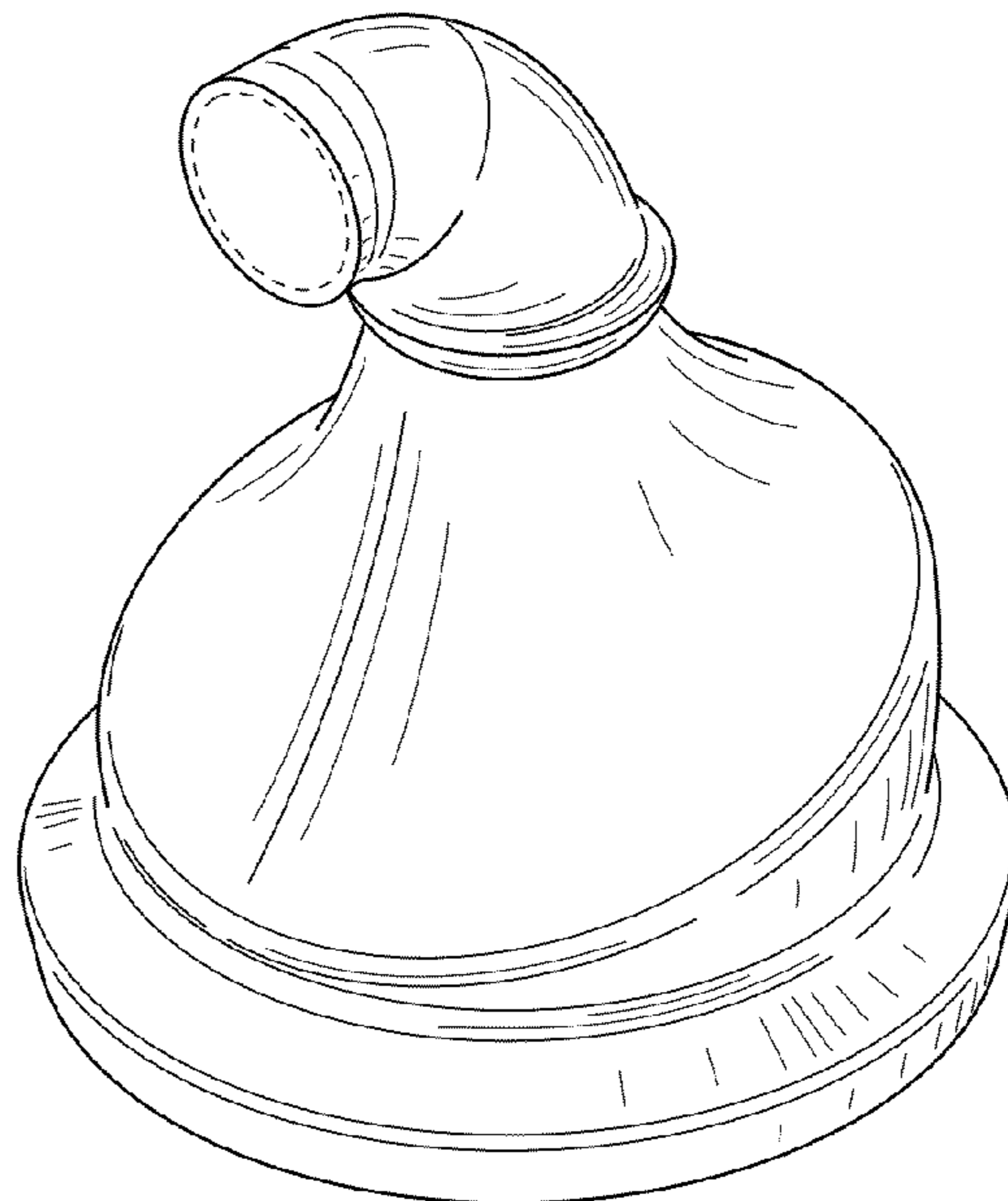
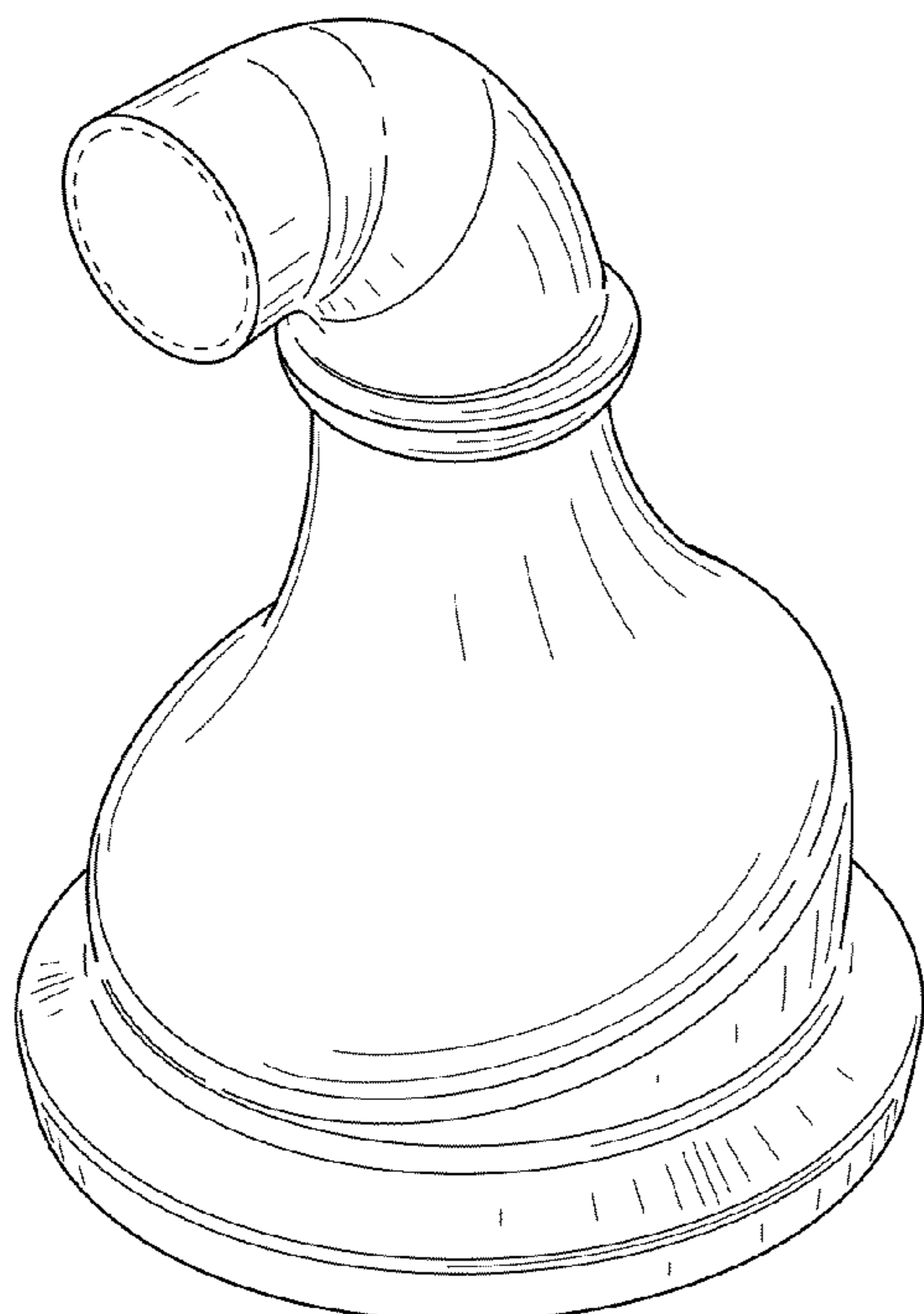

