The ornamental design for a container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my design for a container.

FIG. 2 is a sagittal perspective view of my new design for a container through the line 2-2 of FIG. 5, showing the interior configuration thereof.

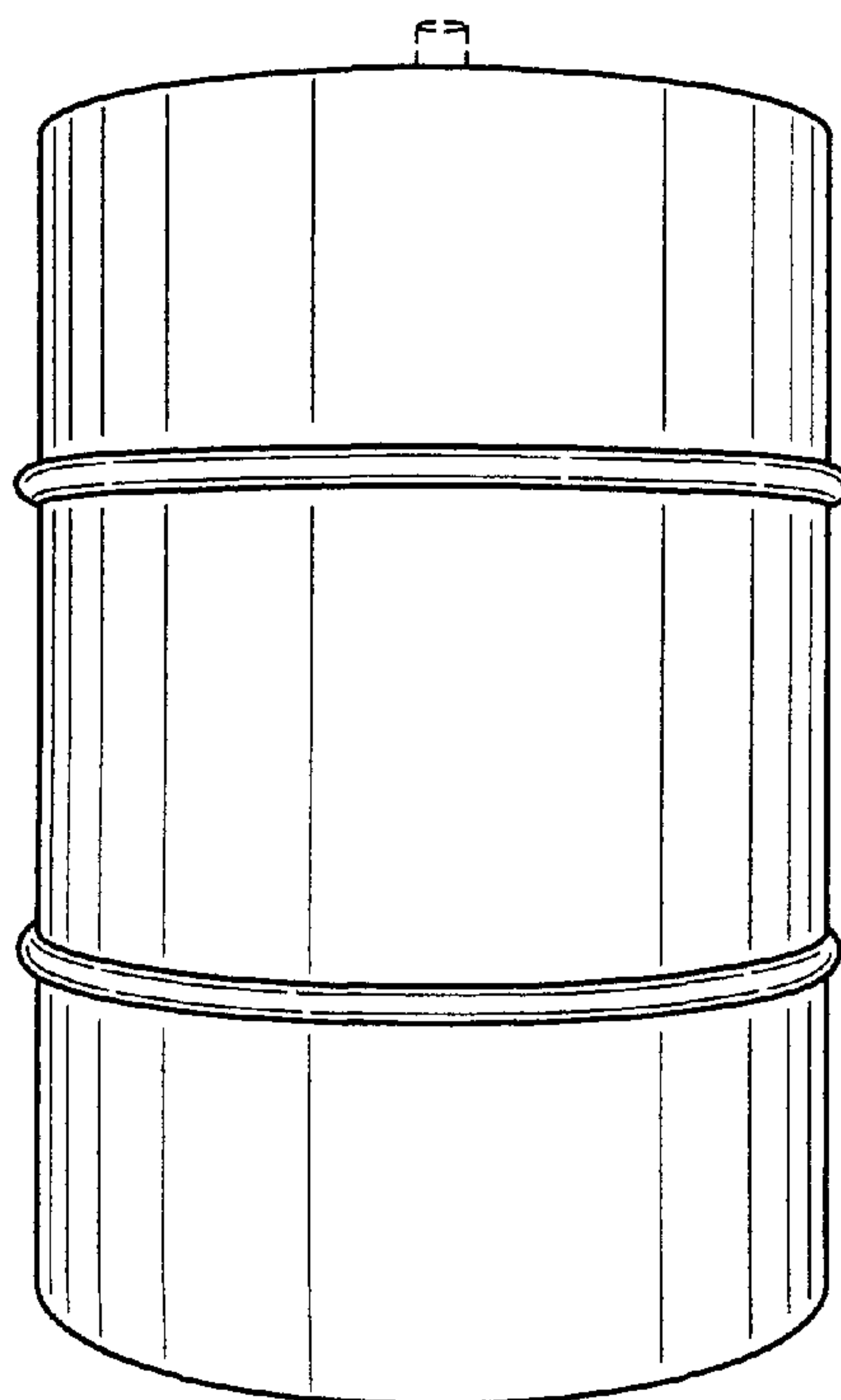
FIG. 3 is a elevational view of the front of the container of my new design.

