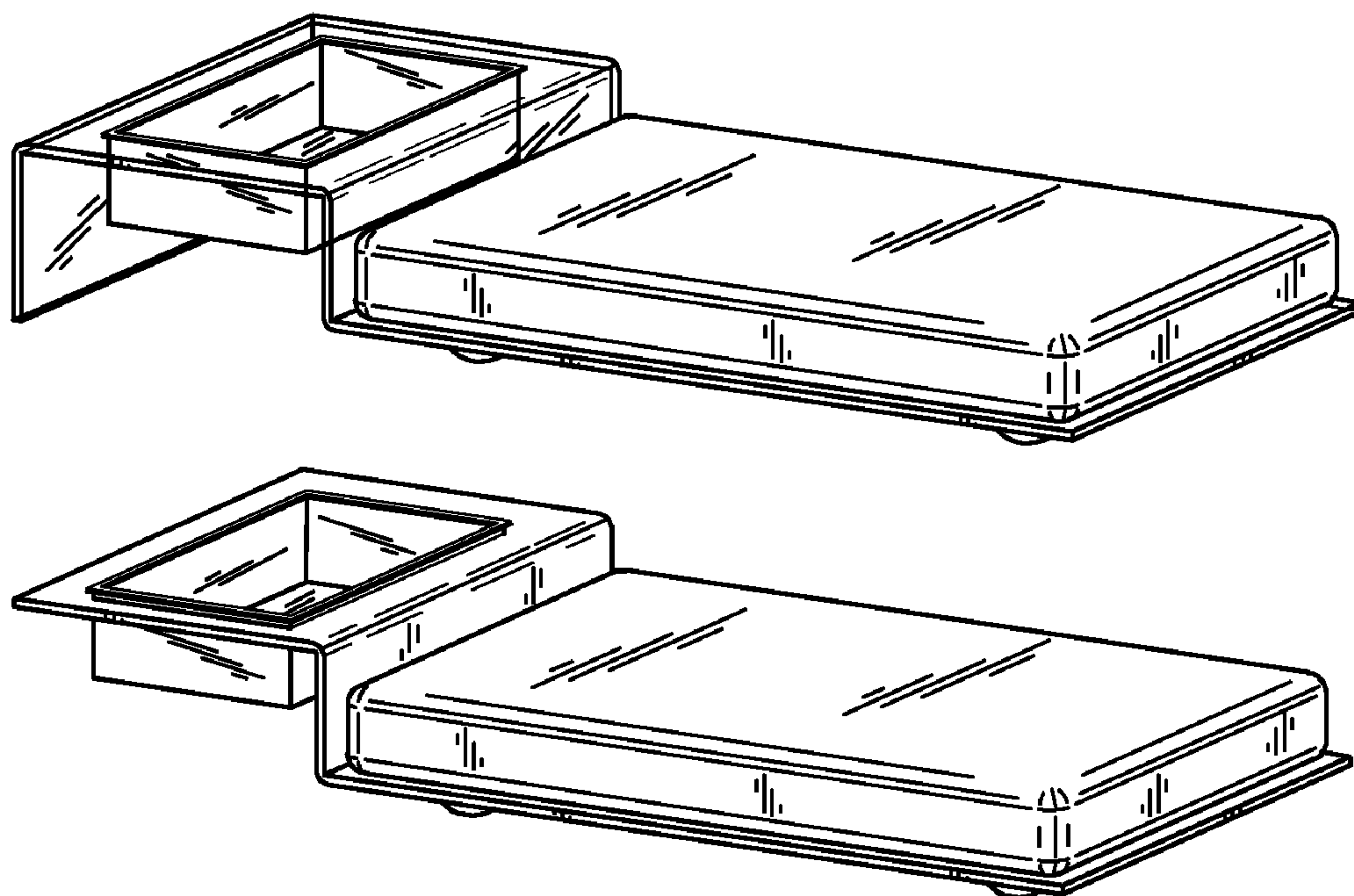
I claim the ornamental design for a combination pet bed and container support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a combination pet bed and bowl support, showing a first embodiment of my new design;

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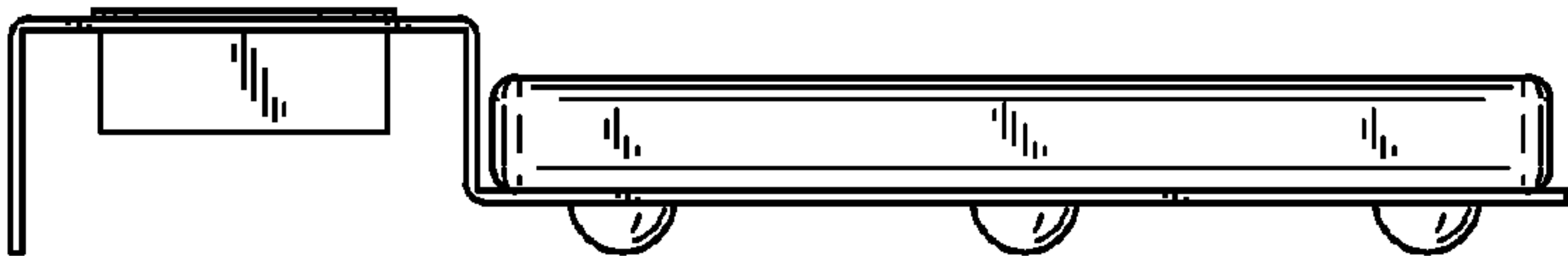
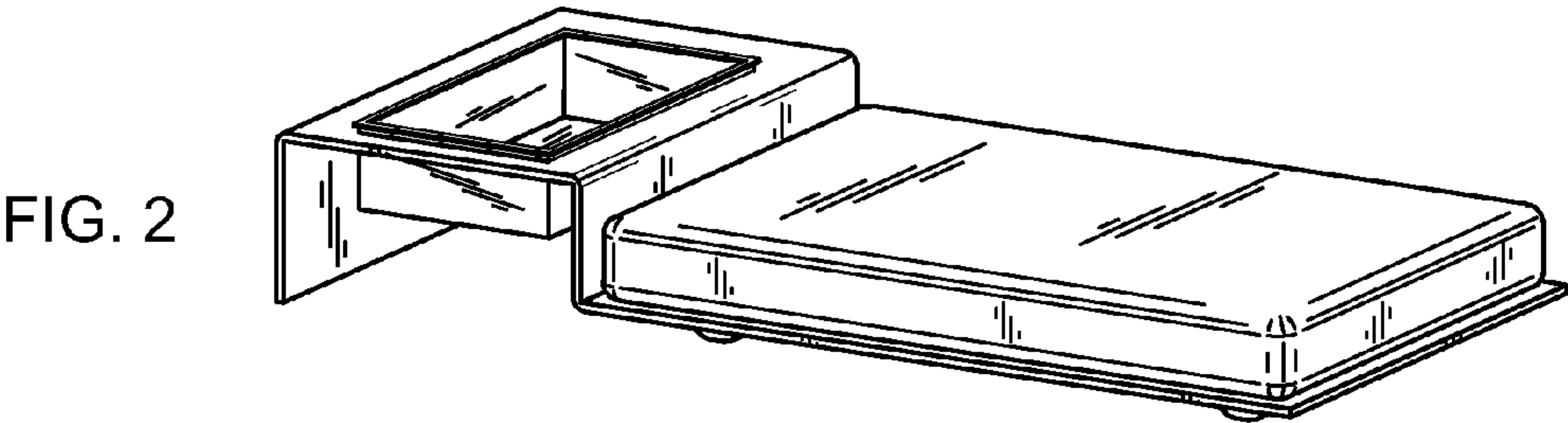
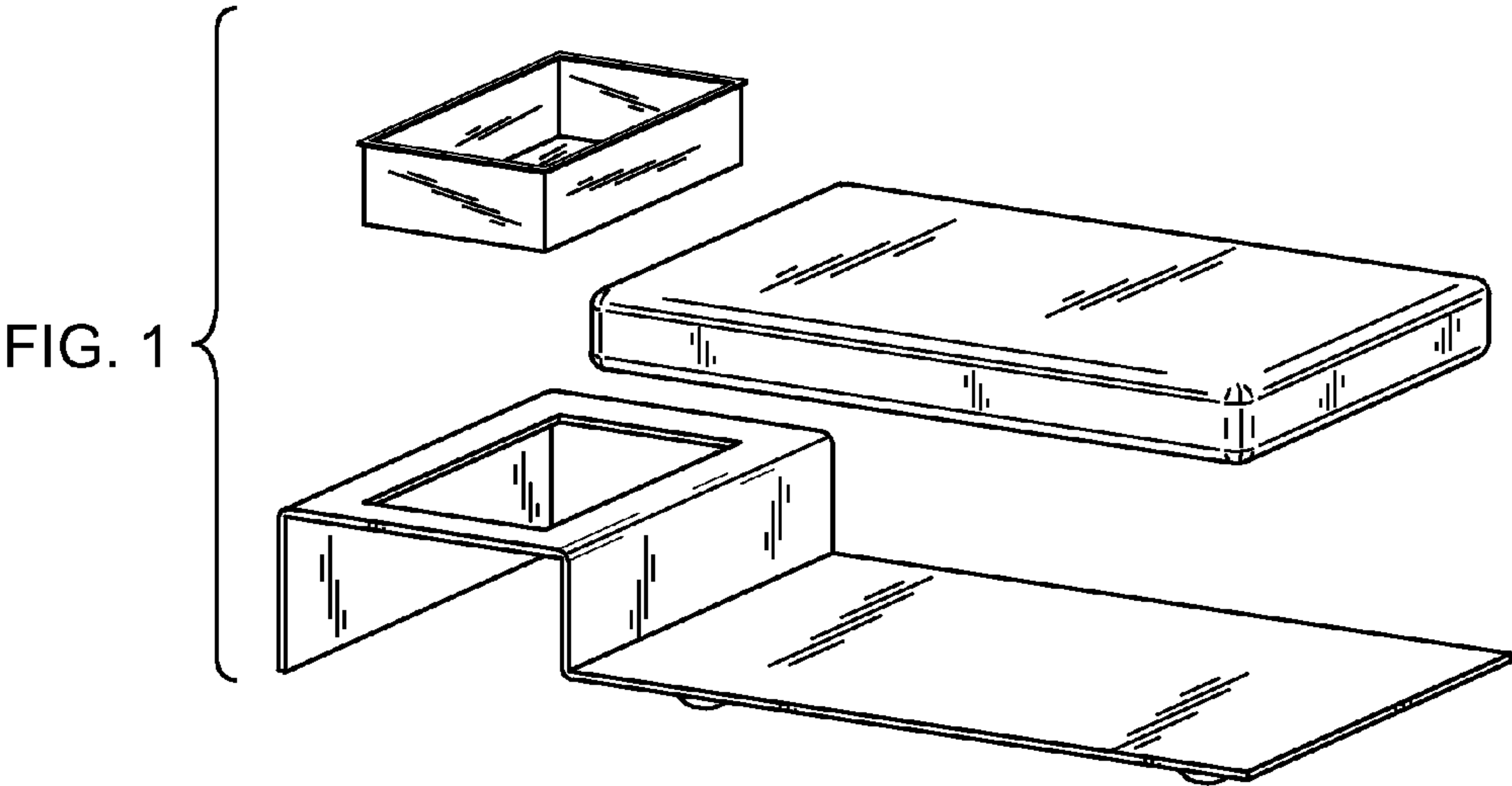

