DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of an element of a boot, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the embodiment of FIG. 1, shown in an alternate position;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a second side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of an element of a boot, showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of the embodiment of FIG. 7, shown in an alternate position;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 7; and,

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 7.

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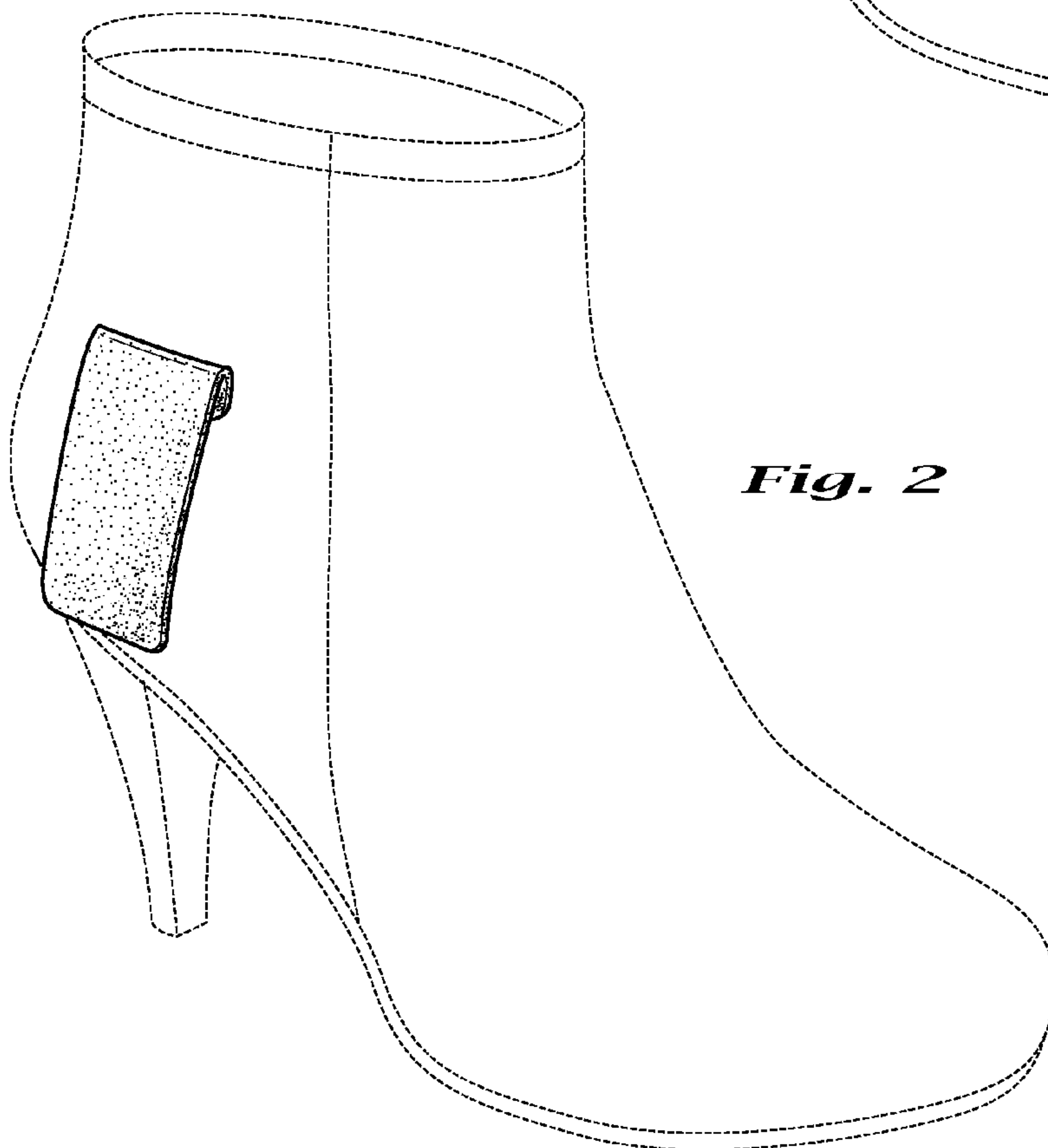

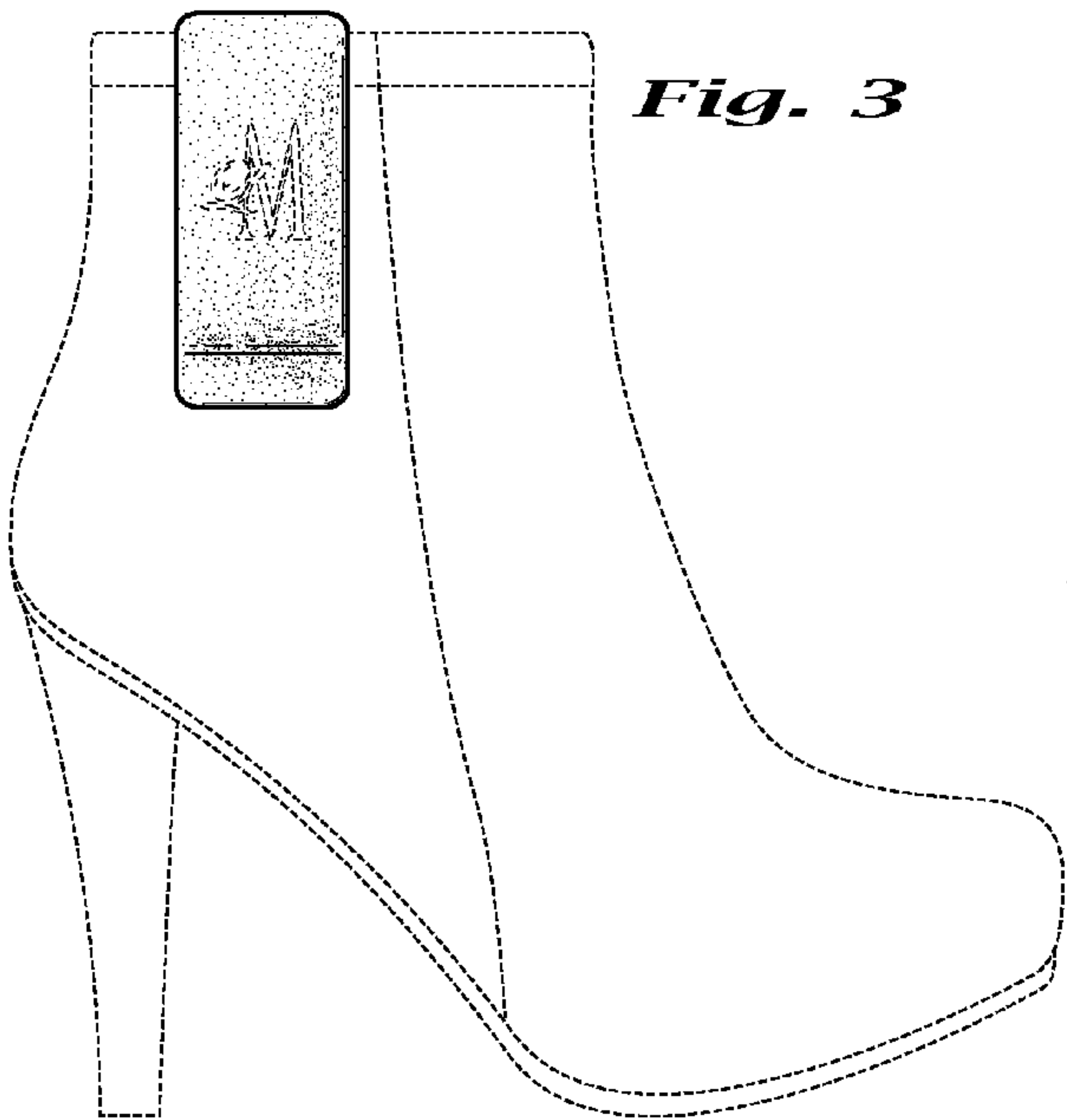

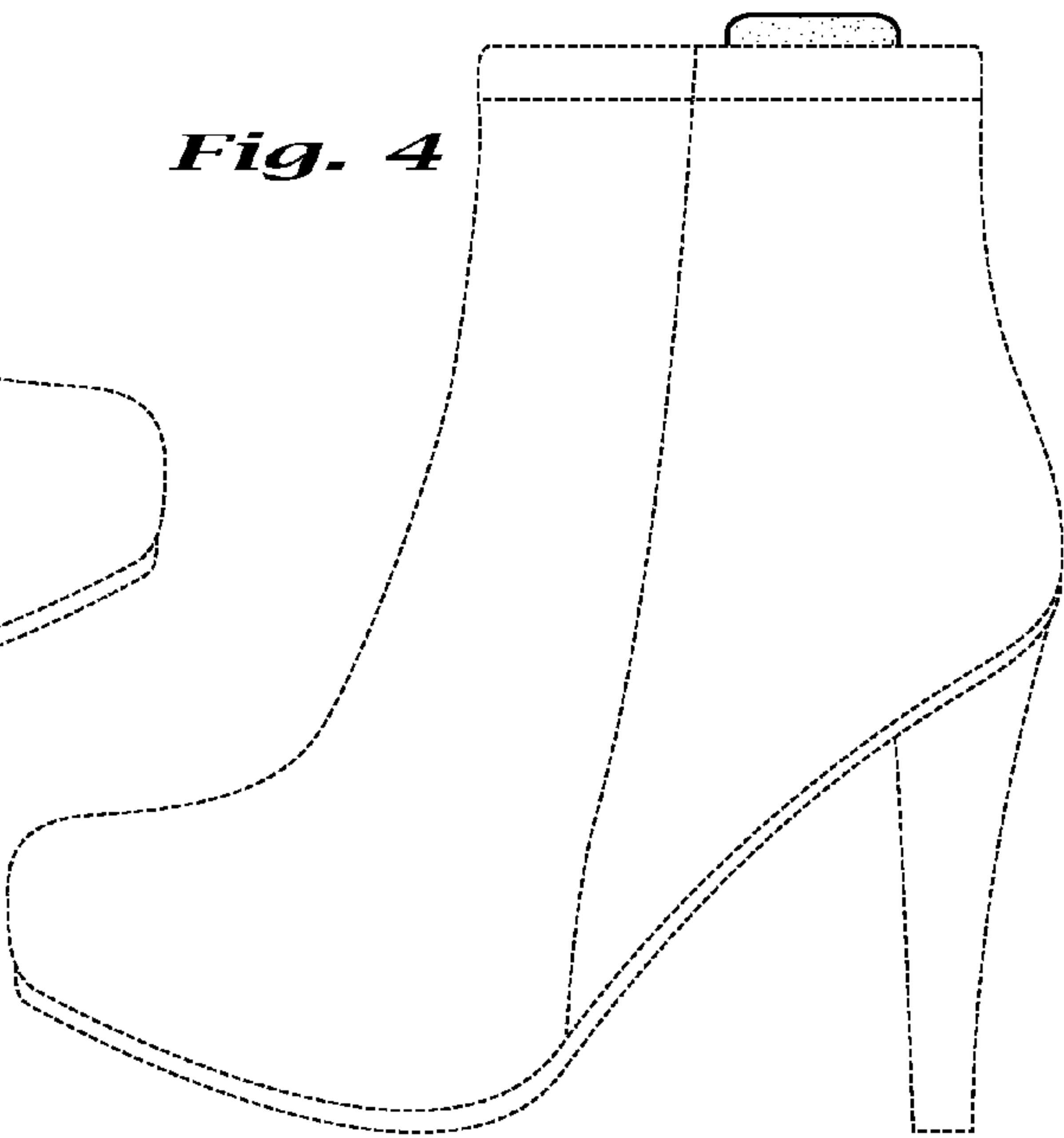

