FIG. 1;

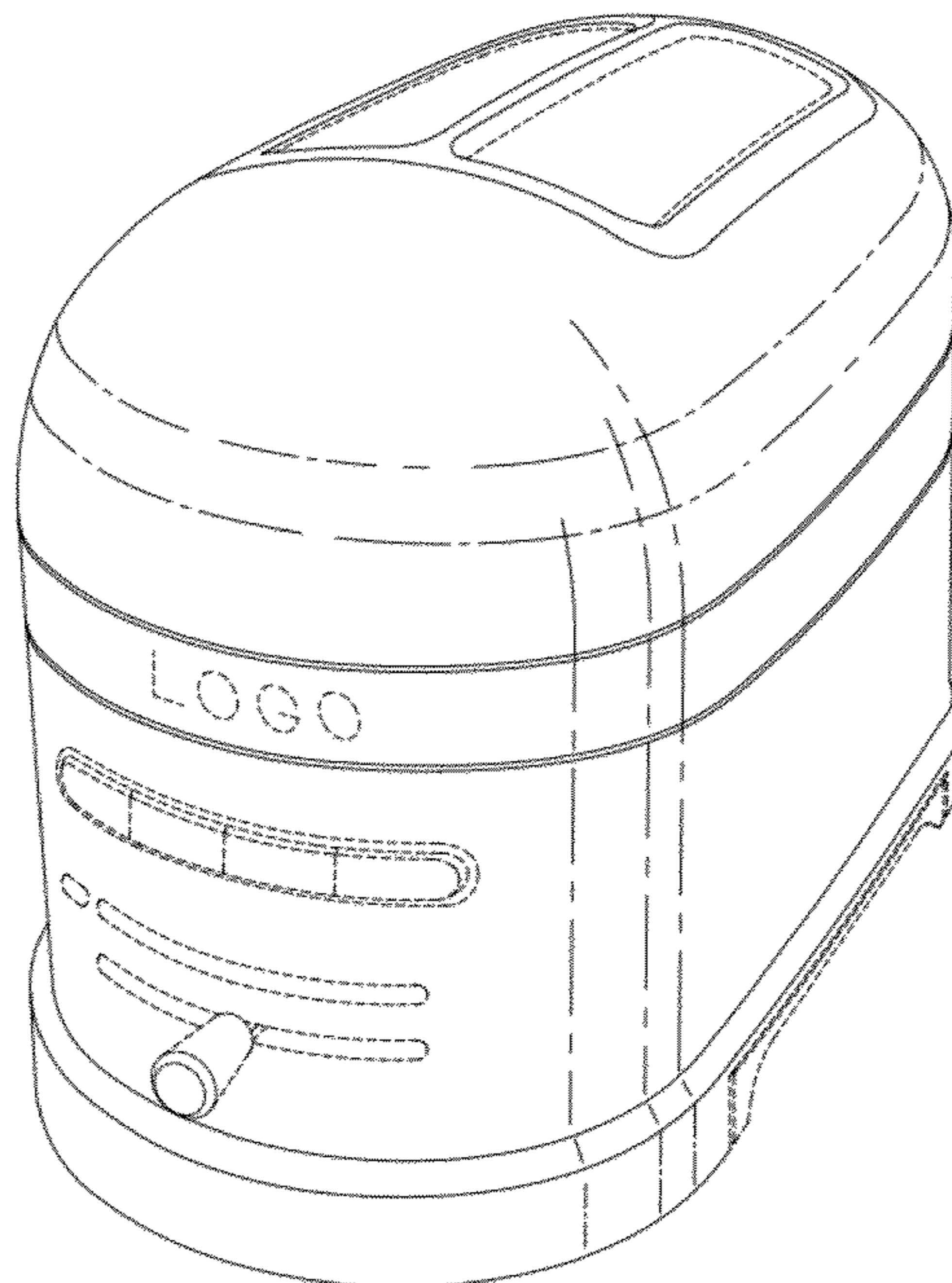
