(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for gardening pants with kneeling pad pockets, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top right front perspective view of gardening pants with kneeling pad pockets showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top left front perspective view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a top right rear perspective view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a top left rear perspective view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a front orthogonal view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a right orthogonal view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a rear orthogonal view thereof.

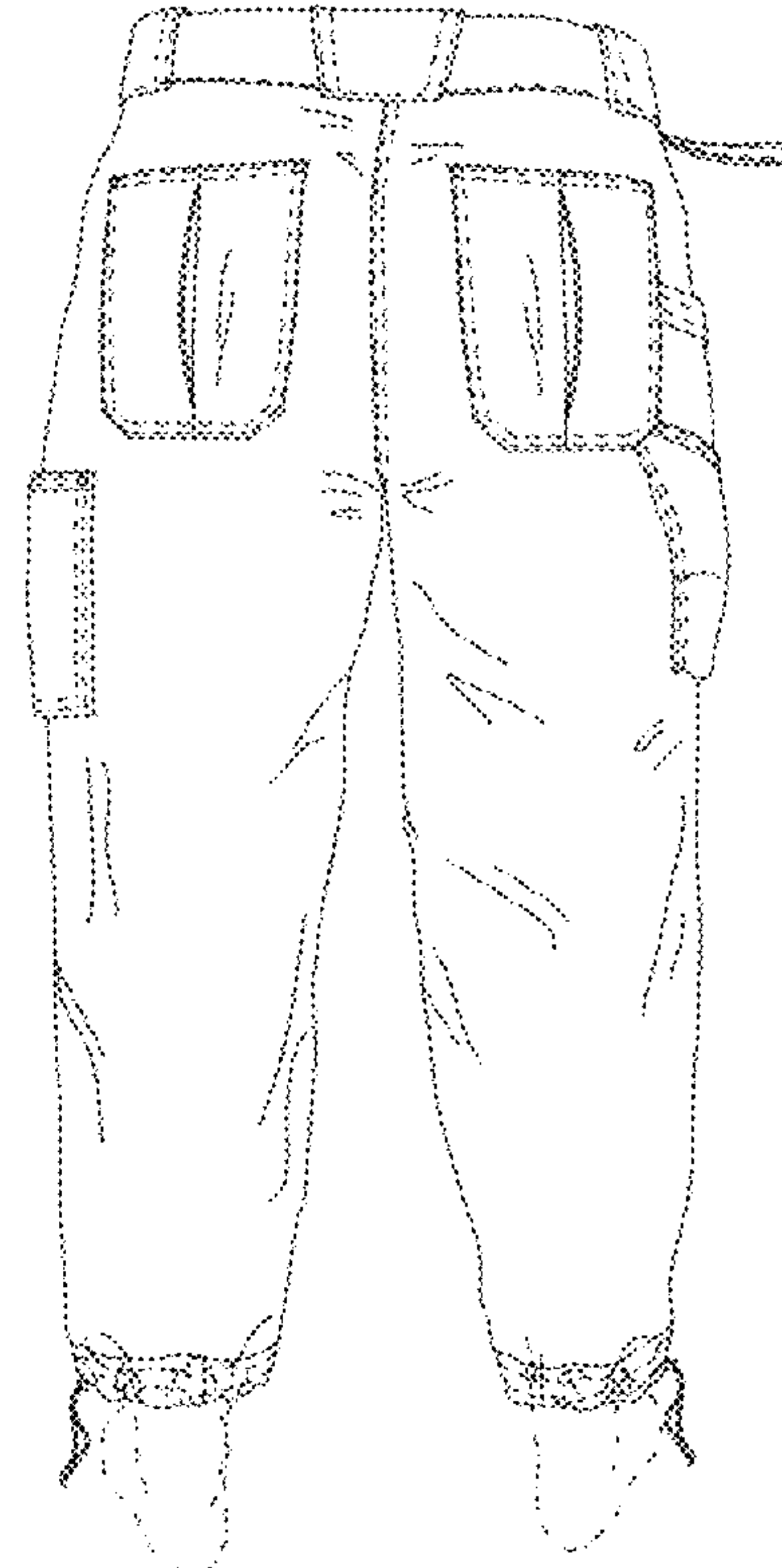
