The ornamental design for a shirt with diagonal pocket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shirt with diagonal pocket showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

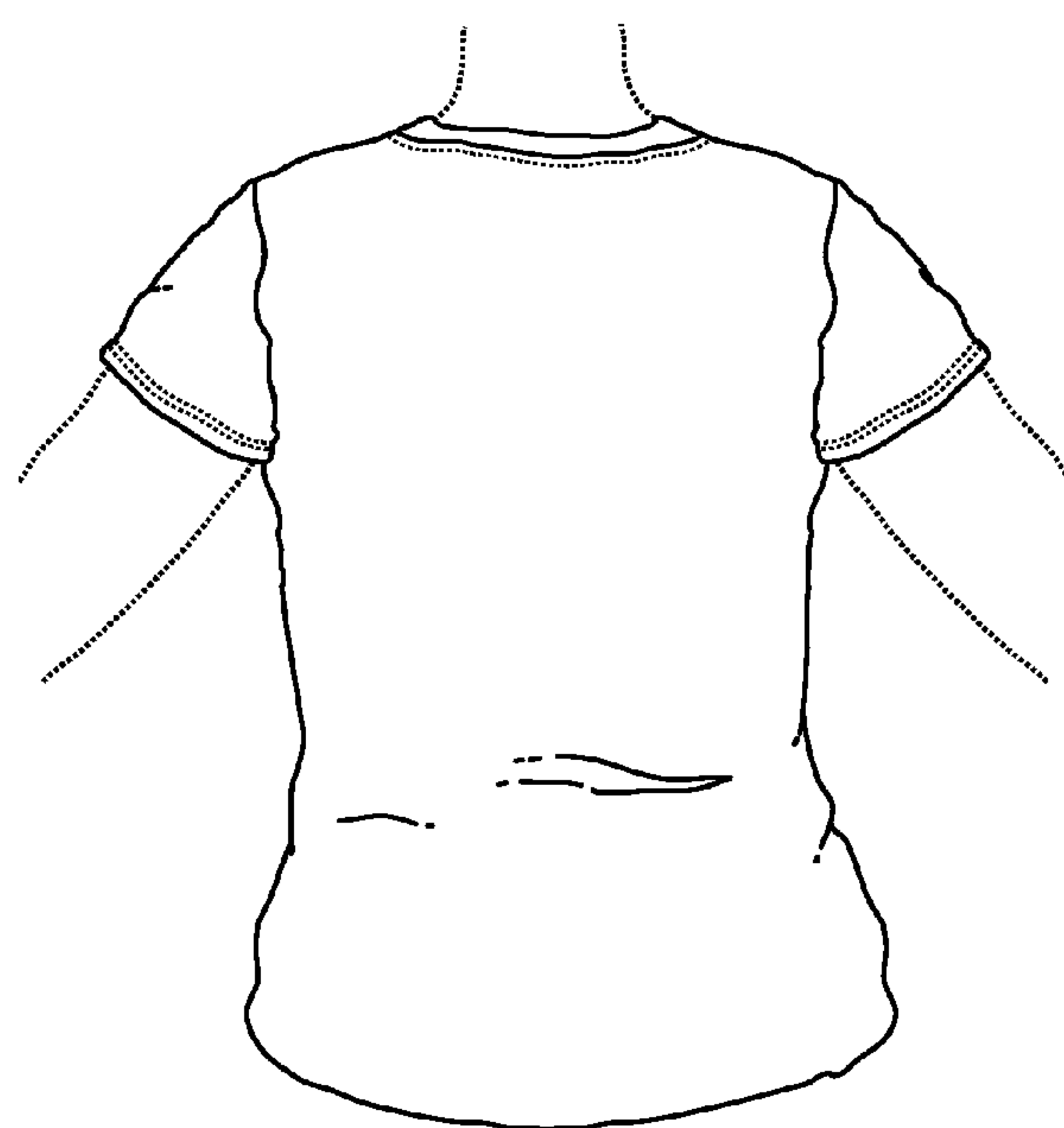
