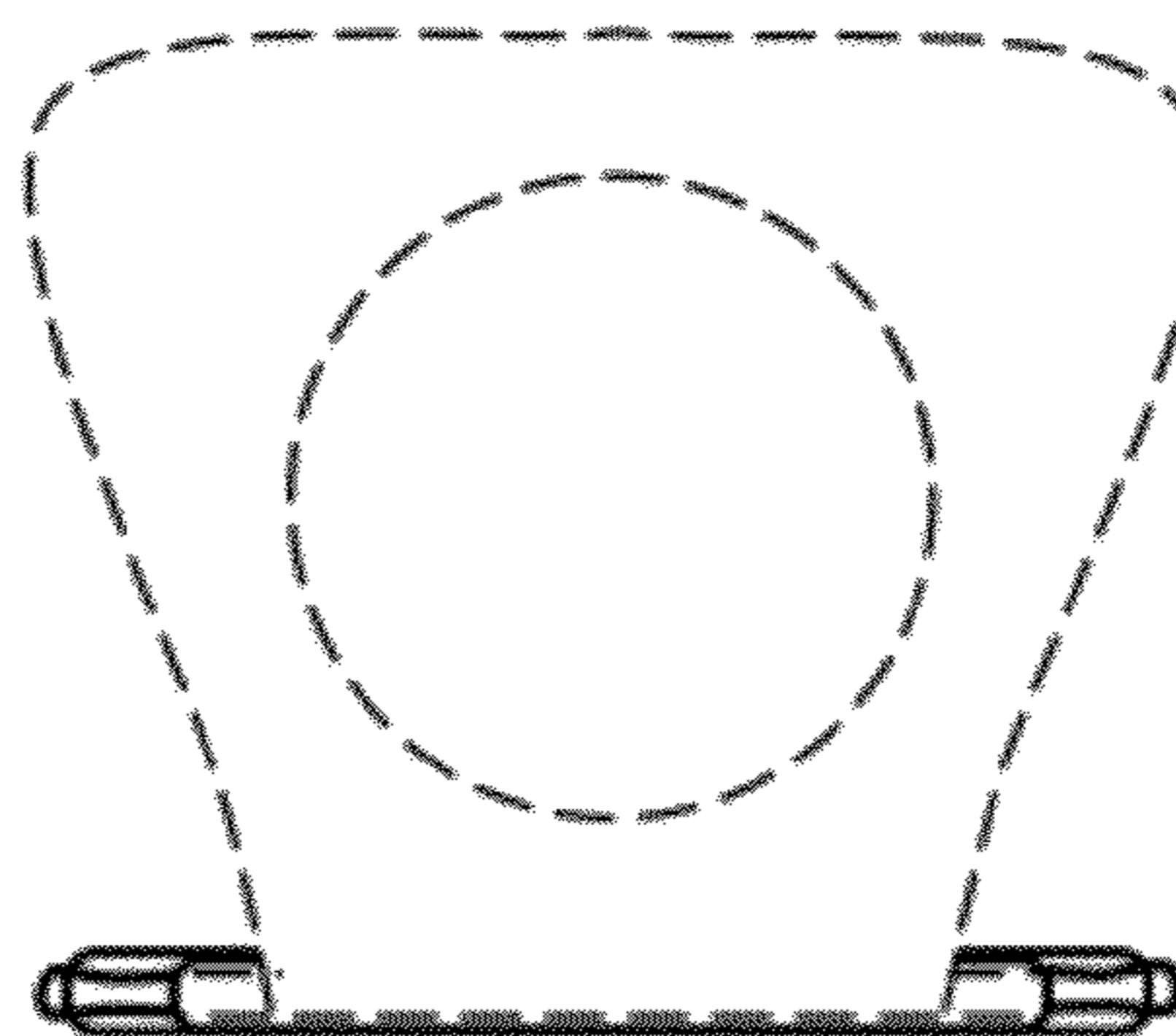

