FIG. 9 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment thereof;

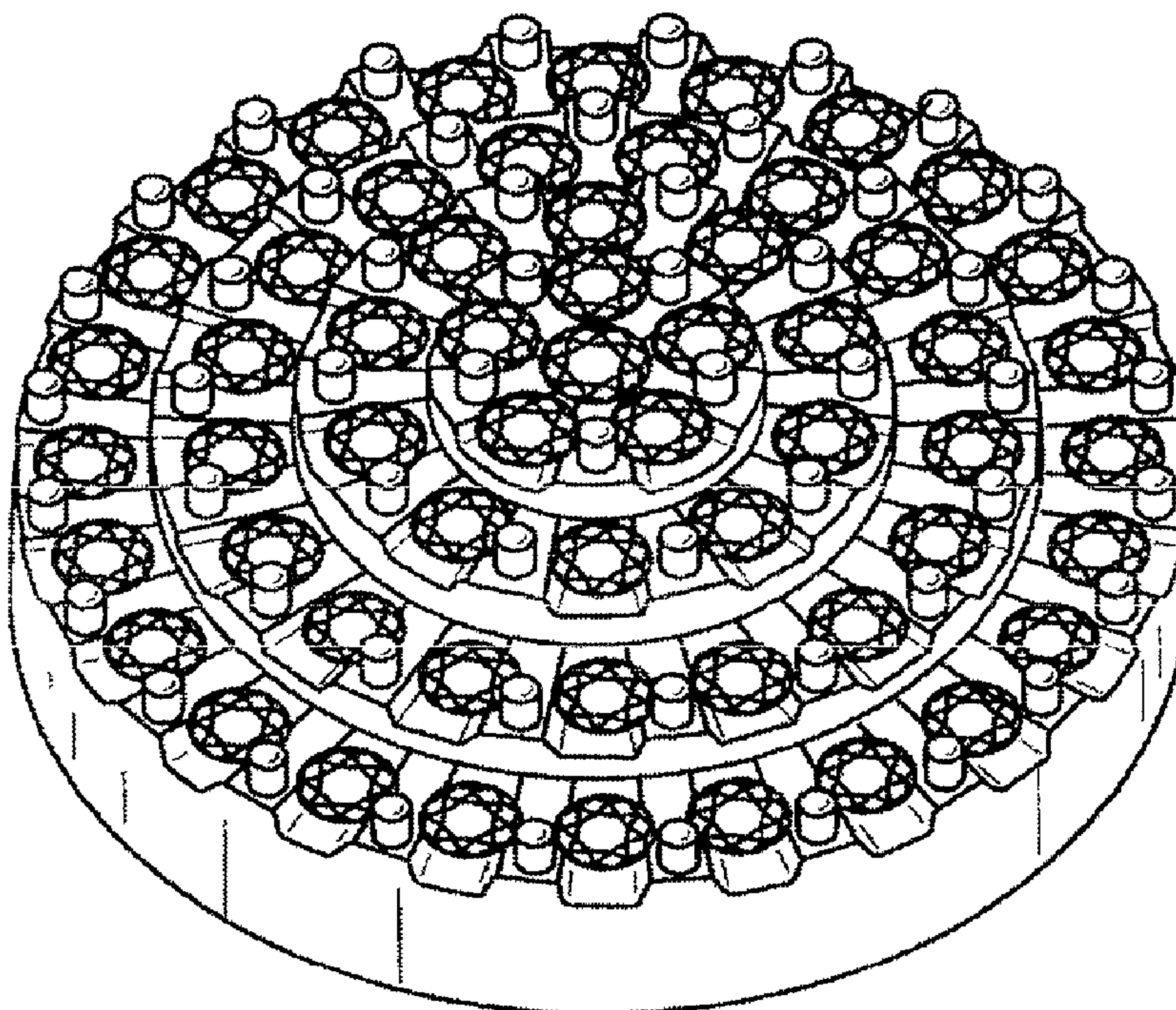
FIG. 10 is a side view of the fourth embodiment thereof;