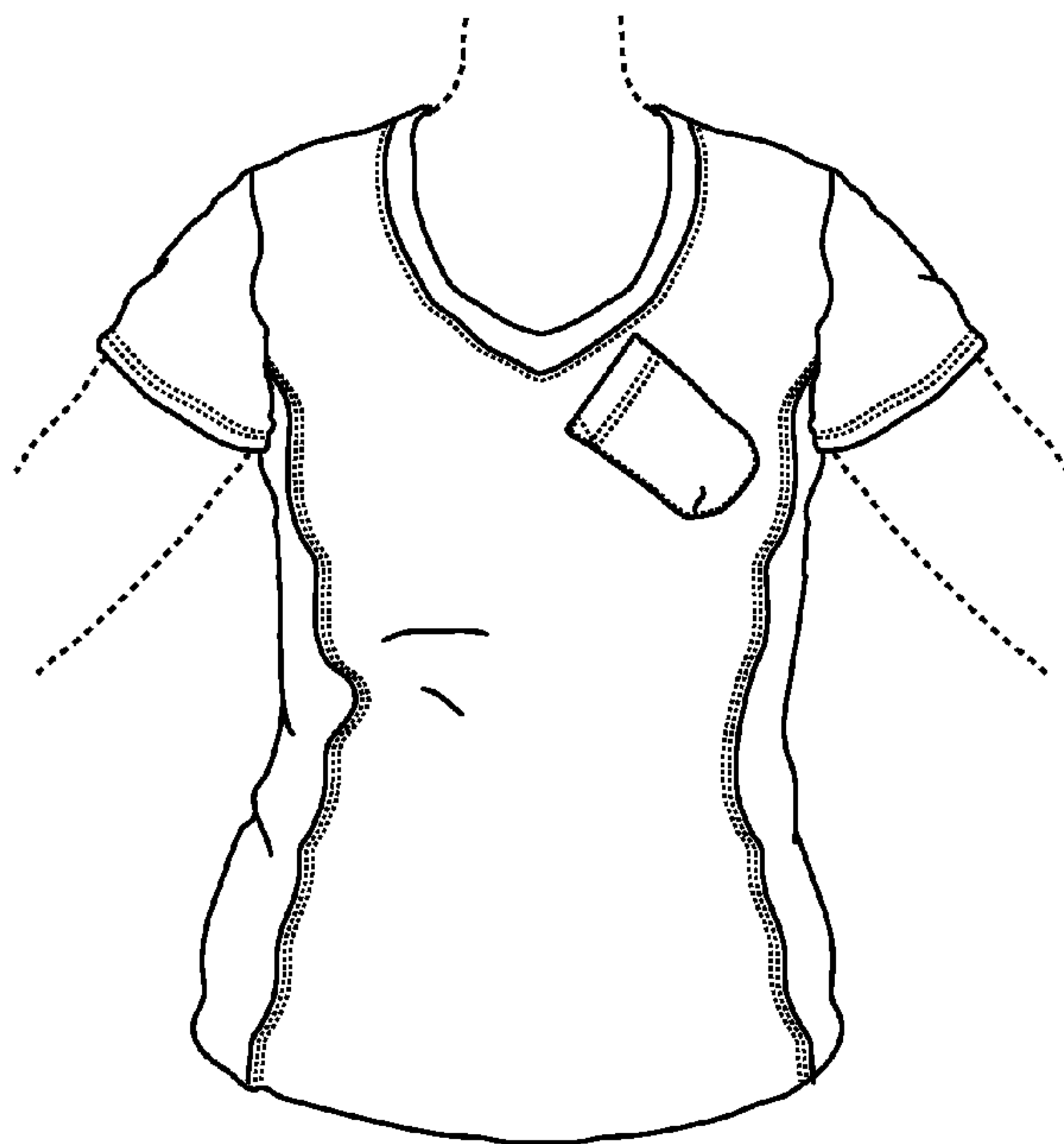
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

