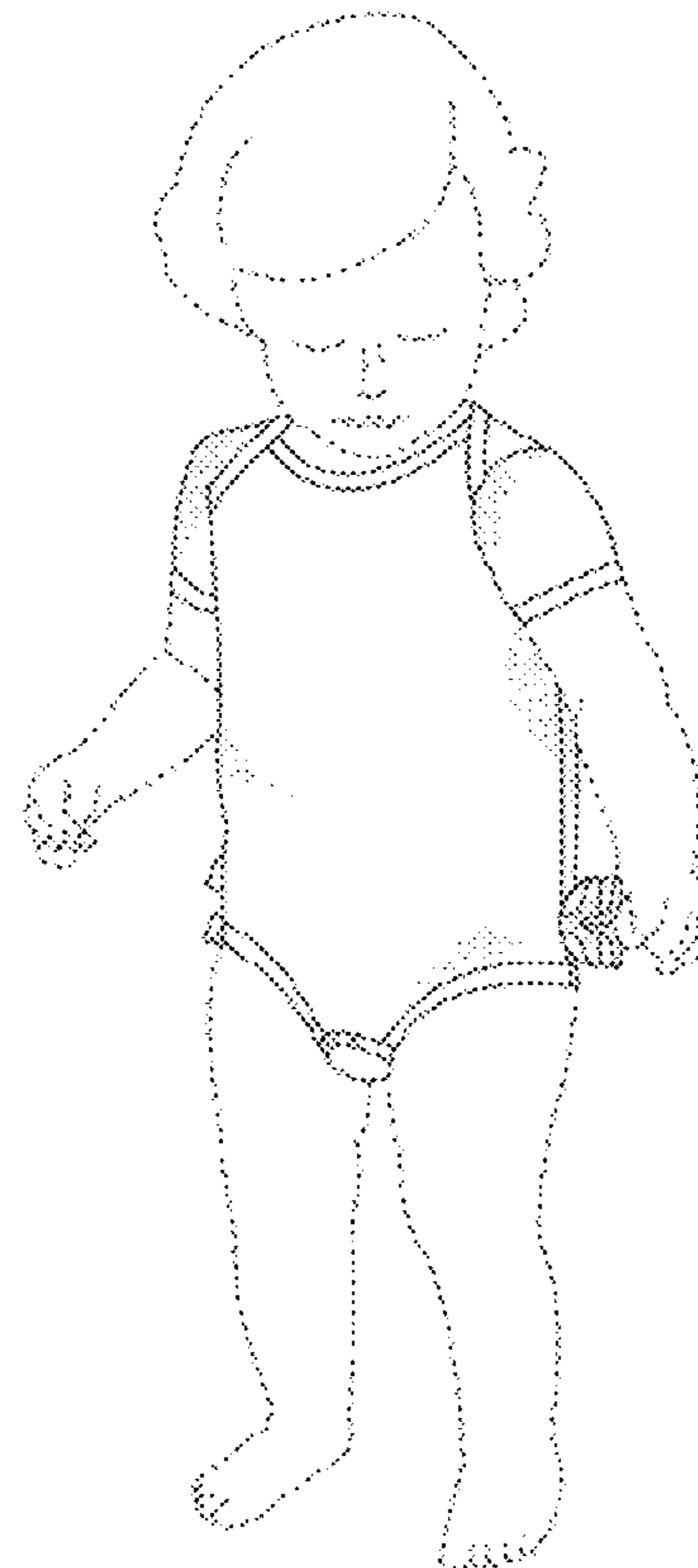
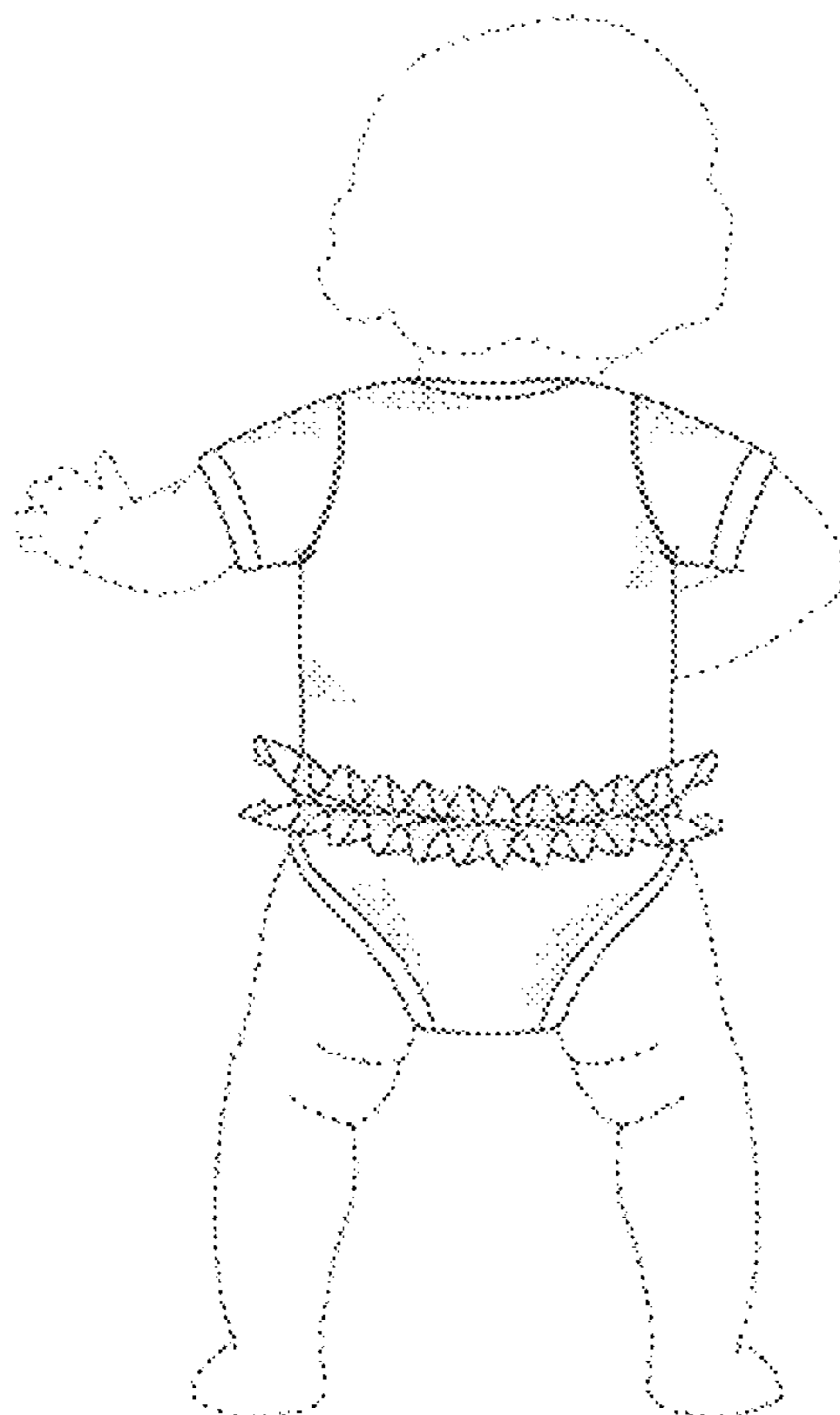
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an infant's garment, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is the rear perspective view of an infant's garment showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is the front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is the rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is the front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is the left side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is the right side elevational view thereof.
The broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 2, representing portions of the human form, show the design as being worn, and form no part of the claimed design.

