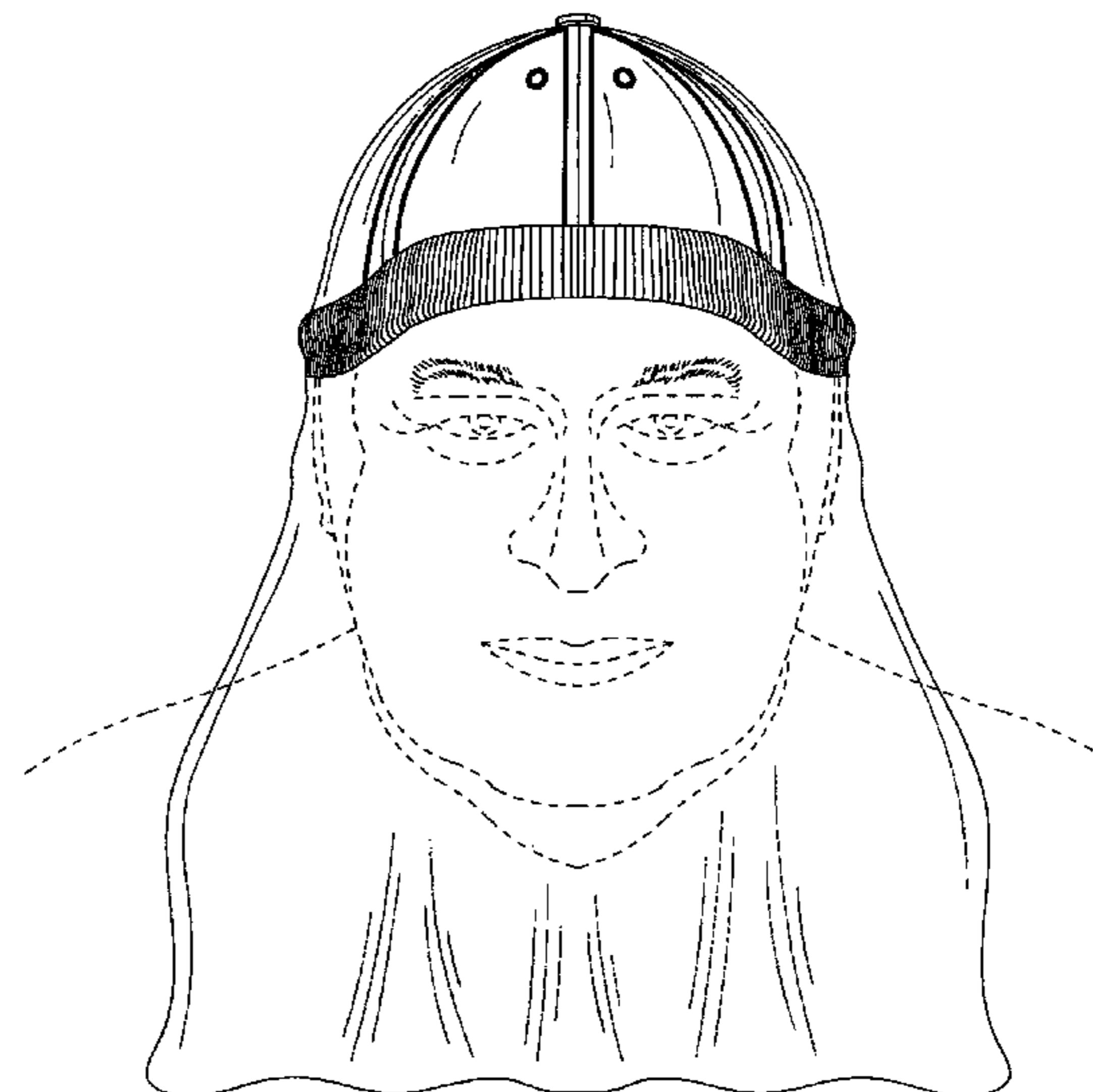
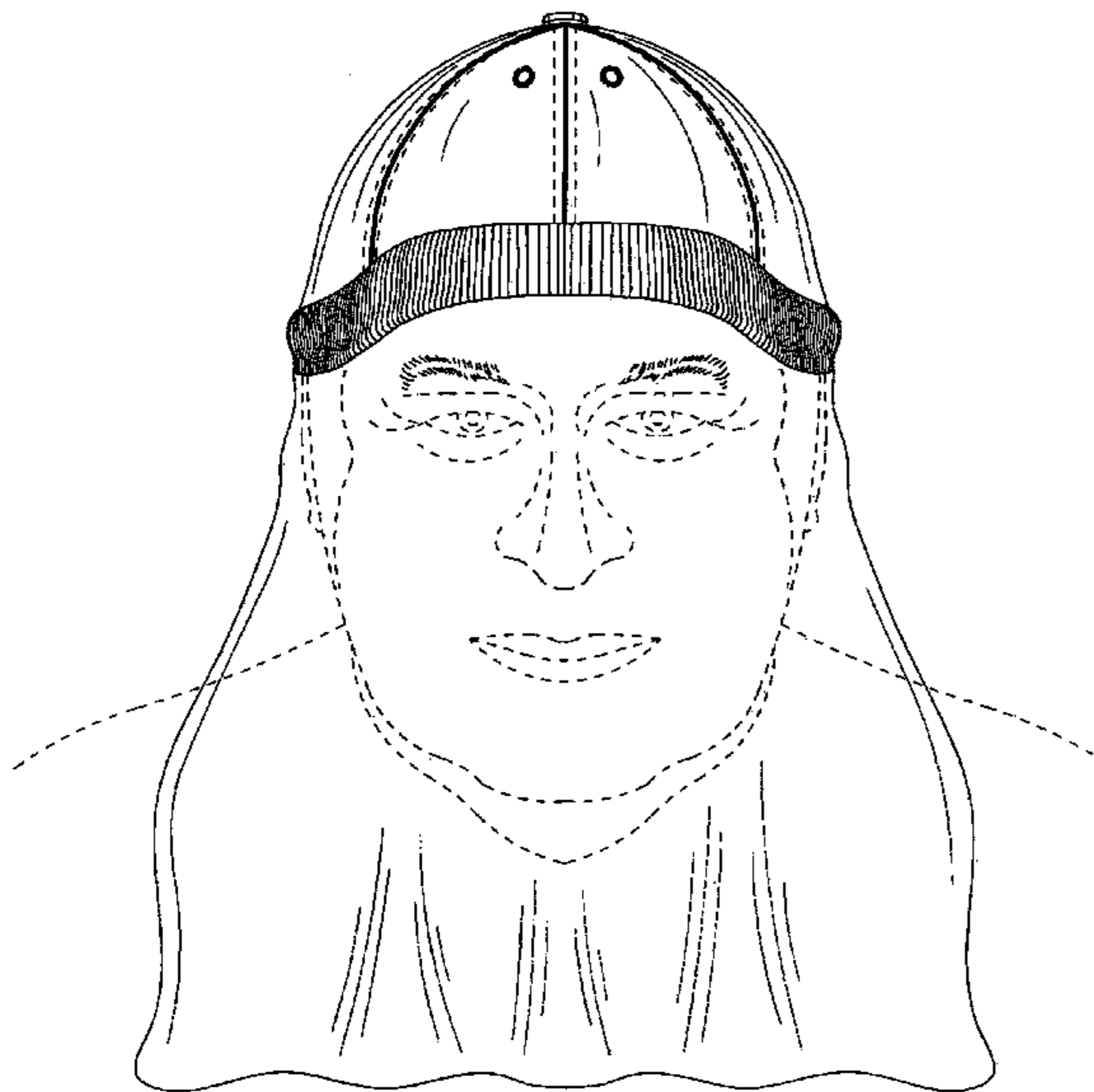
(57) **CLAIM**

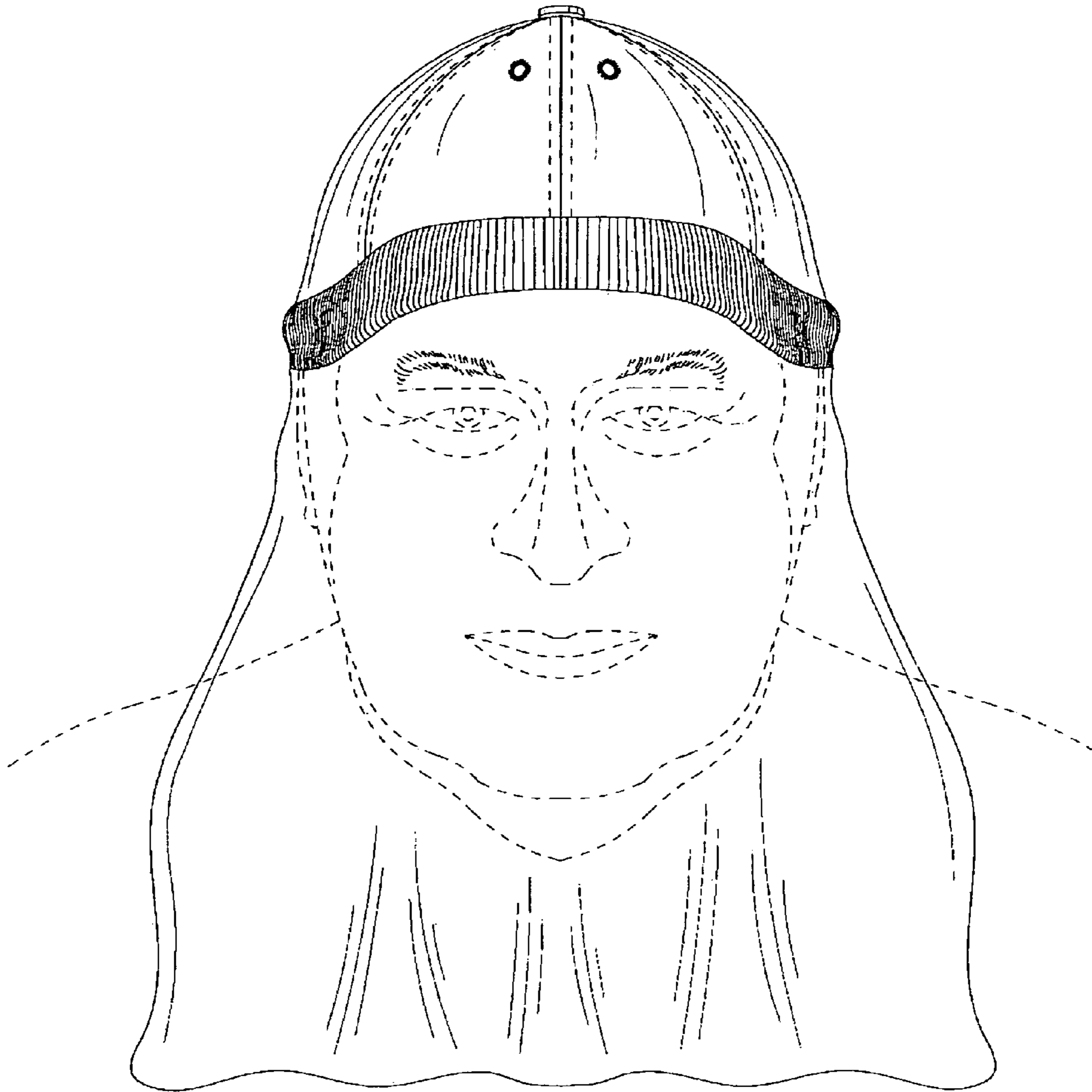
I claim the ornamental design for a hat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

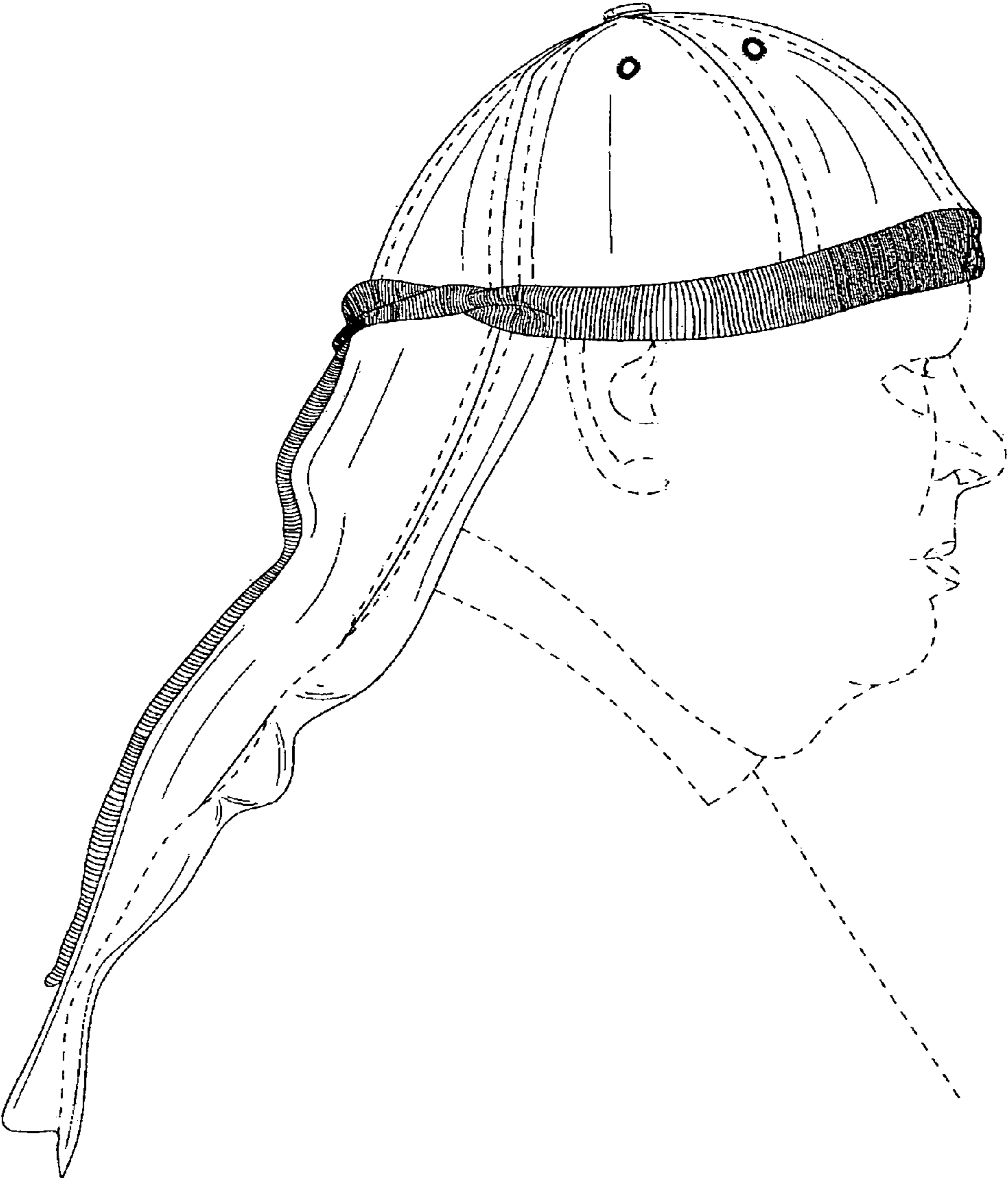
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a first embodiment of a hat. FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image thereof. FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof. FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof. FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof. FIG. 6 is a front elevation view of a second embodiment of a hat. FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image thereof. FIG. 8 is a rear elevation view thereof. FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof. FIG. 10 is a perspective view thereof. FIG. 11 is a front elevation view of a third embodiment of a hat. FIG. 12 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image thereof. FIG. 13 is a rear elevation view thereof. FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 15 is a perspective view thereof. The heavier black solid lines on the hat of FIGS. 6-15 are top stitching. The broken-line illustration of a person wearing the hat is environmental structure only and forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines on the hat itself are top stitching and are part of the claimed design.