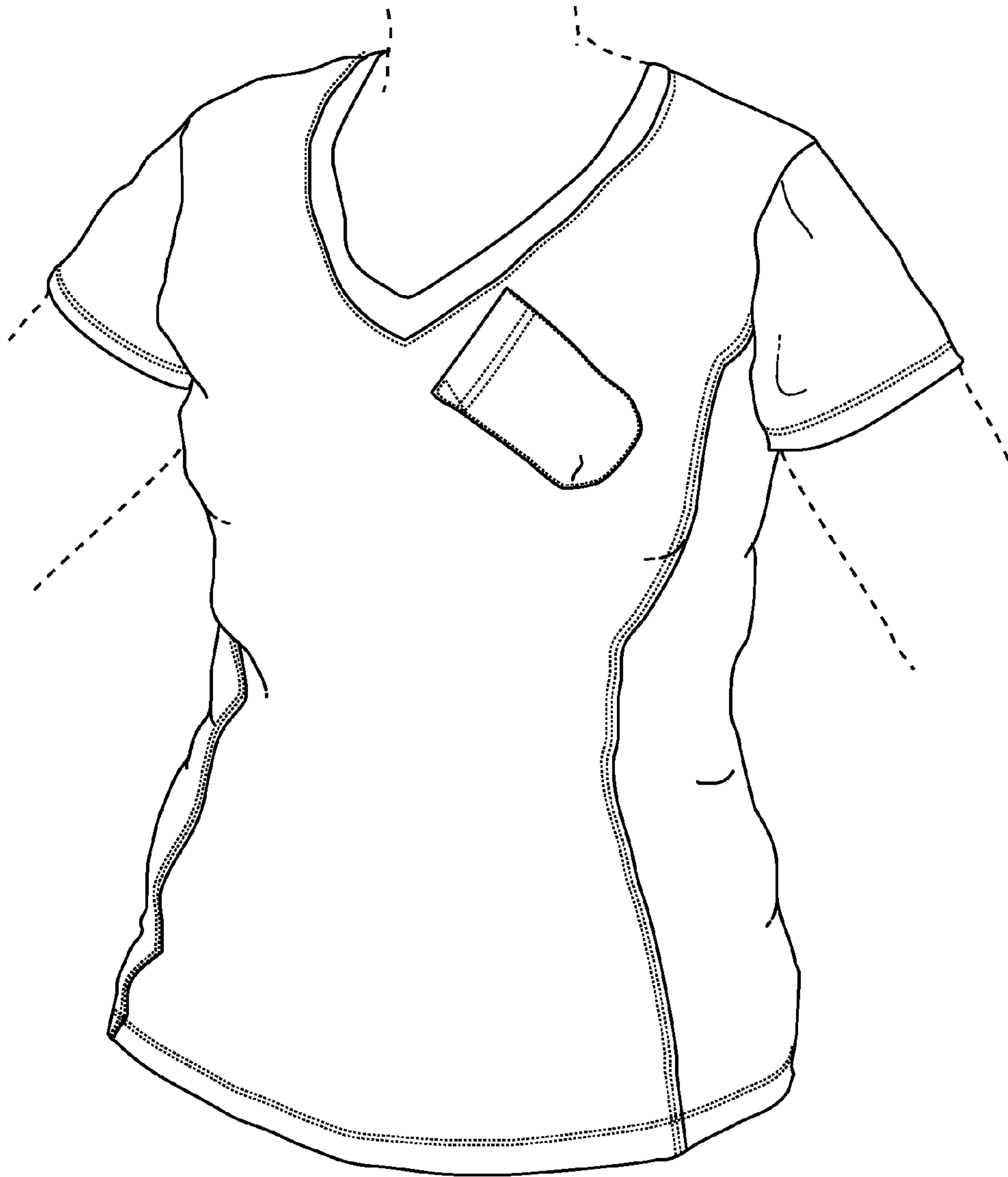