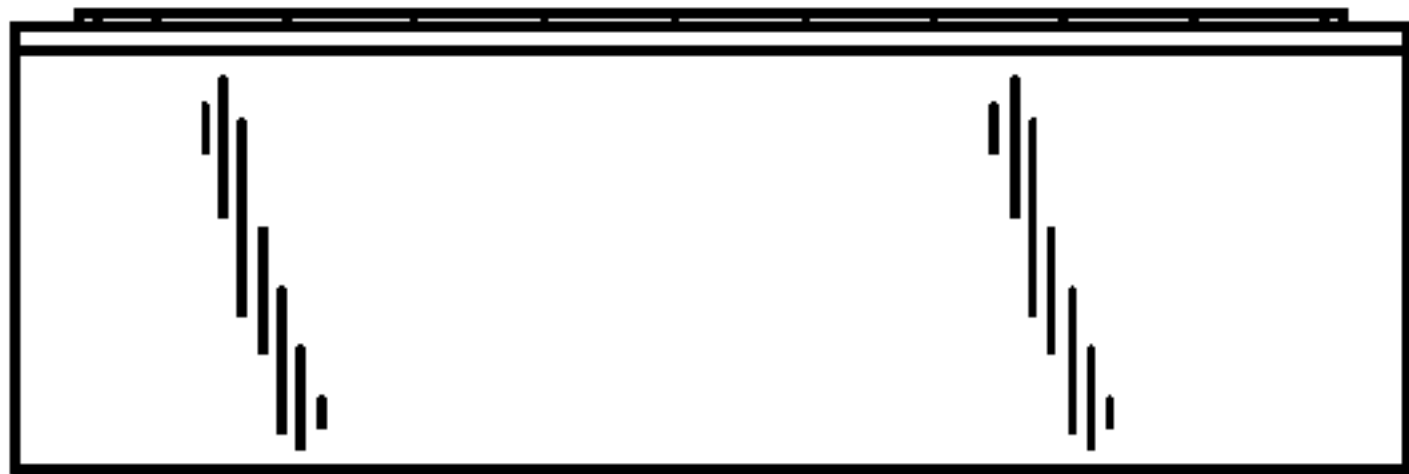

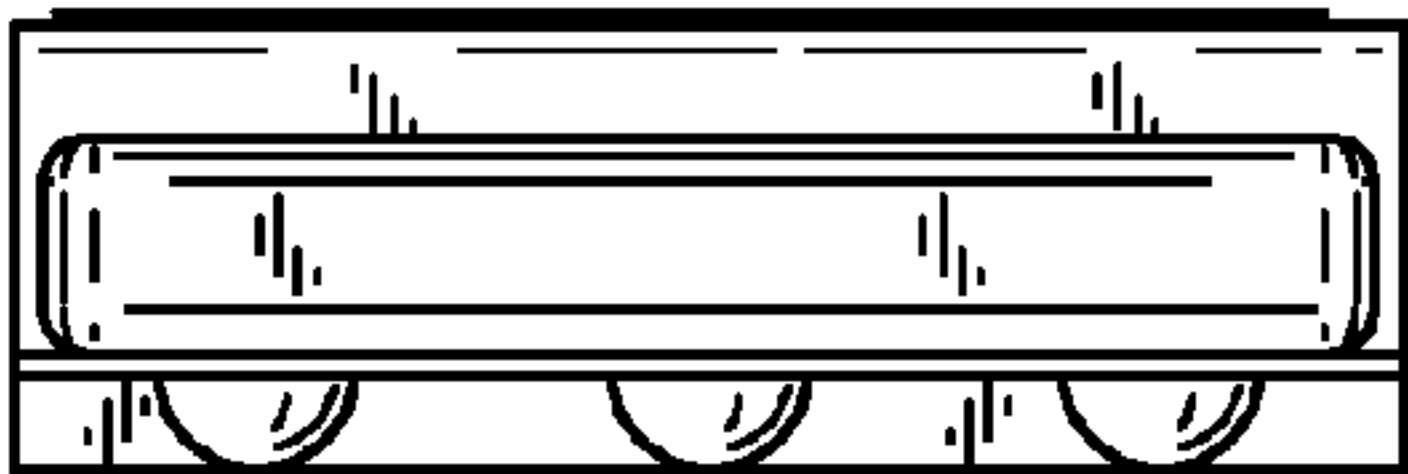

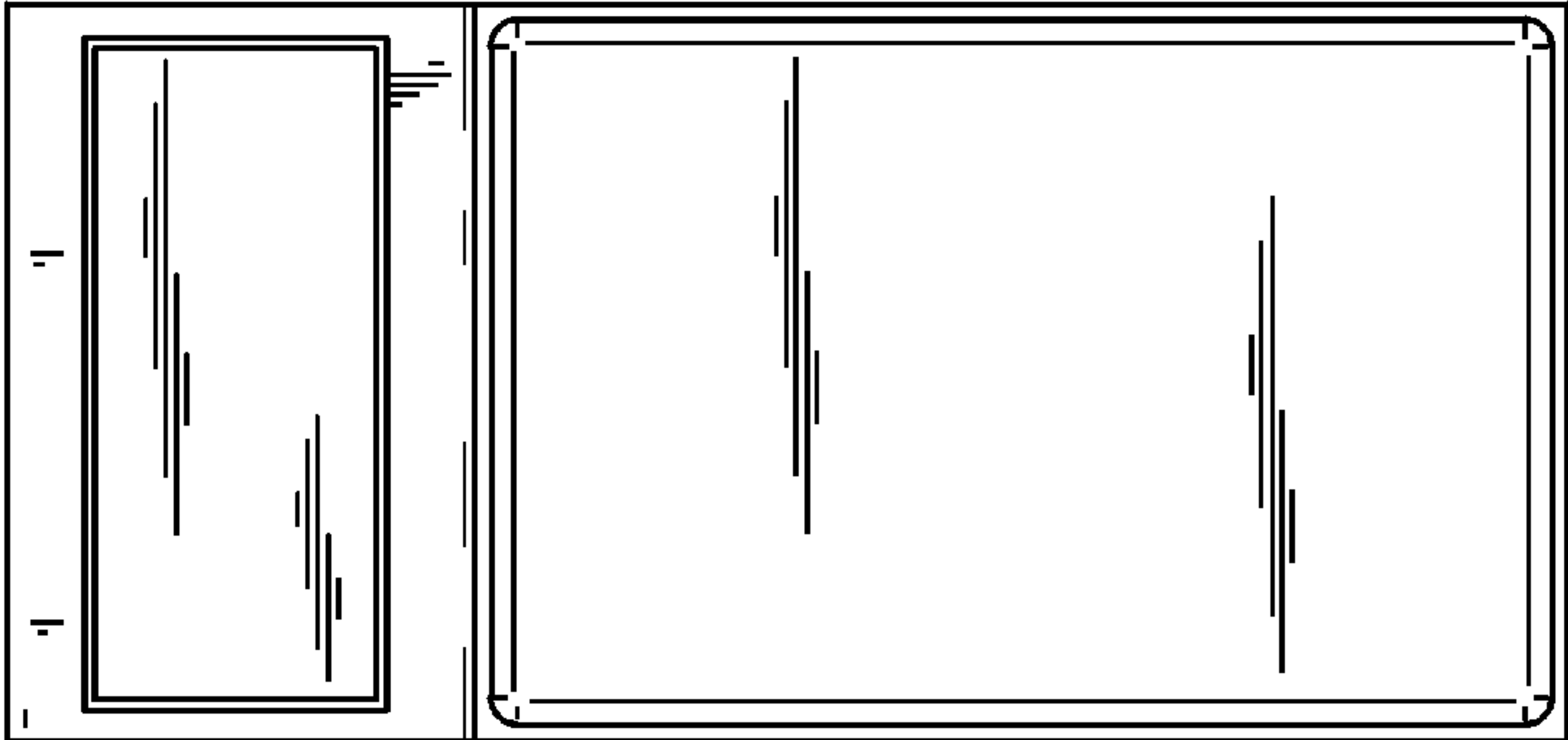

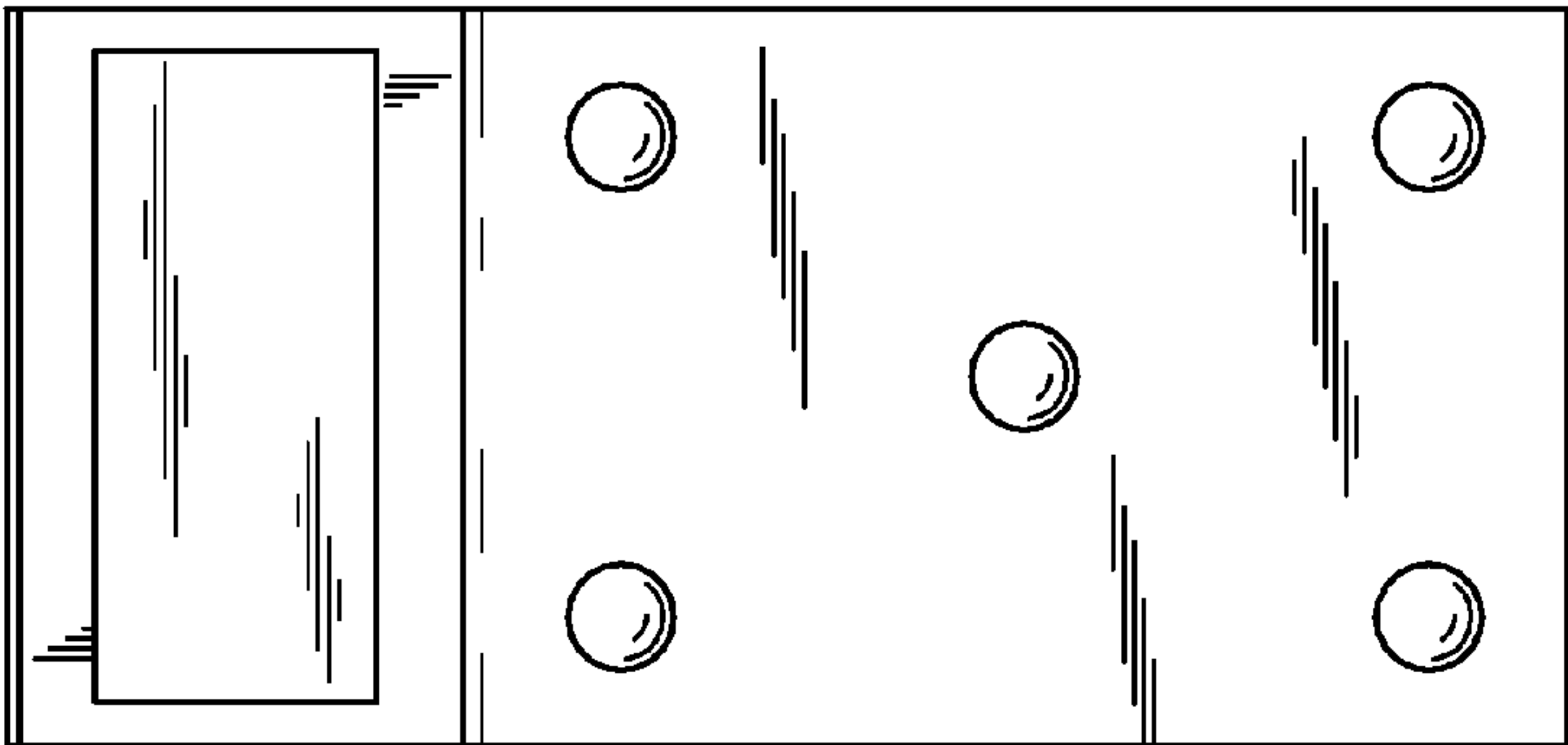
