FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the folding chair in a fifth partially unfolded position;

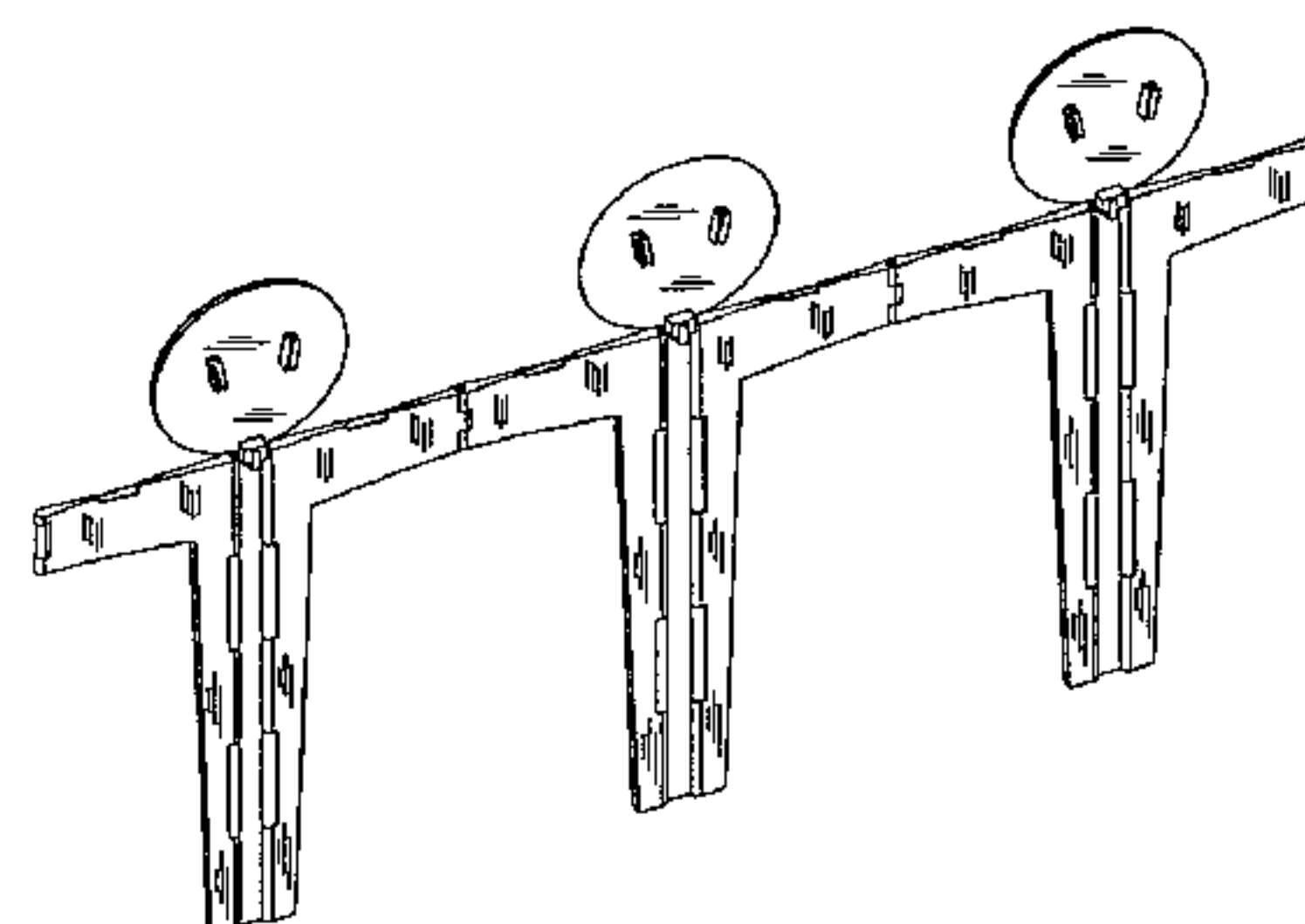
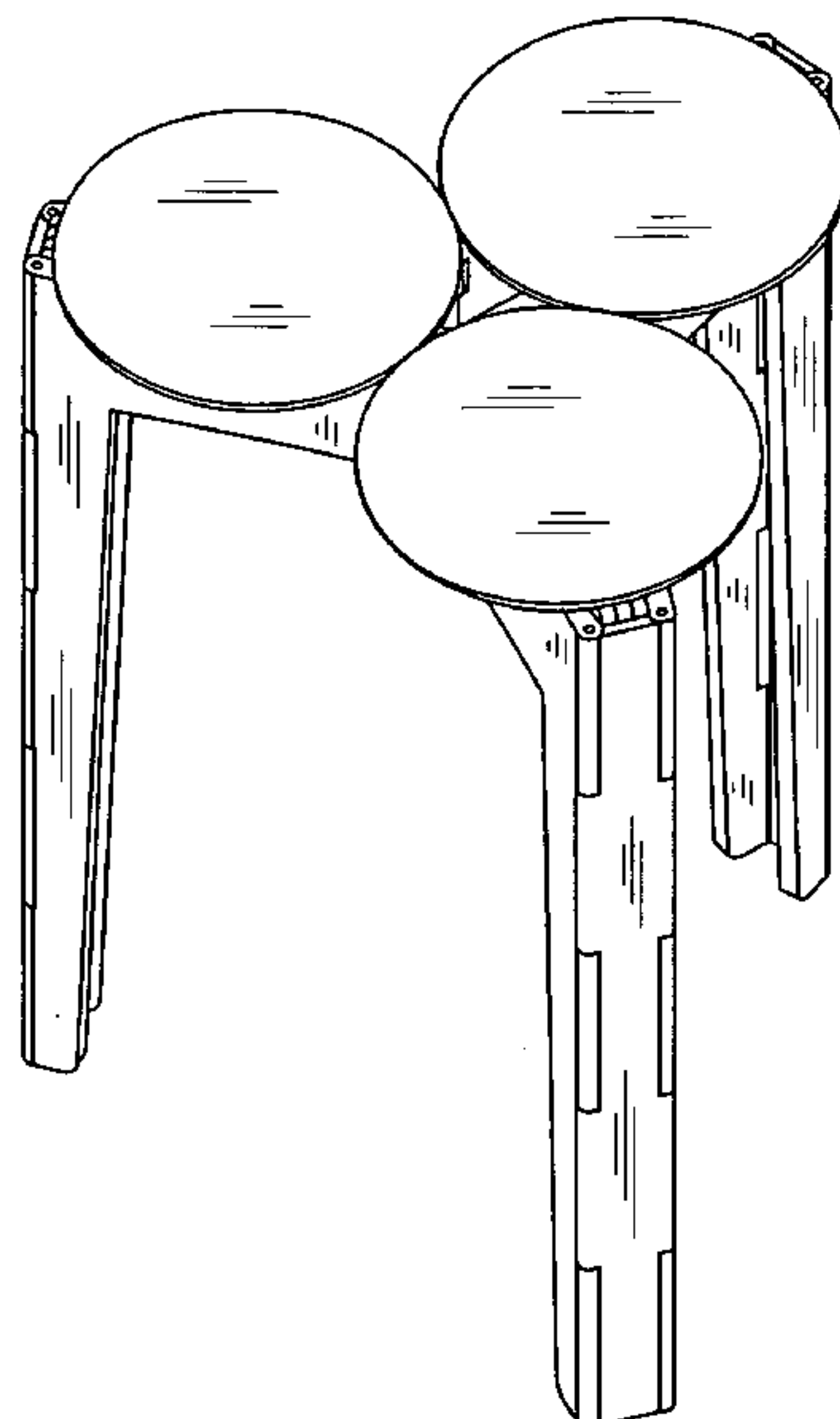
FIG. 11 is a perspective view of the folding chair in a sixth partially unfolded position;

