(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a placemat having a napkin and chopsticks holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a placemat having a napkin and chopsticks holder in a position of use with a napkin and chopsticks package in accordance with my design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 25 is a right side view of the fourth embodiment;

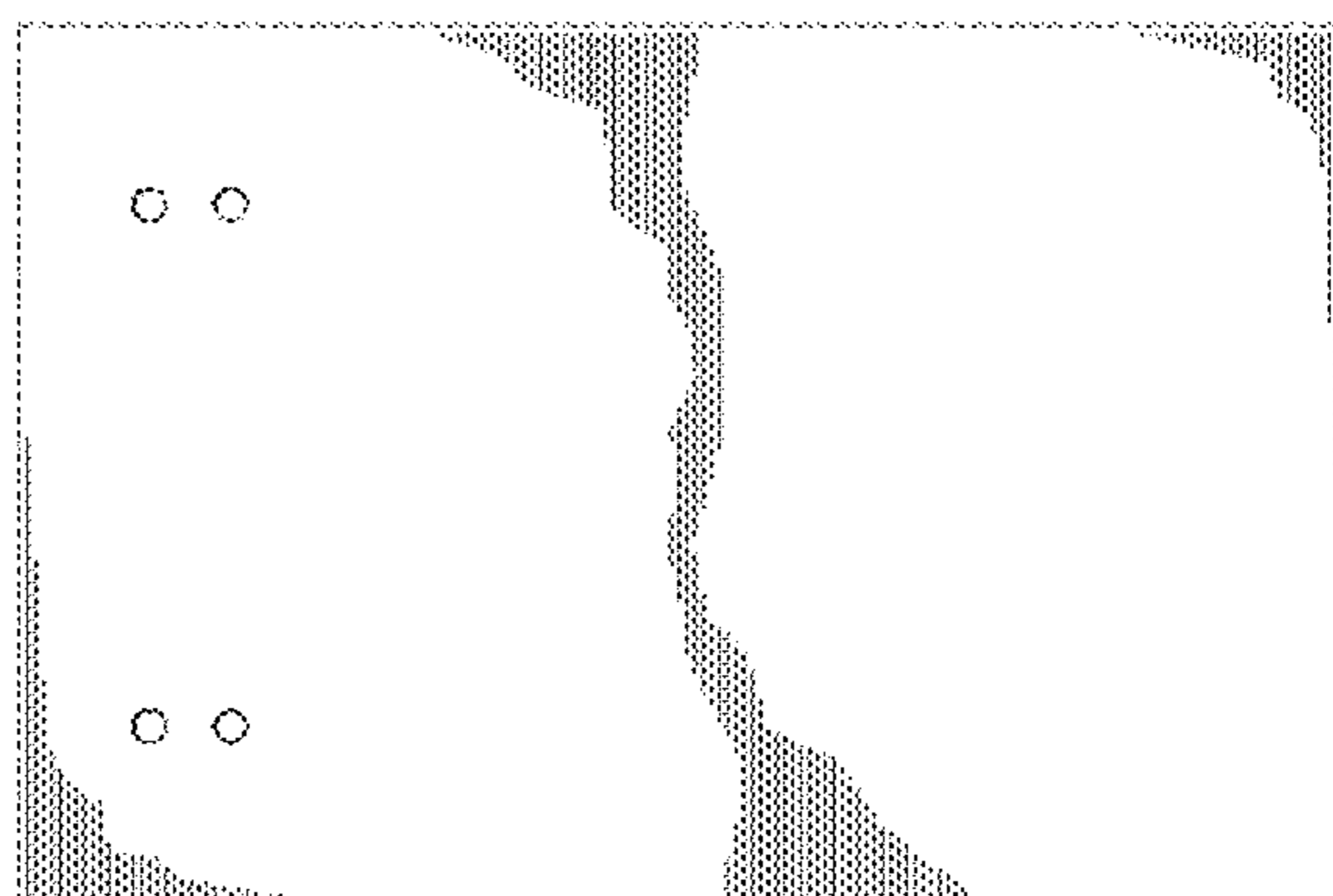
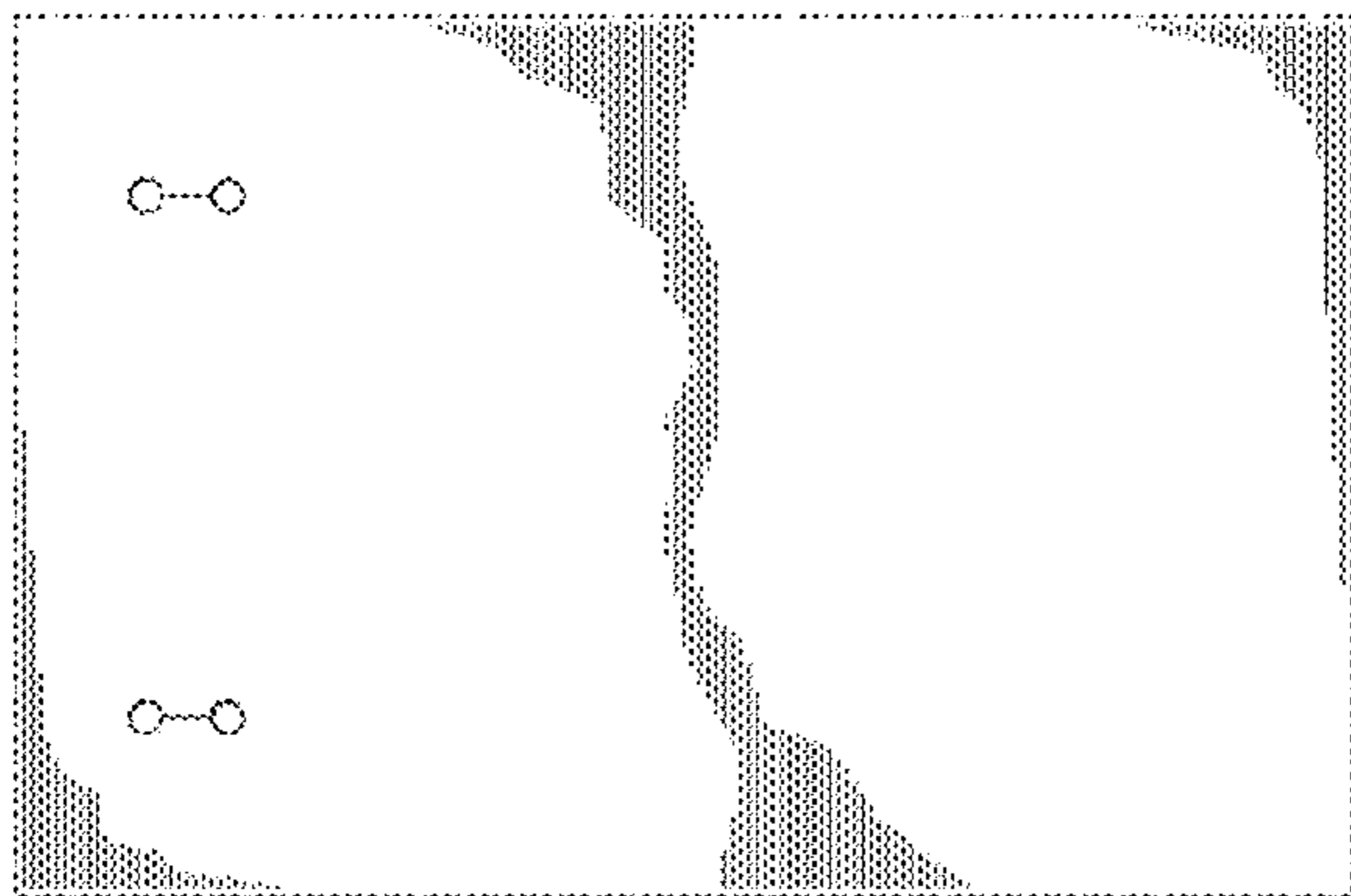
FIG. 26 is a left side view of the fourth embodiment;