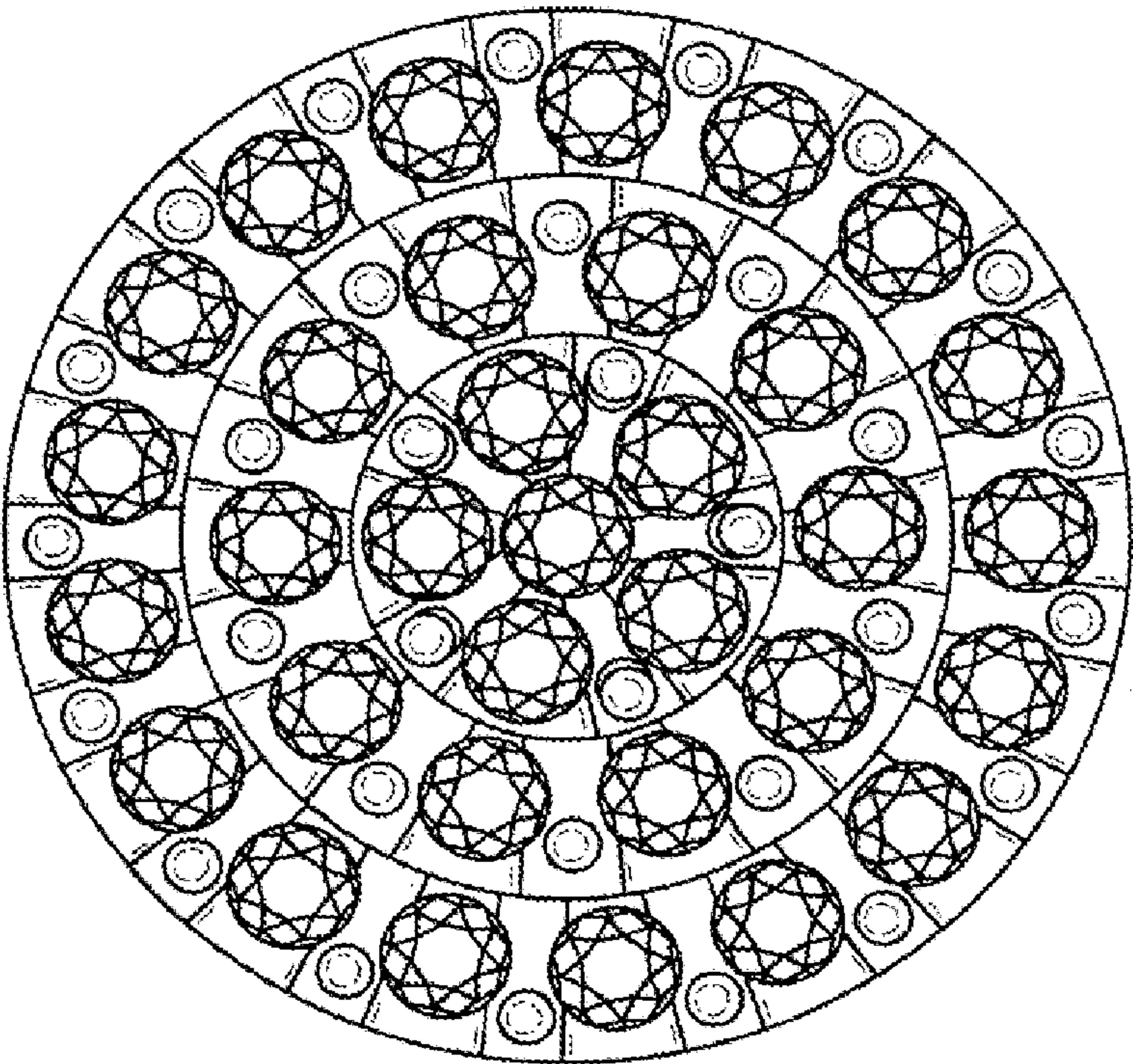

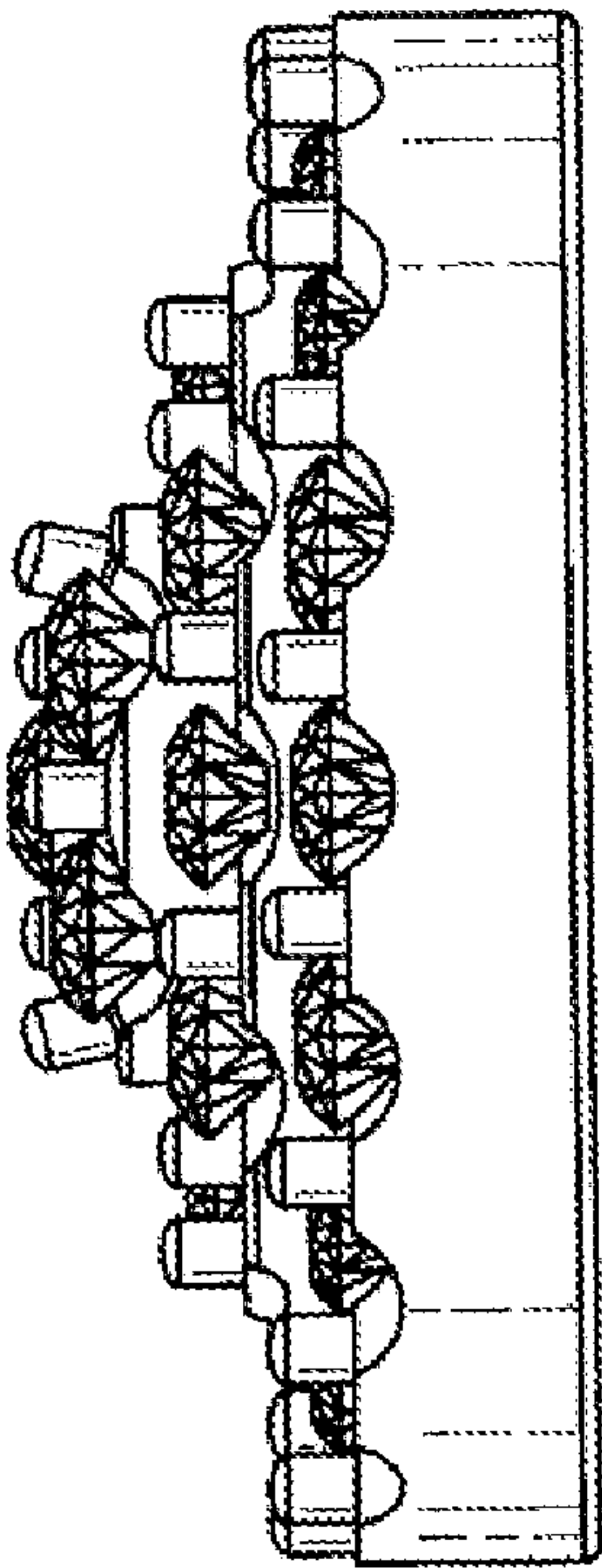