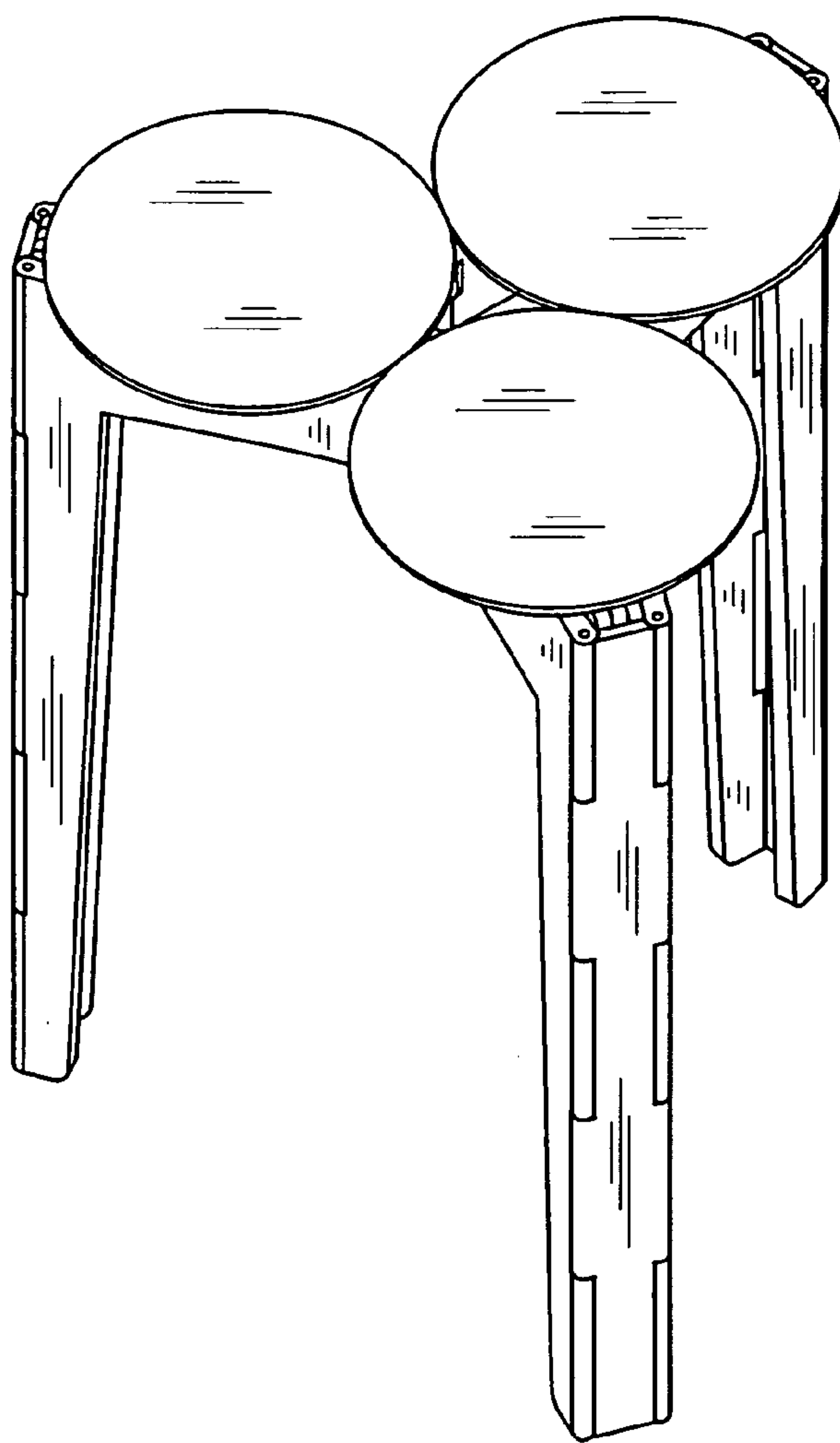

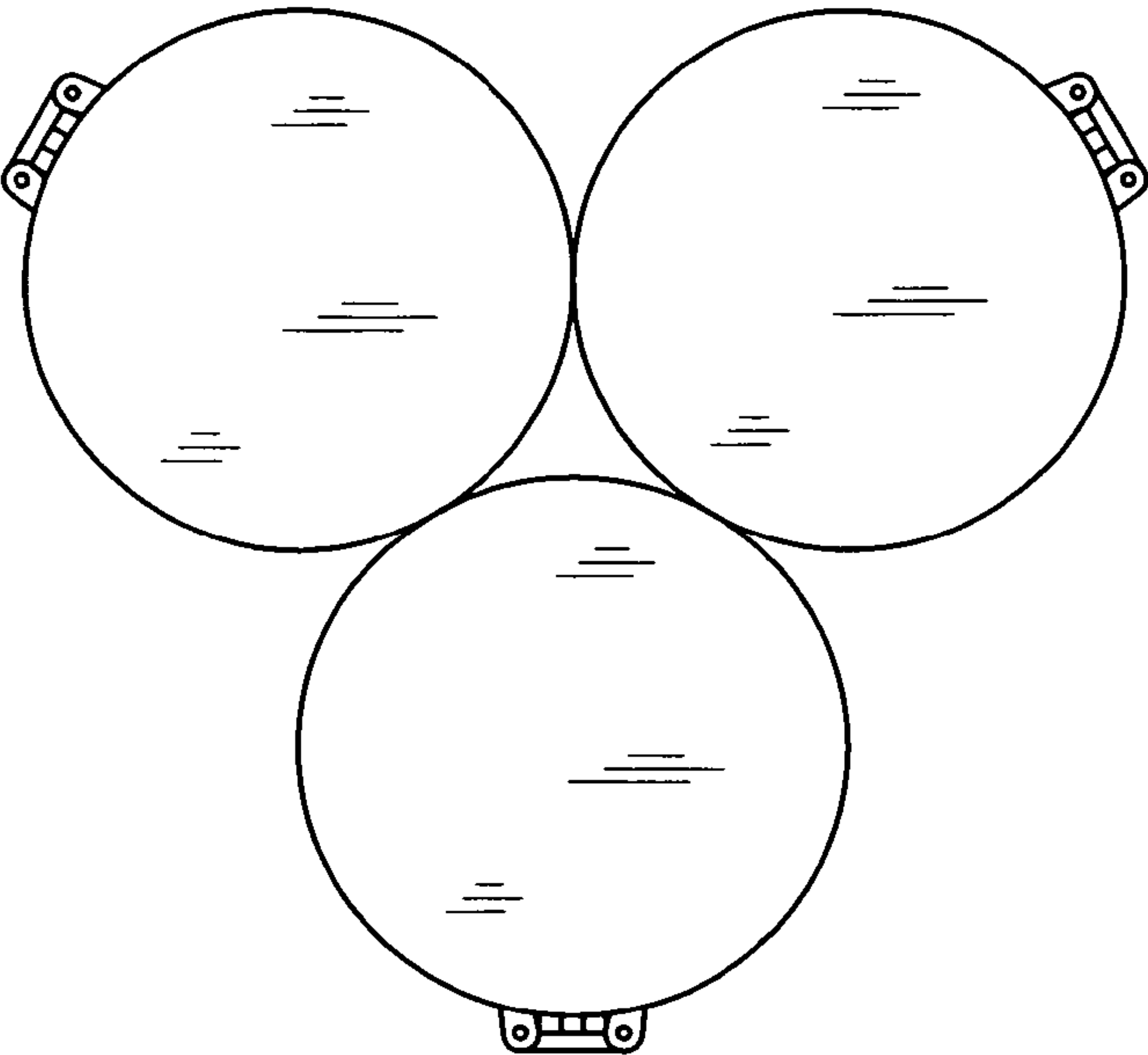