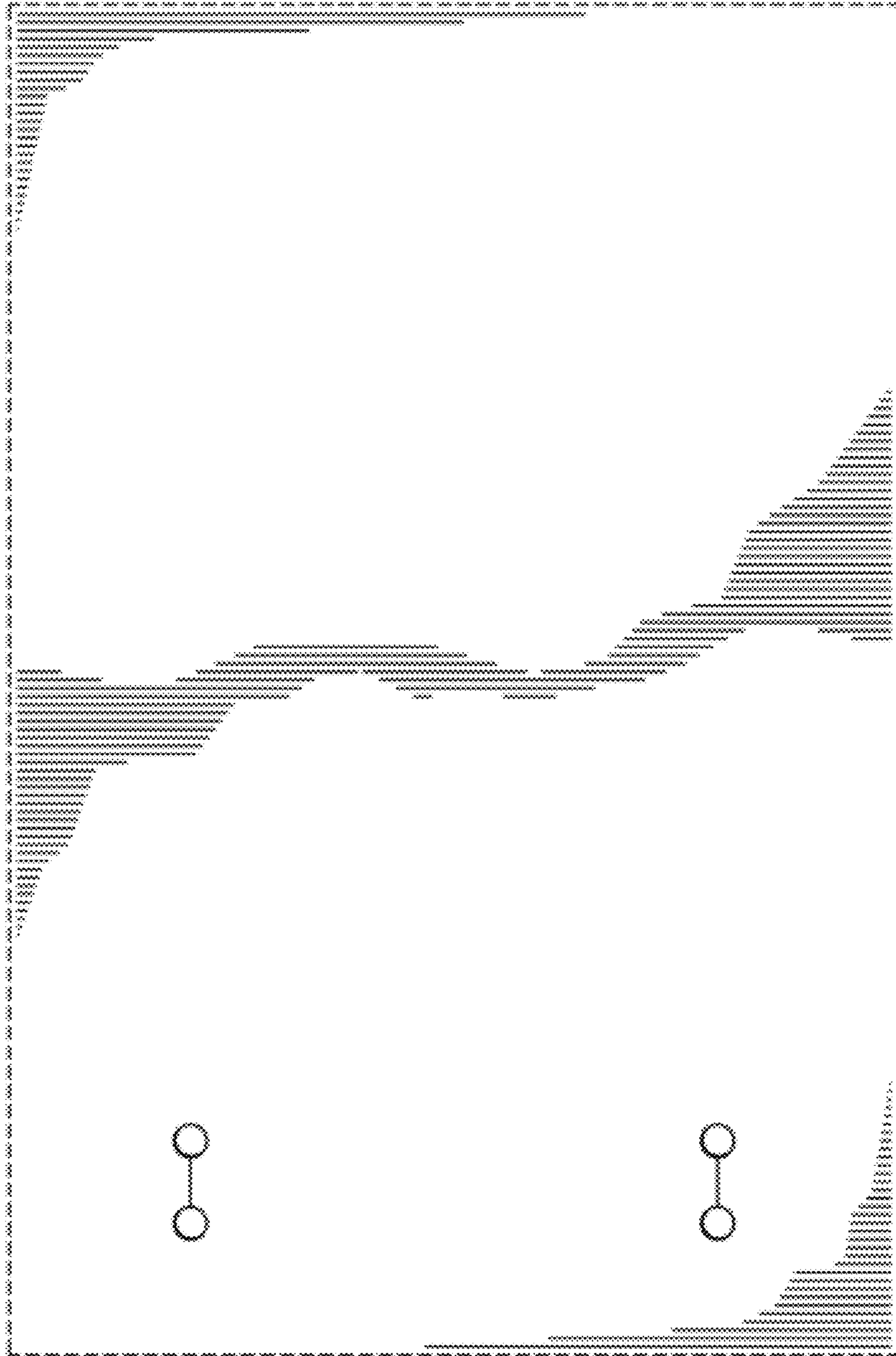

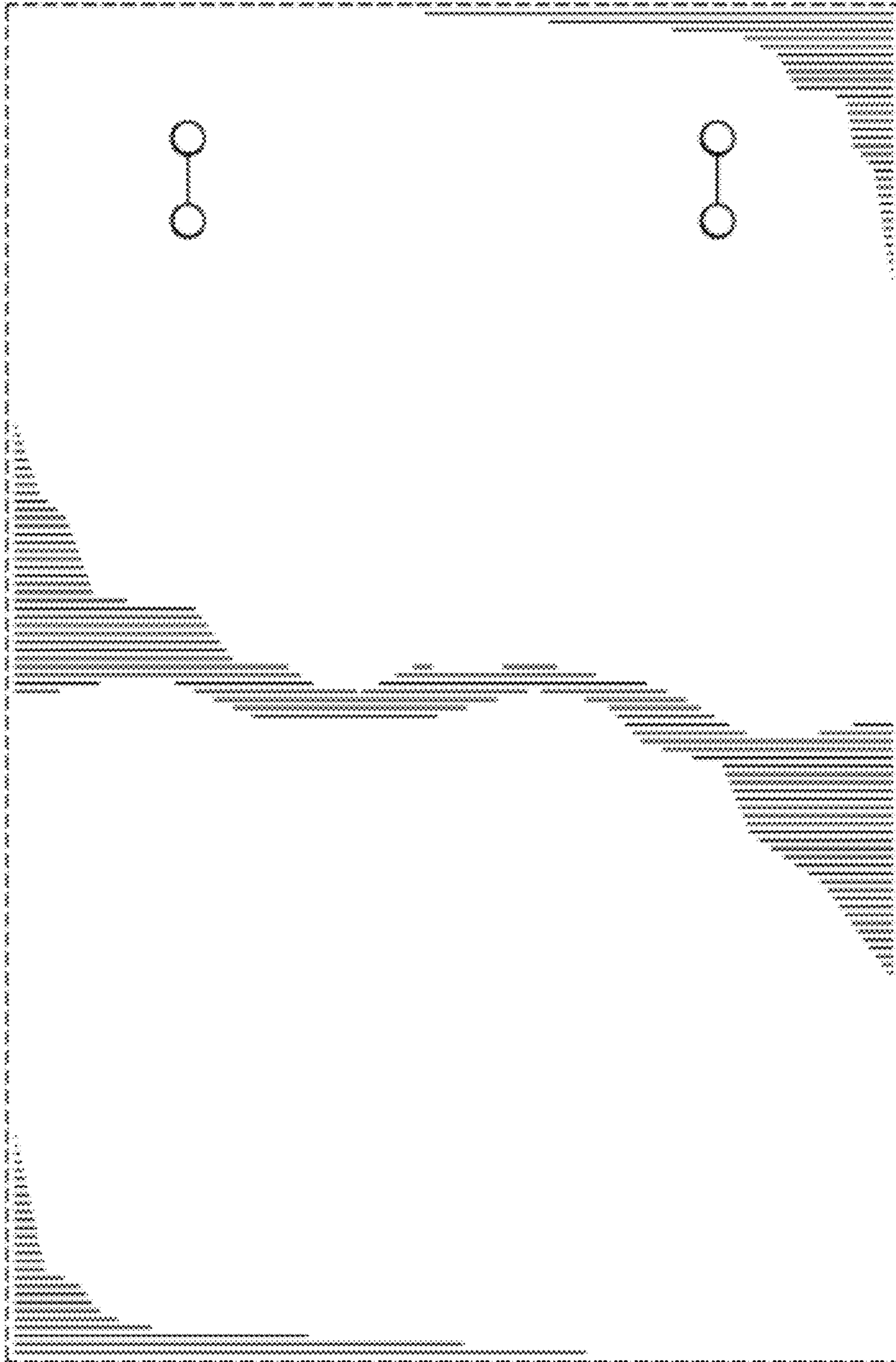

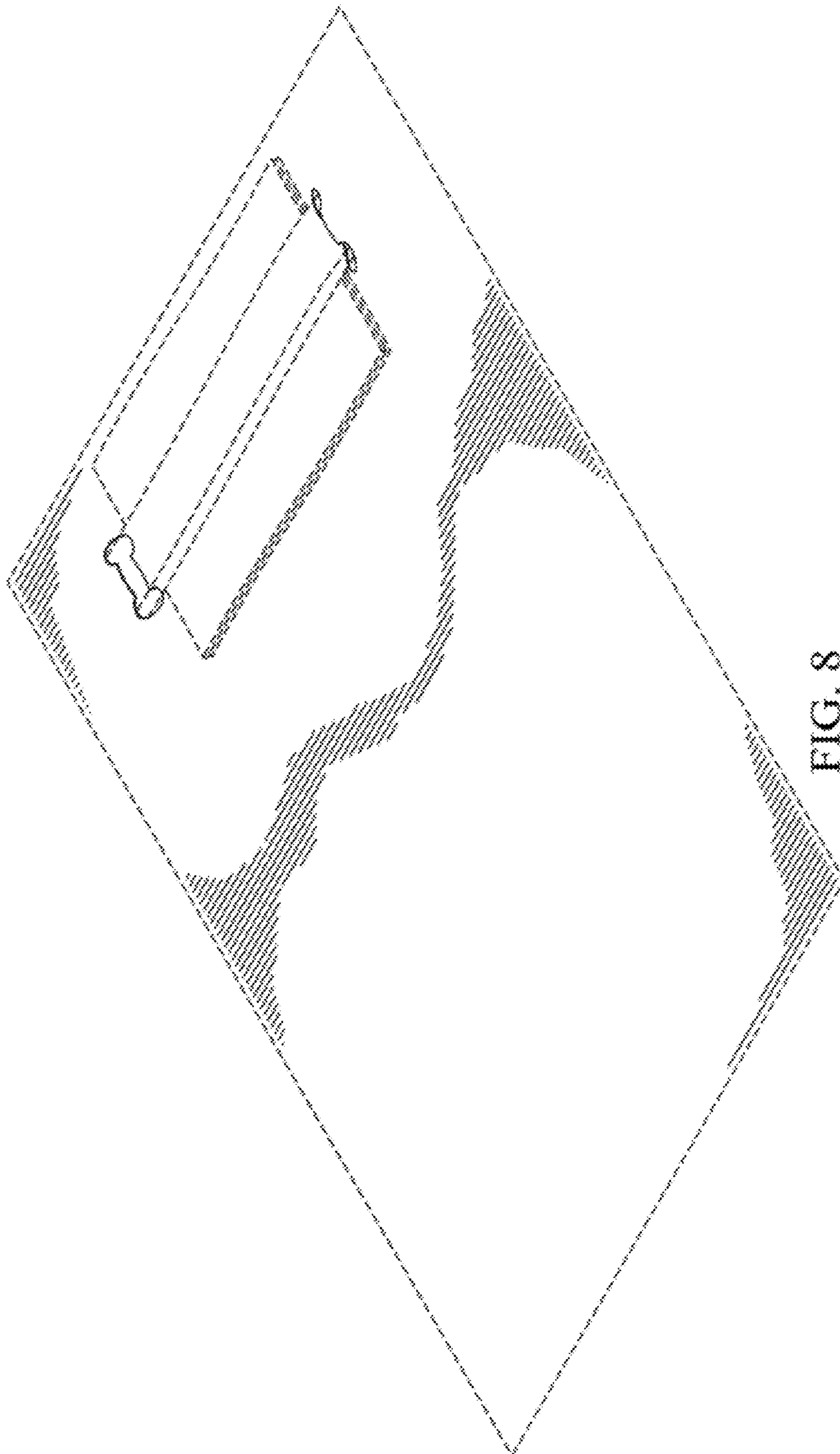