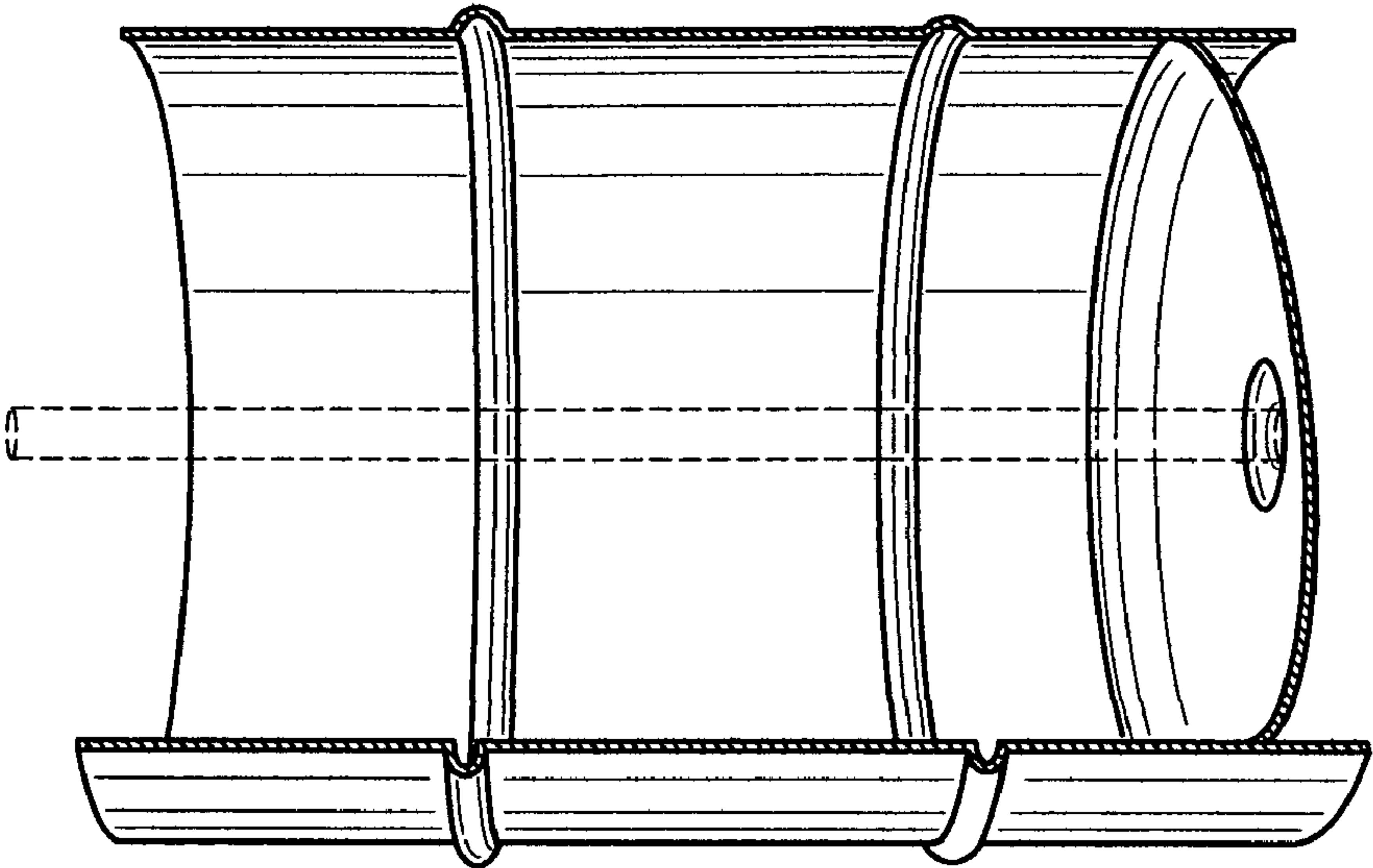

