The ornamental design for an earring or similar articles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom view being identical;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image; and,
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken lines shown in the drawings represent portions of the earring that form no part of the claimed design.

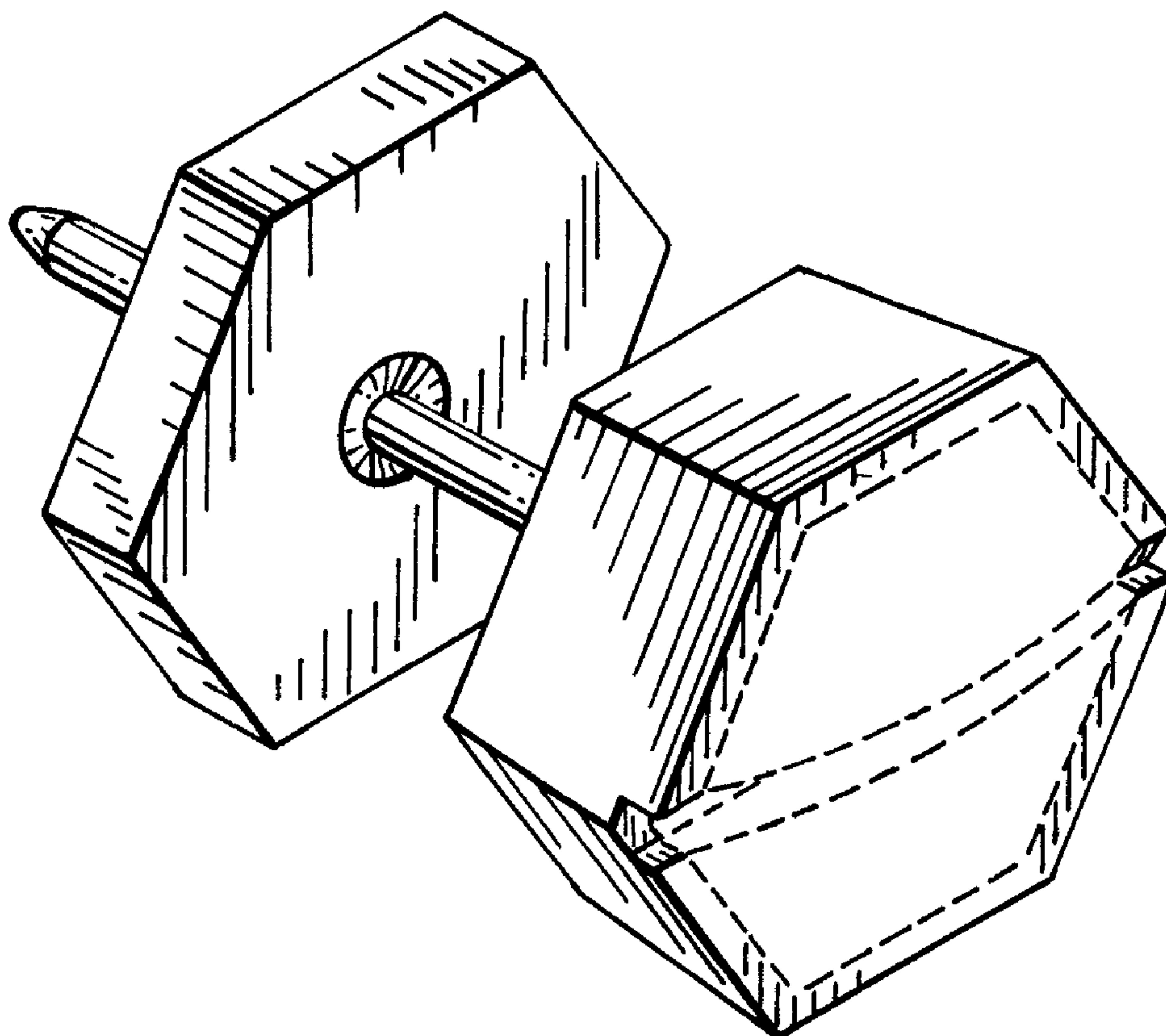

