(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a healthcare facility privacy curtain, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the curtain of the present invention (track system not shown);

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the curtain of the present invention, showing the configuration that is presented when the curtain is in use on a track system (track system in broken lines);

FIG. 3 is a front view of the curtain of the present invention when in the configuration of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the present invention when in the configuration of FIG. 2, with the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the present invention when in the configuration of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the present invention when in the configuration of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view of the present invention when in the configuration of FIG. 2.

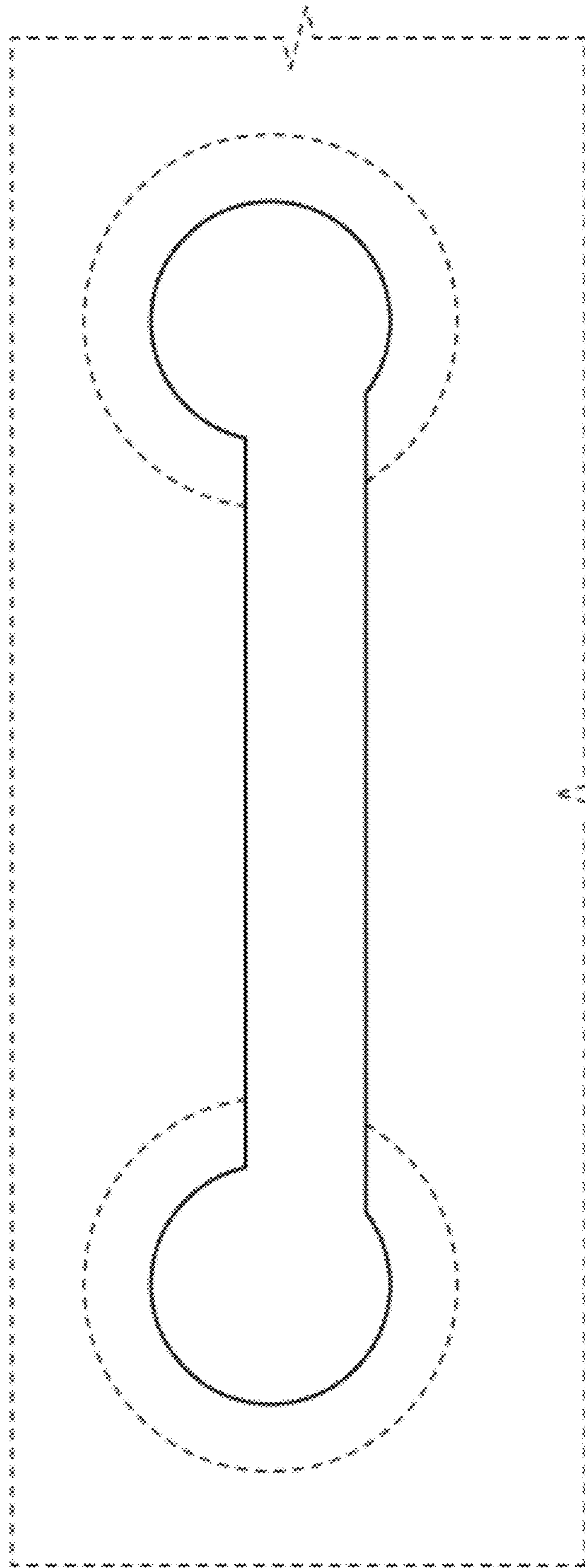

