(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a multimedia signal transmitter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a multimedia signal transmitter showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

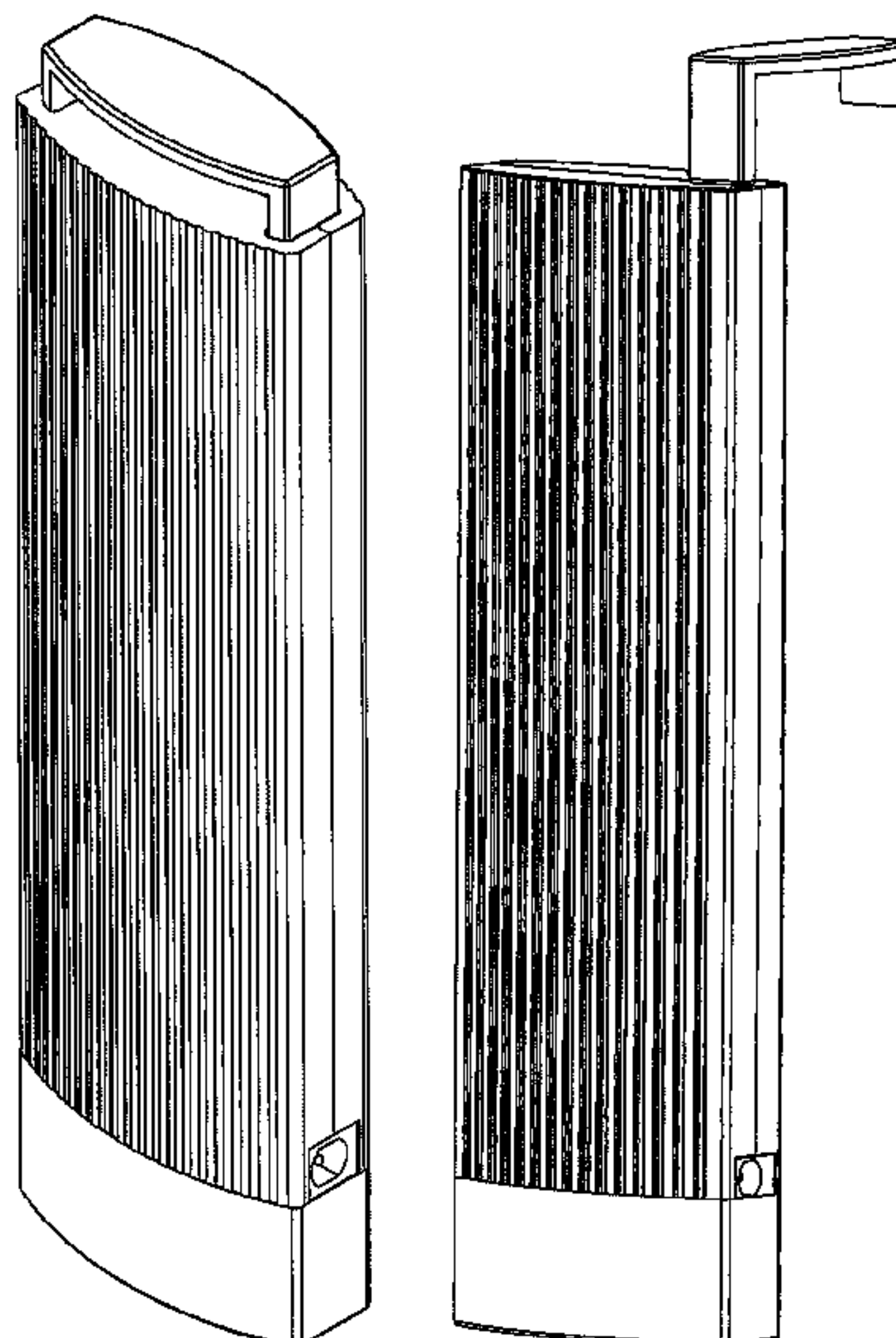
FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