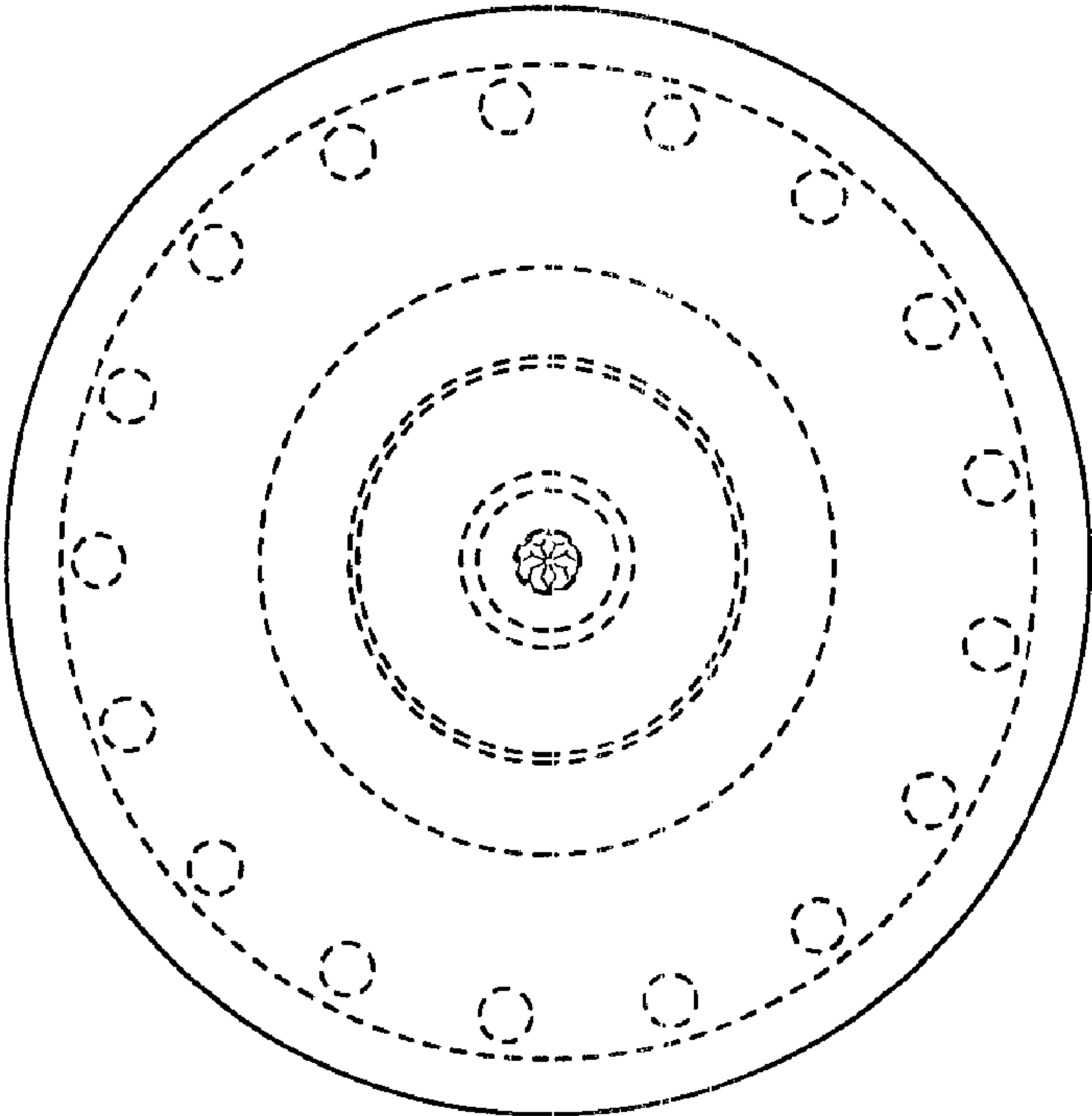

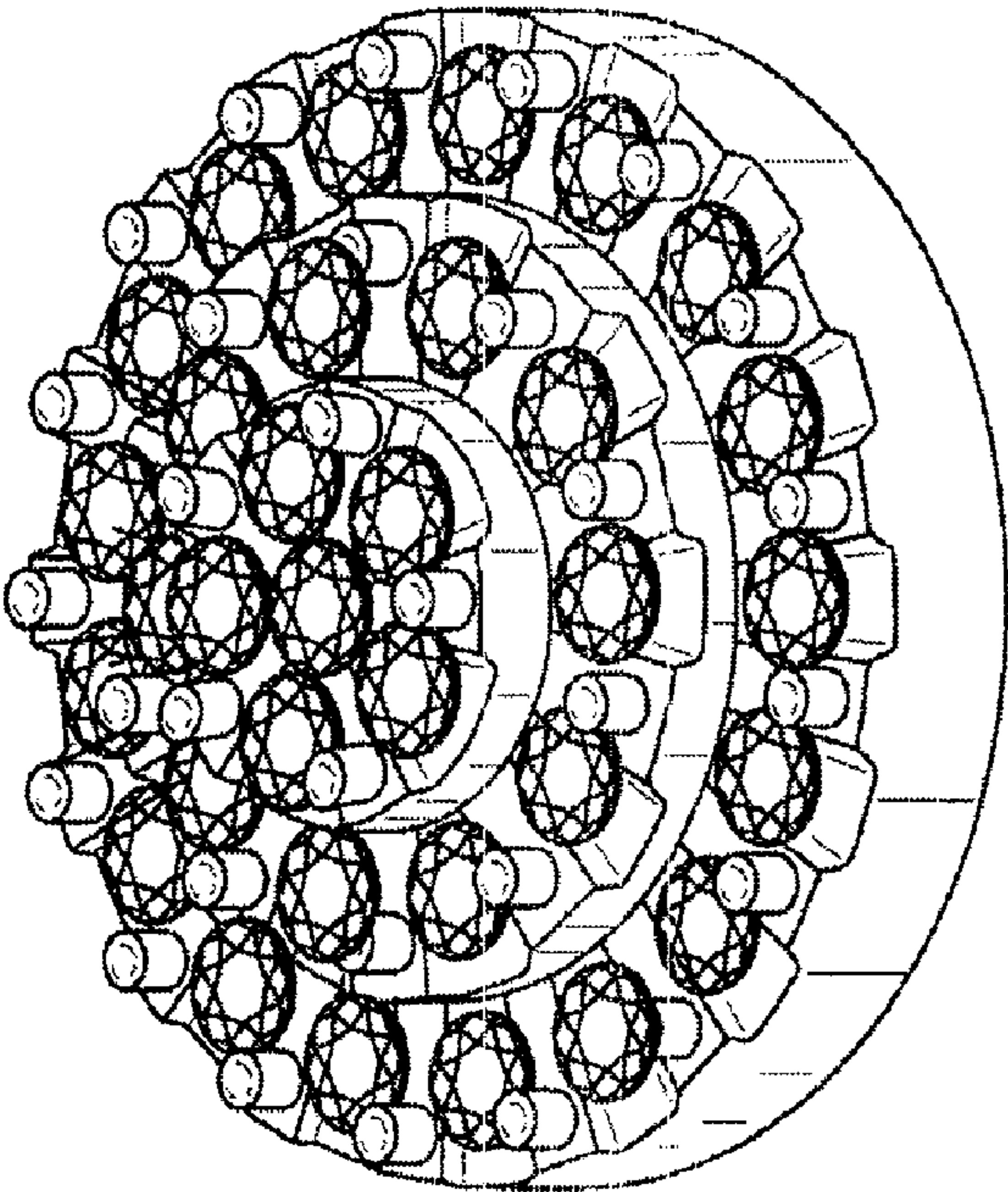

