FIG. 2 is an isometric view of the divided lunch box set, presented in the exploded state;

FIG. 8 is an isometric view of the cover of the divided lunch box set;

FIG. 11 is a front view of the cover of the divided lunch box set; and,  
FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the cover of the divided lunch box set.  
The utensils are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

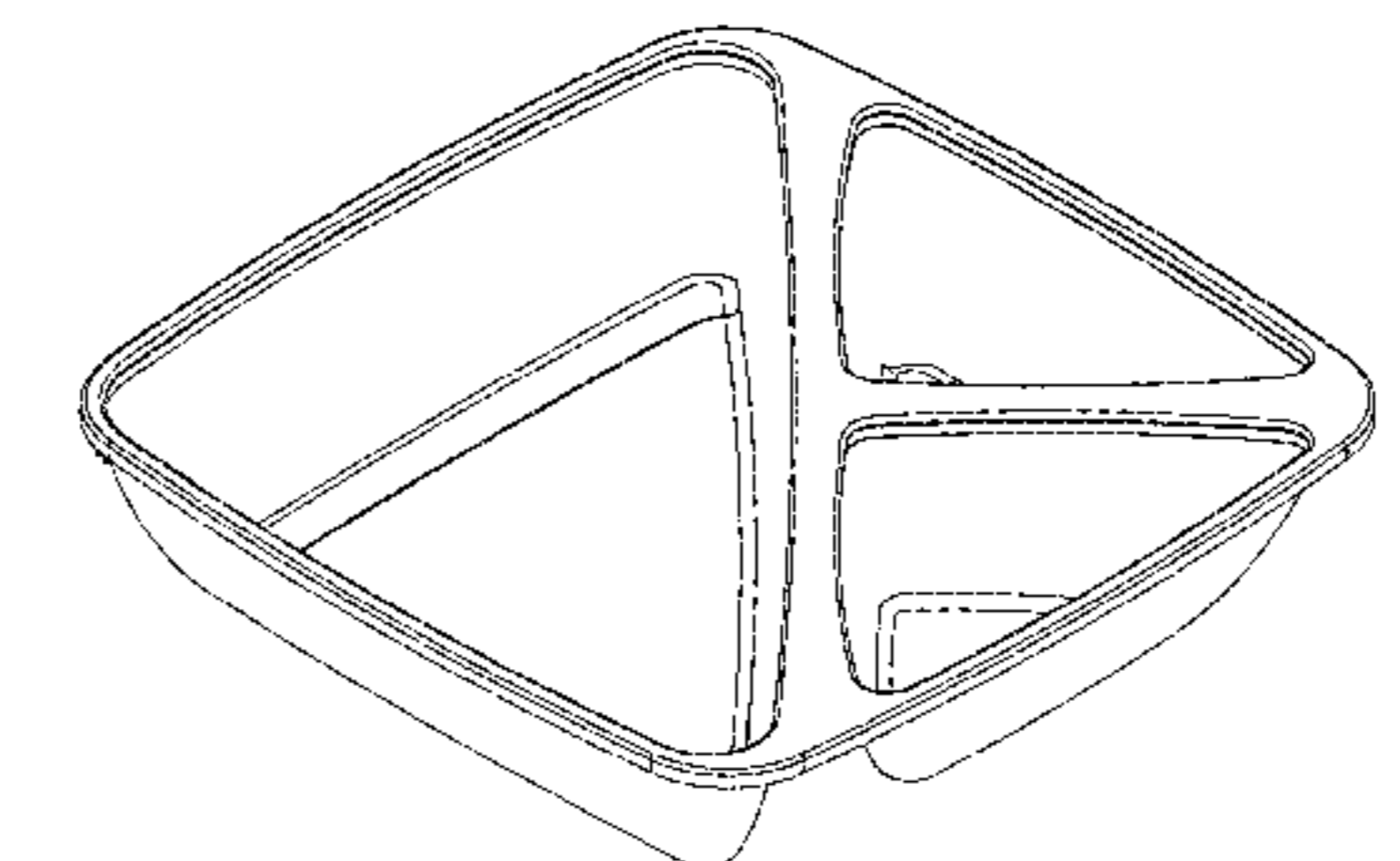
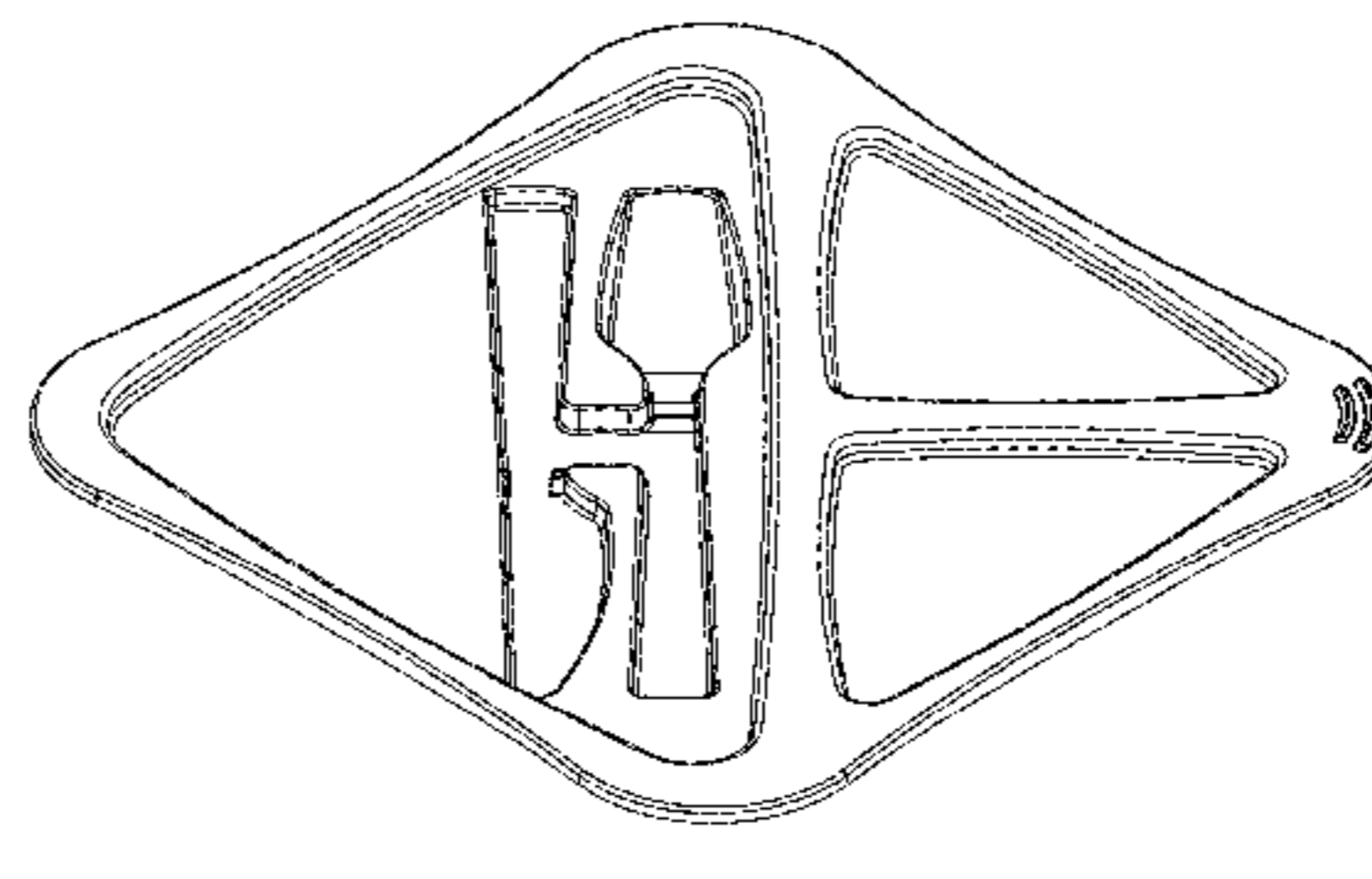
