FIG. 9 is a bottom perspective view of an overcap brush showing my new design in a third embodiment;

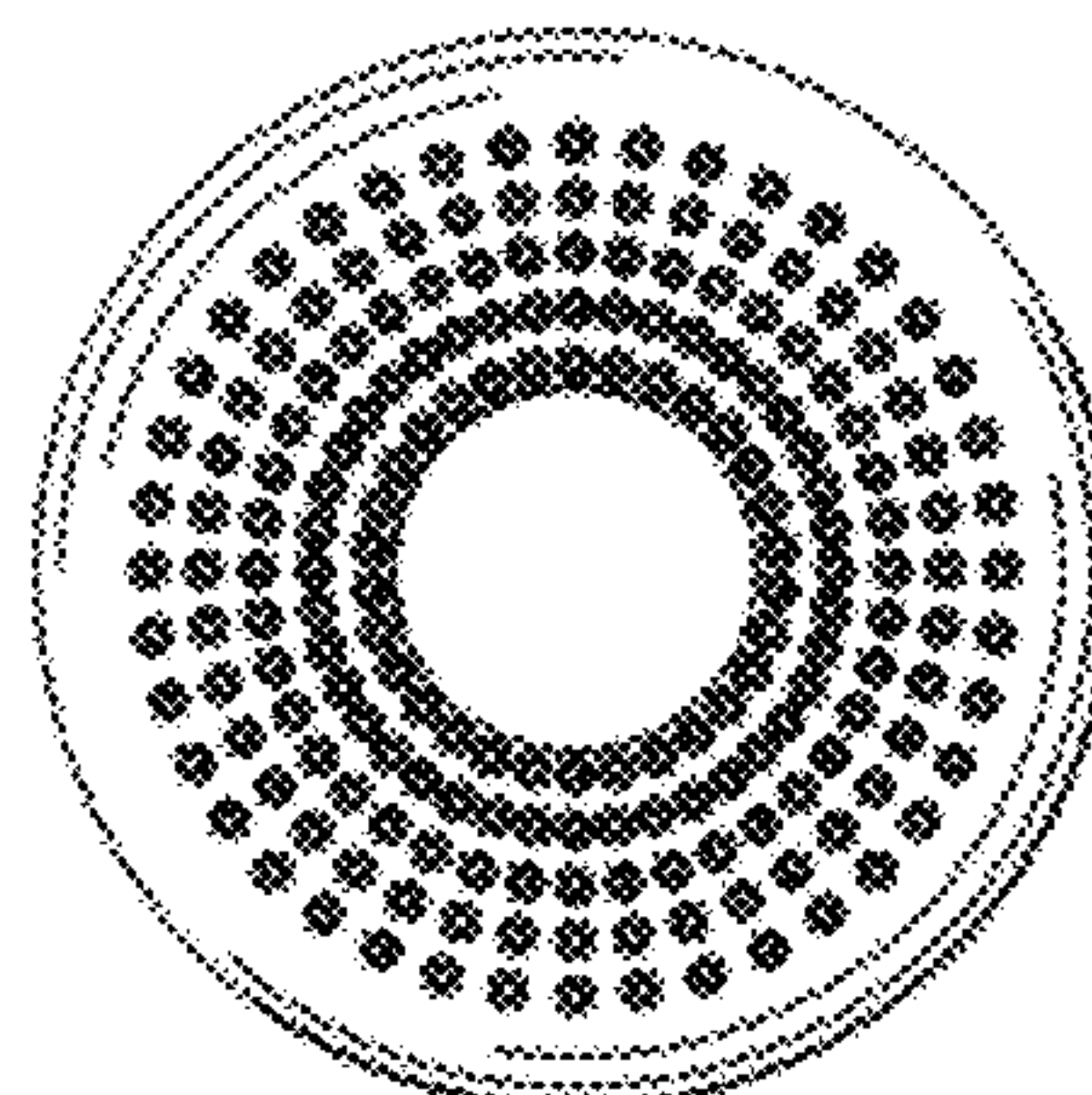
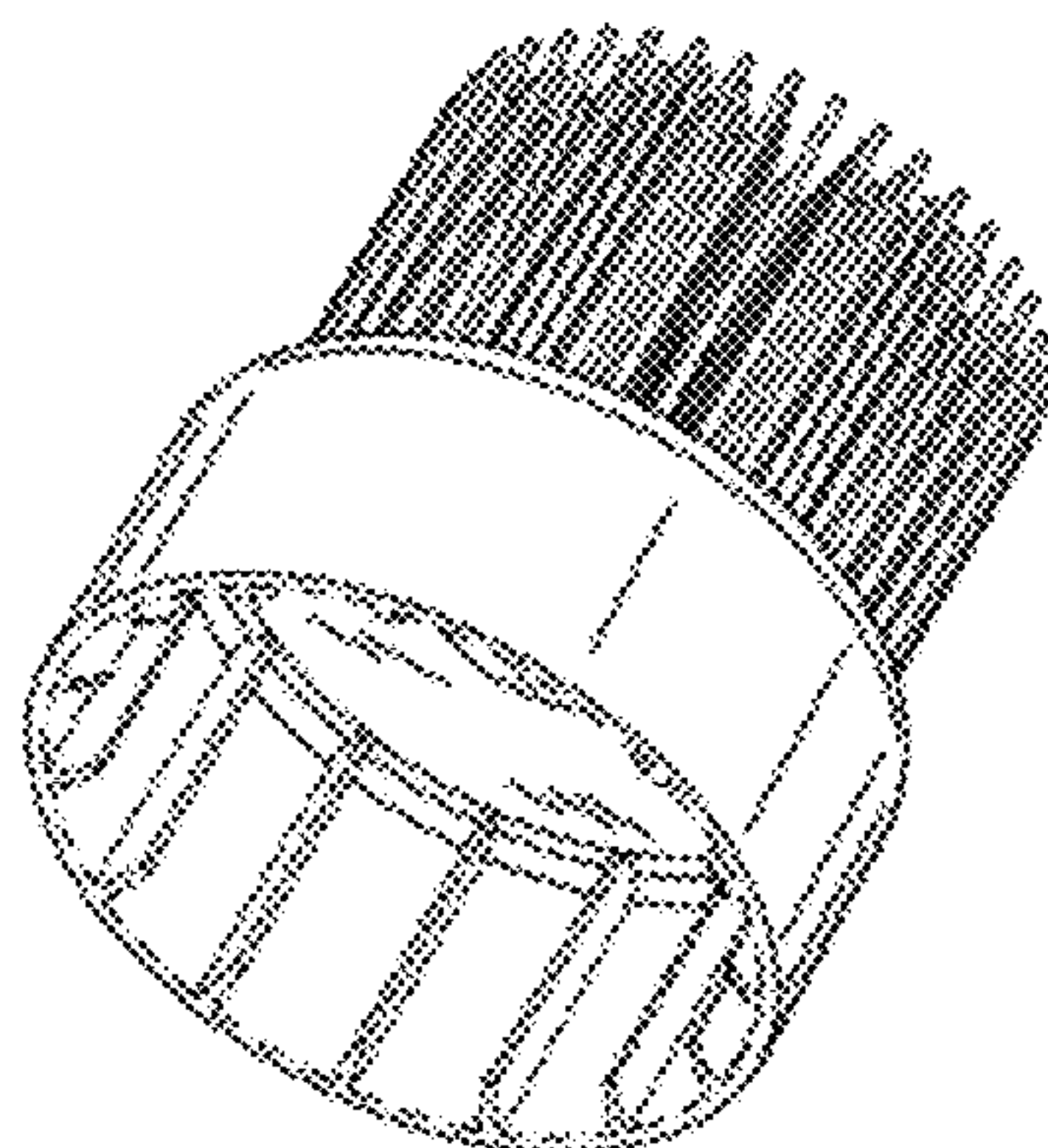
FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;

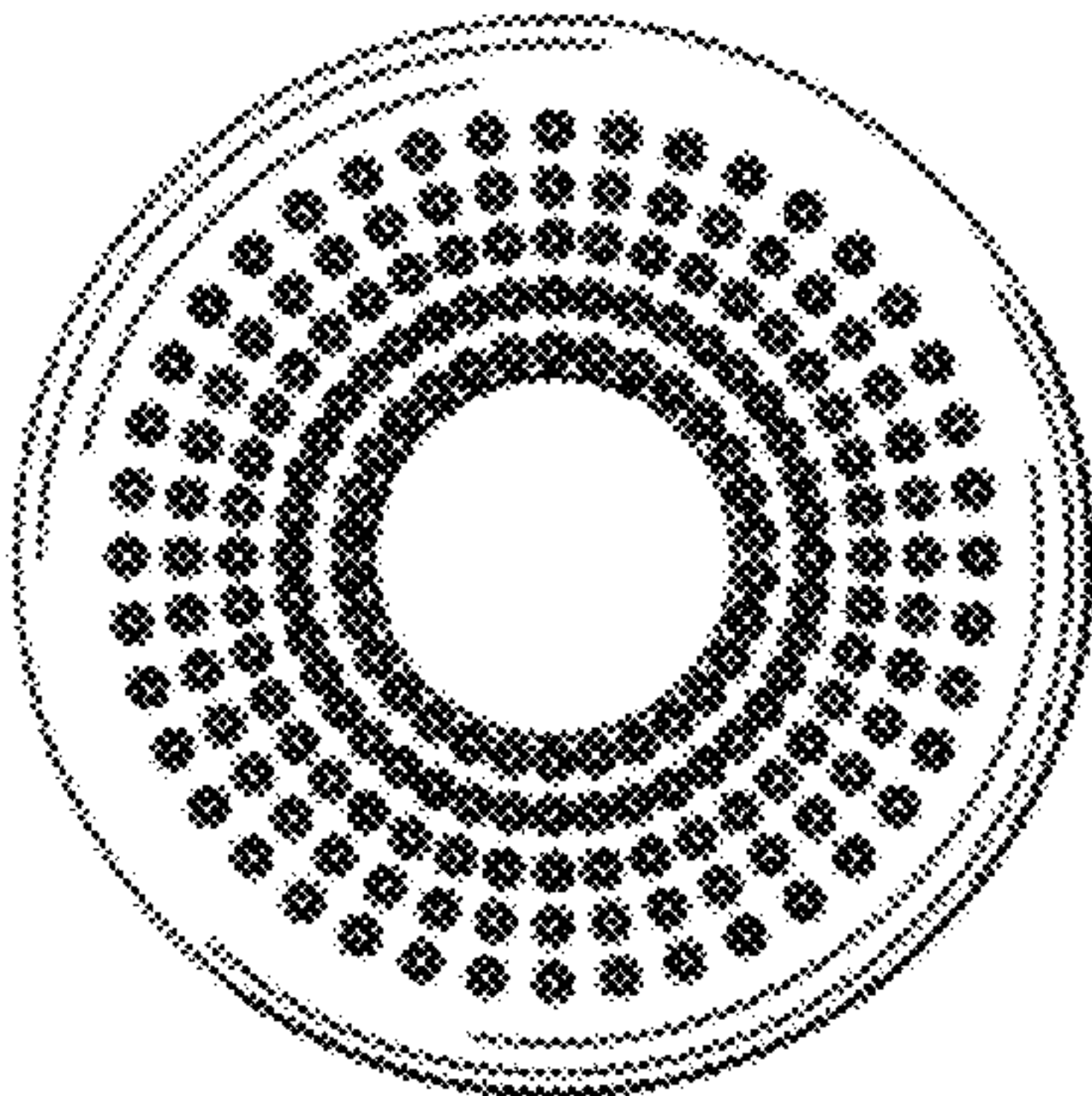