, showing the multimedia signal transmitter in a first position of use shown with environment;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof, showing the multimedia signal transmitter in a second position of use; and,

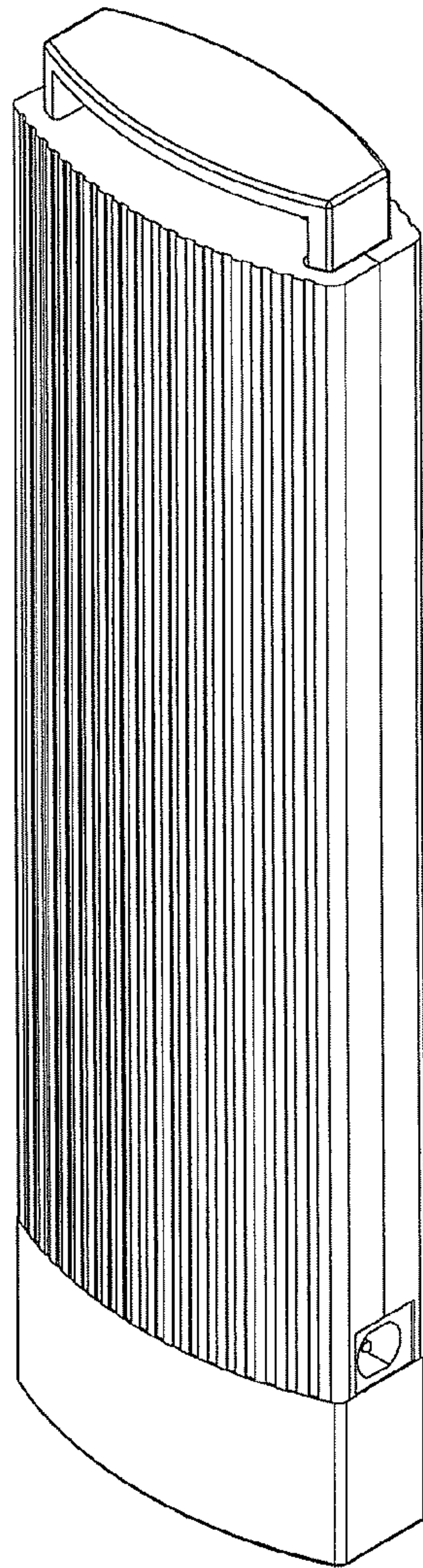

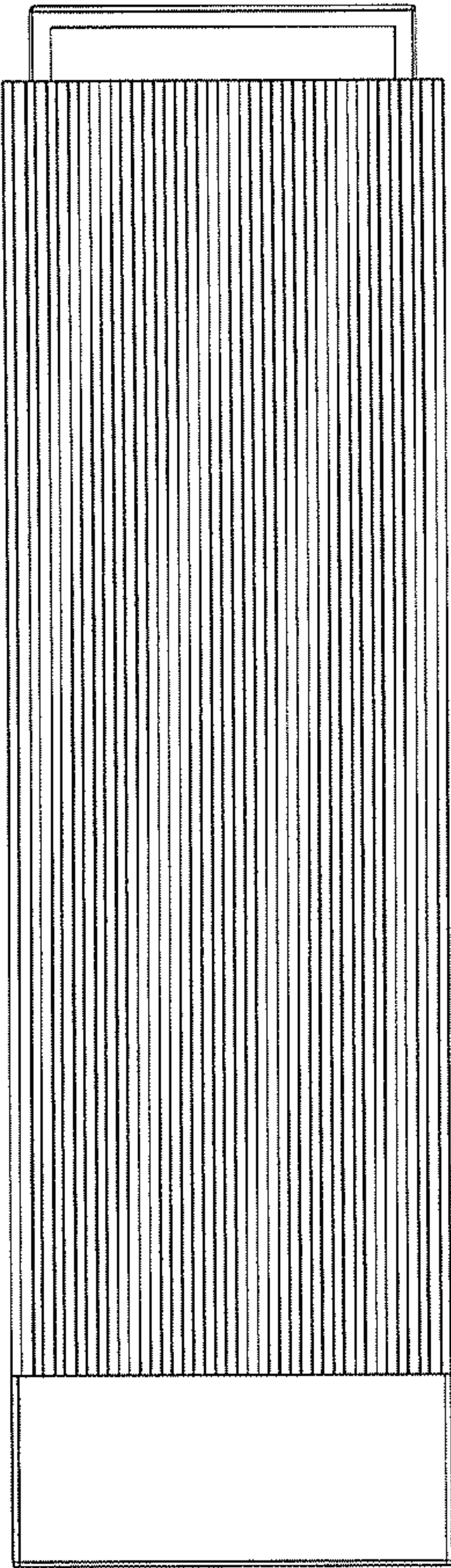