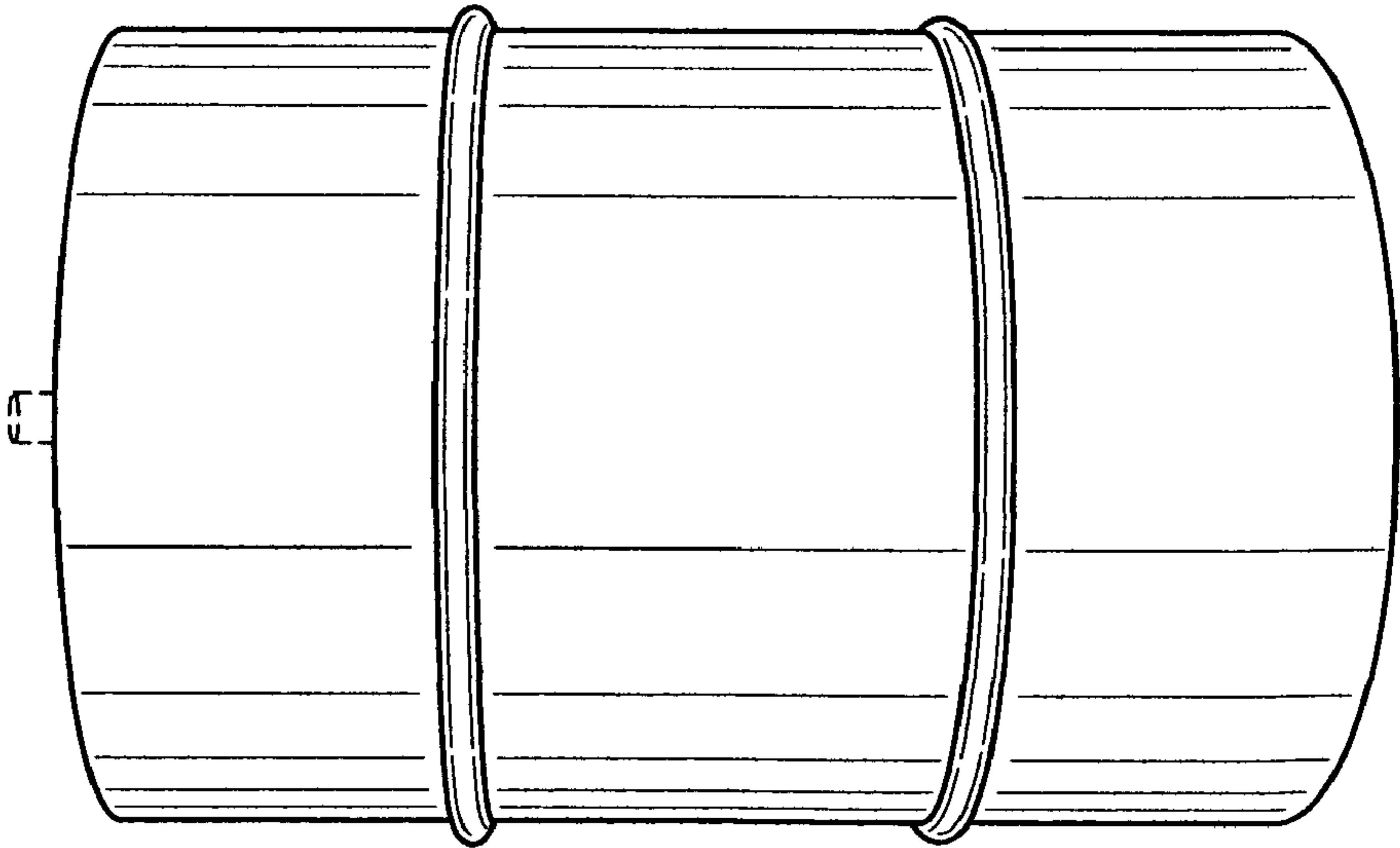

