(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a glove, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective top view (back of hand view) of the ornamental design for a portion of a left glove.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the ornamental design shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view of the ornamental design shown in FIG. 1.

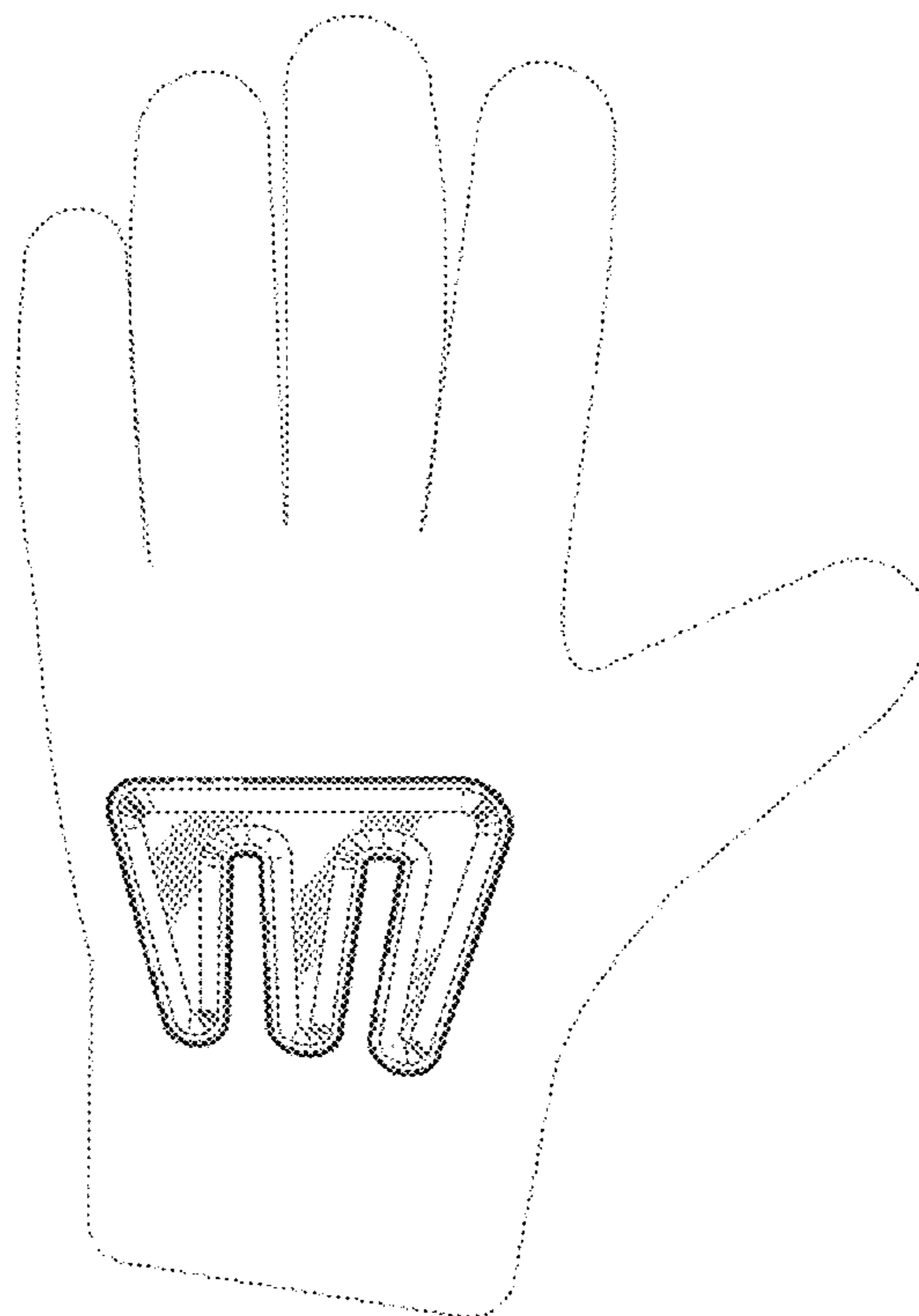
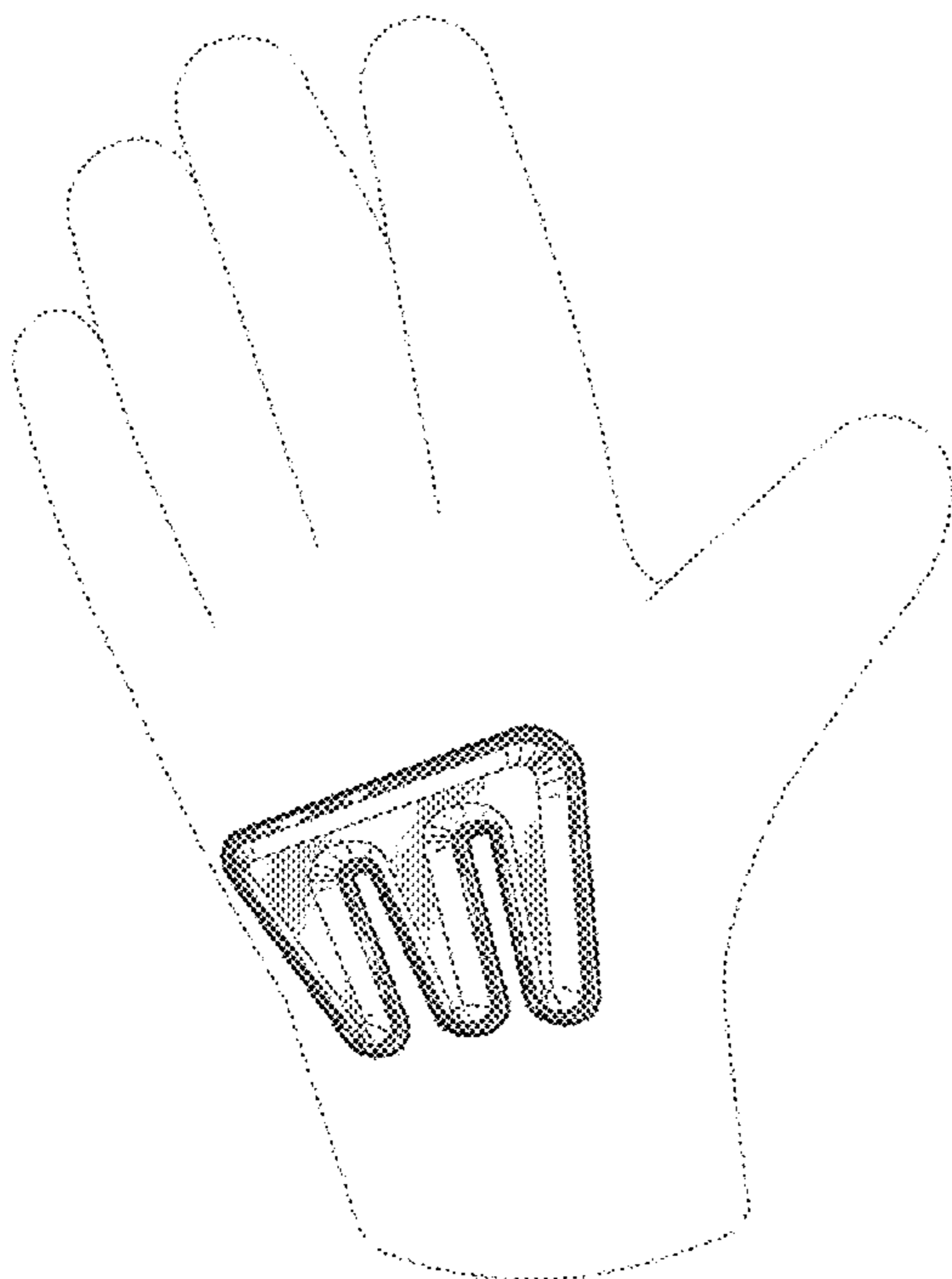
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view of the ornamental design shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the ornamental design shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the ornamental design shown in FIG. 1.

While a left-hand glove embodiment is illustrated, a second, unshown embodiment is comprised of a right-hand glove that is a mirror image of the design that is shown in FIGS. 1-6.