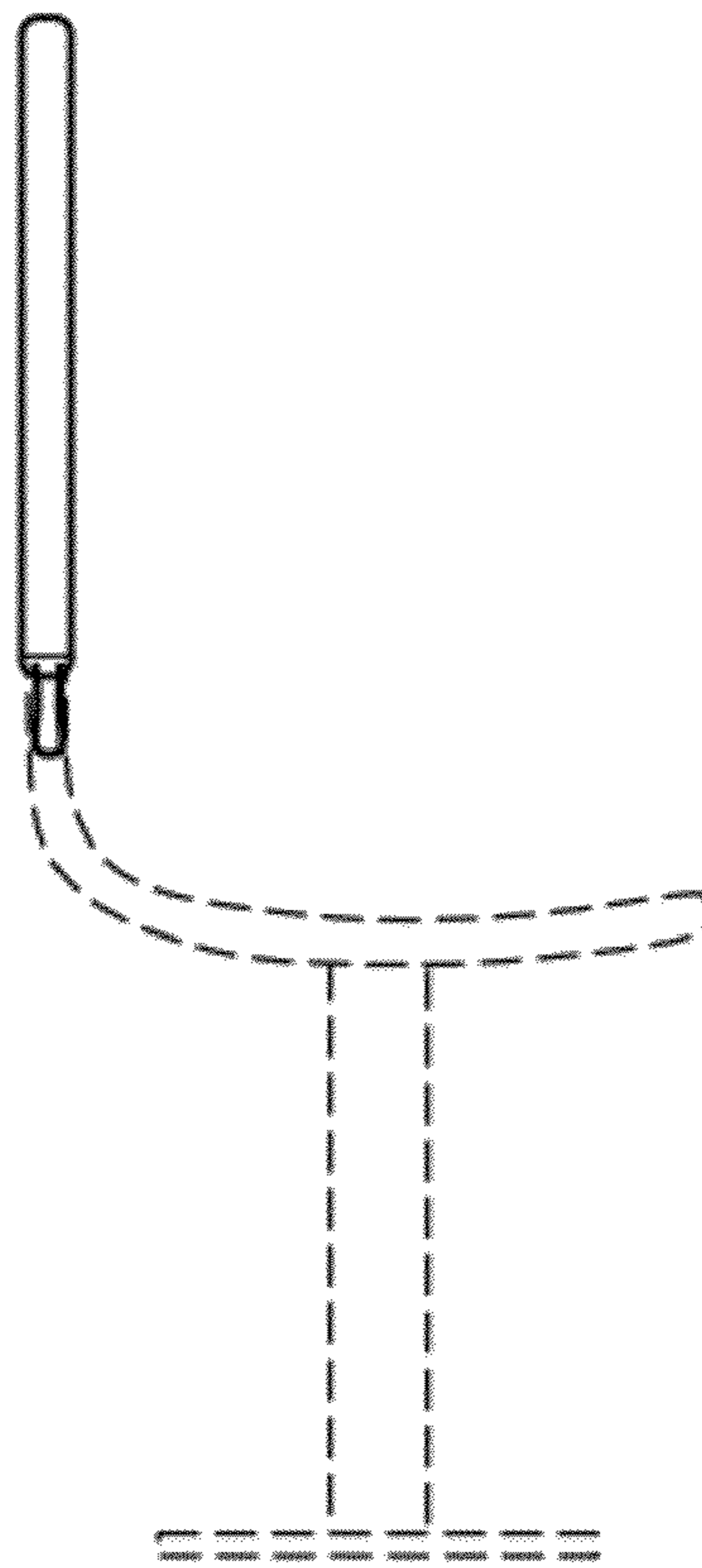
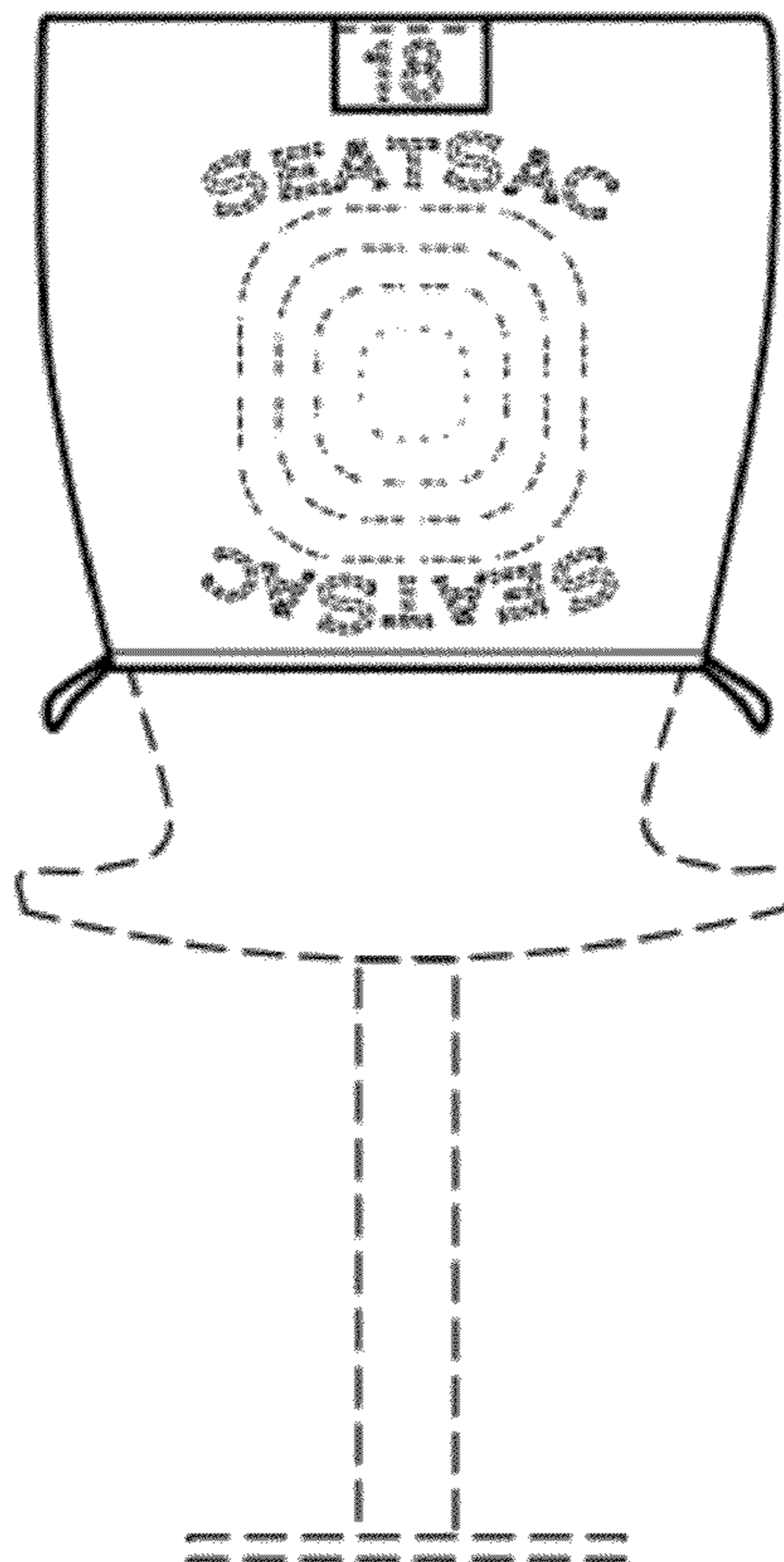