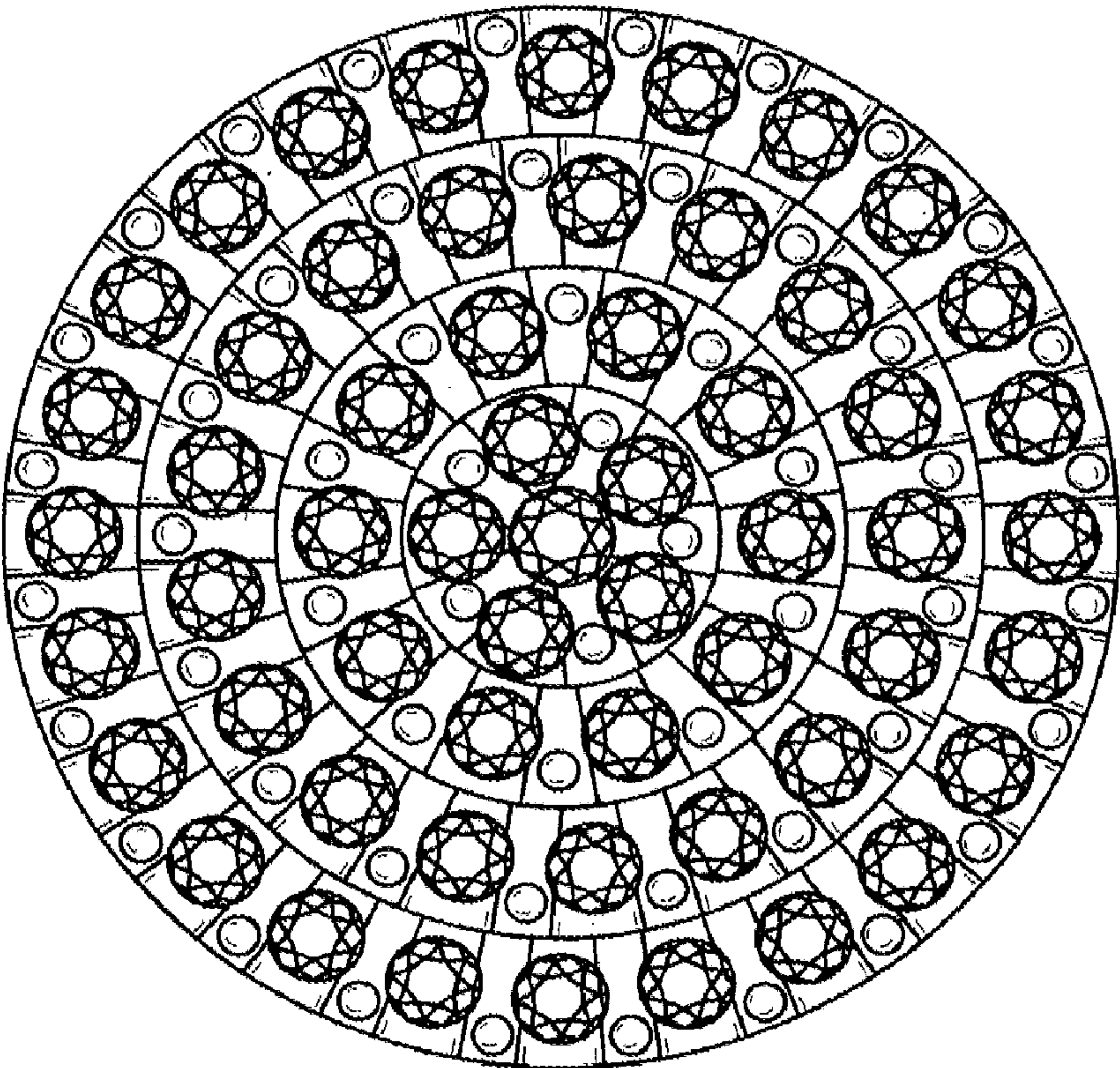

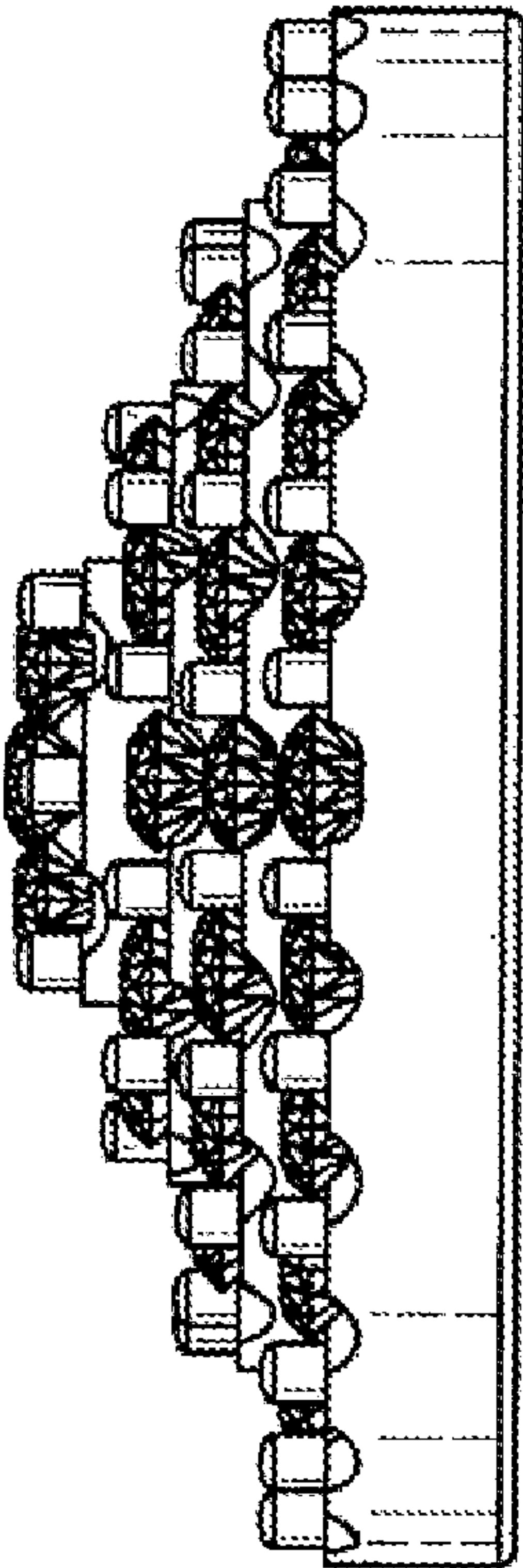