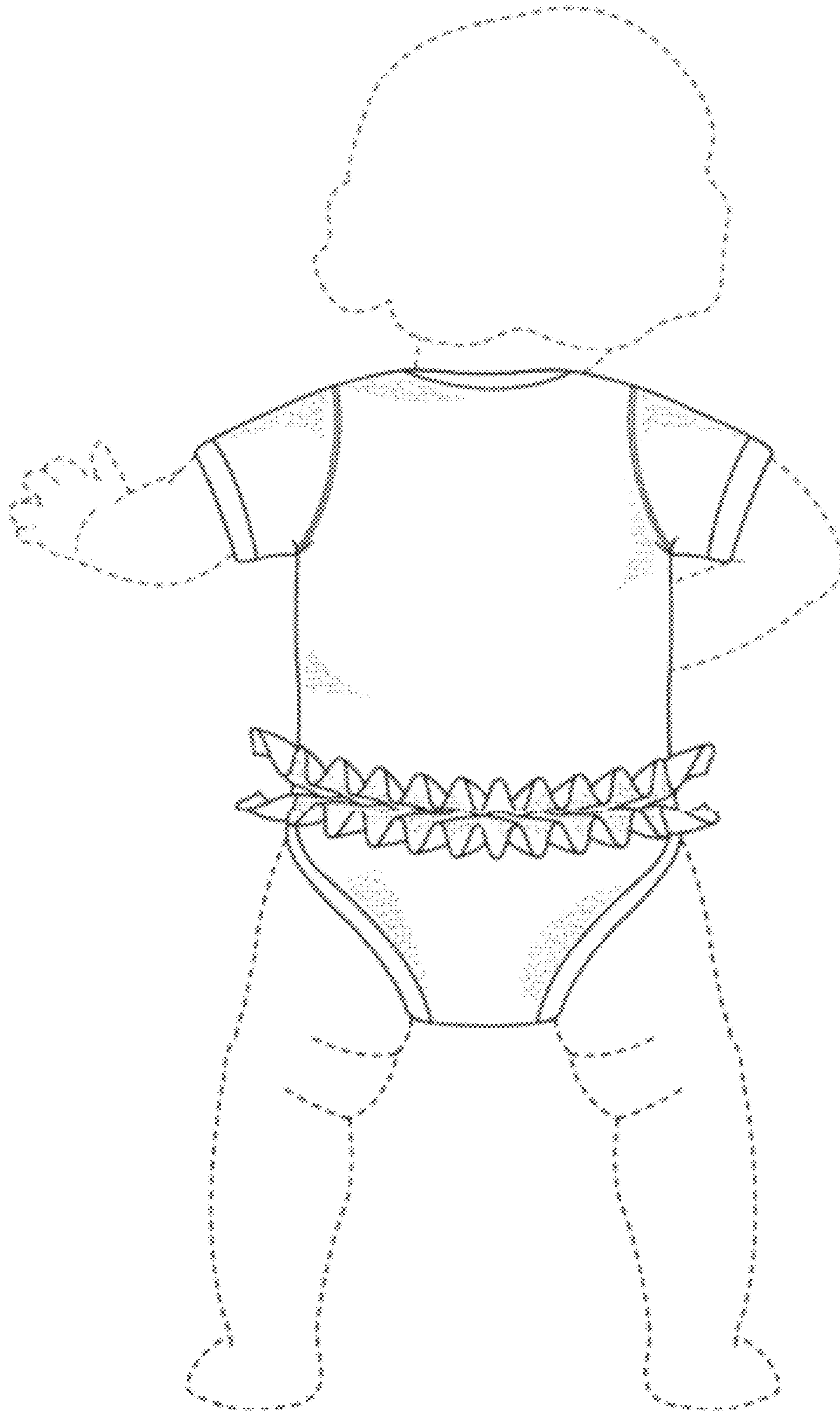

