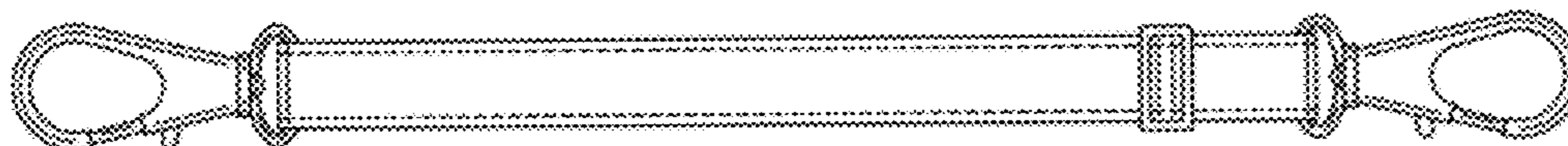
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a grocery cart leash, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a grocery cart leash showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a right elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the shown;  
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged isometric view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 7 is an in-use isometric view thereof.  
 The broken lines in FIG. 7 depict a grocery cart and vehicle trunk as environmental subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design.

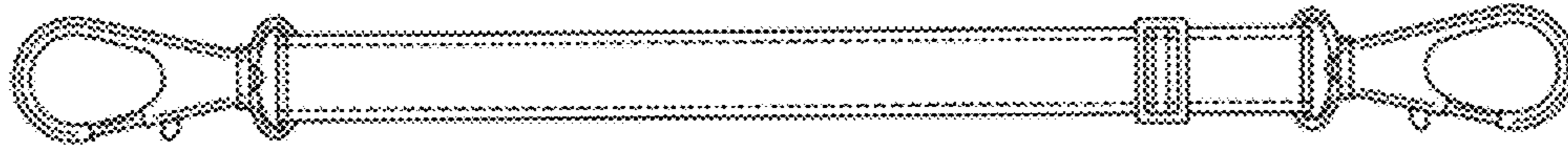

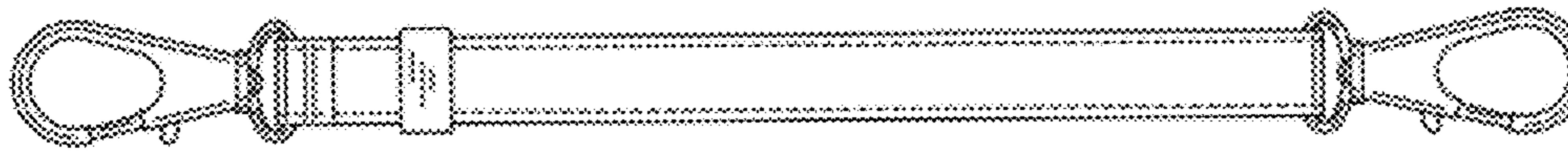

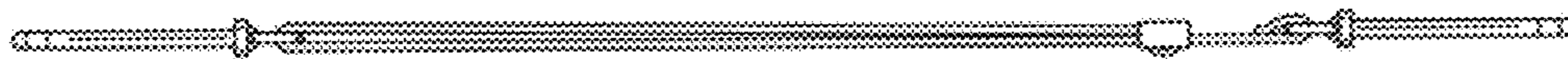

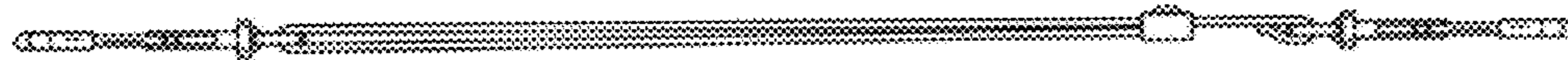

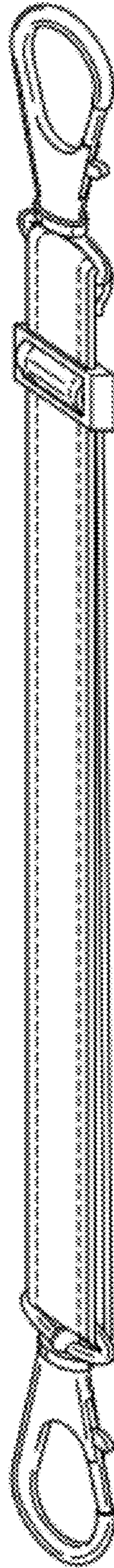

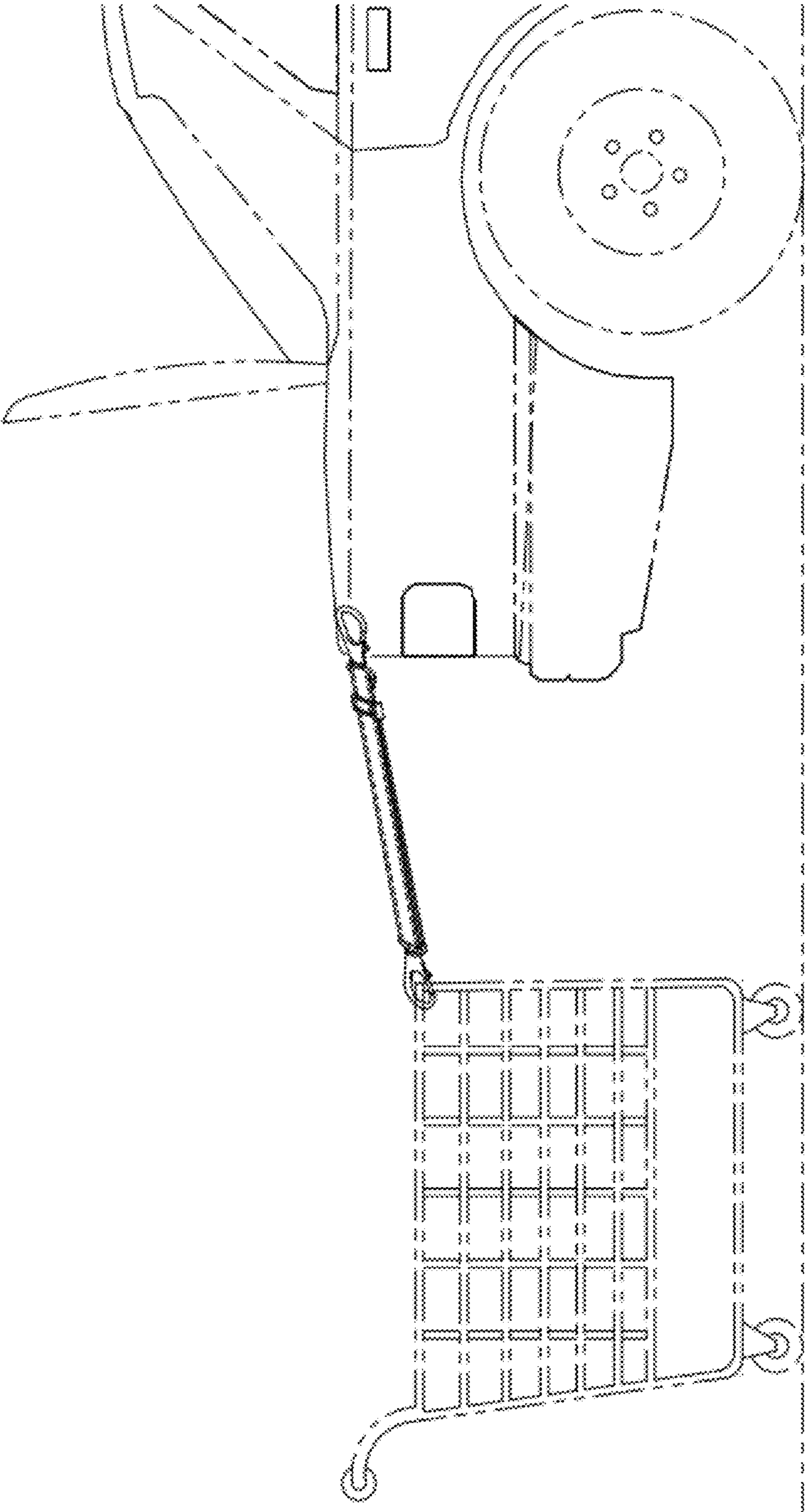