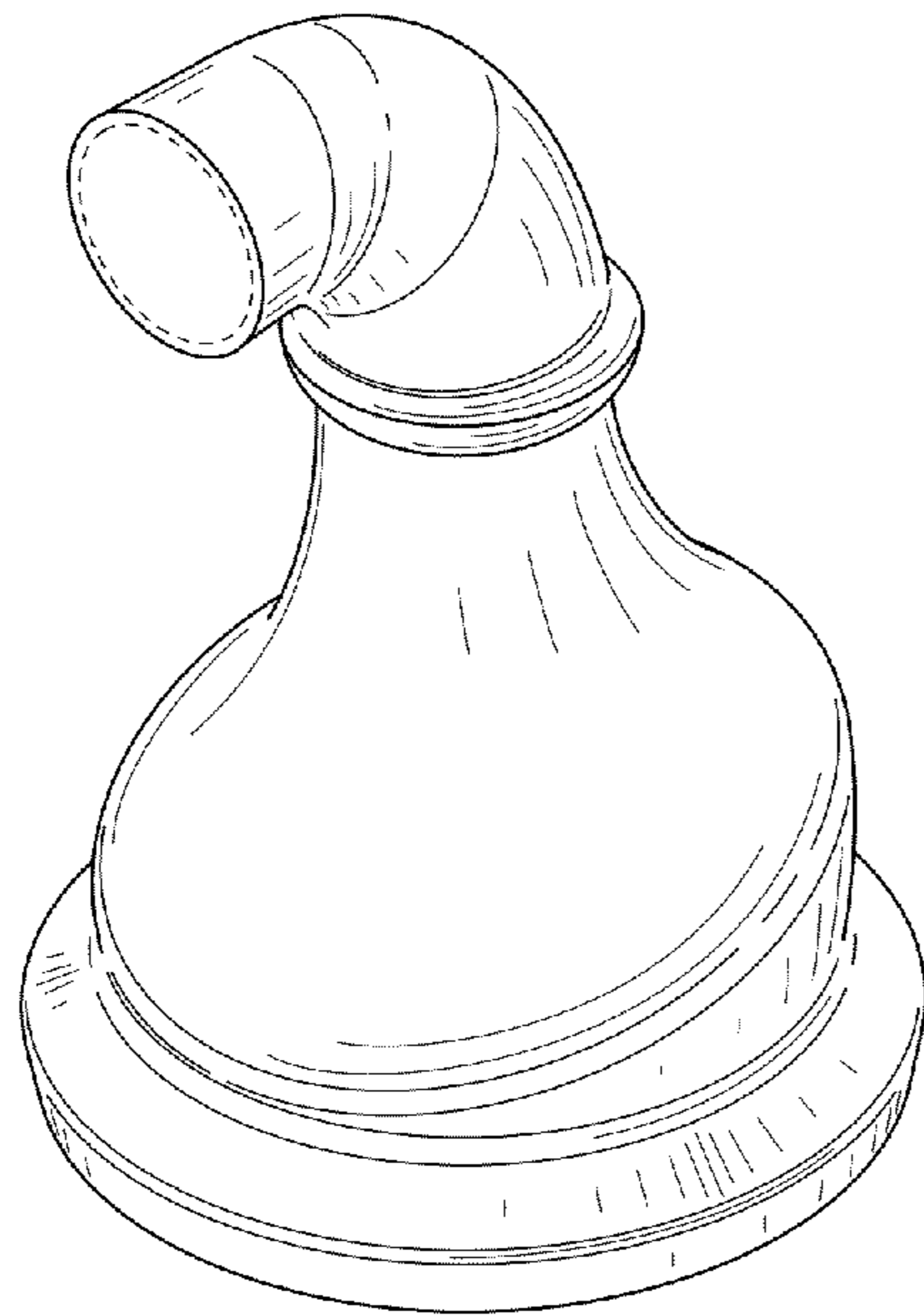
The ornamental design for a bath accessory post, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

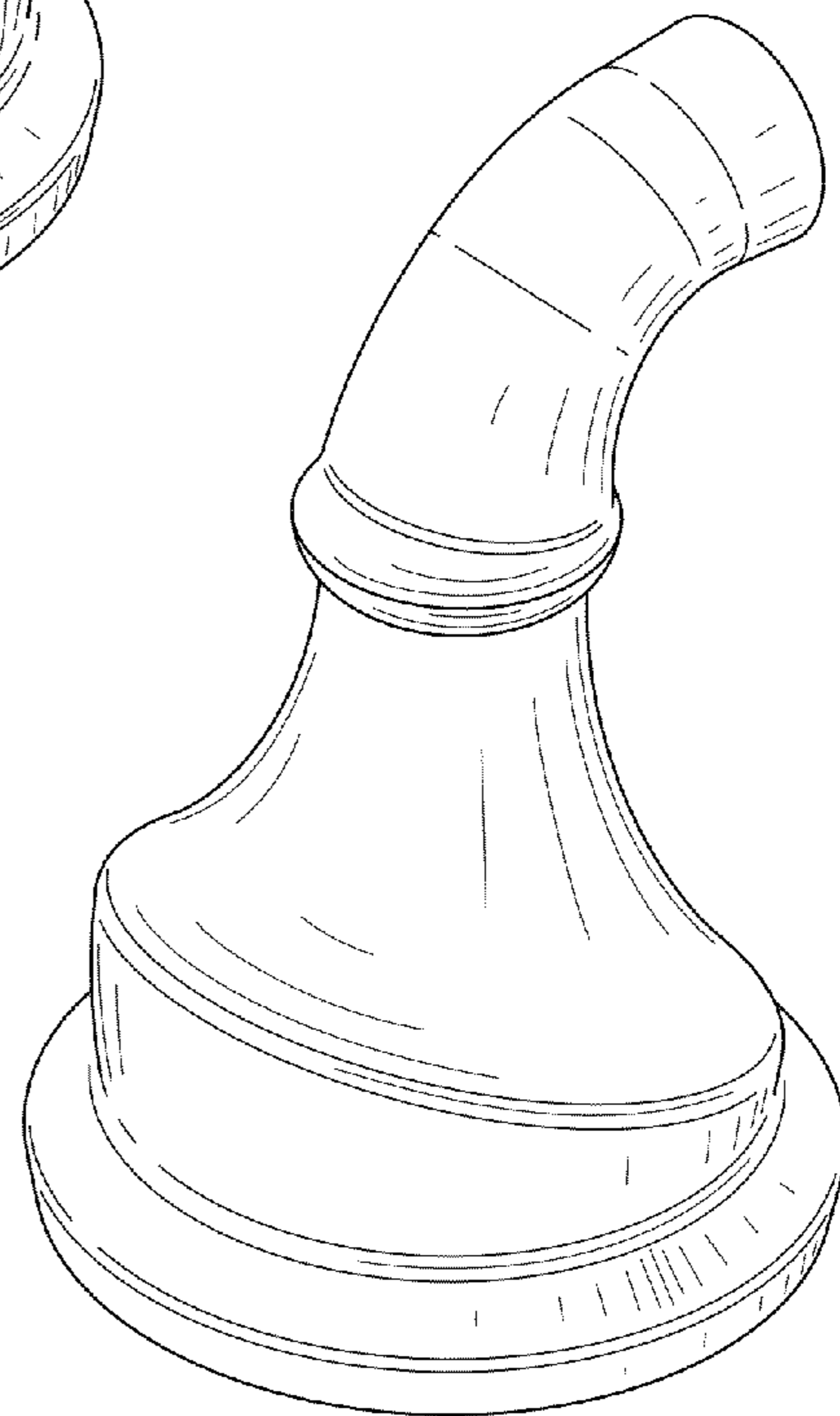

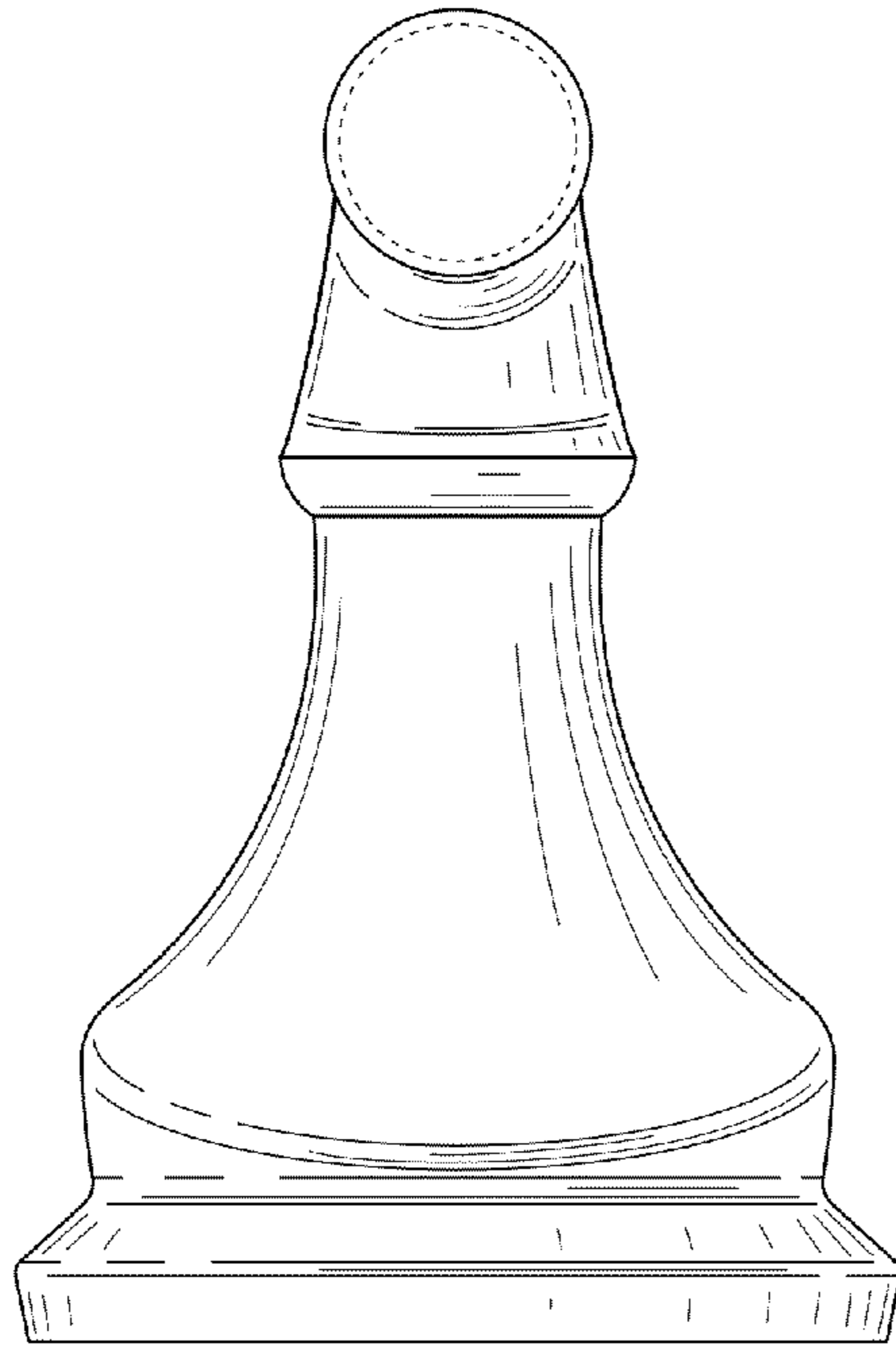