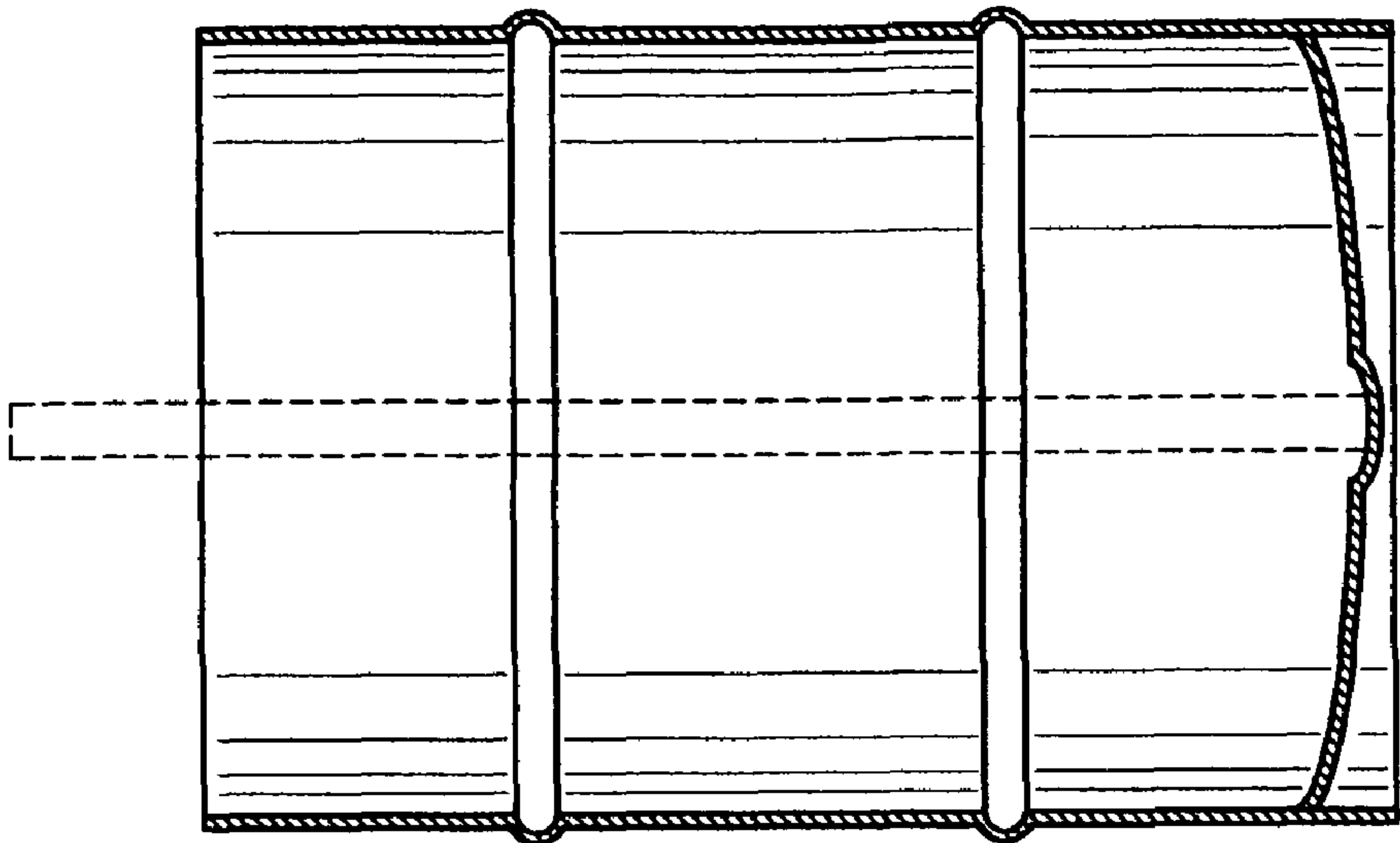