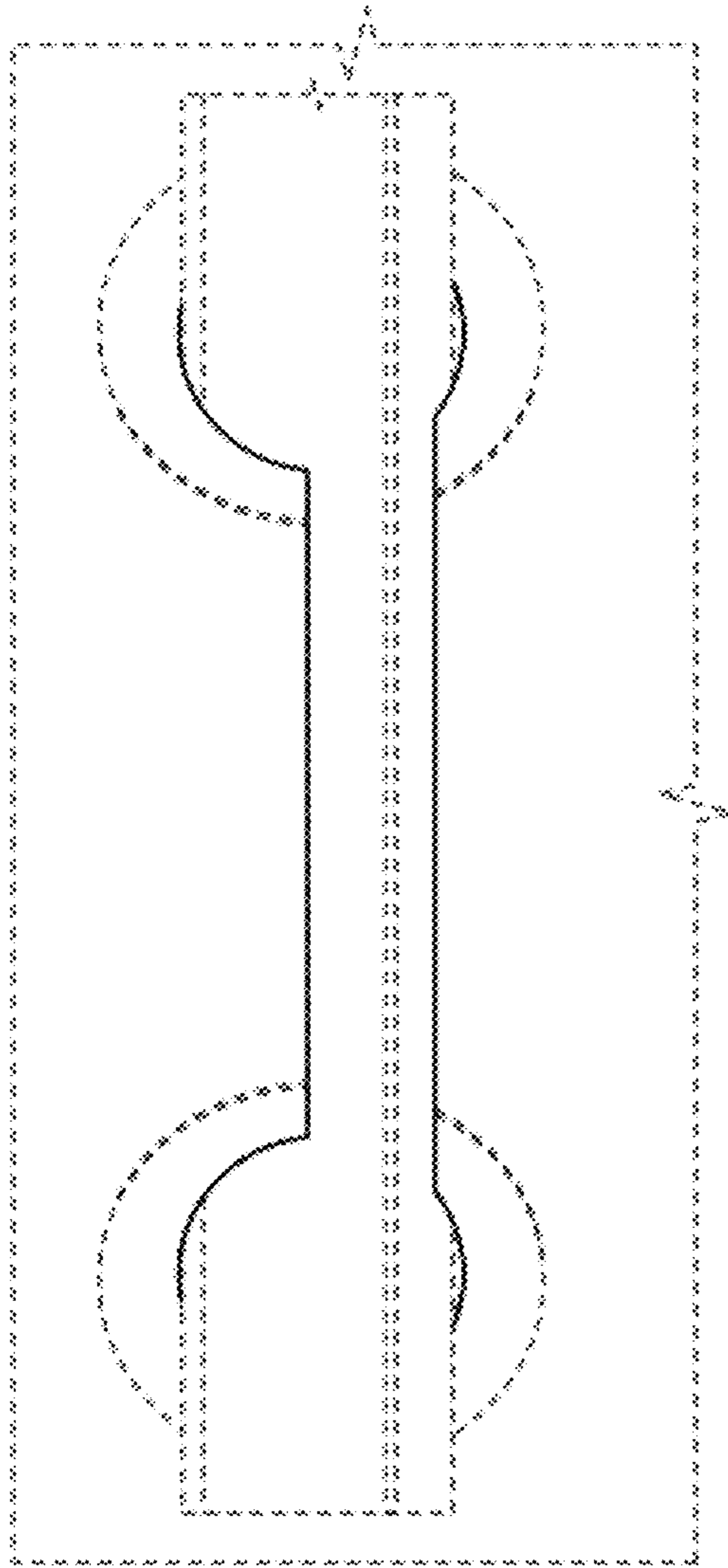
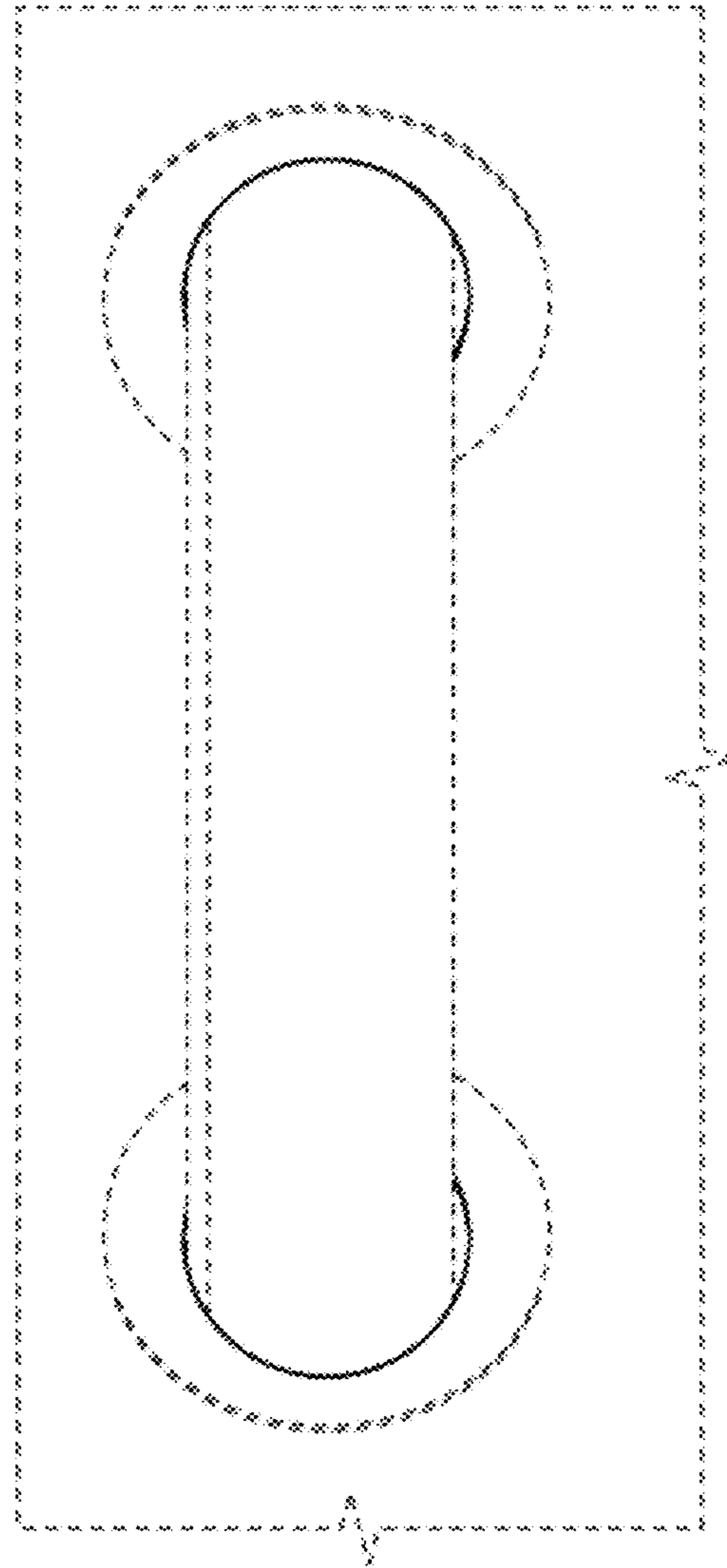

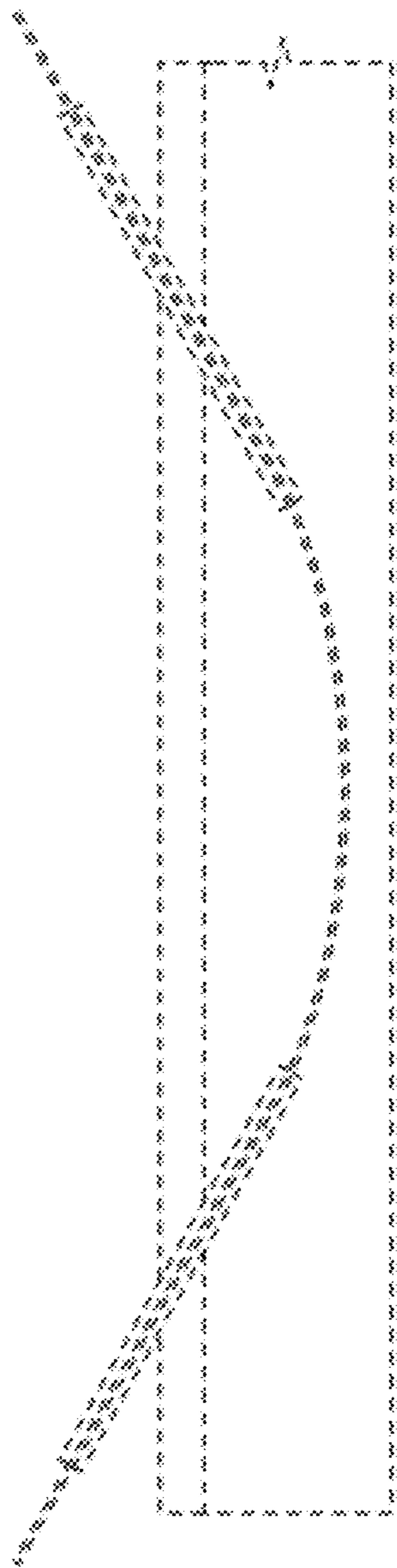

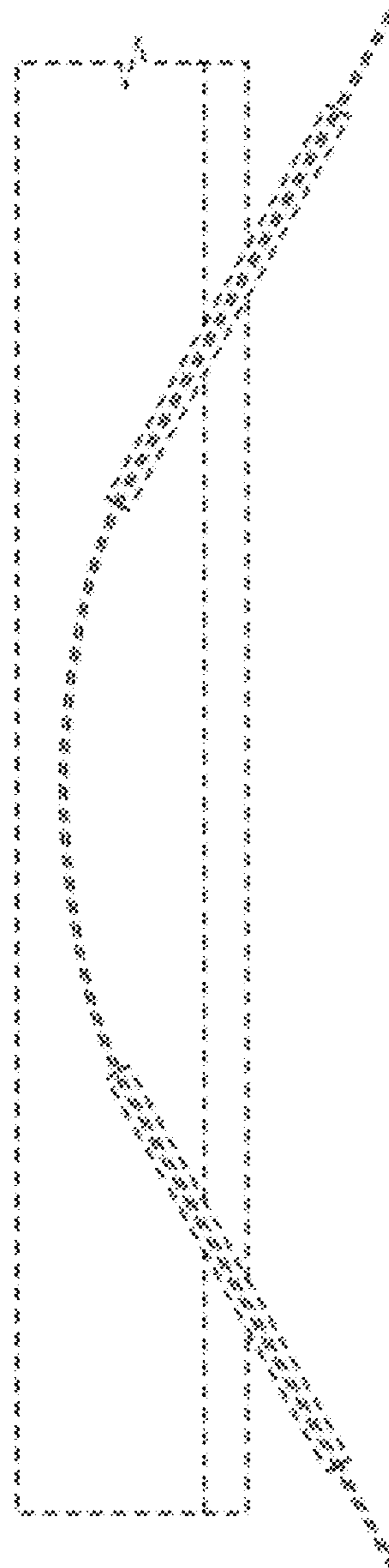

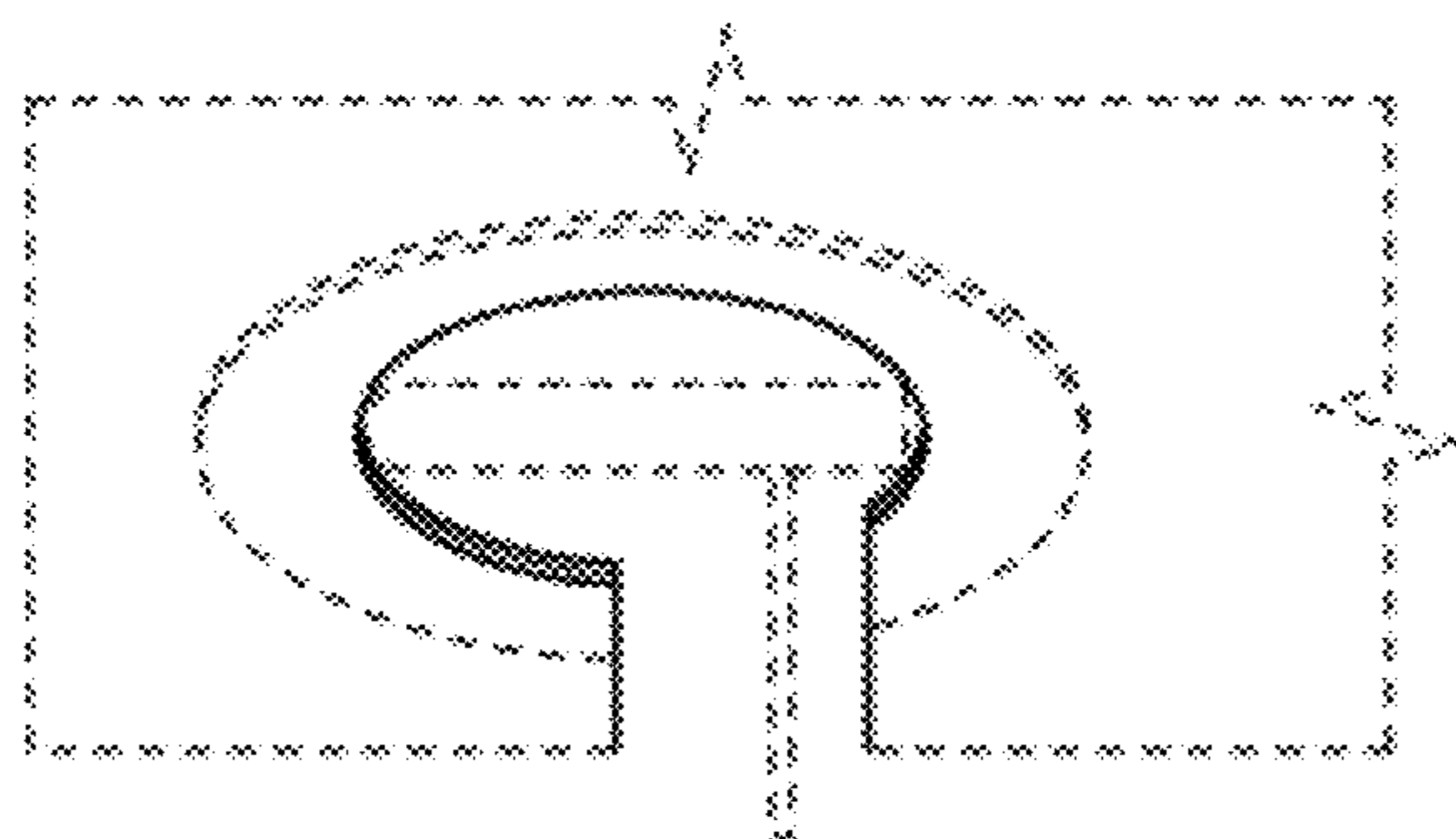

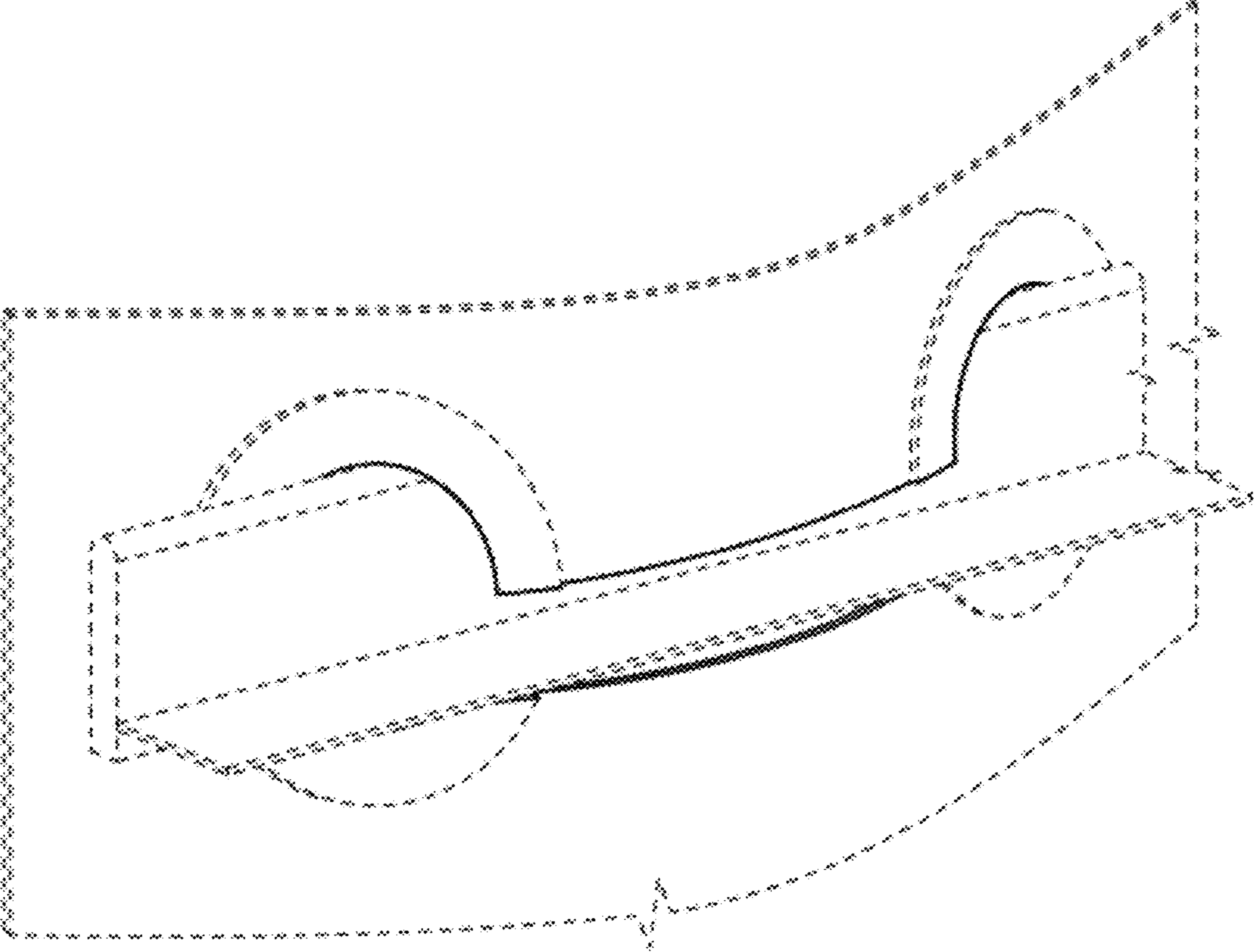
