(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an organizer bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevated view of the organizer bag showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevated view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top end view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom end view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right end view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof;

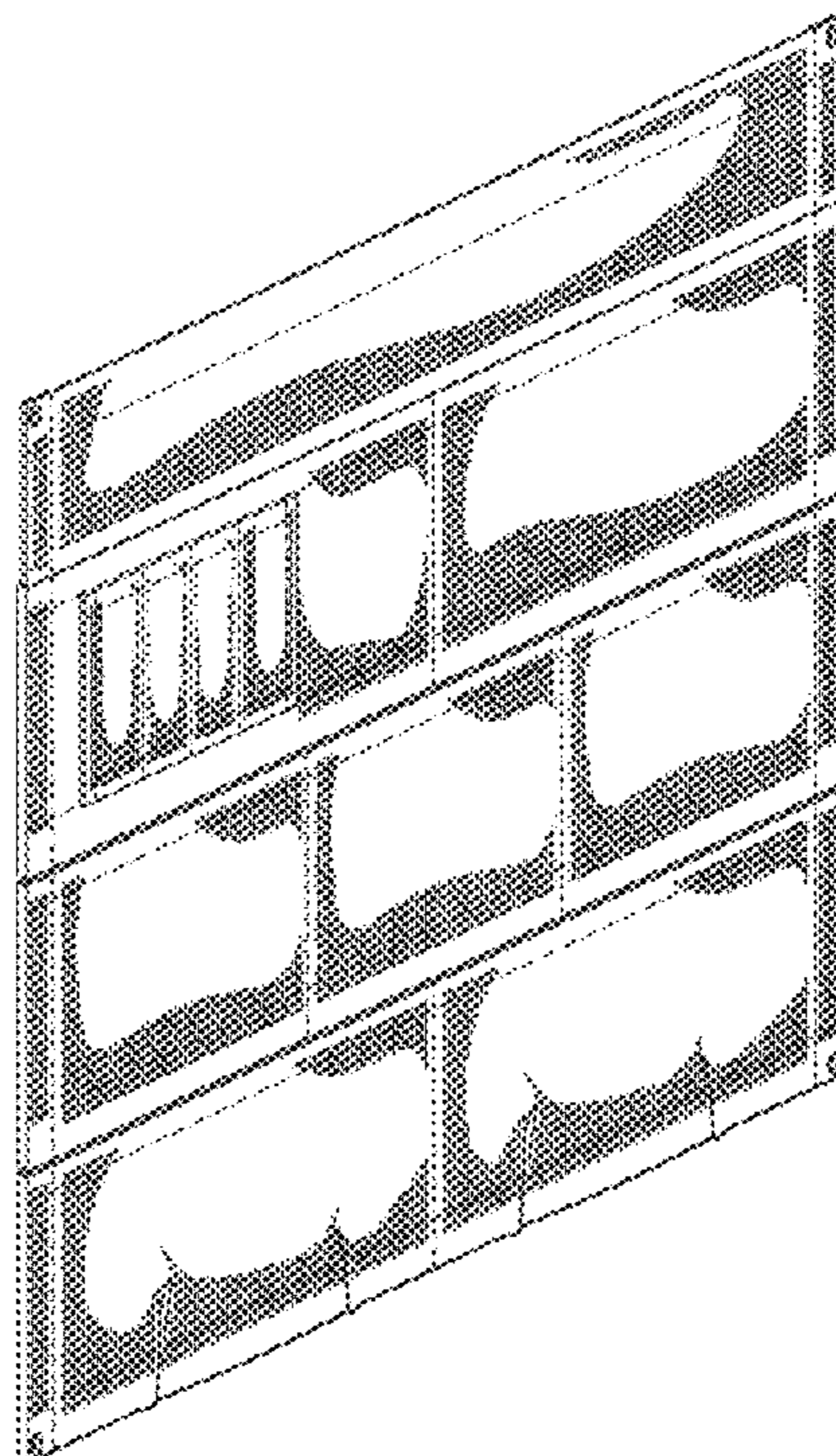
FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view thereof; and,

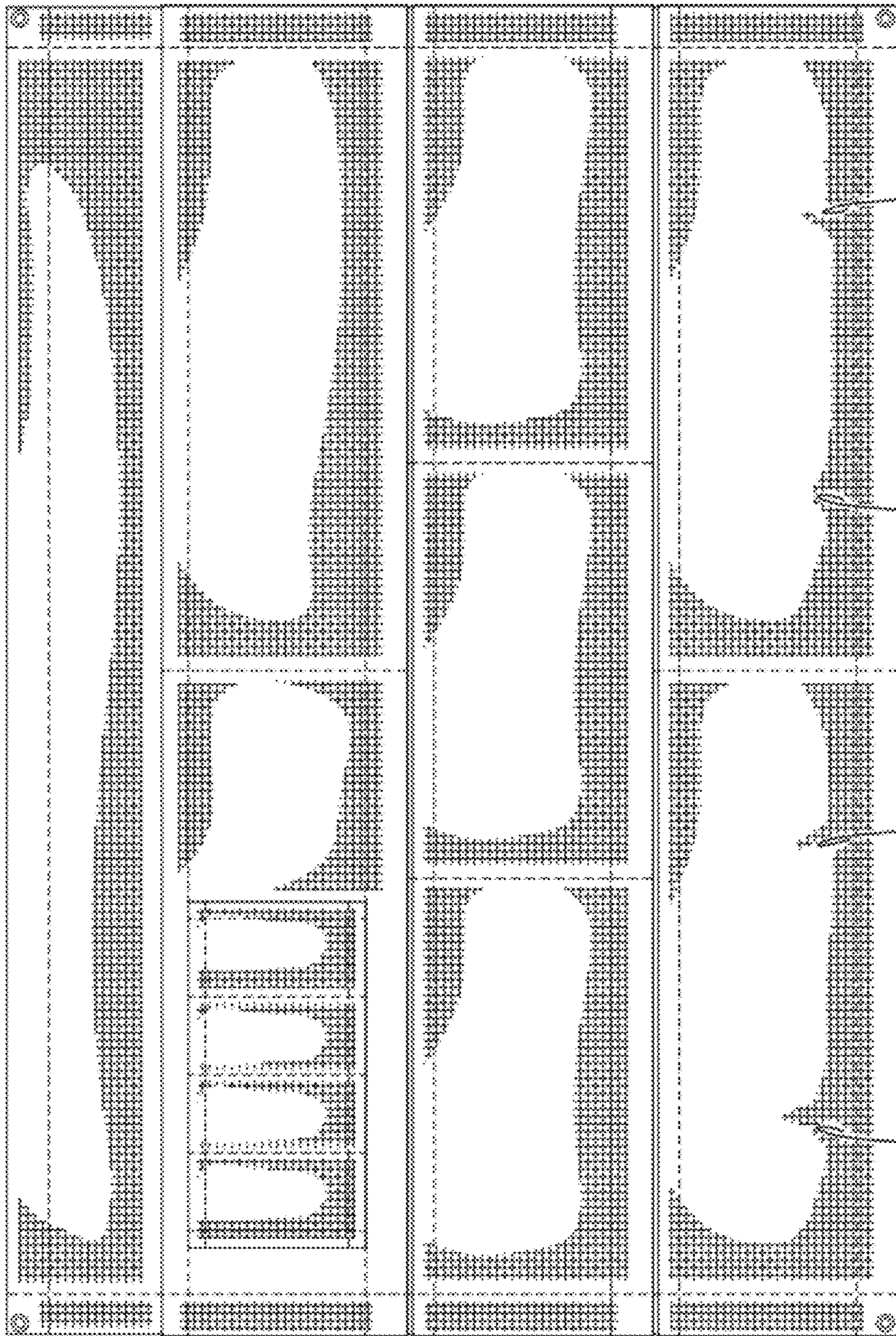