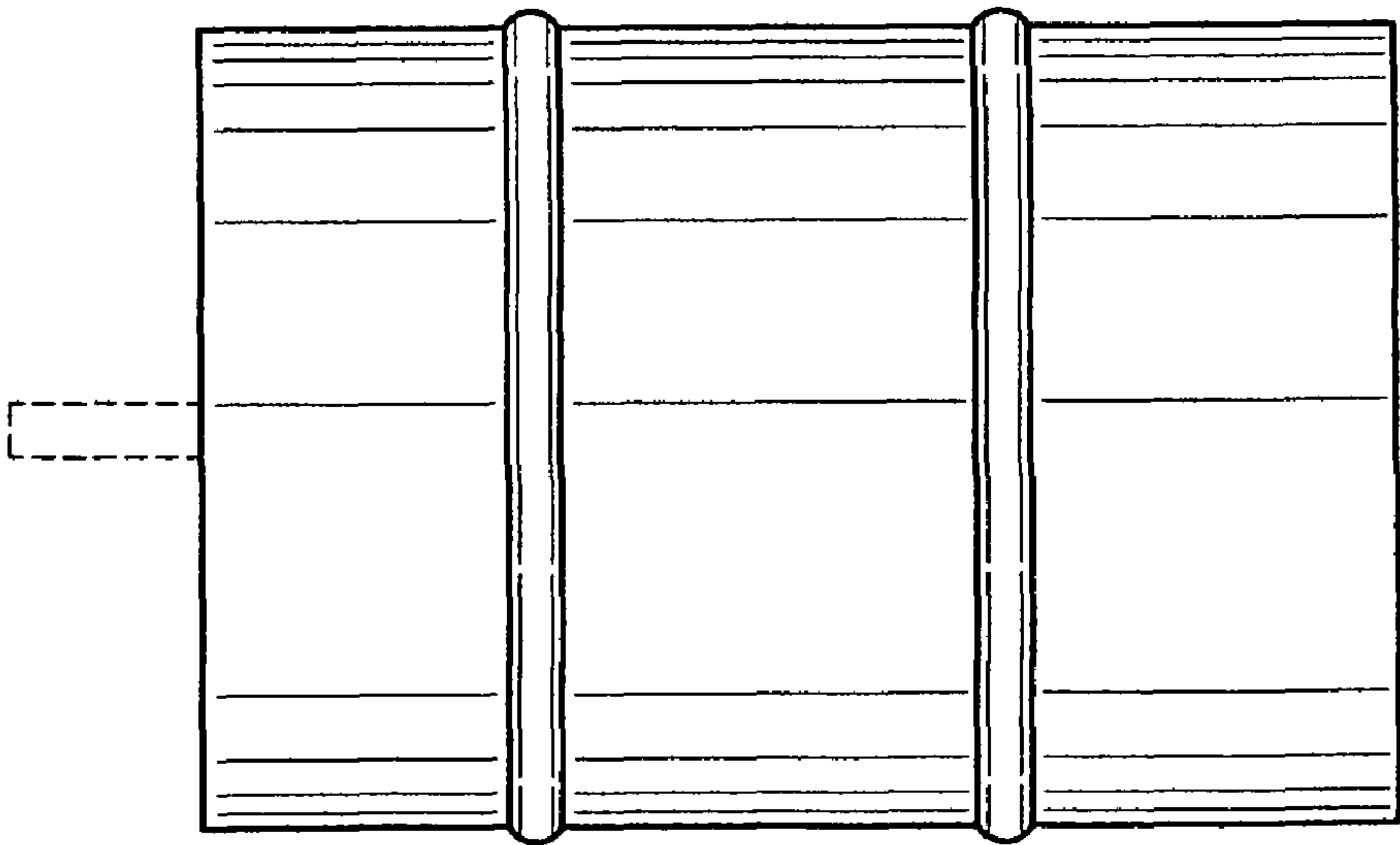