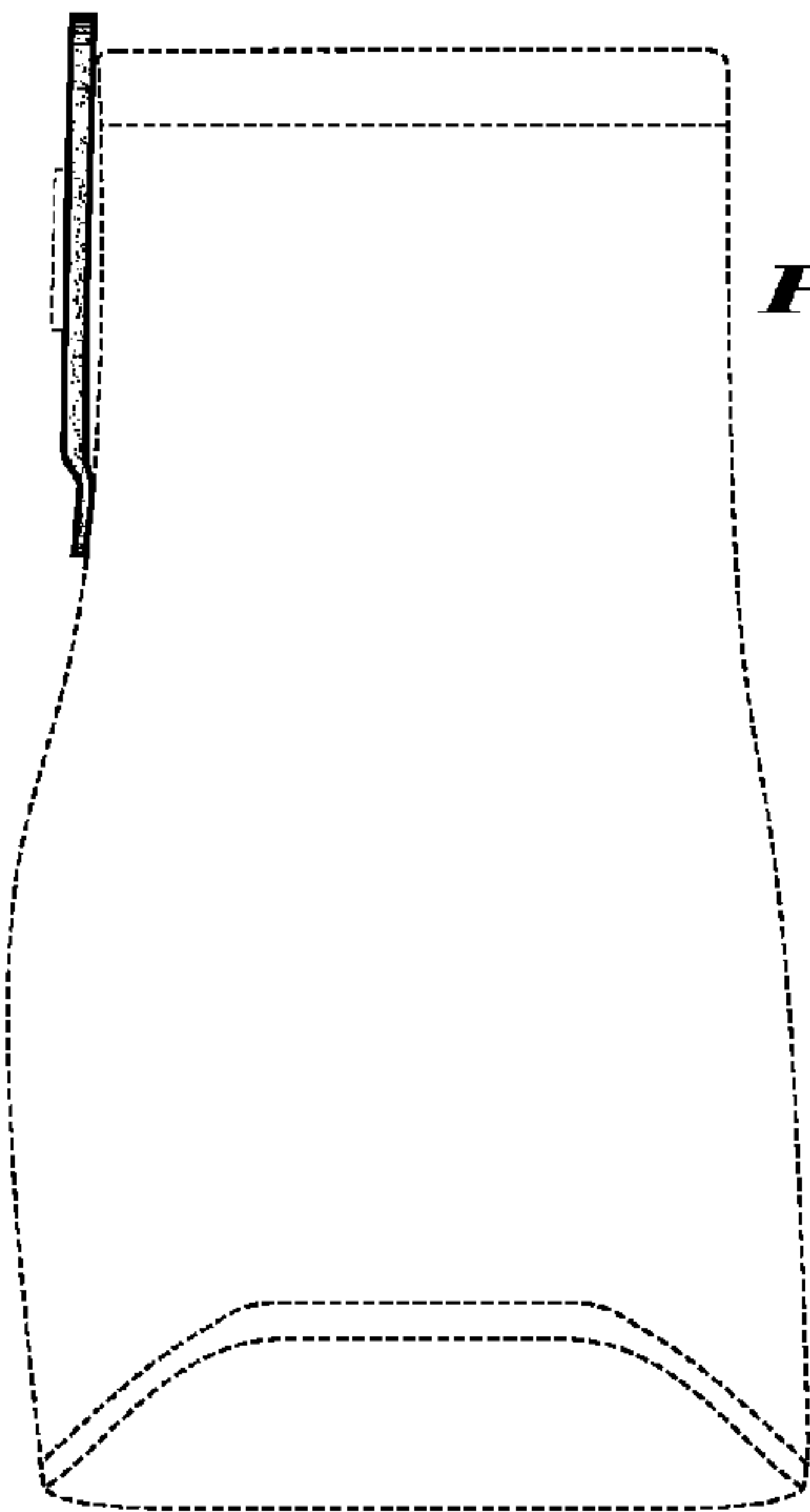

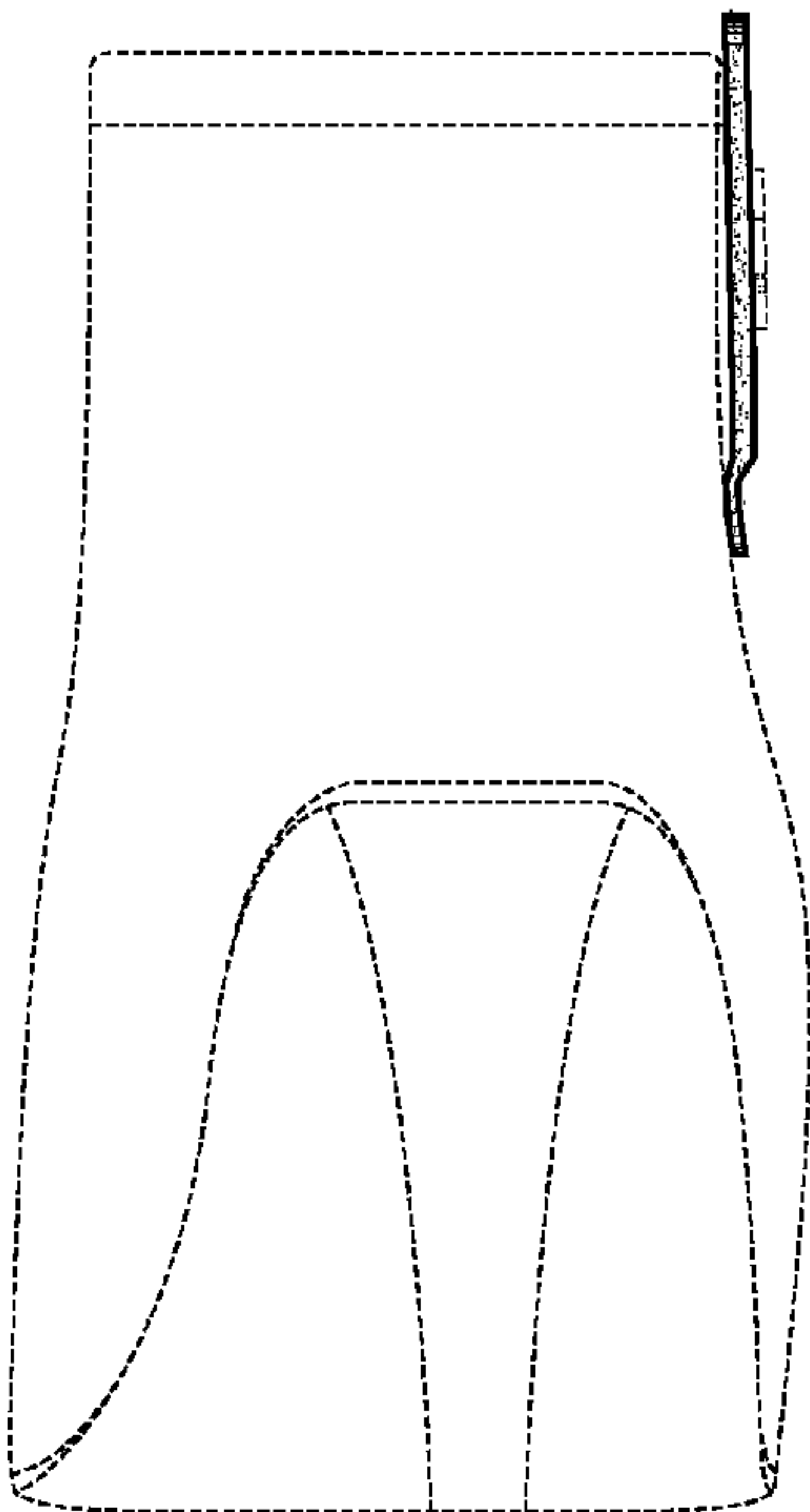

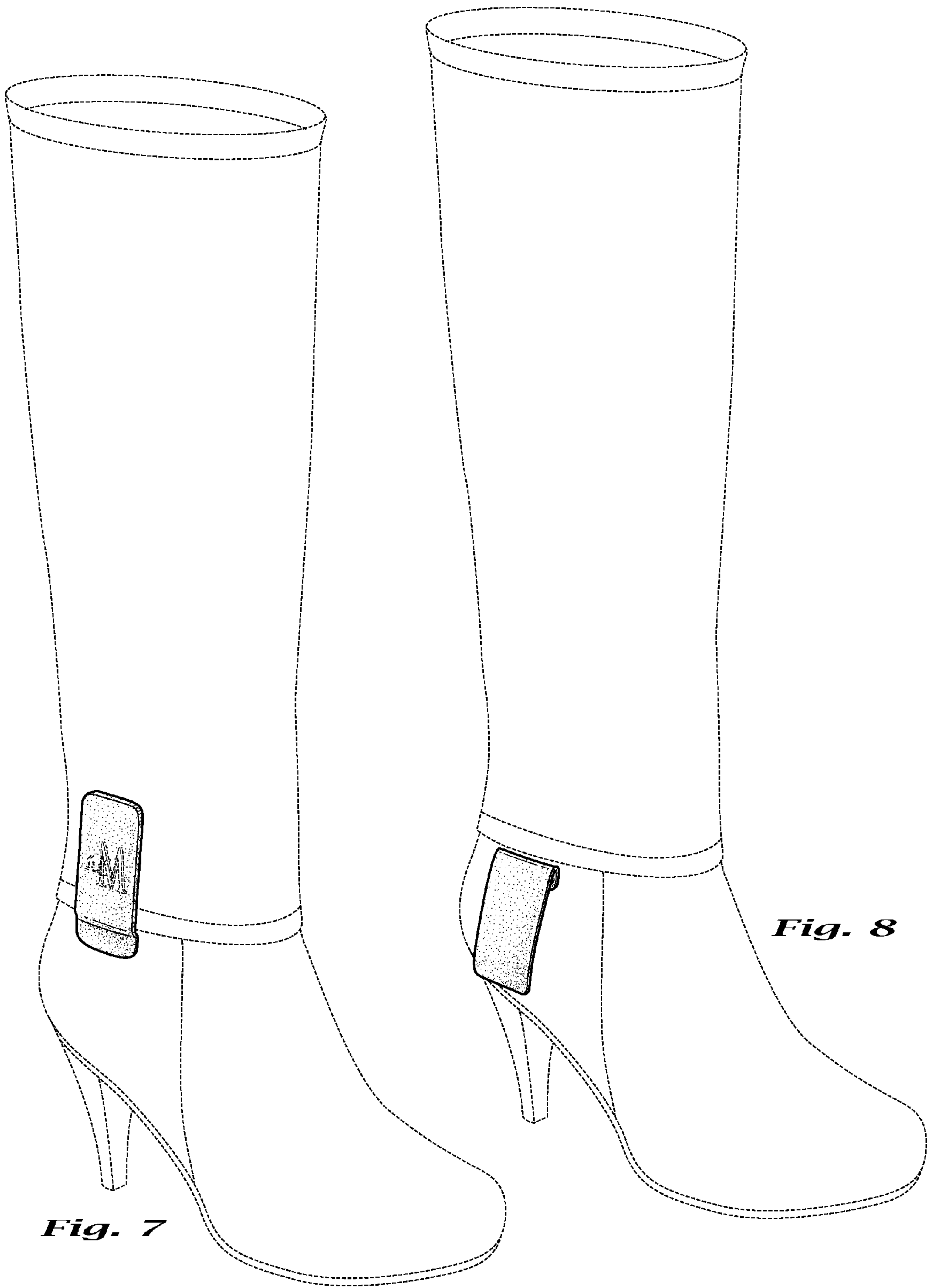

