ment of the vehicle door handle showing our new design;

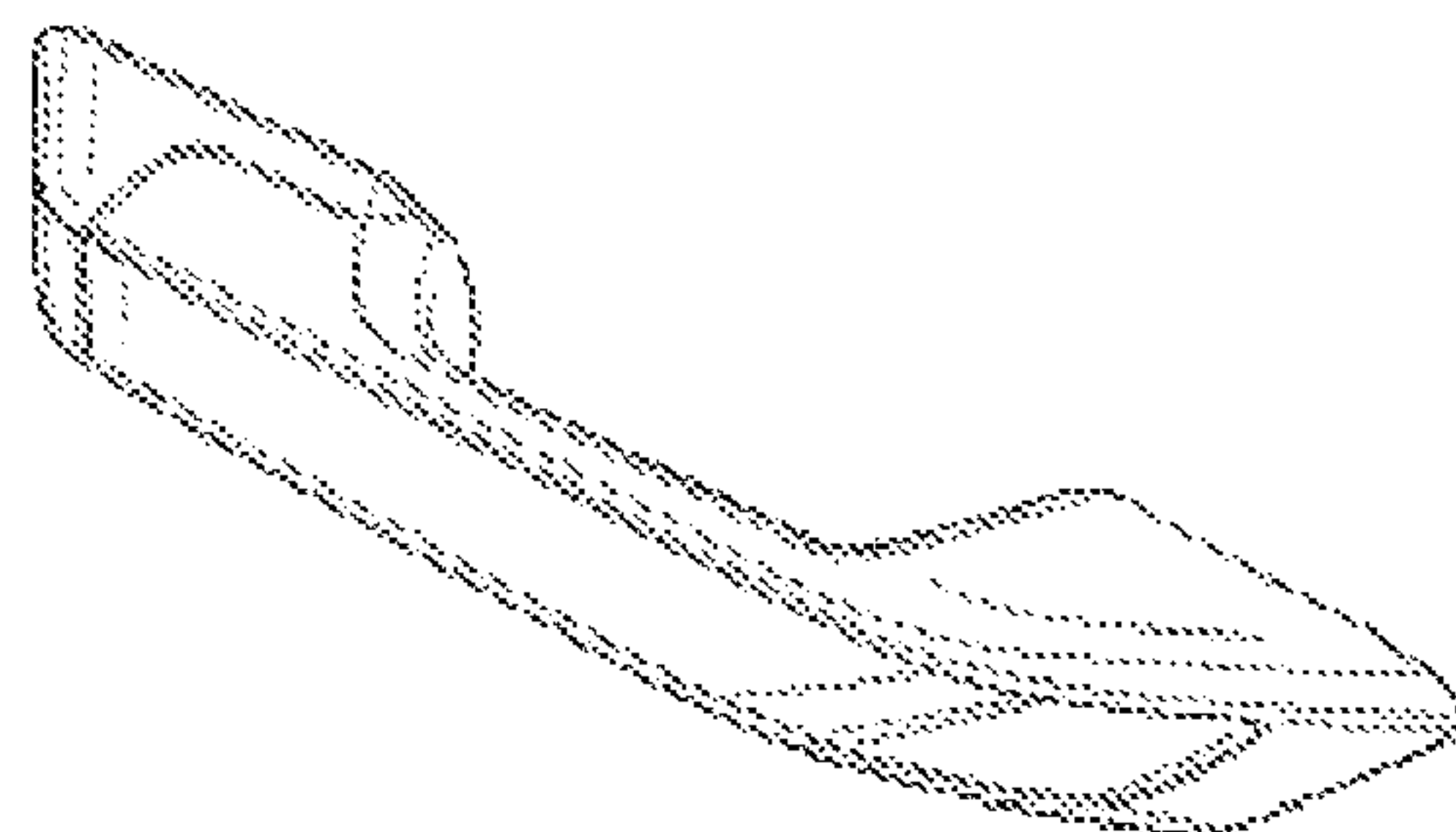
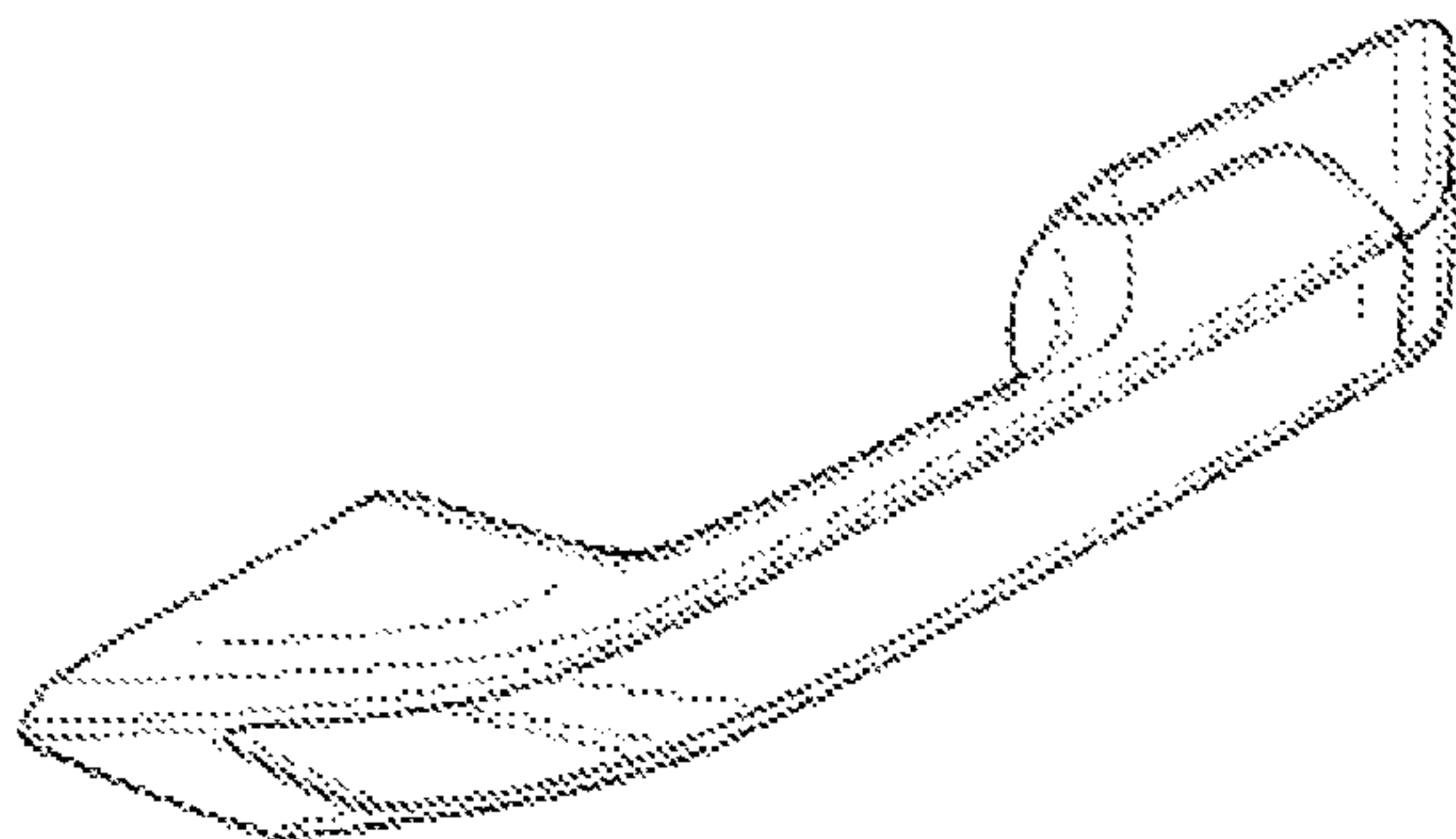
FIG. 7 is a