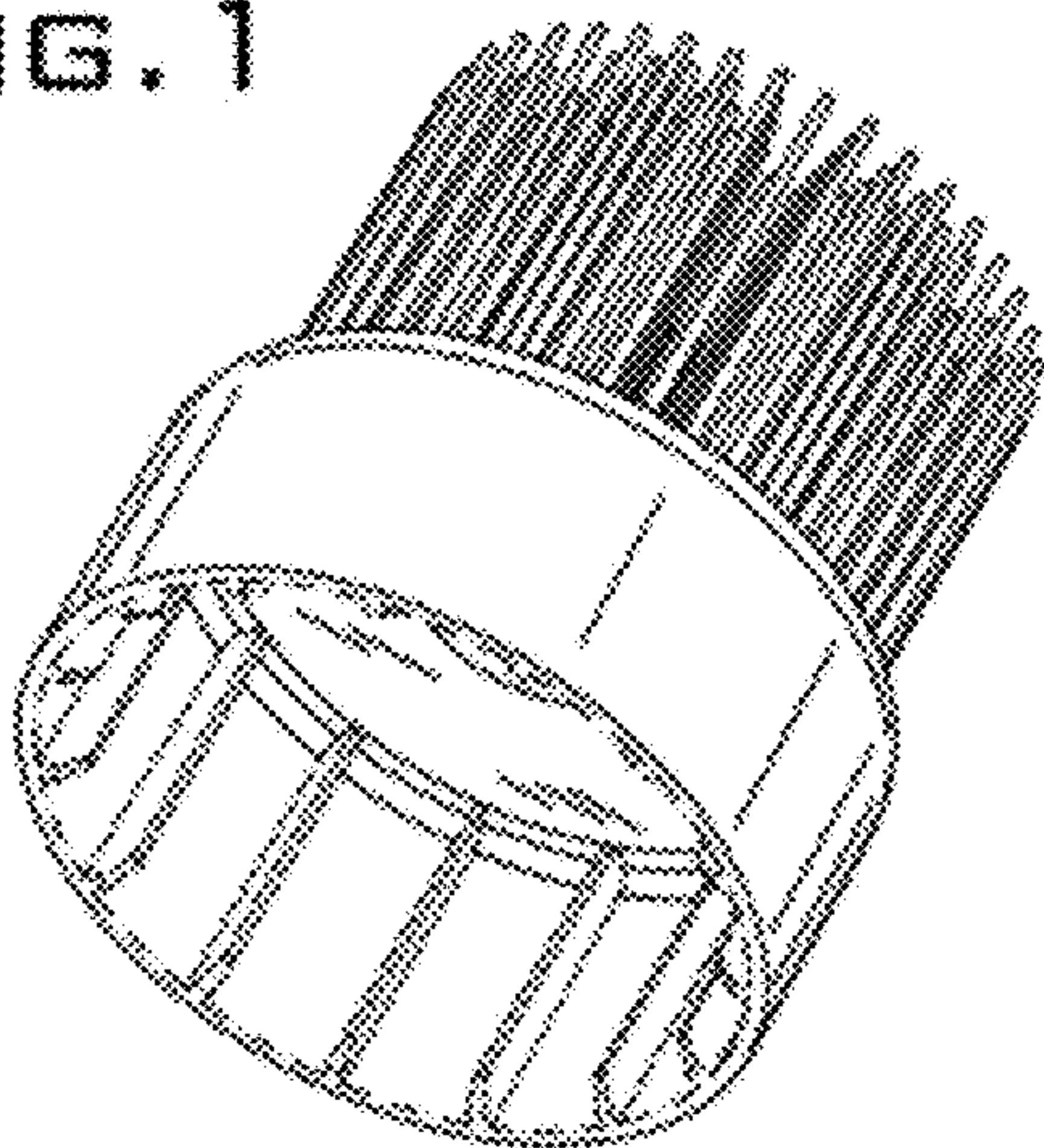

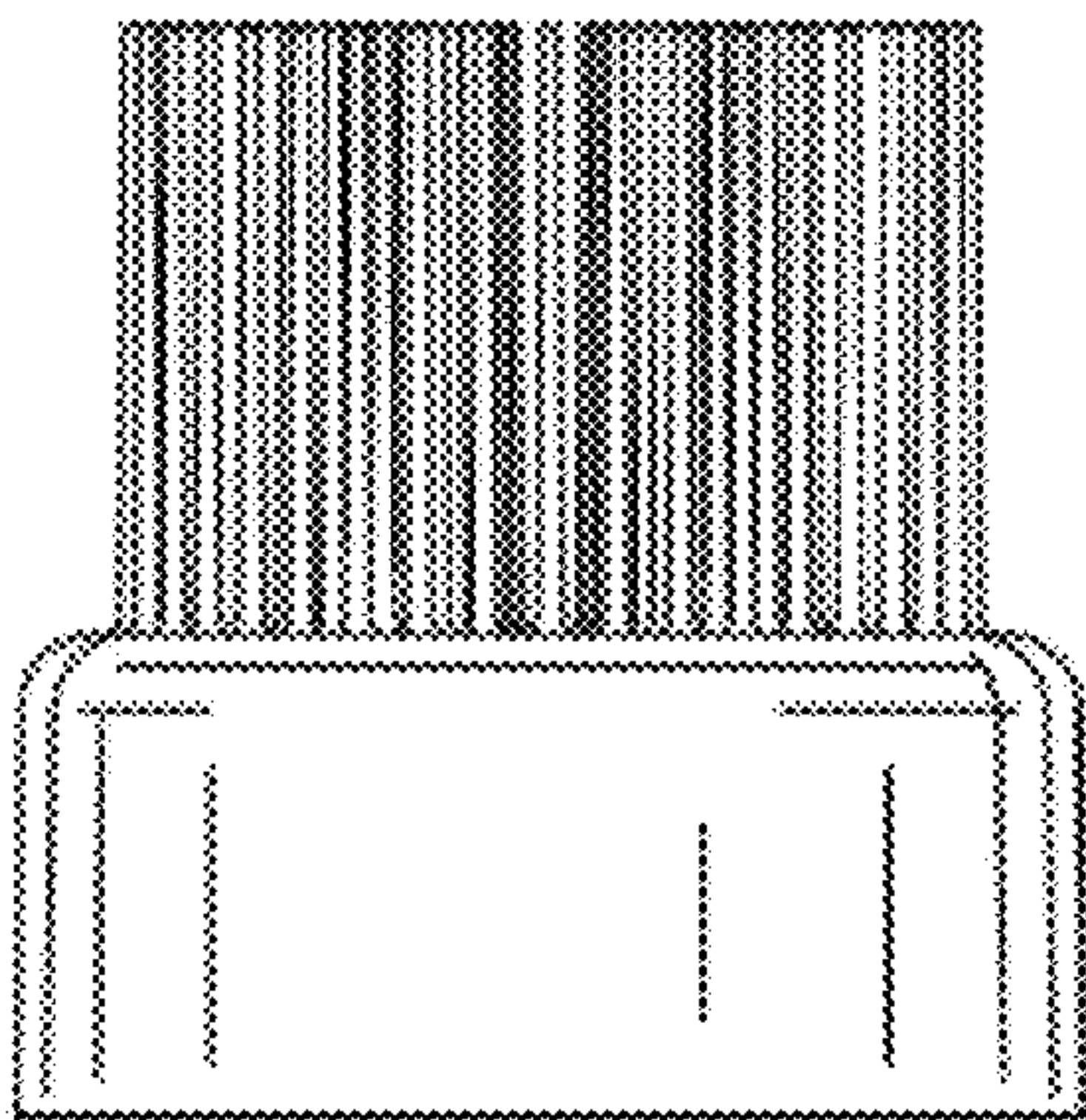