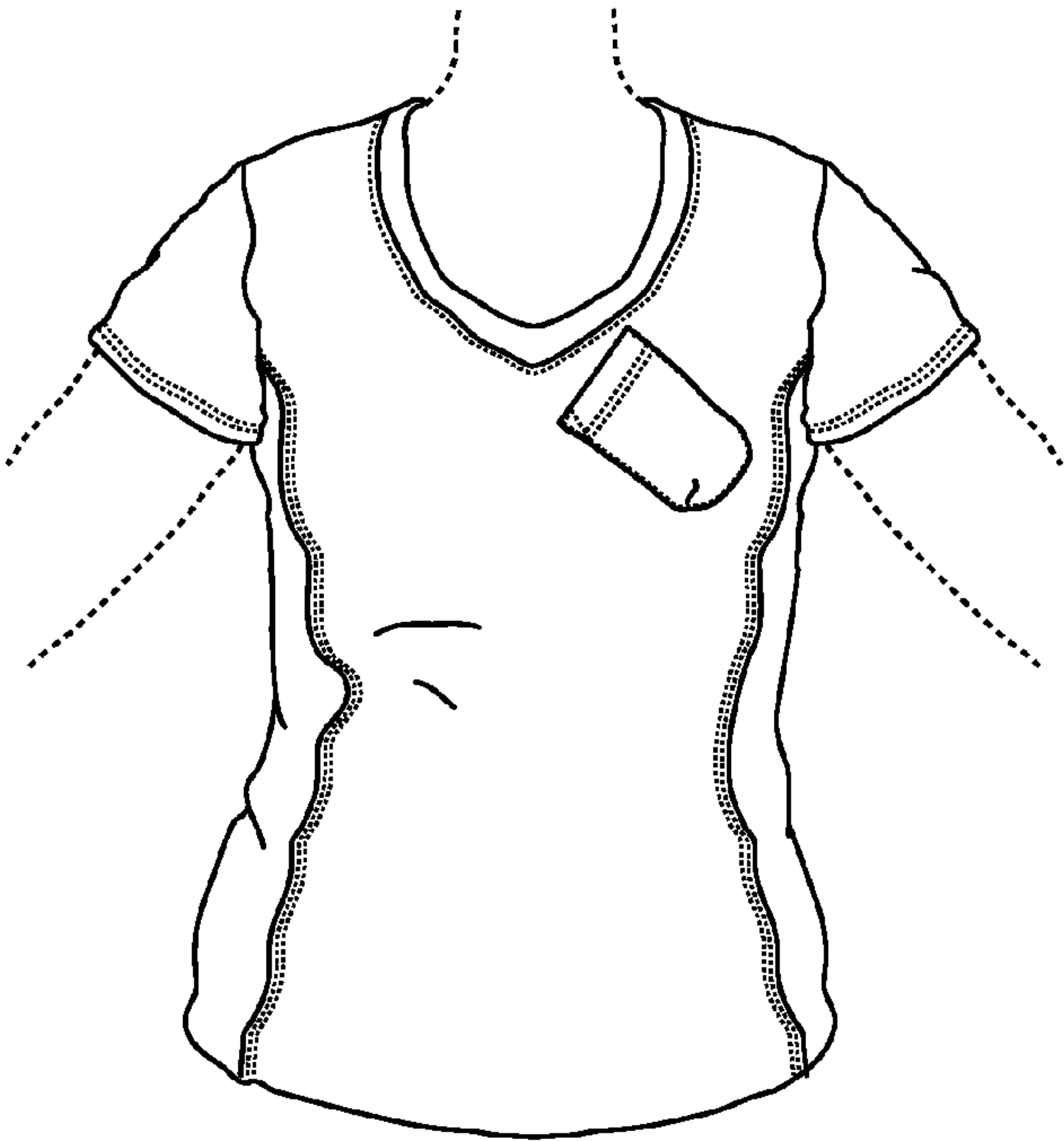

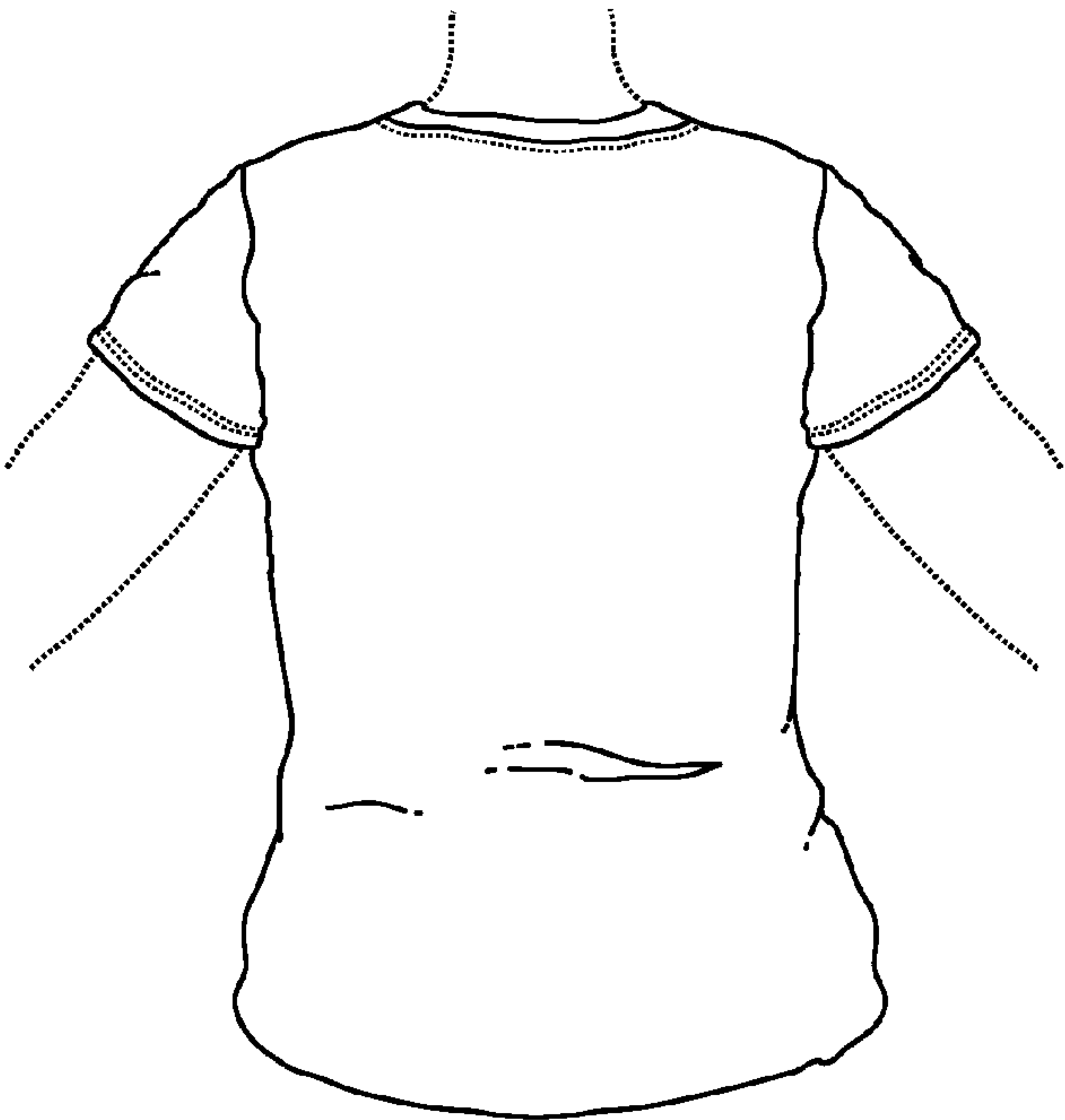