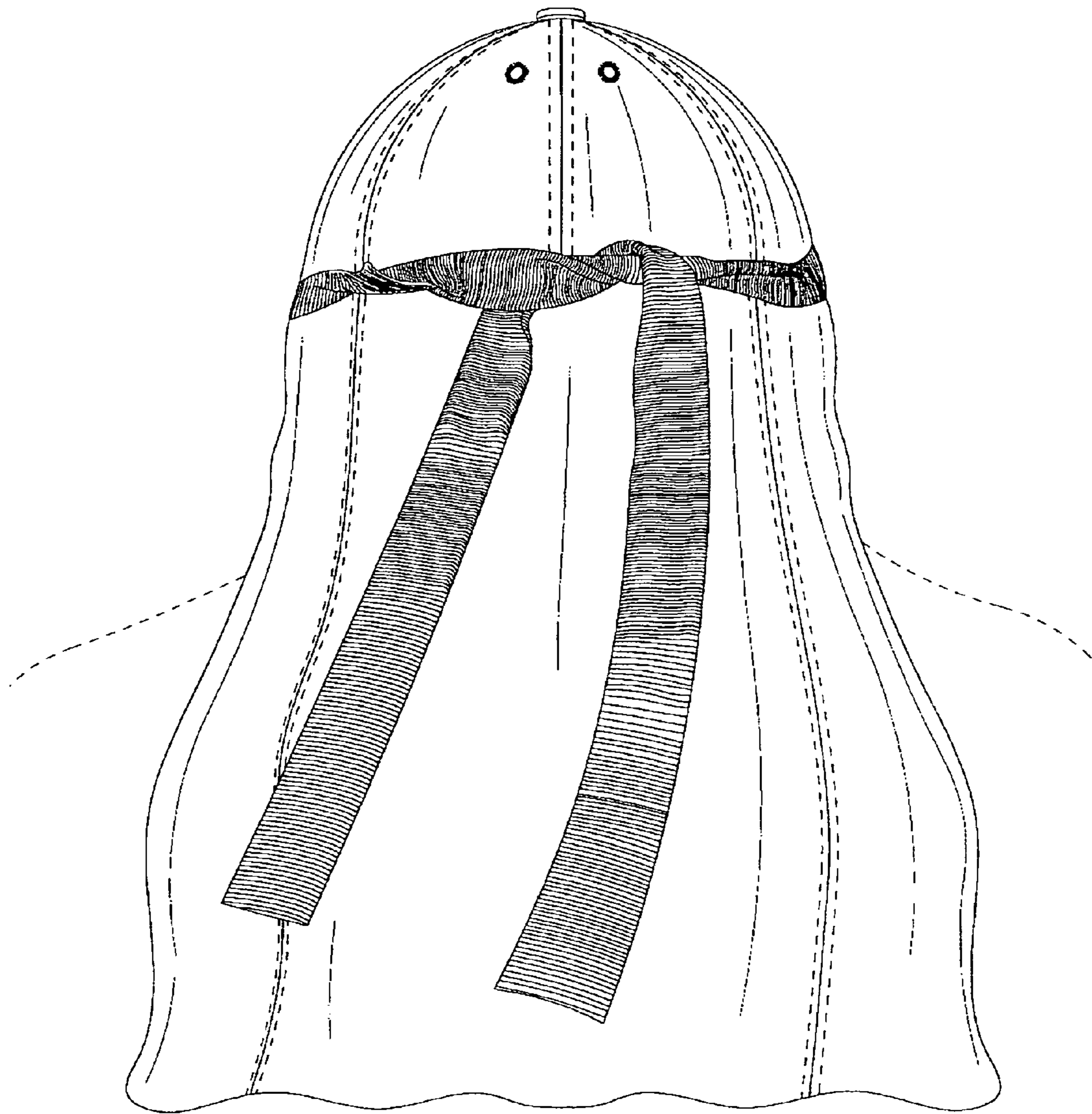

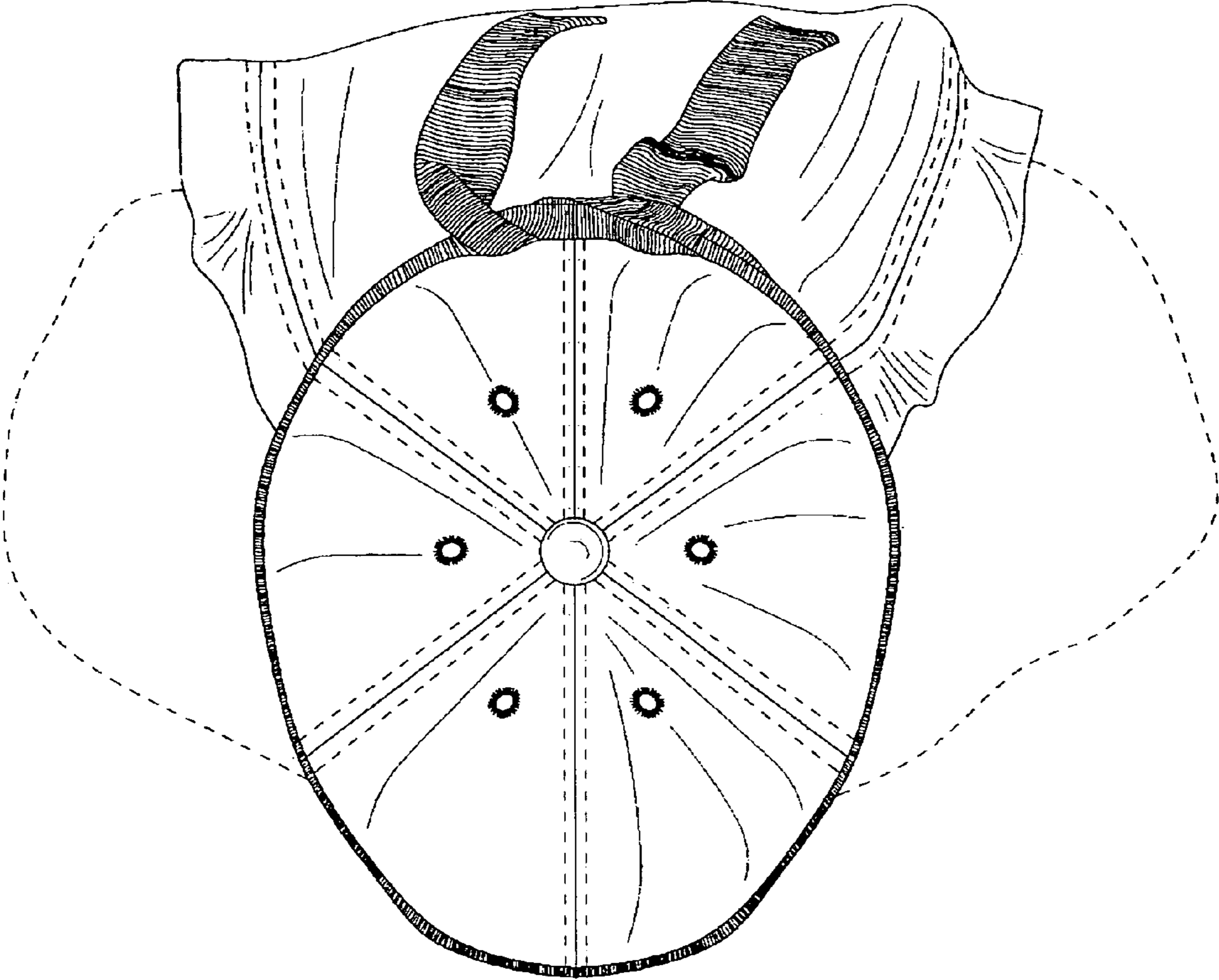