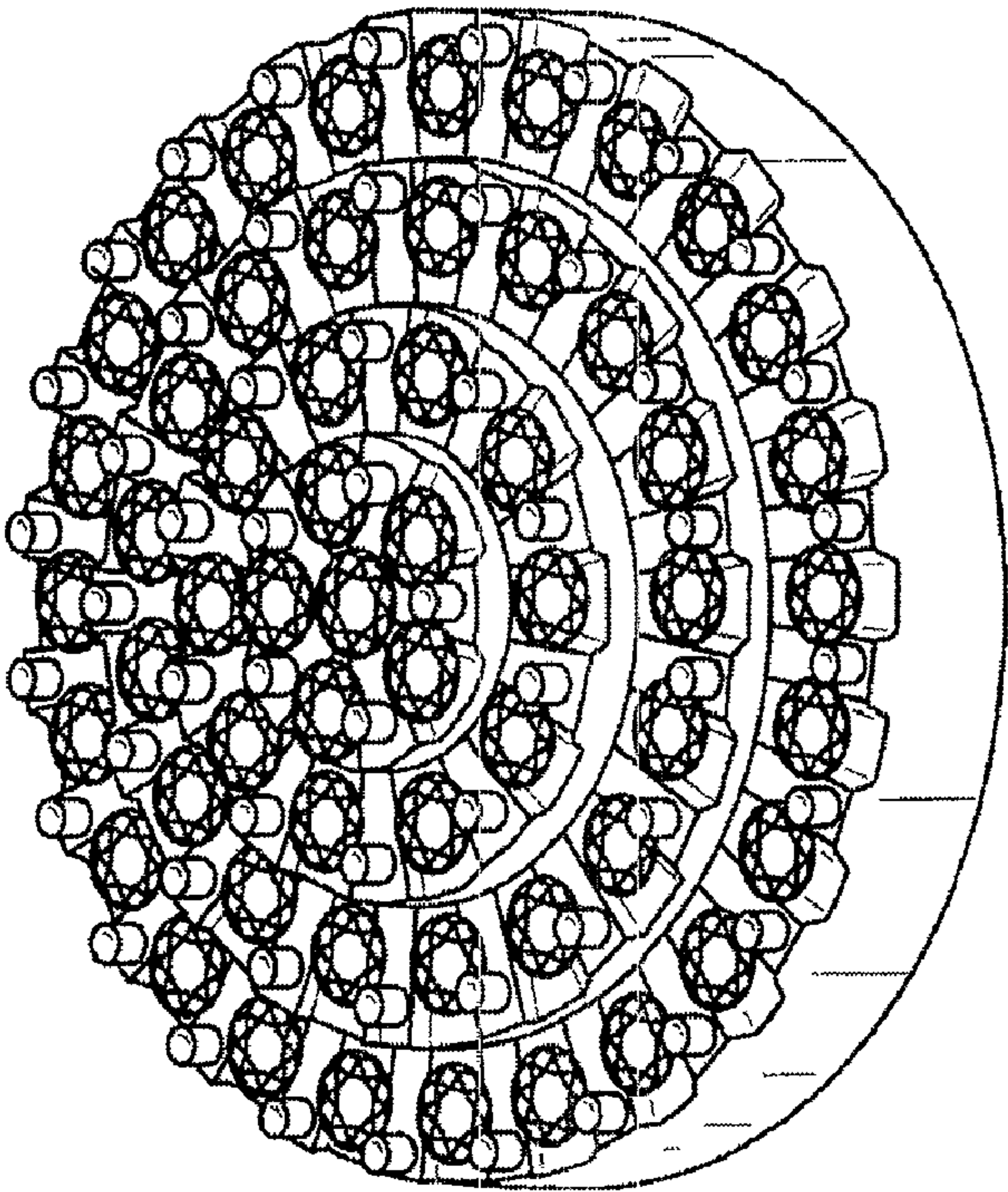

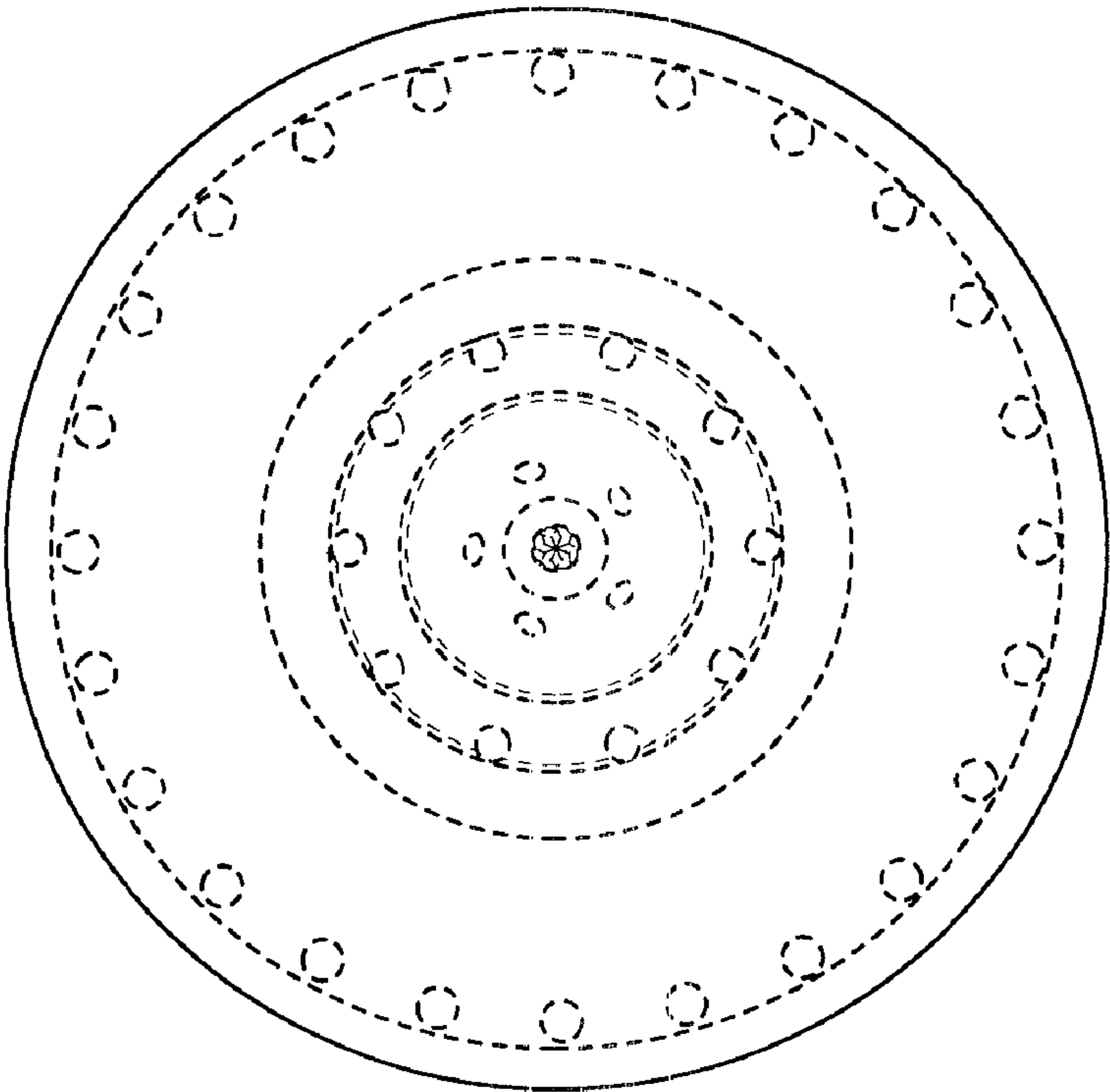