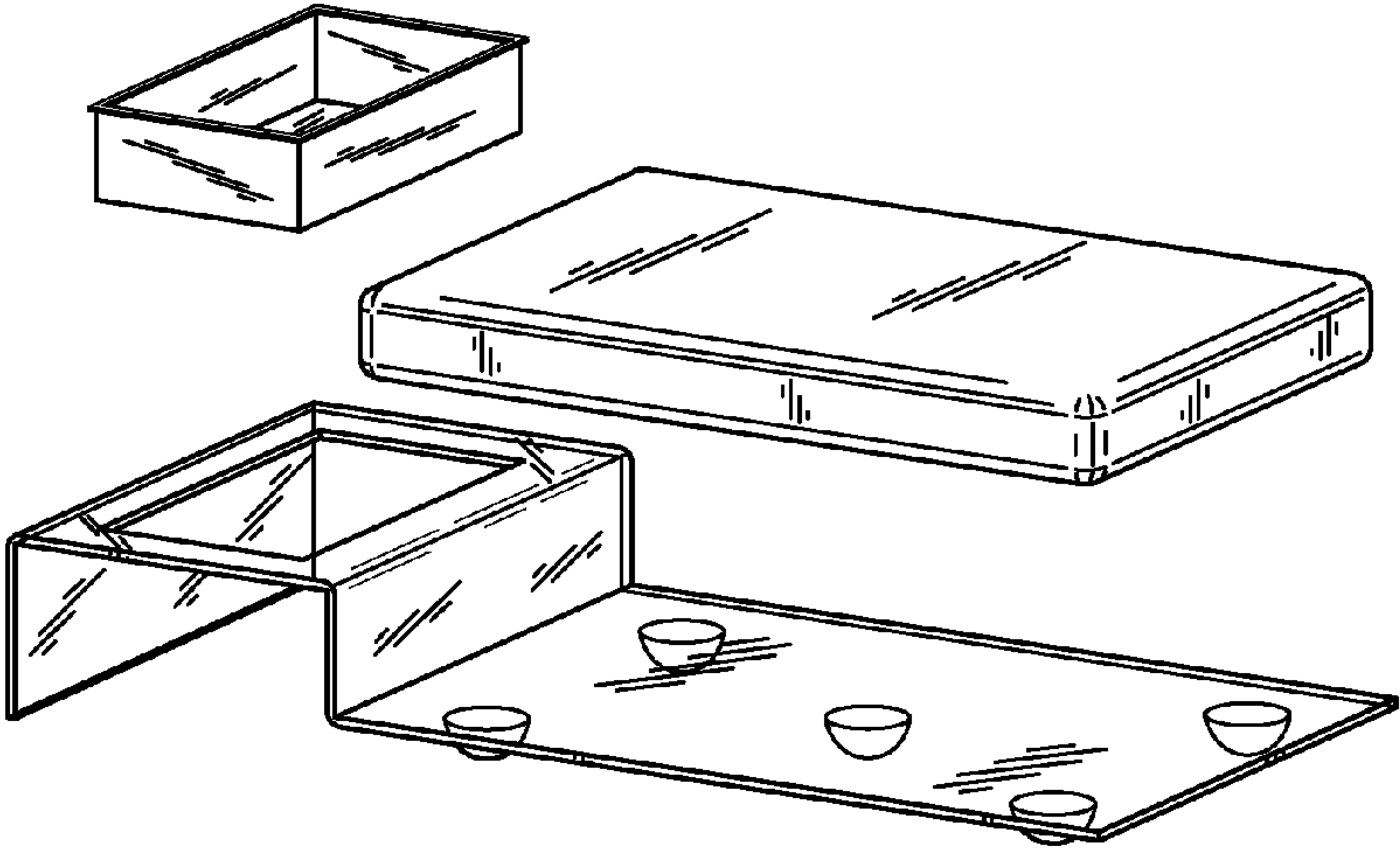
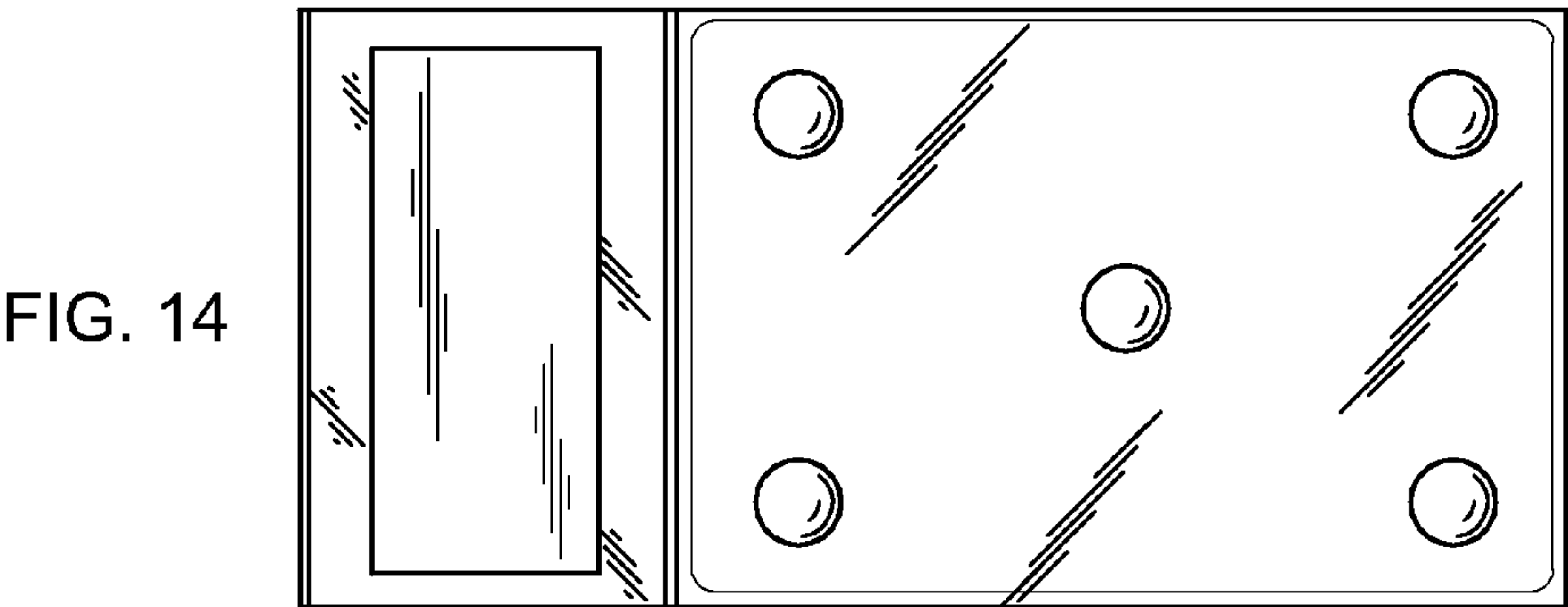
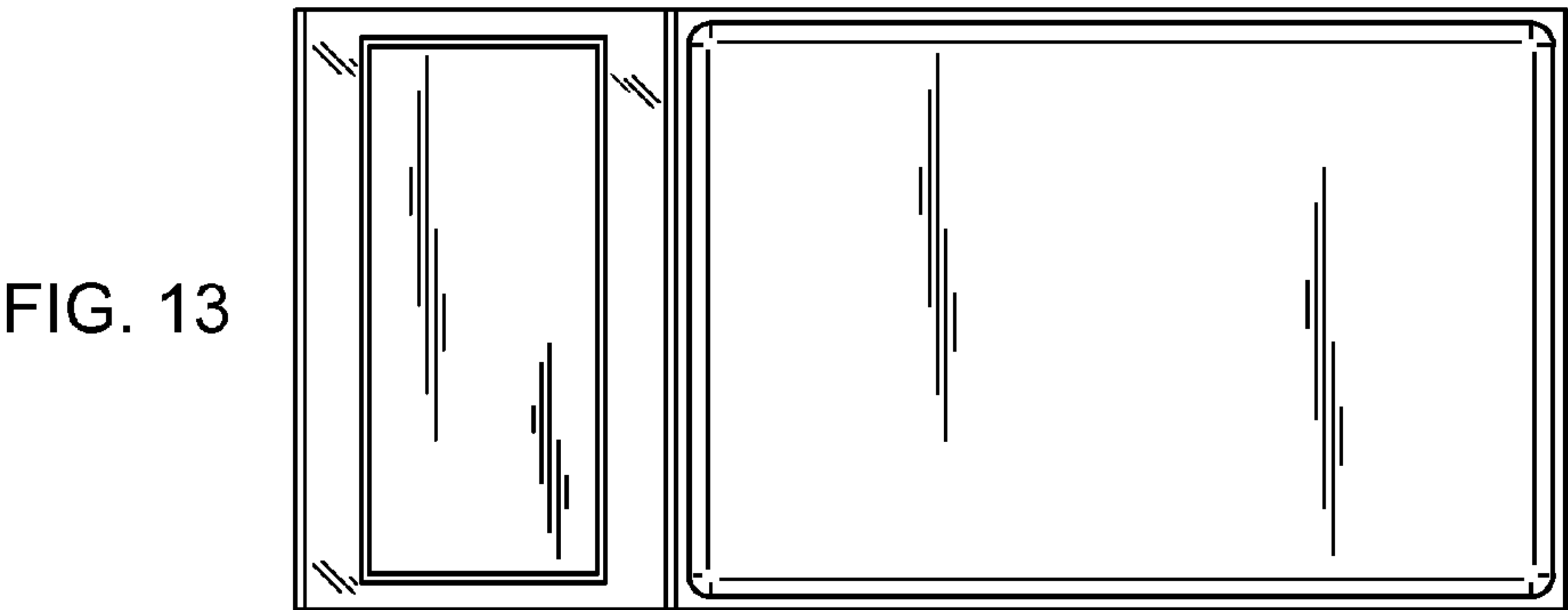