FIG. 5 is a second side elevation view of the two-slice toaster

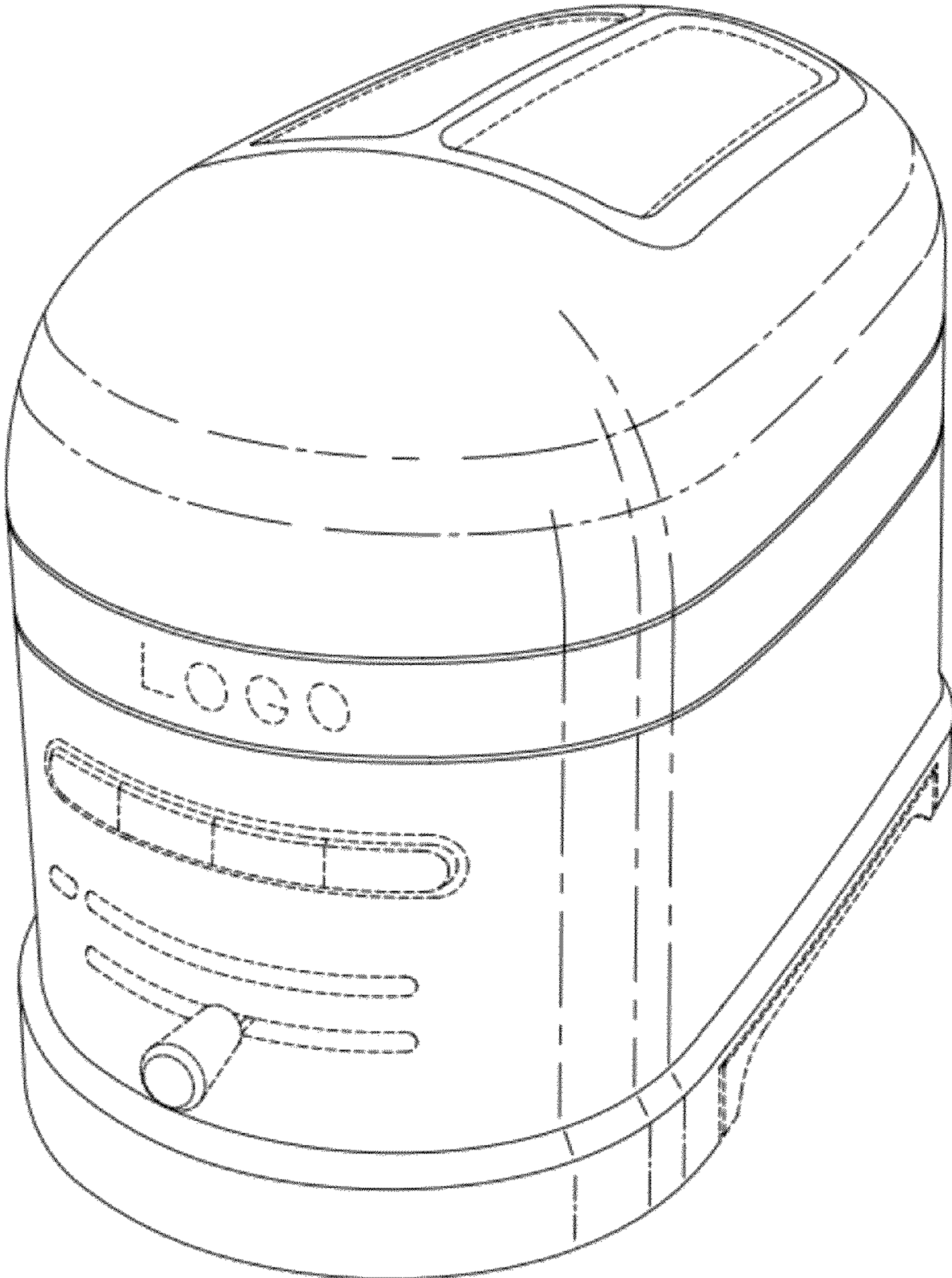

