FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

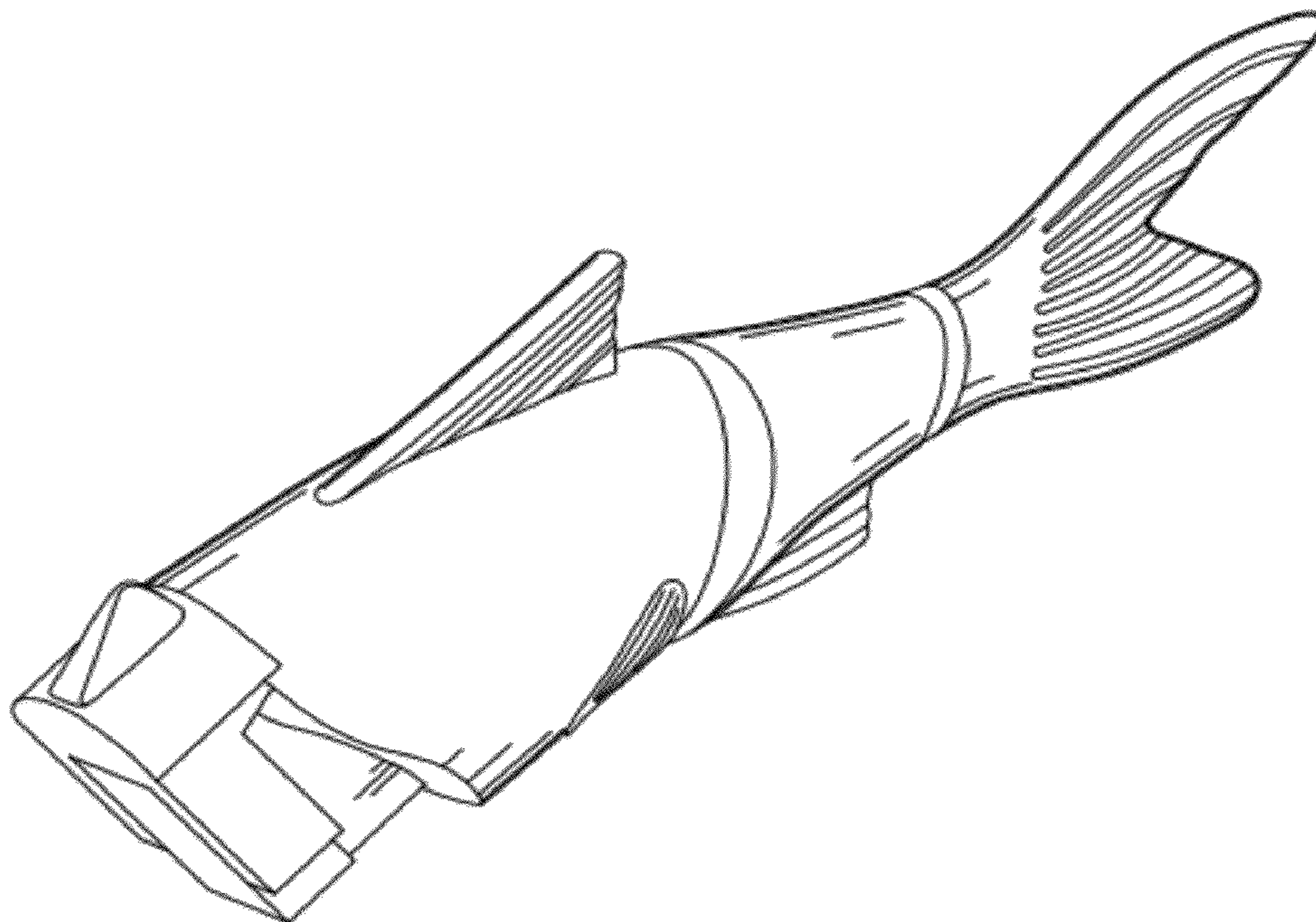
FIG. 4 is a left side perspective