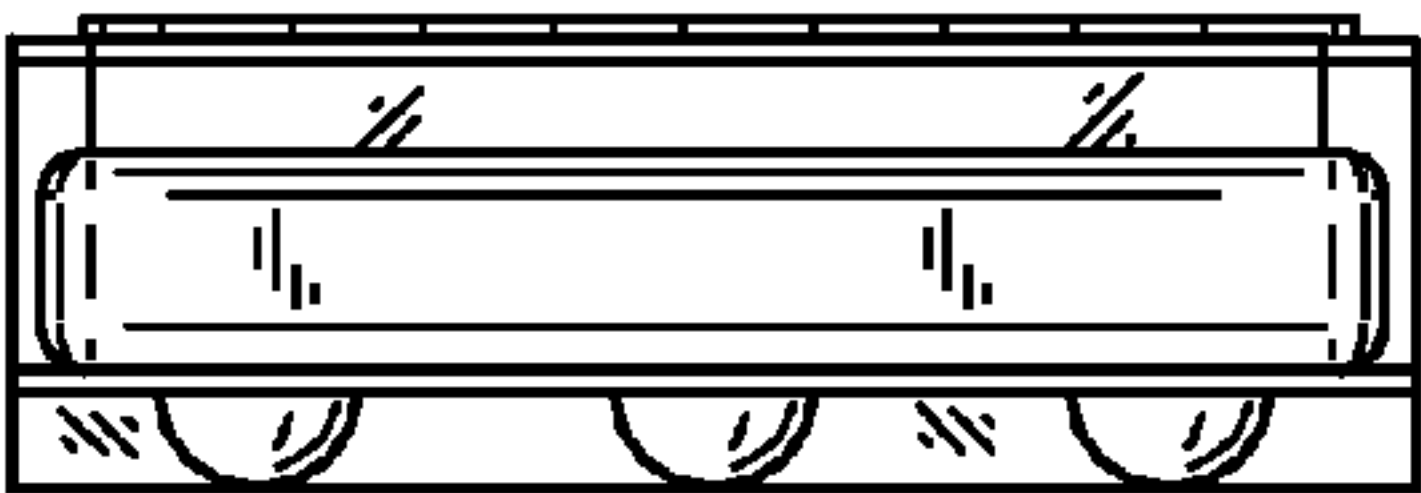
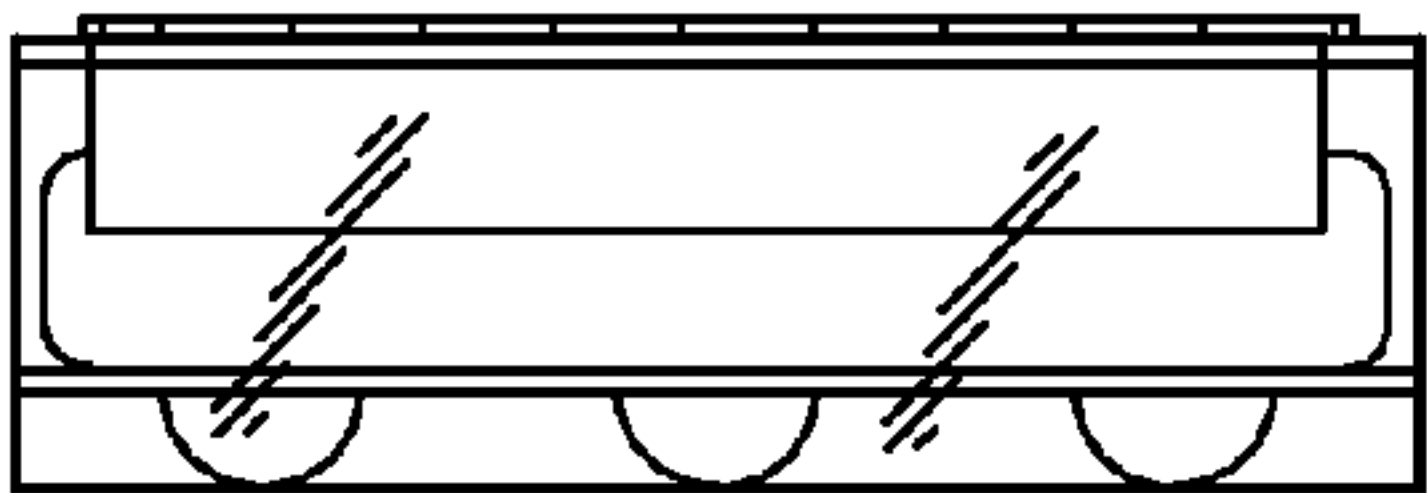
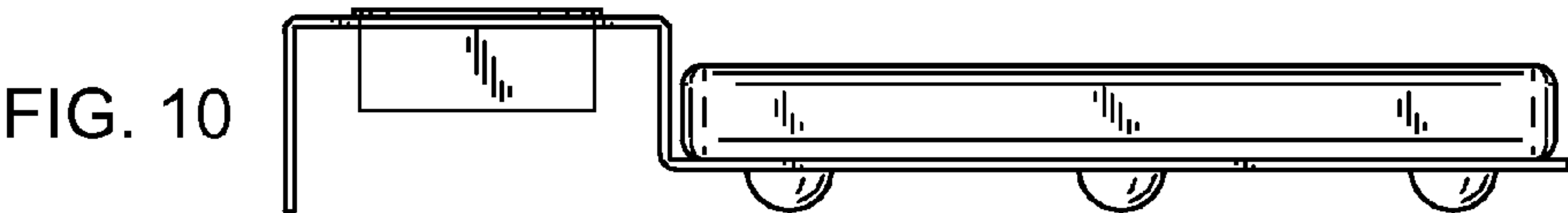
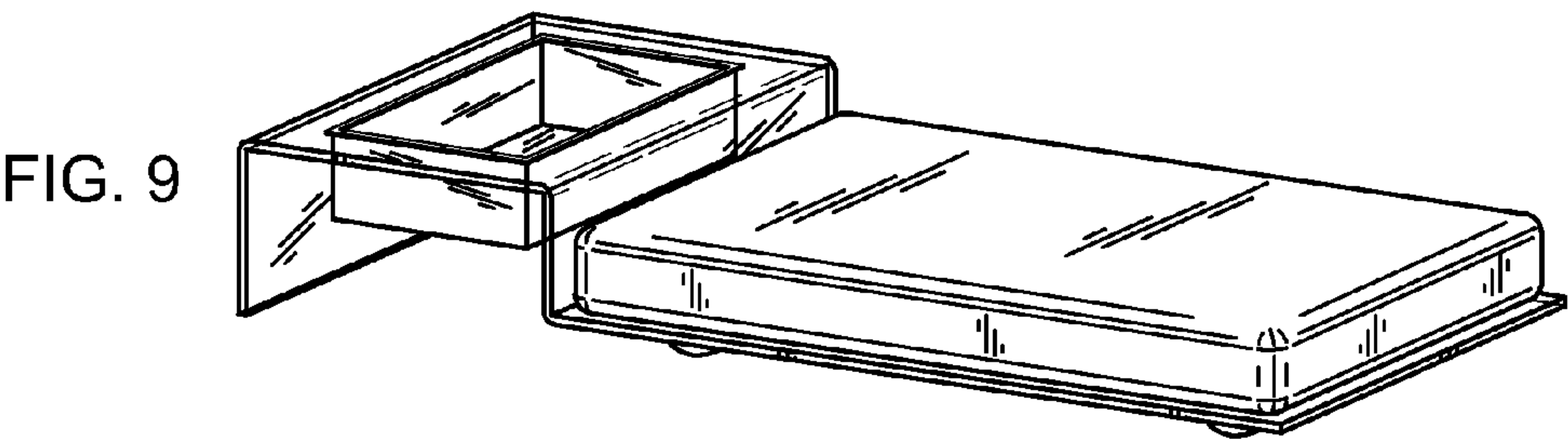