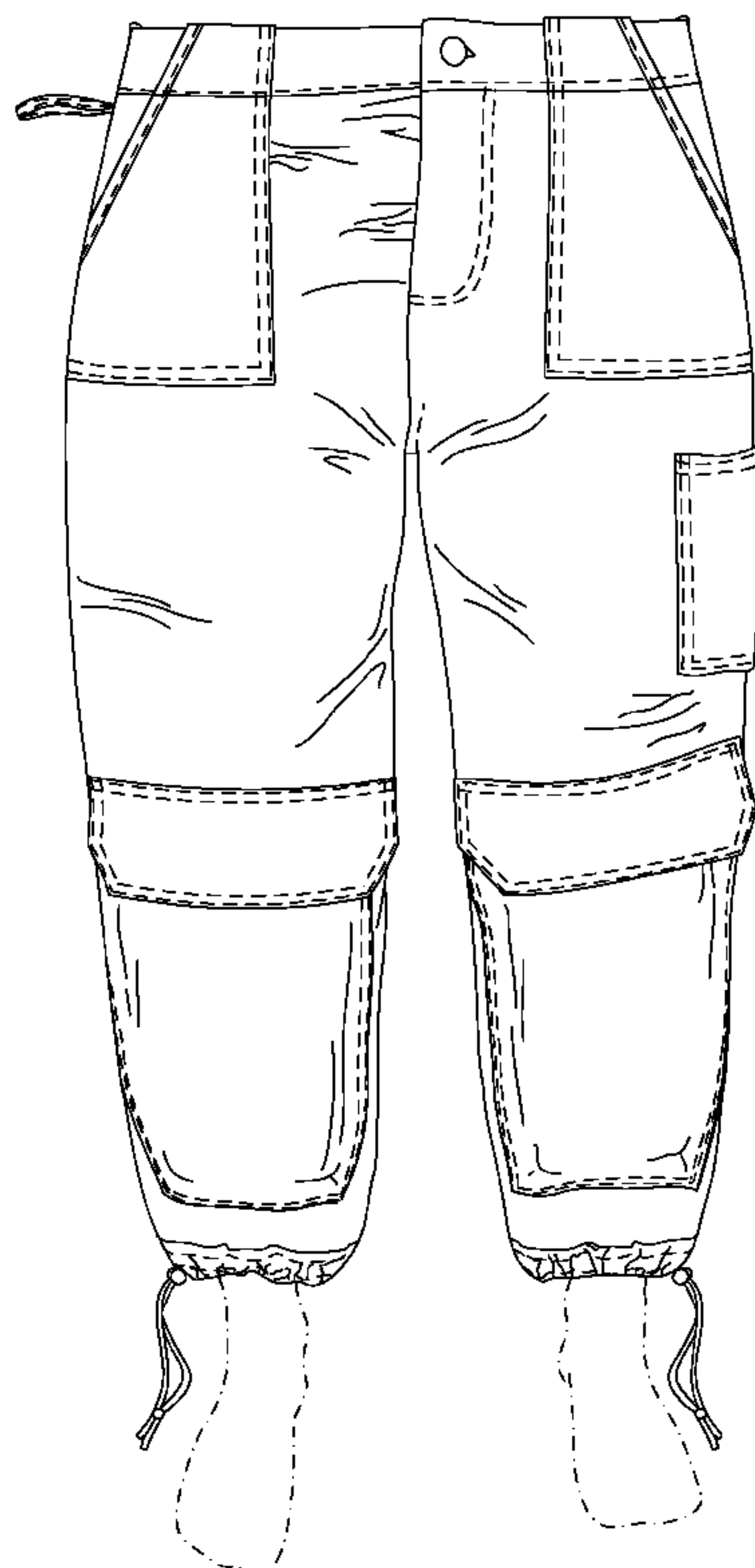
FIG. 8 is a left orthogonal view thereof.

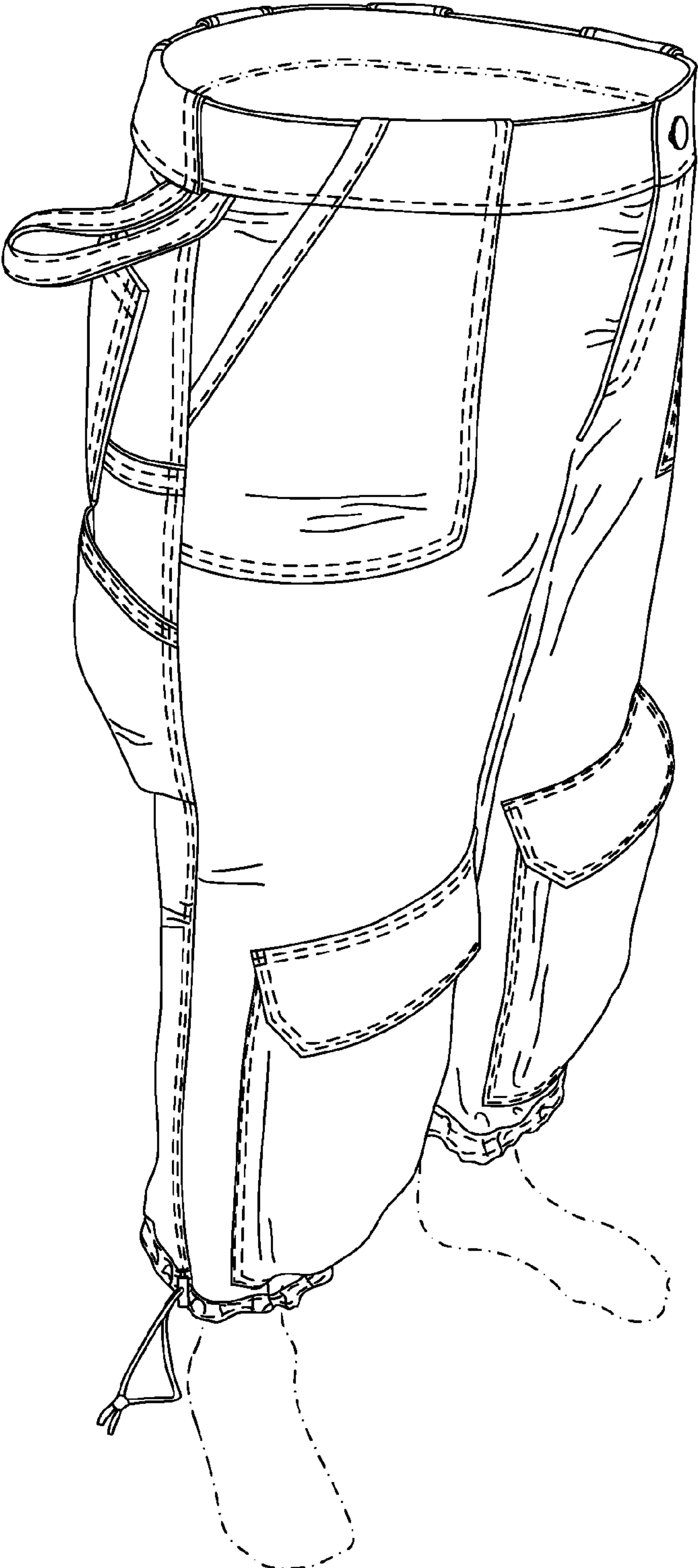
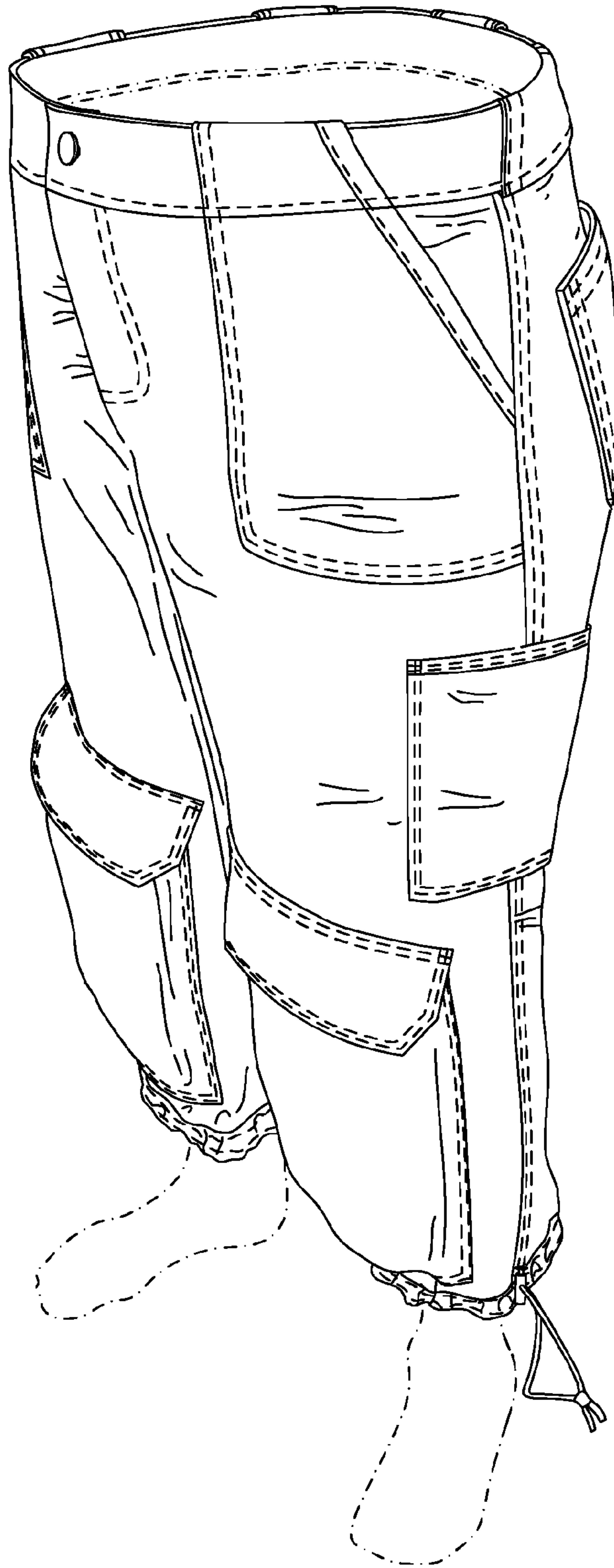