view showing the front, left side and bottom thereof;

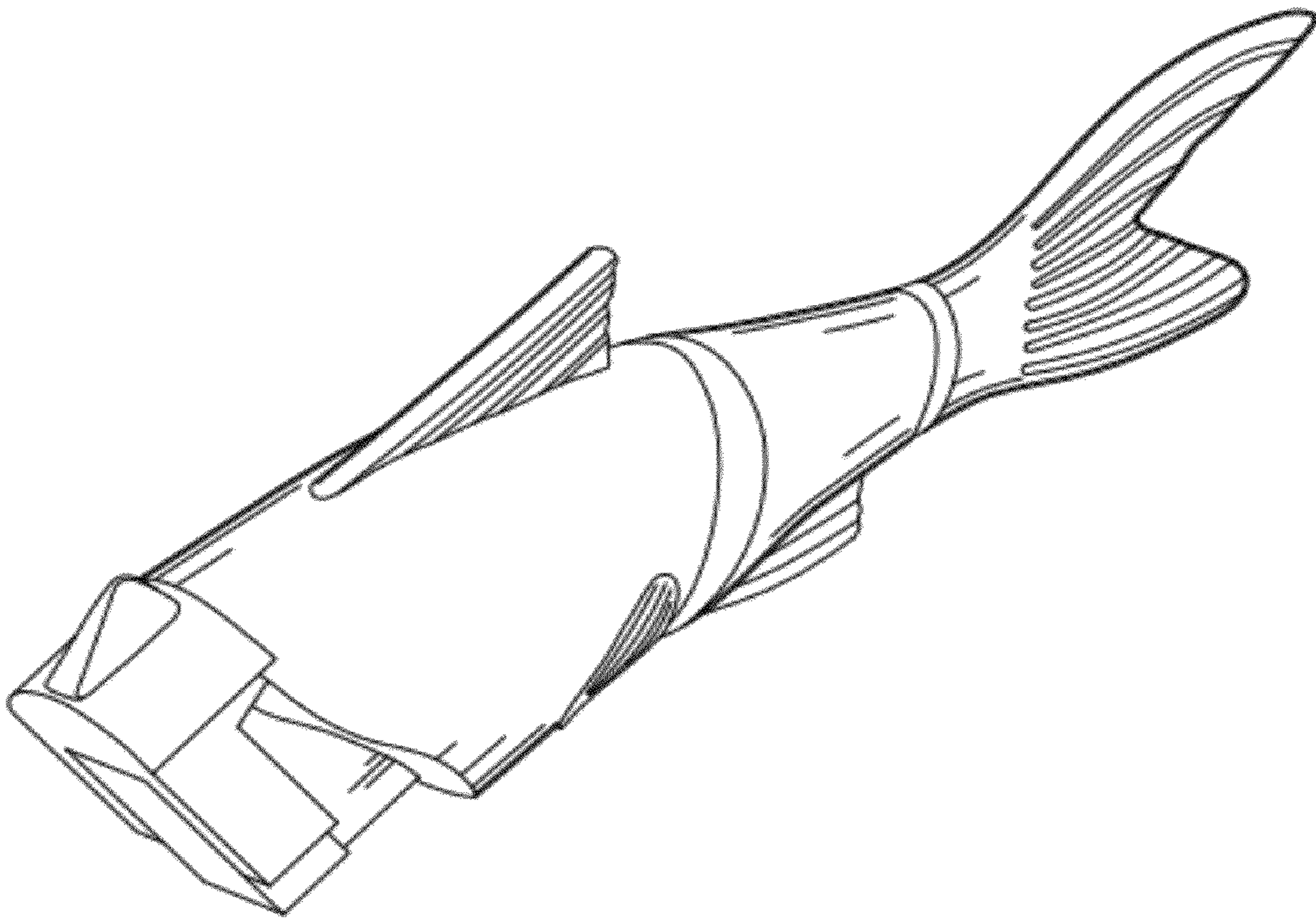
FIG. 5 is bottom view