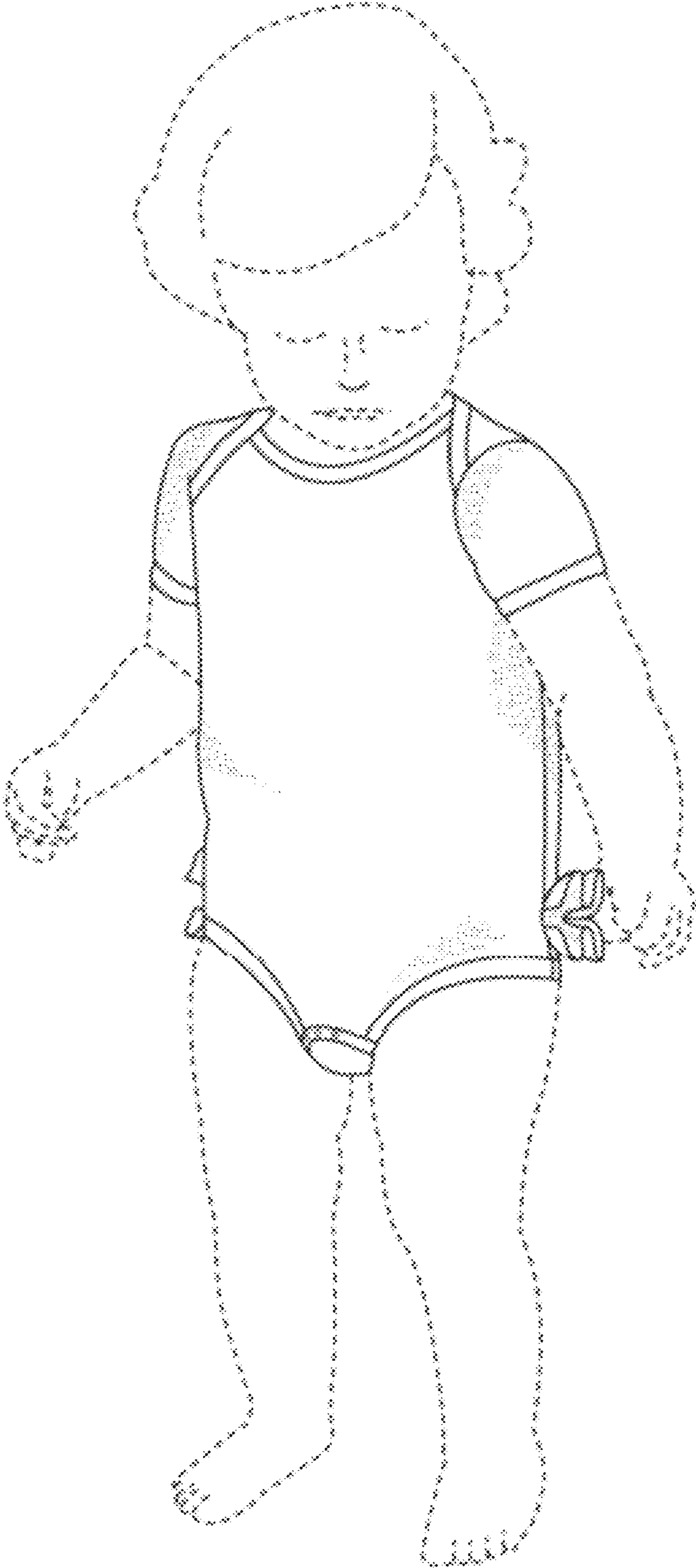