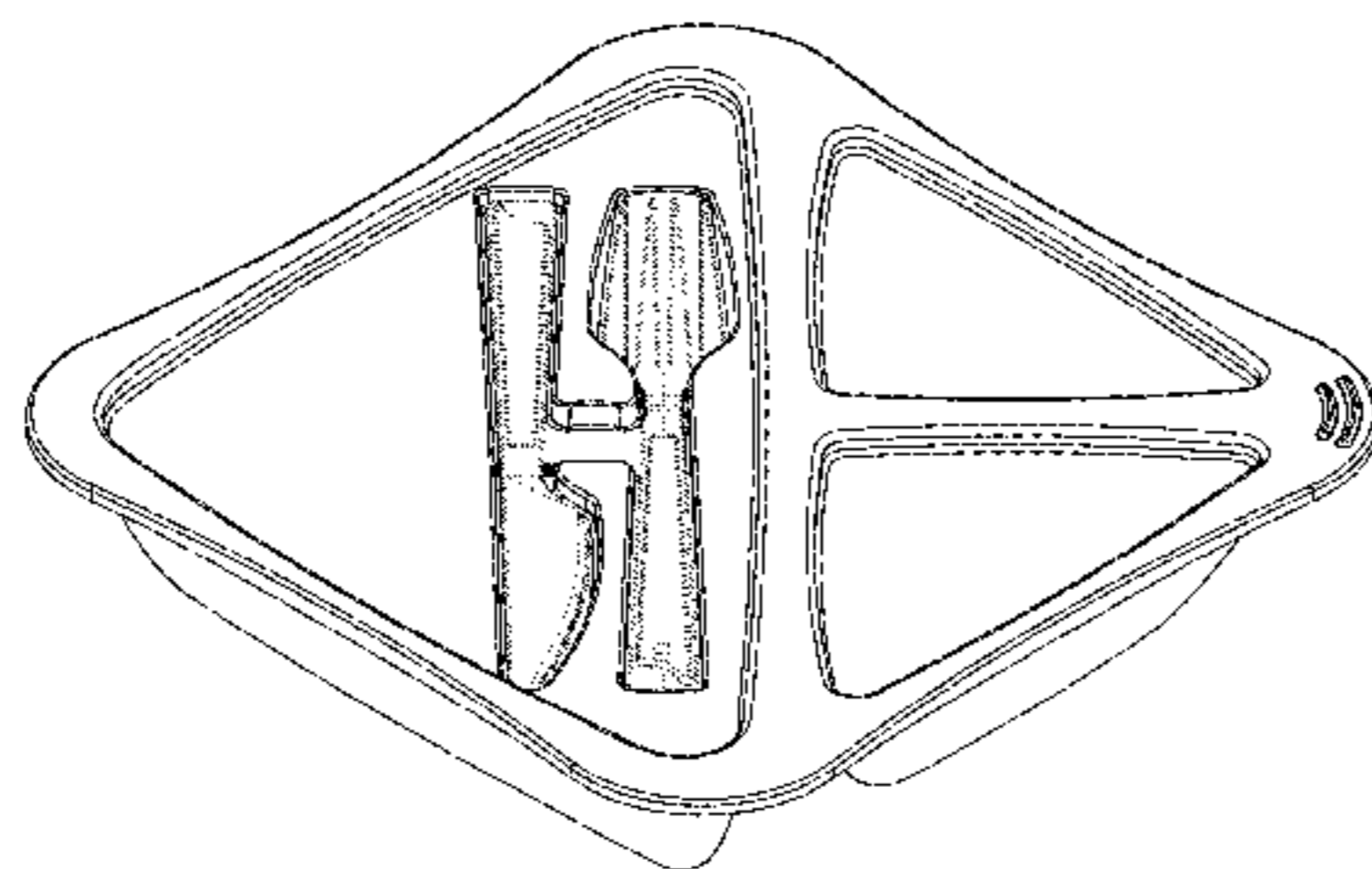

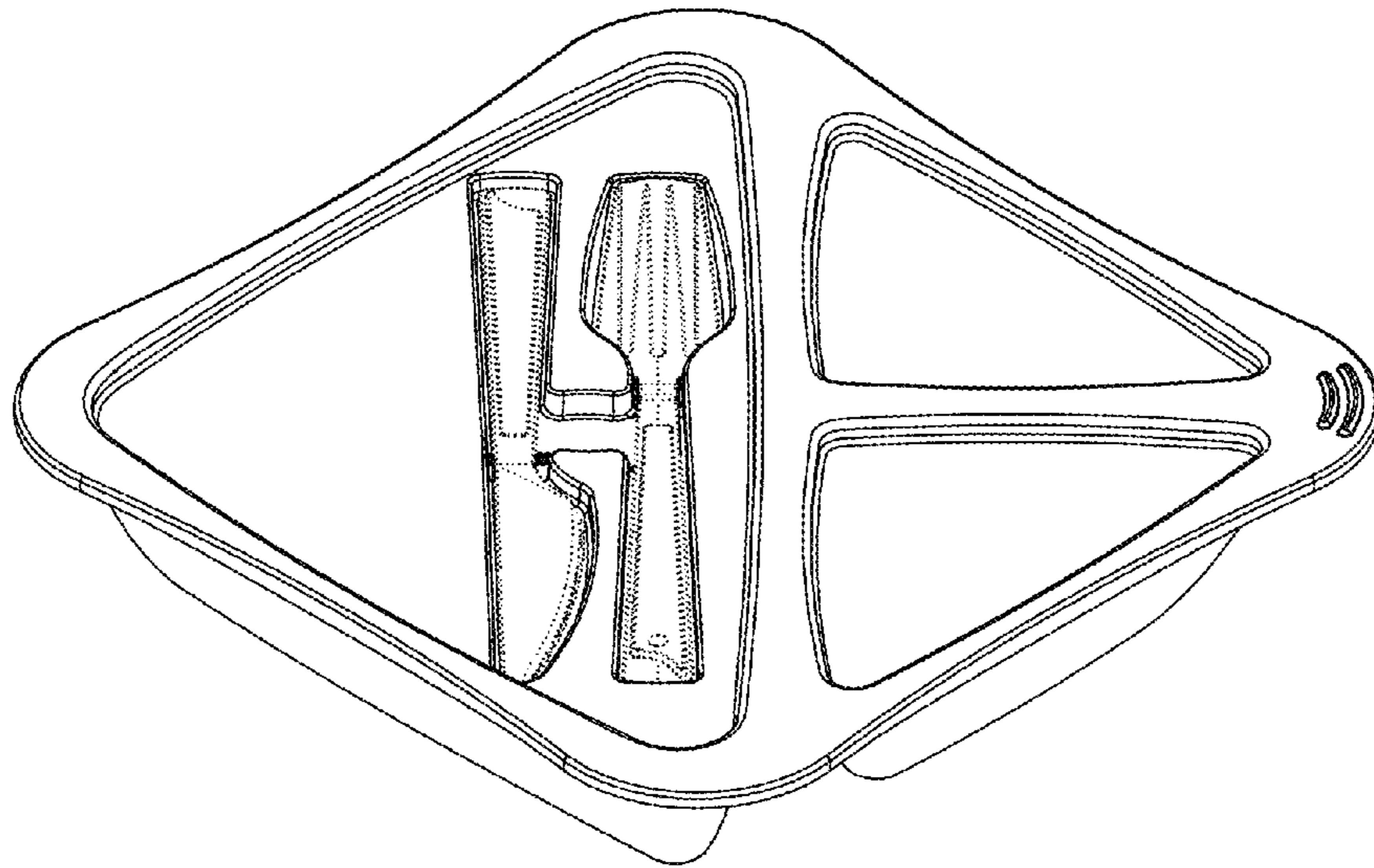

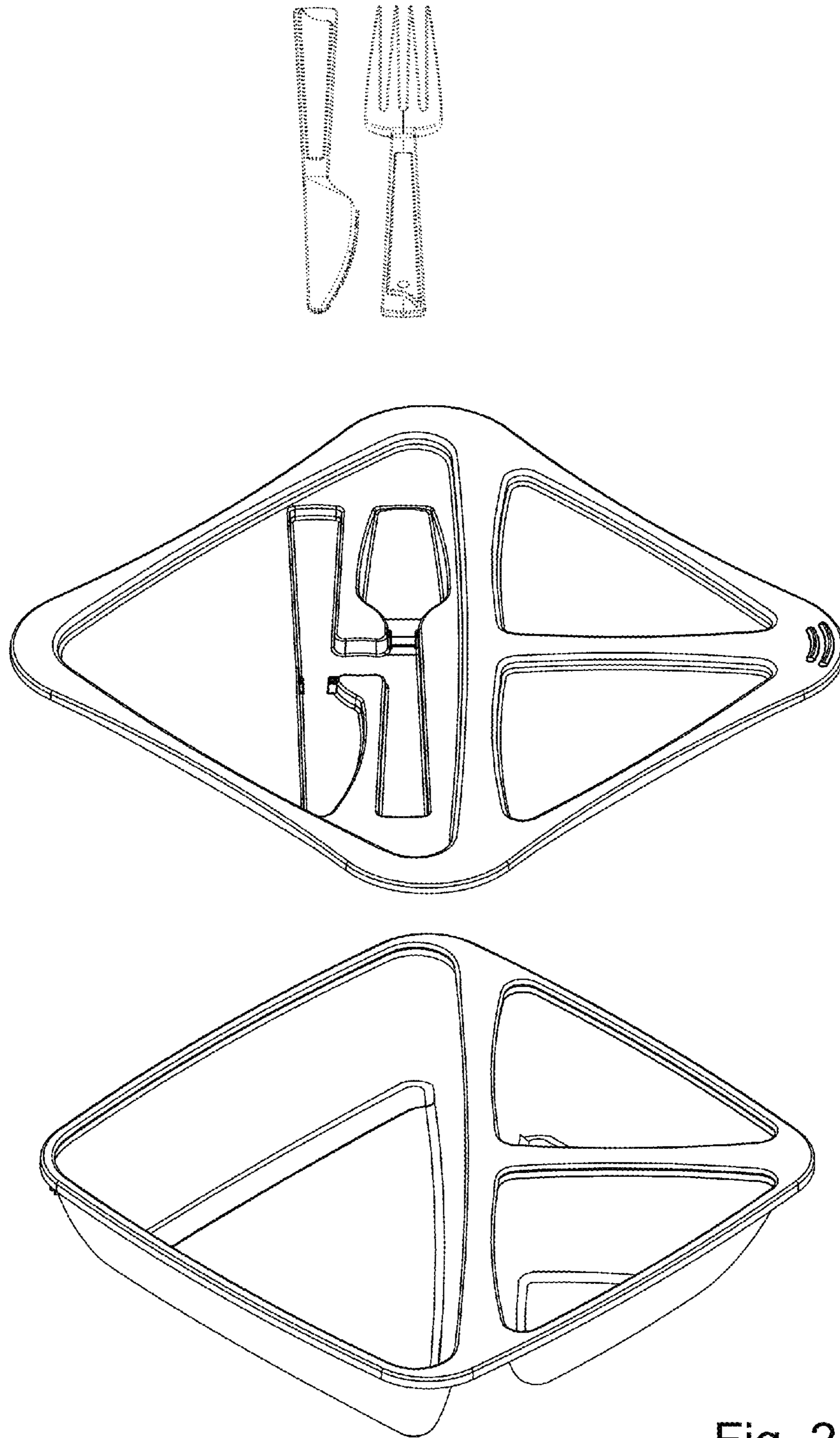