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front view thereof; and,

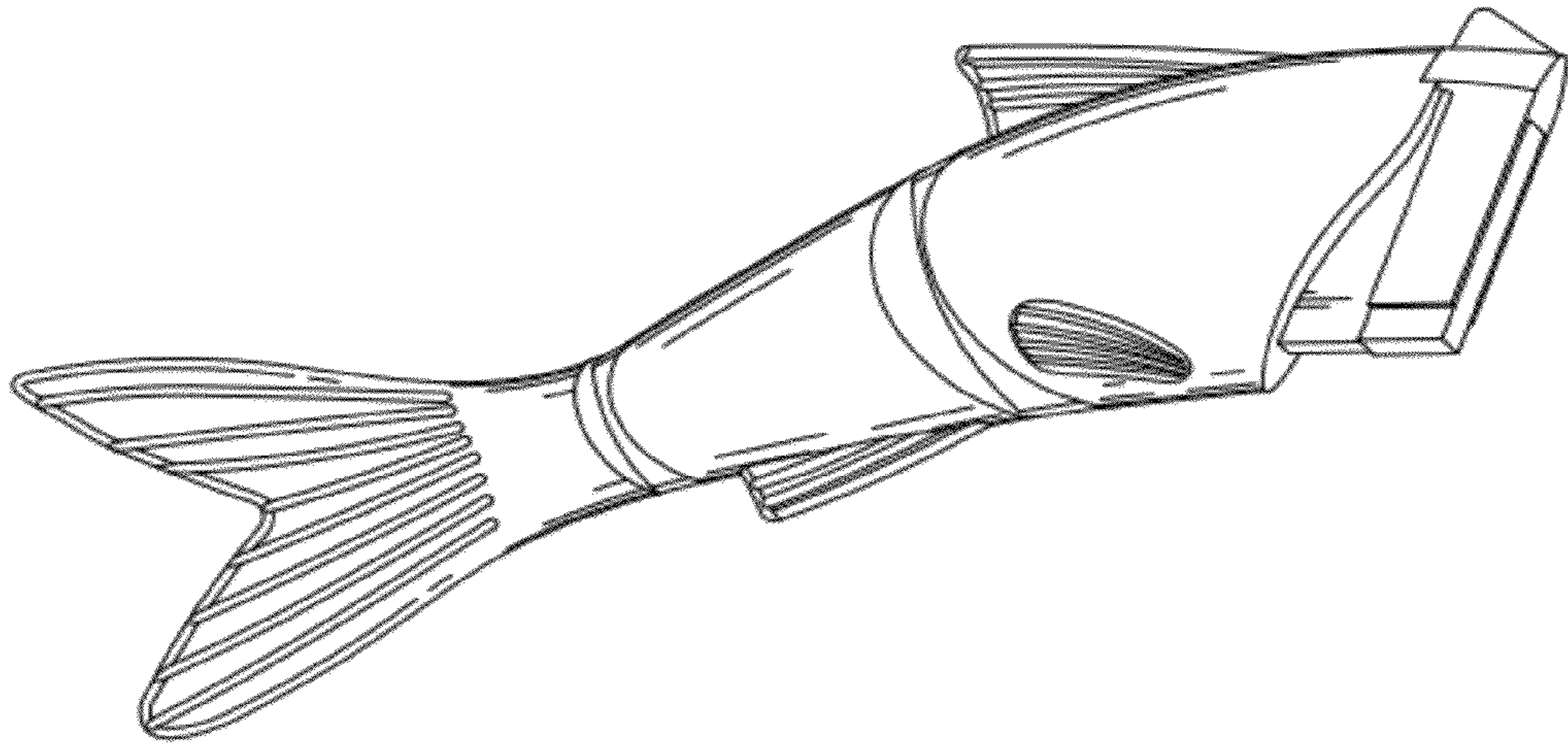
FIG. 7 is a rear view thereof.