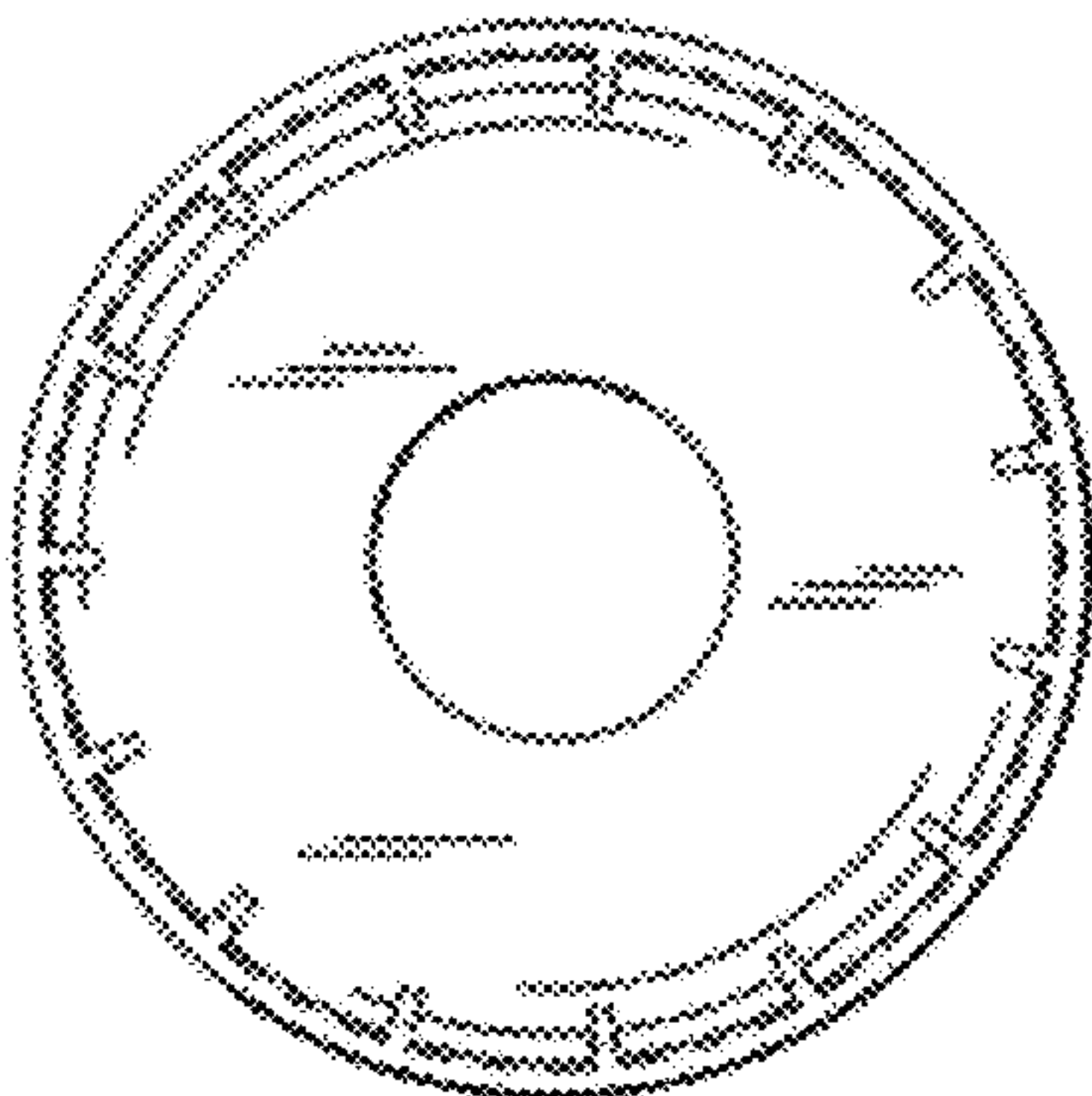

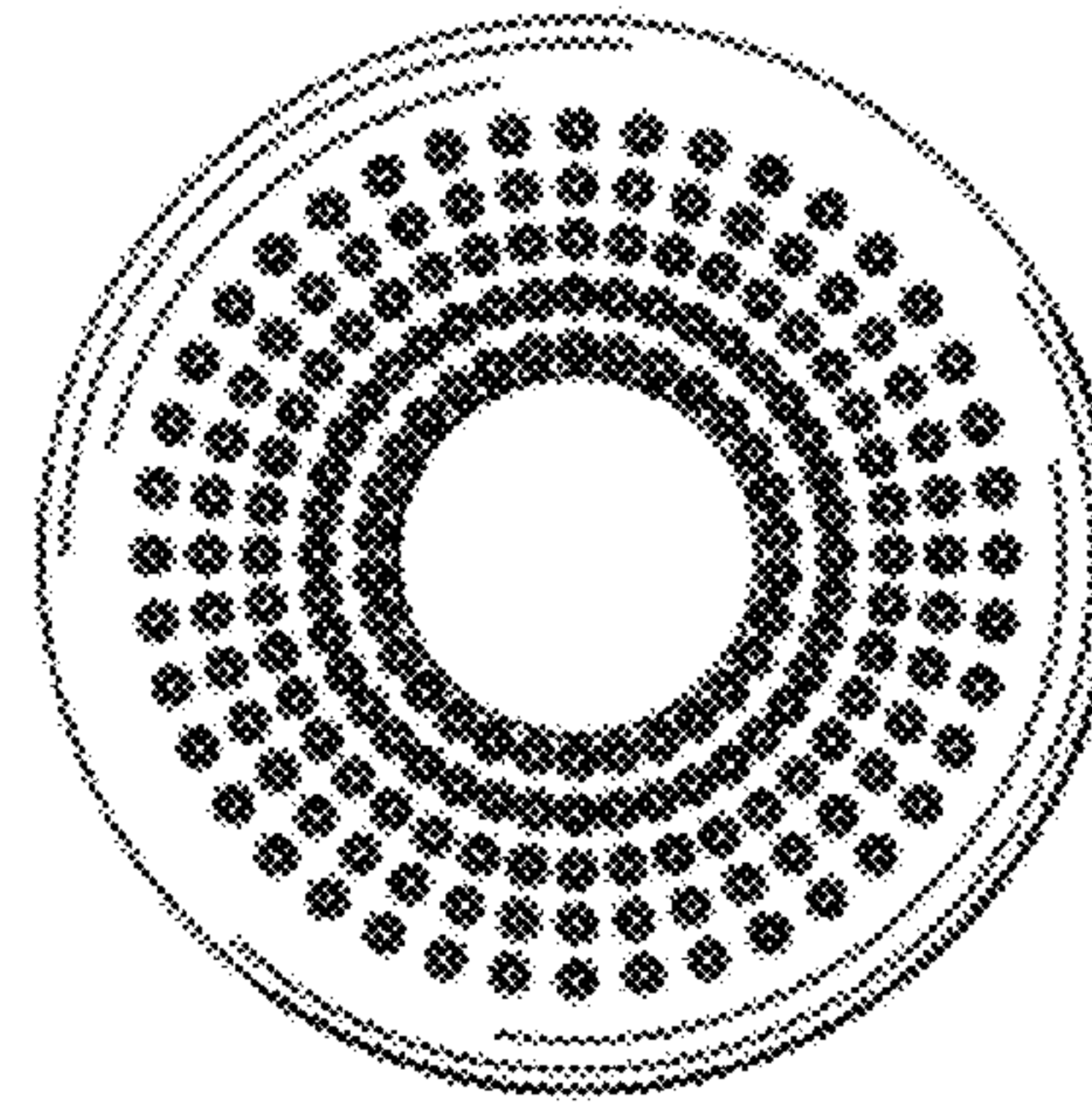