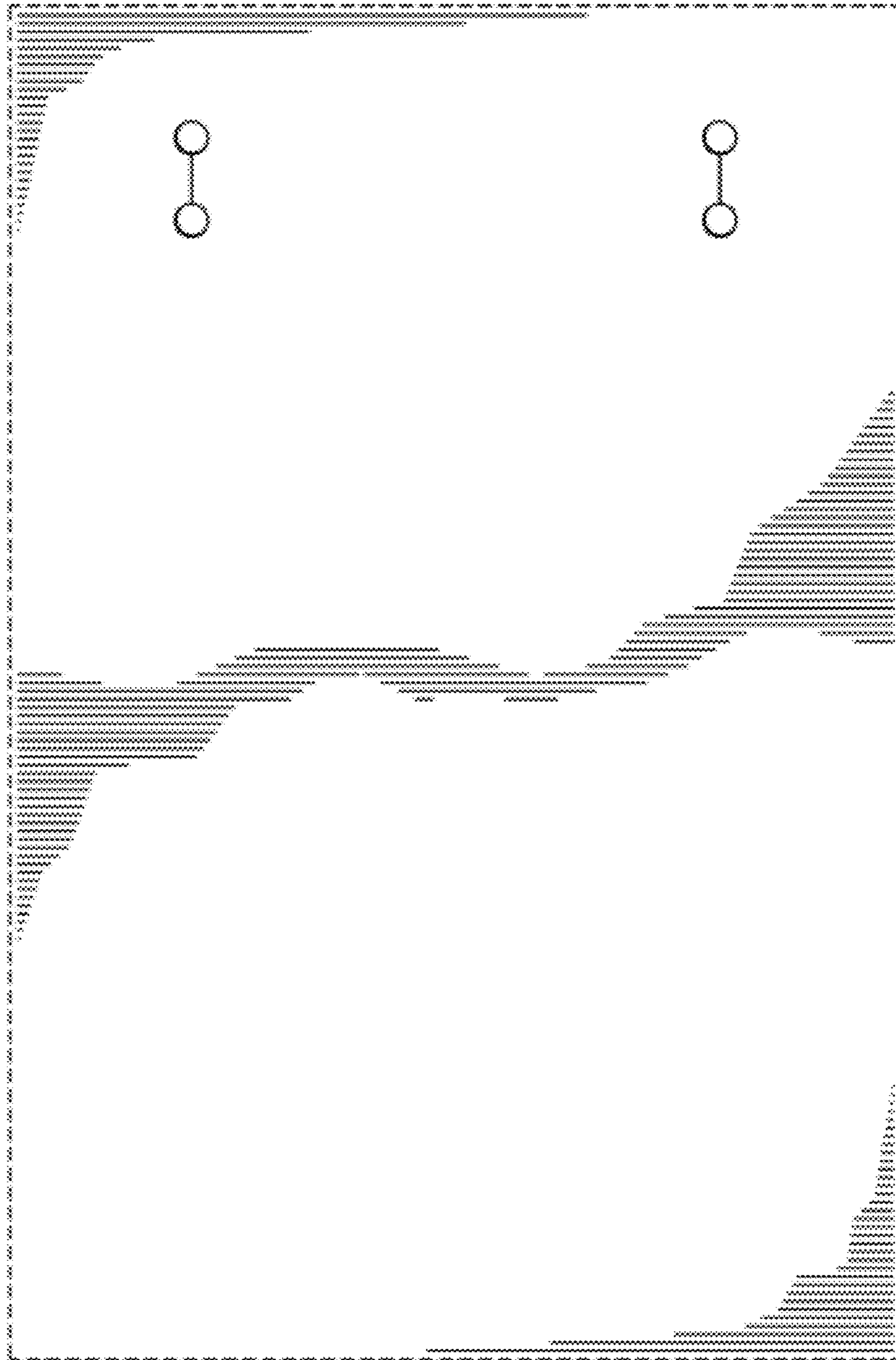

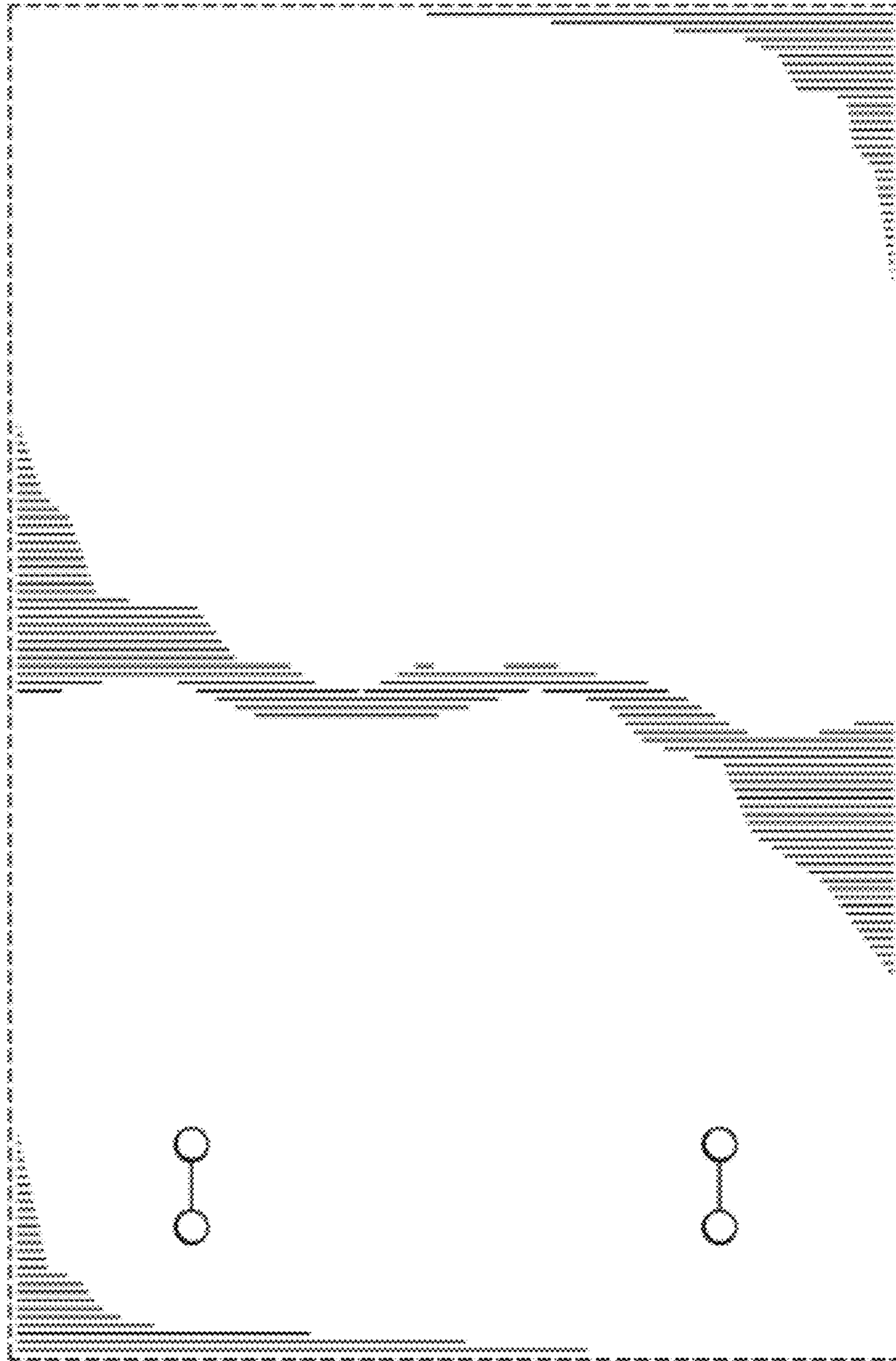

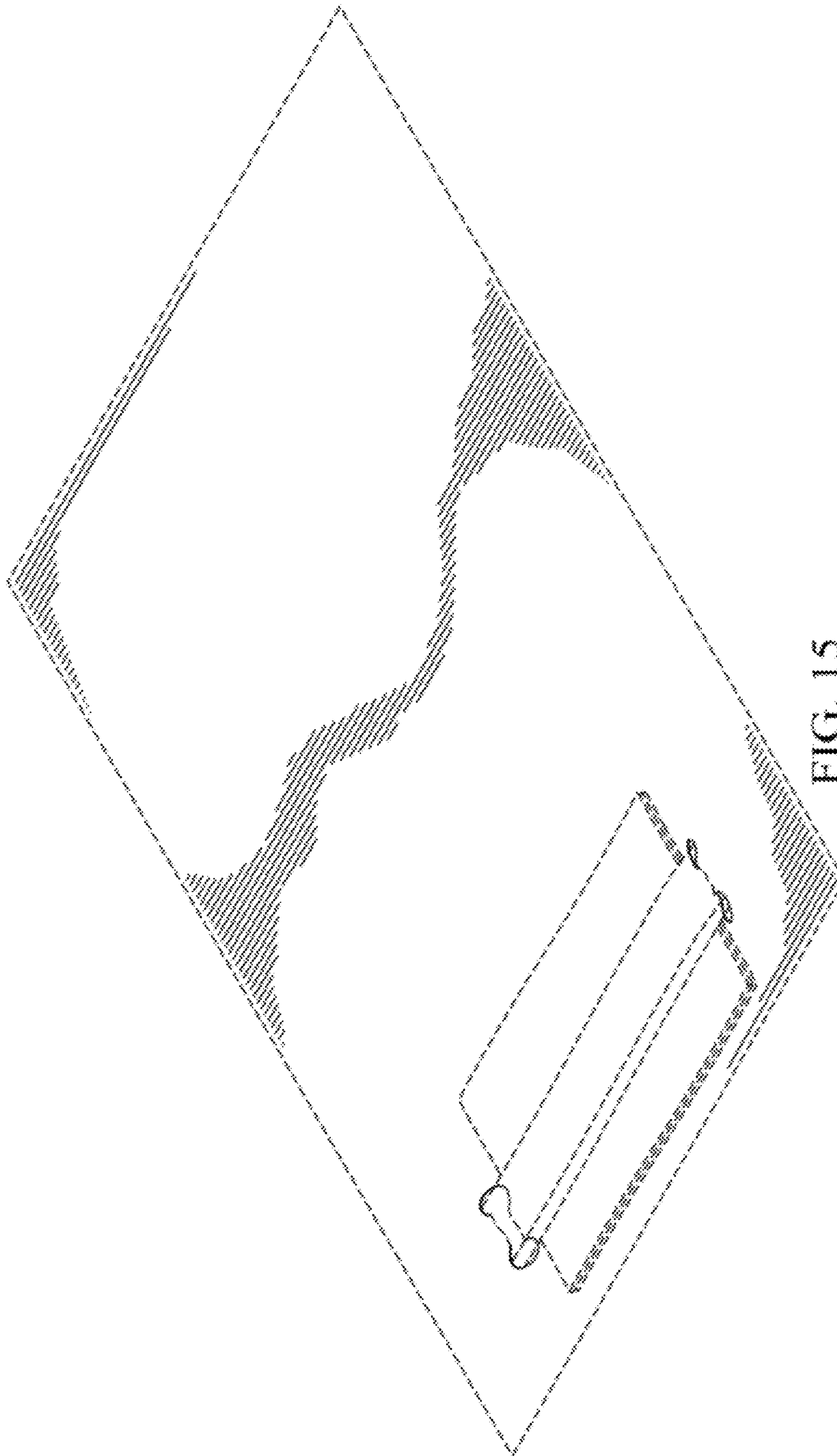