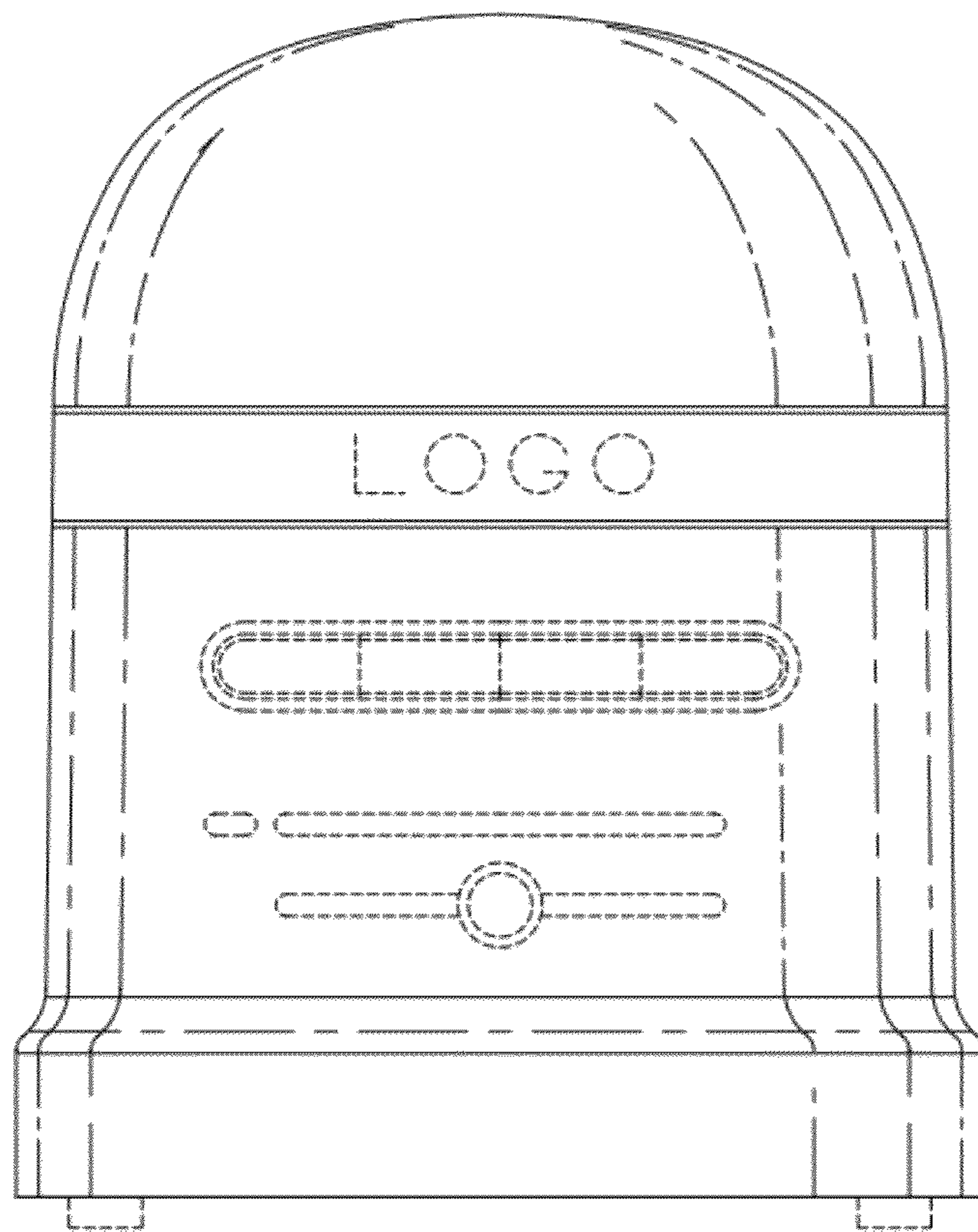