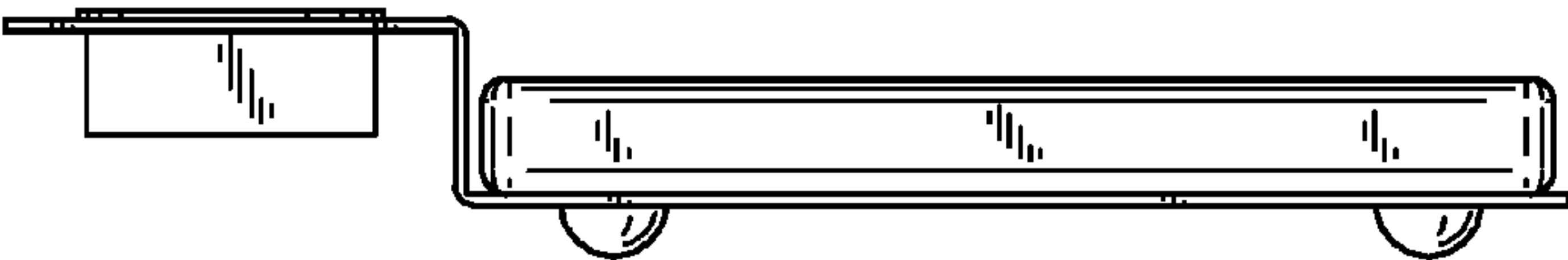
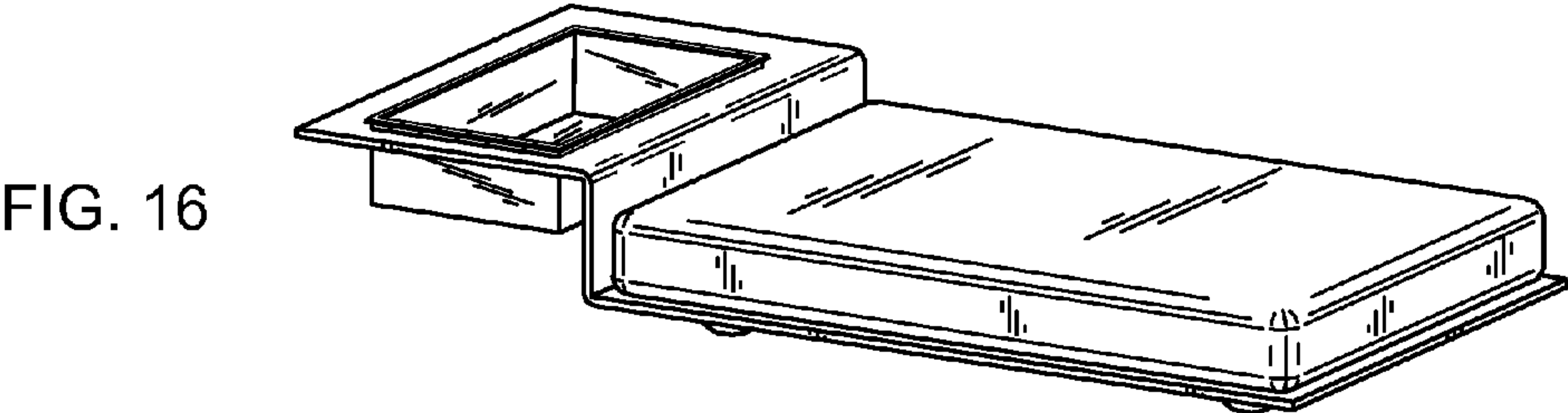
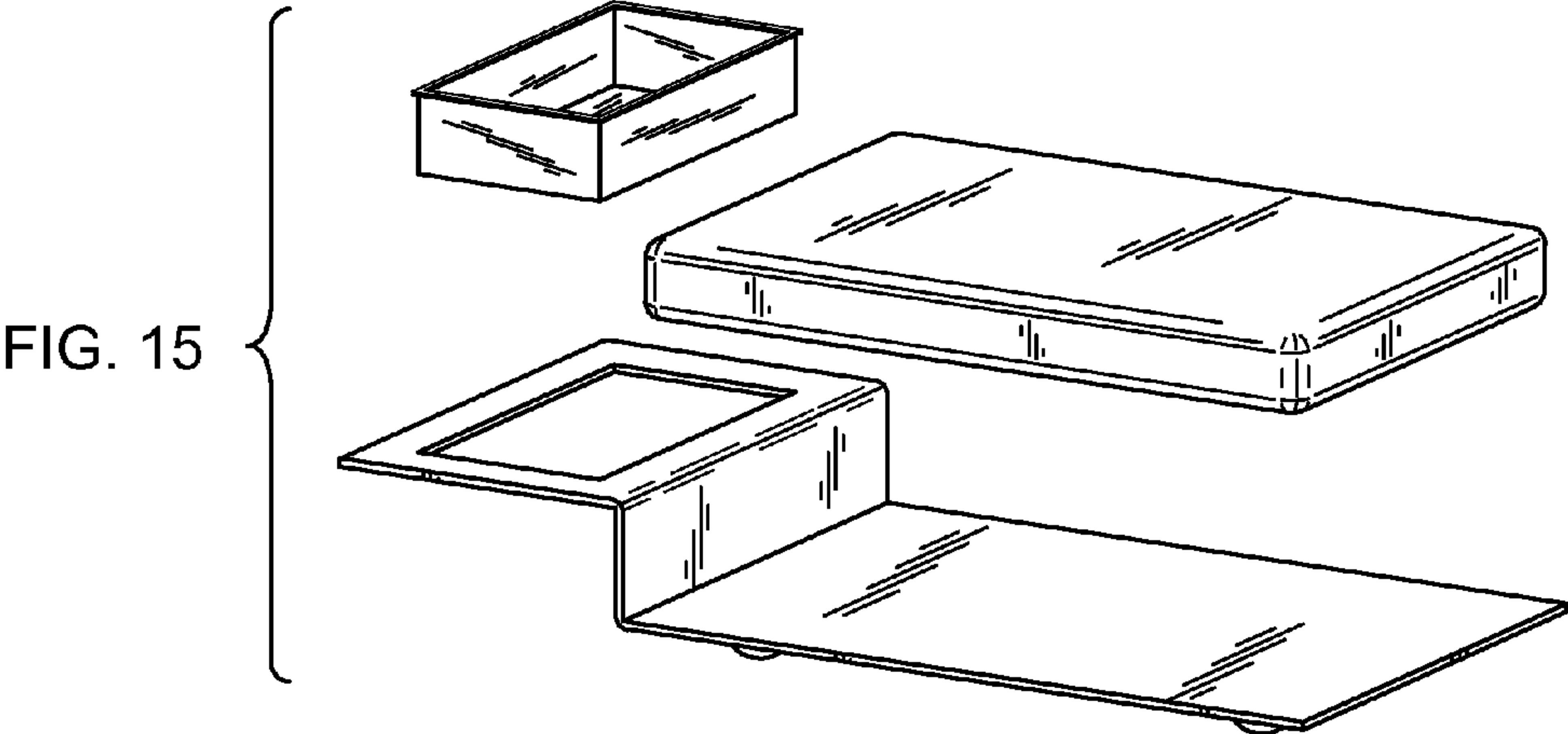