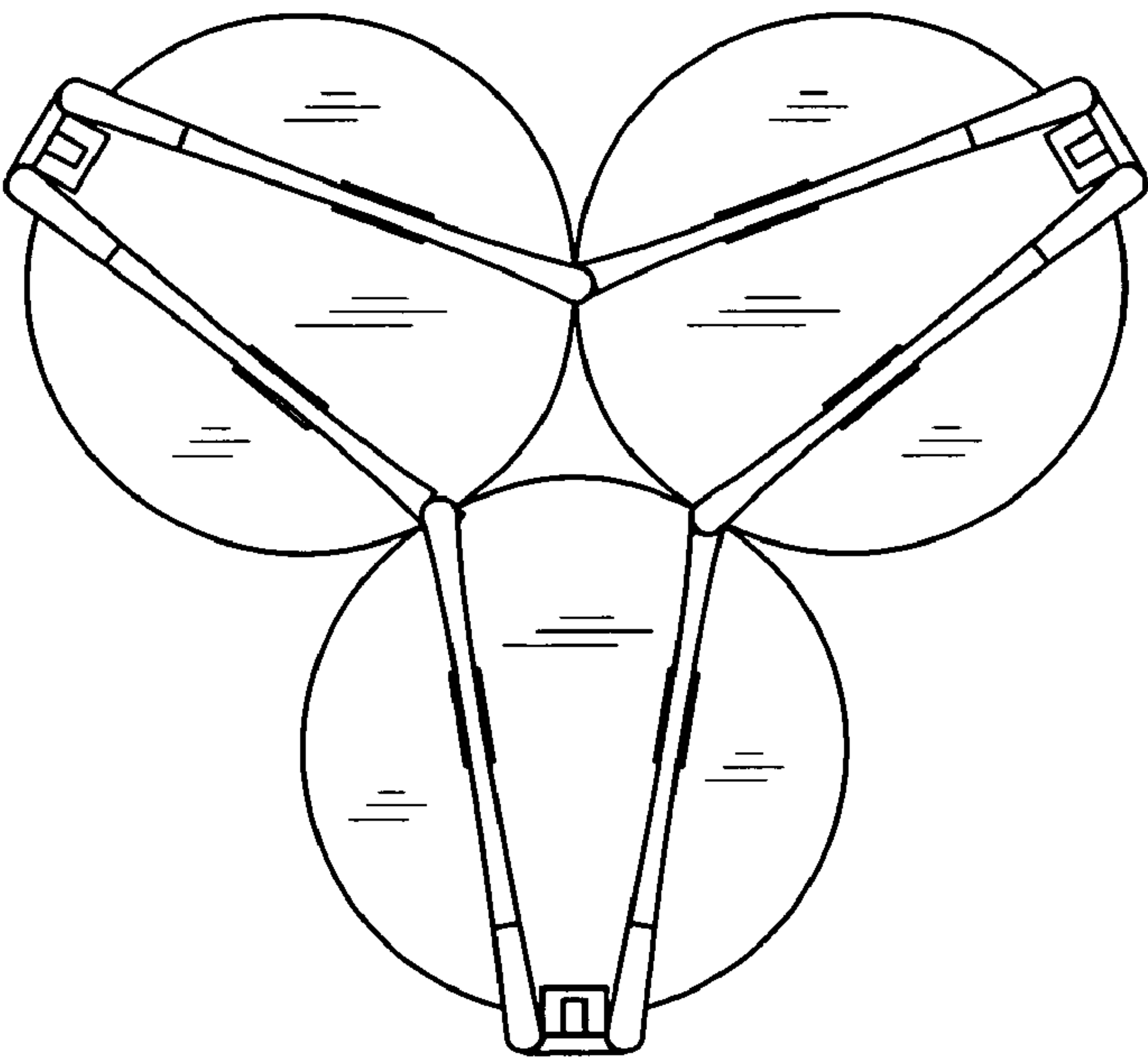

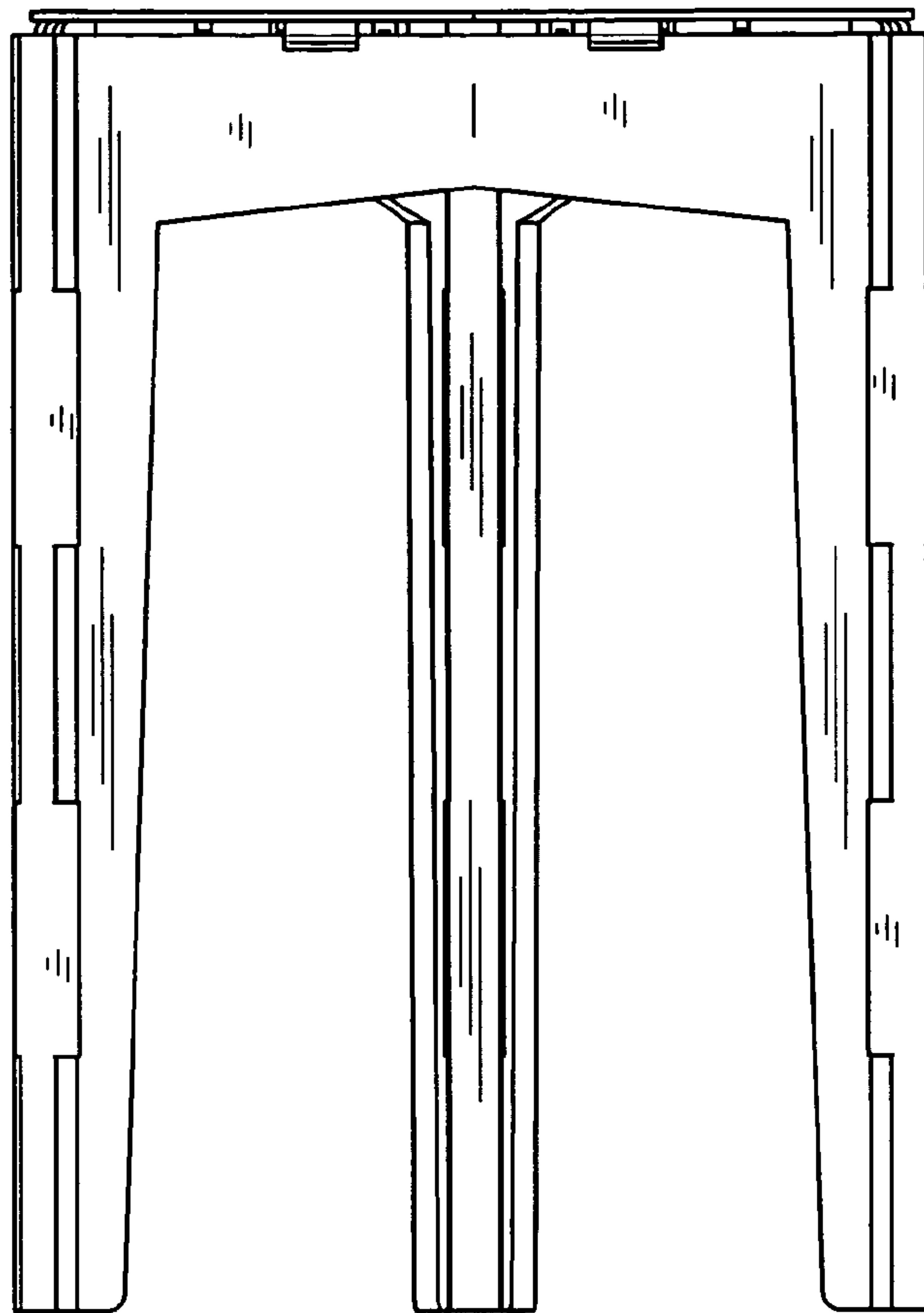