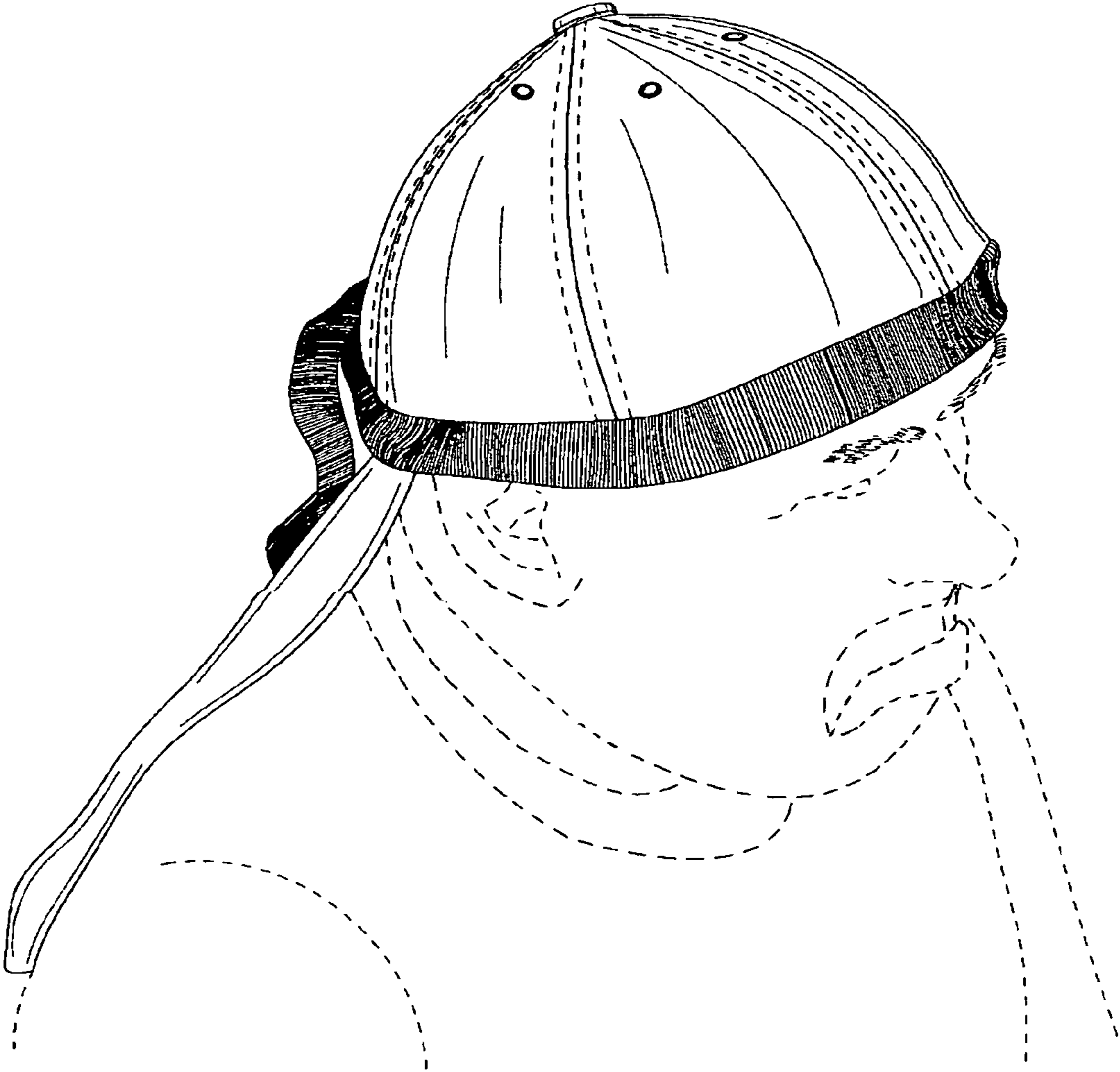
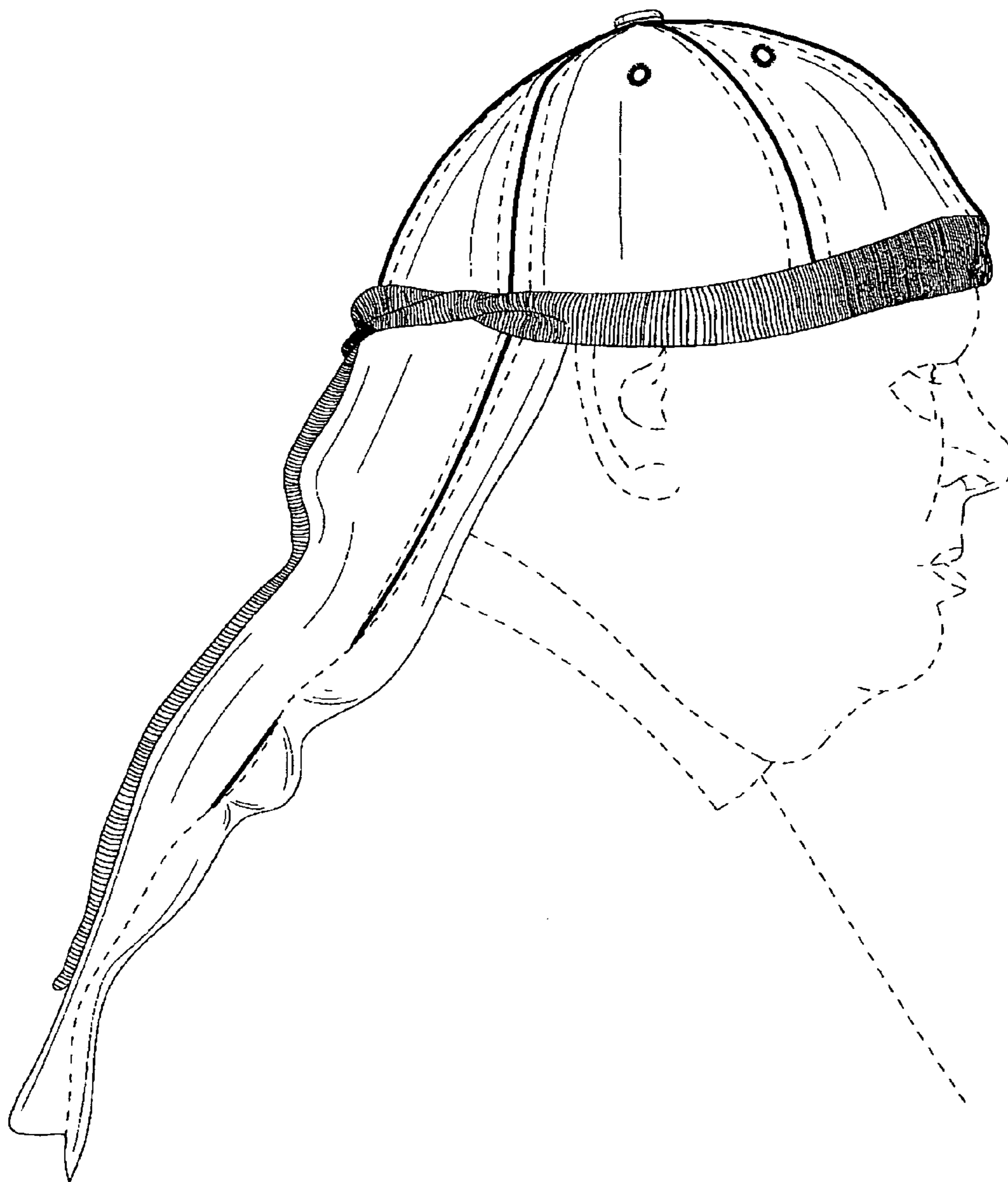