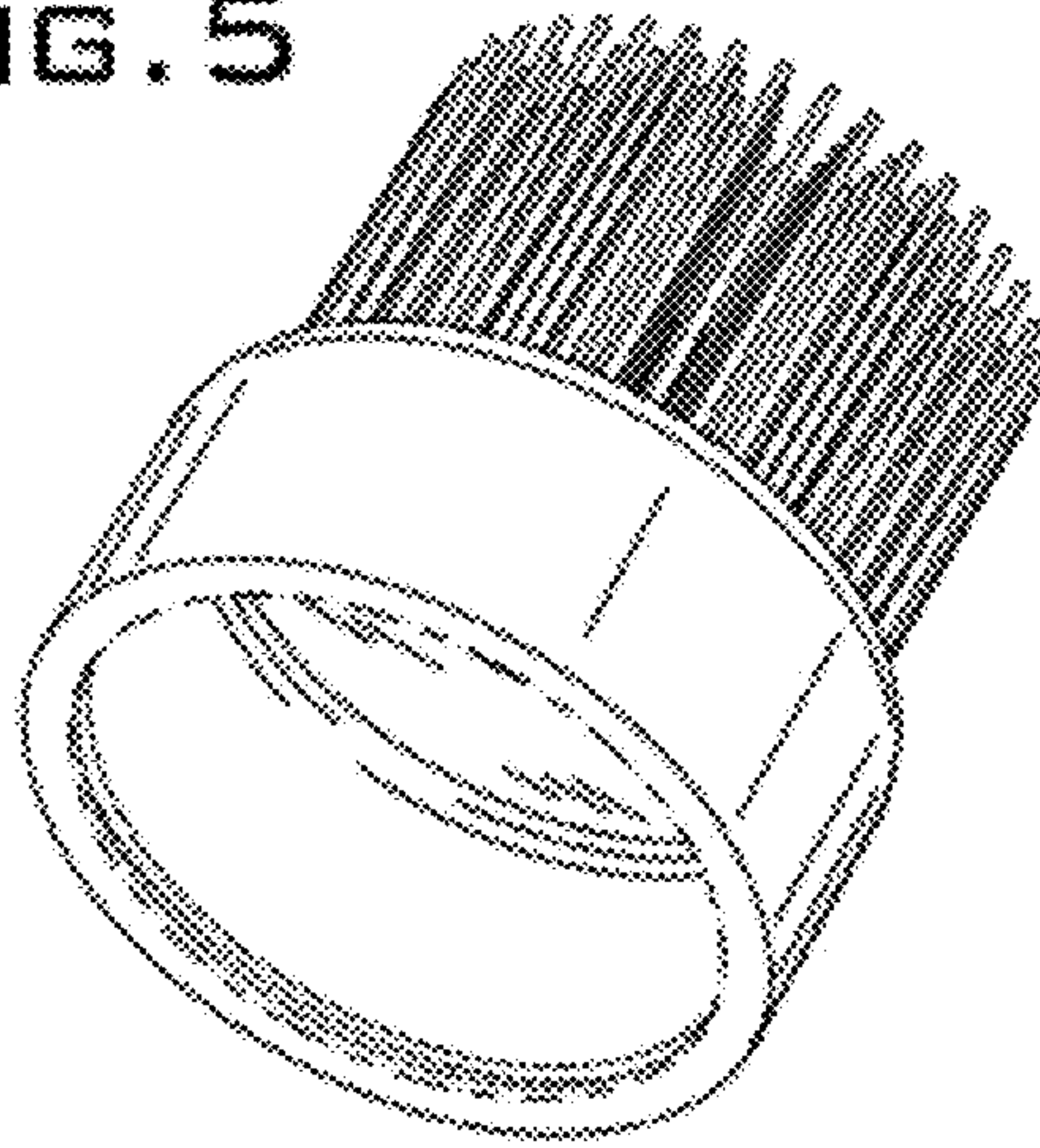

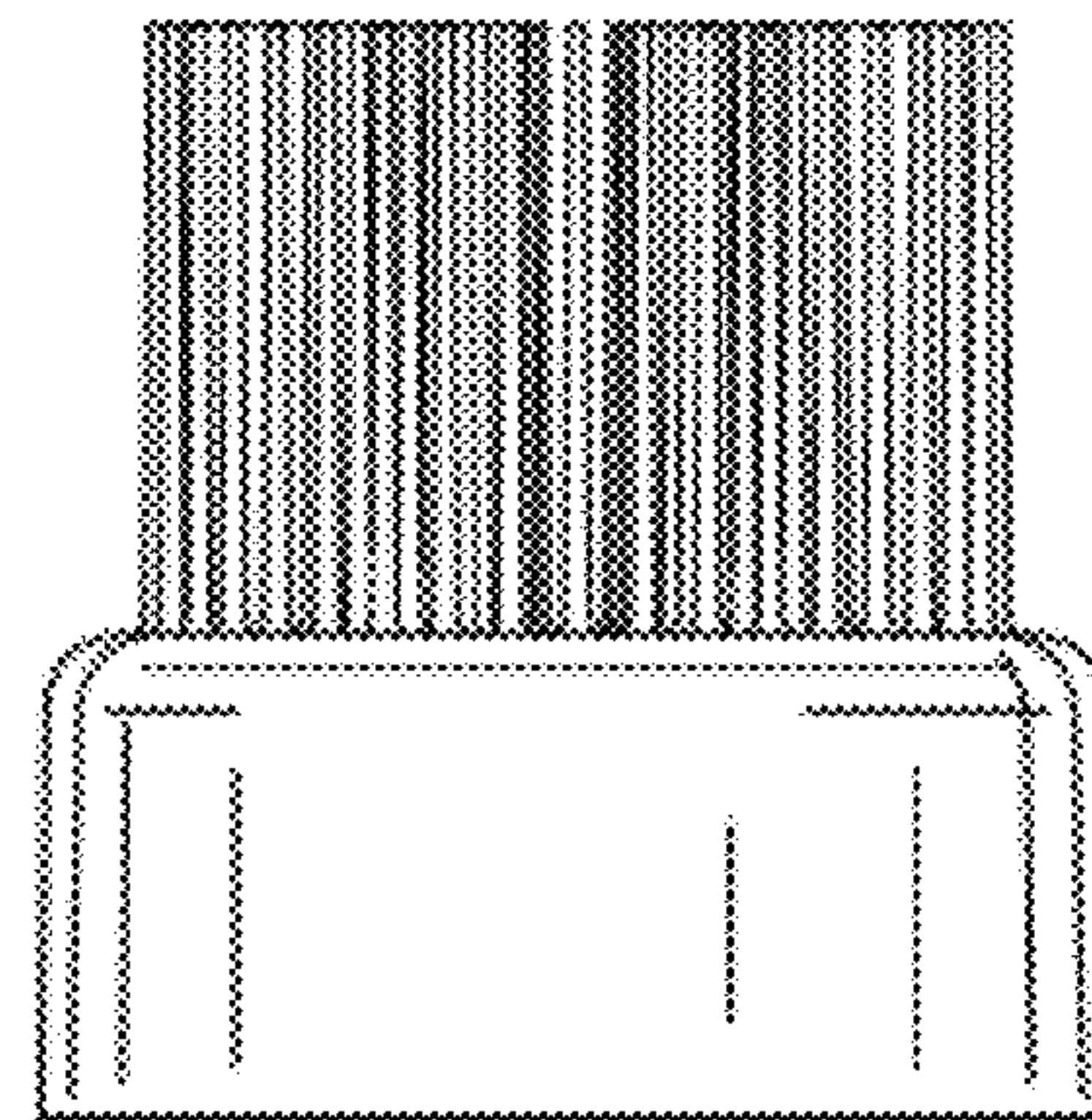