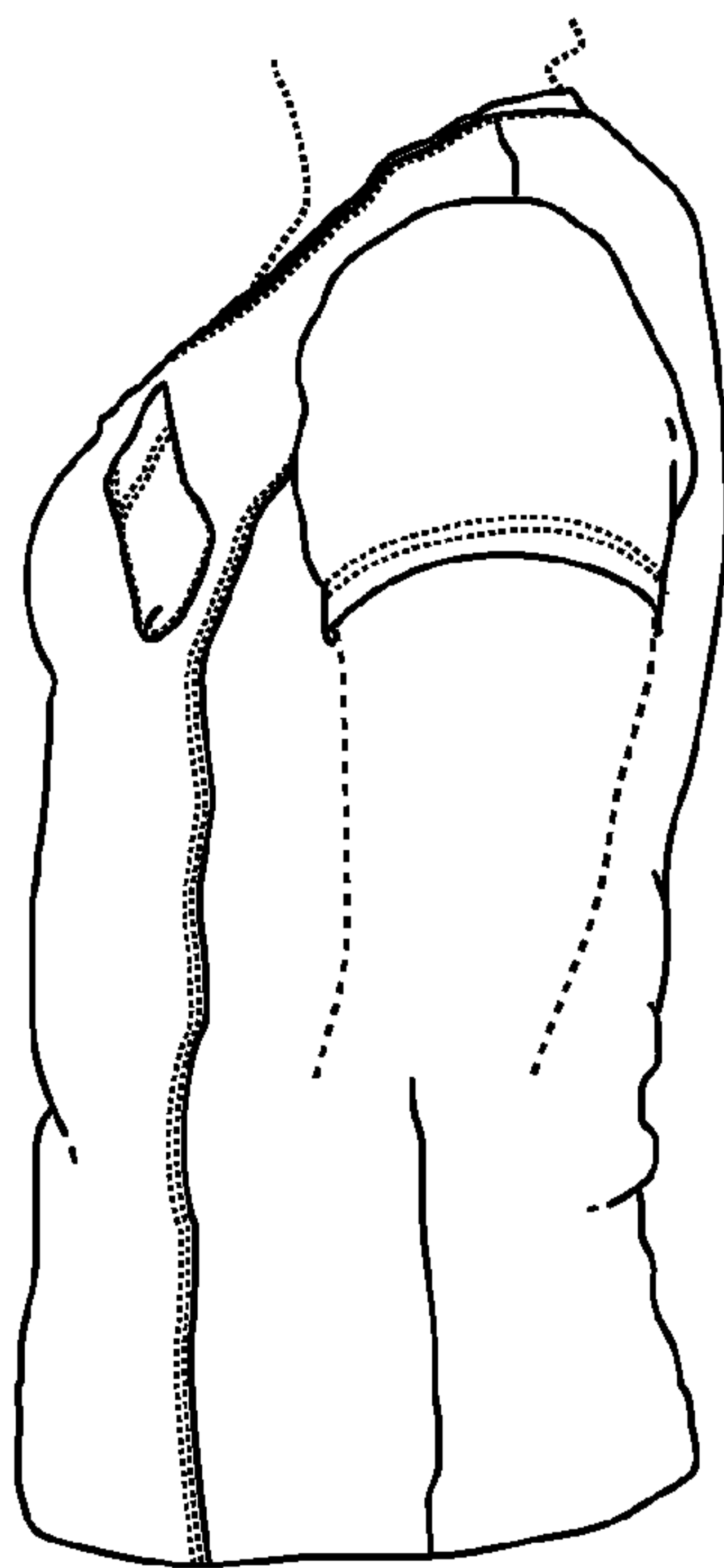

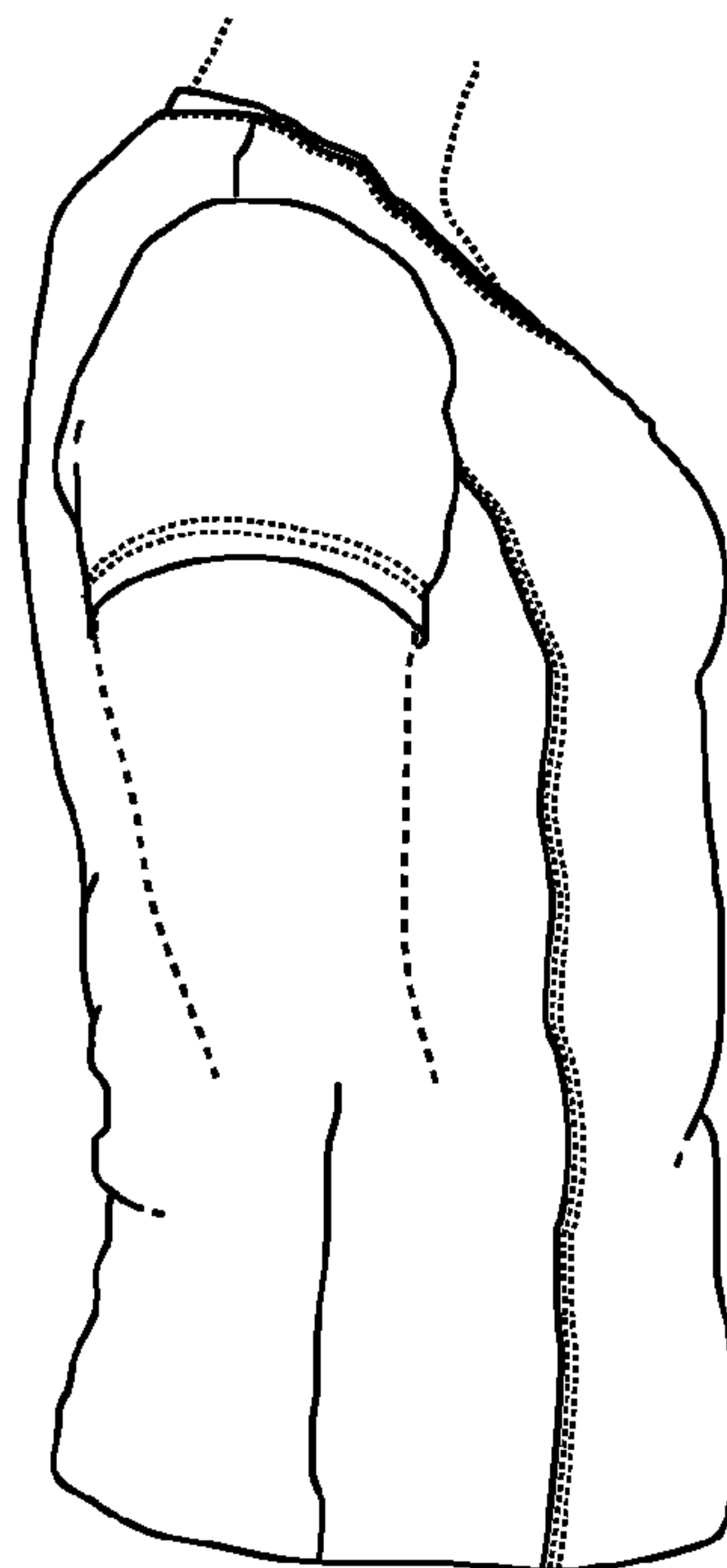