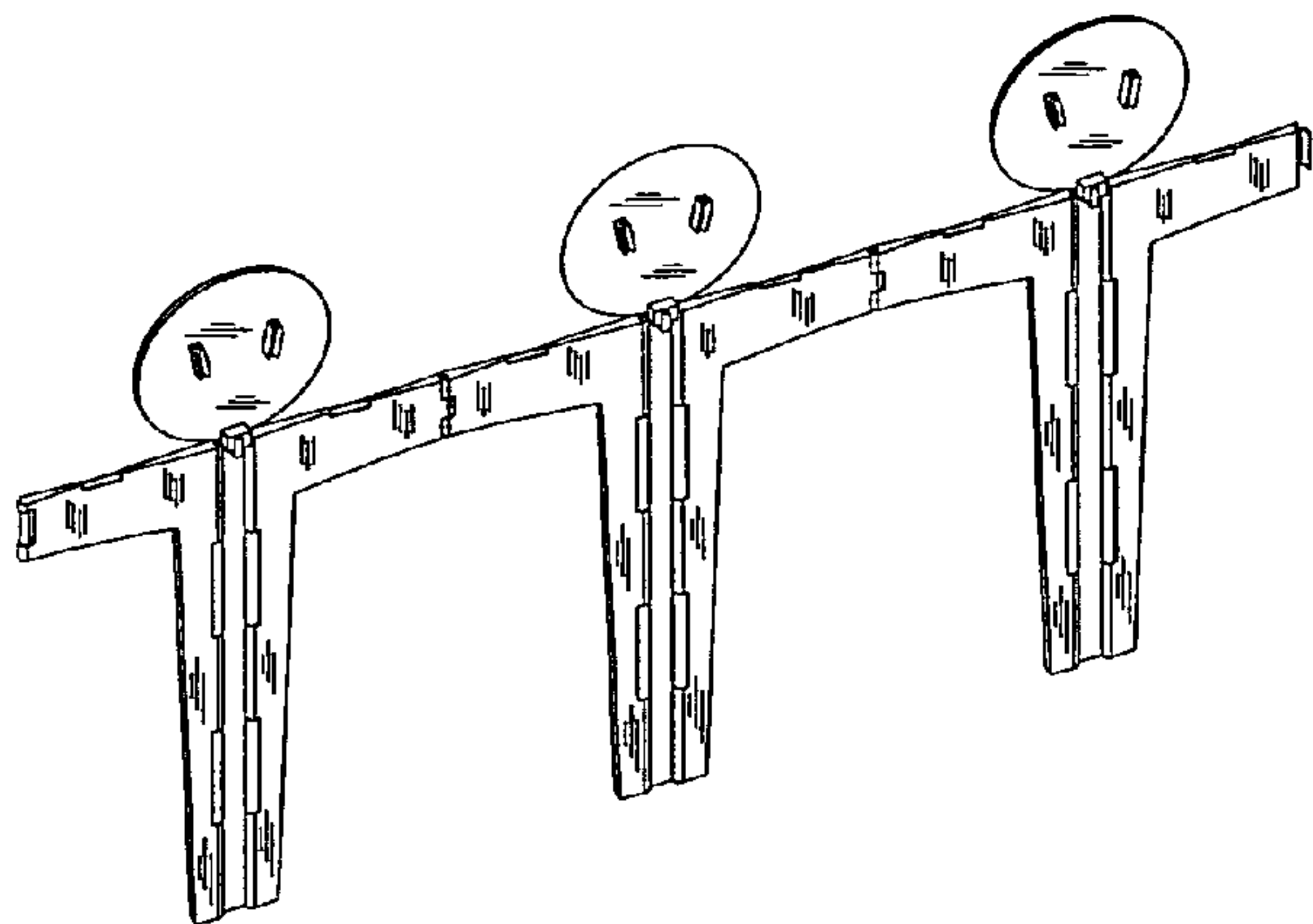

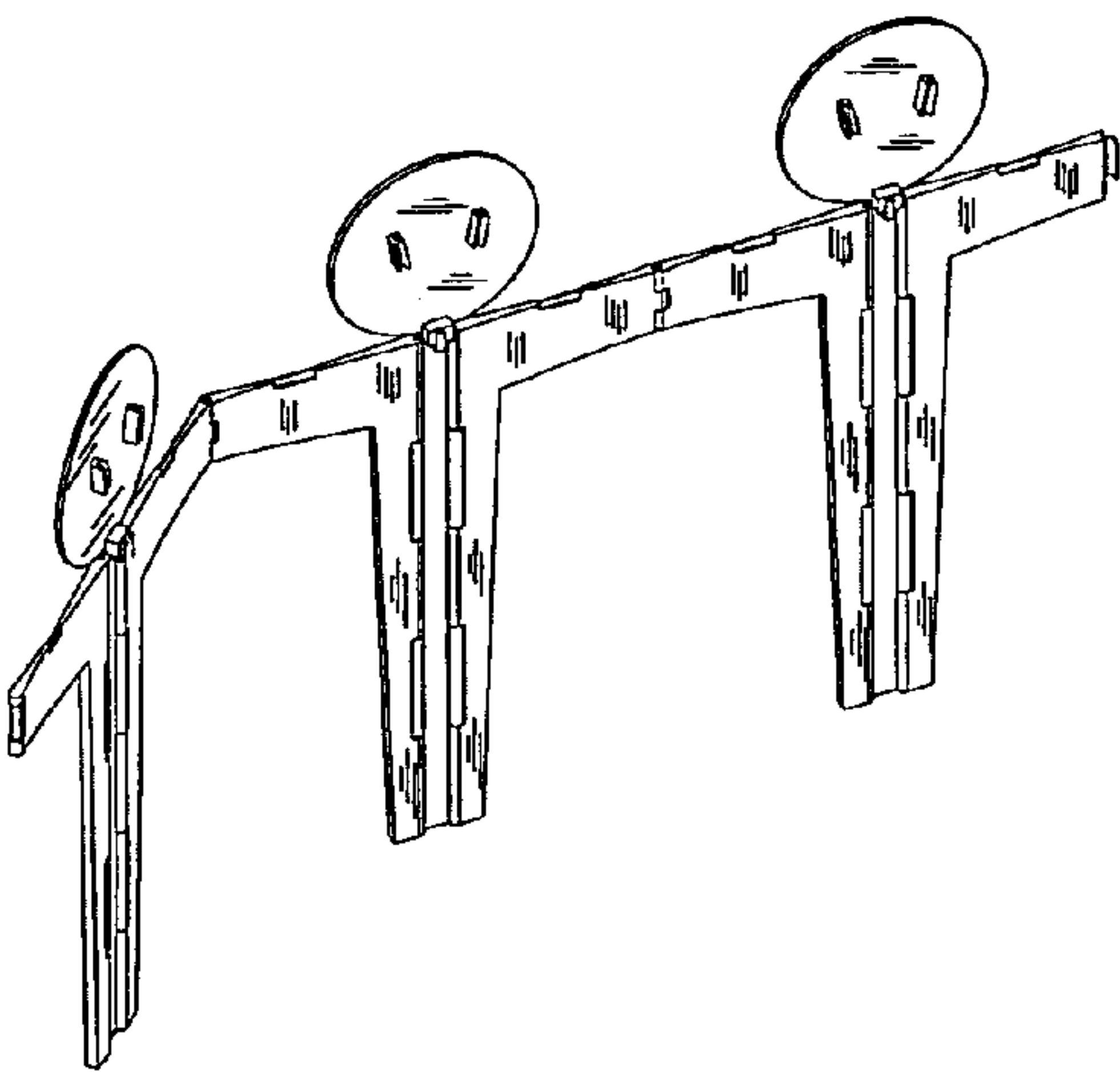