perspective view depicted from the other side

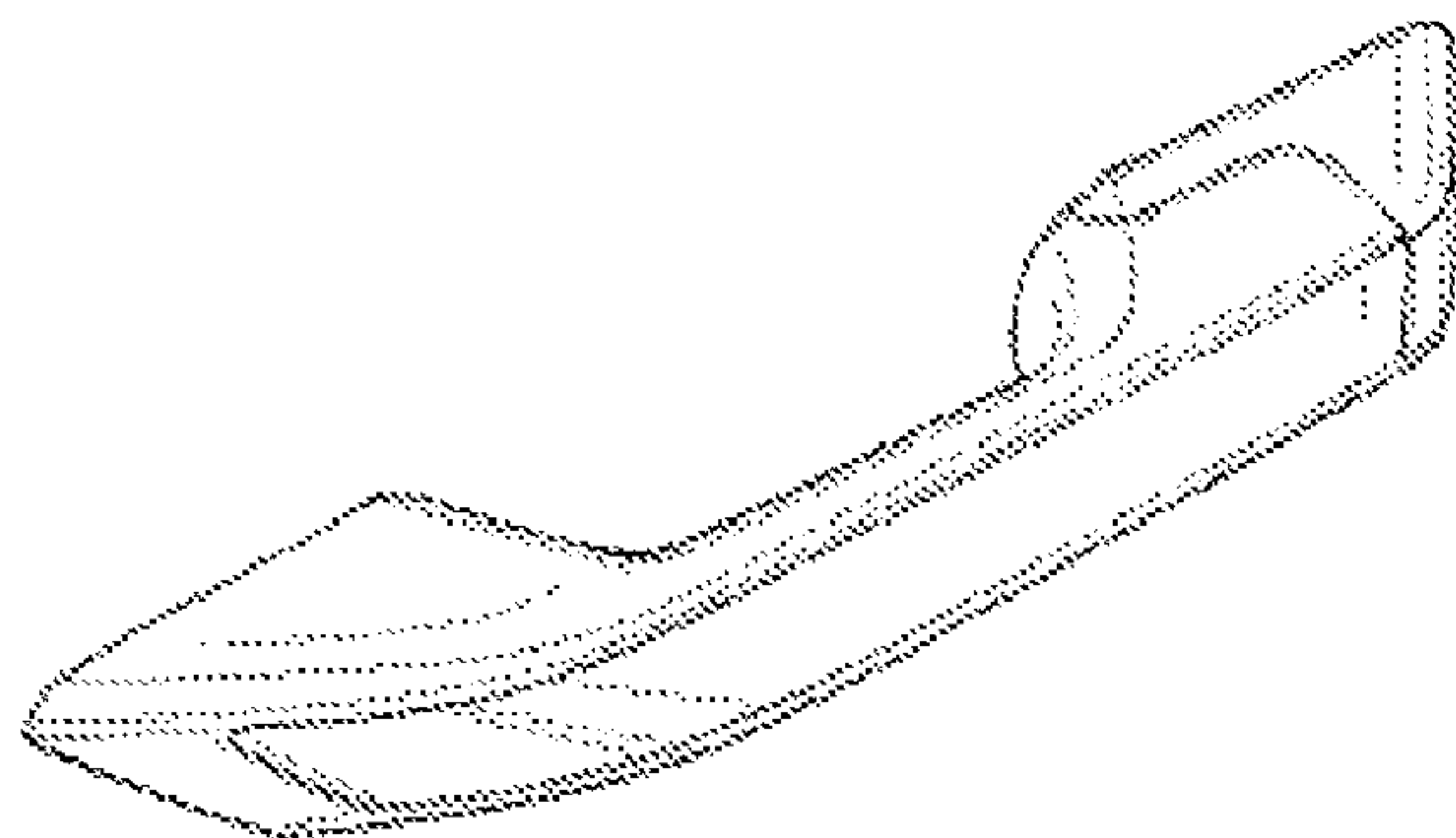