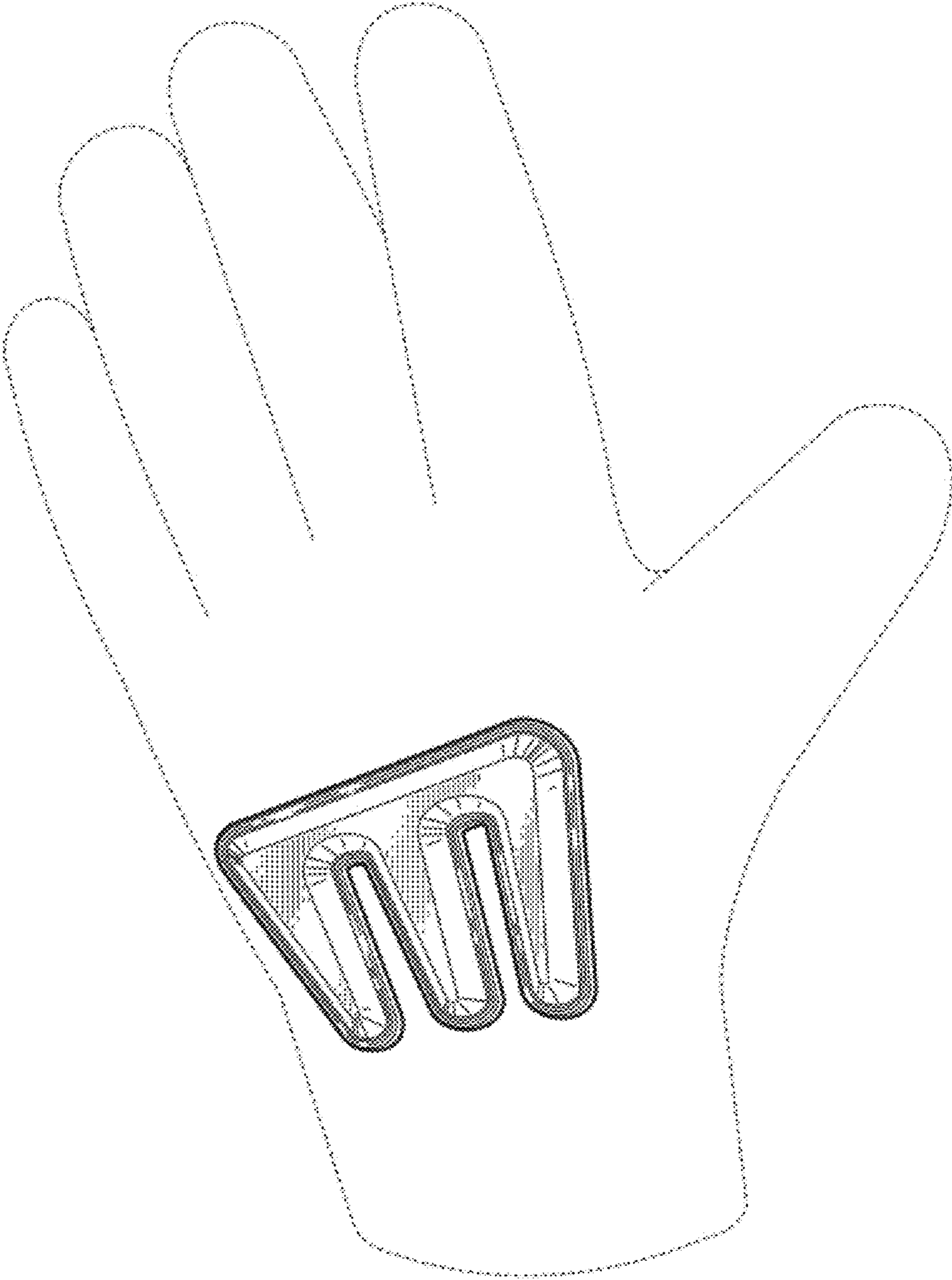

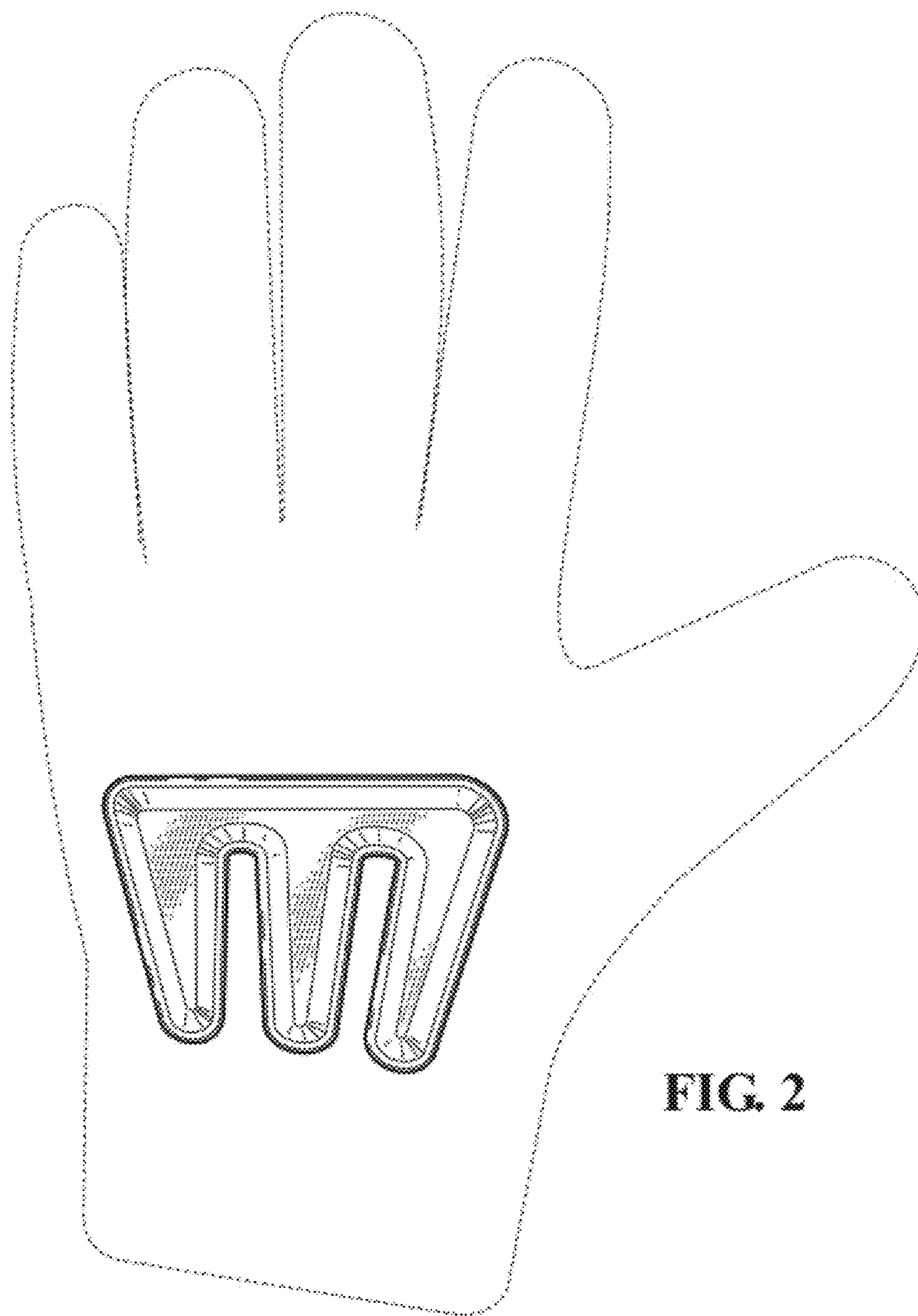

