(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a baseball helmet-shaped hat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the baseball helmet-shaped hat shown as worn with the wearer being depicted in dashed lines;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the baseball helmet-shaped hat of FIG. 1

FIG. 3 is a front view of the baseball helmet-shaped hat of FIG. 1

FIG. 4 is a rear view of the baseball helmet-shaped hat of FIG. 1

FIG. 5 is a top view of the baseball helmet-shaped hat of FIG. 1; and,

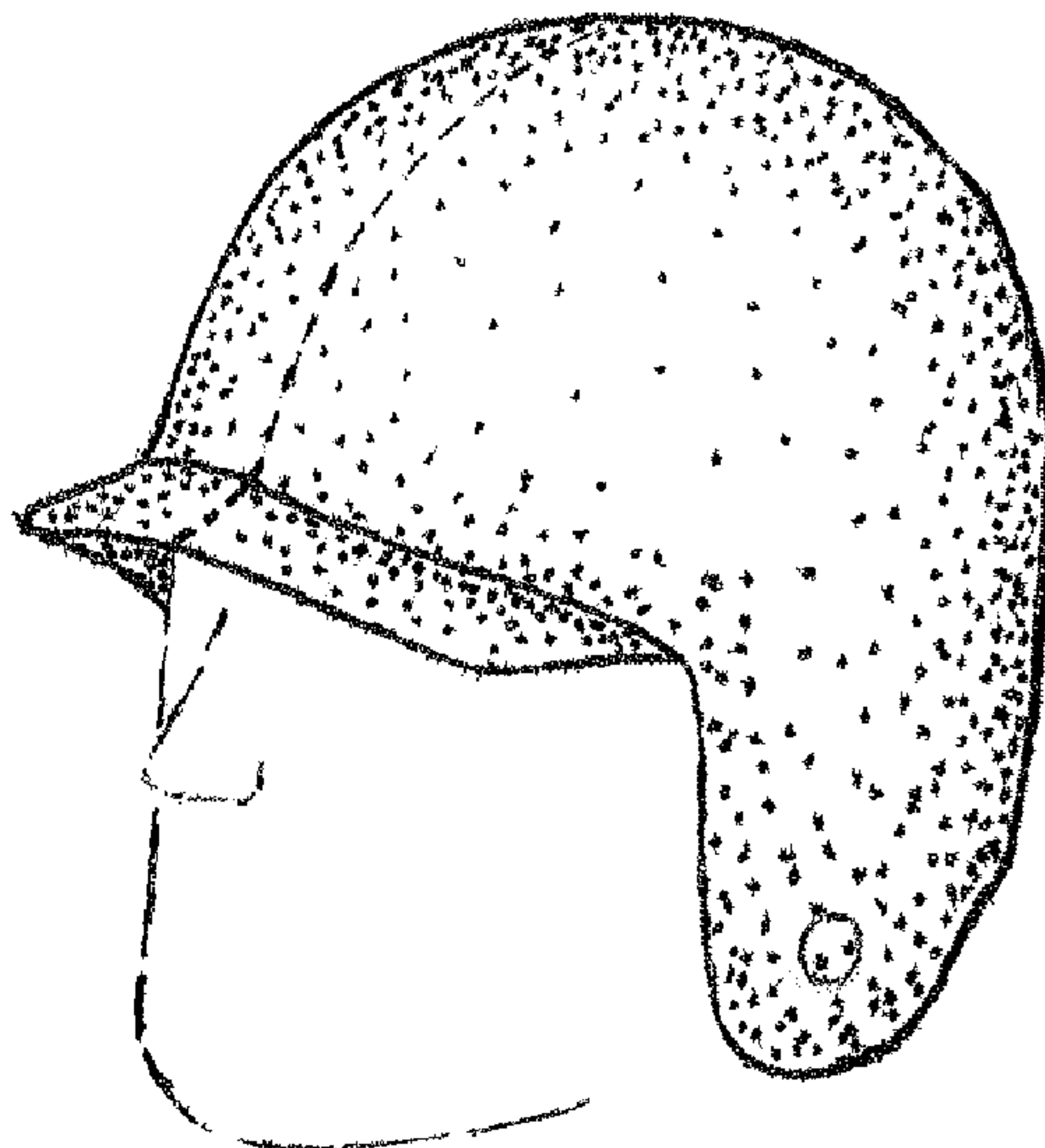

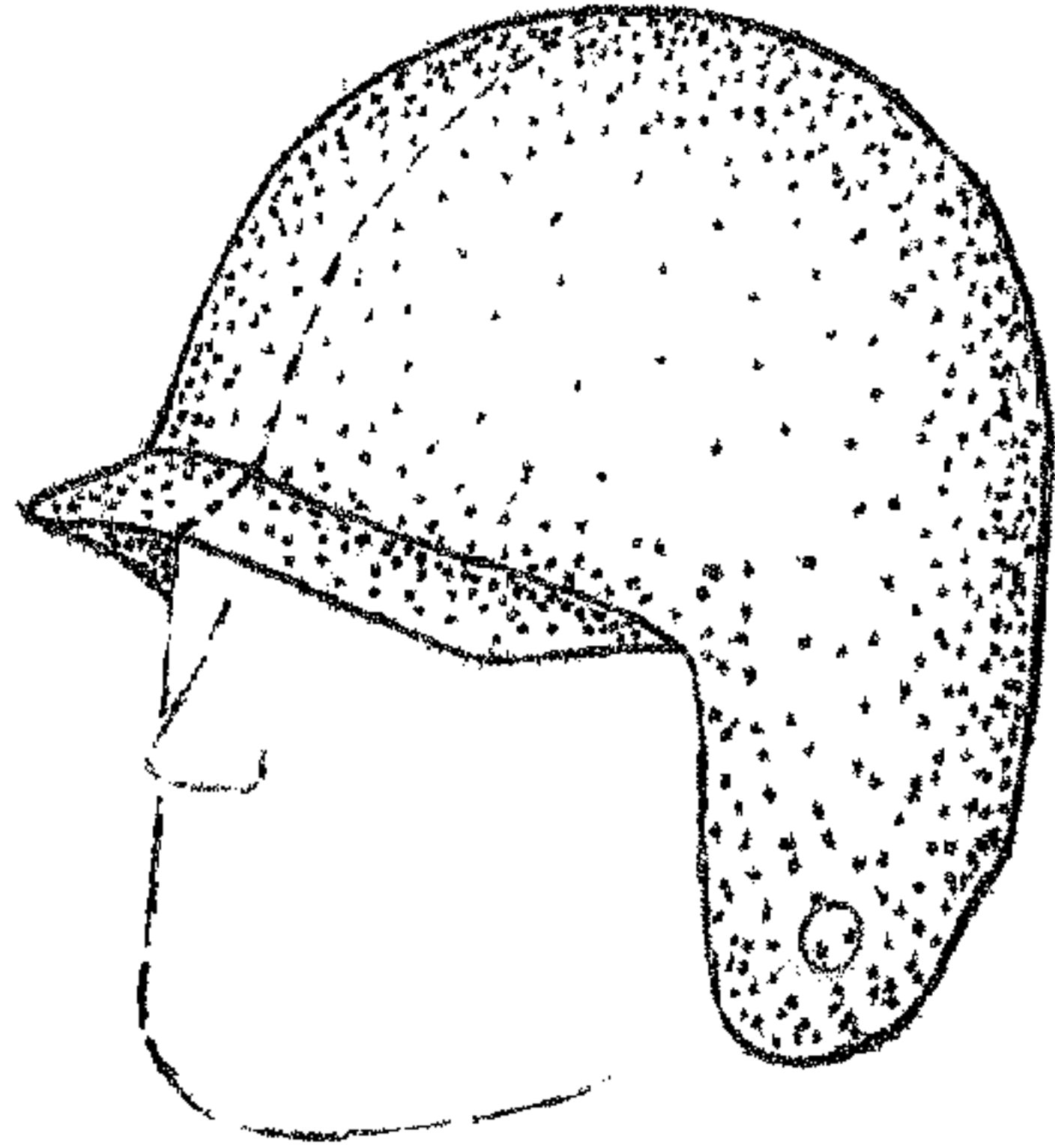

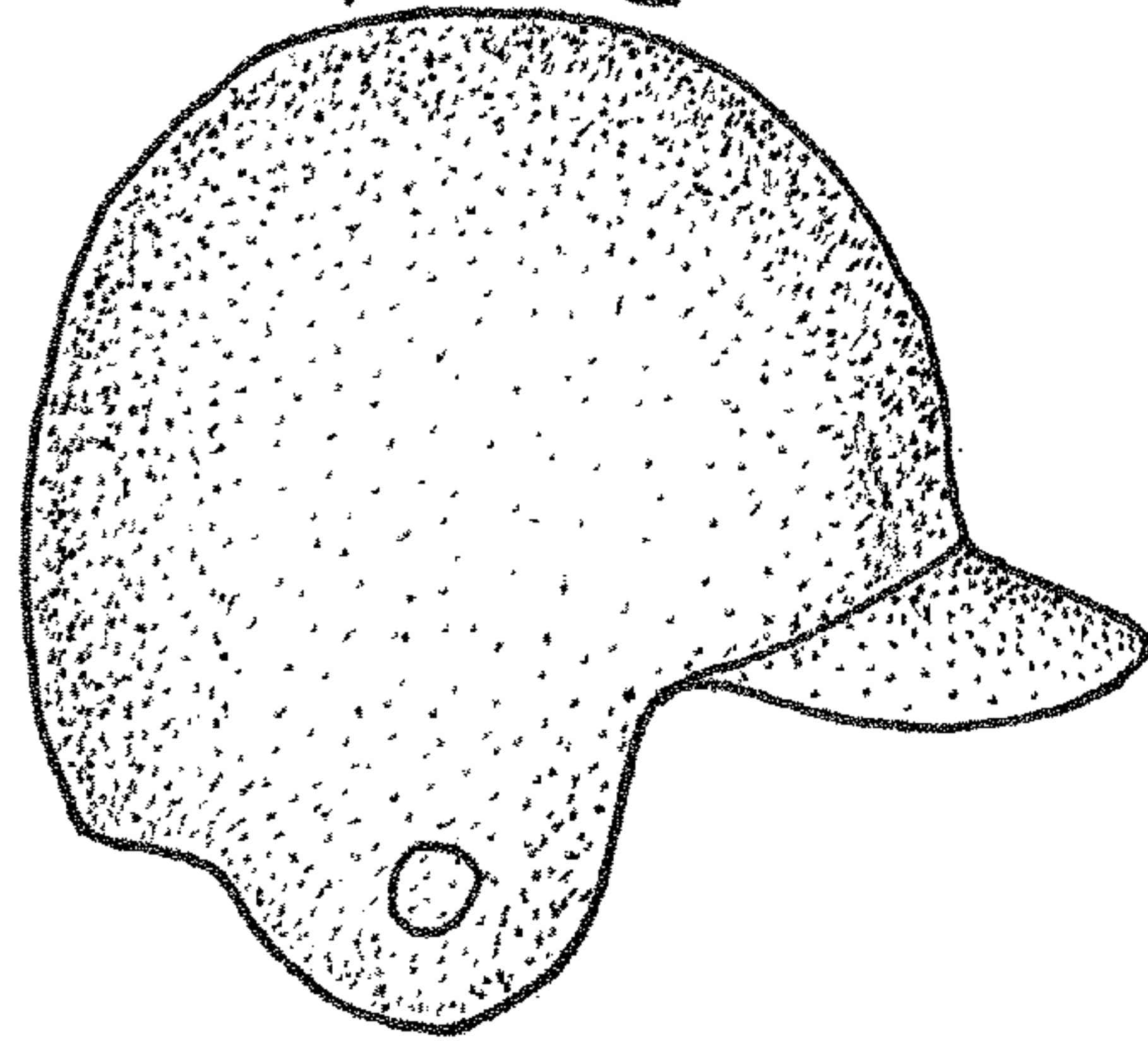