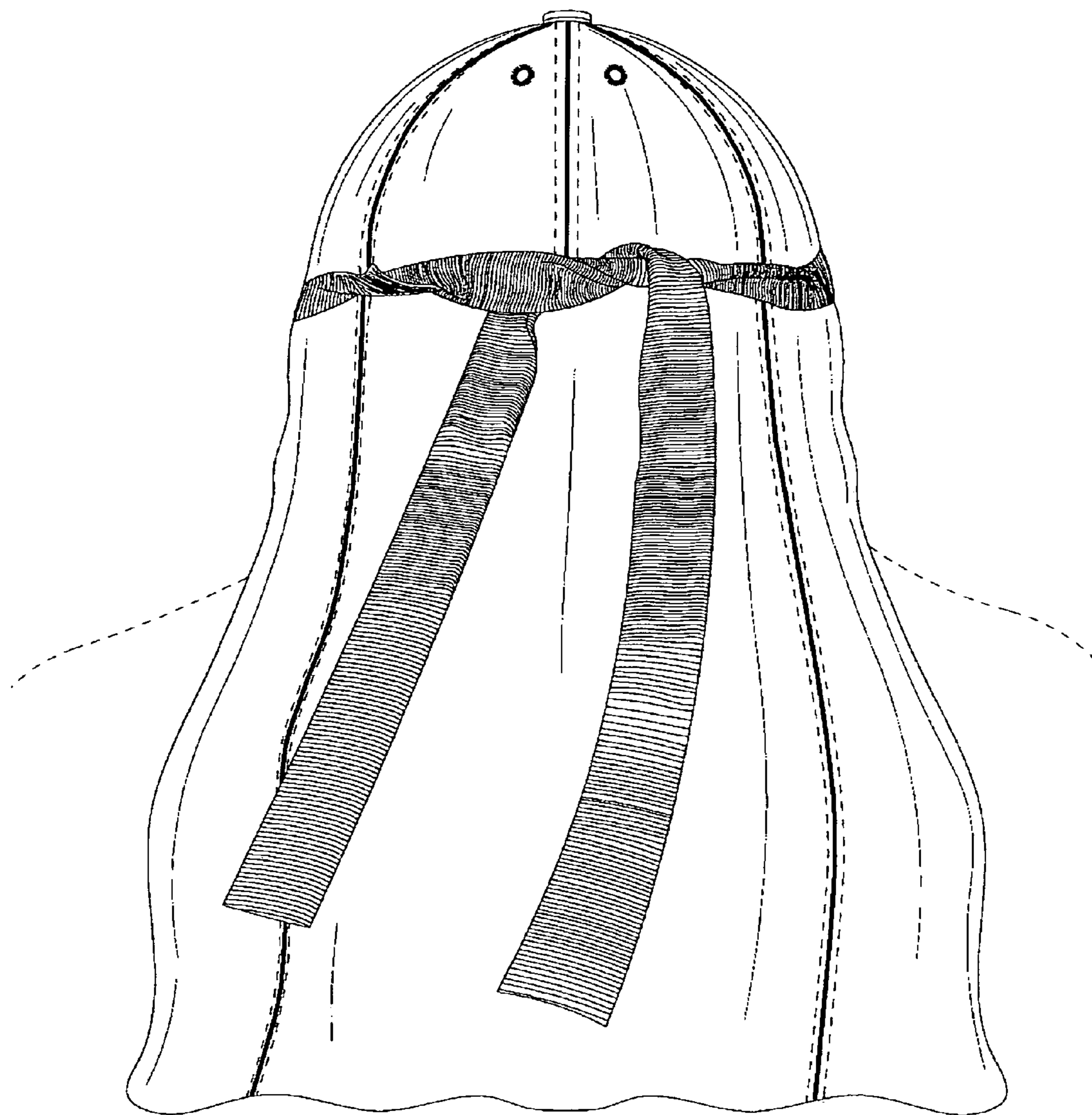
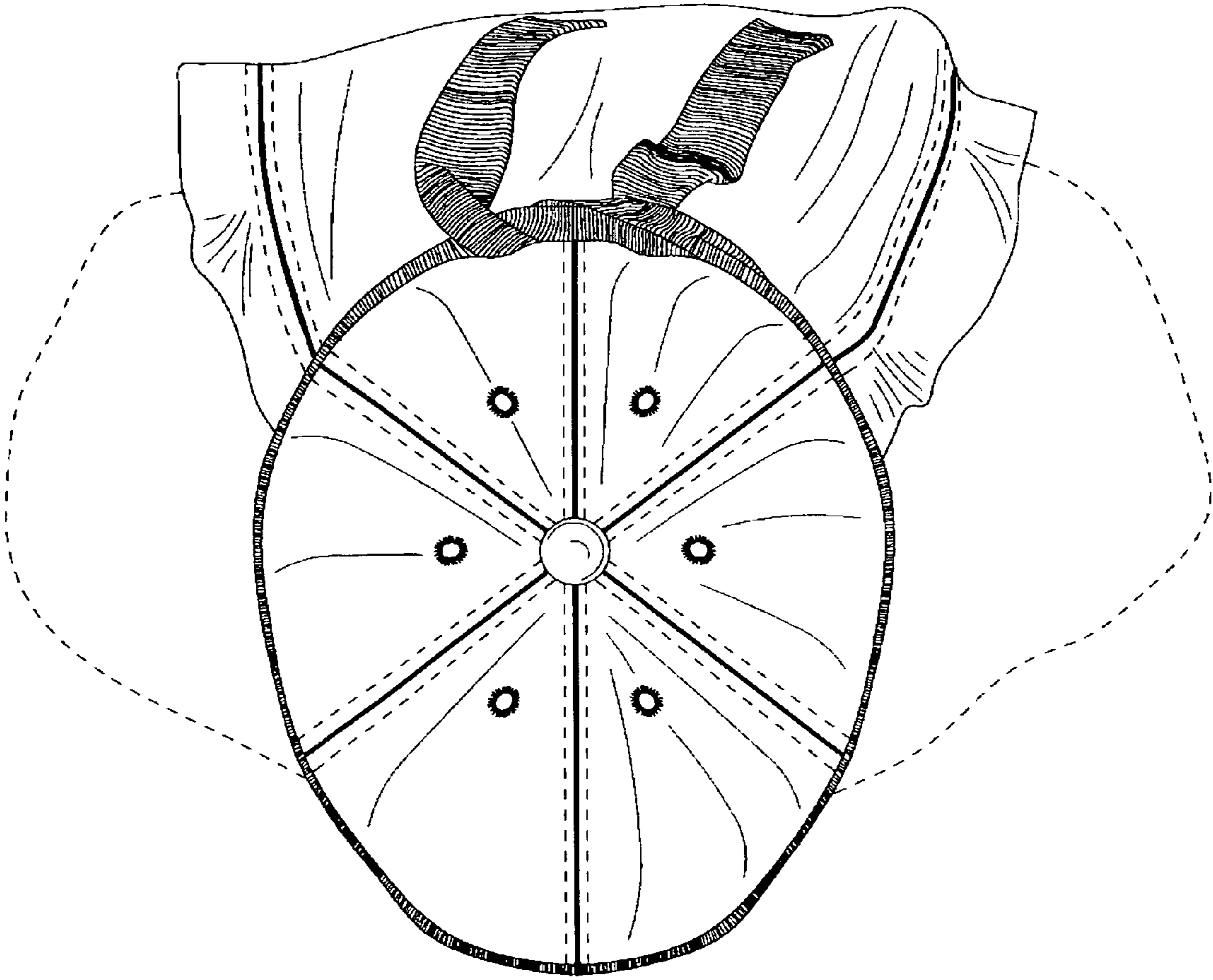