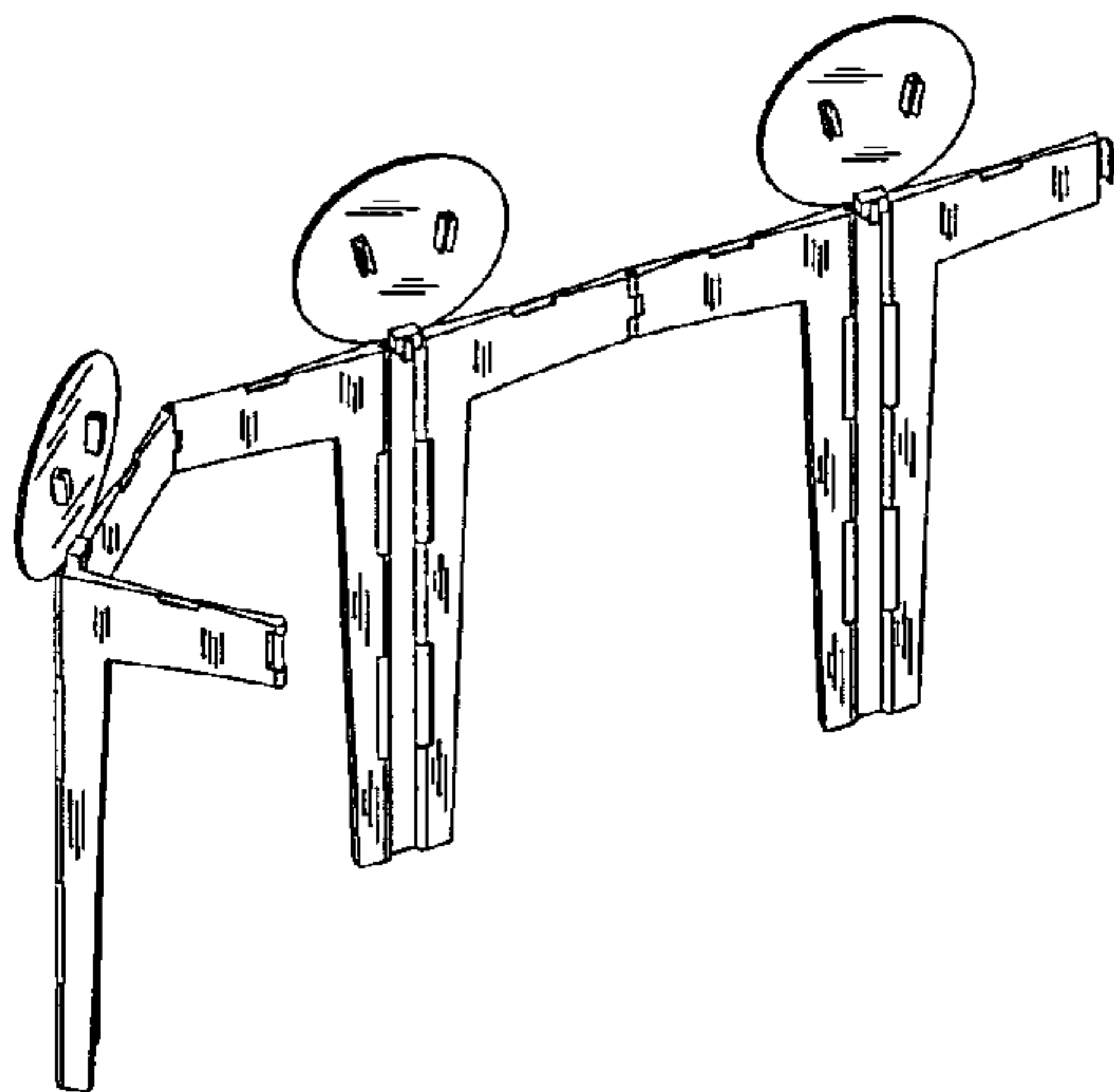

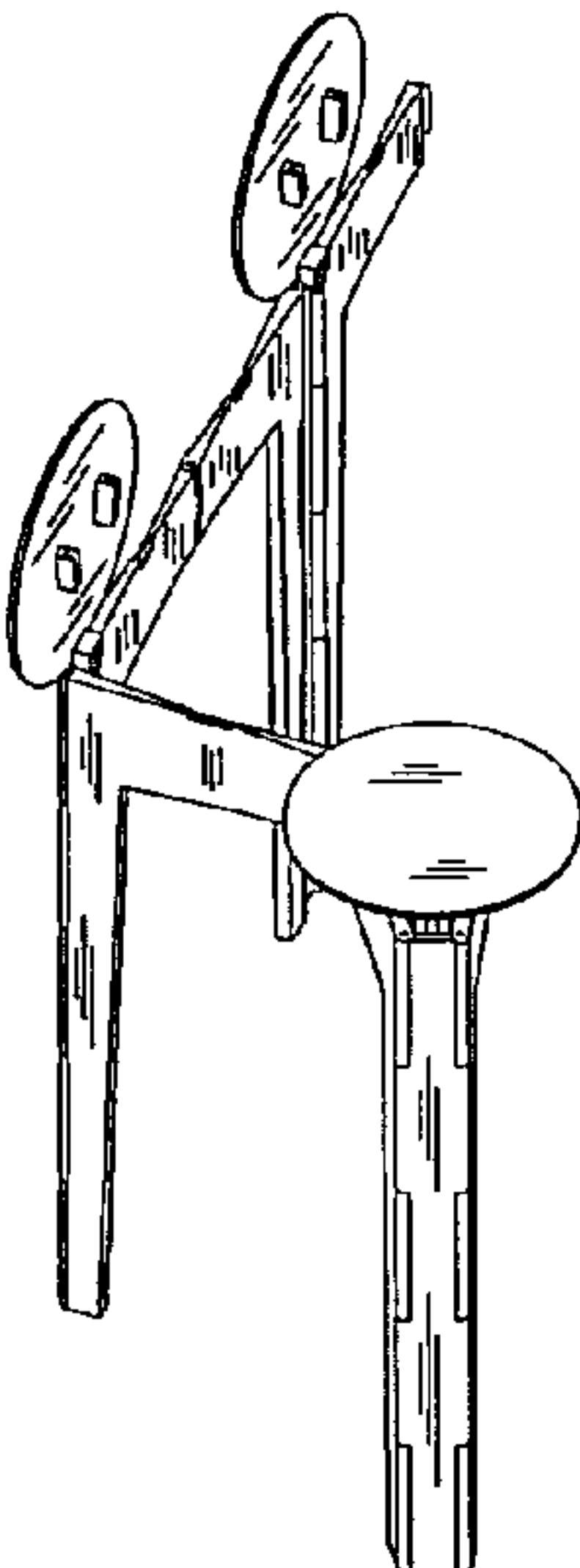