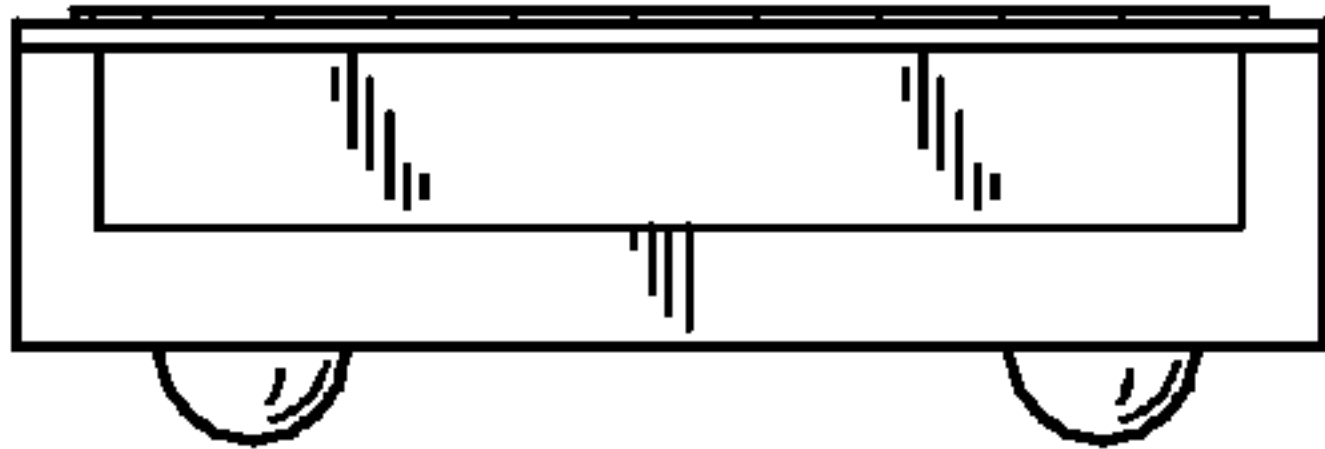

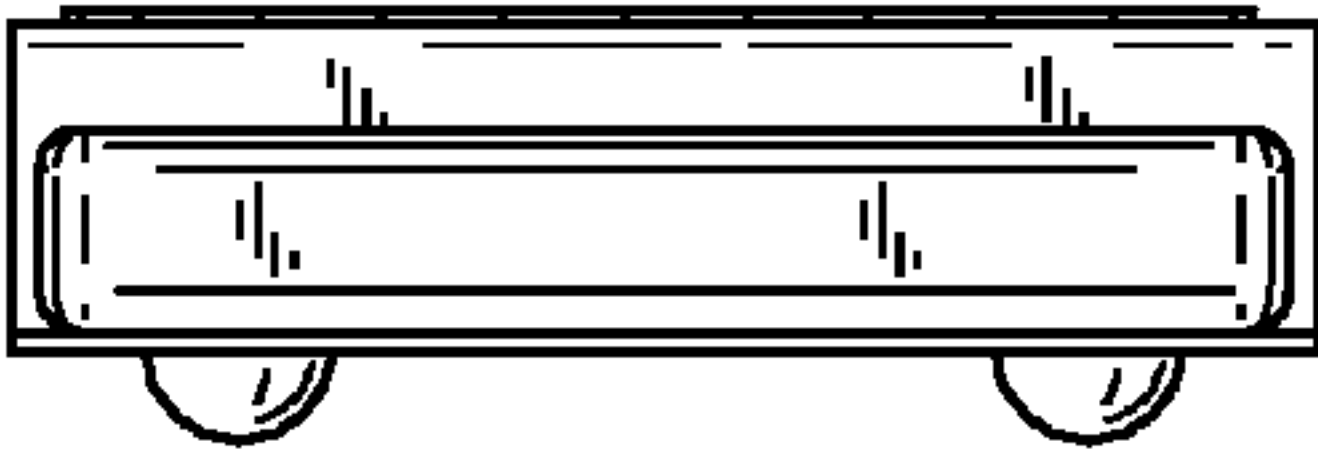

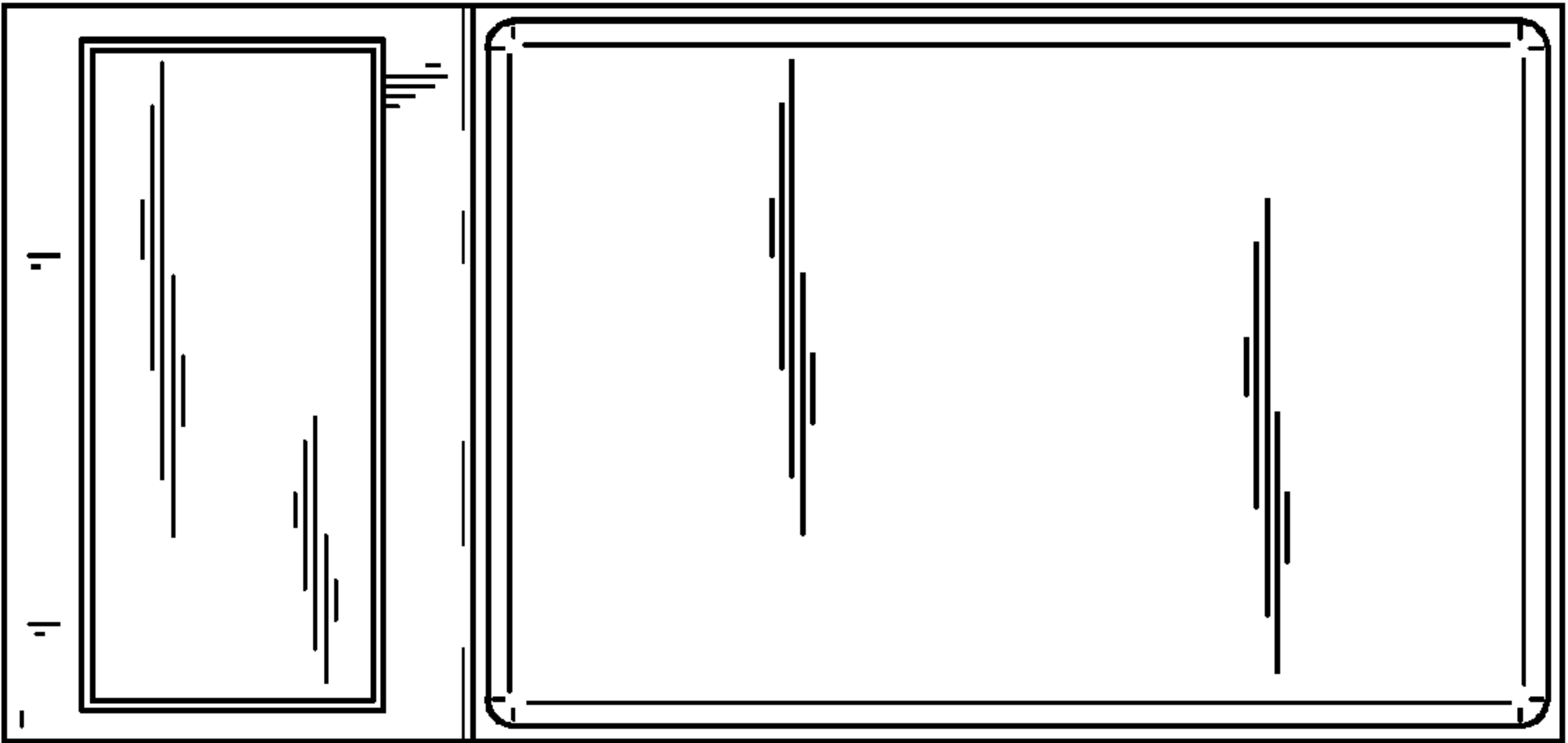