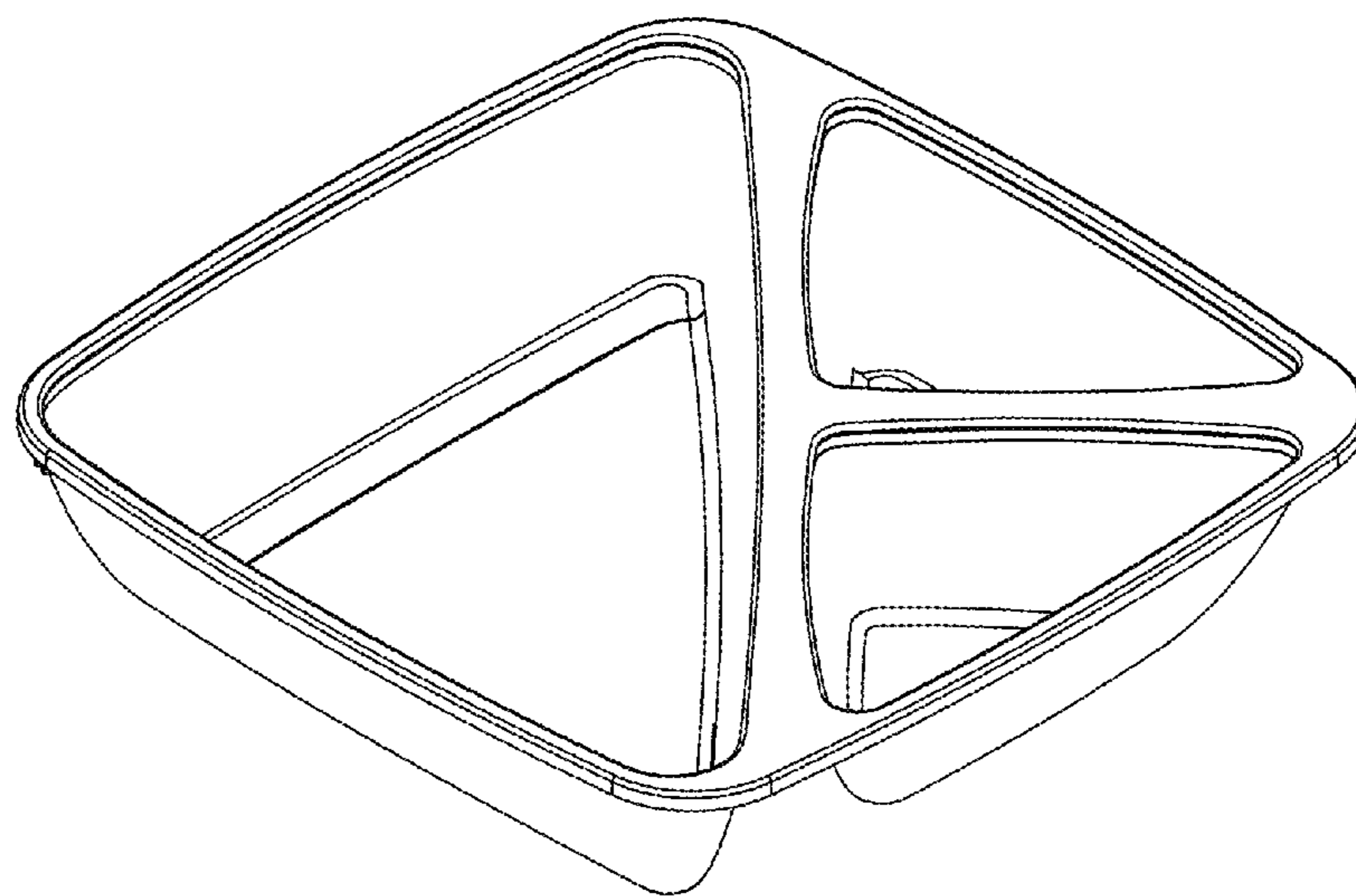

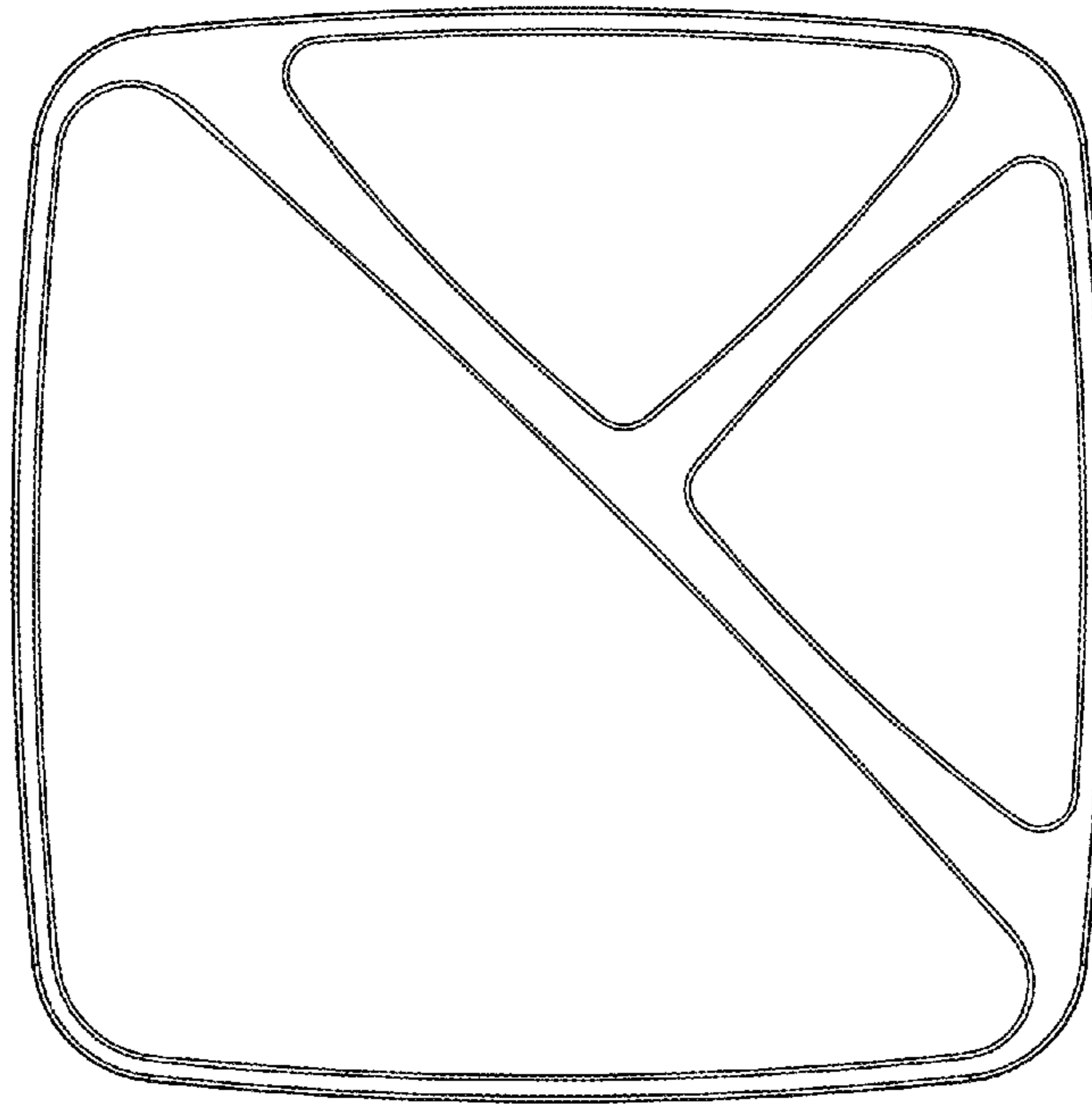