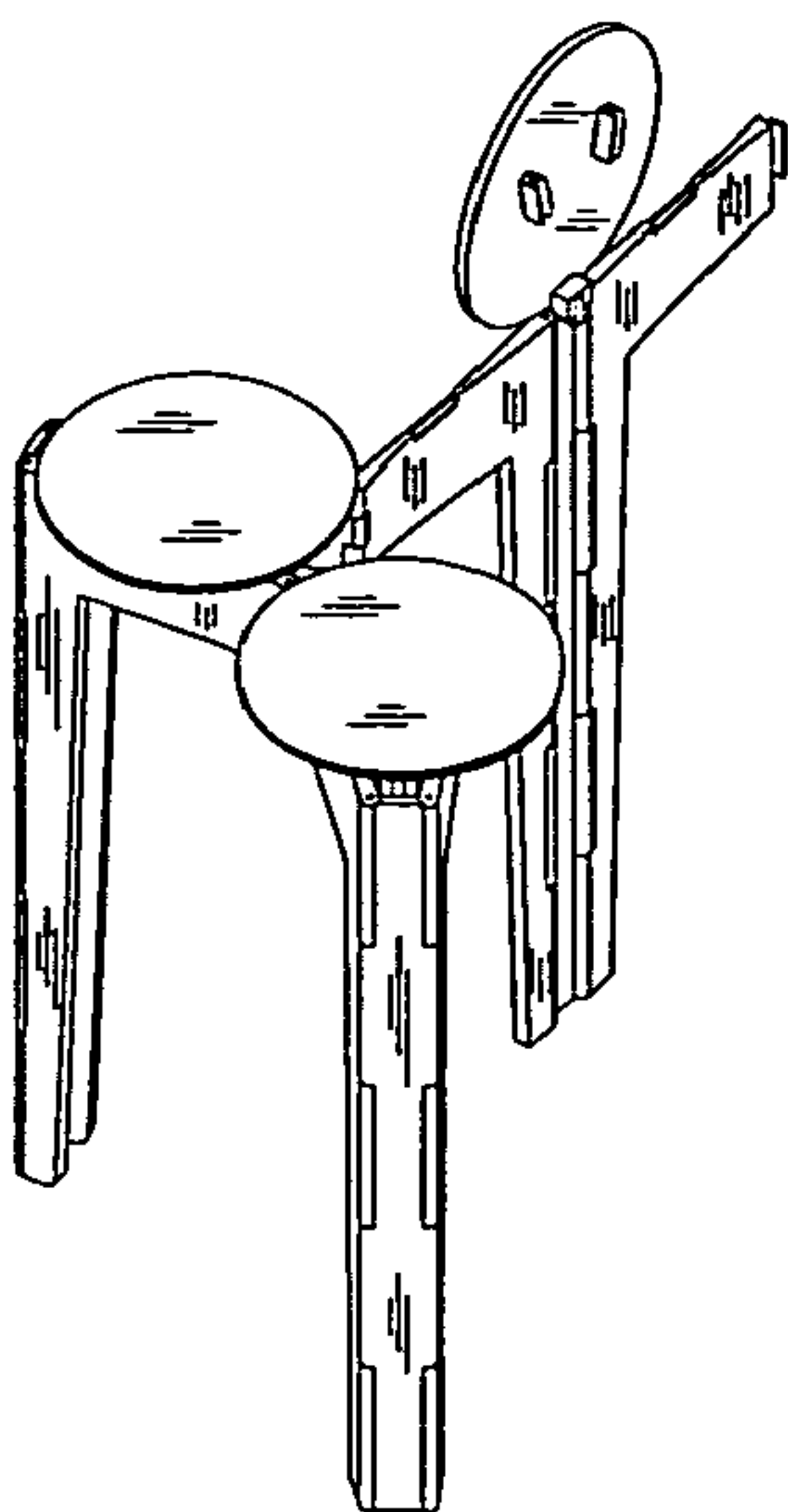

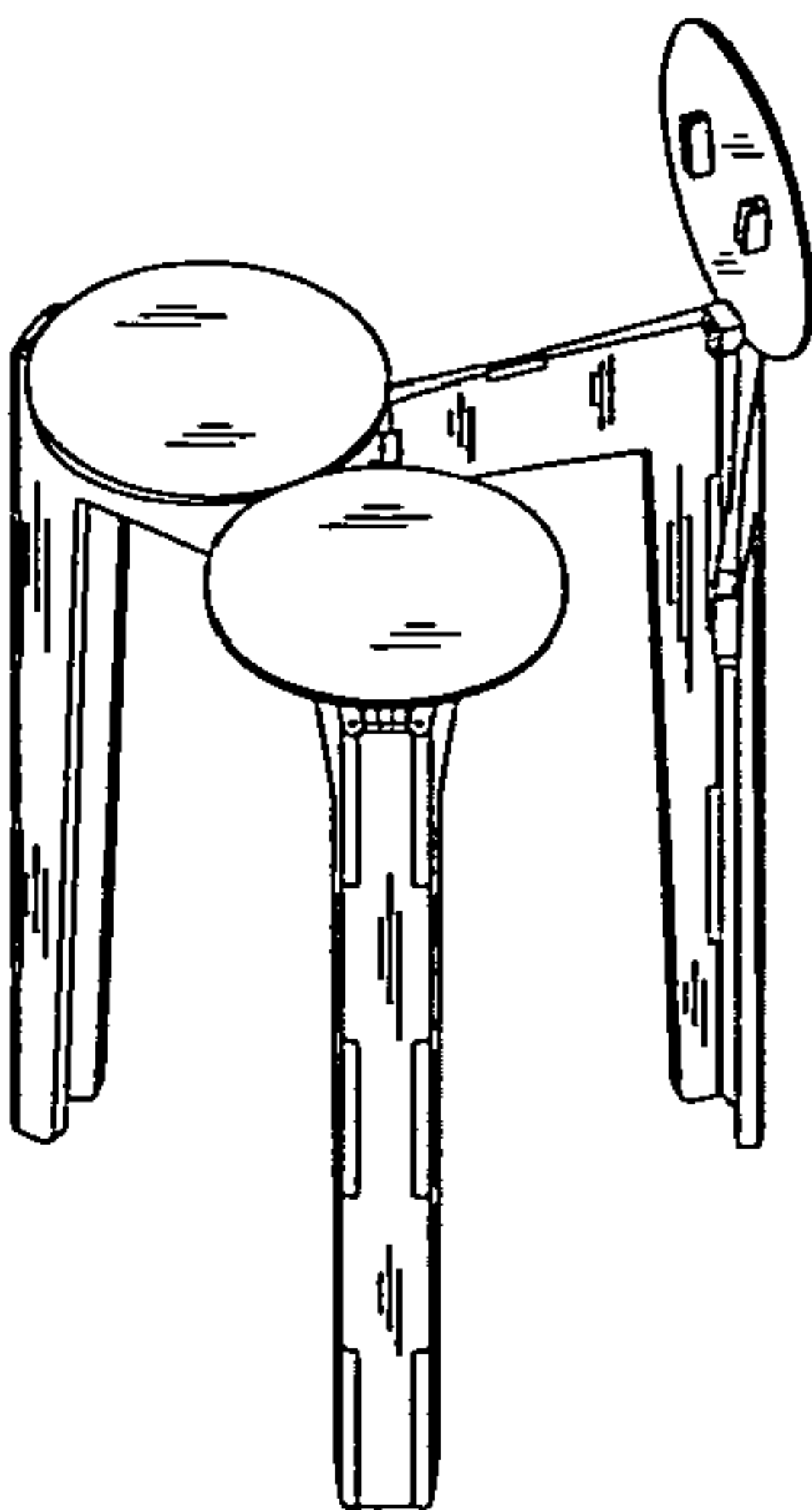