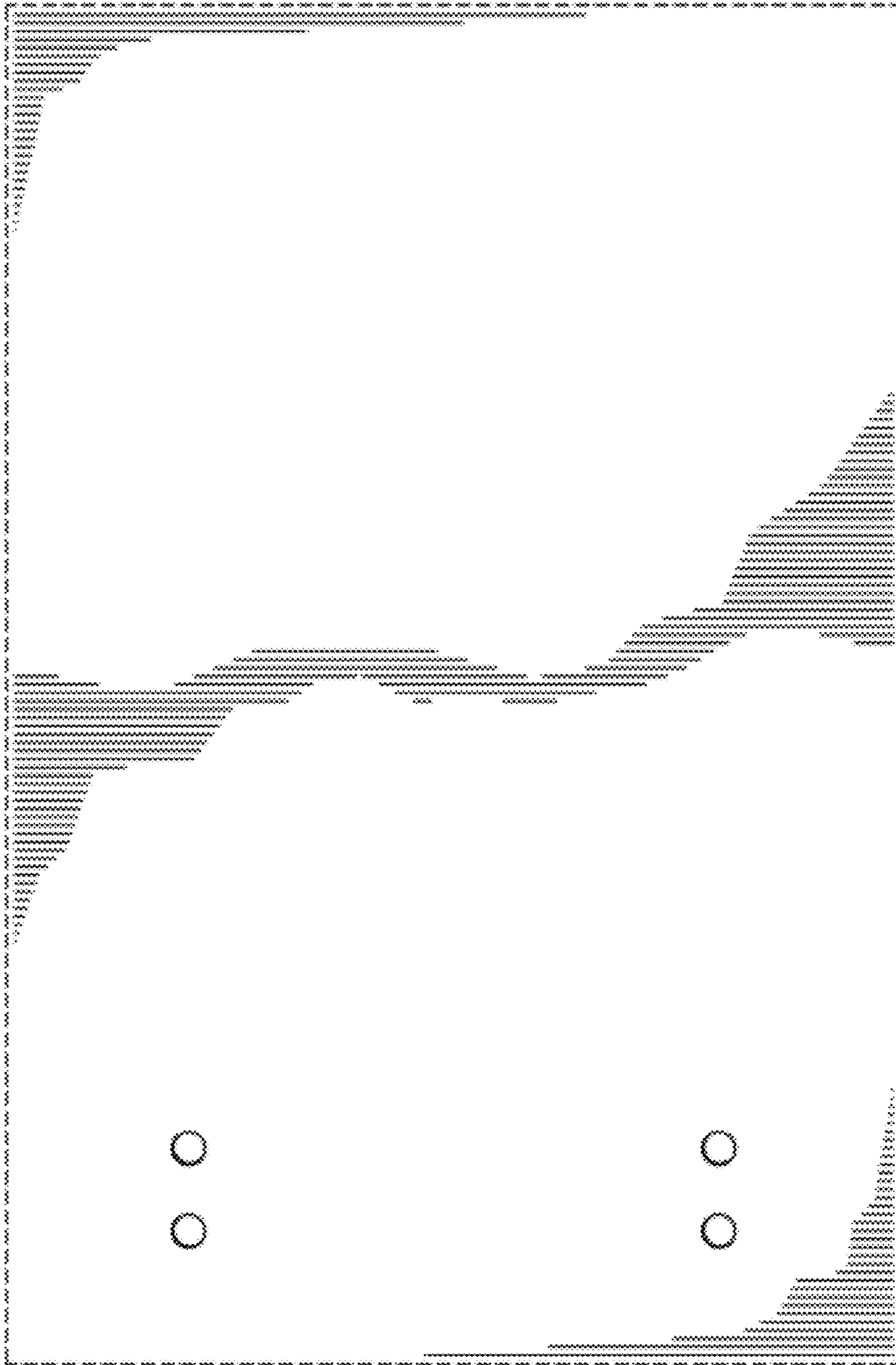

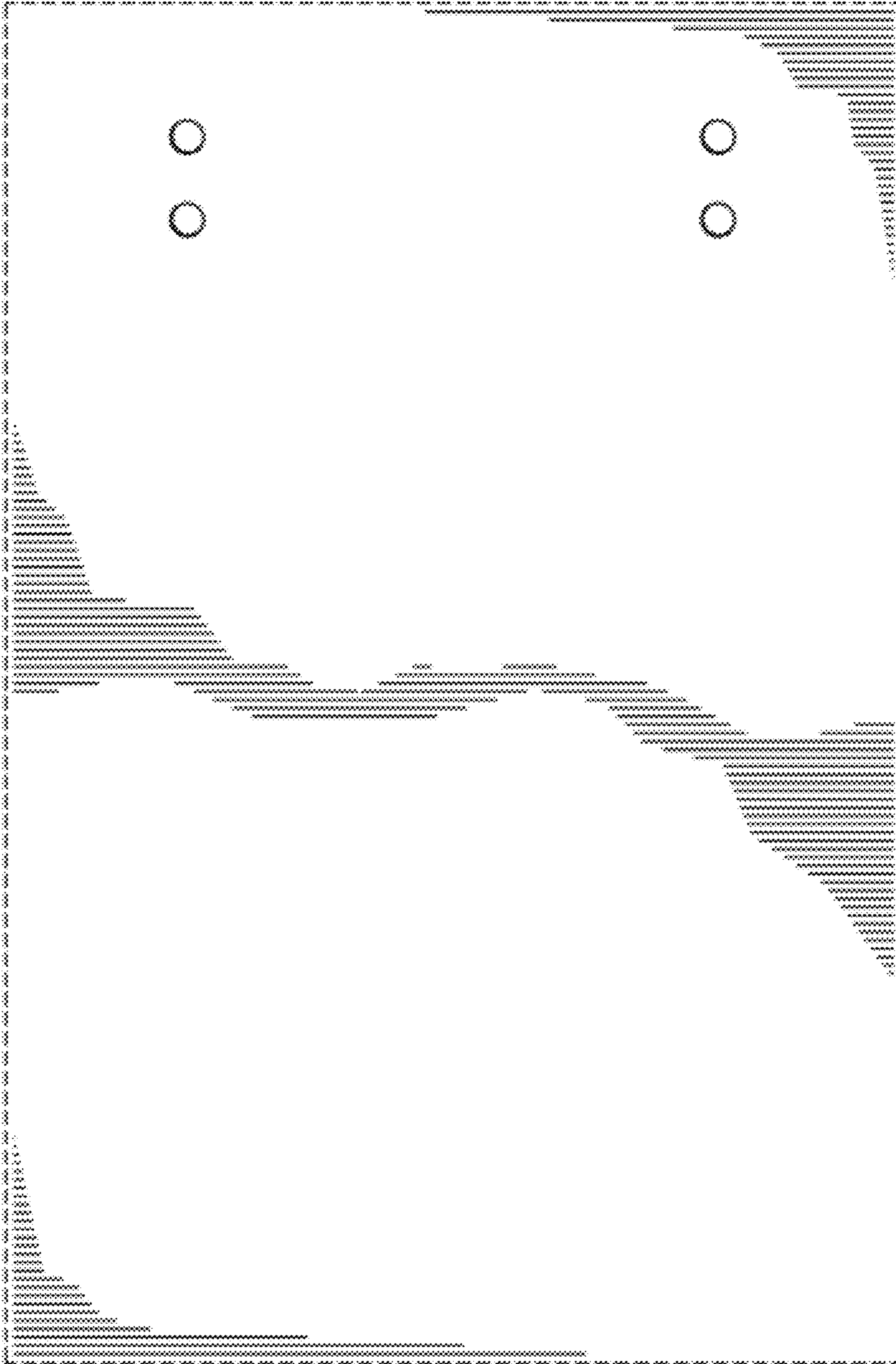

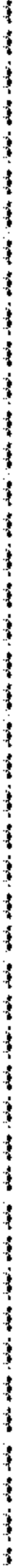