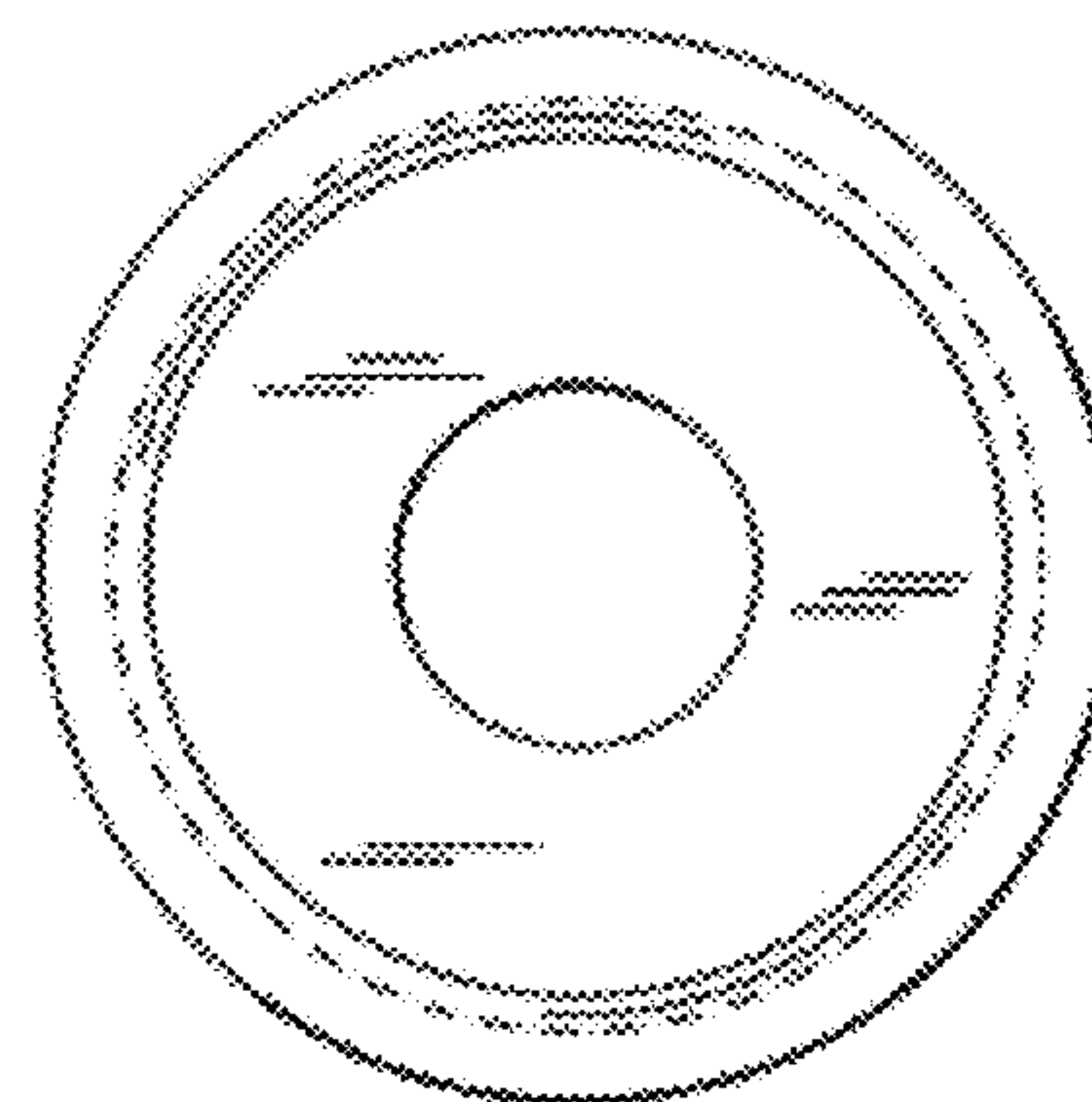

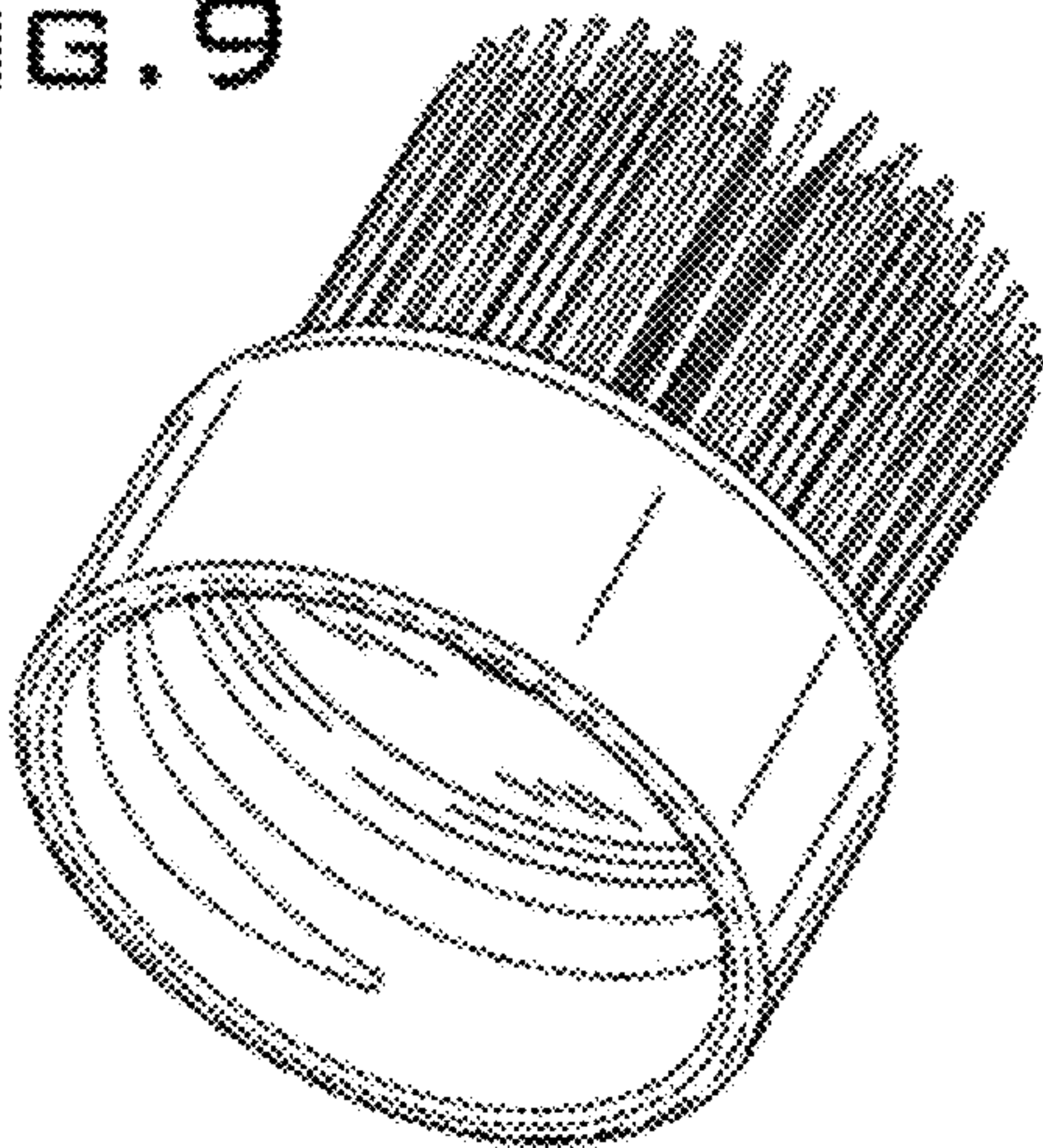