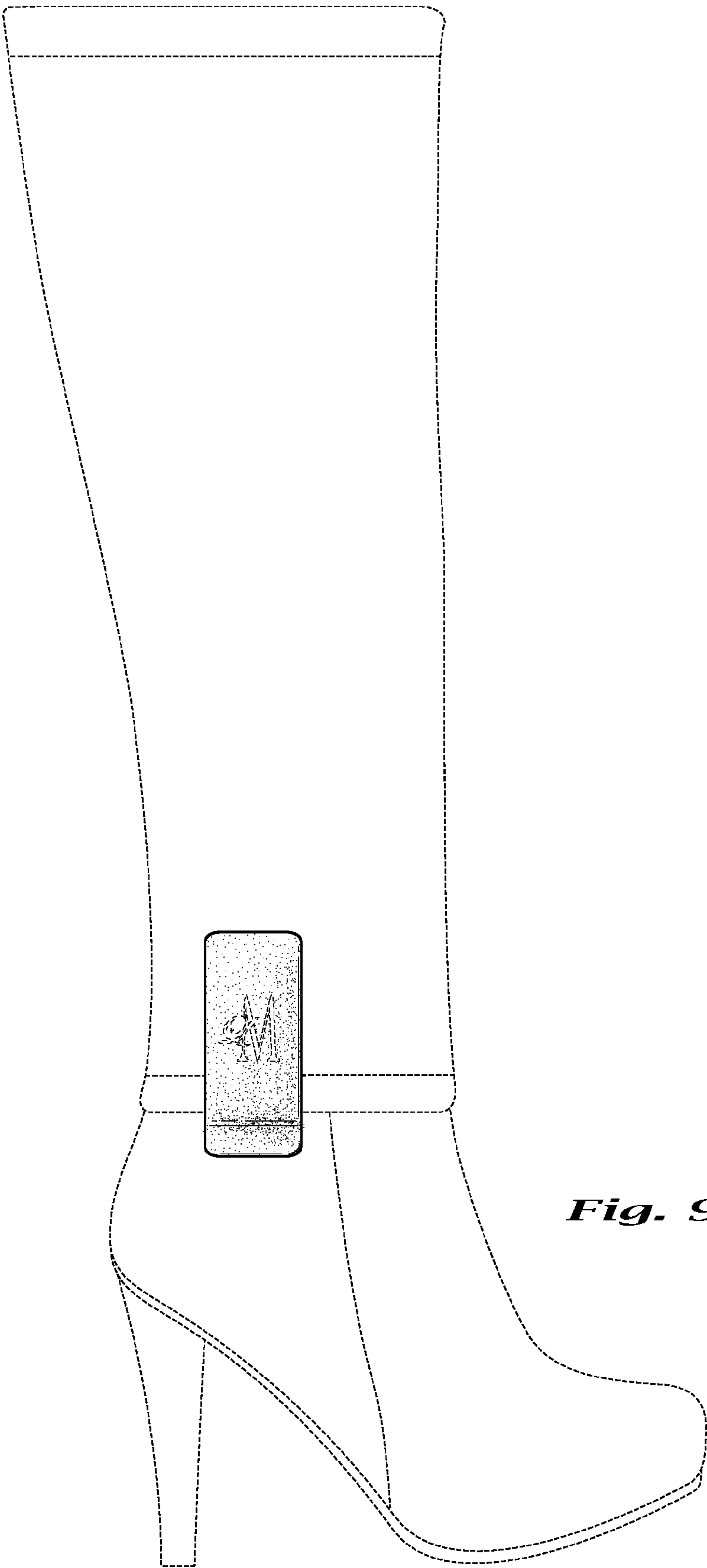

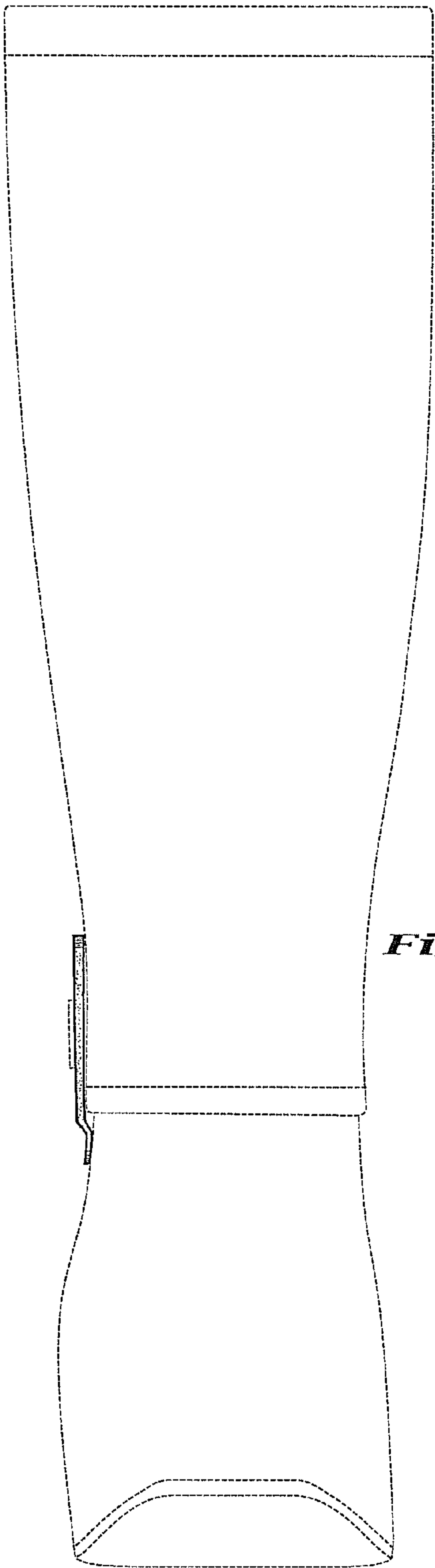

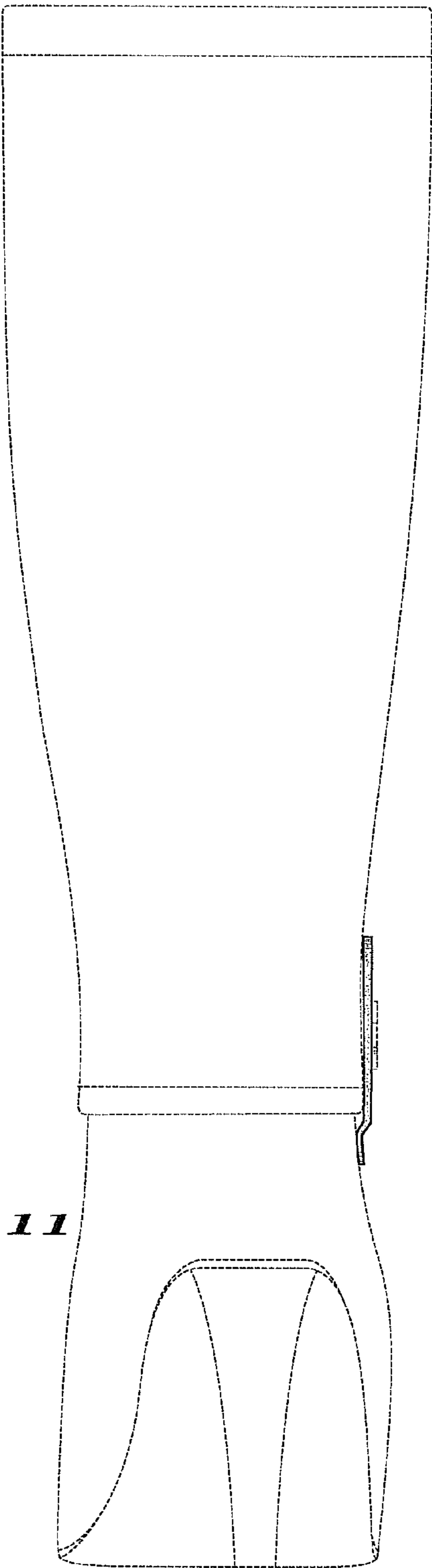