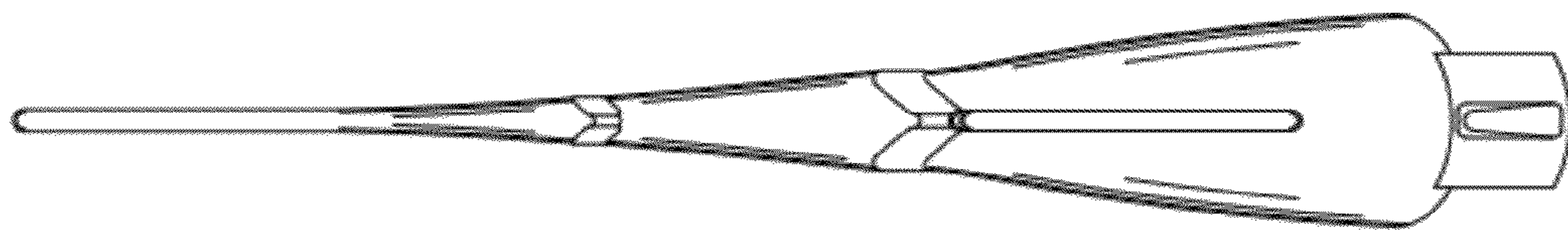




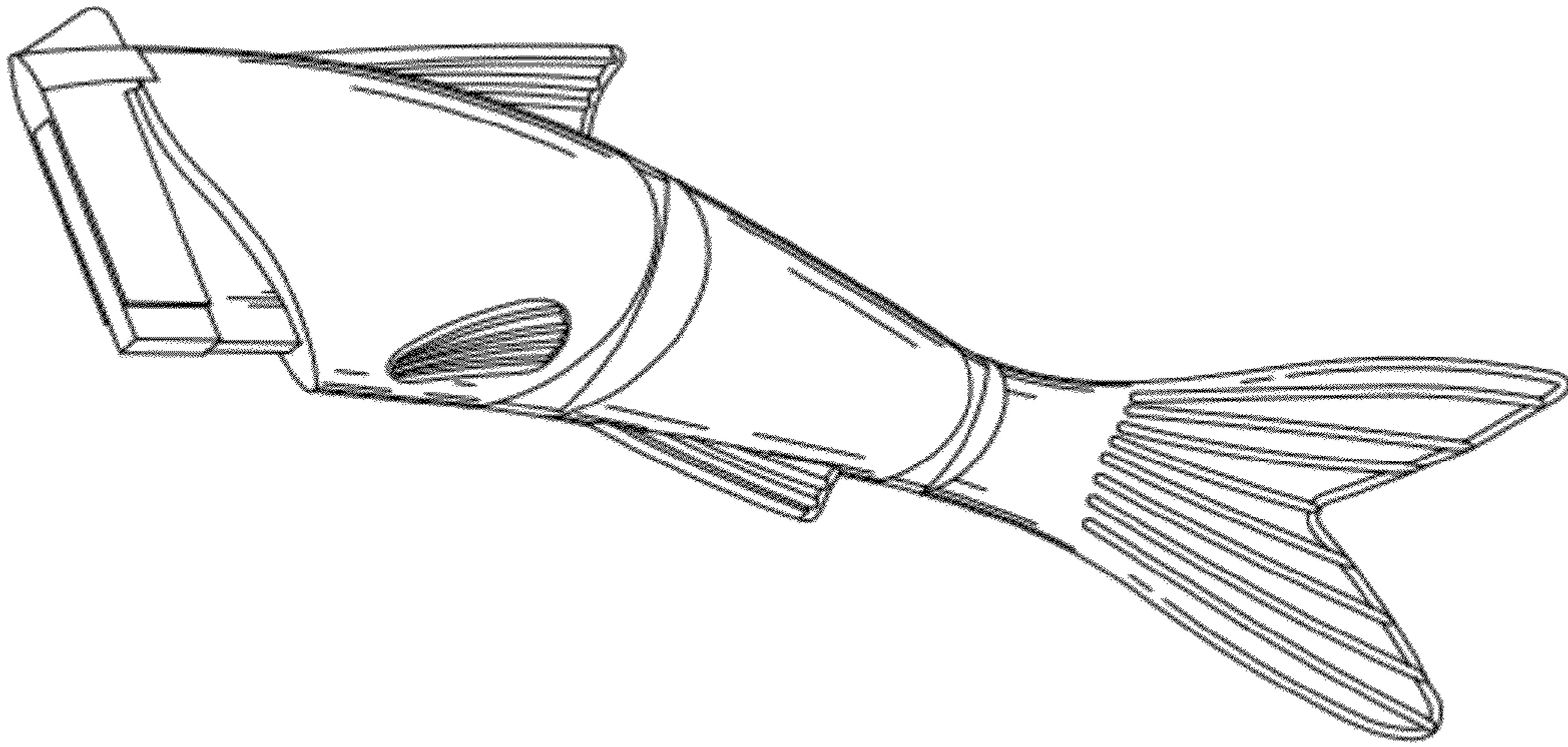