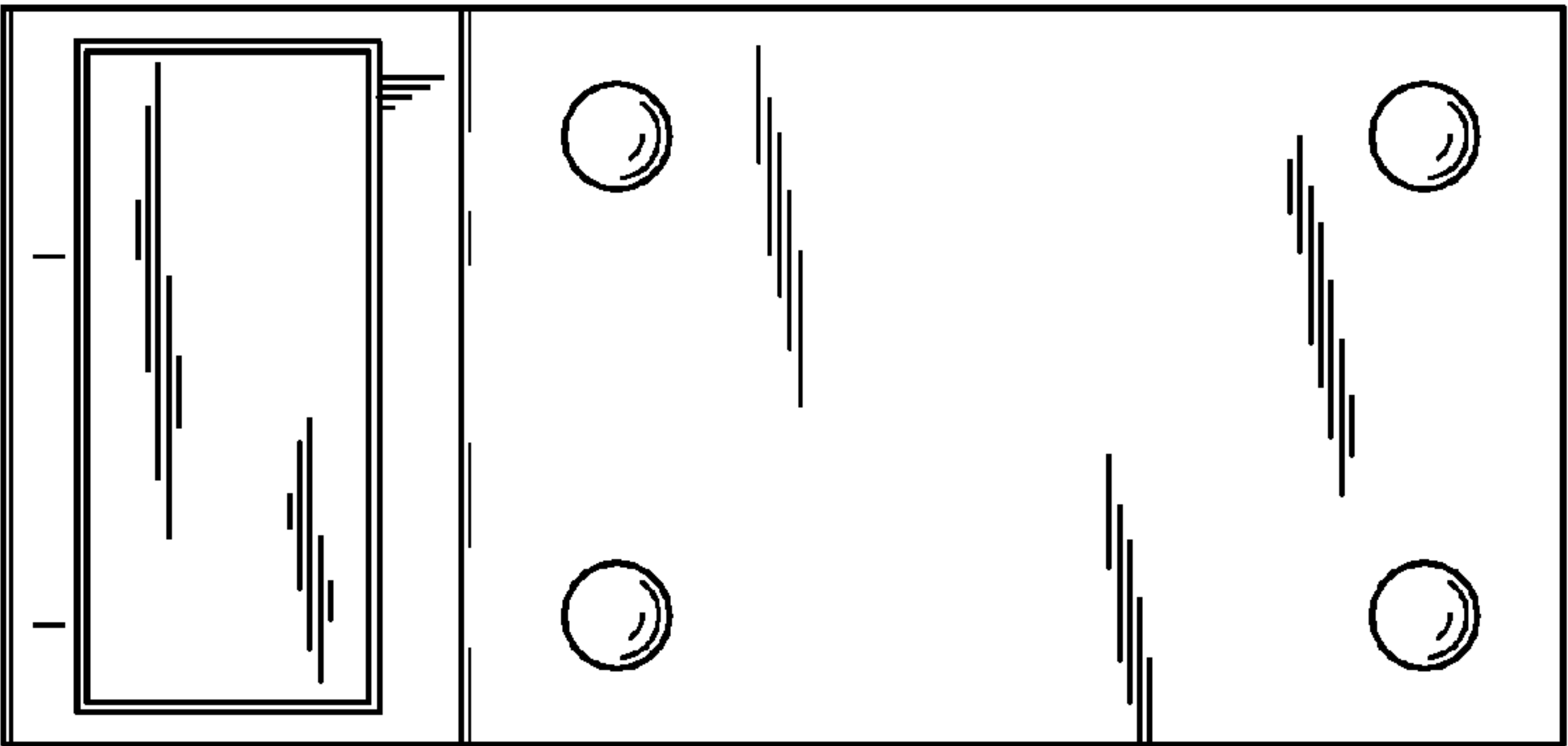

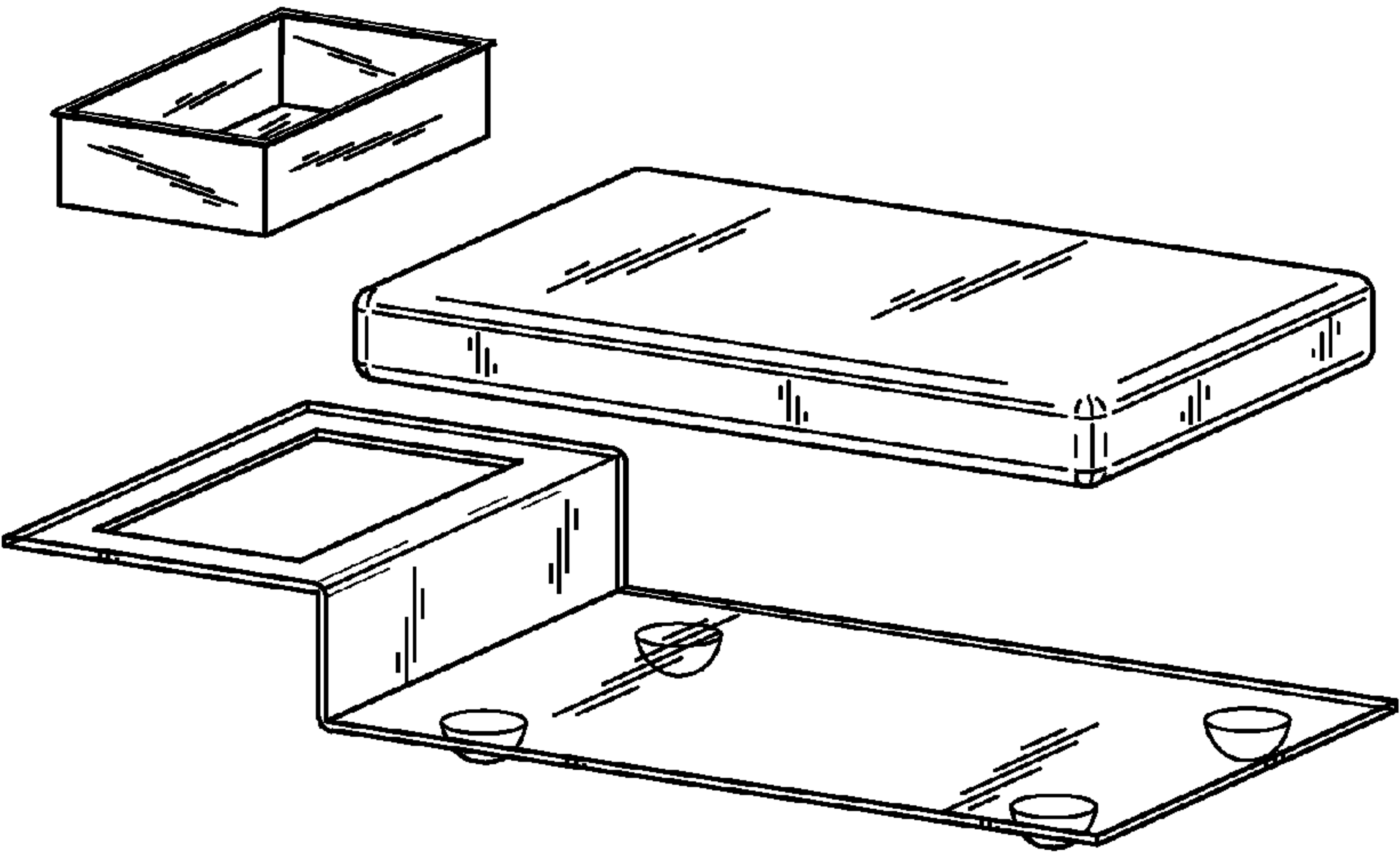
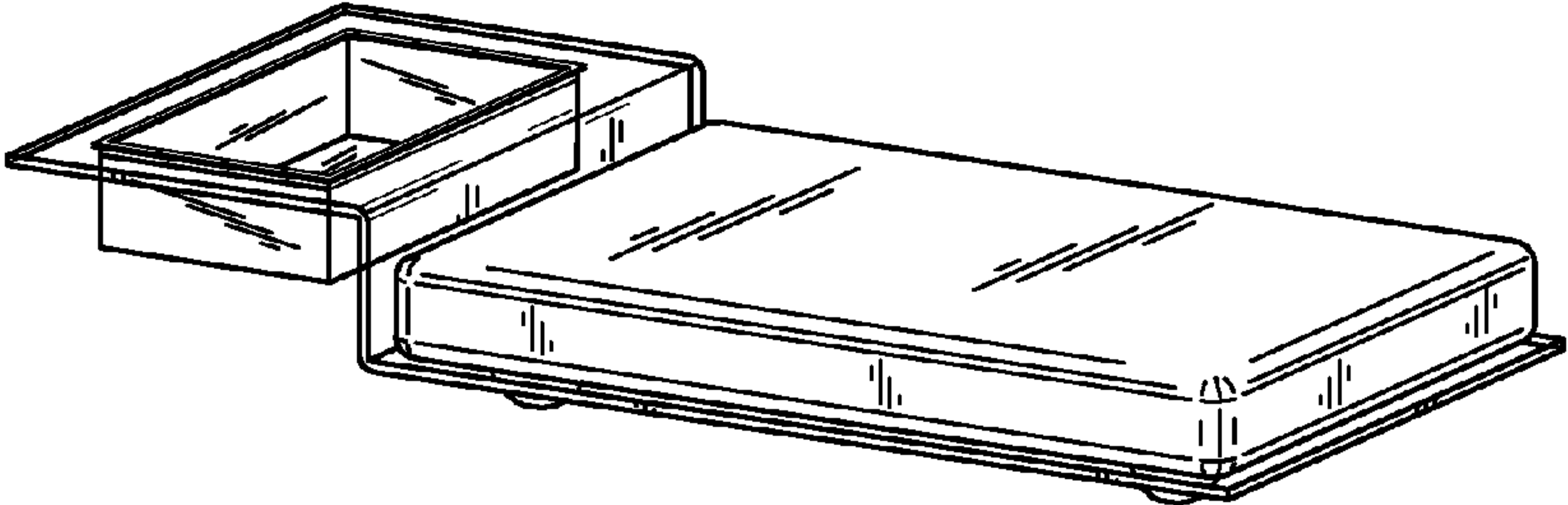