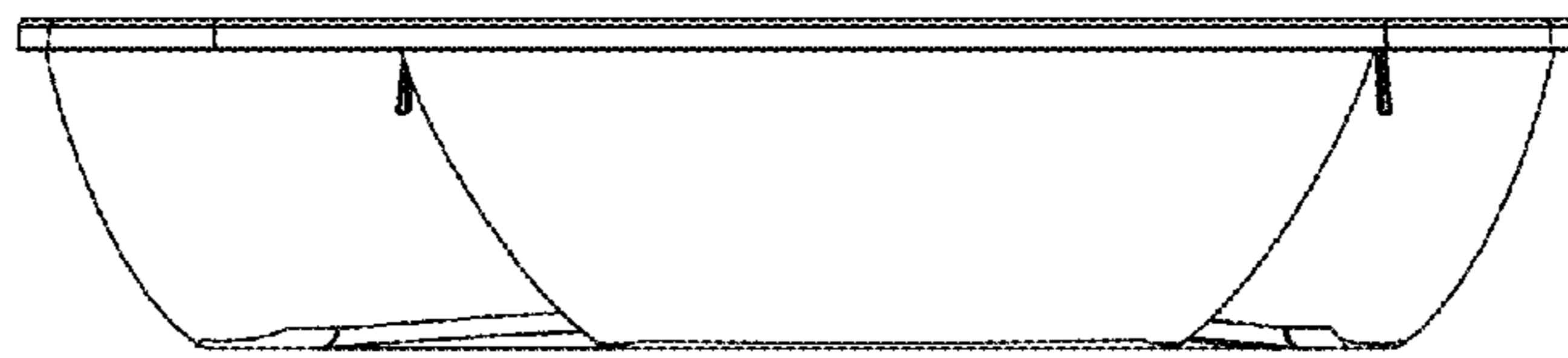

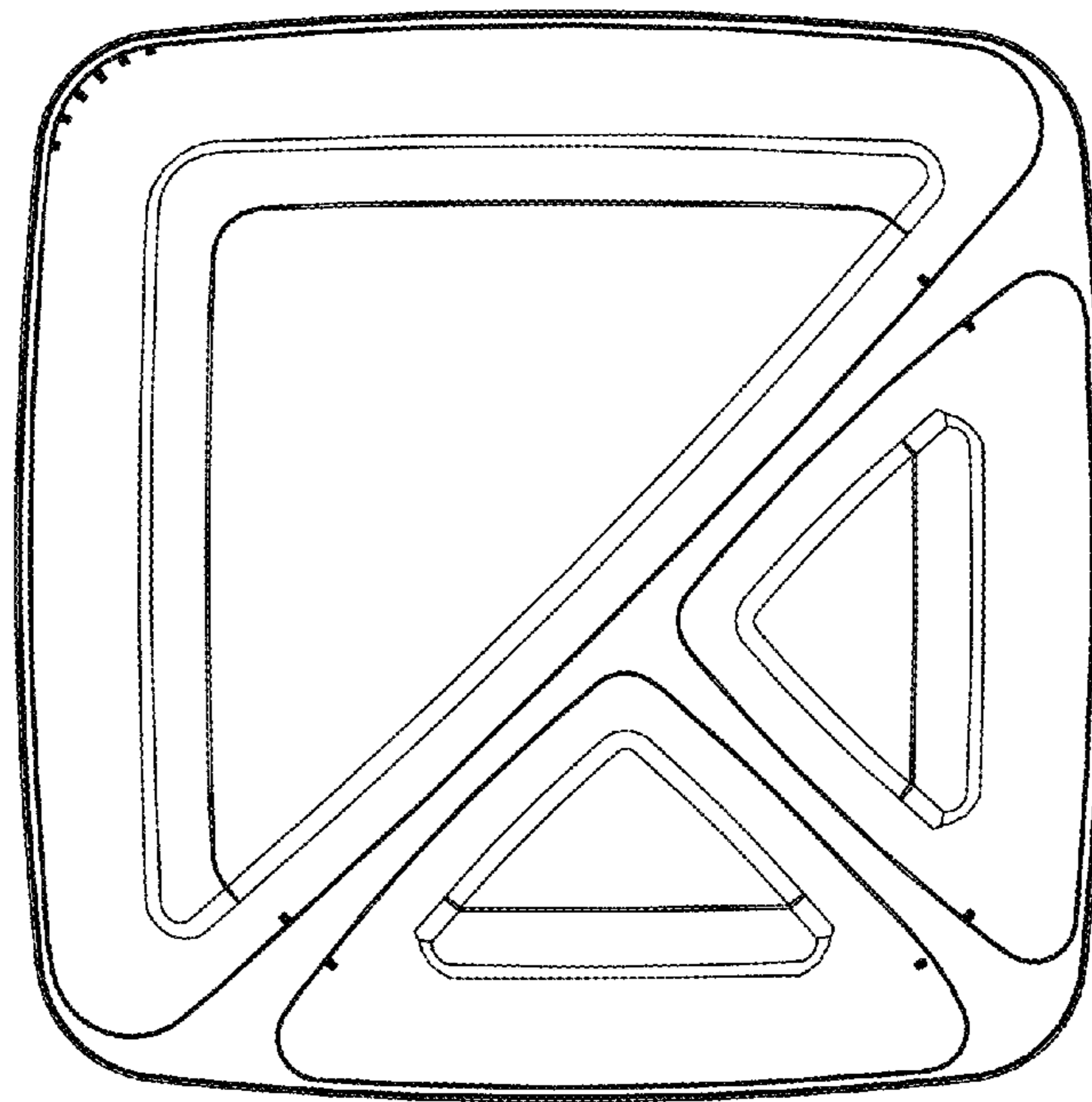

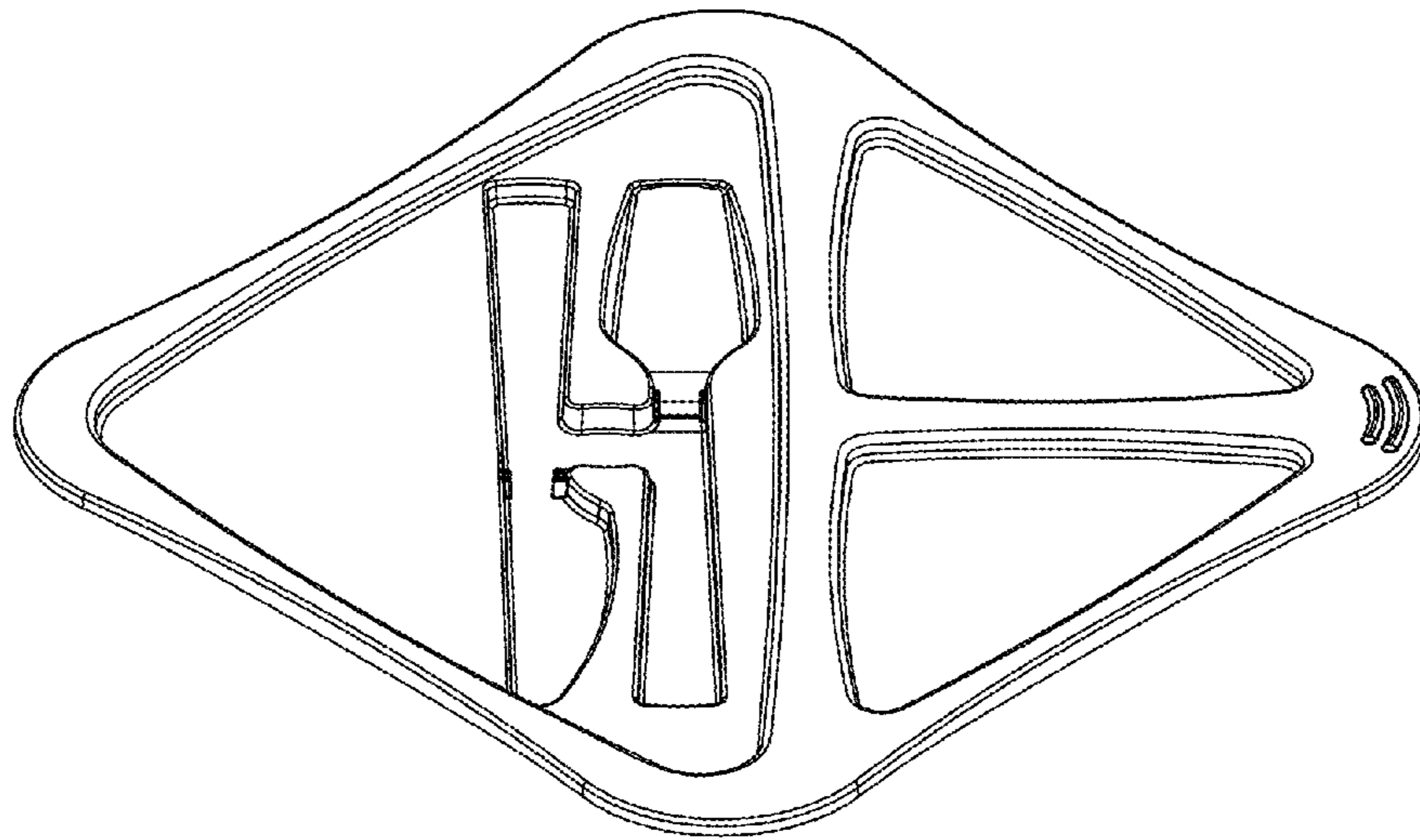