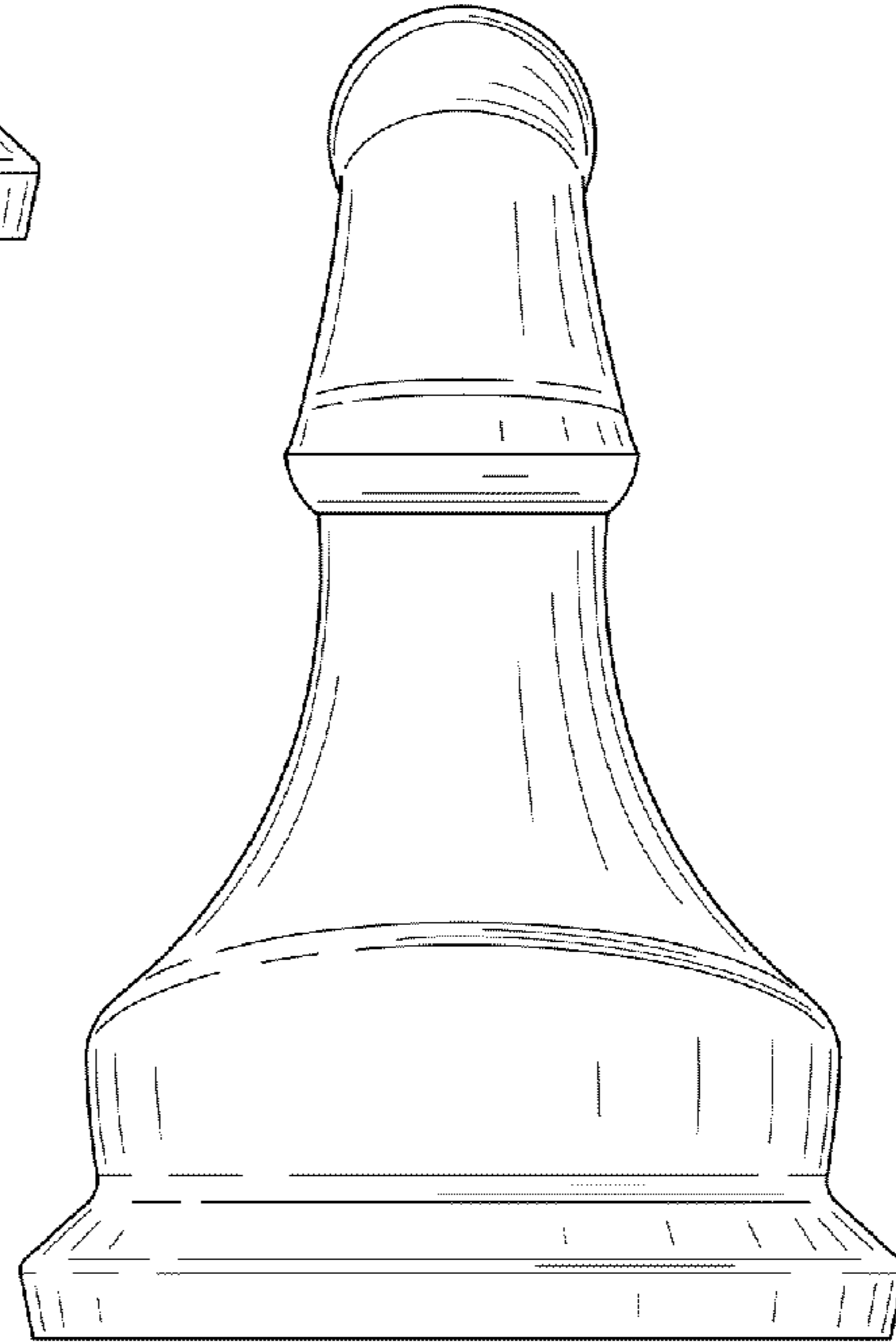

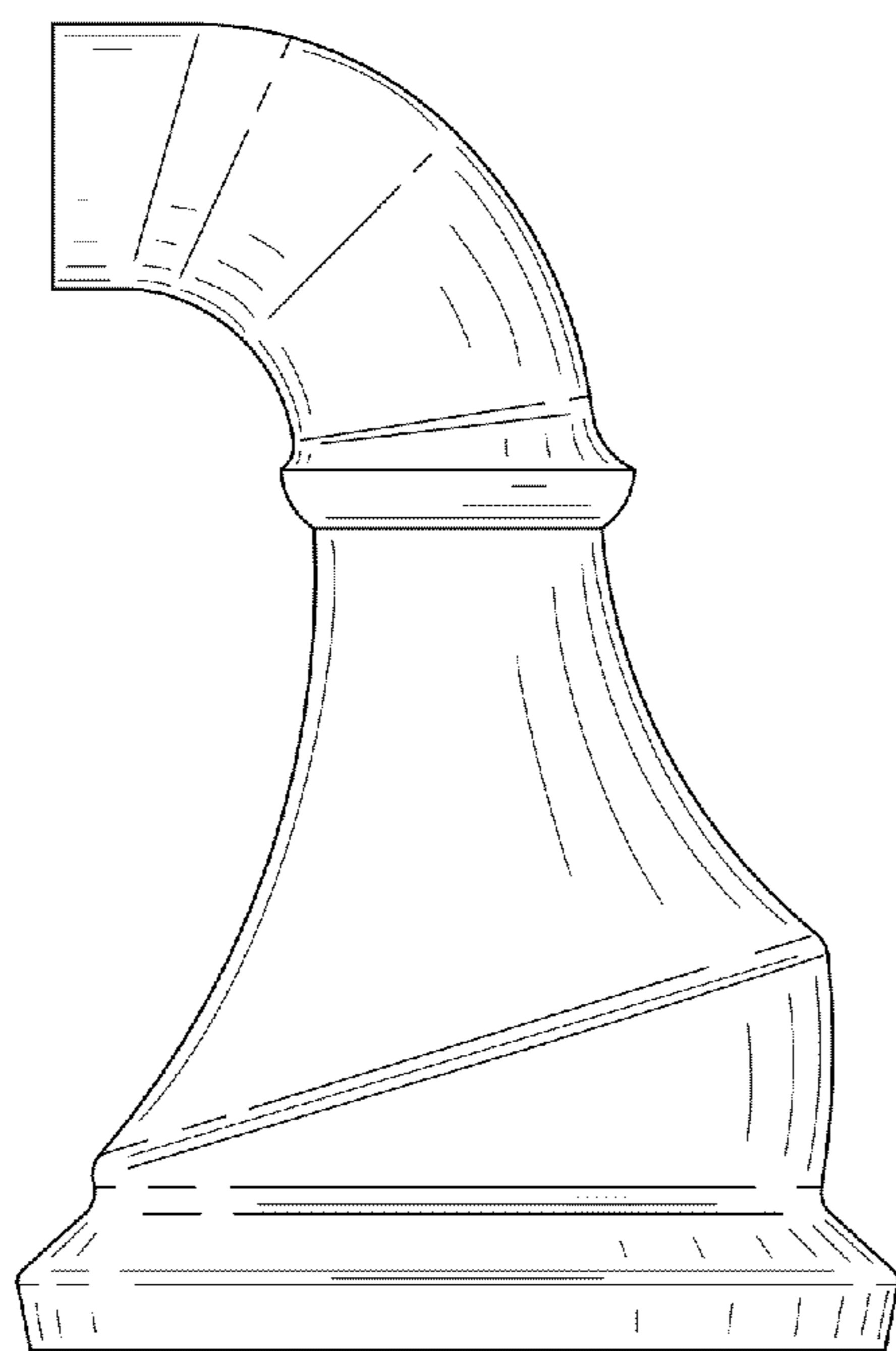