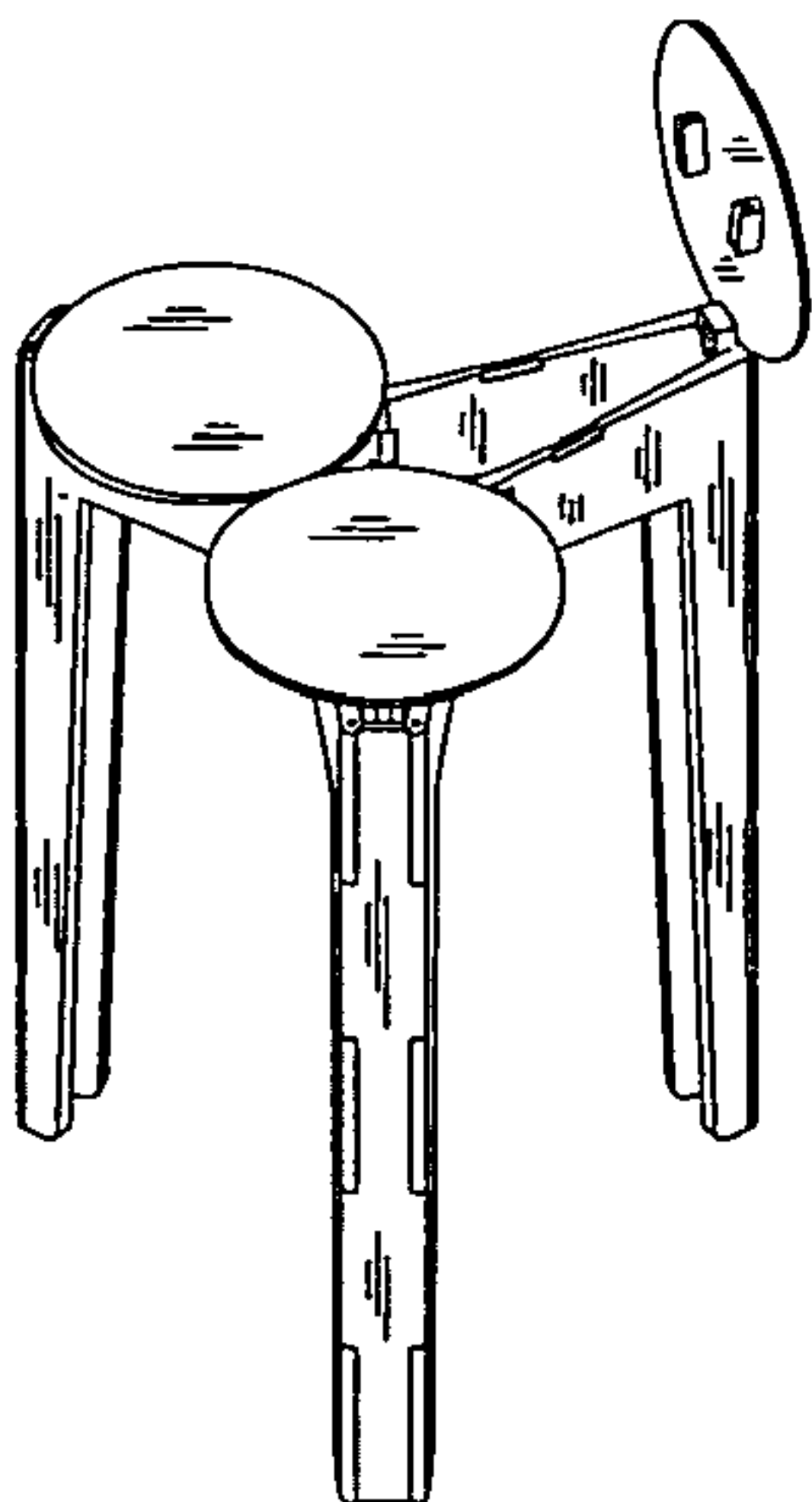

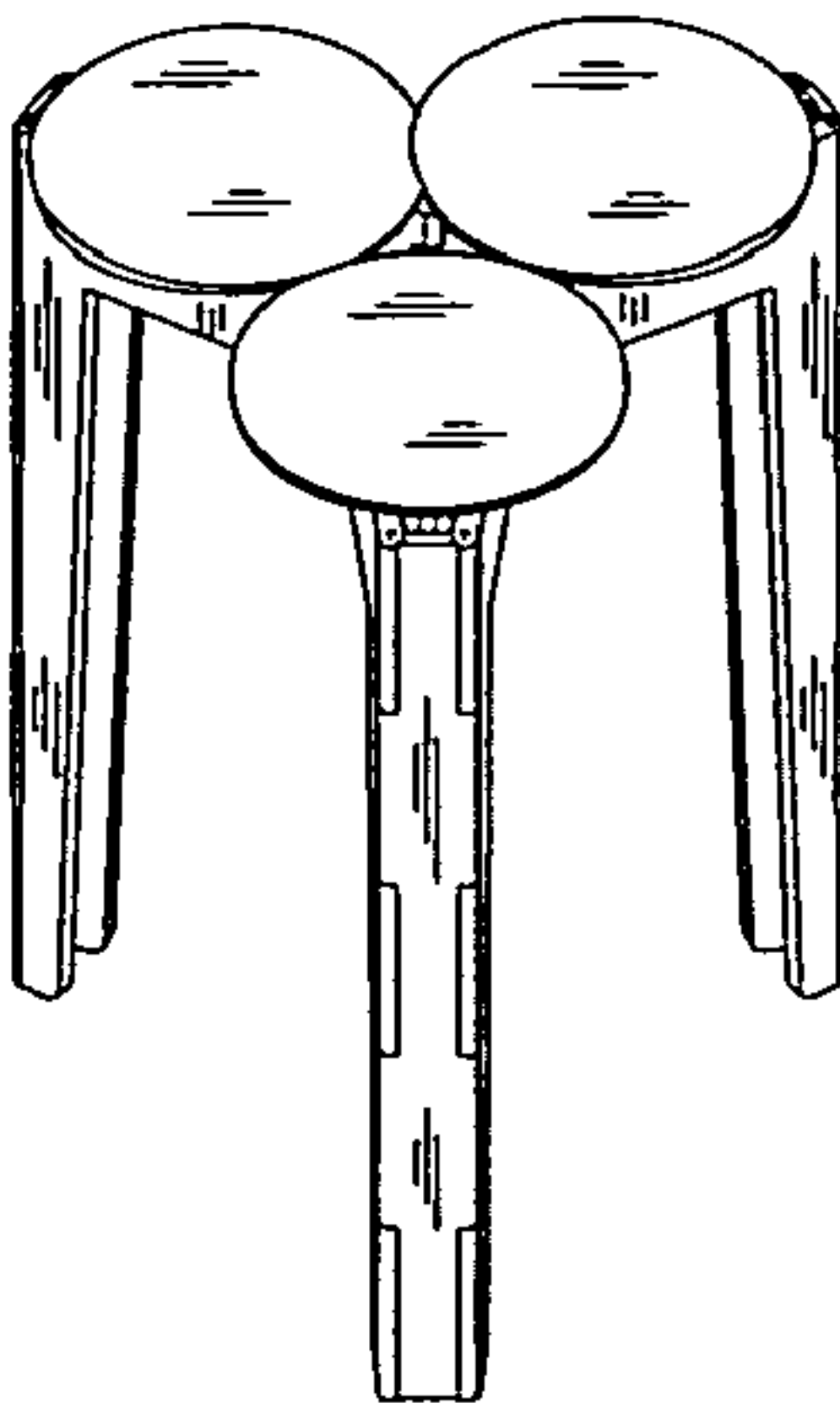