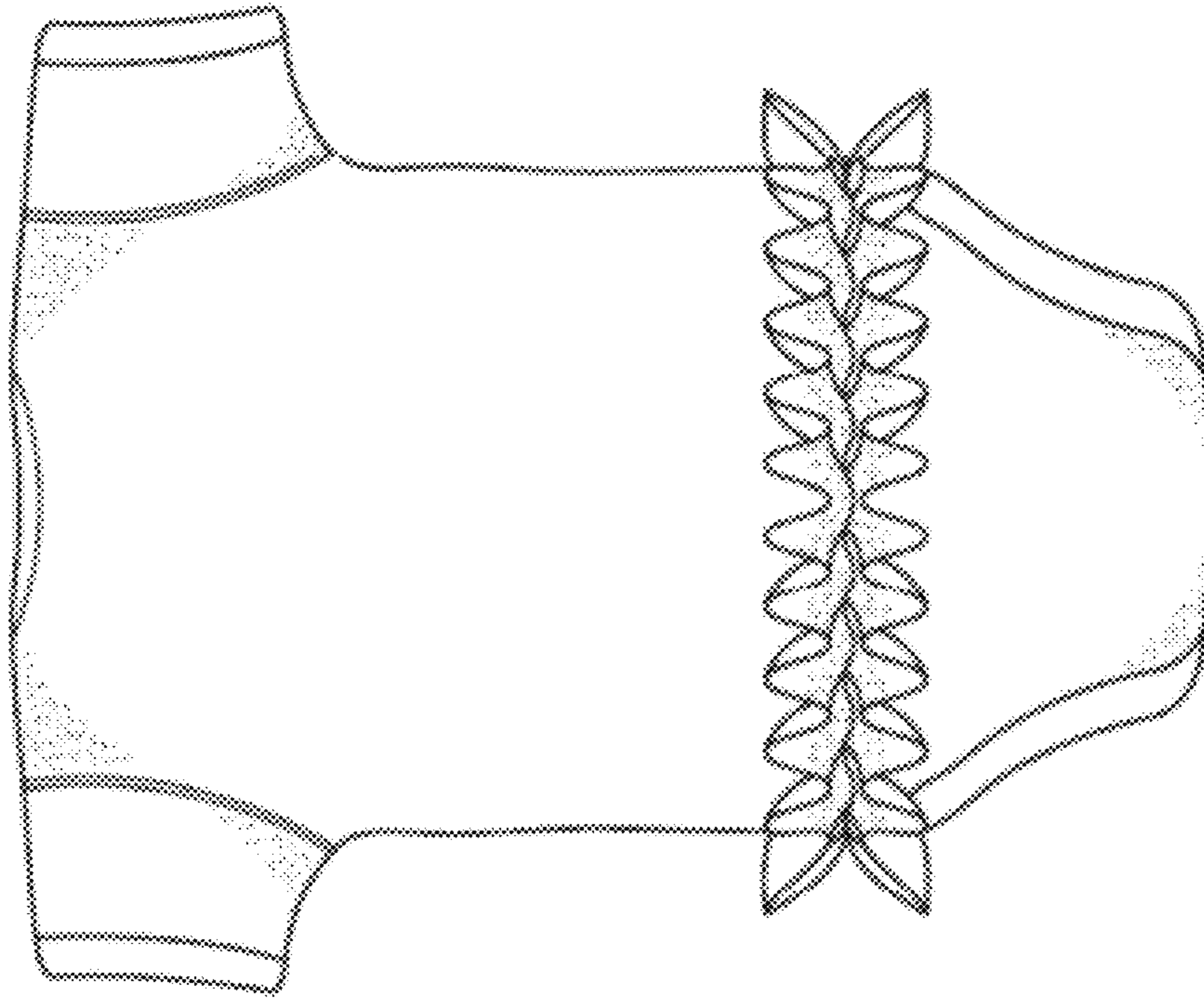

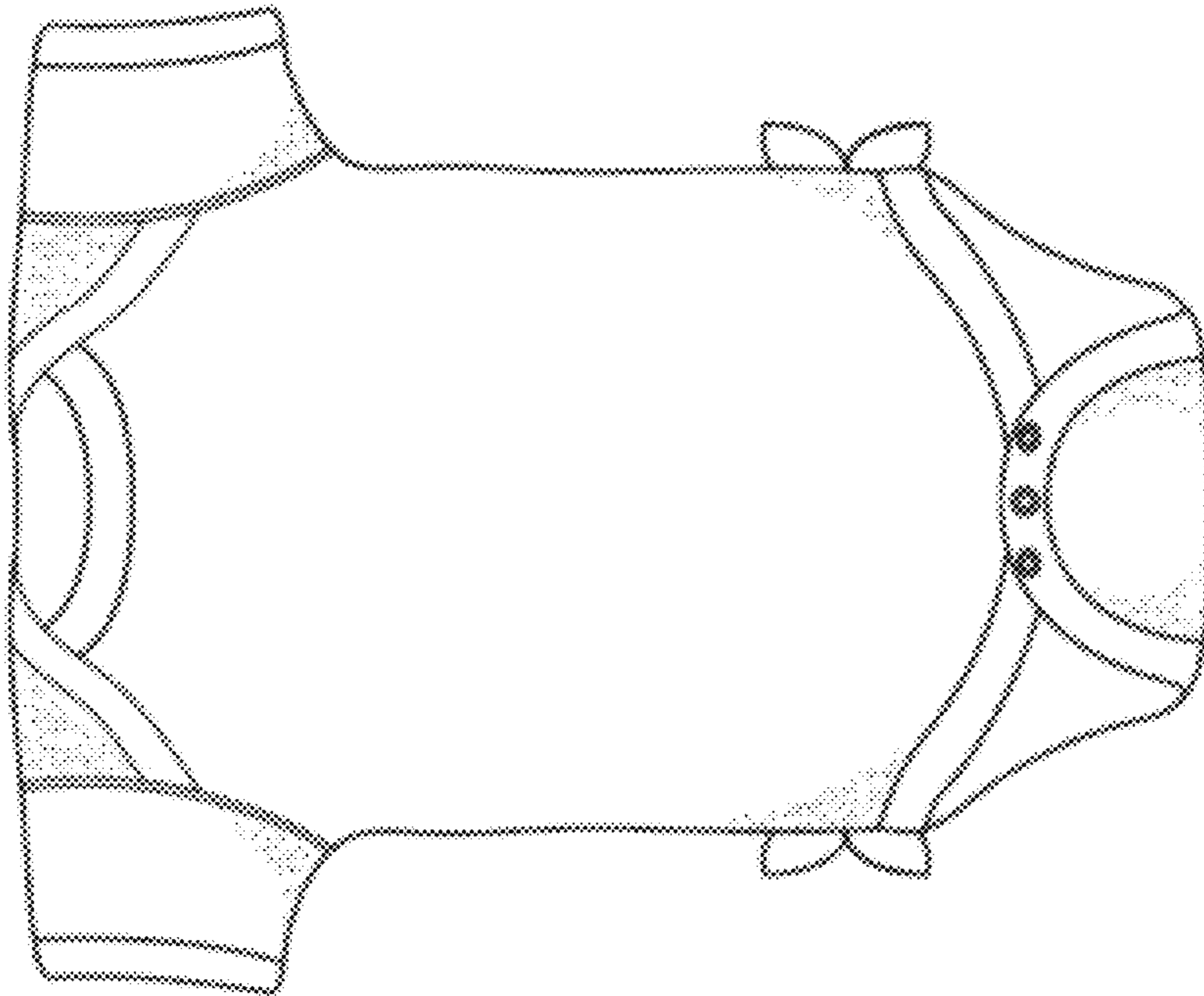