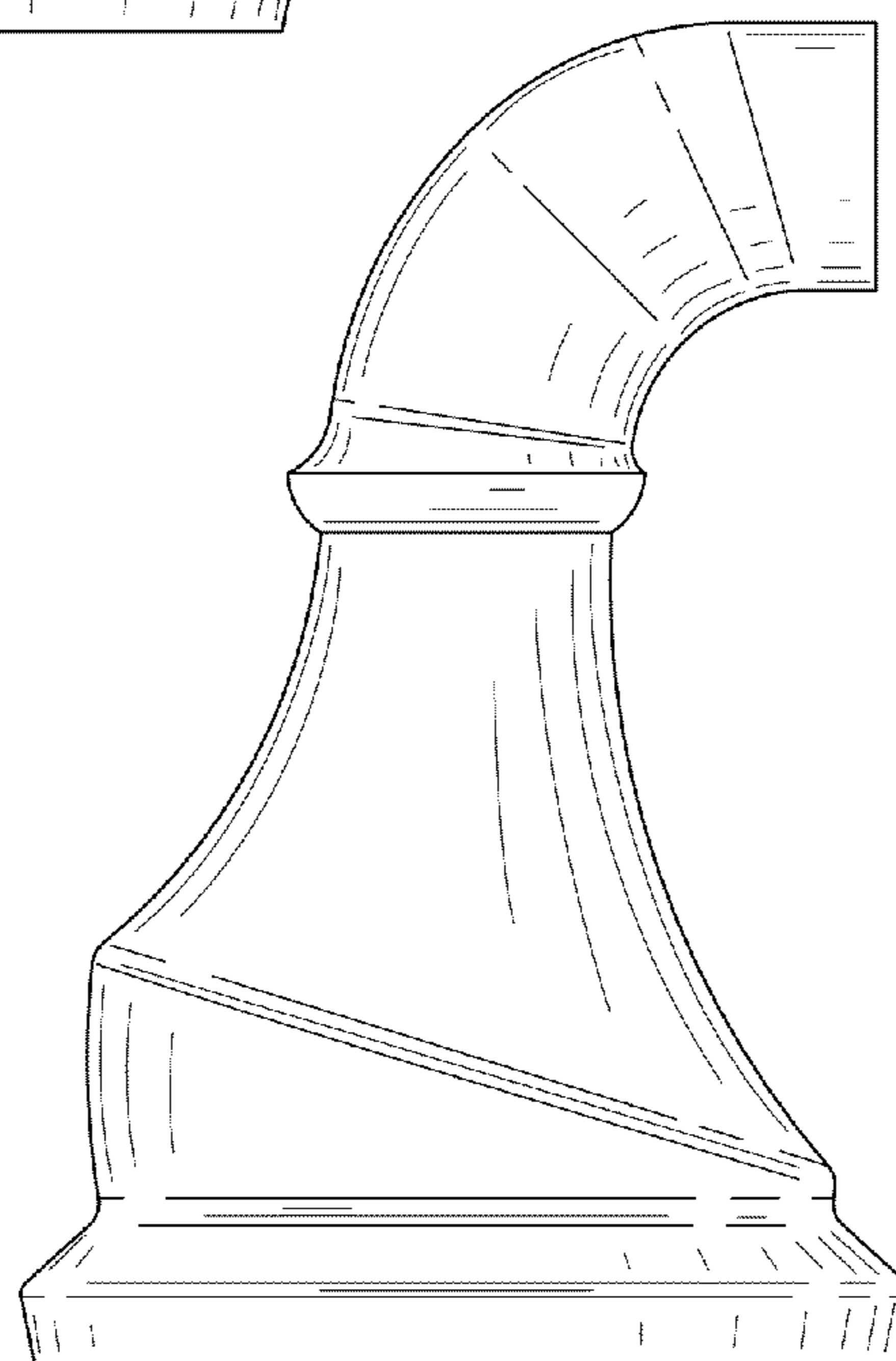

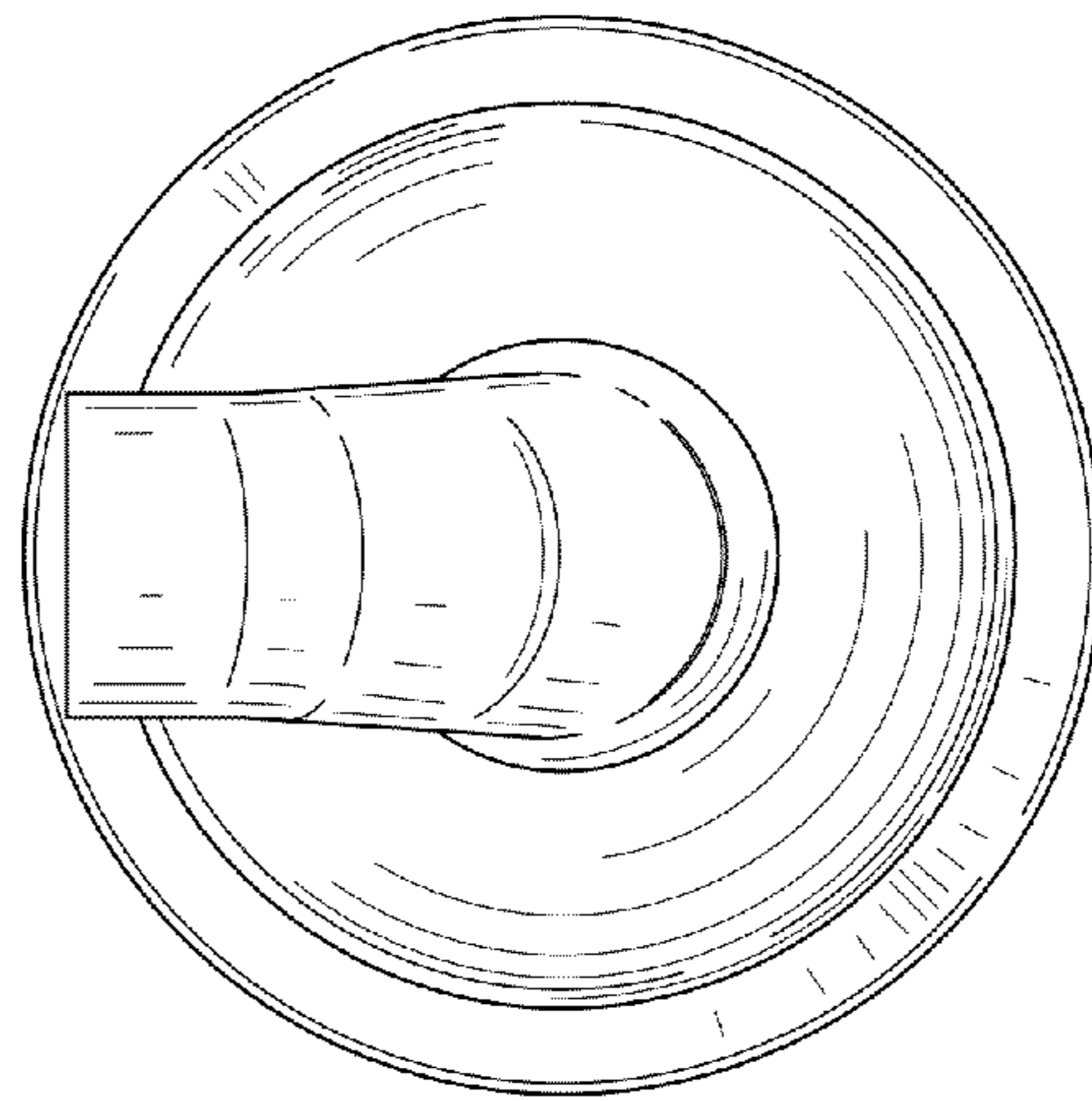