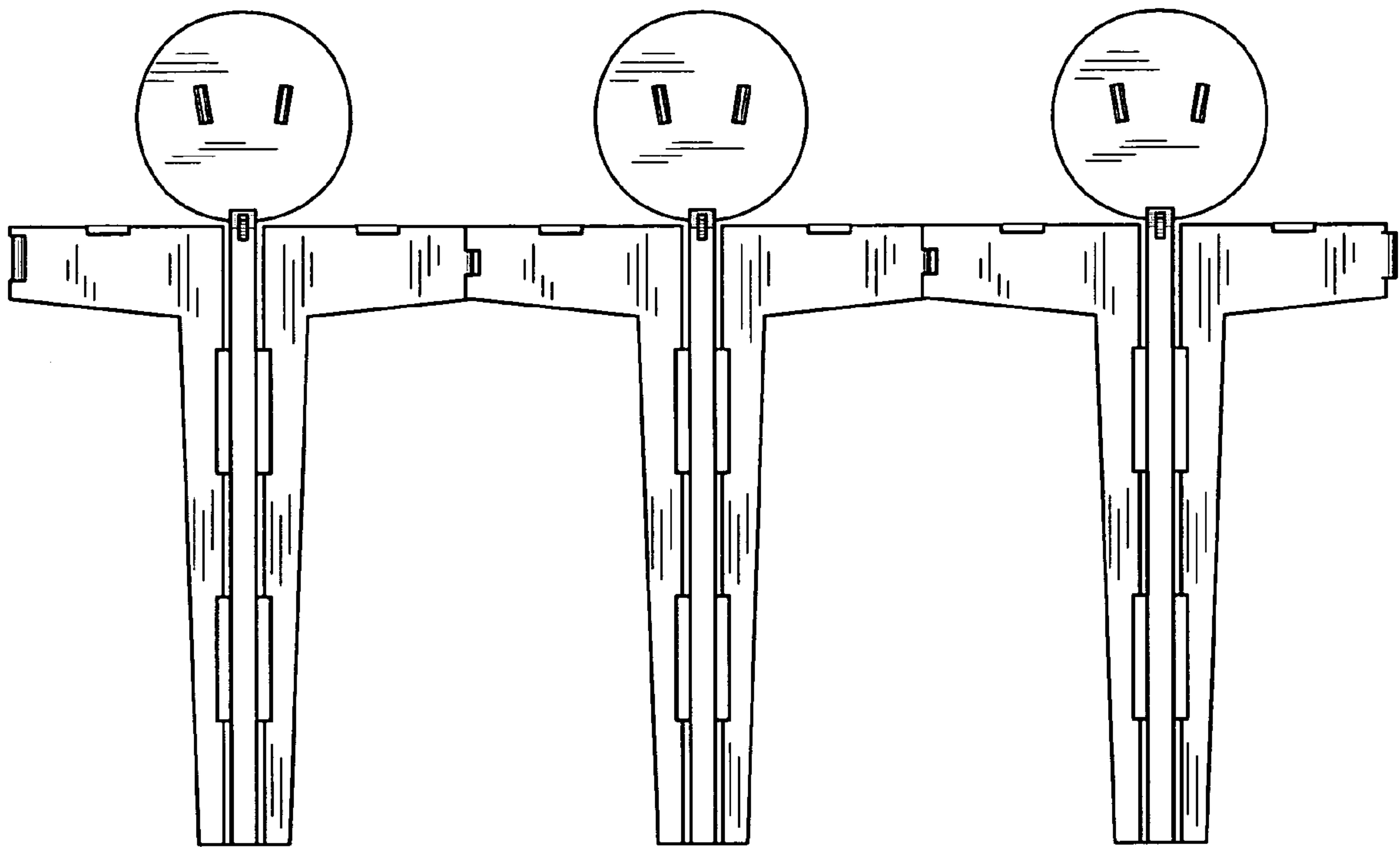

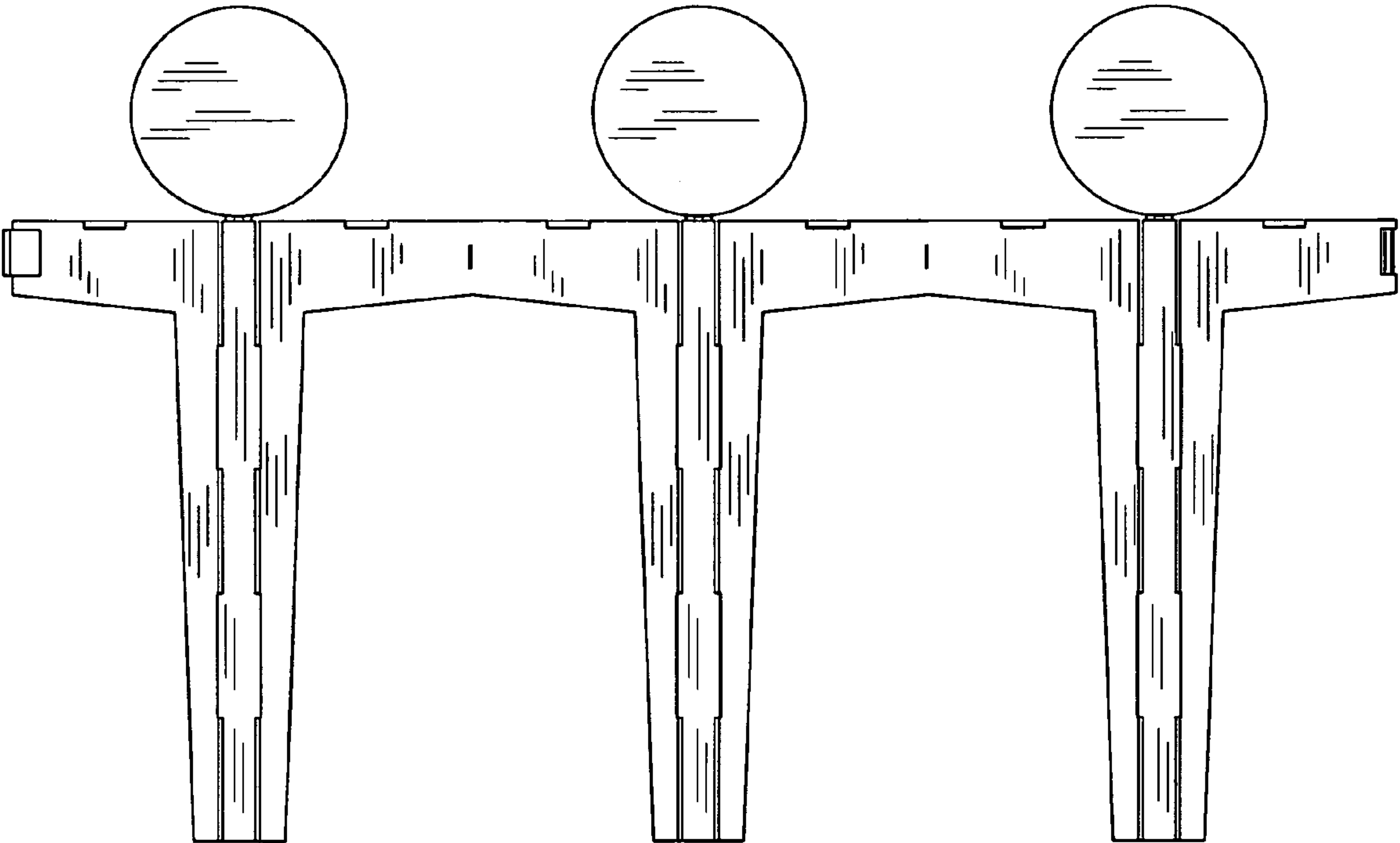