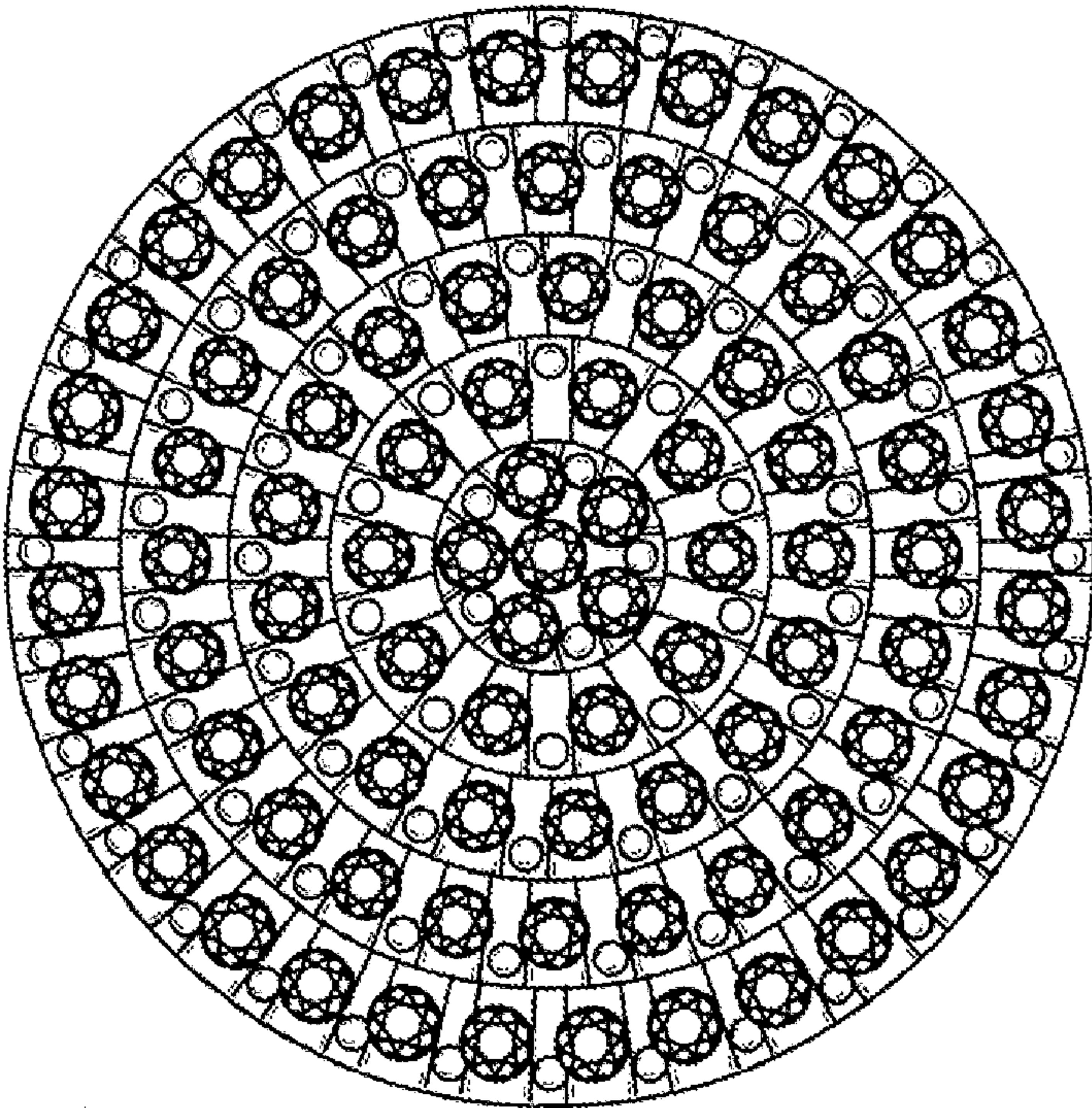

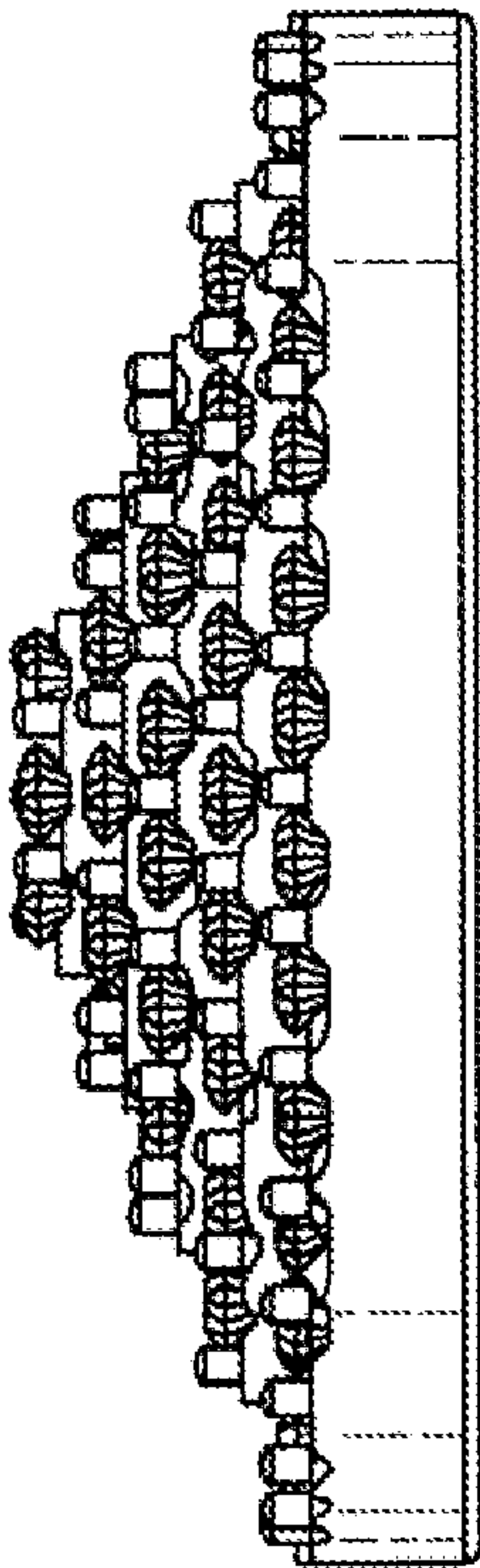