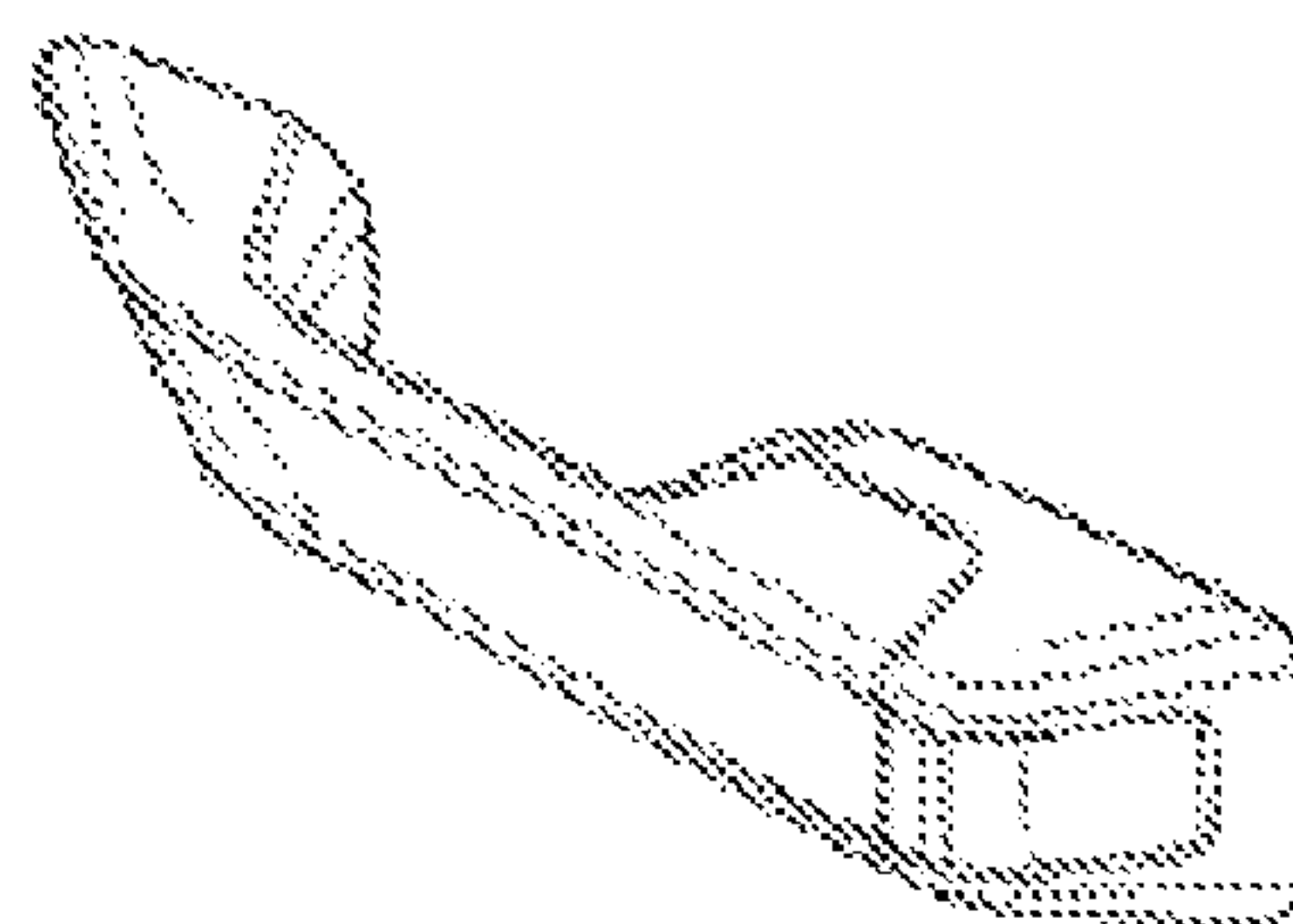

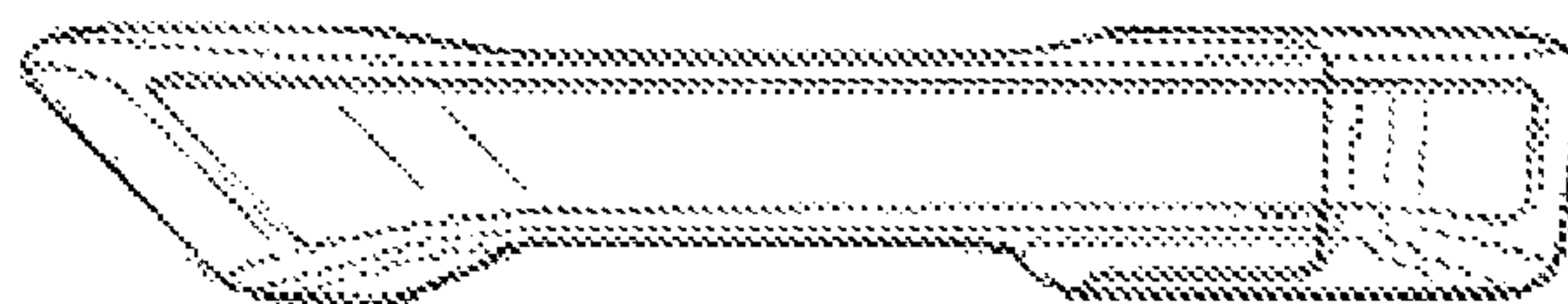