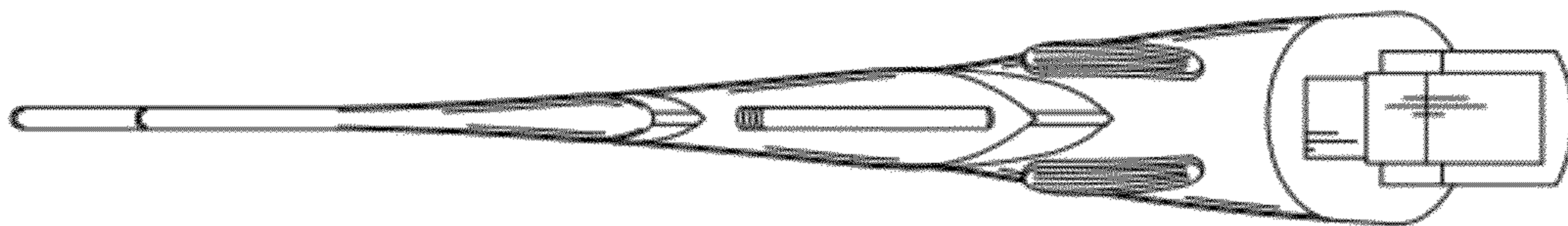

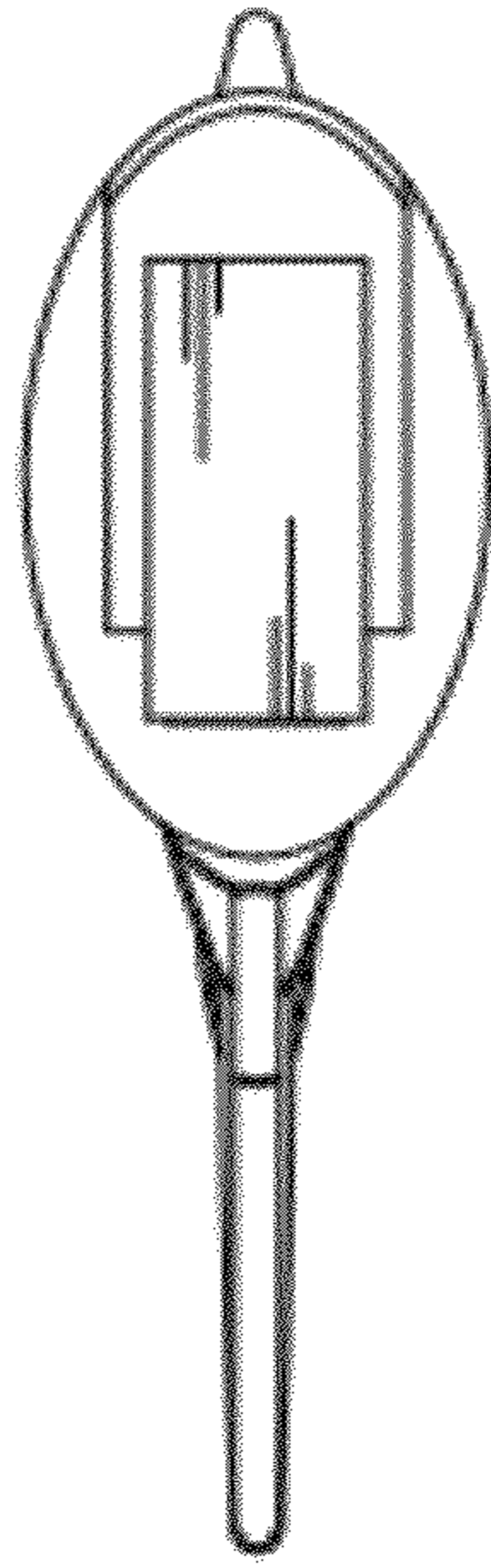

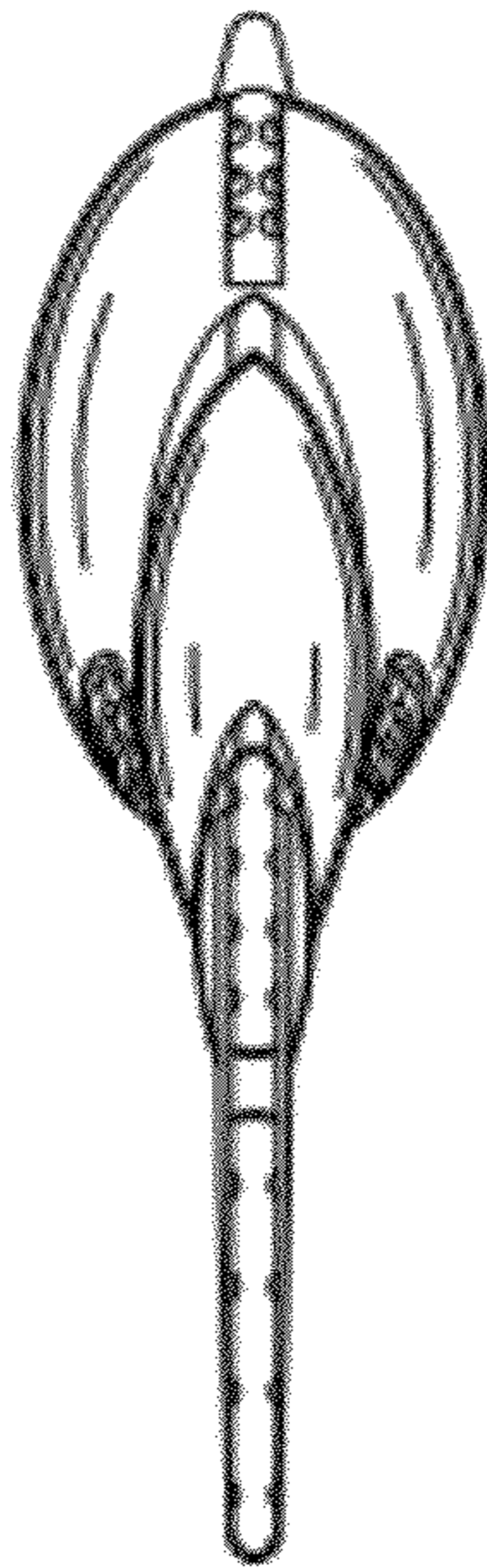