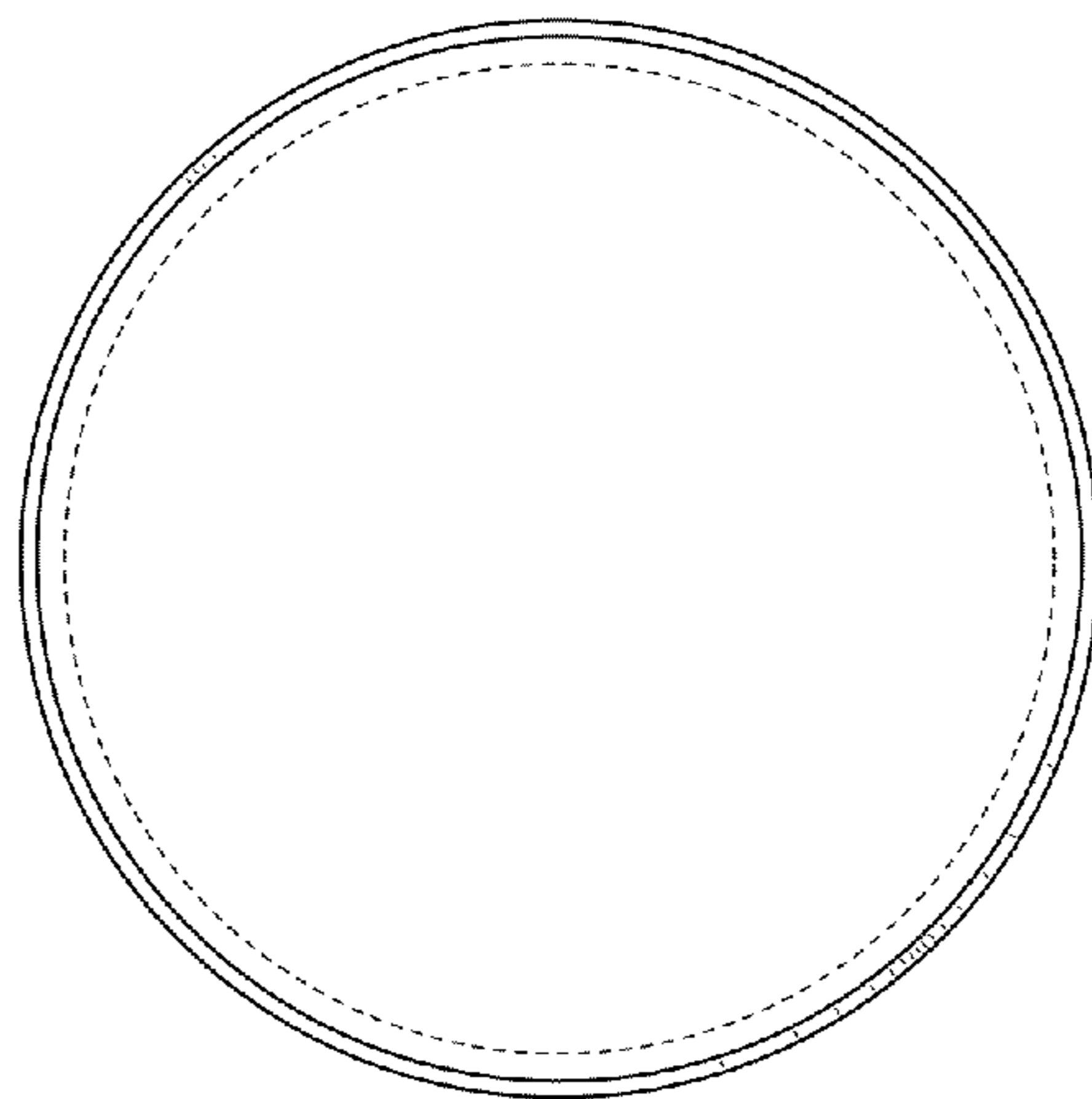

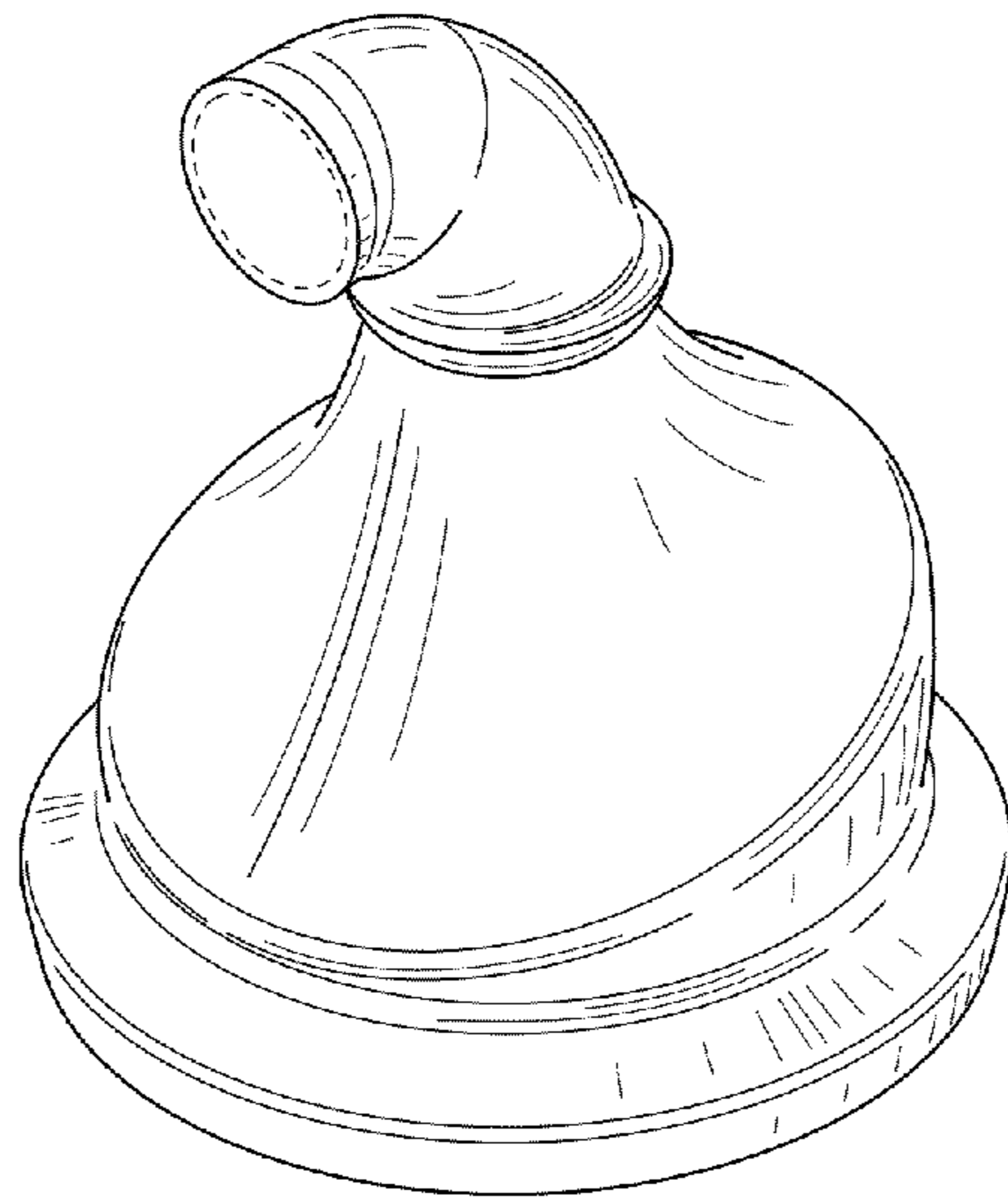