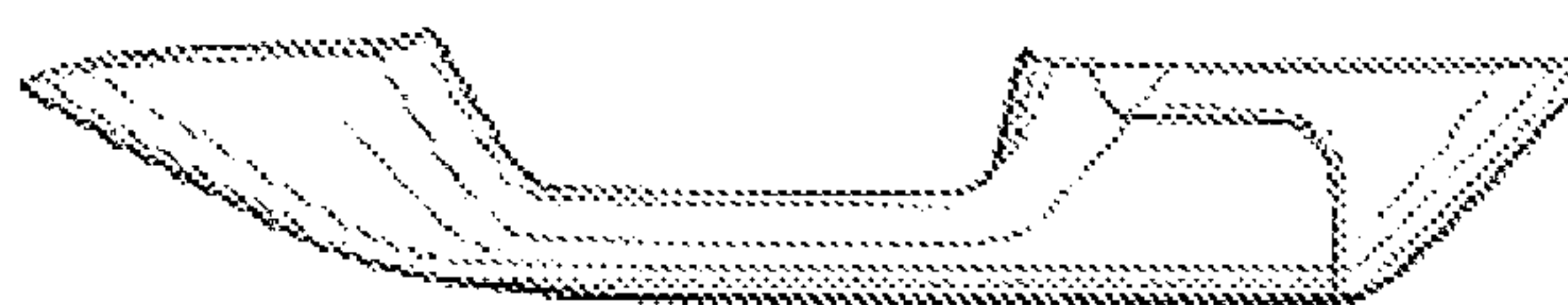