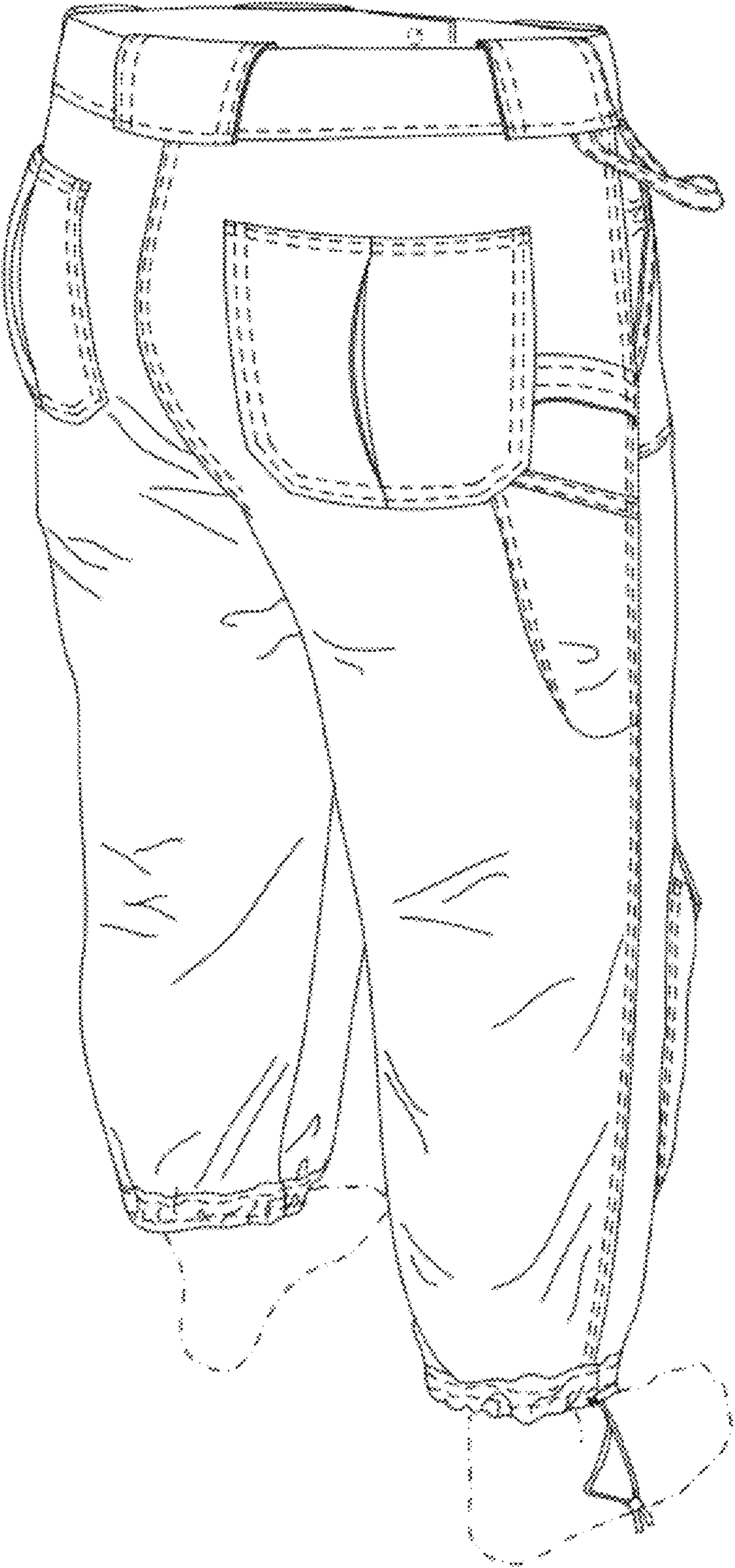

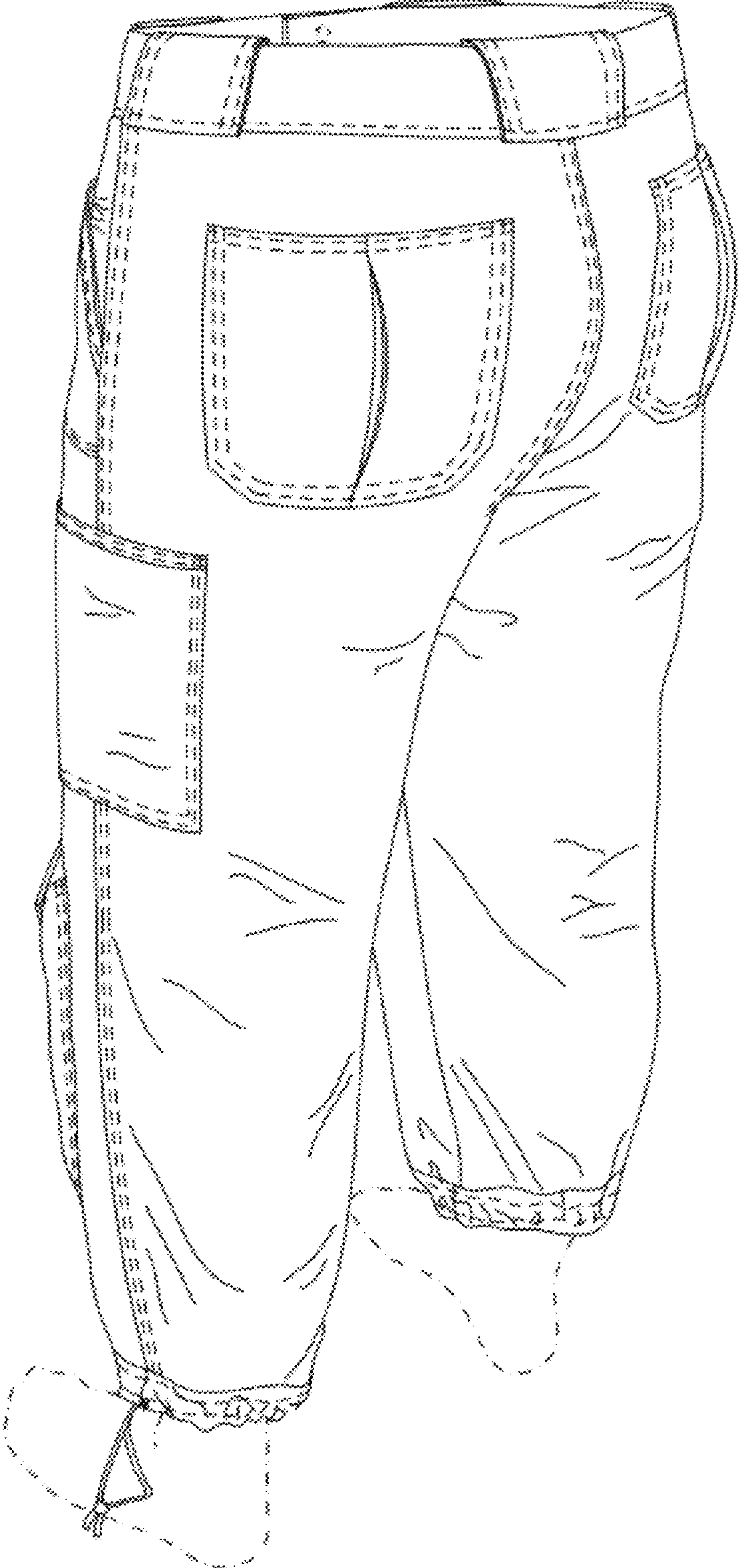

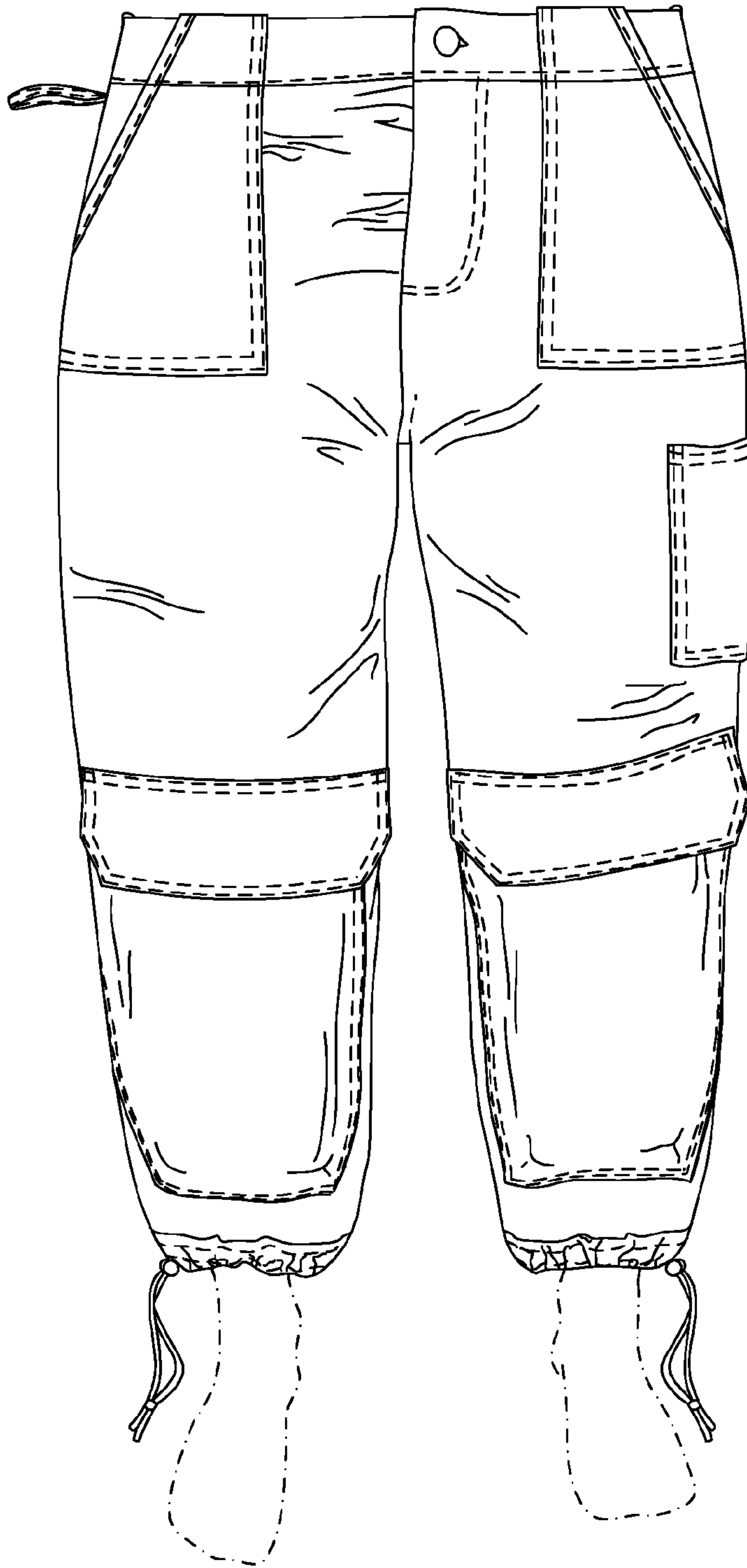