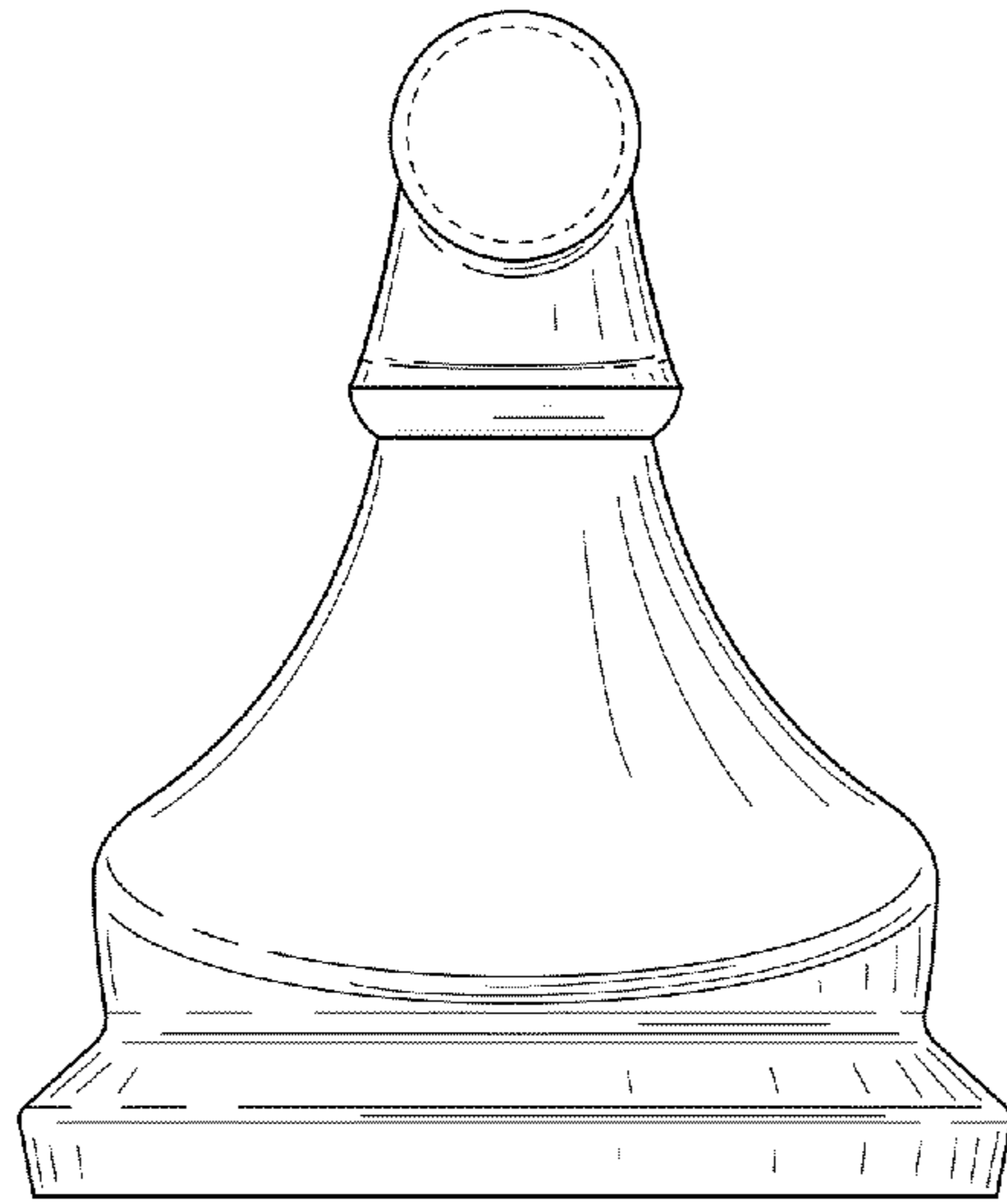


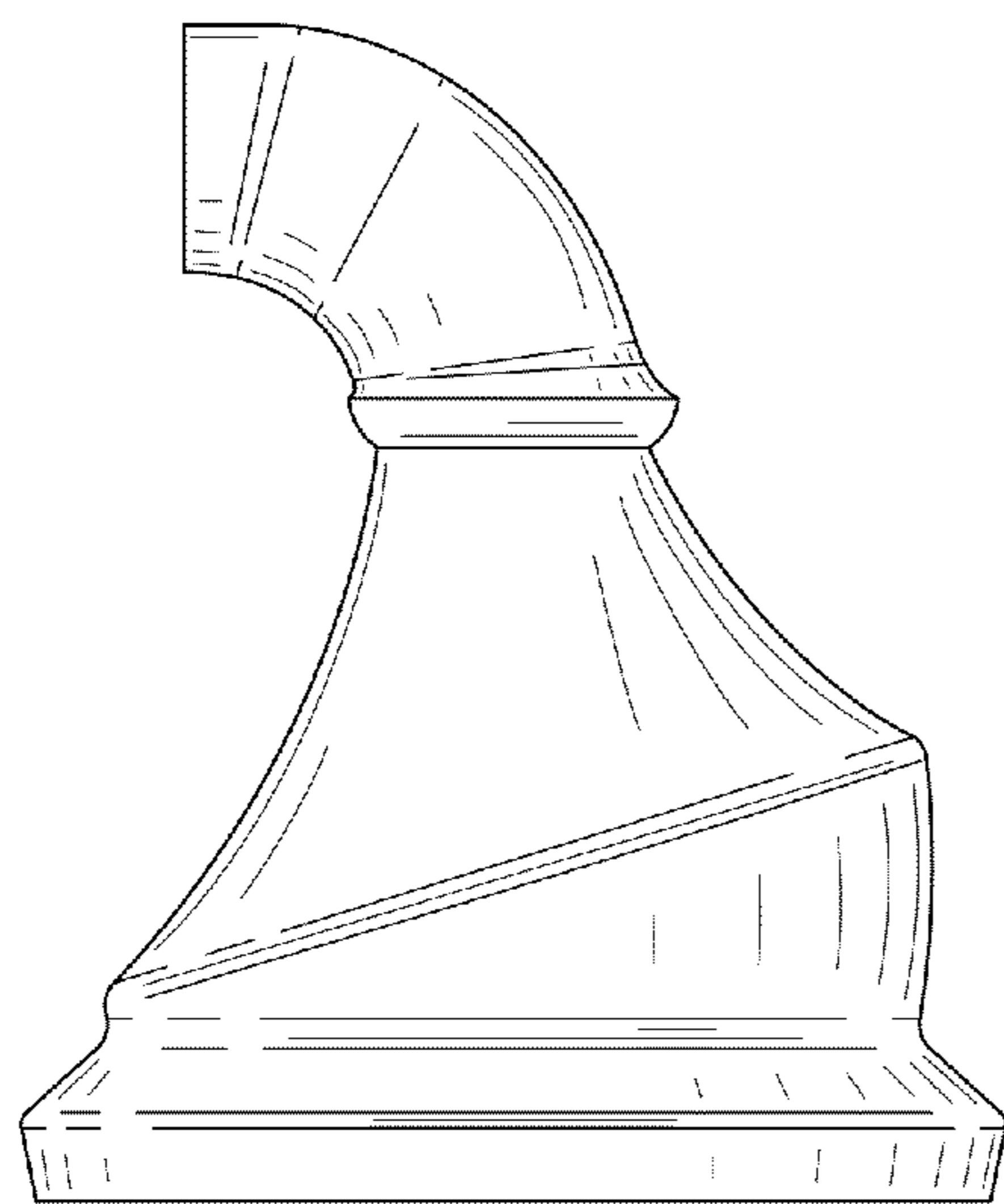

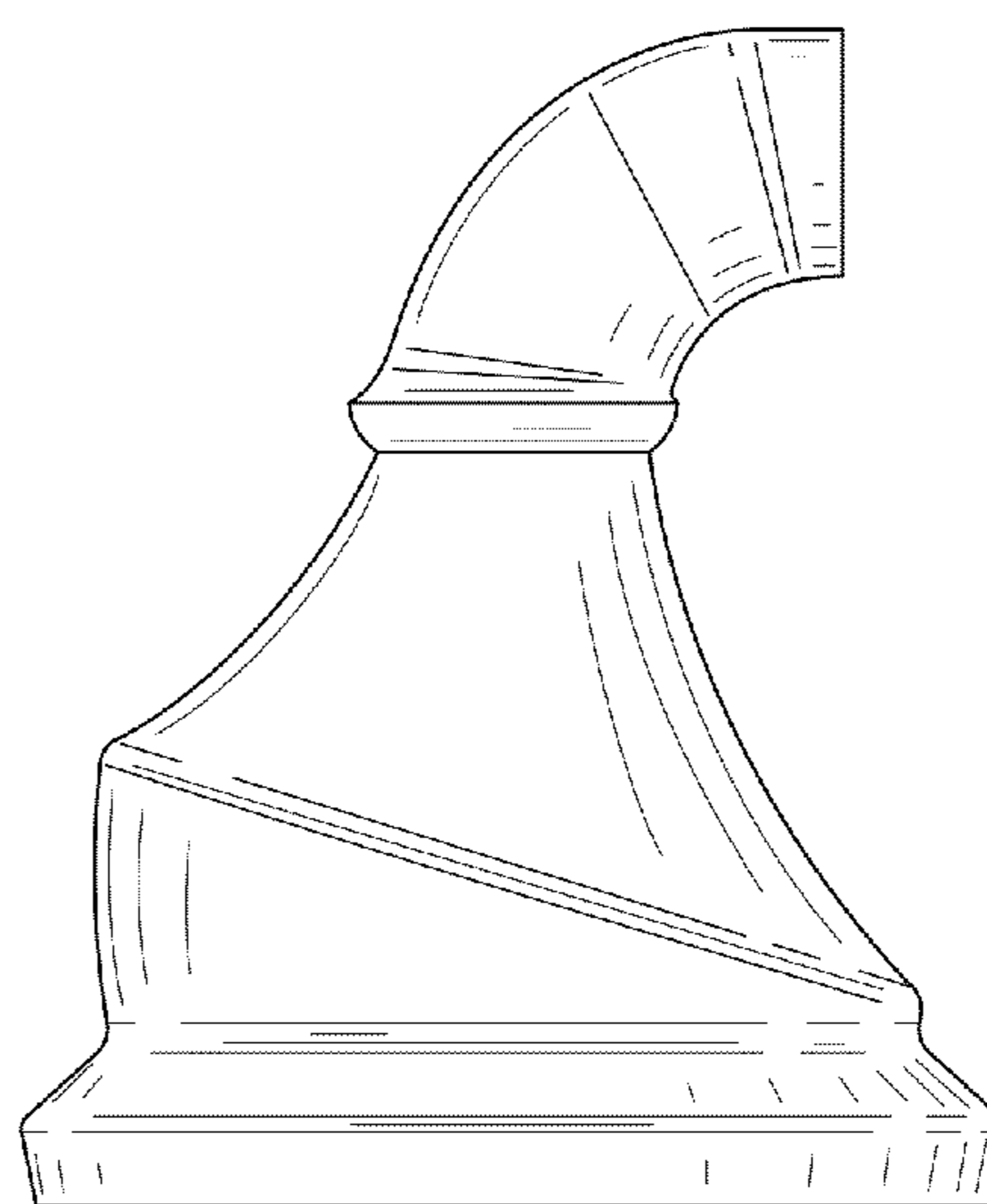