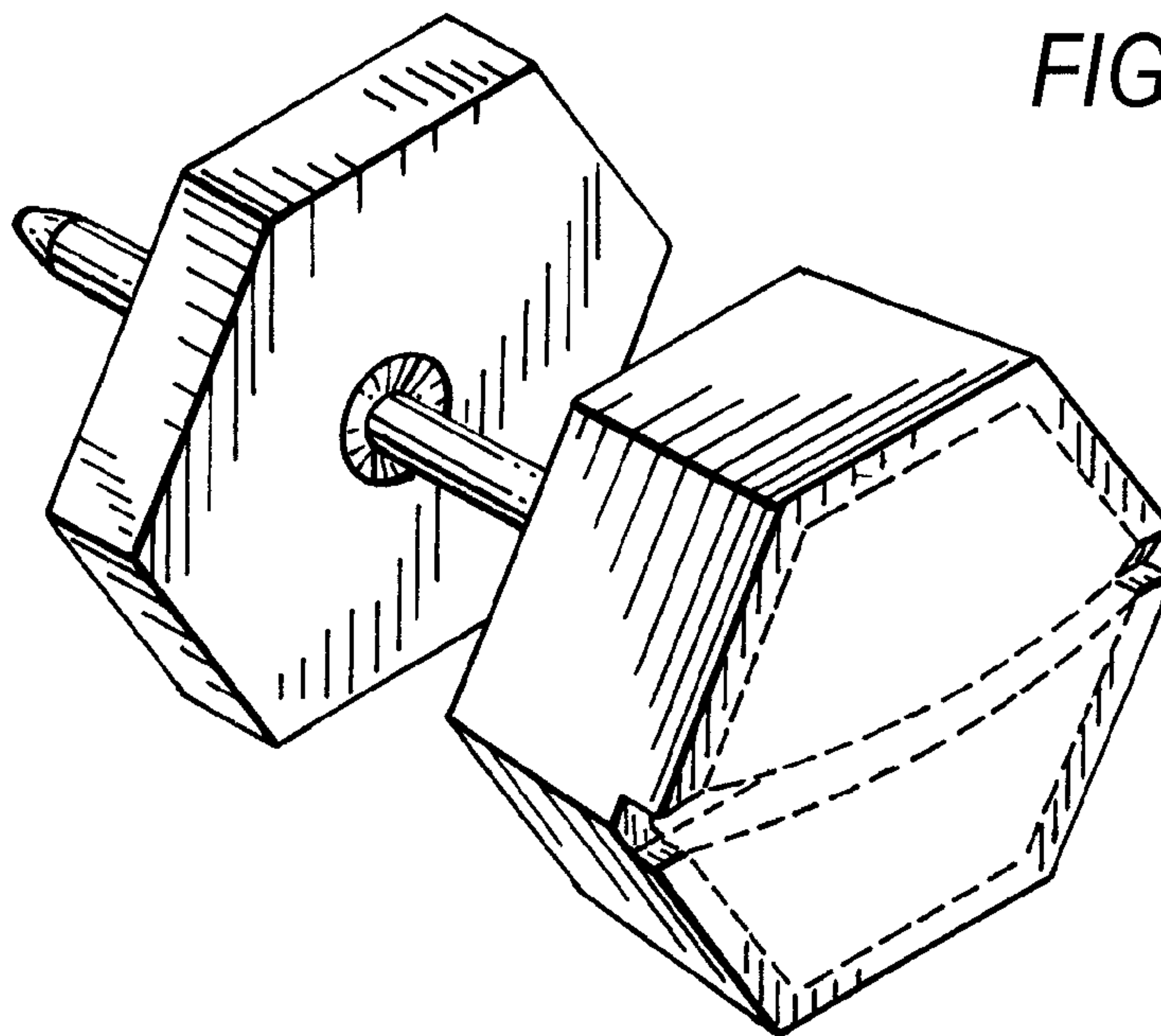

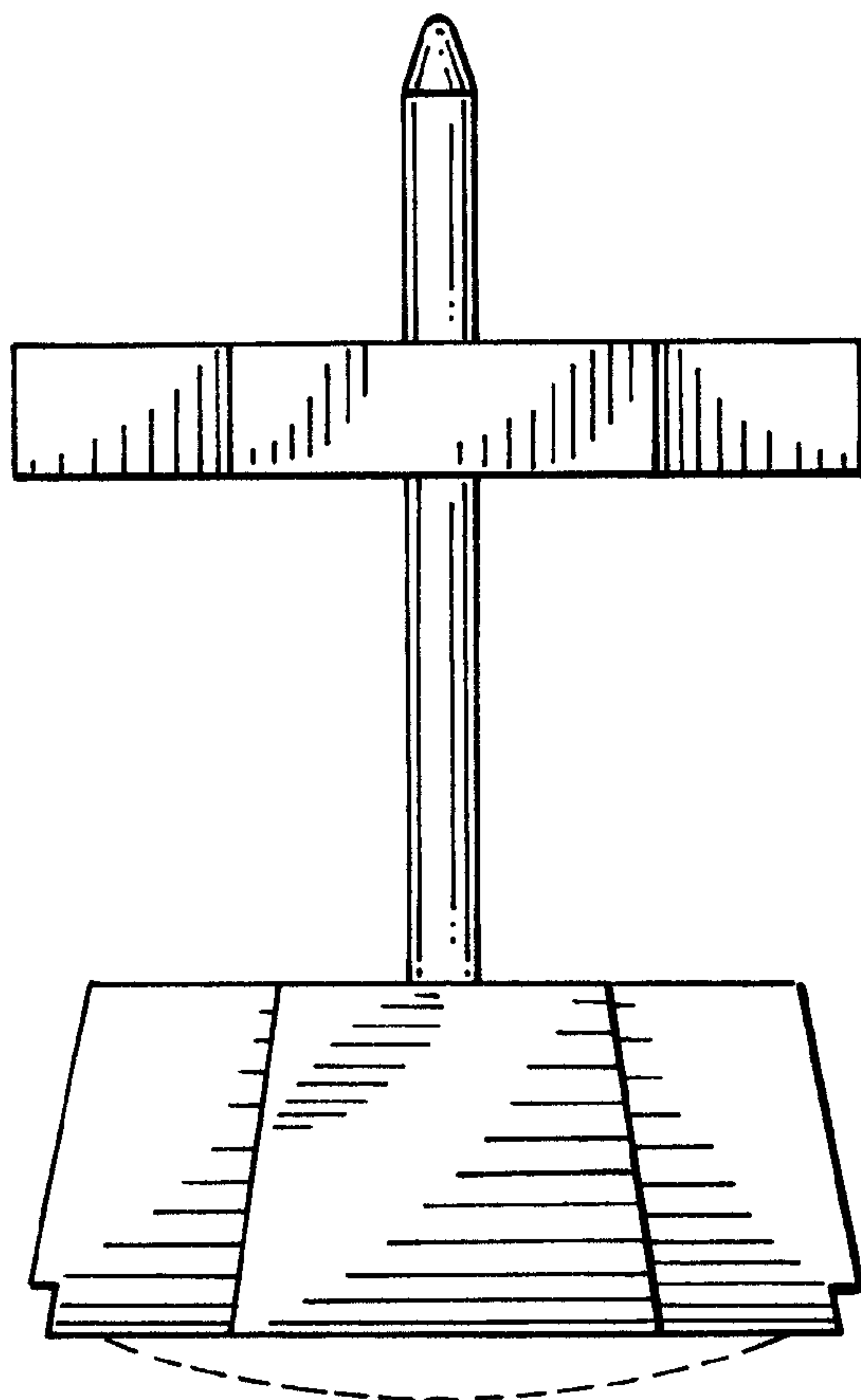

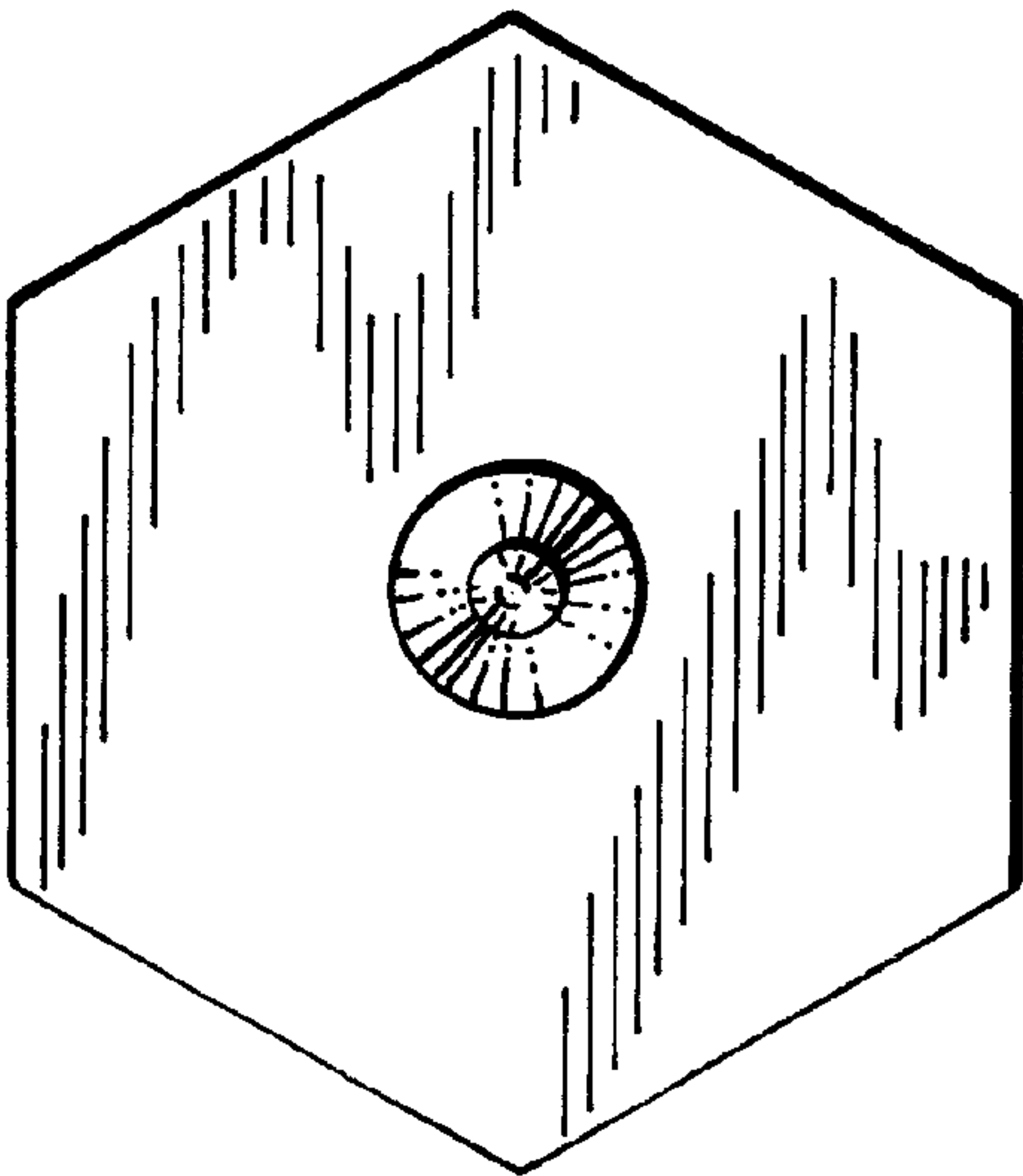