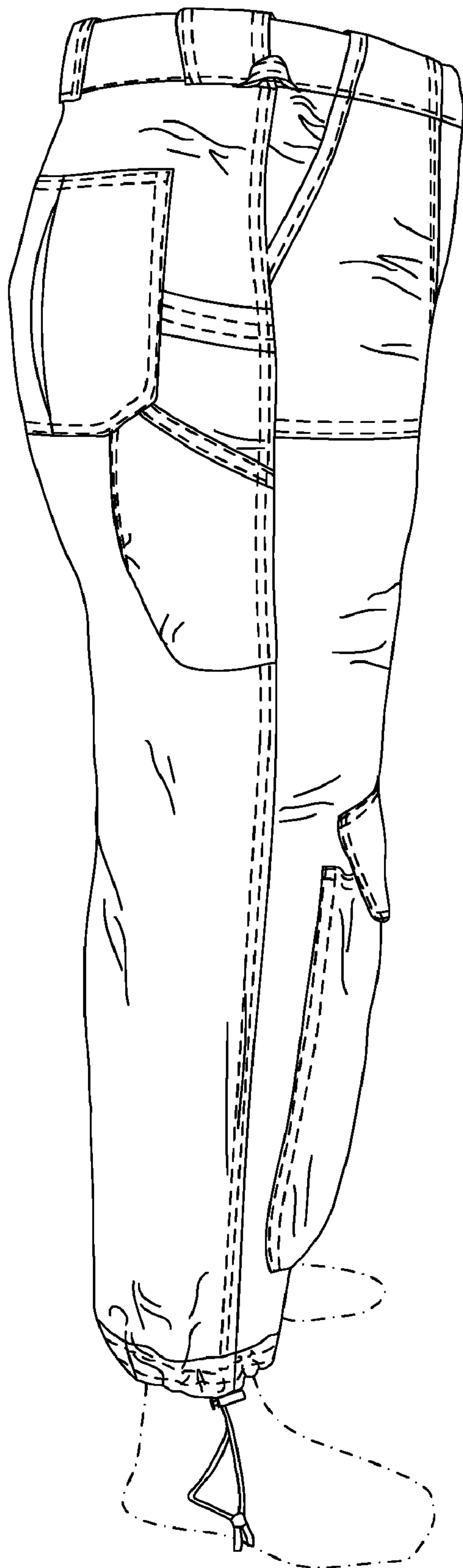

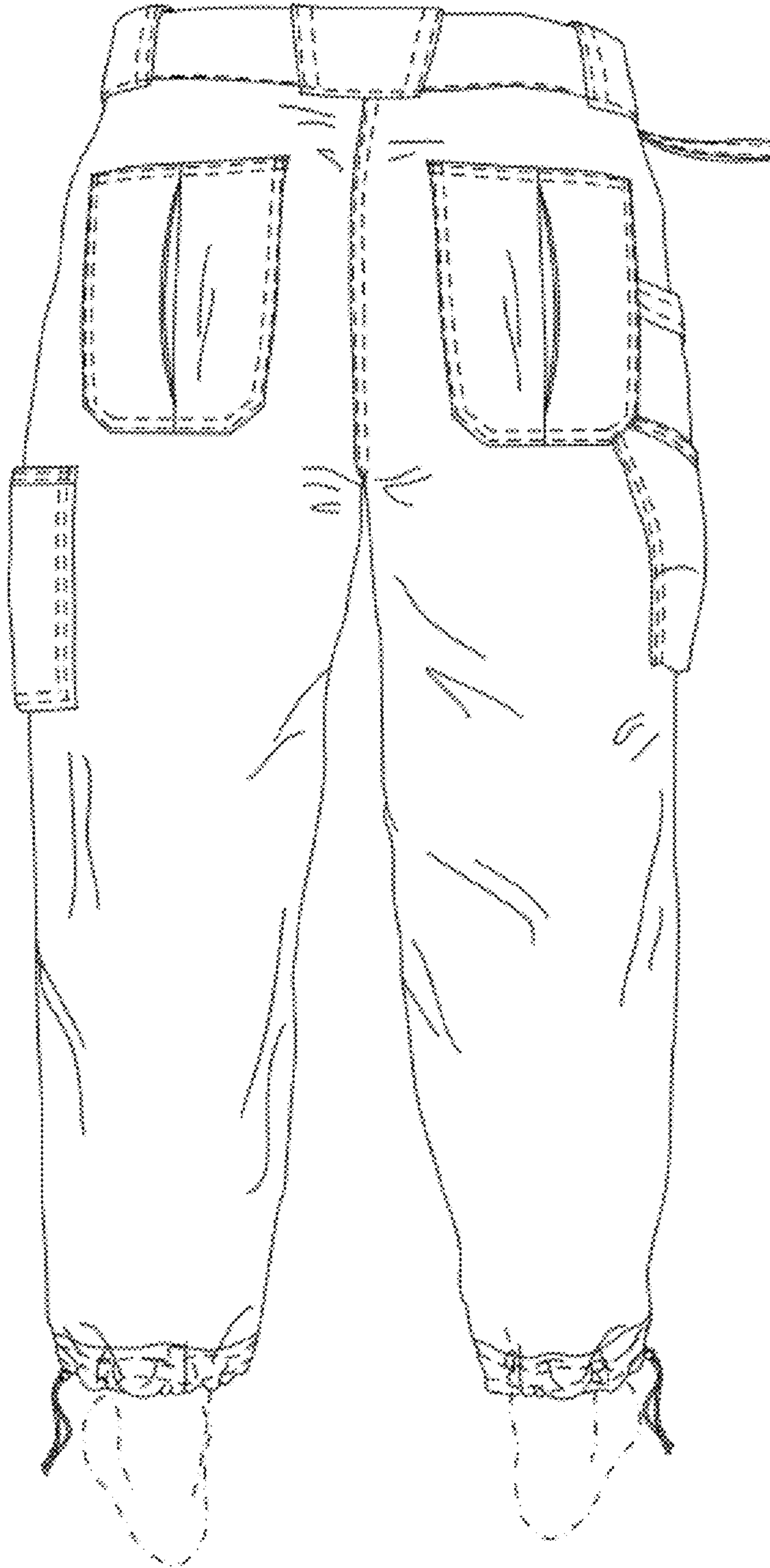

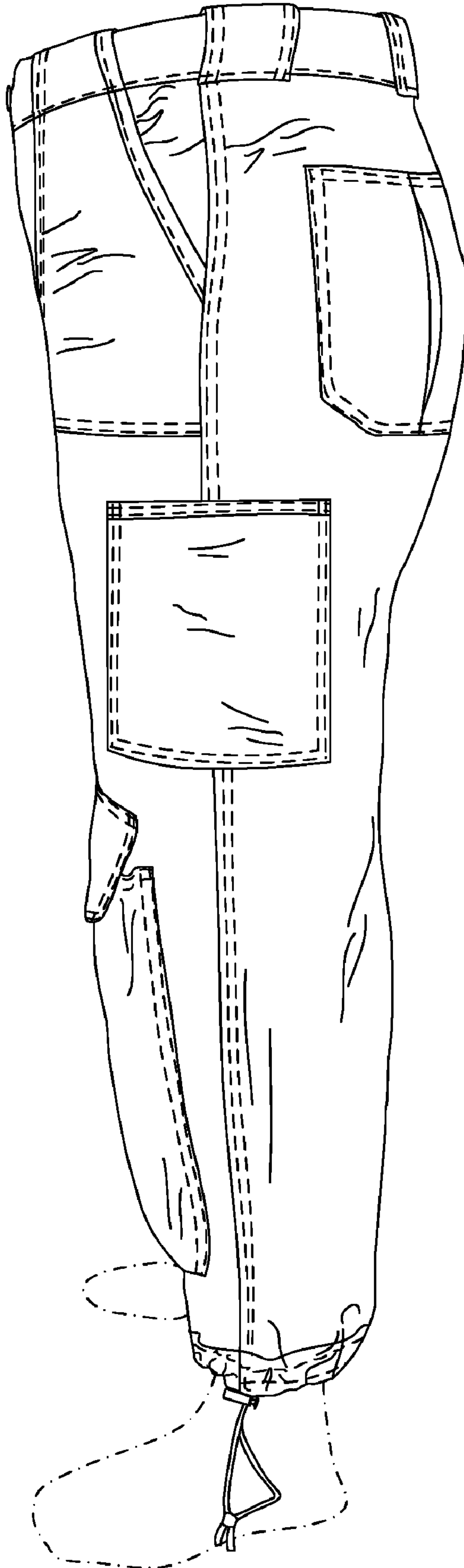

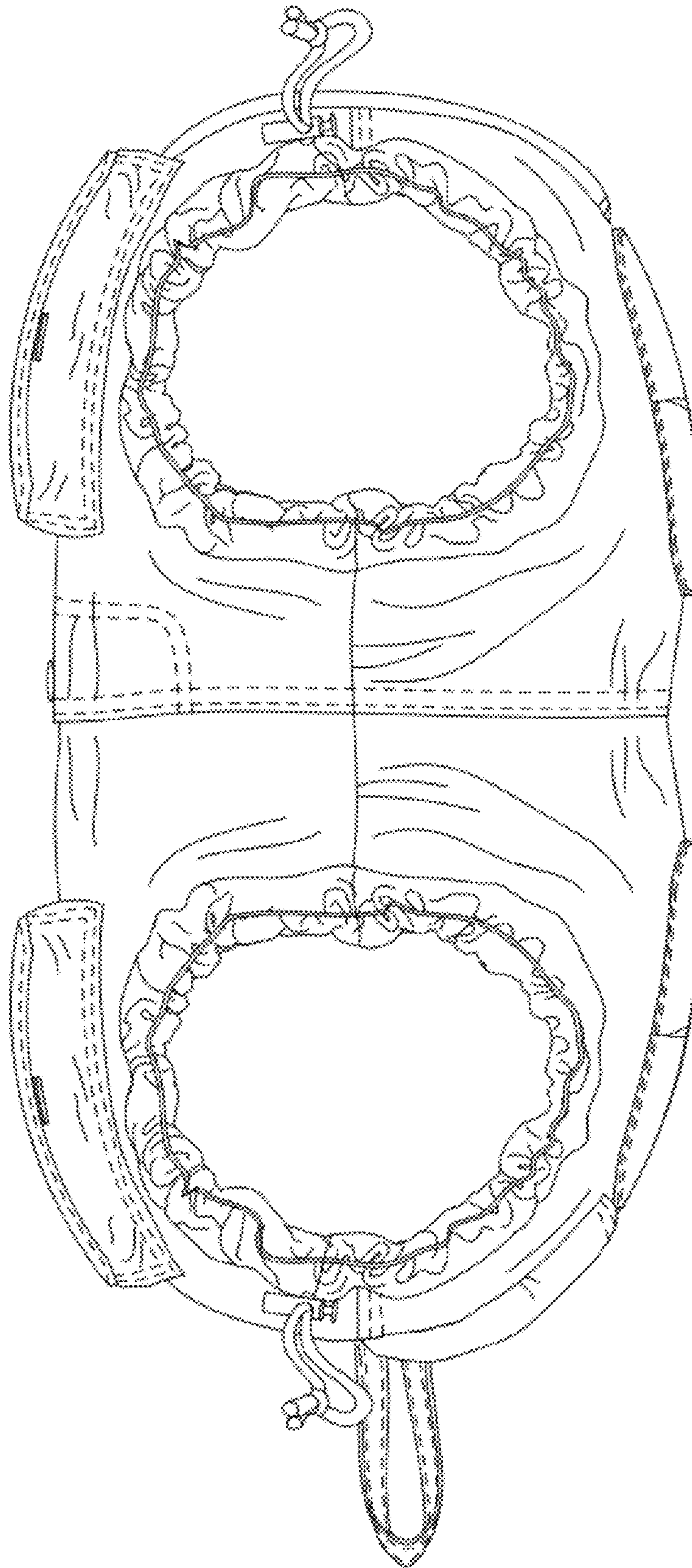