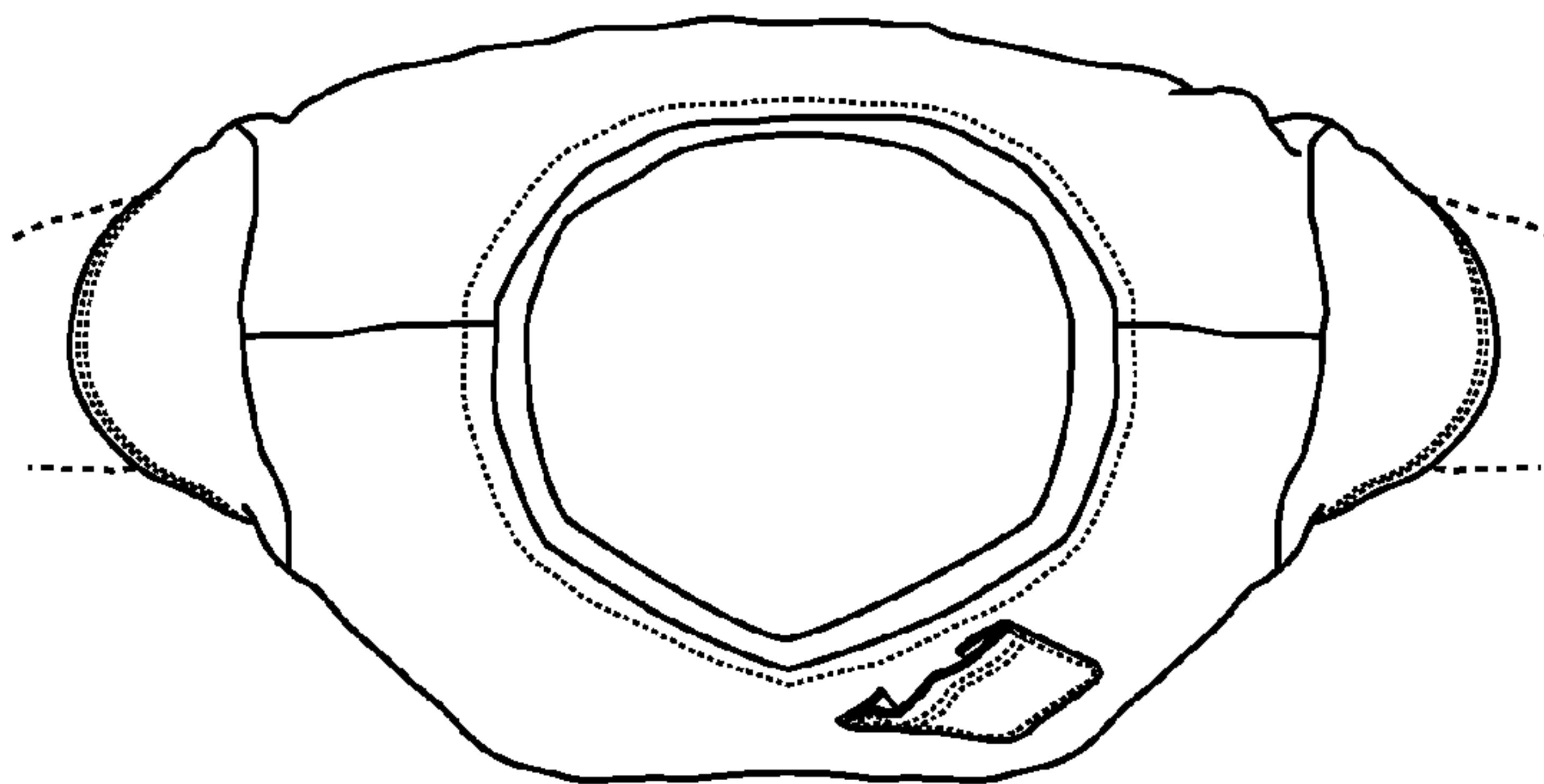

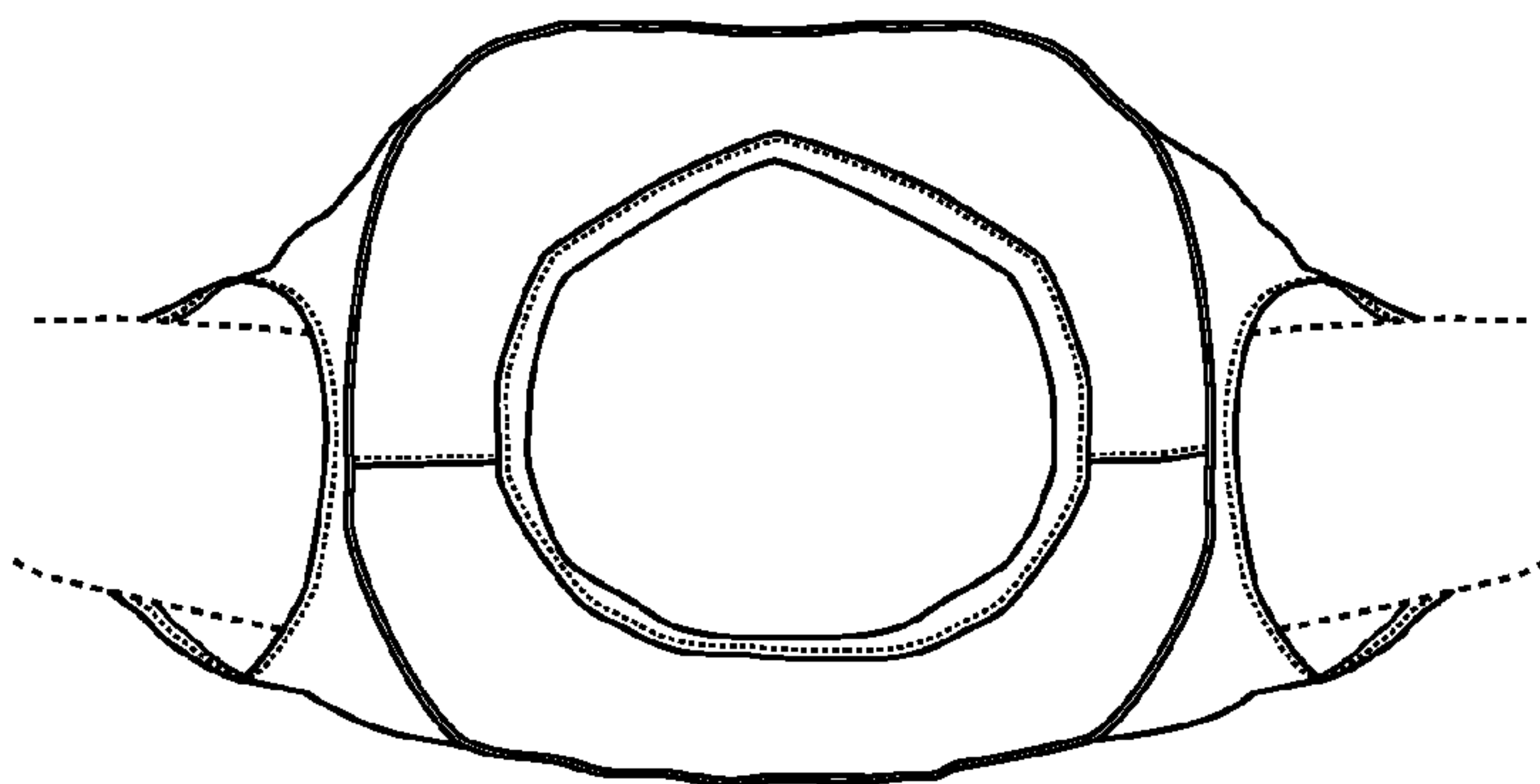