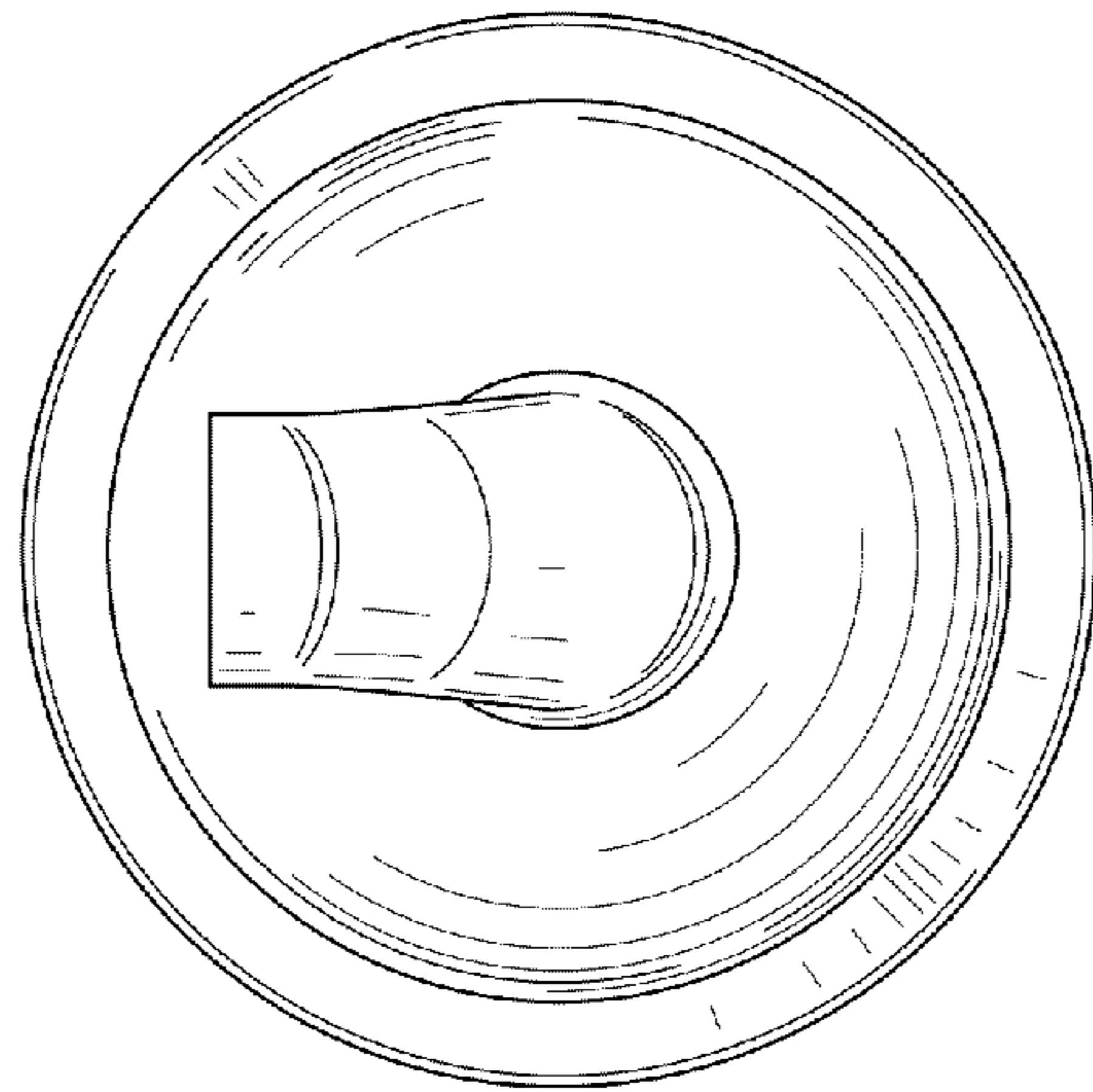

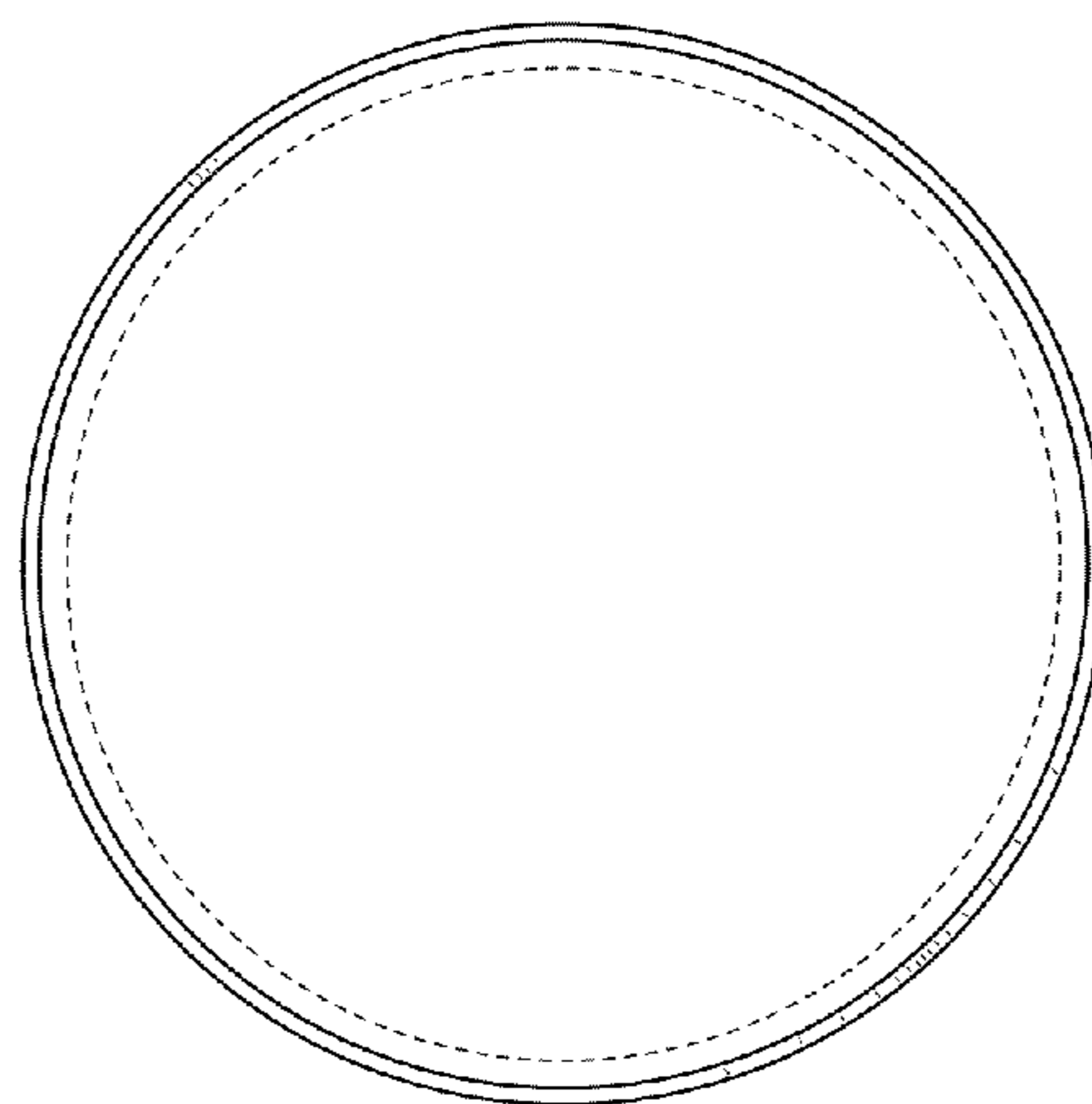