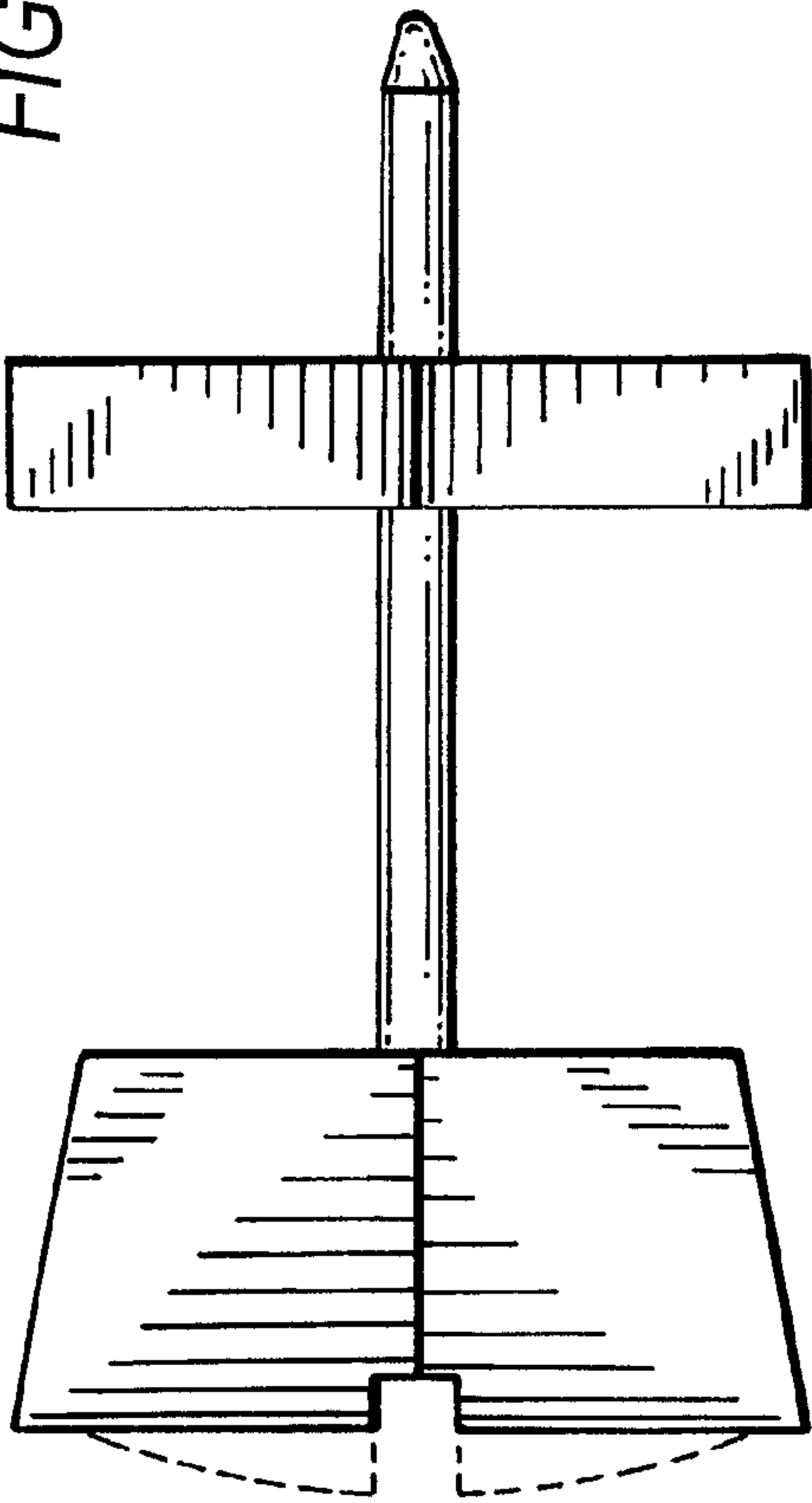

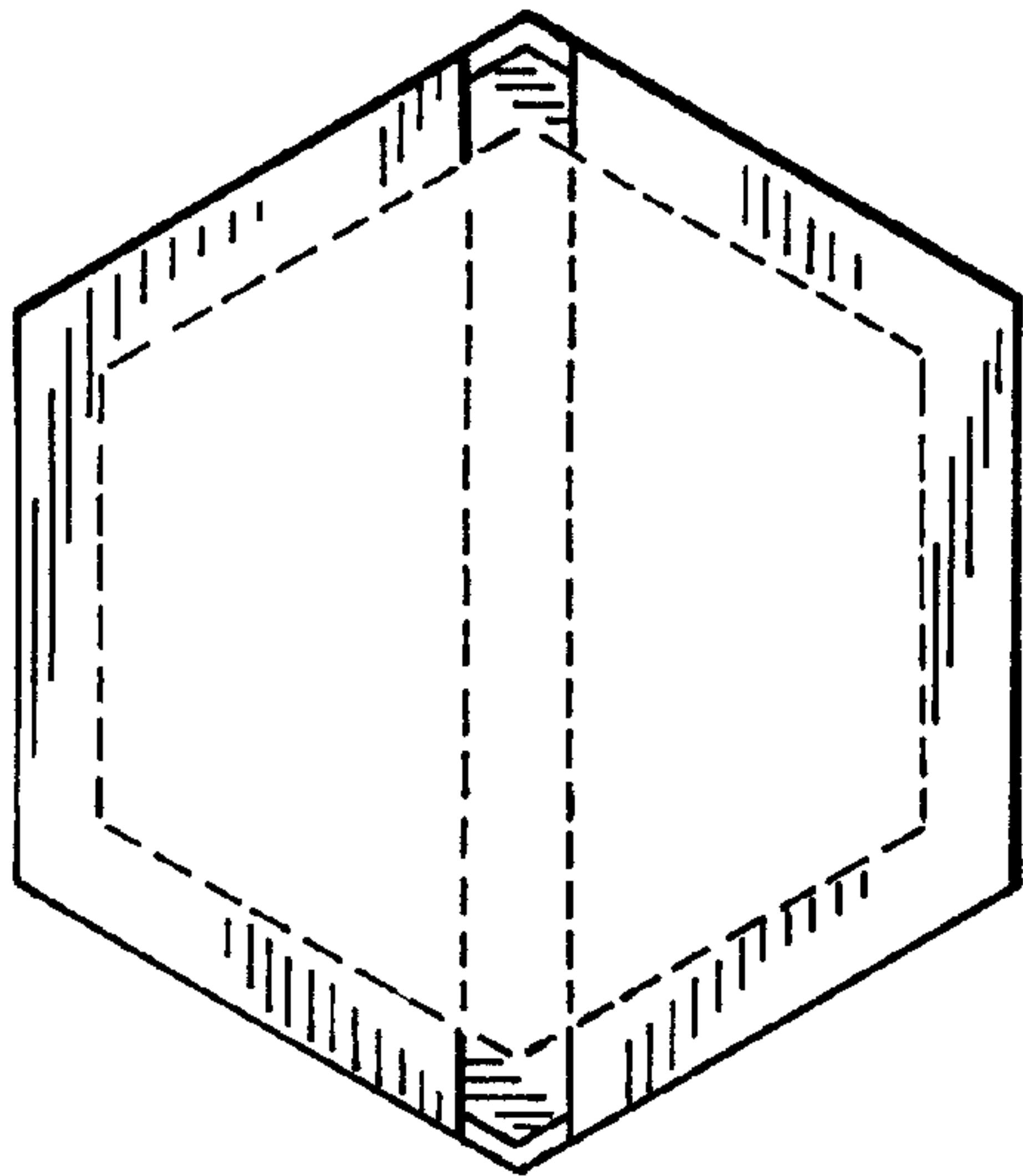