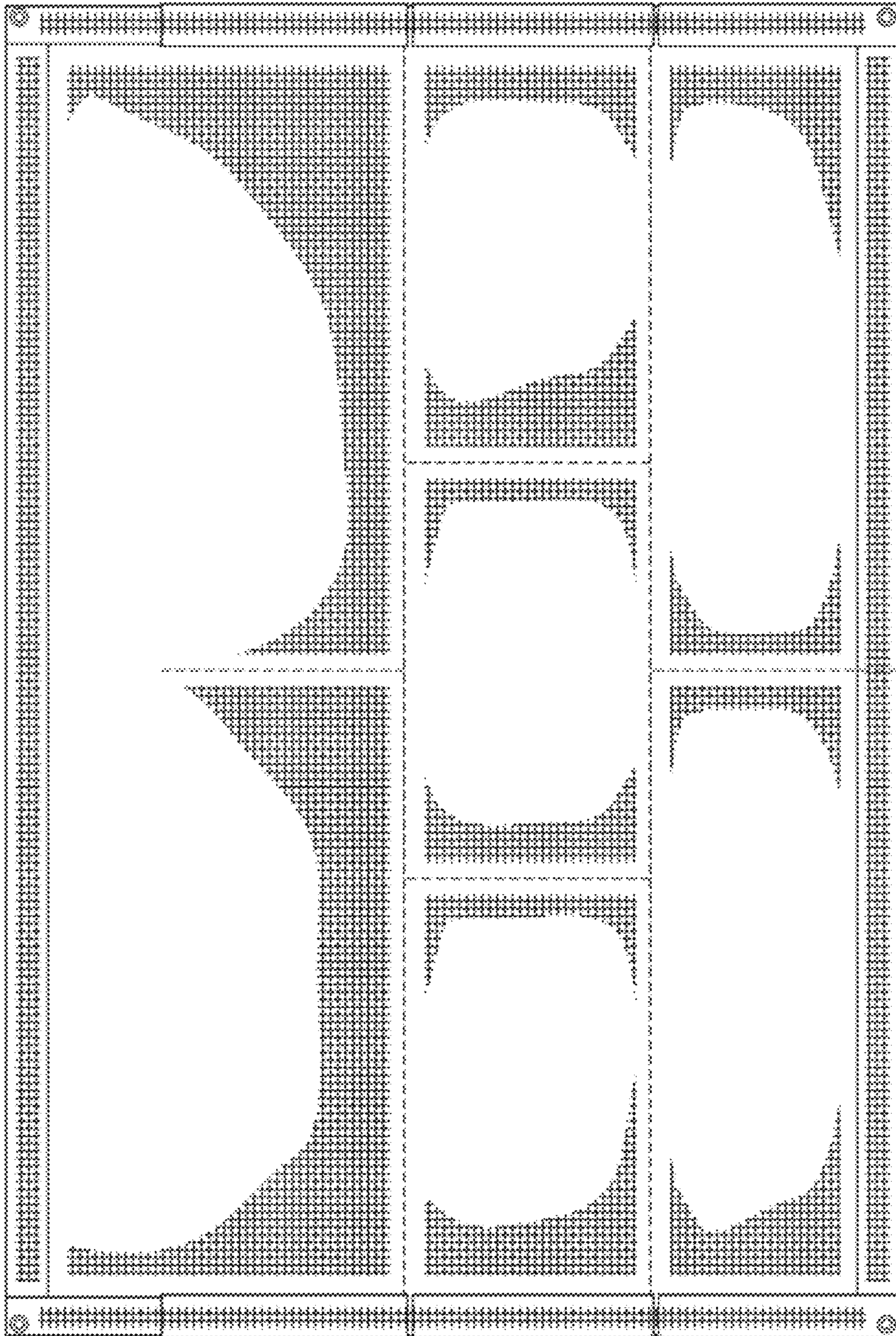

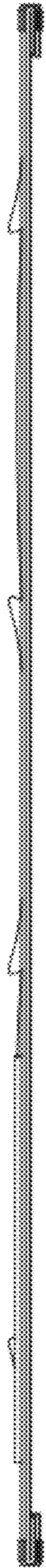

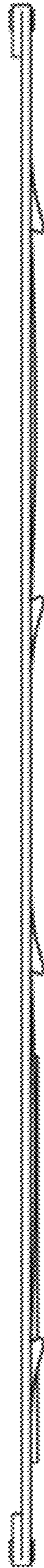

