(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a safety razor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, and right side perspective view of a safety razor showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear, bottom, and left side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is an enlarged right side view thereof; FIG. 8 is an enlarged left side view thereof; and, FIG. 9 is an enlarged cross-sectional view of the claimed part of the article taken along line 9-9 in FIG. 8.

The features shown in broken lines in the drawings depict environmental subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dotted lines in the drawings denote the boundary of the claim and form no part of the claimed design.

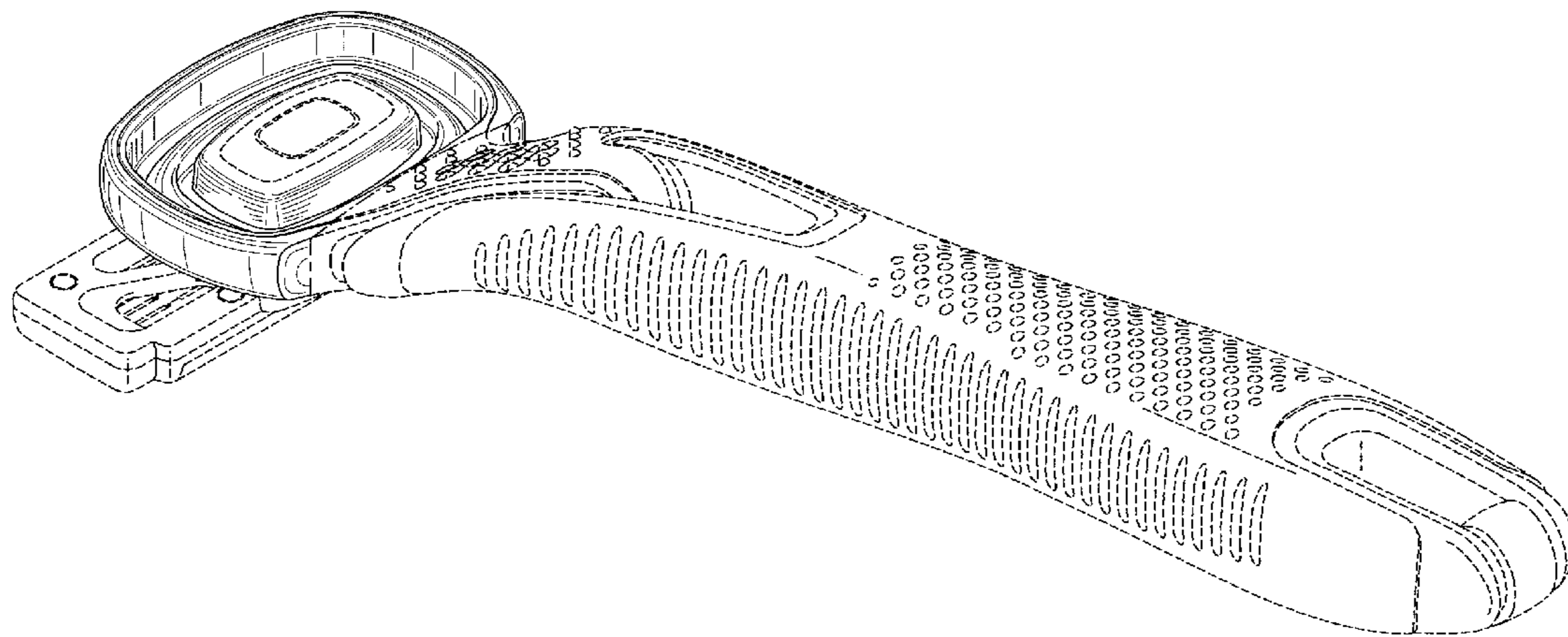