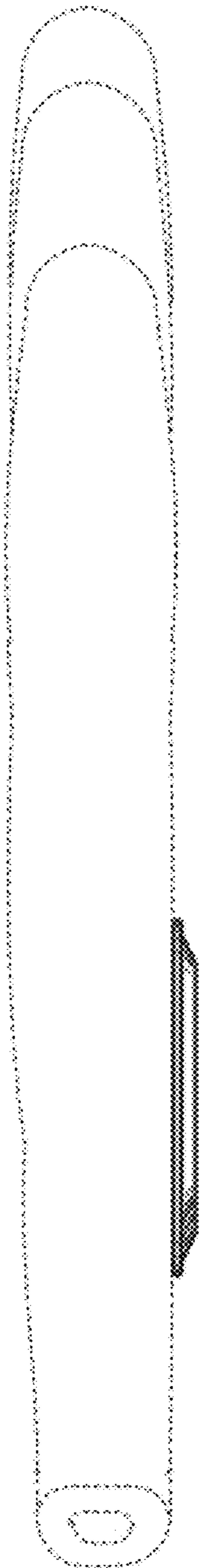

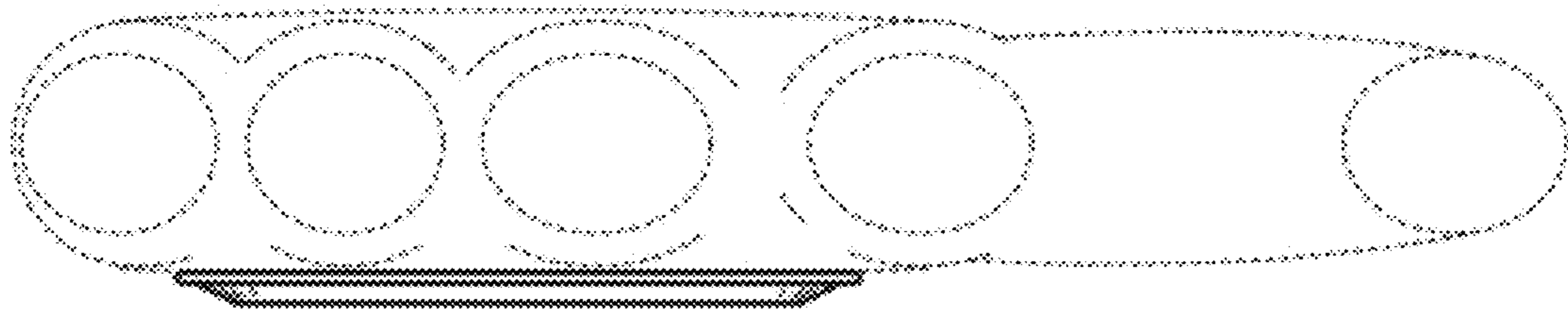

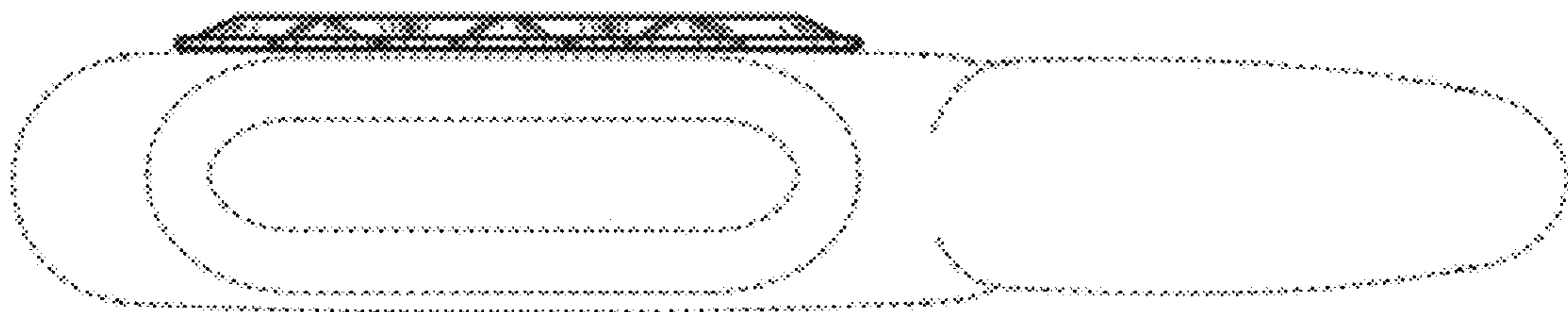