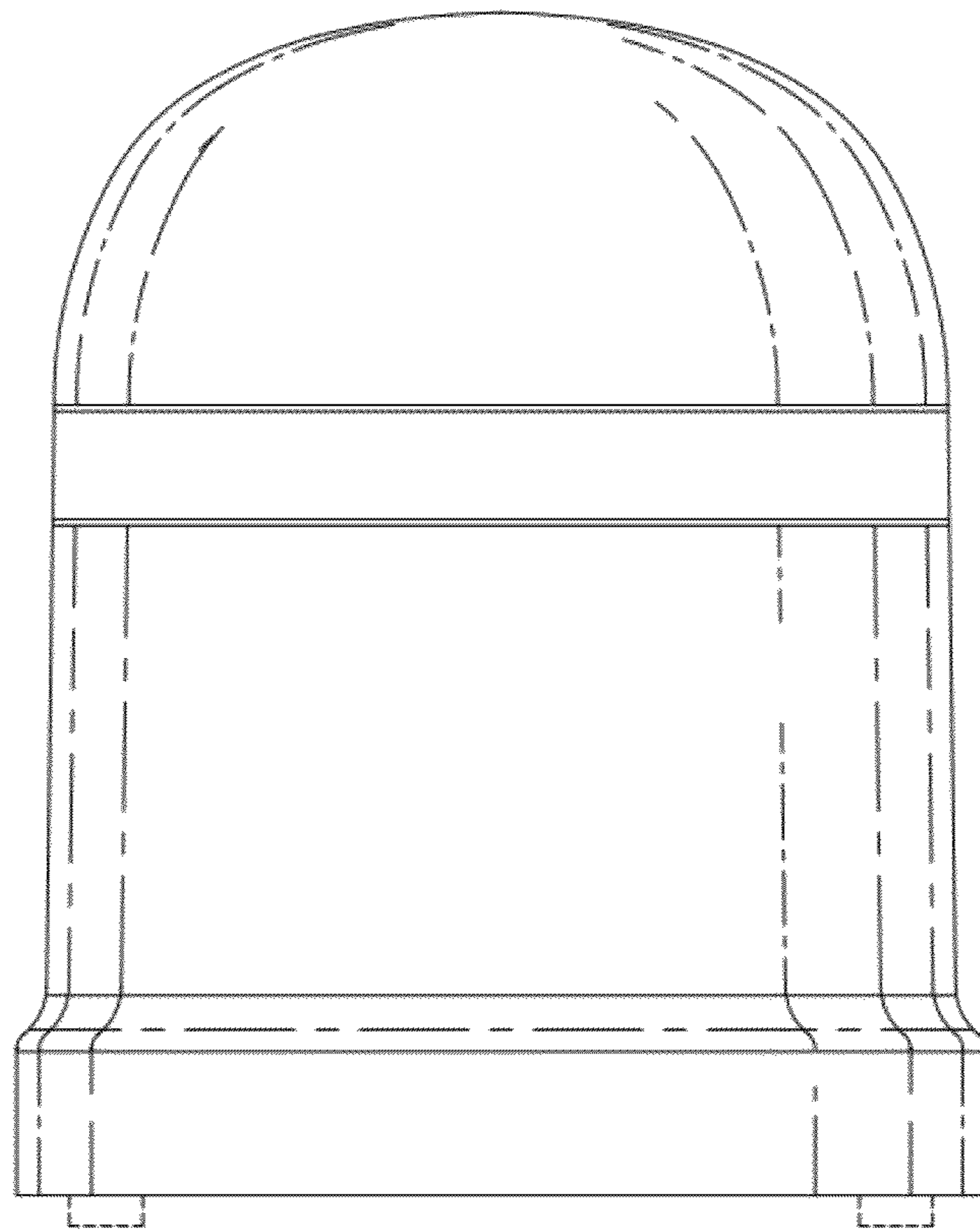