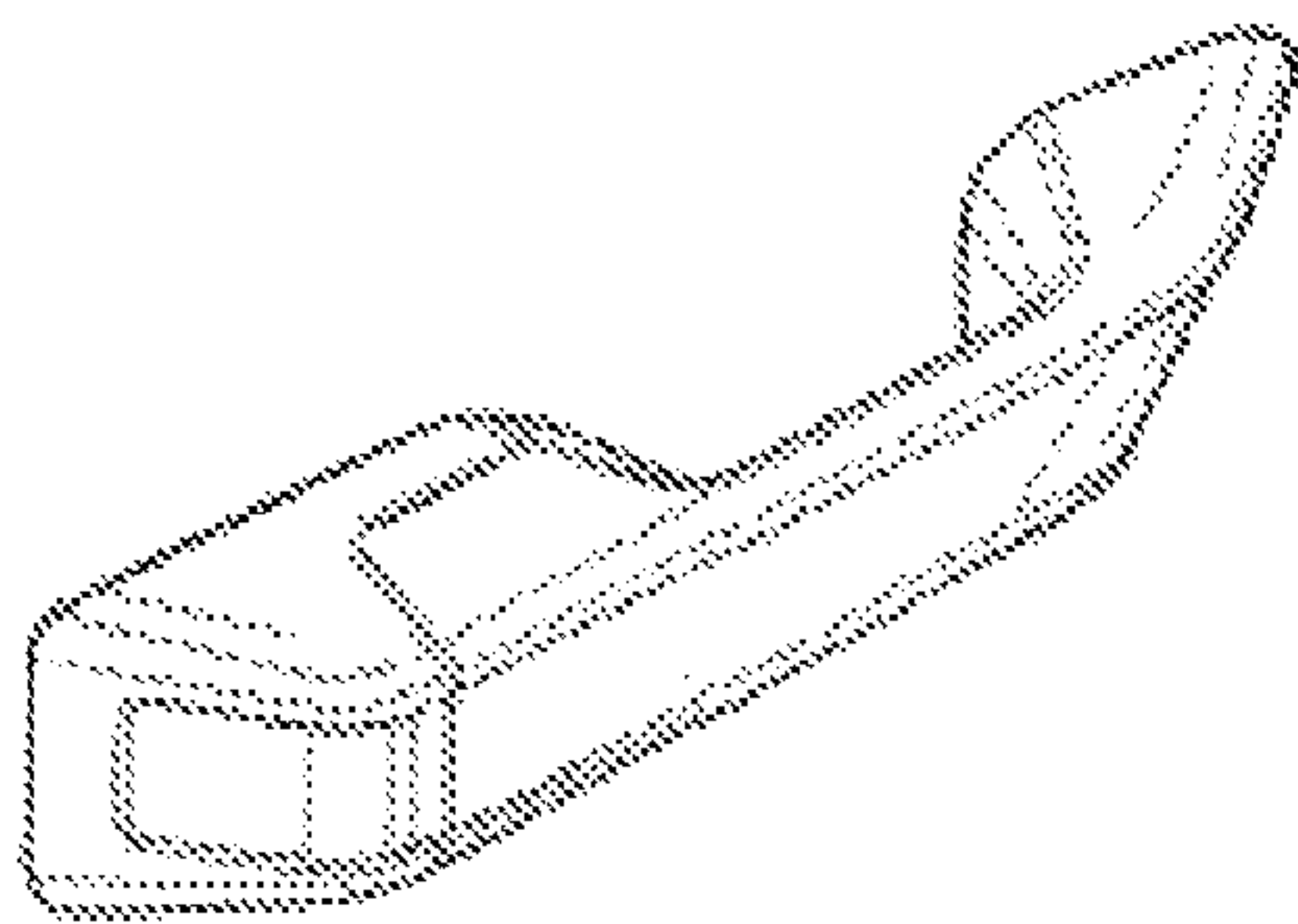

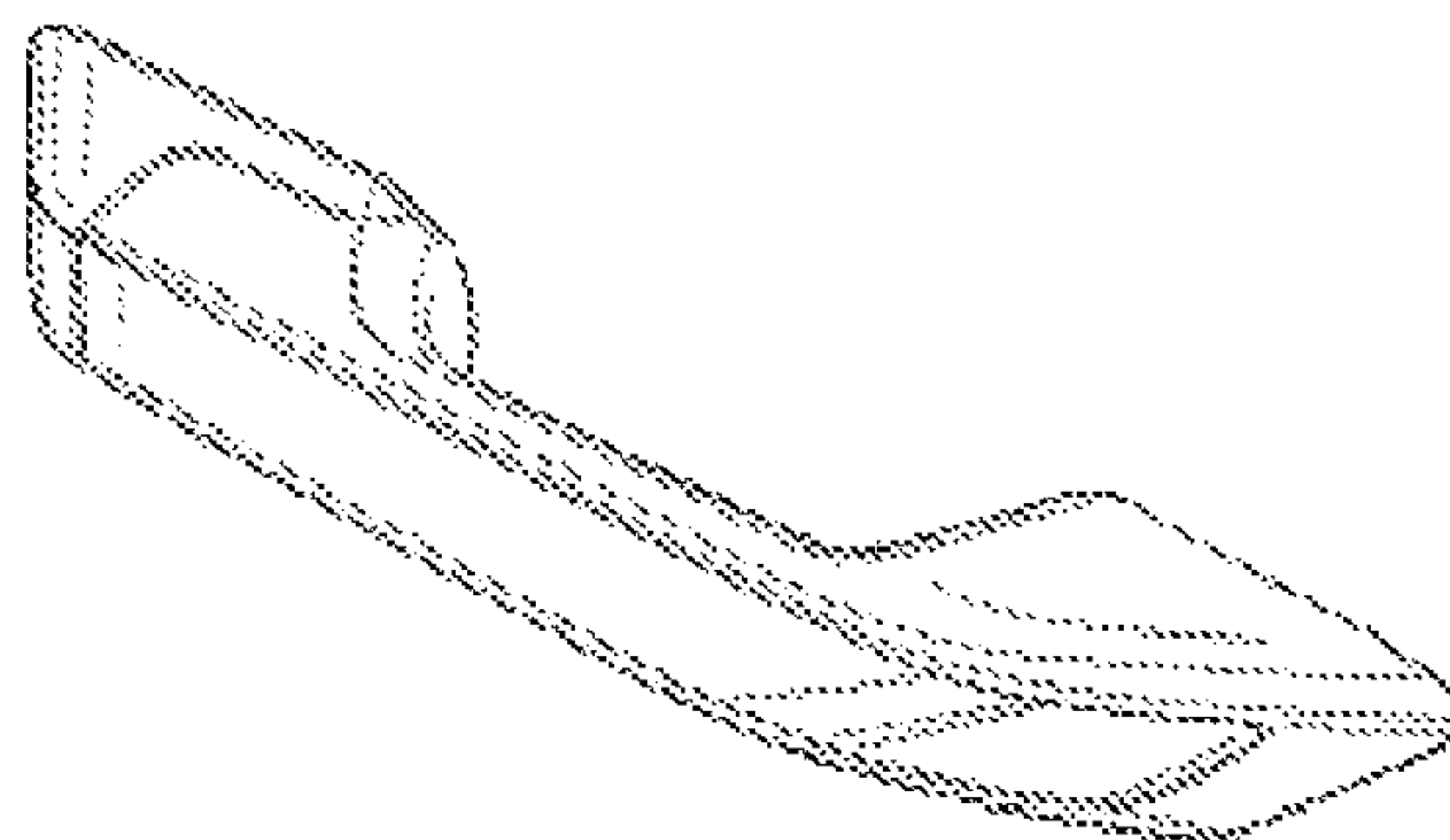