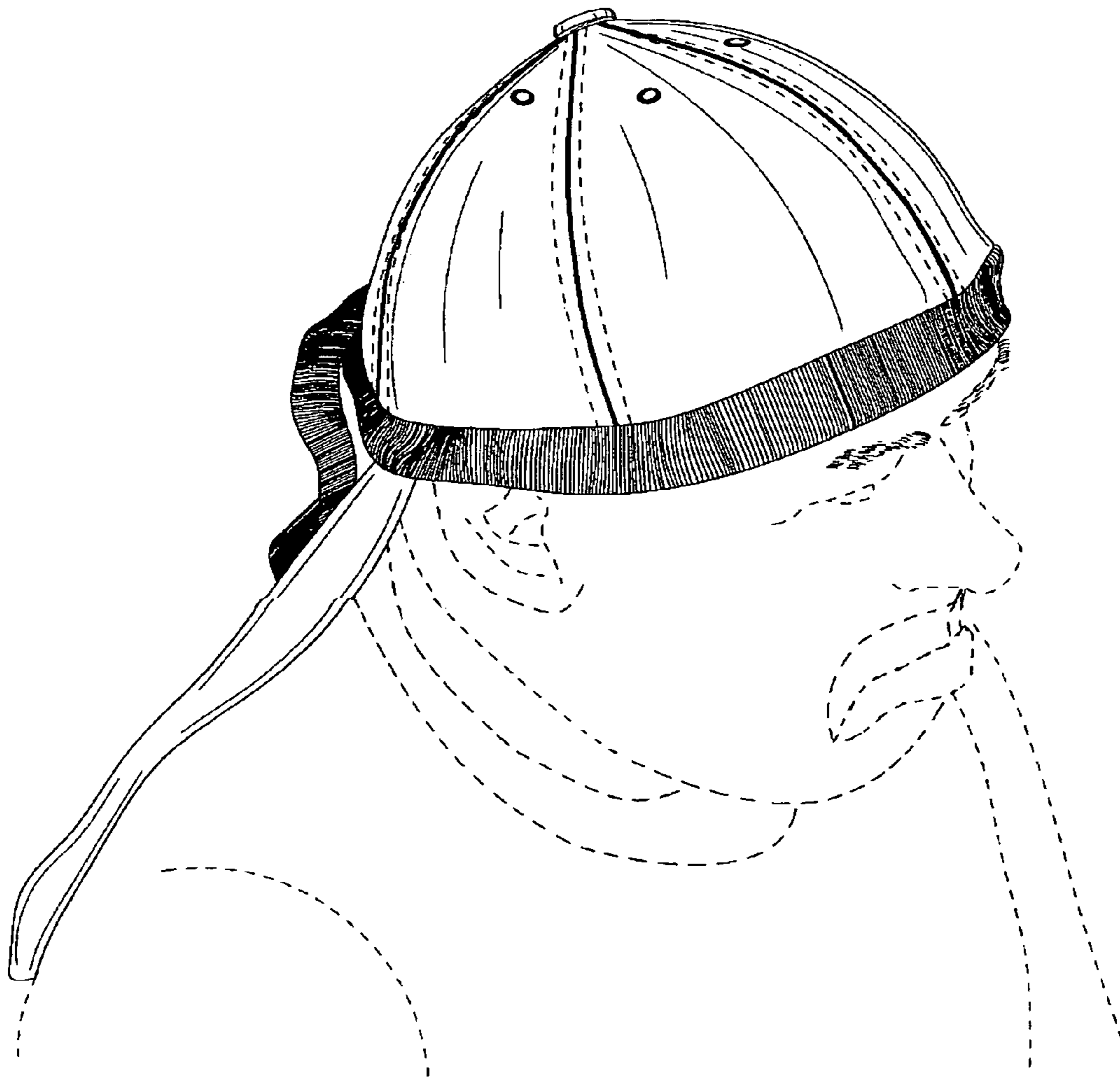


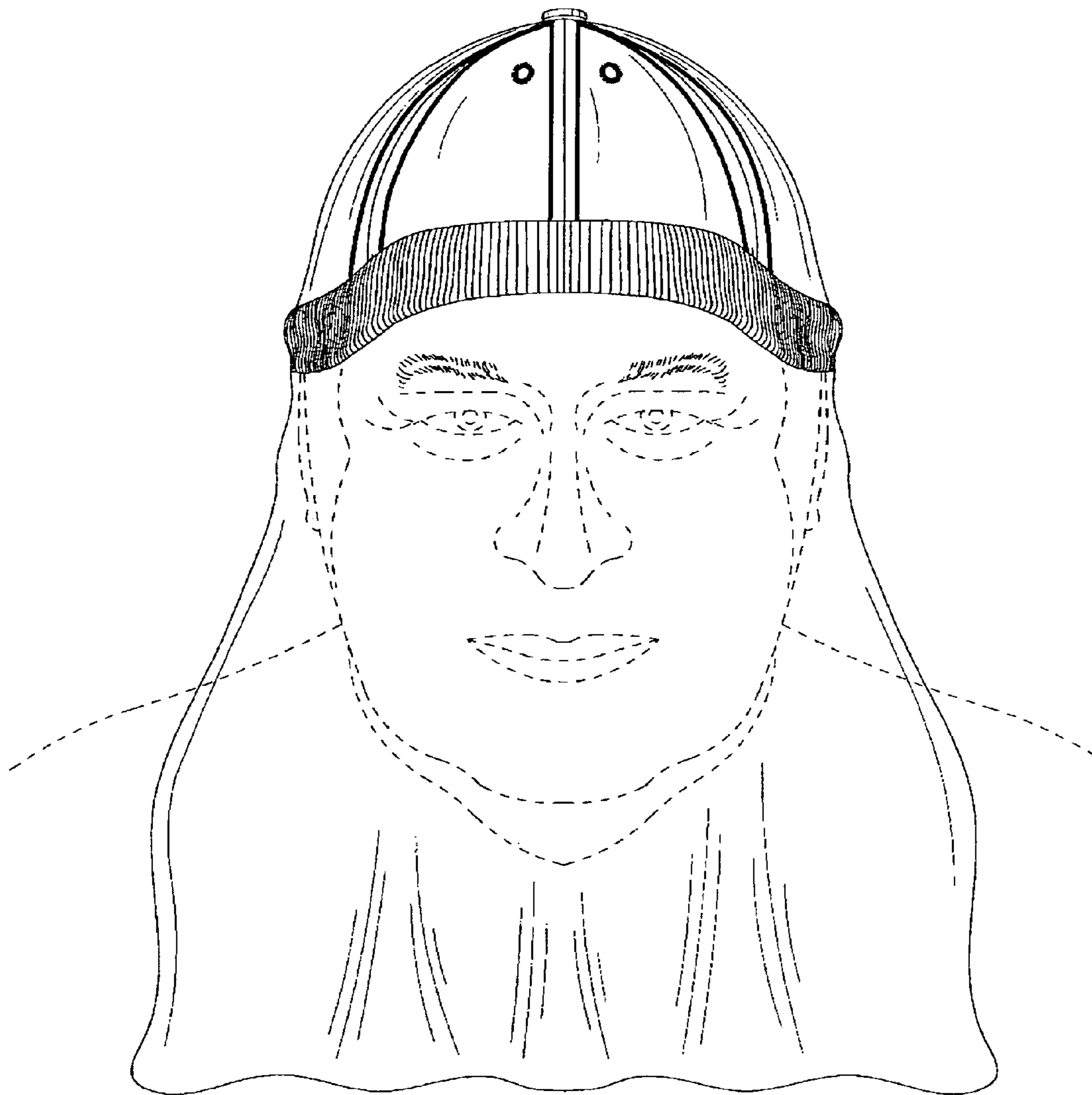