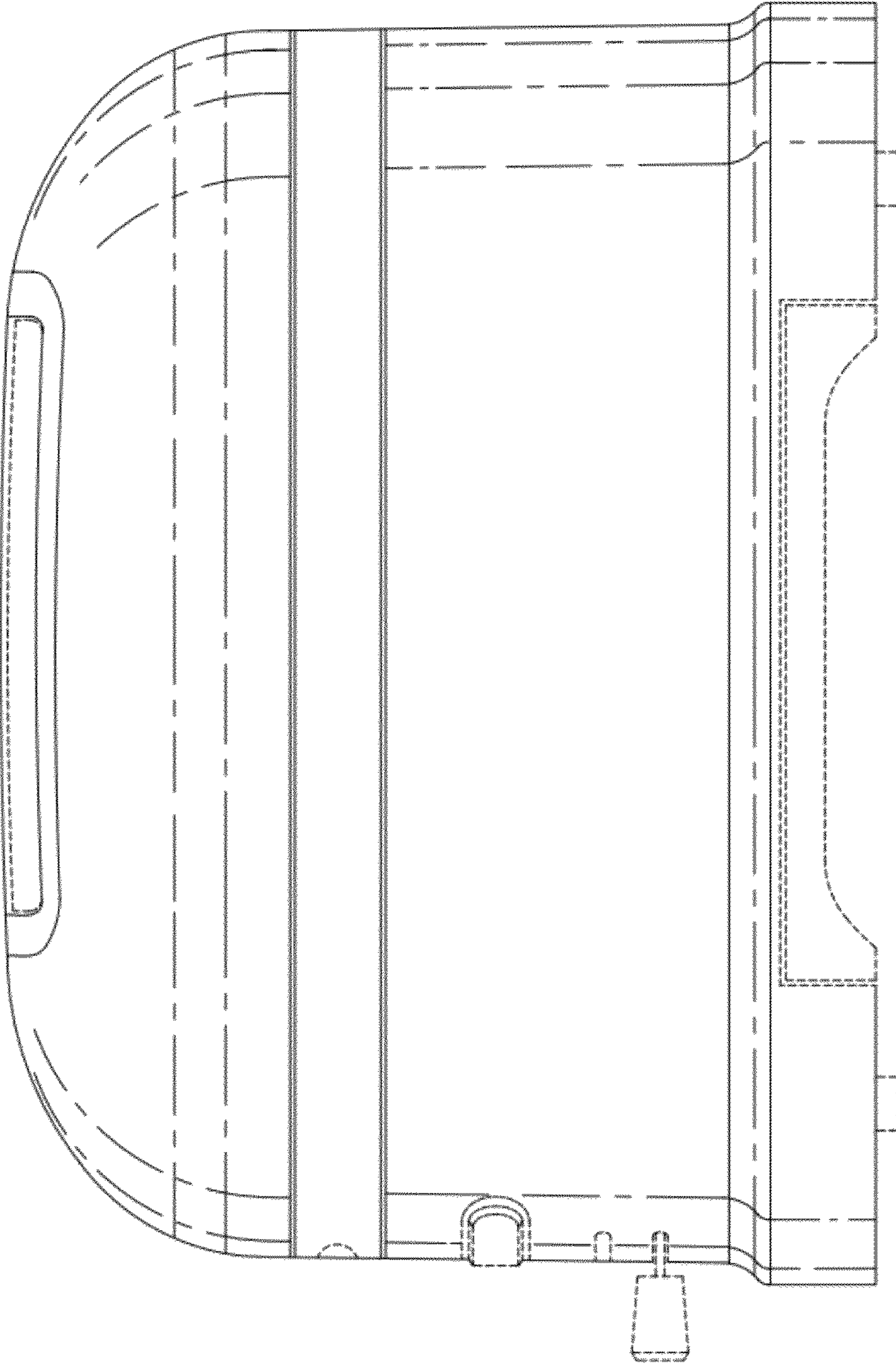

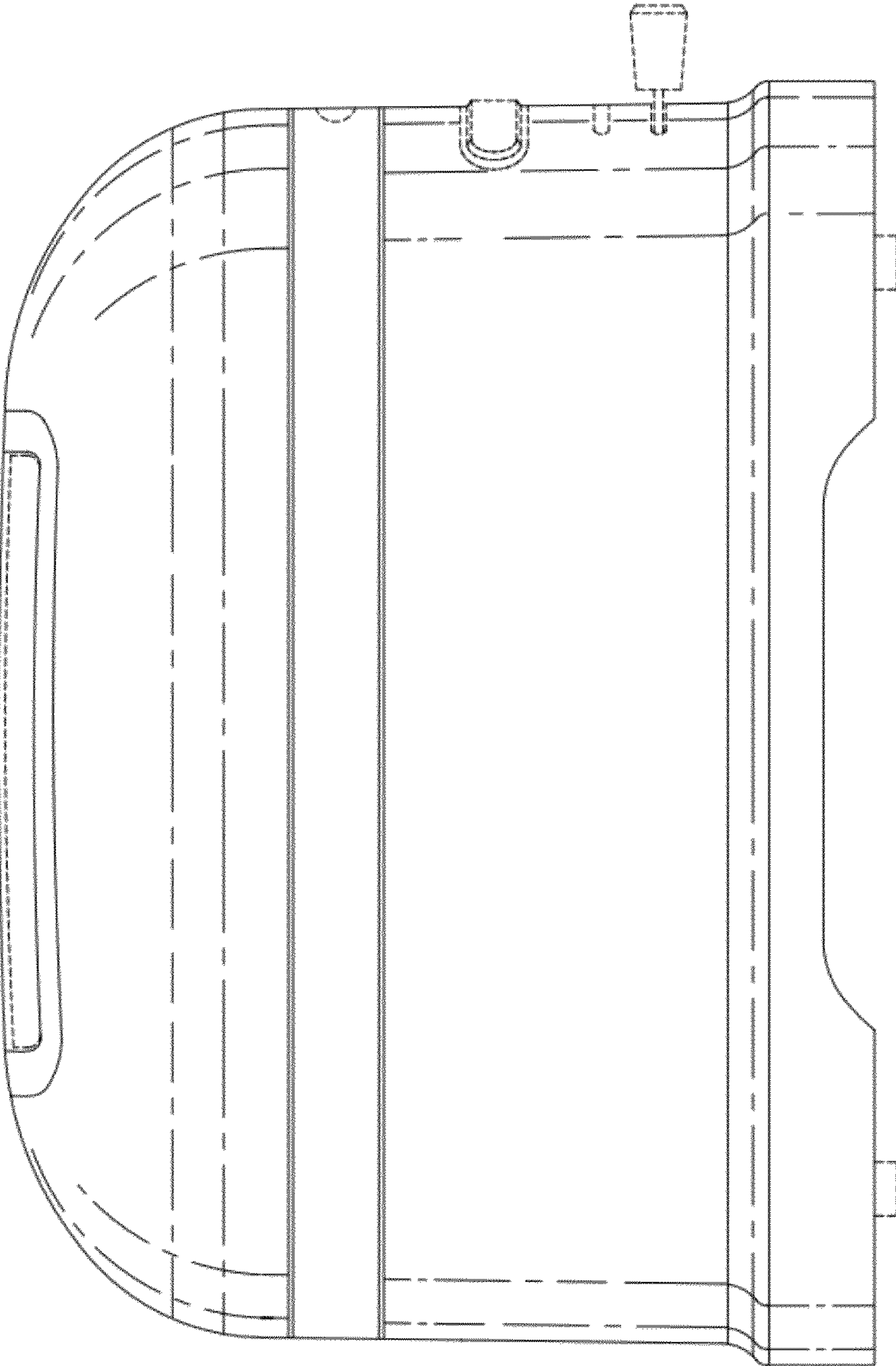