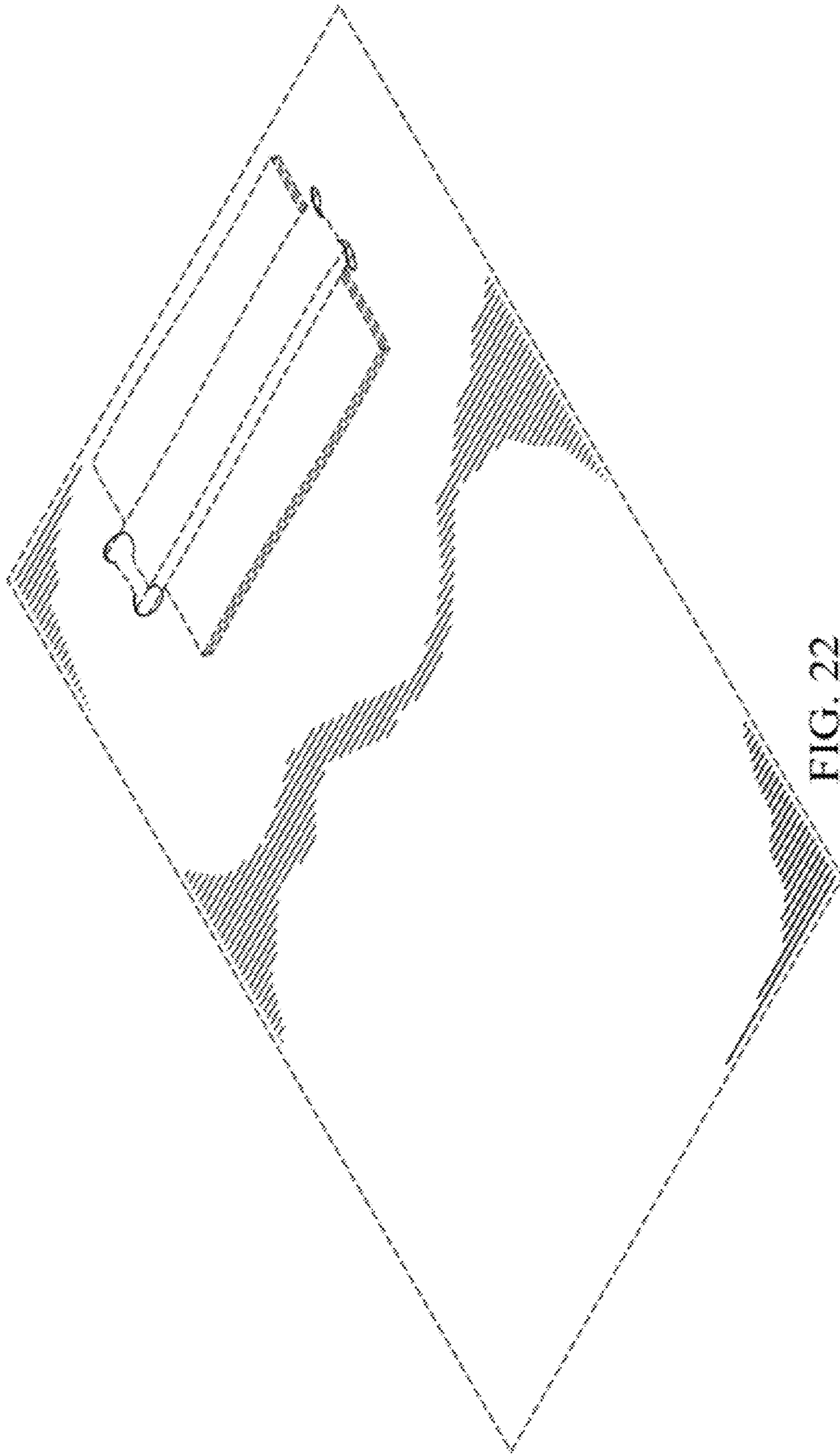

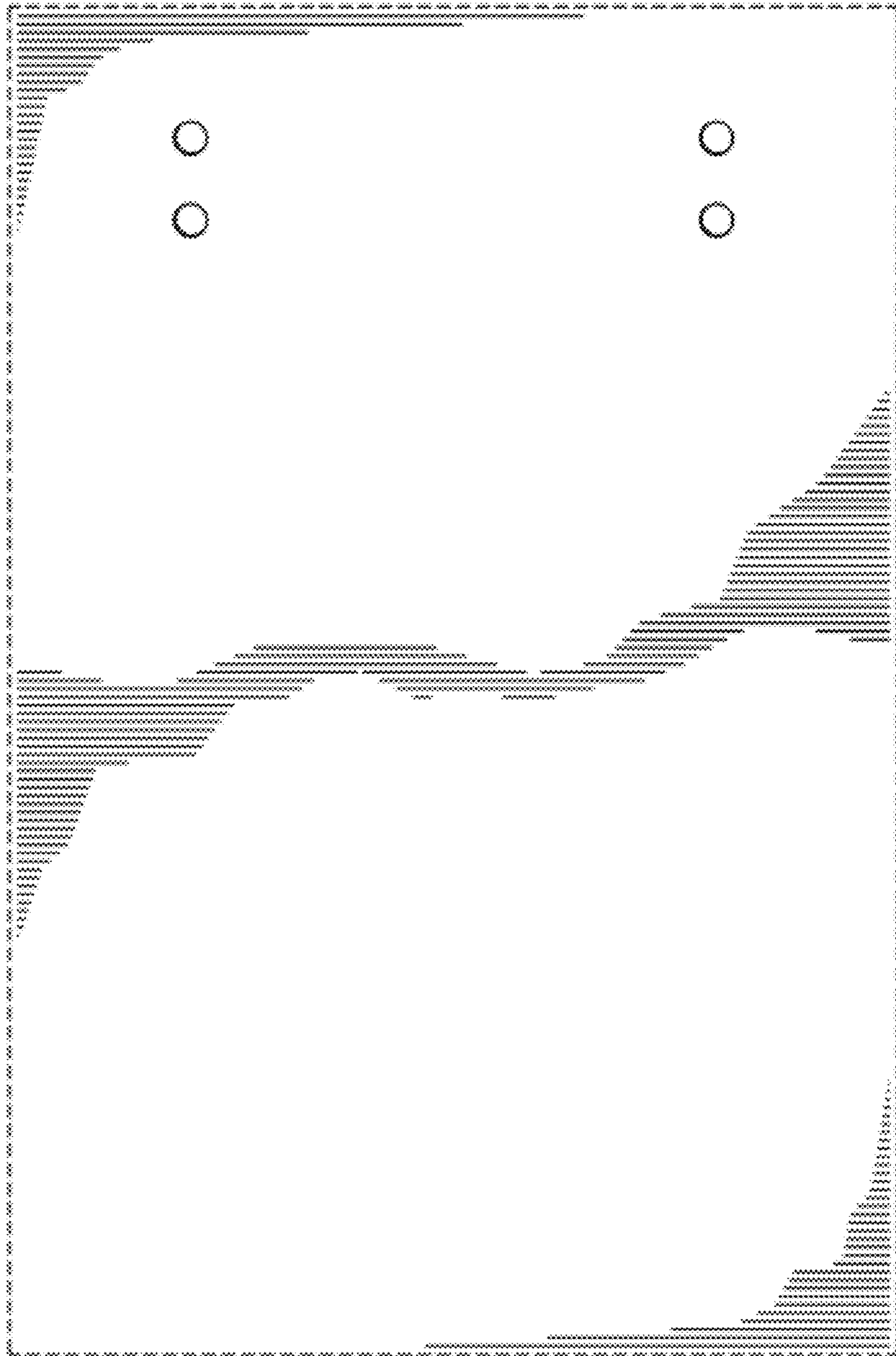

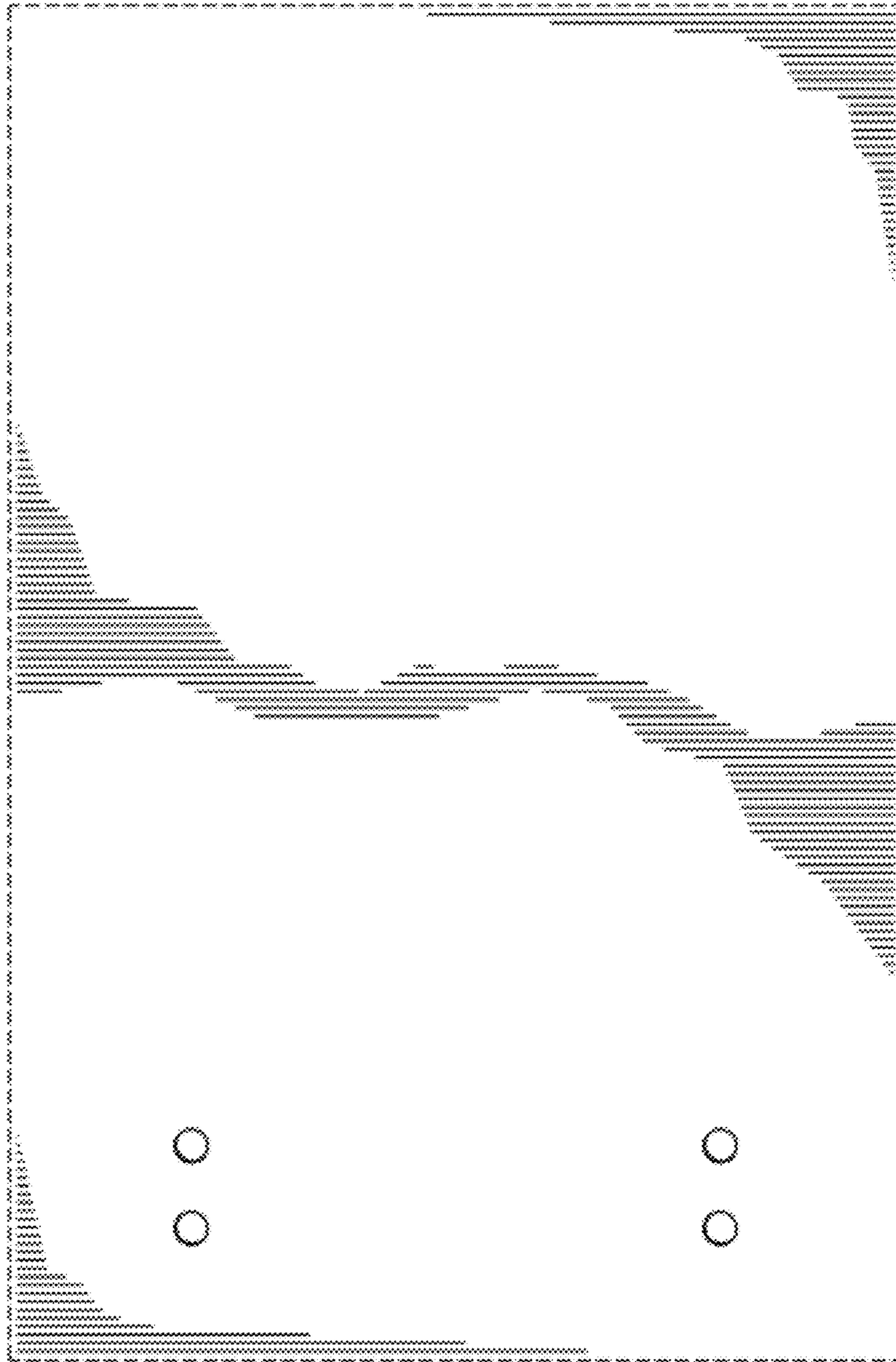