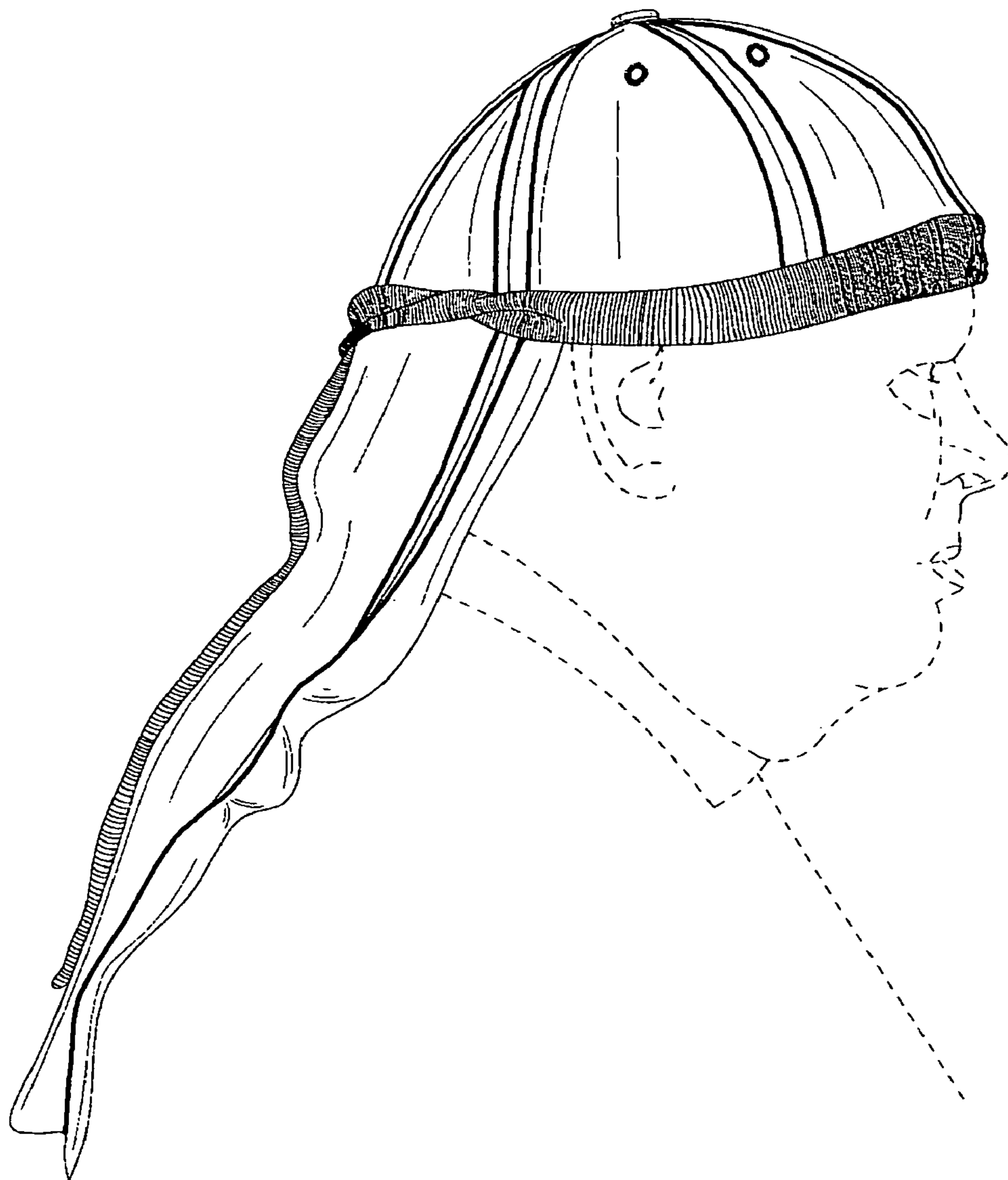

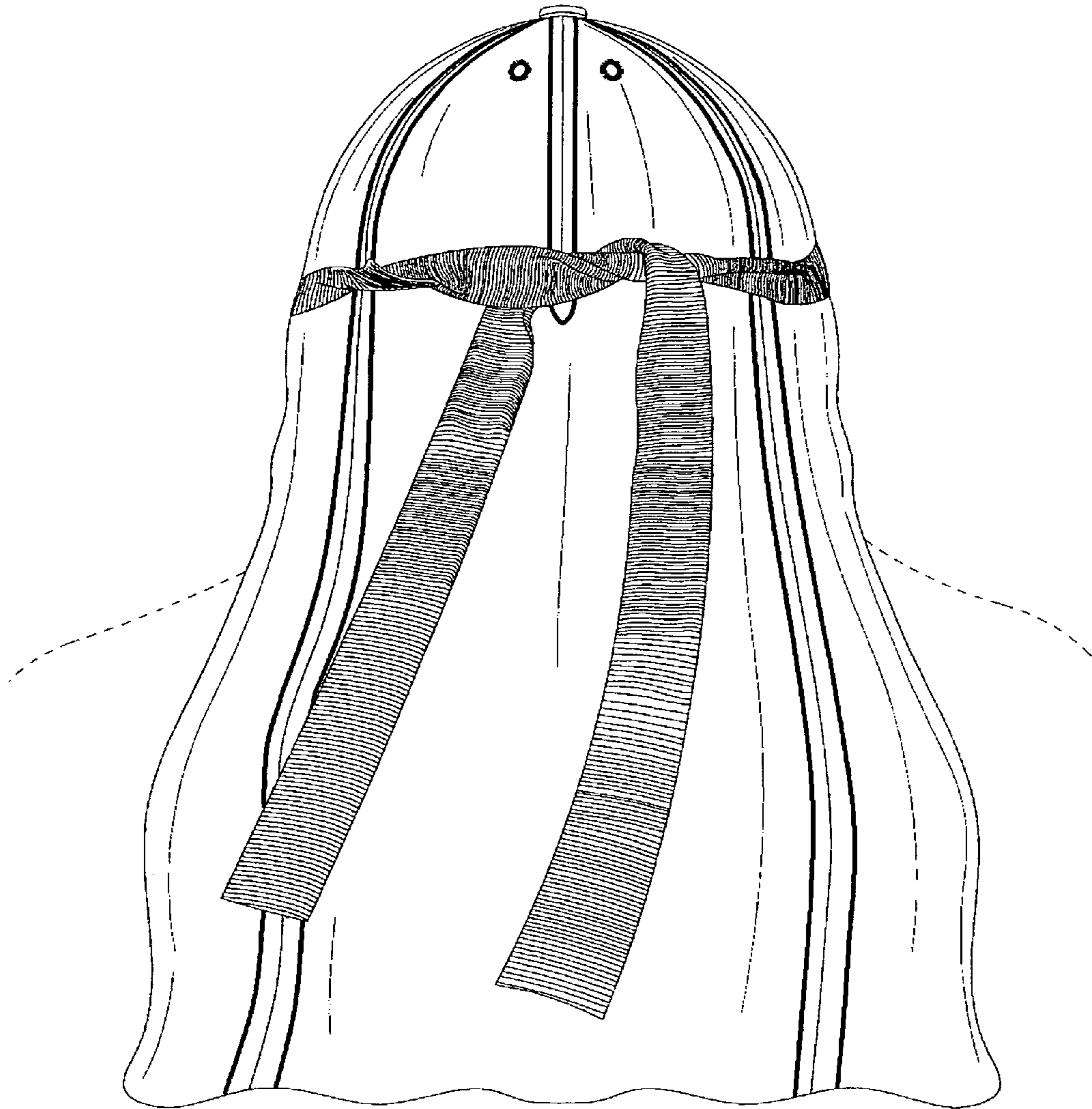