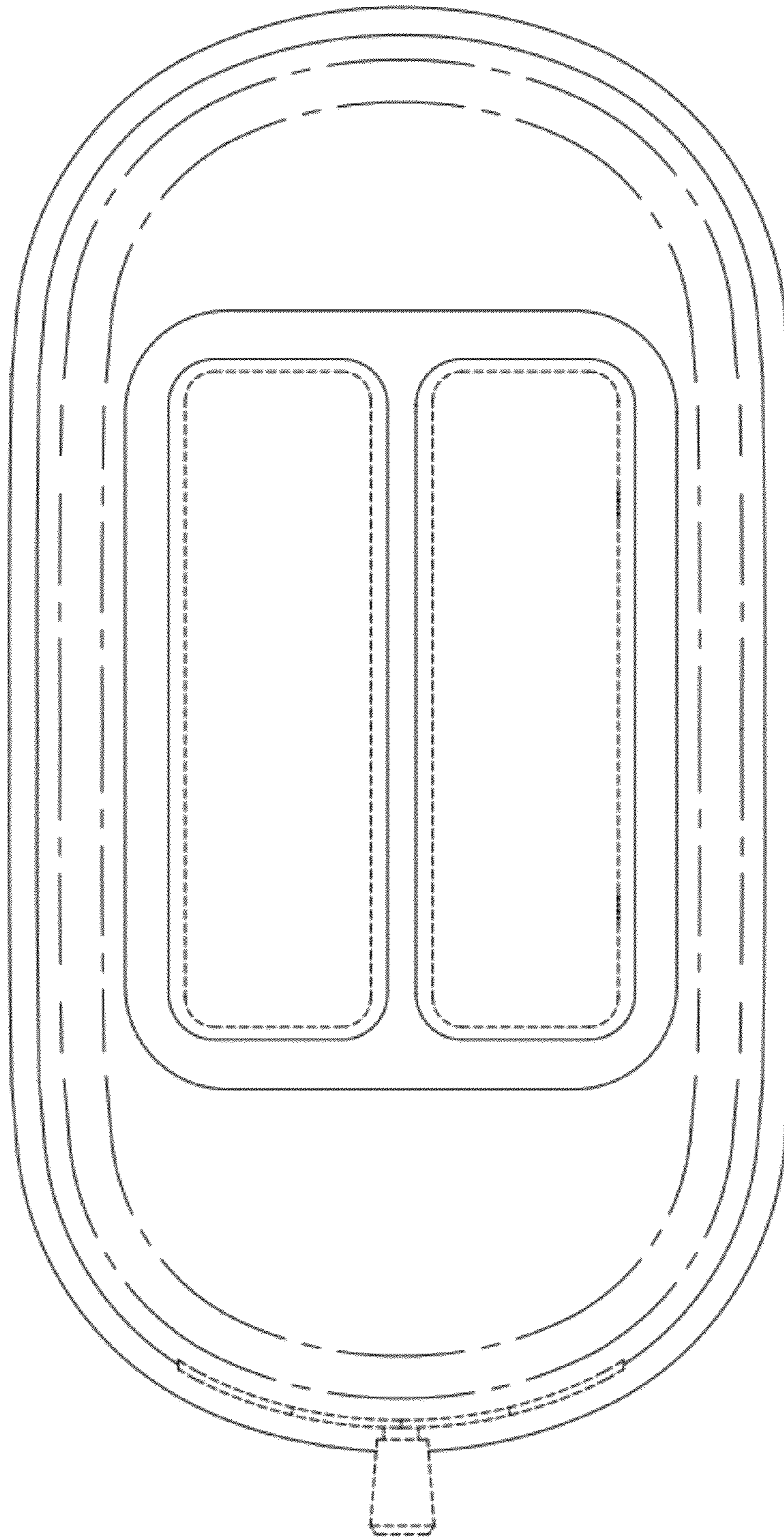