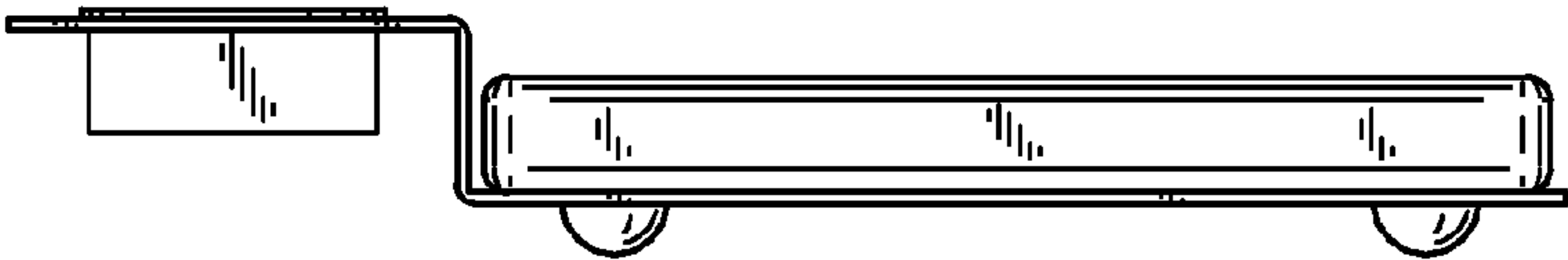

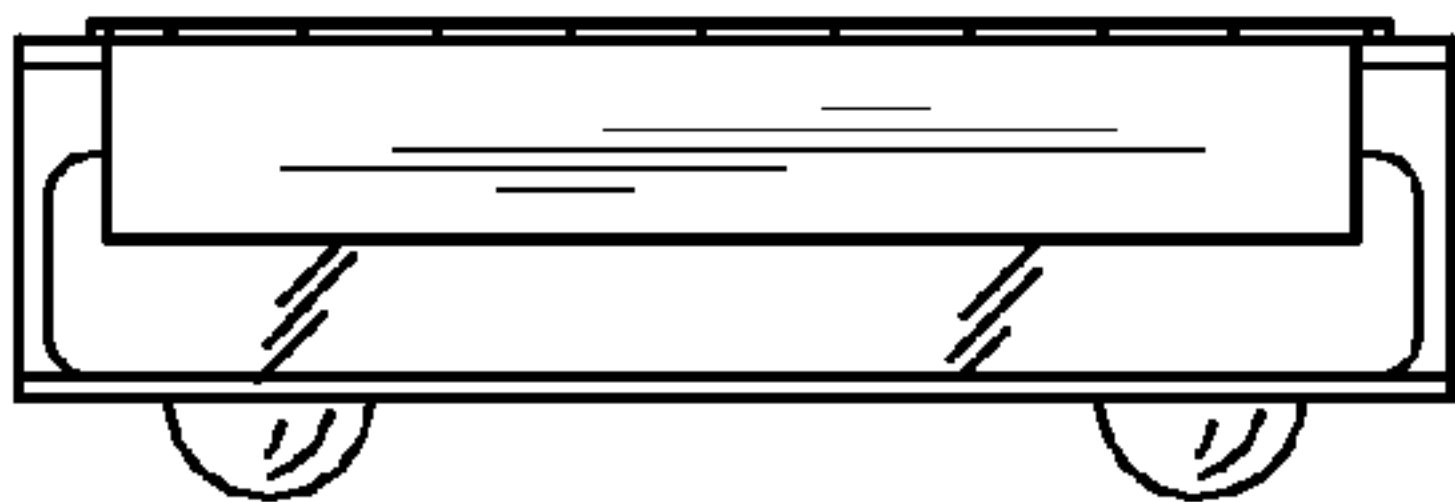

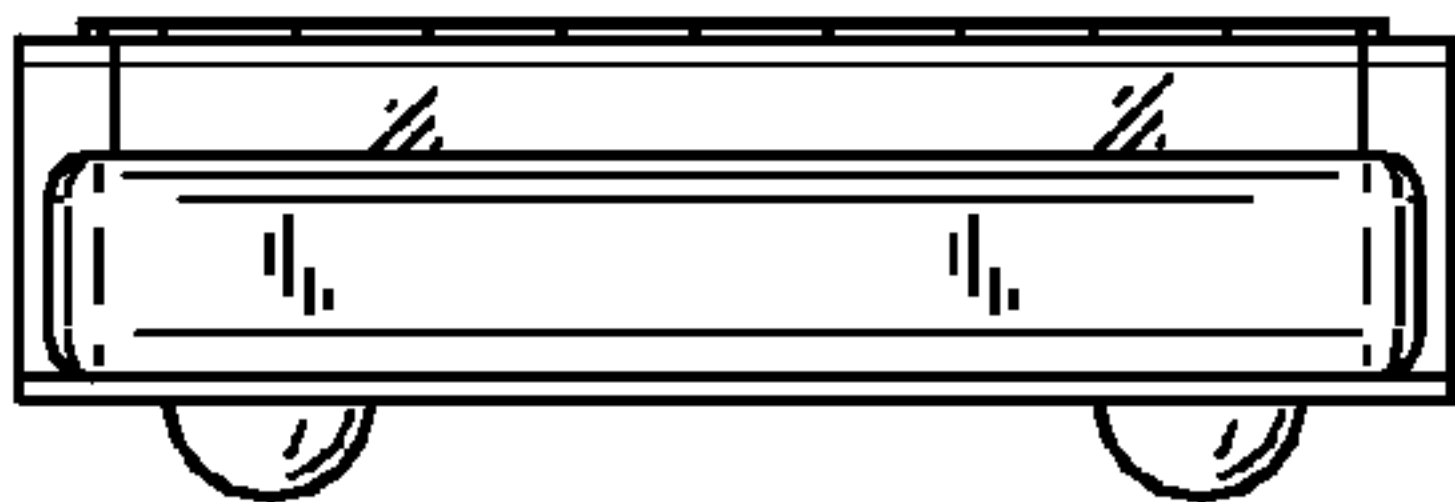

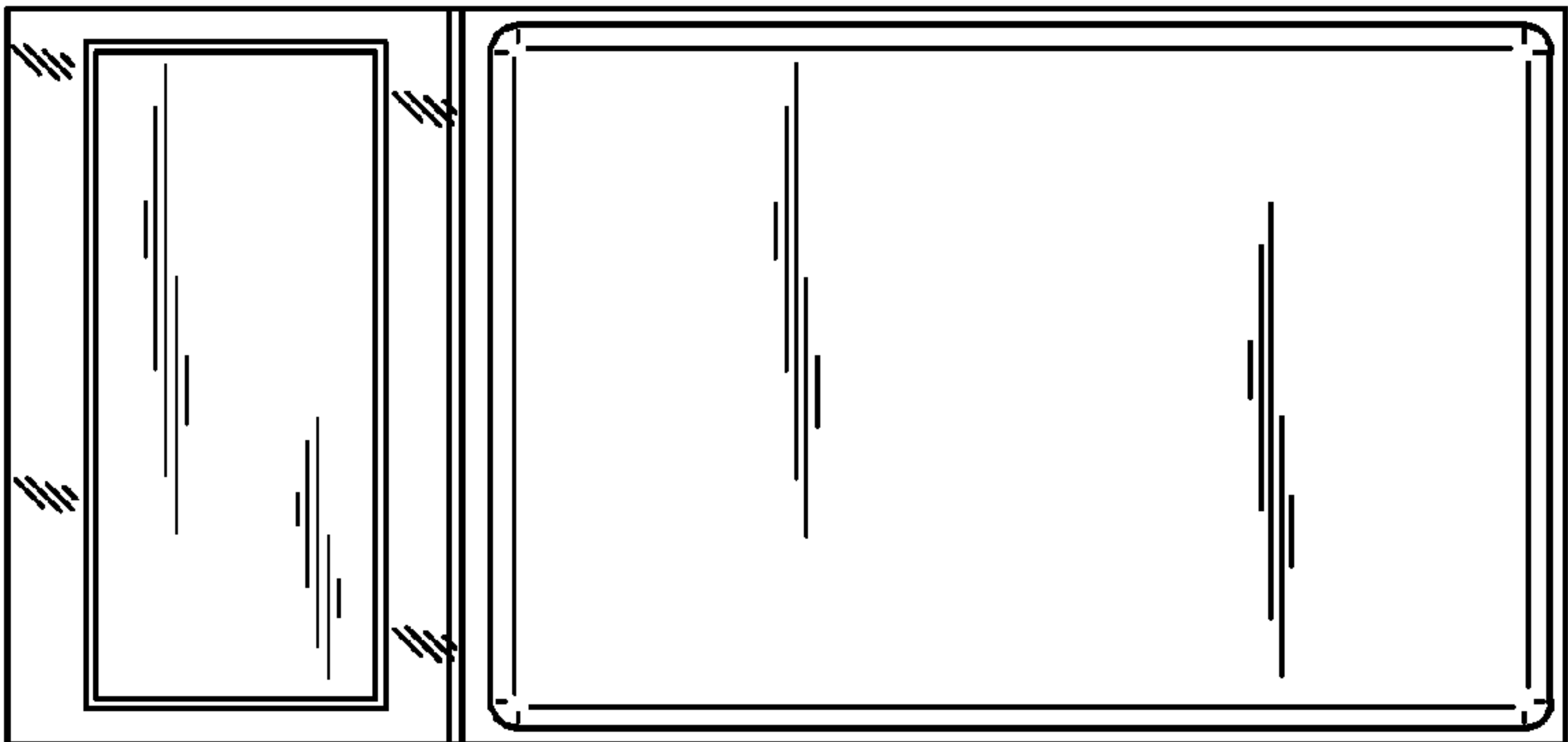

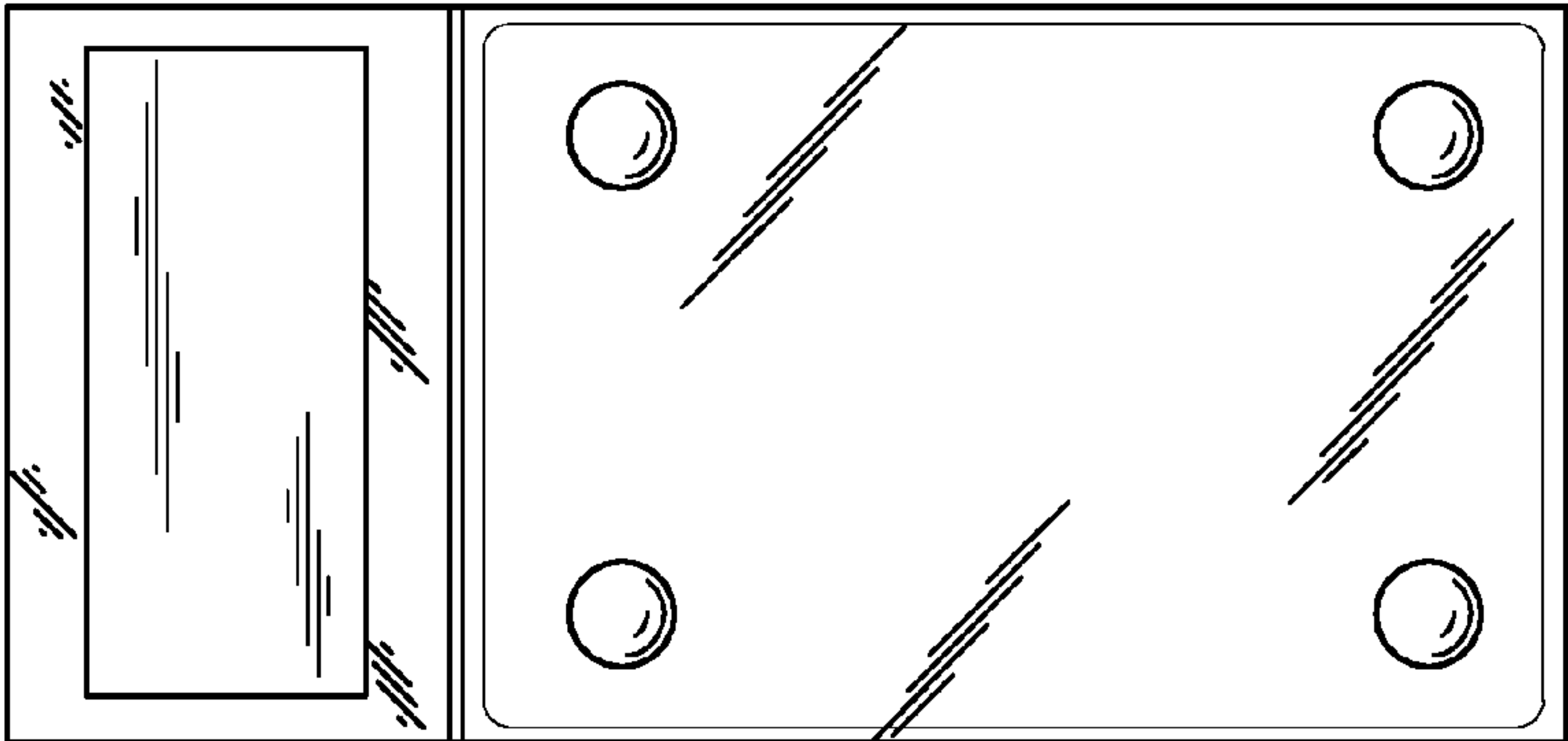