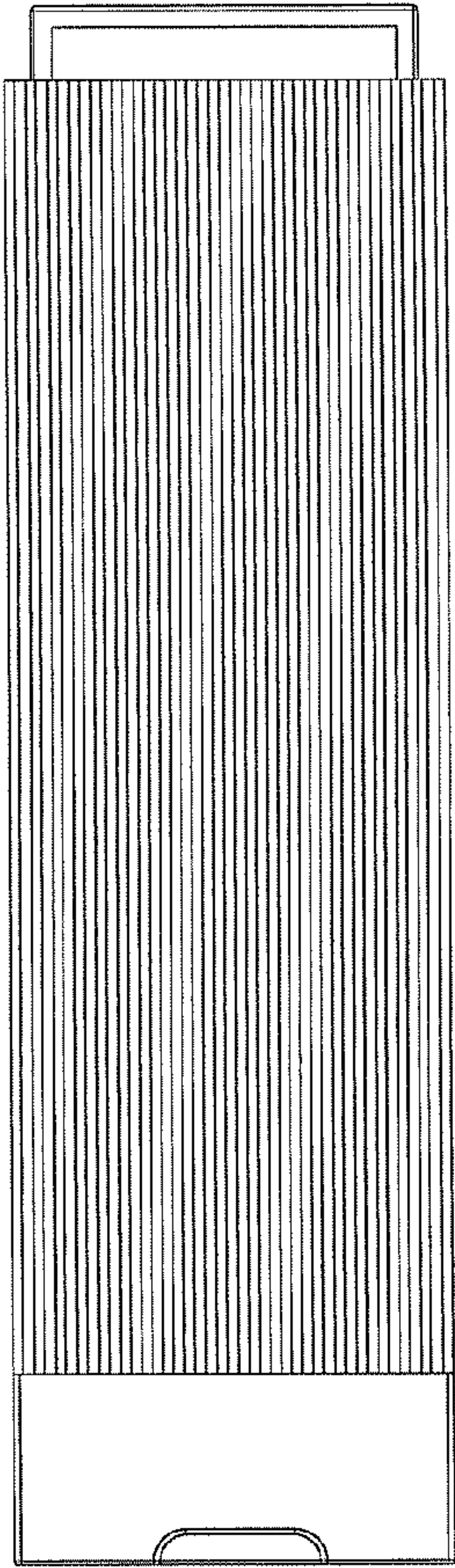

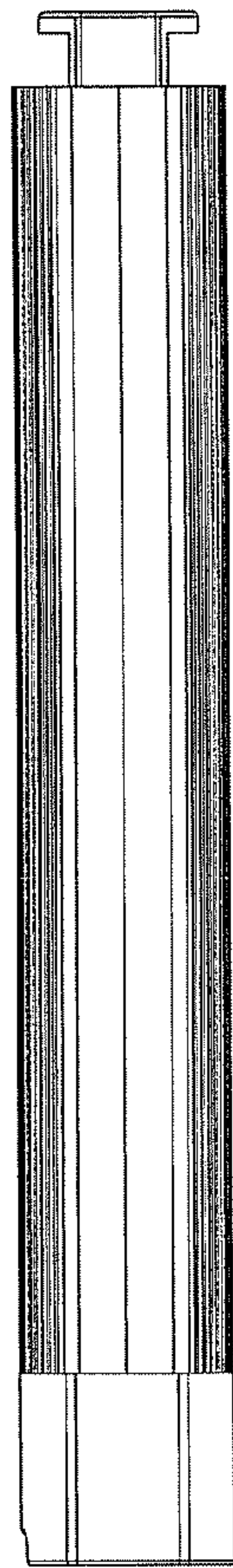

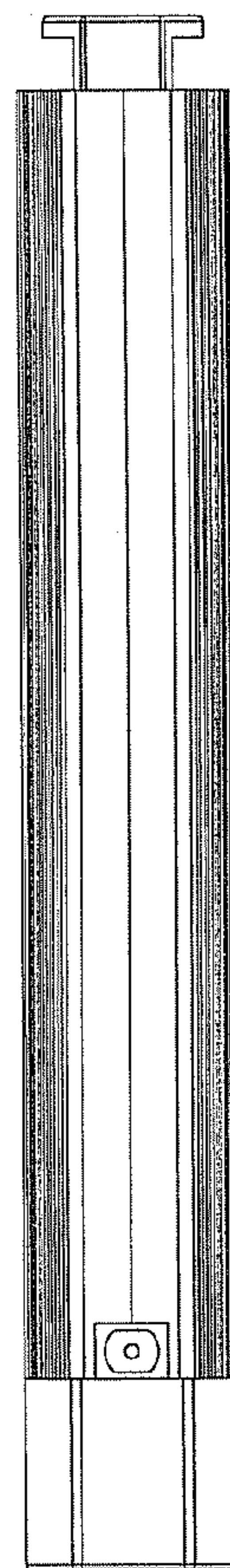