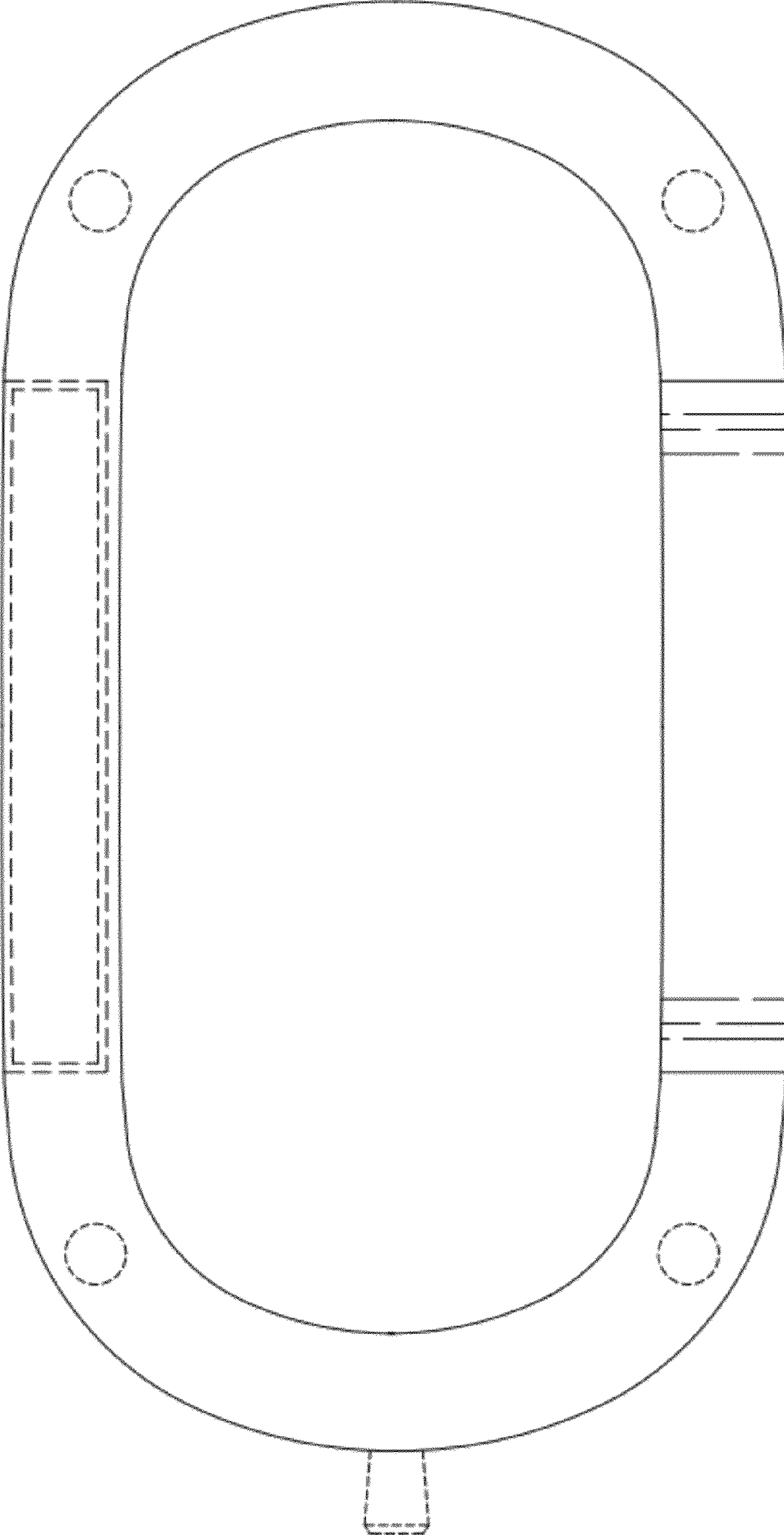