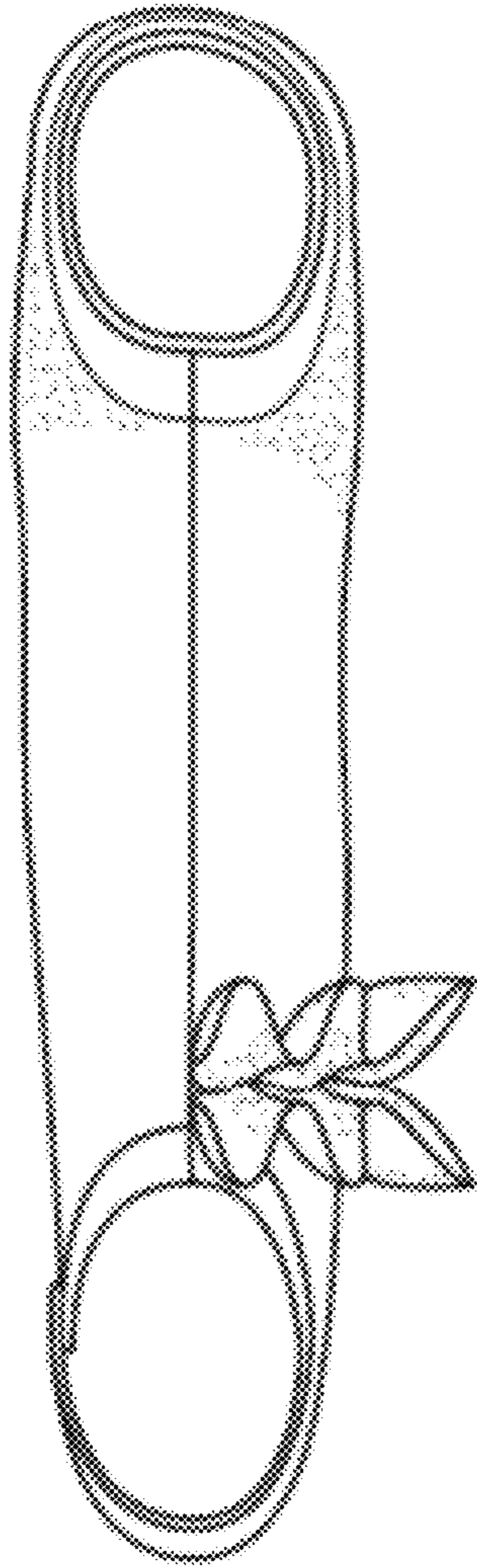