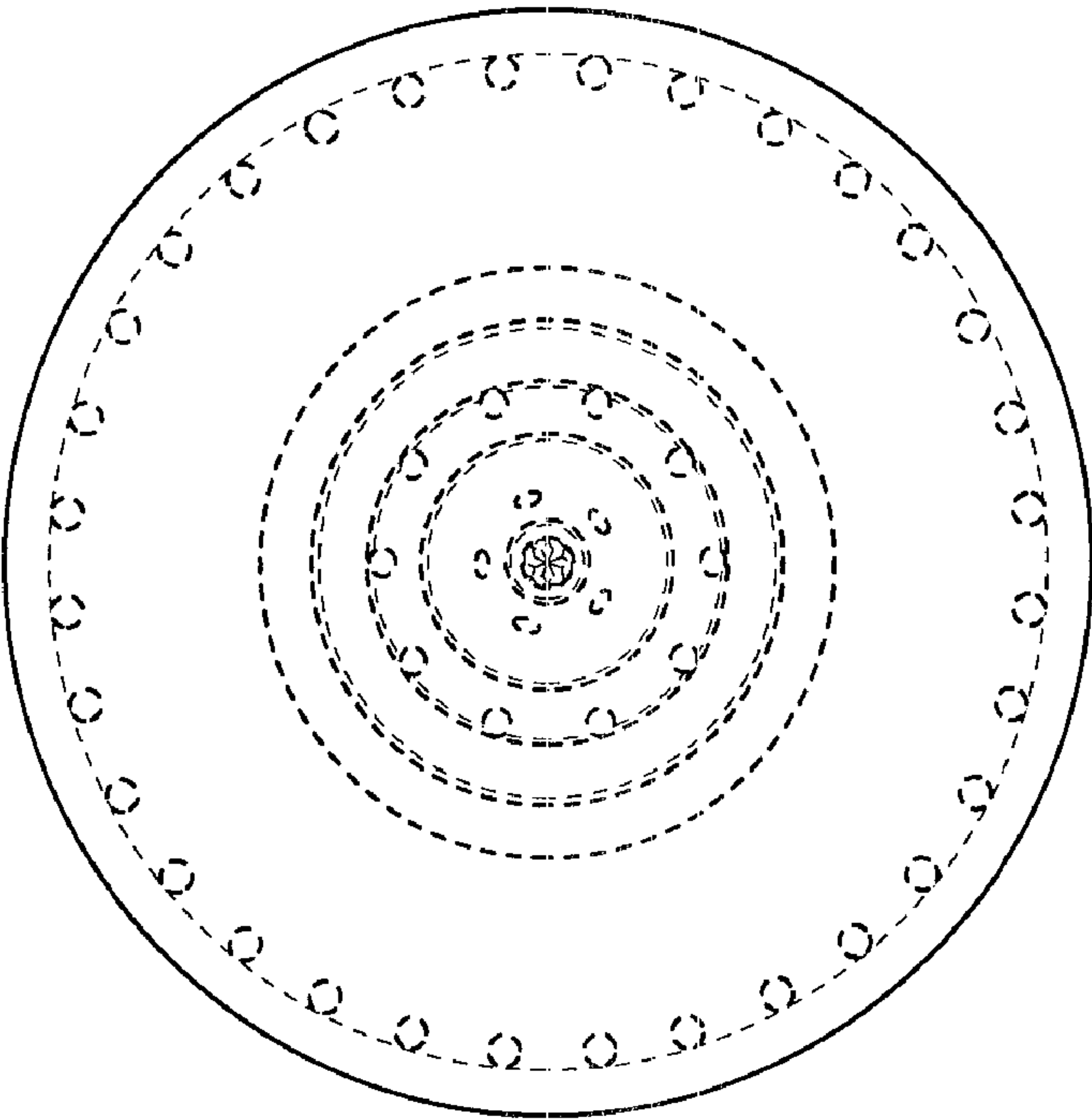

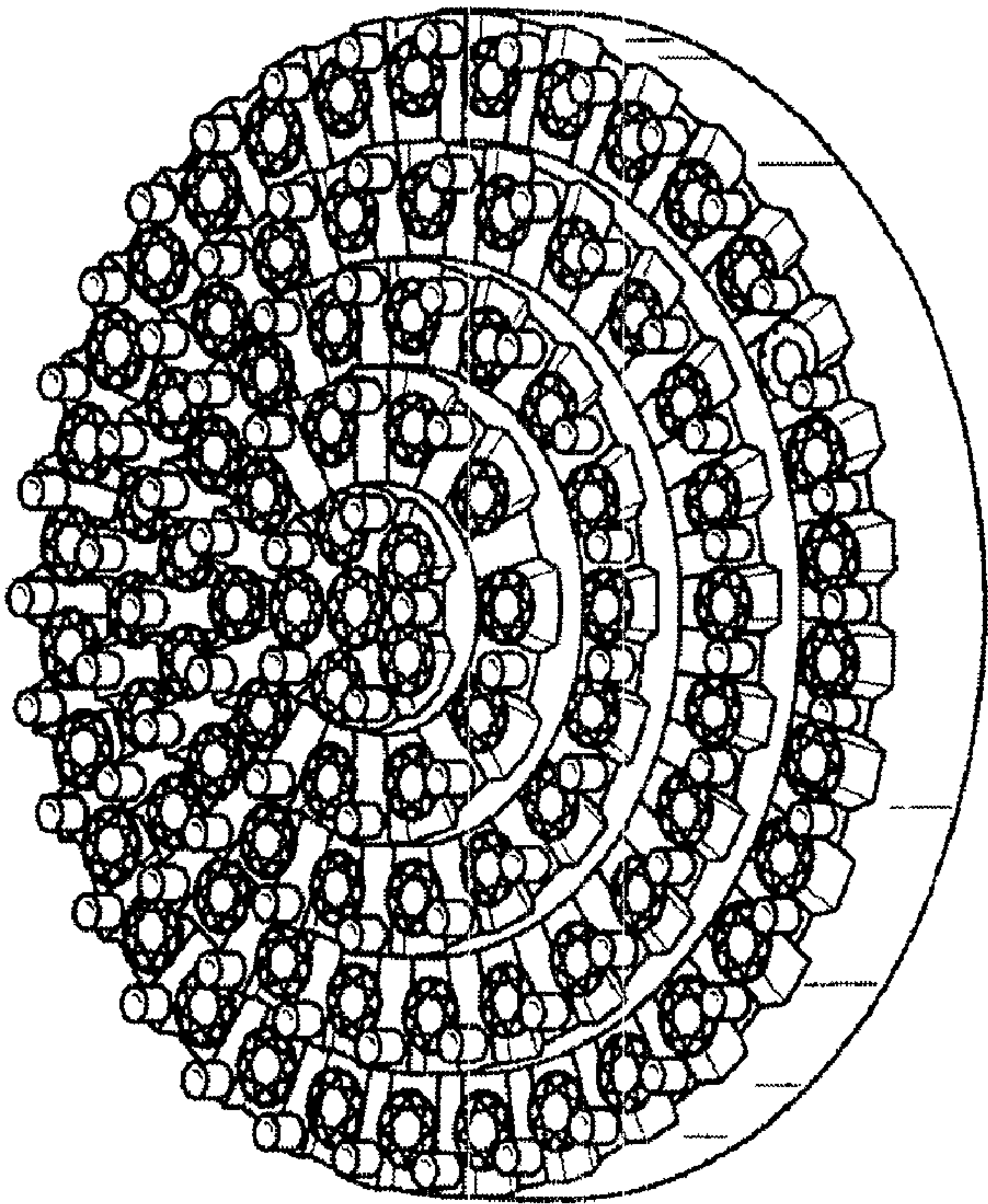