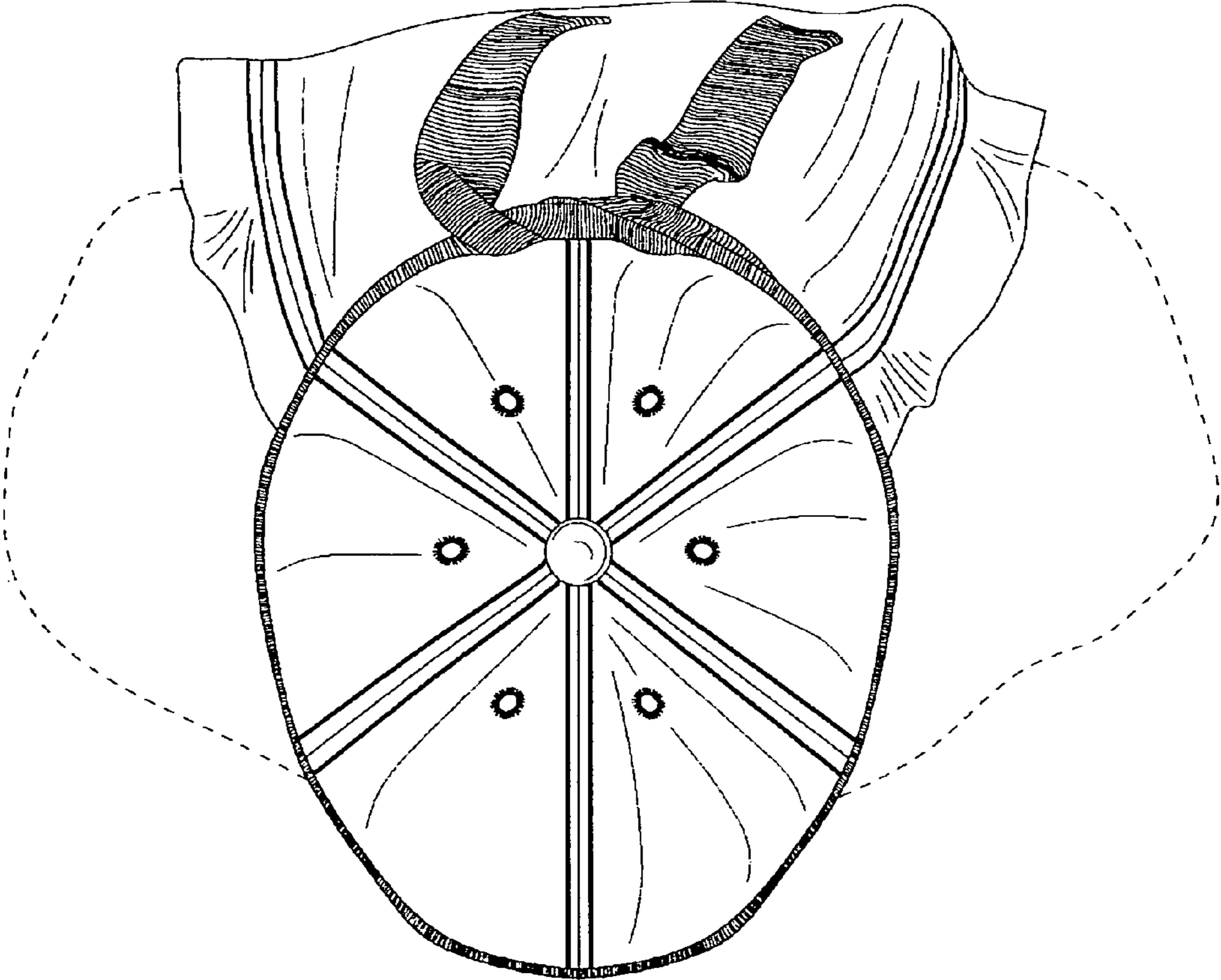

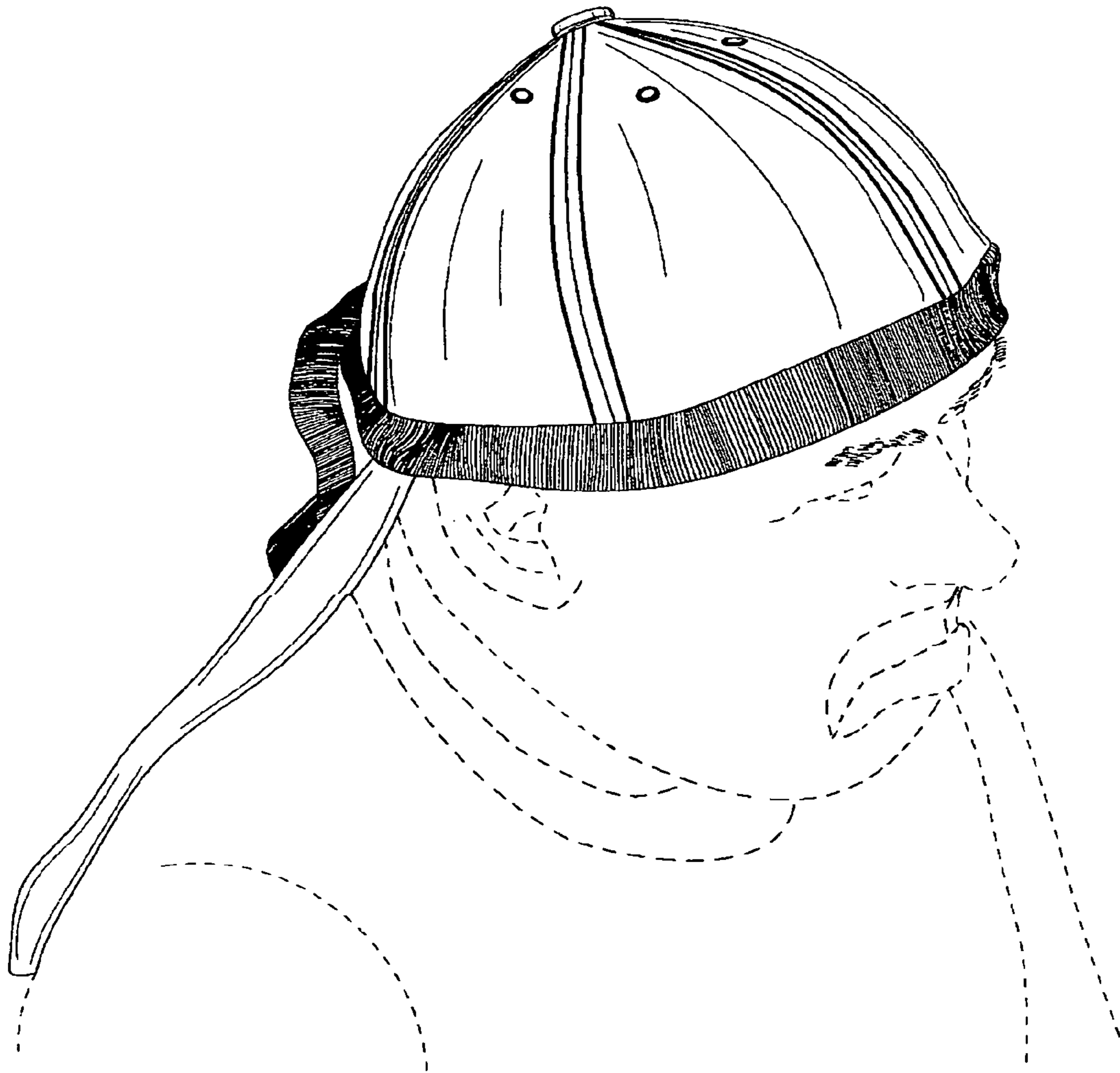