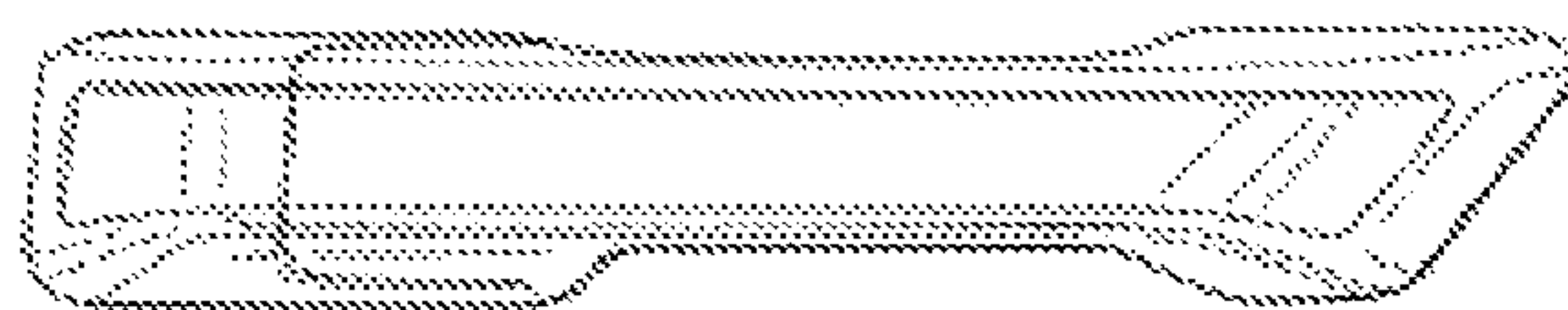

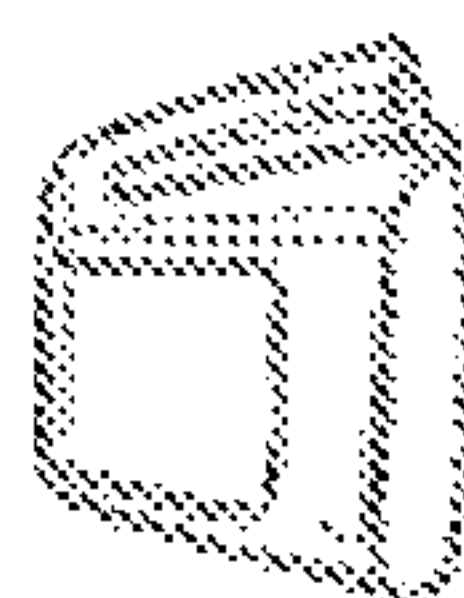