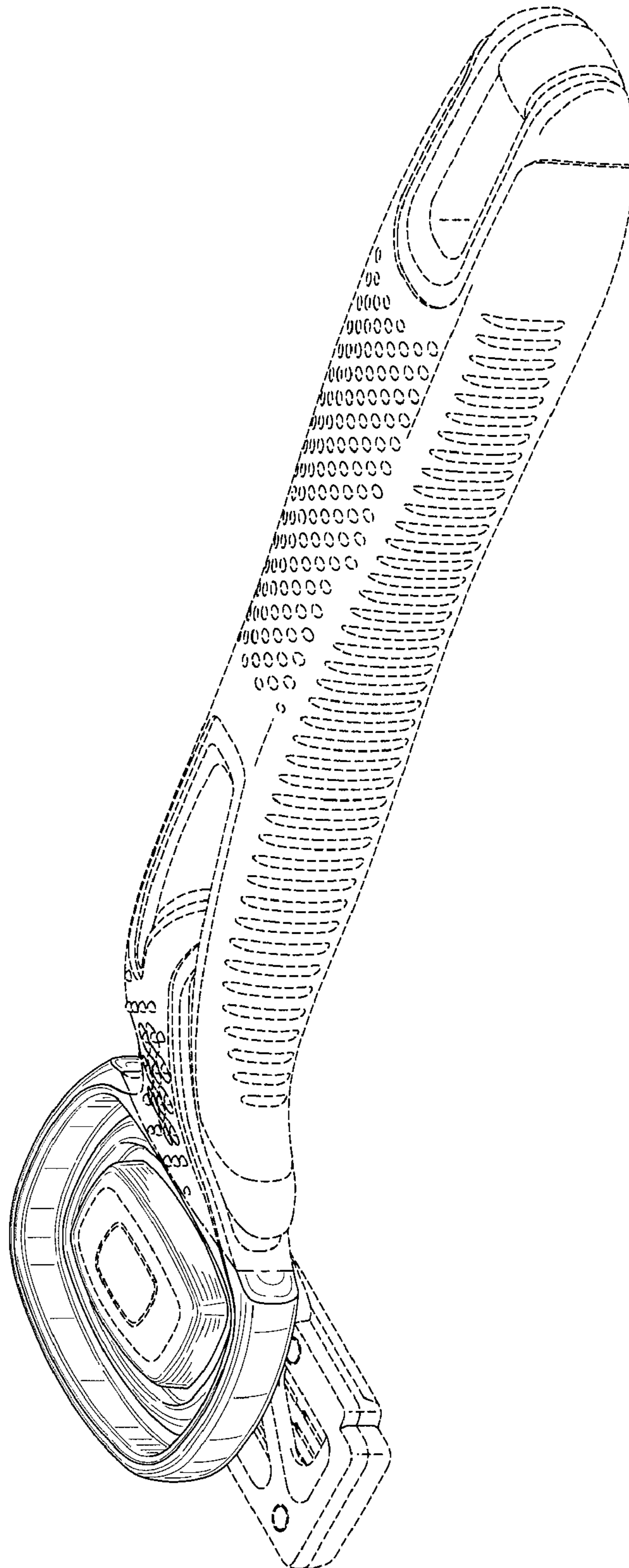

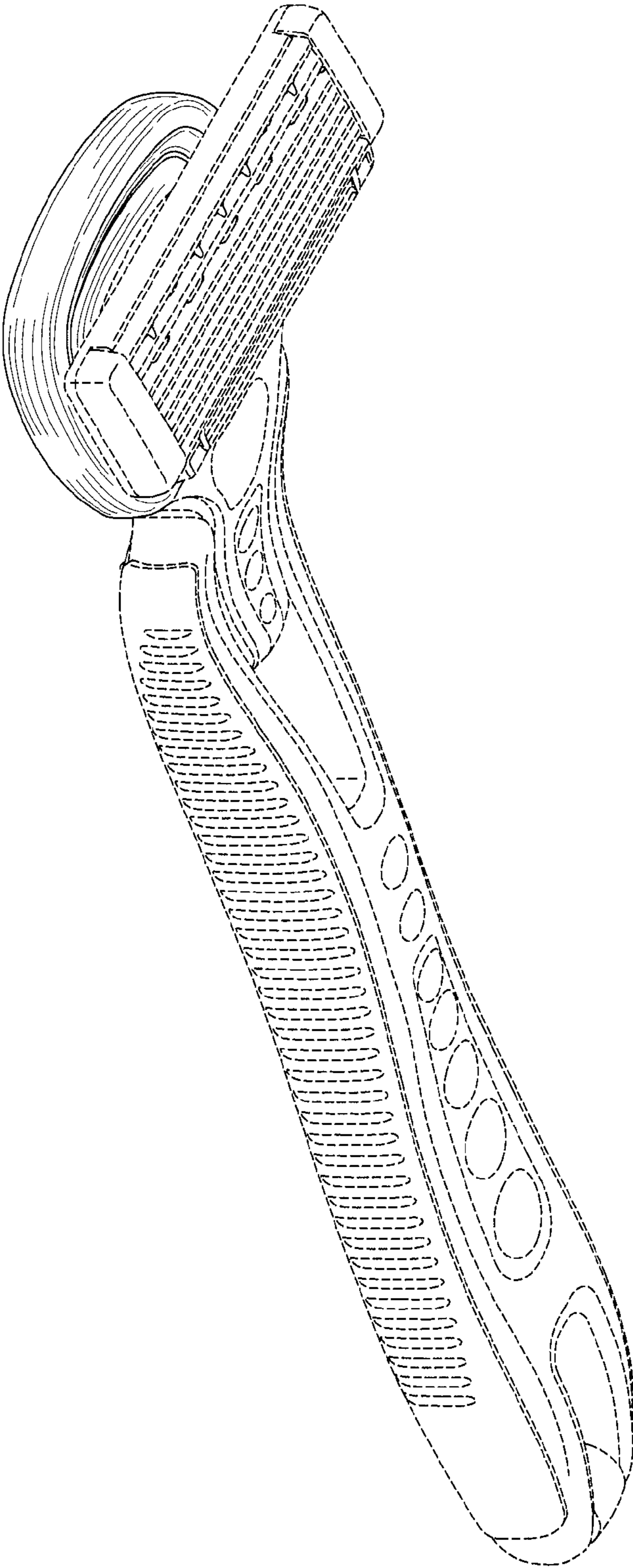

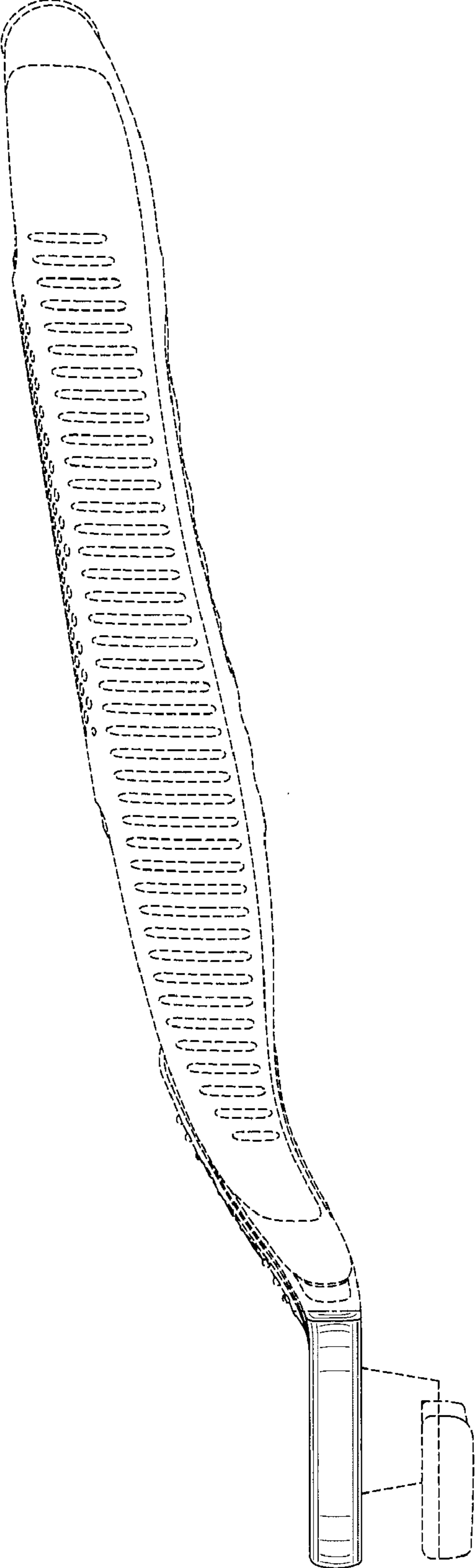

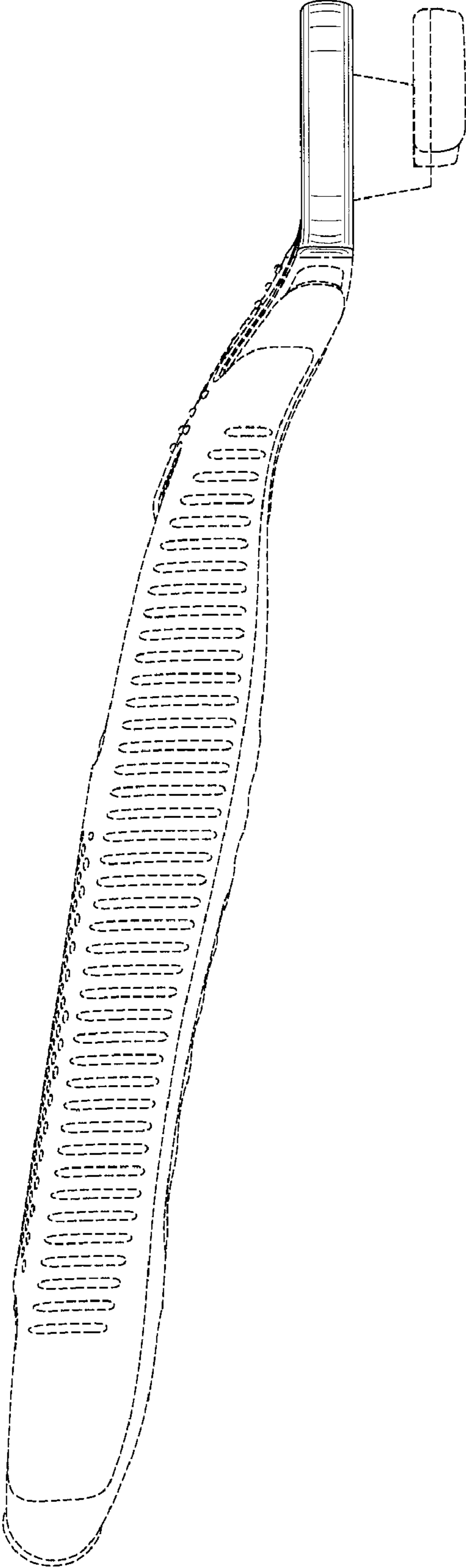

