(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a garage door screen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a garage door screen, showing a first embodiment of the new design in a deployed configuration;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, illustrated in a flat configuration;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the new design in a deployed configuration;

FIG. 10 is an enlarged perspective view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view thereof, illustrated in a flat configuration;

FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 11;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of FIG. 11;

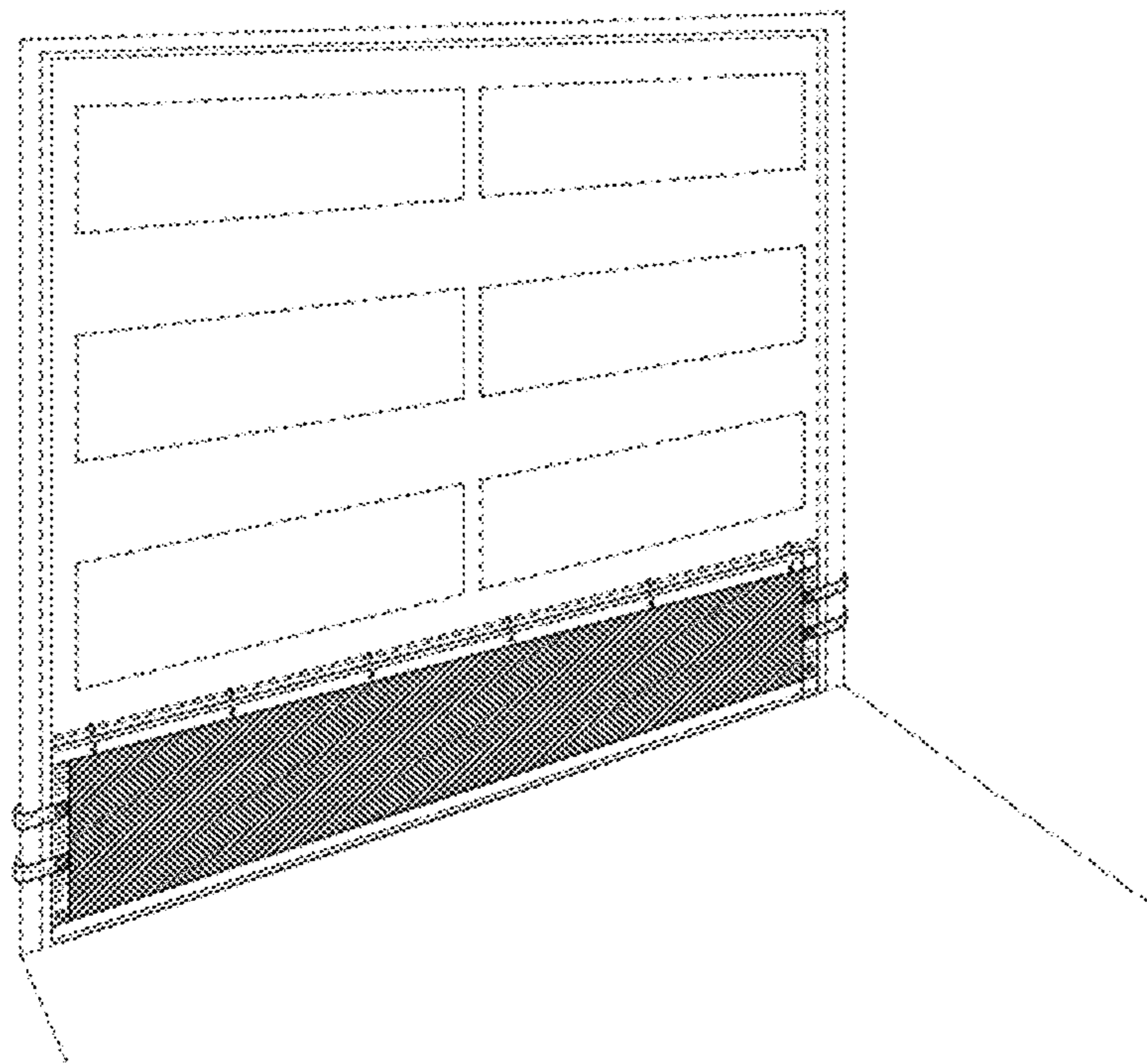
FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 11;