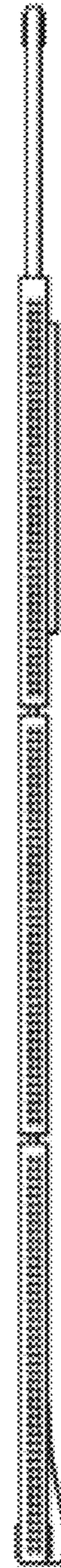

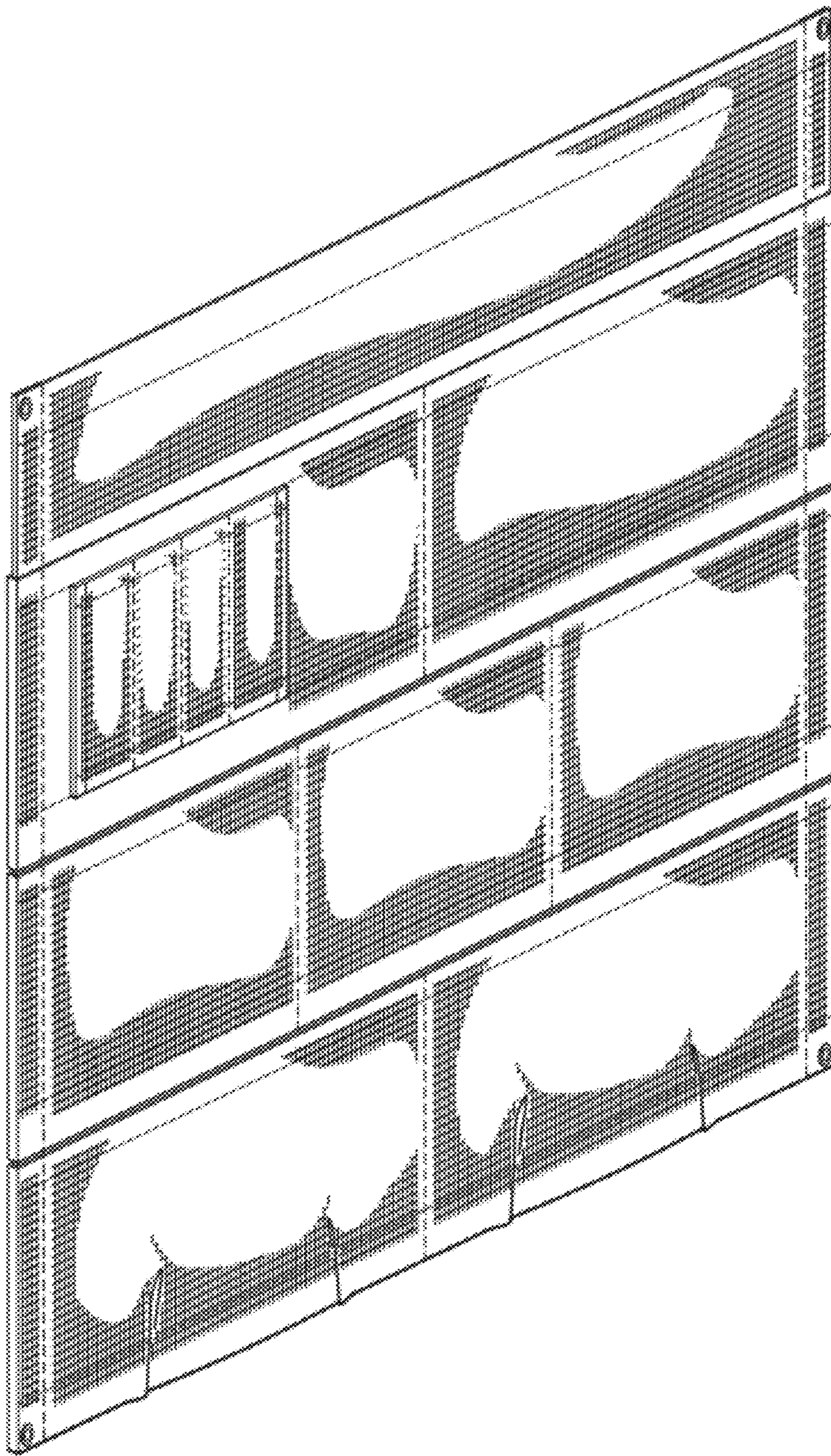

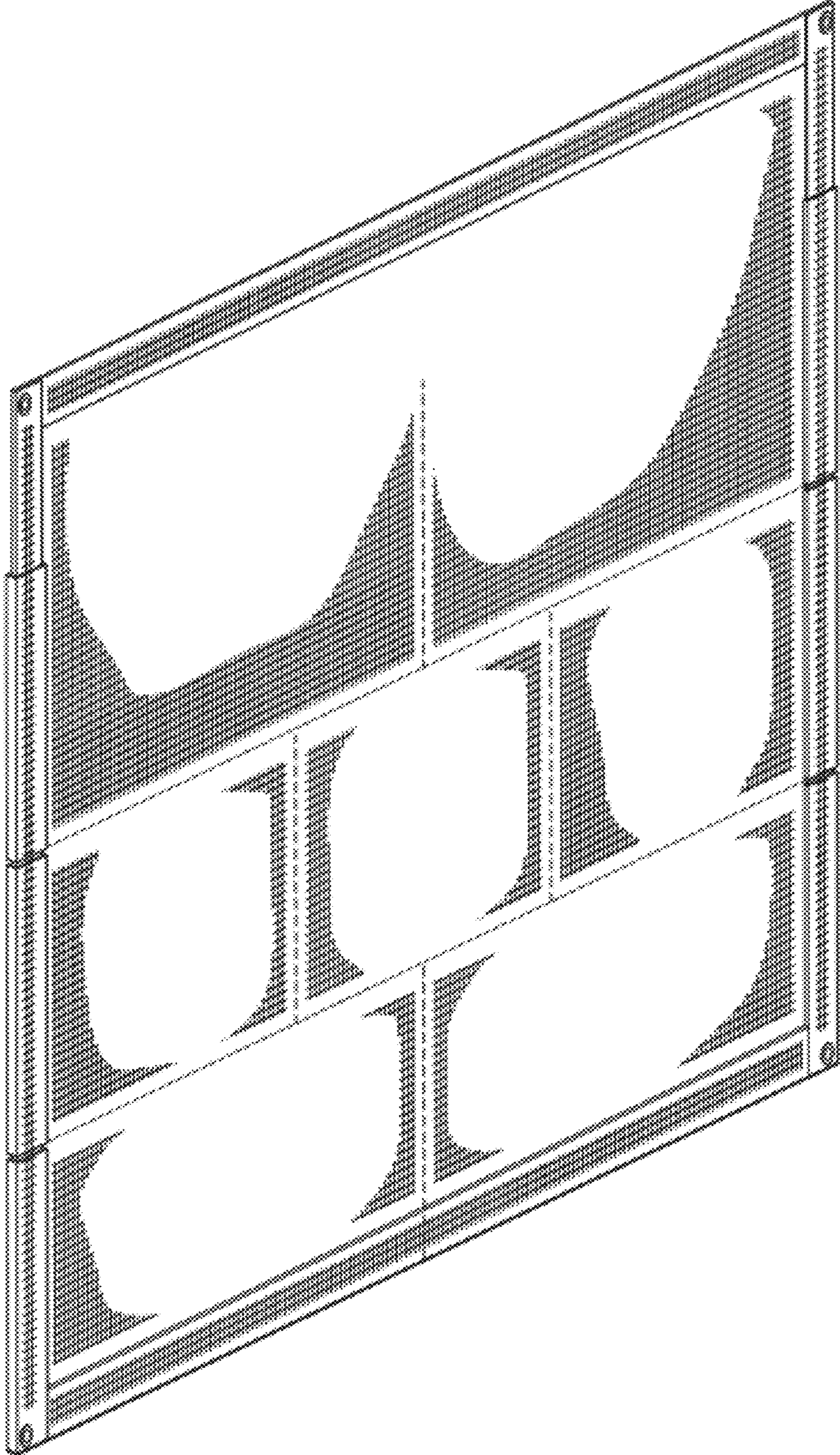

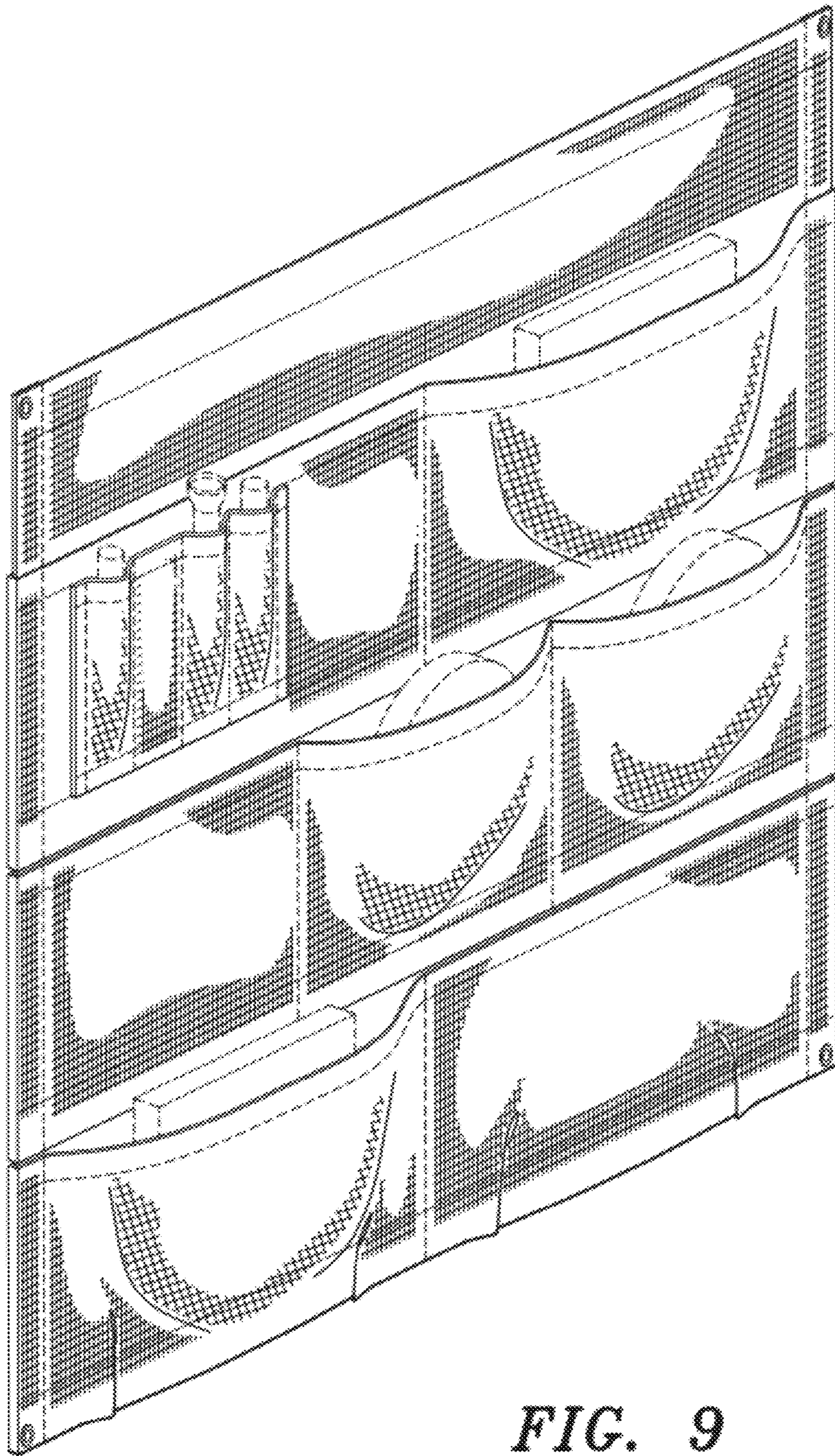