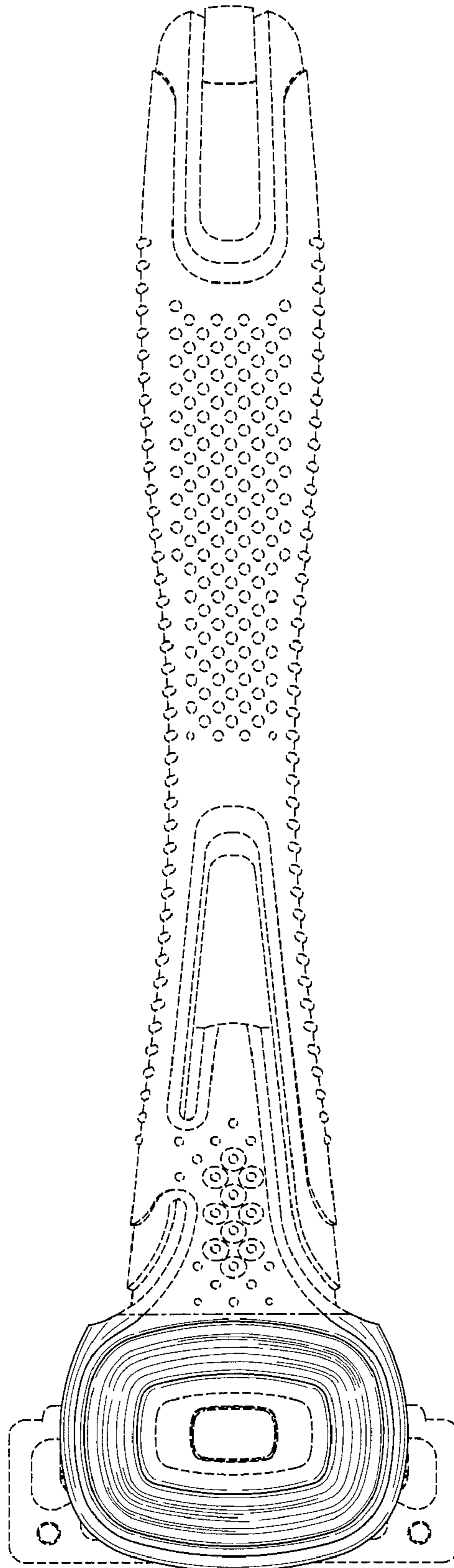

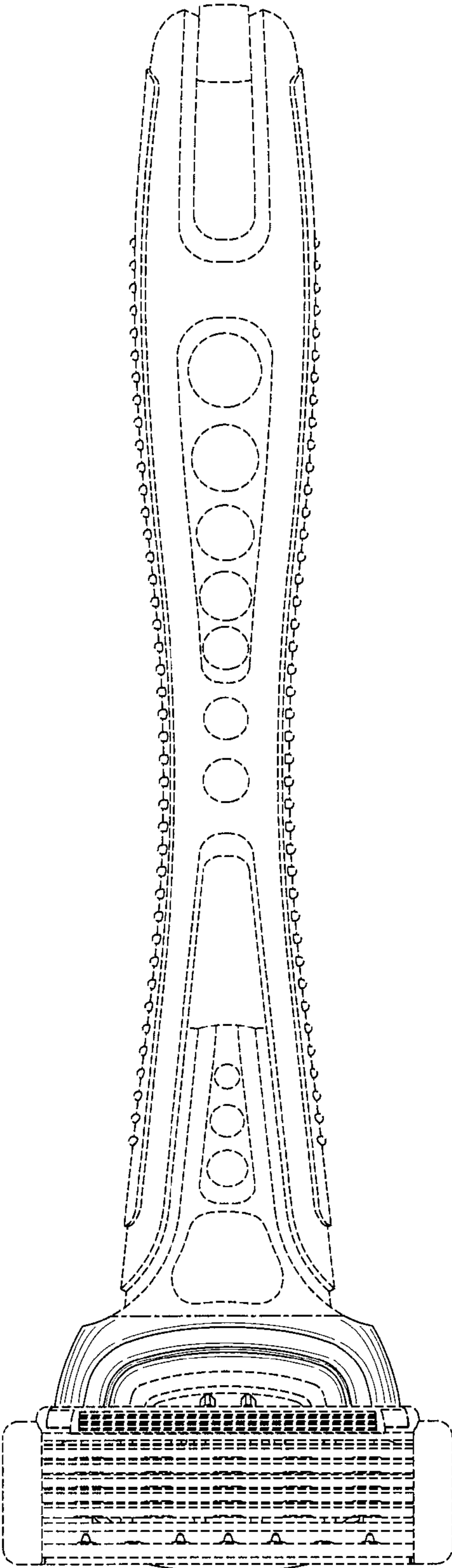

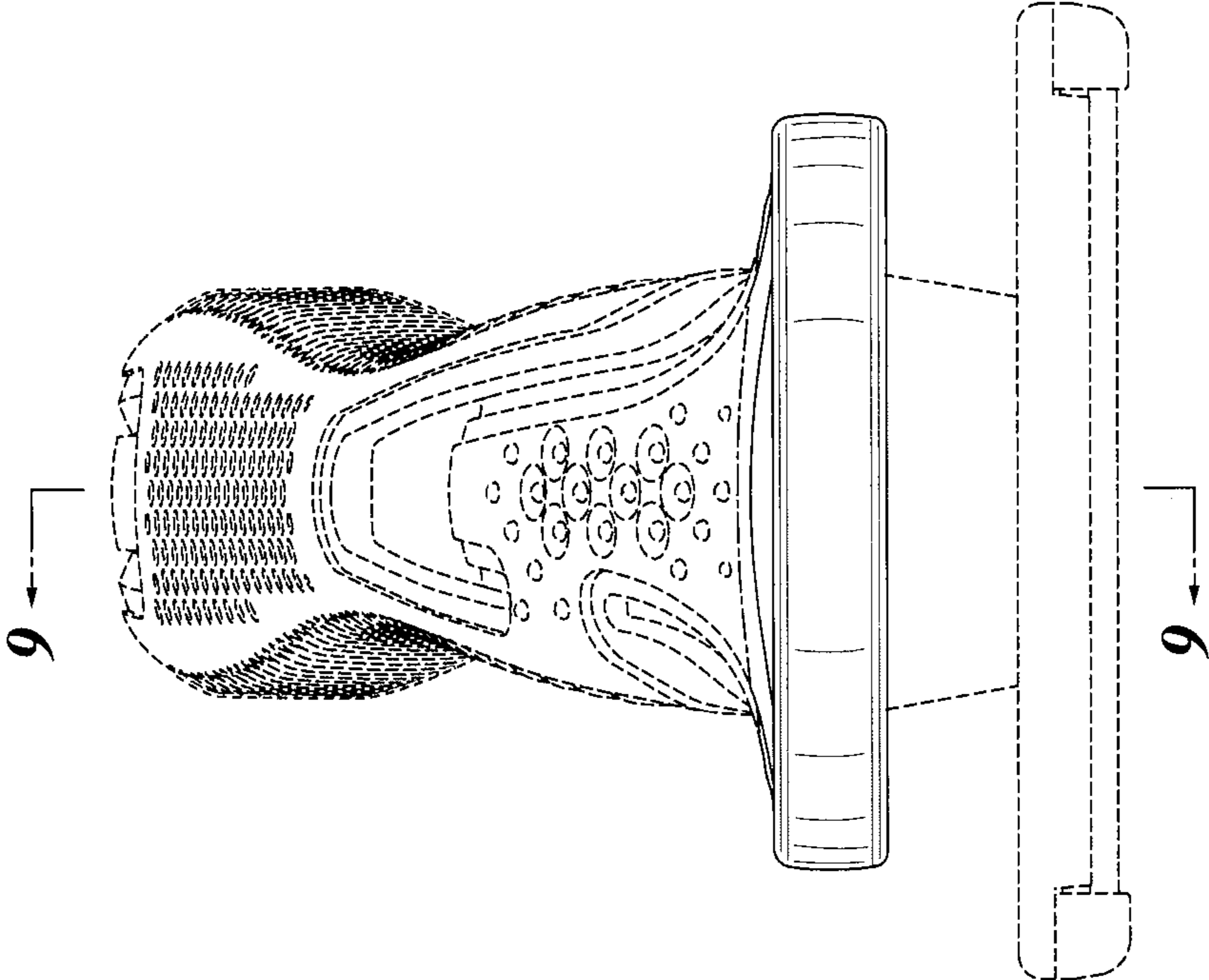

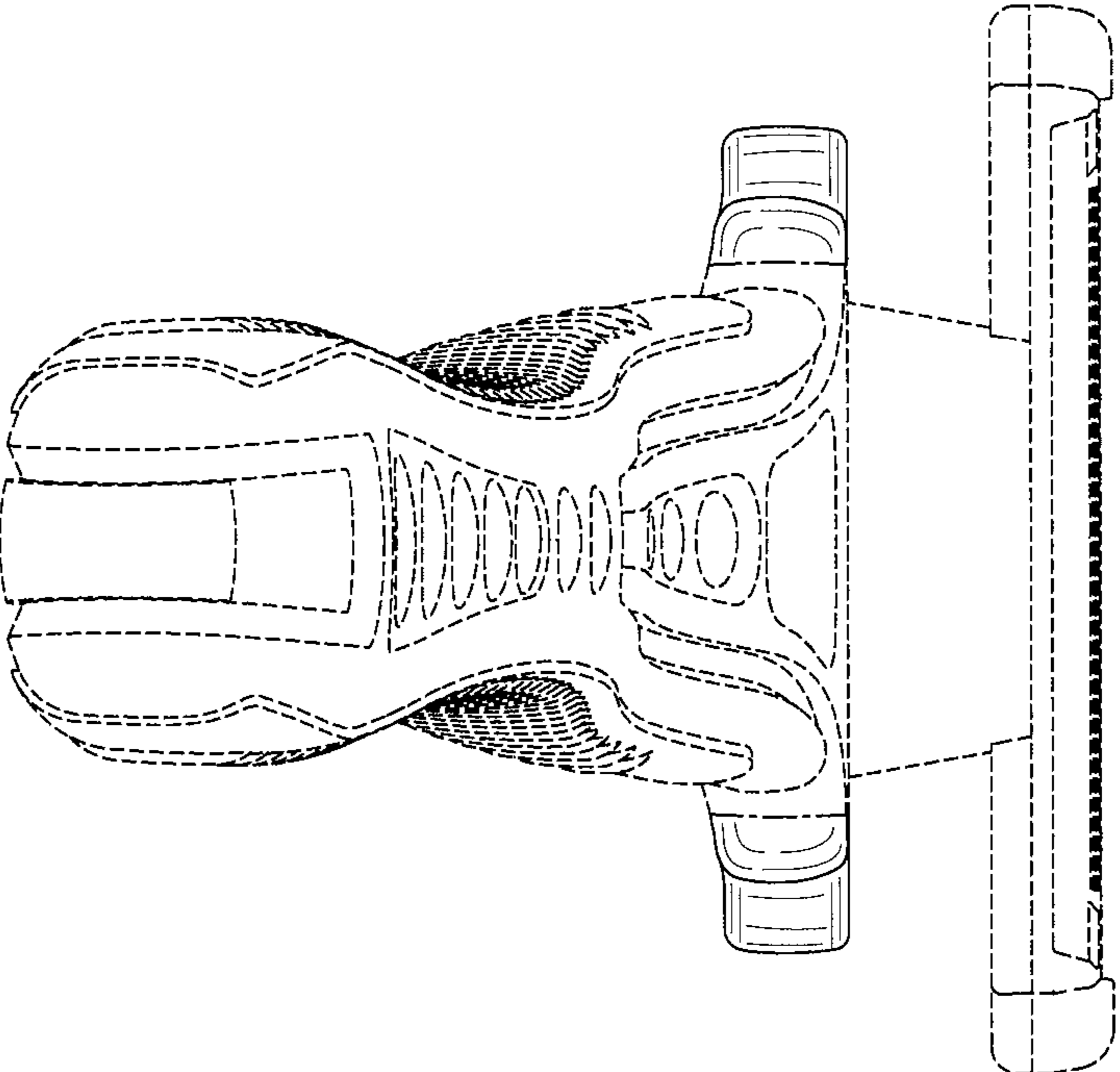