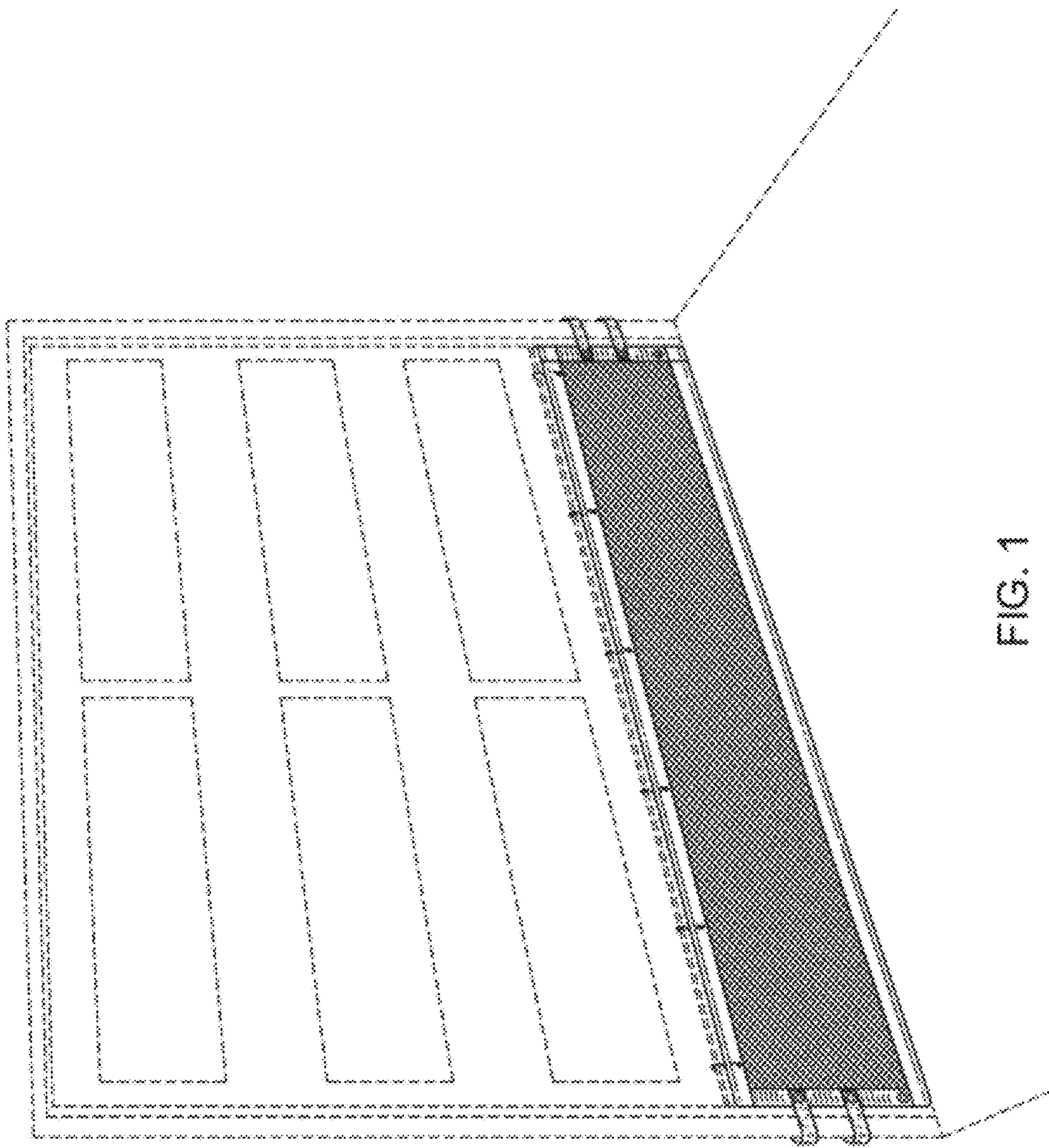

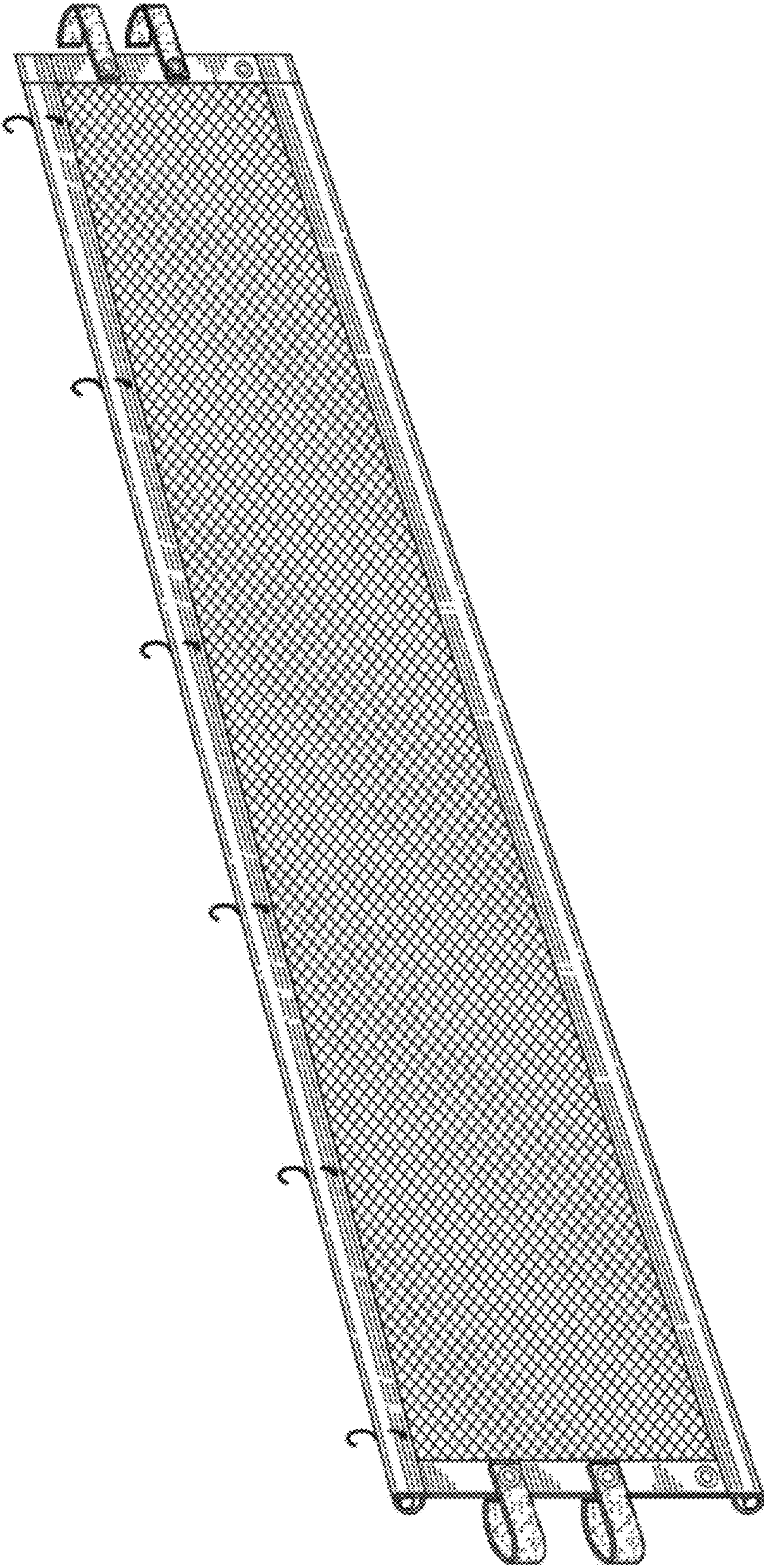

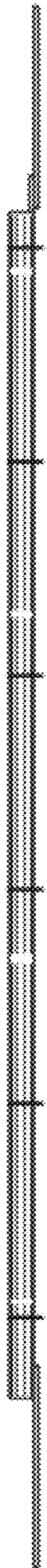

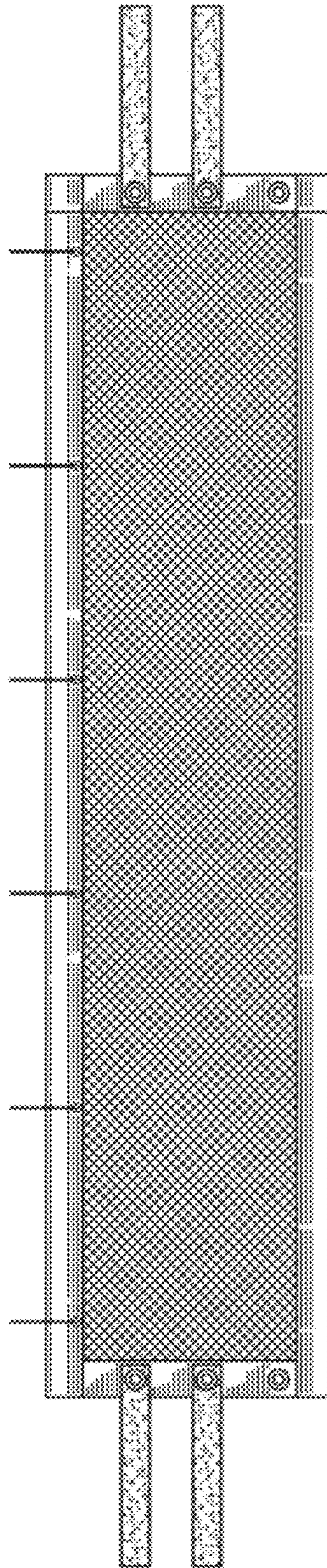