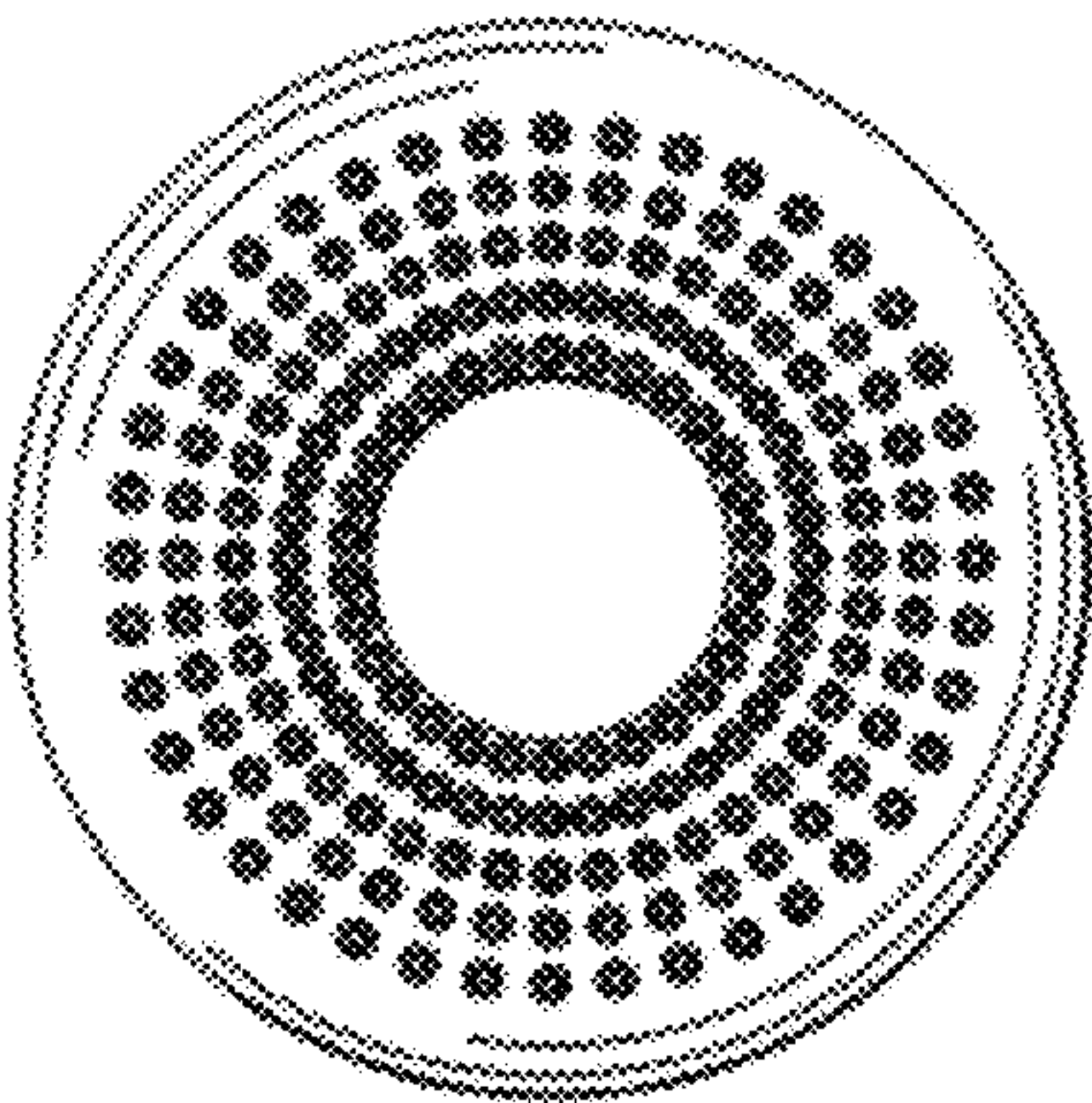

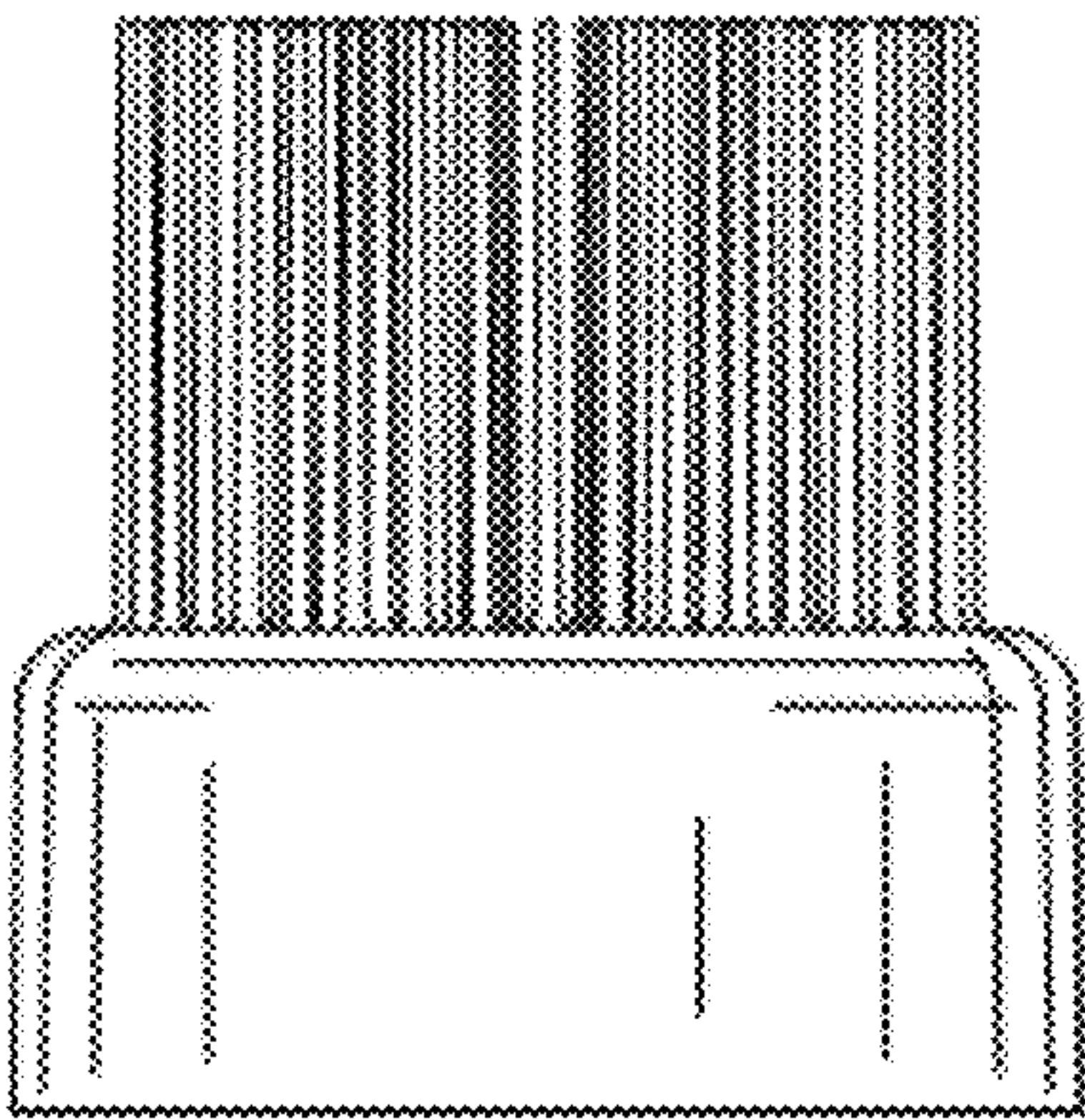