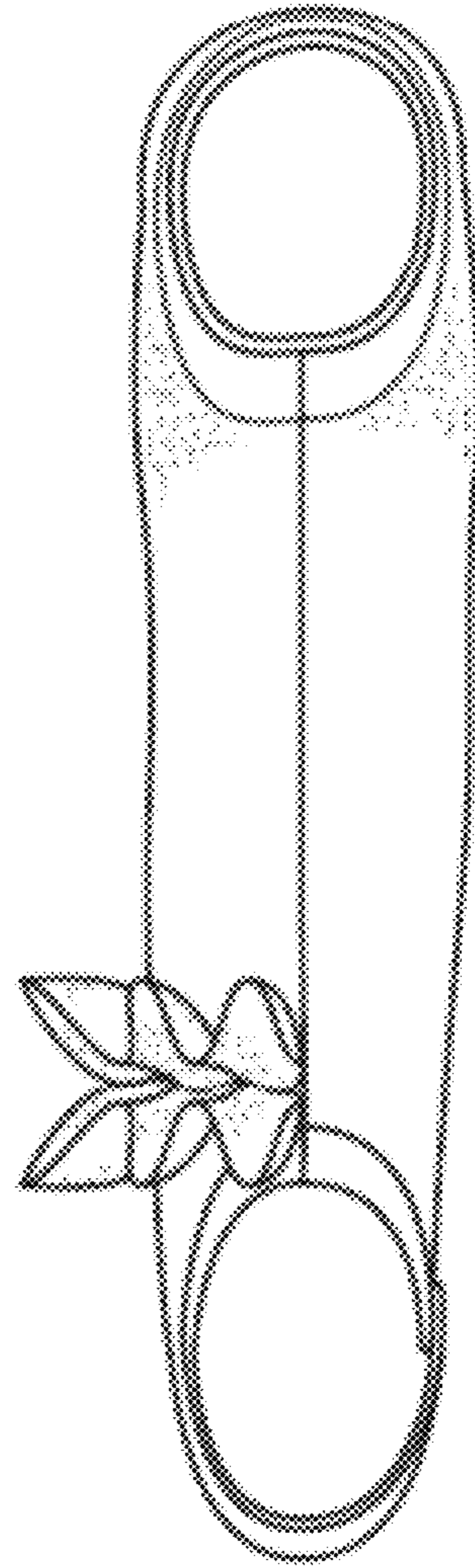