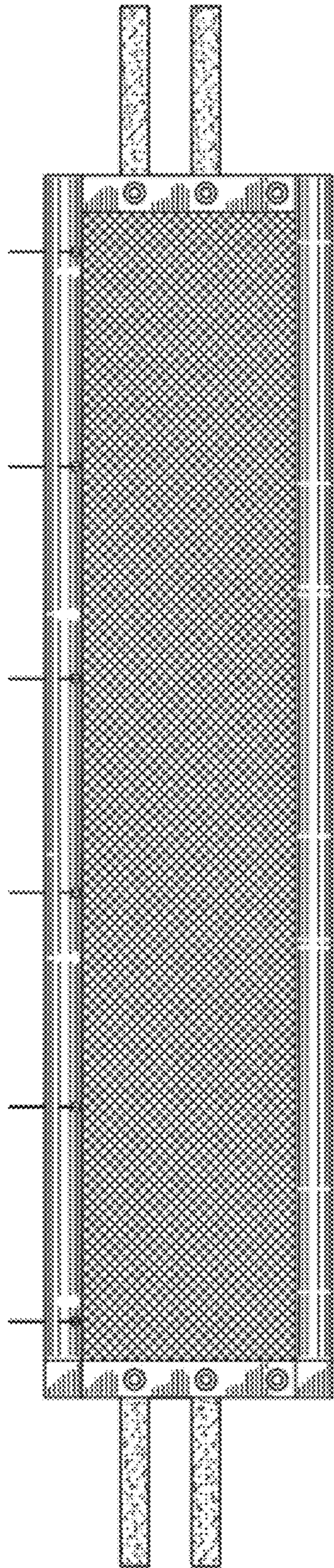

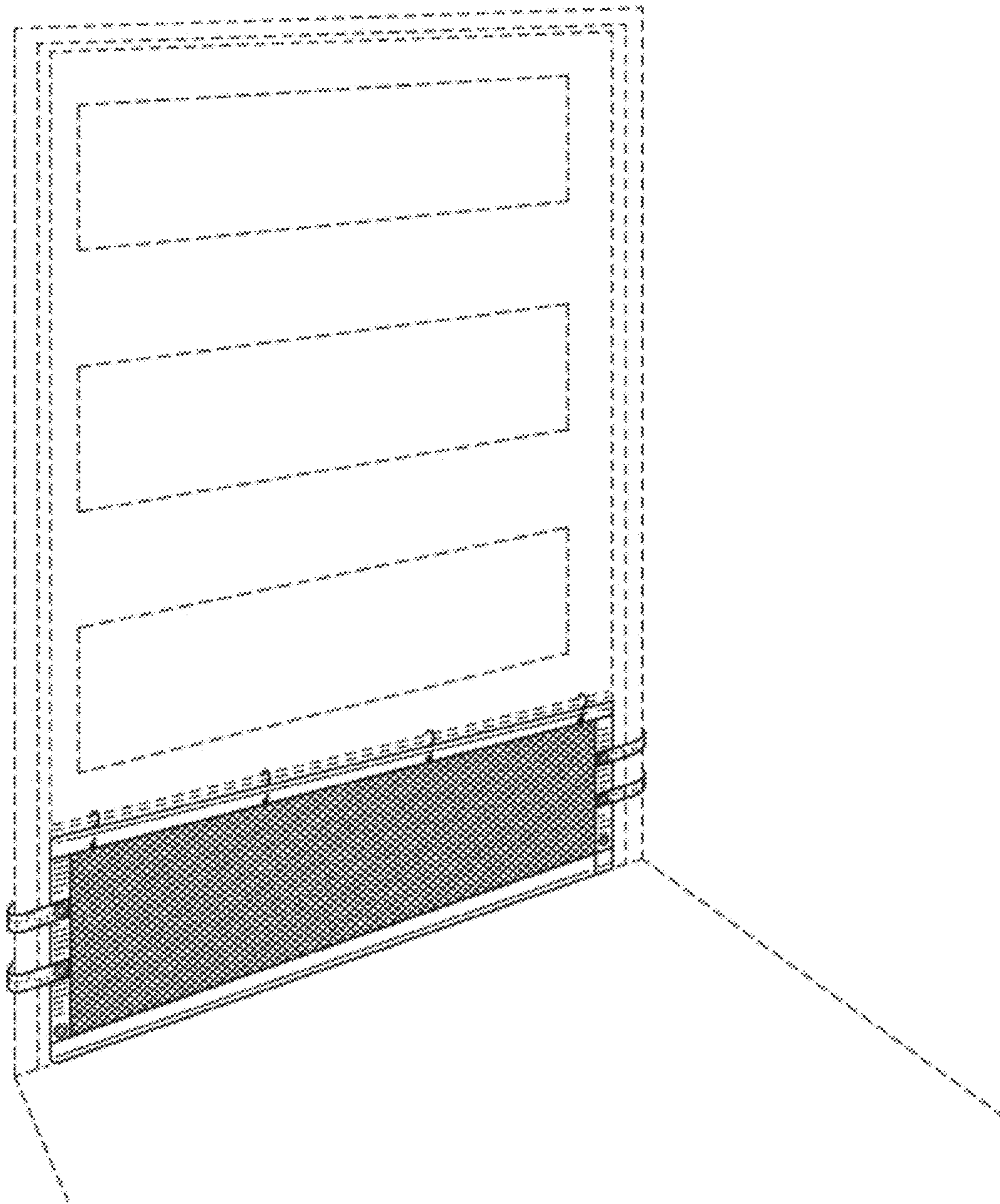

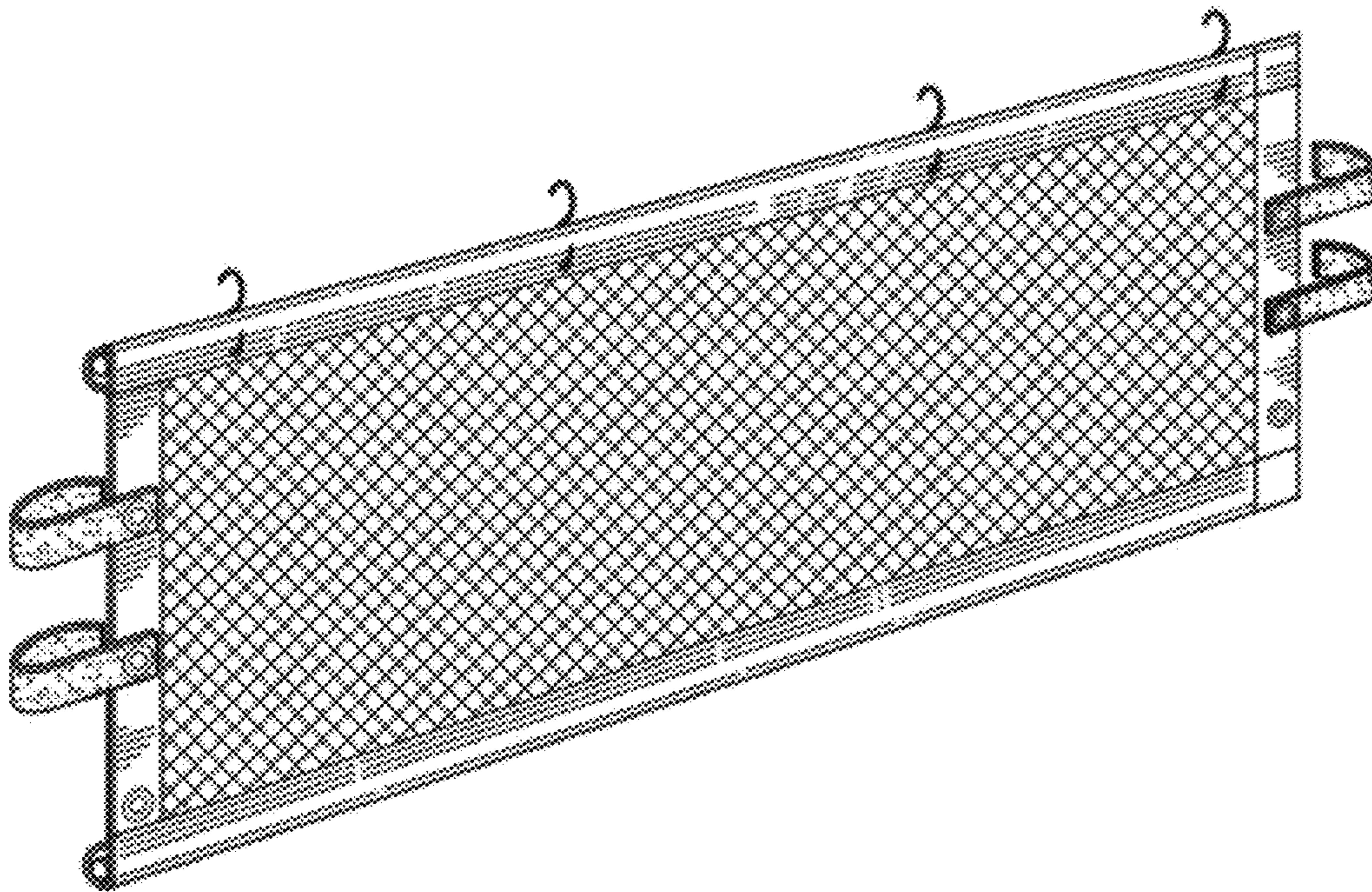