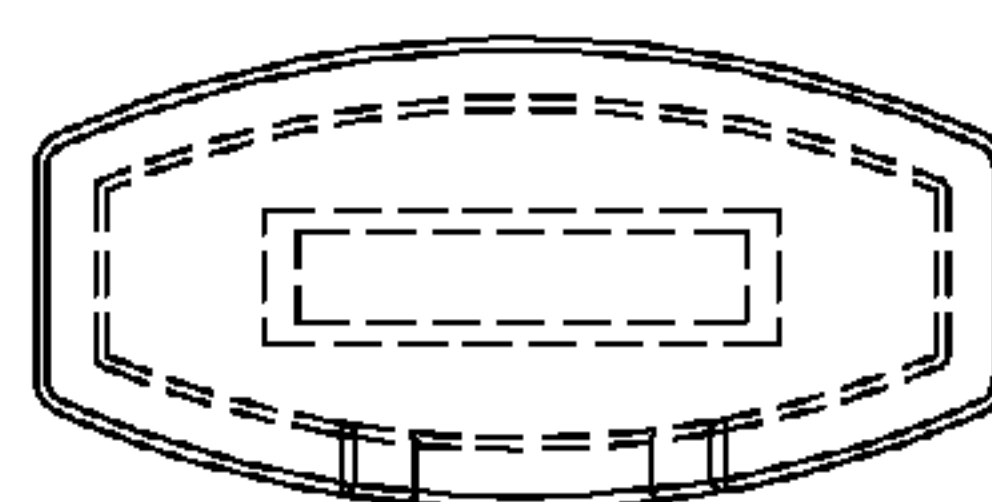

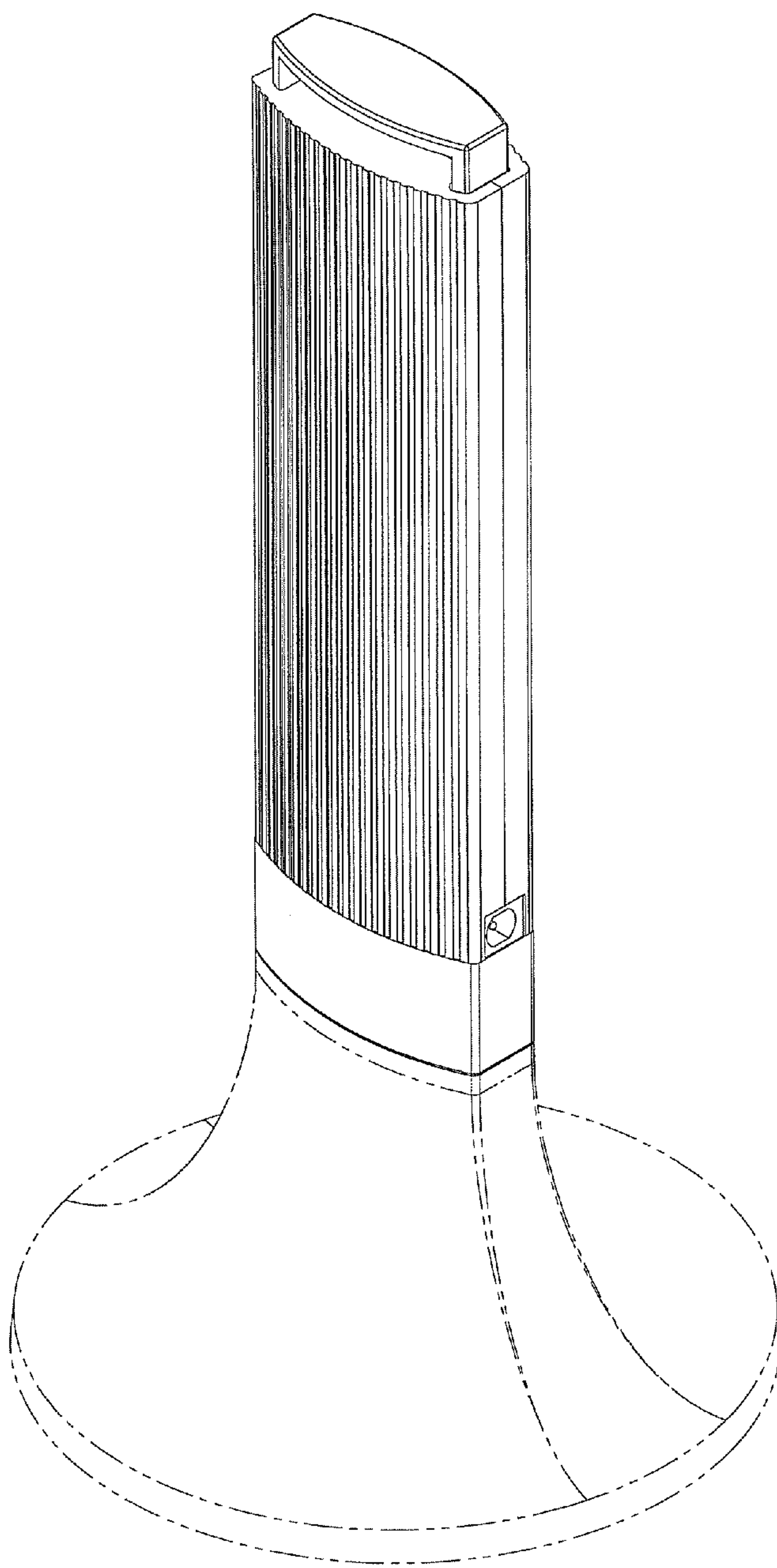

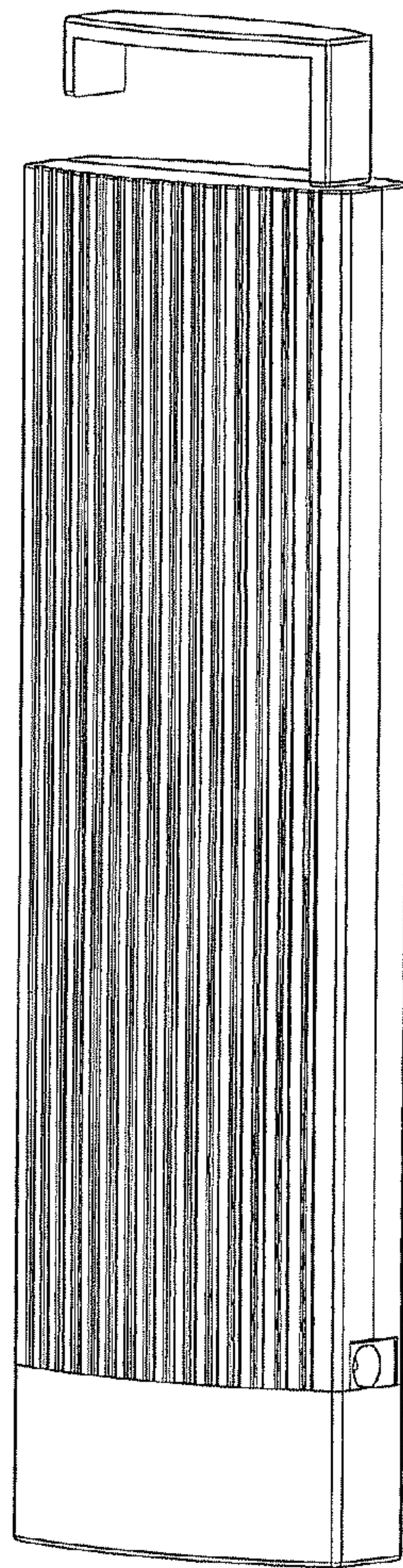

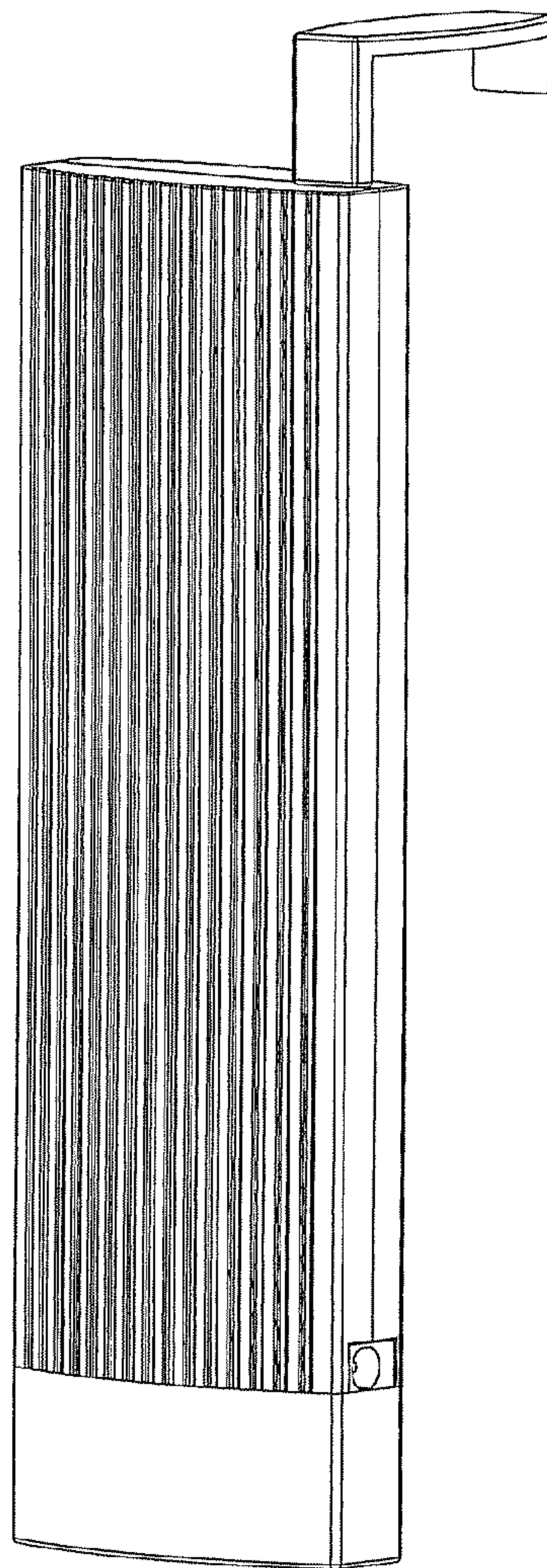