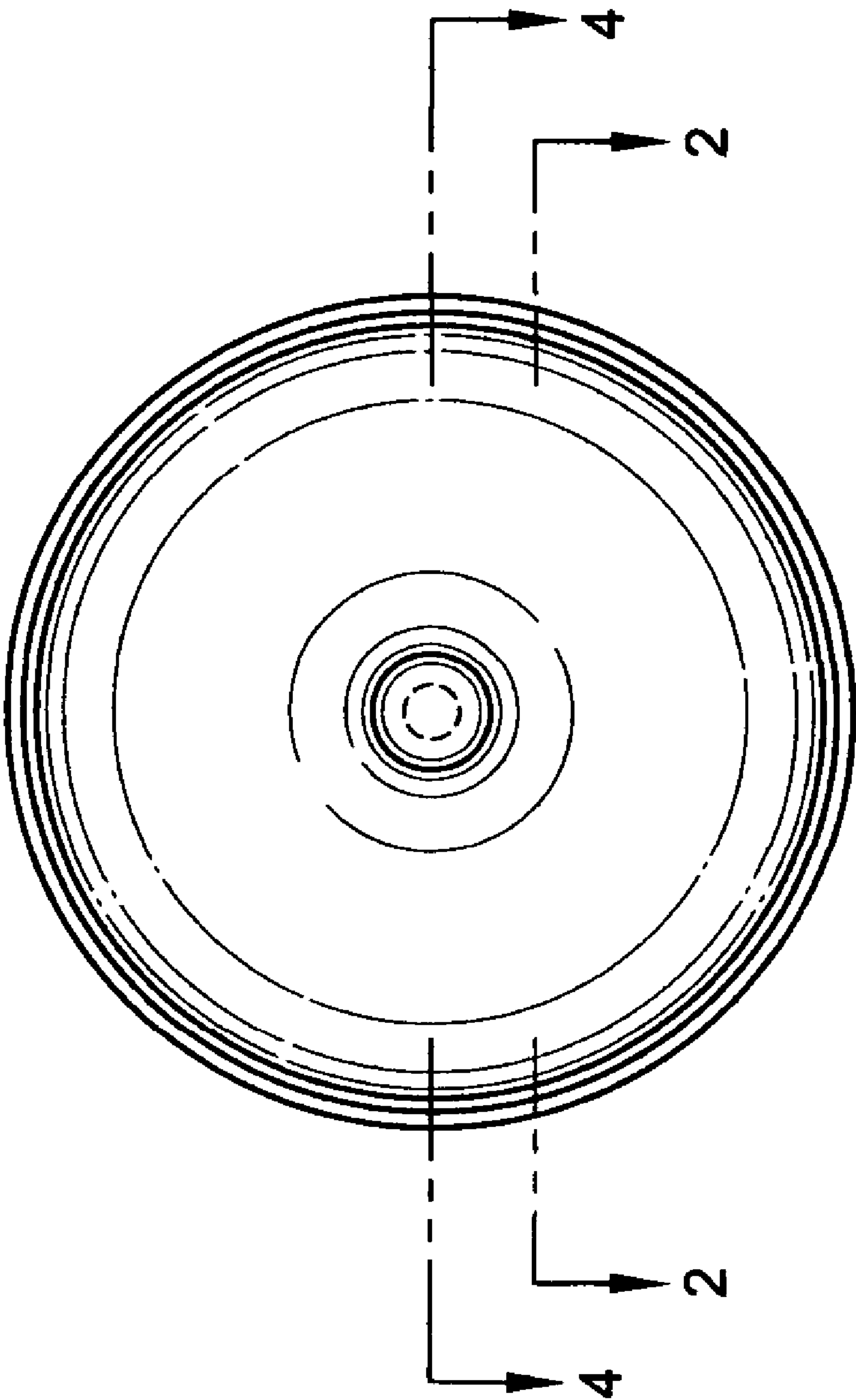