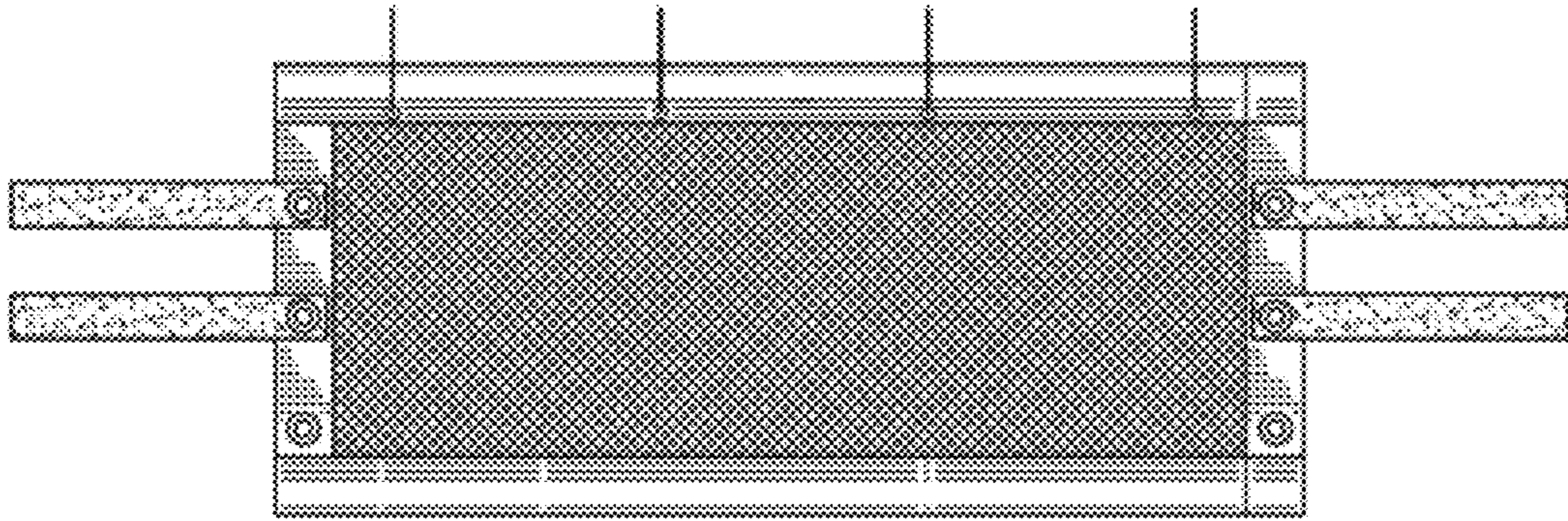

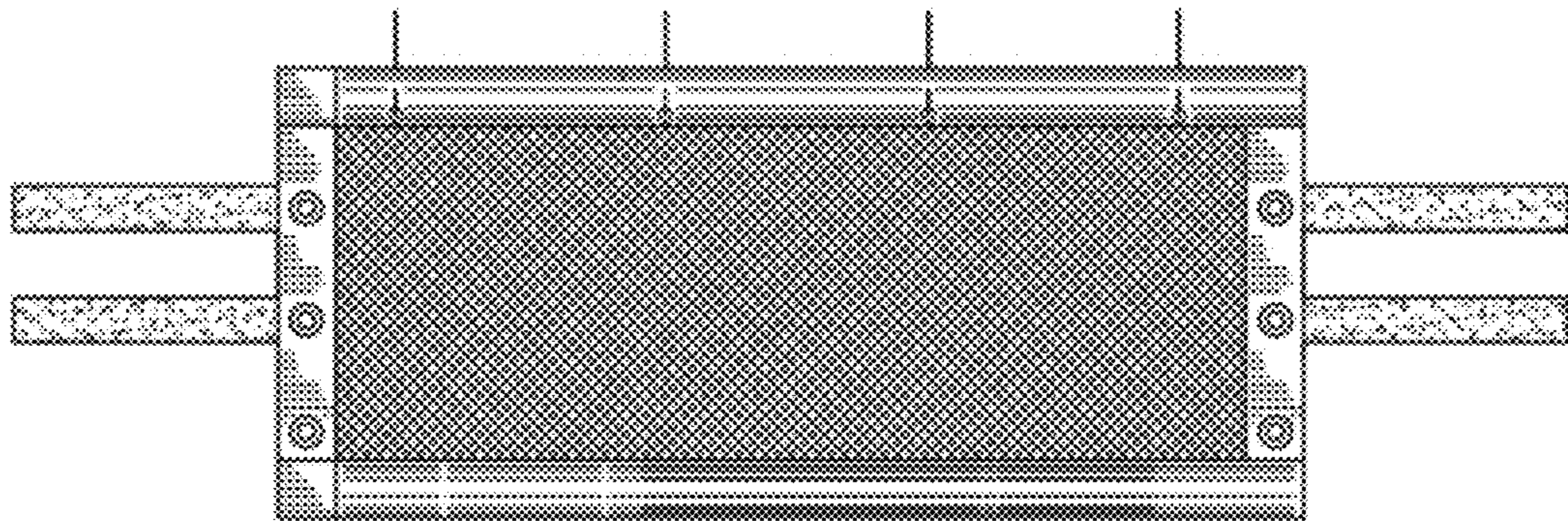

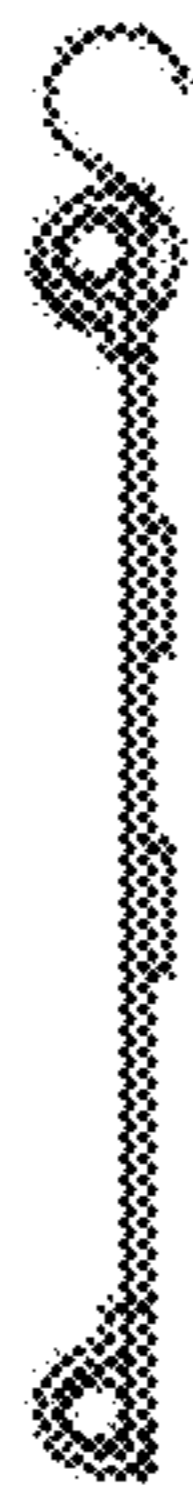

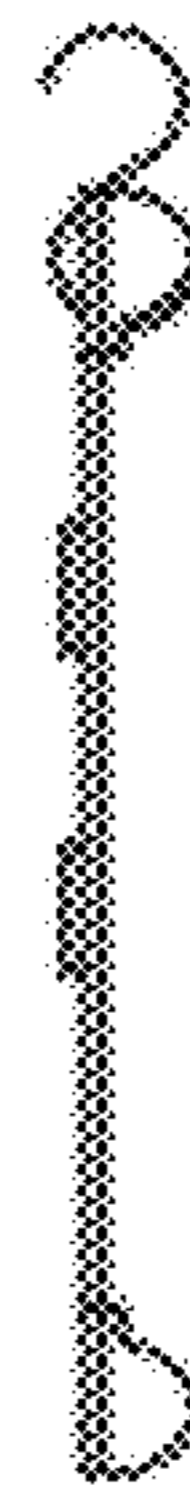