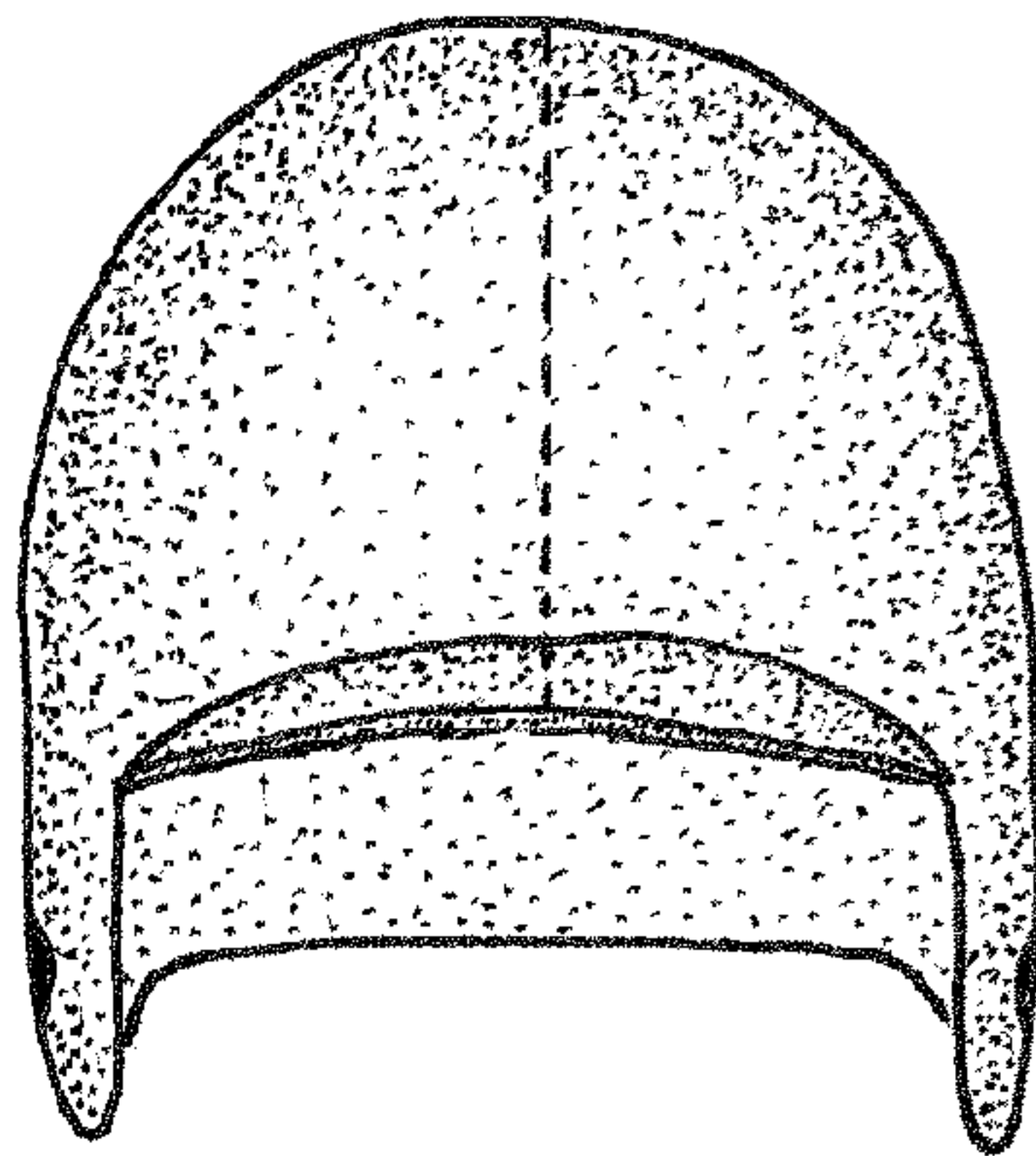

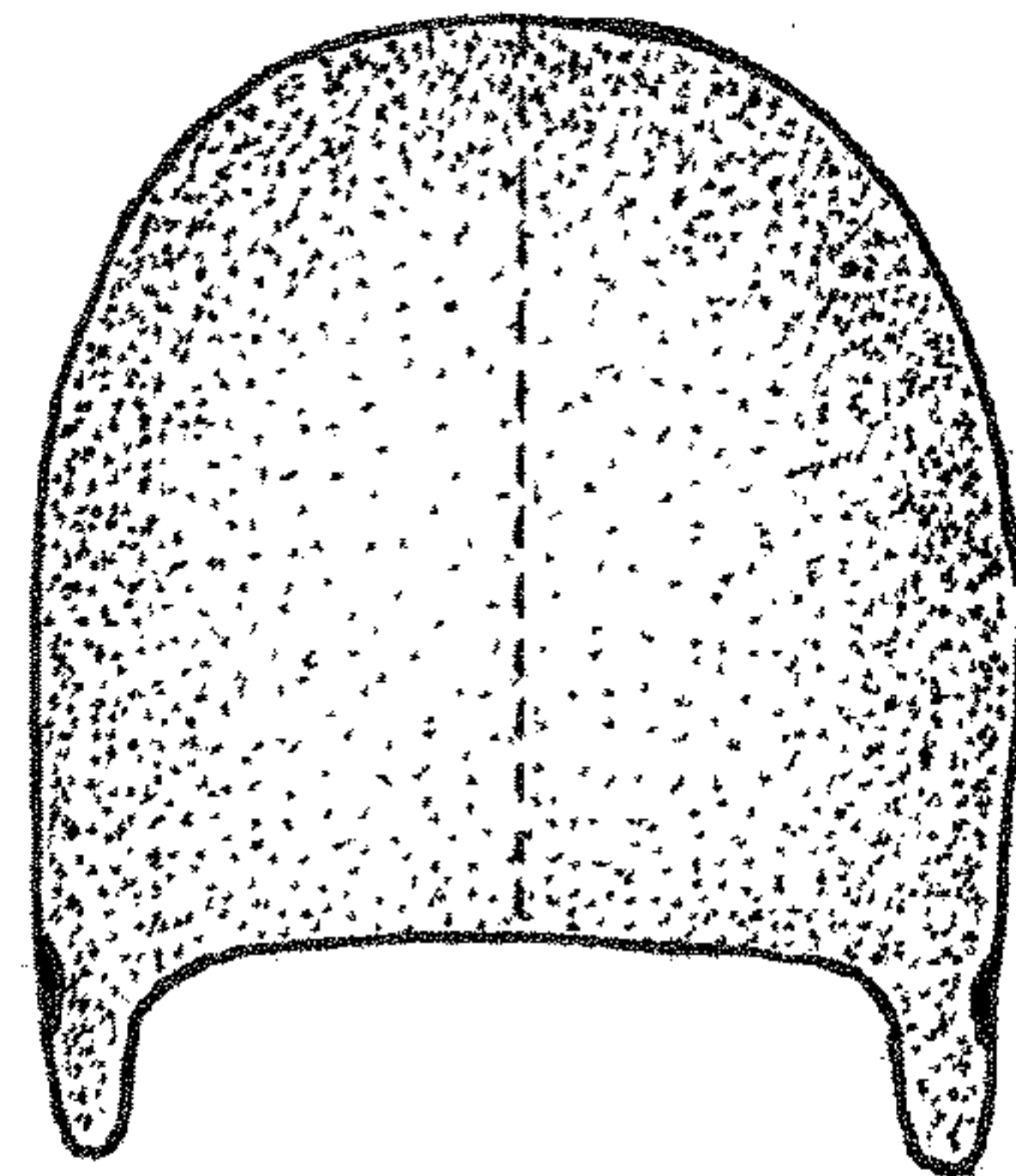

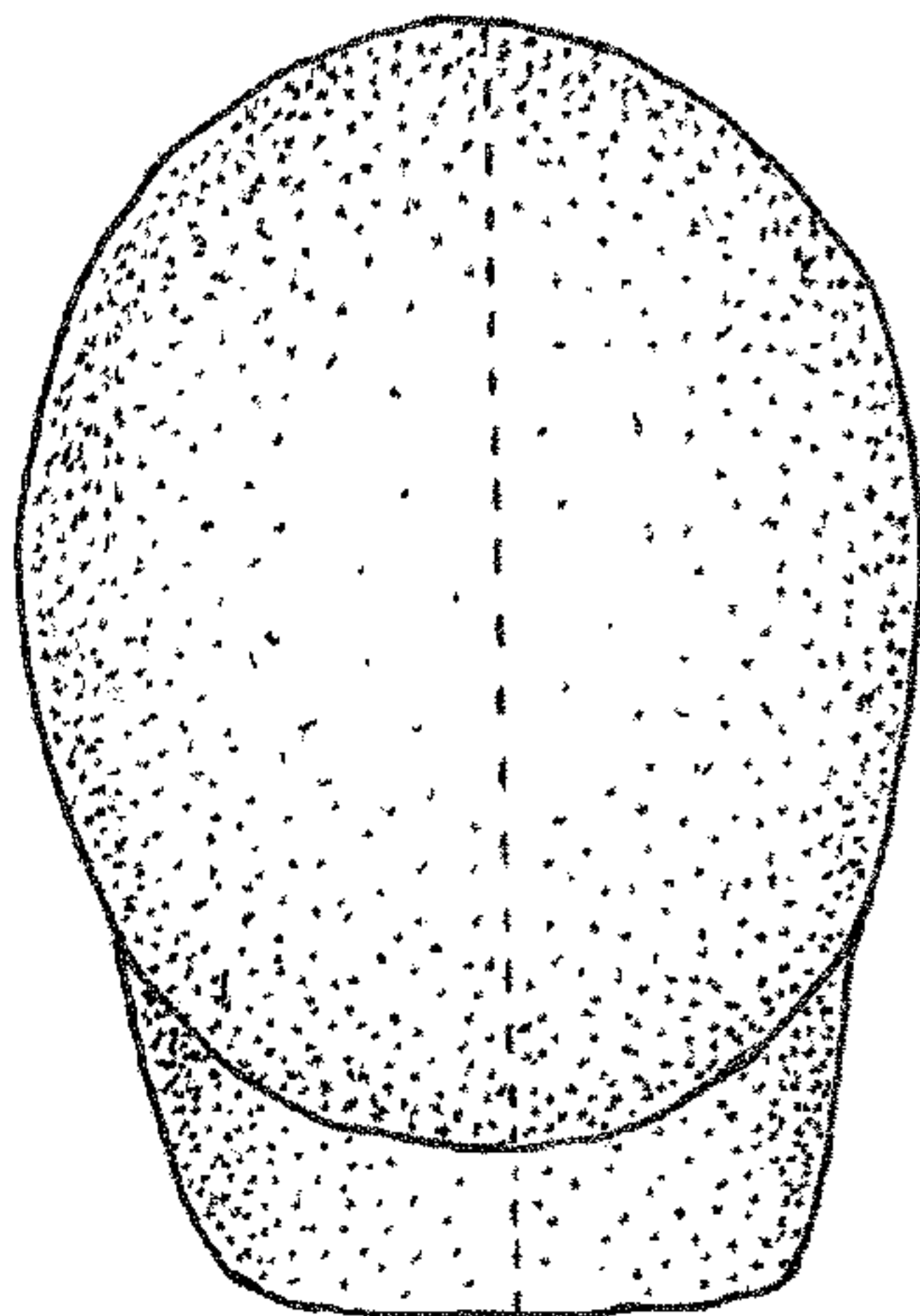