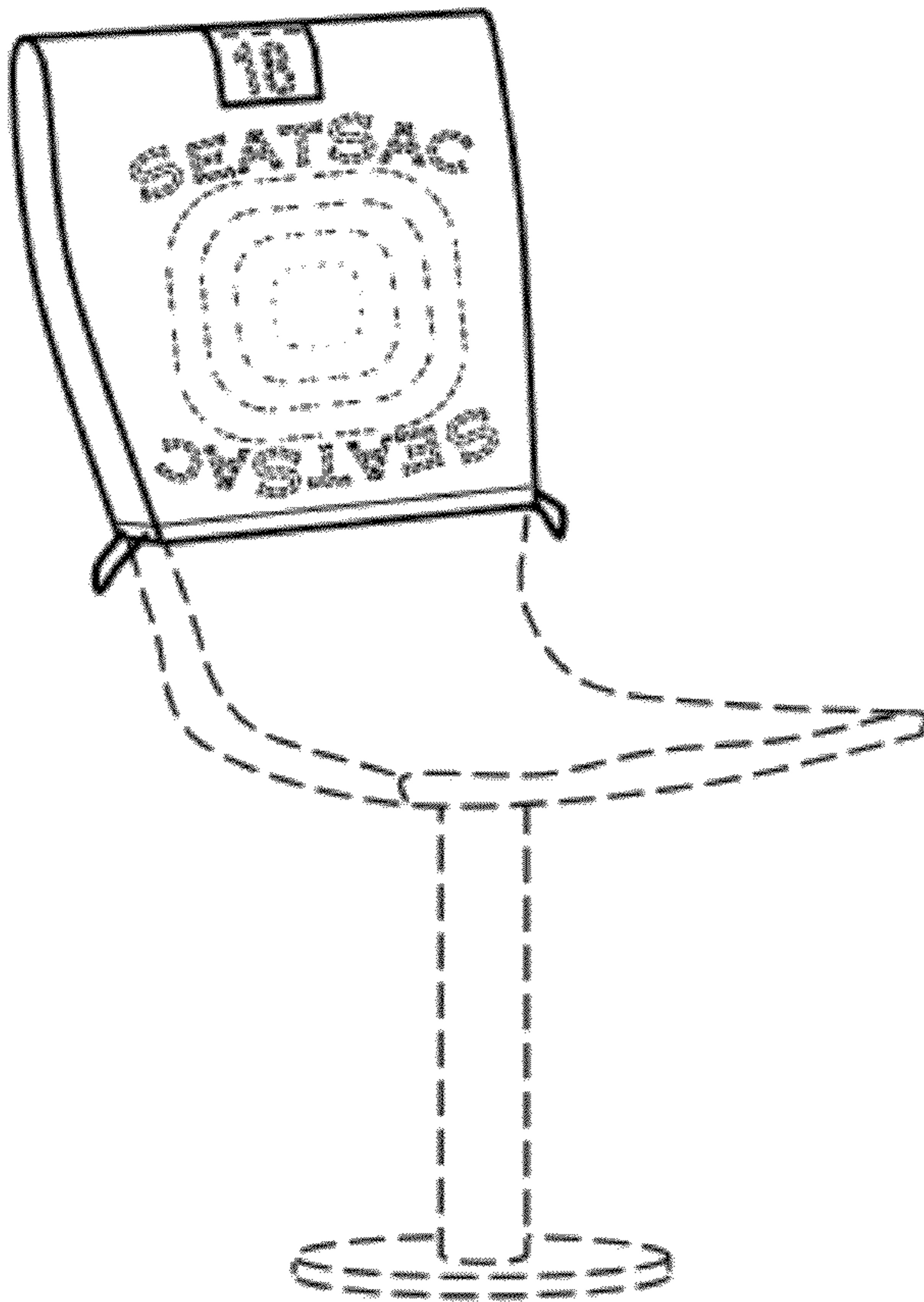