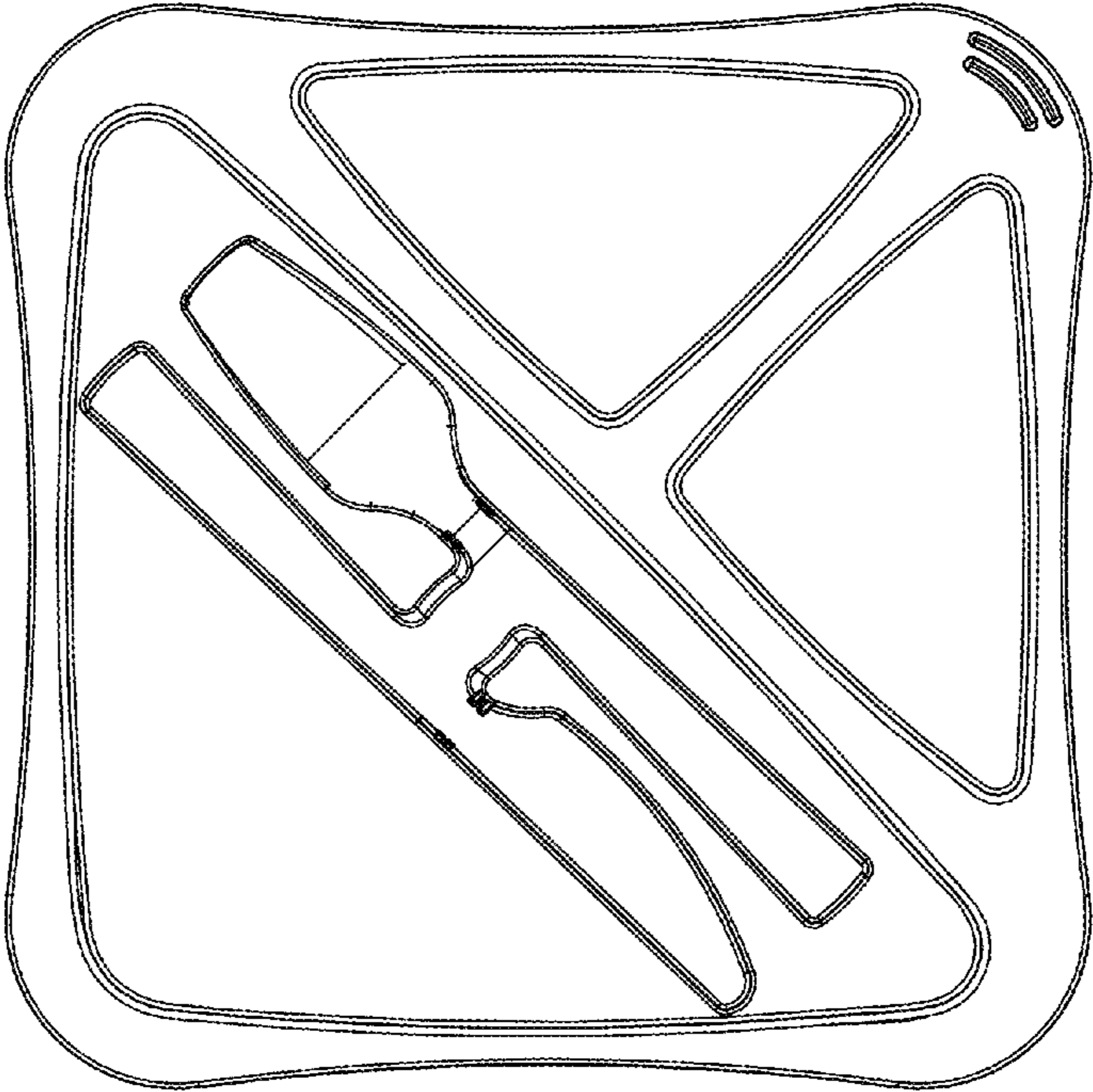

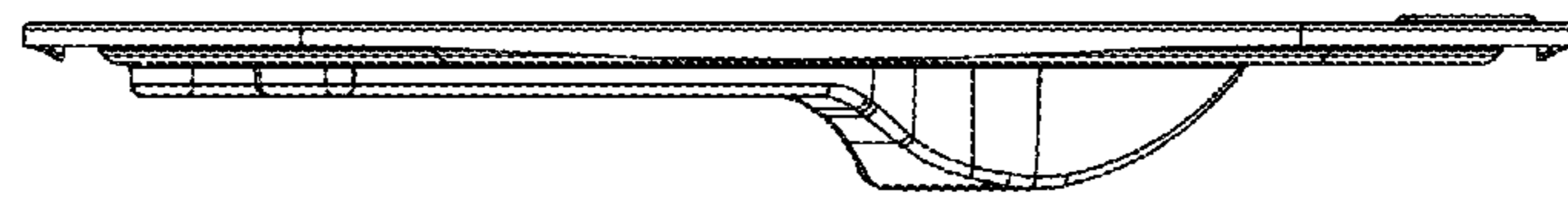

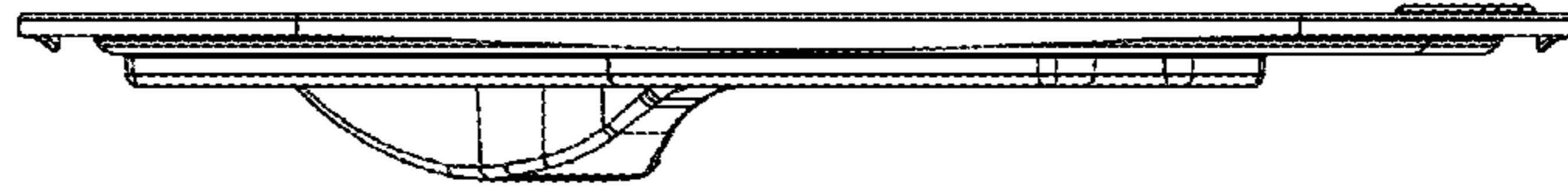

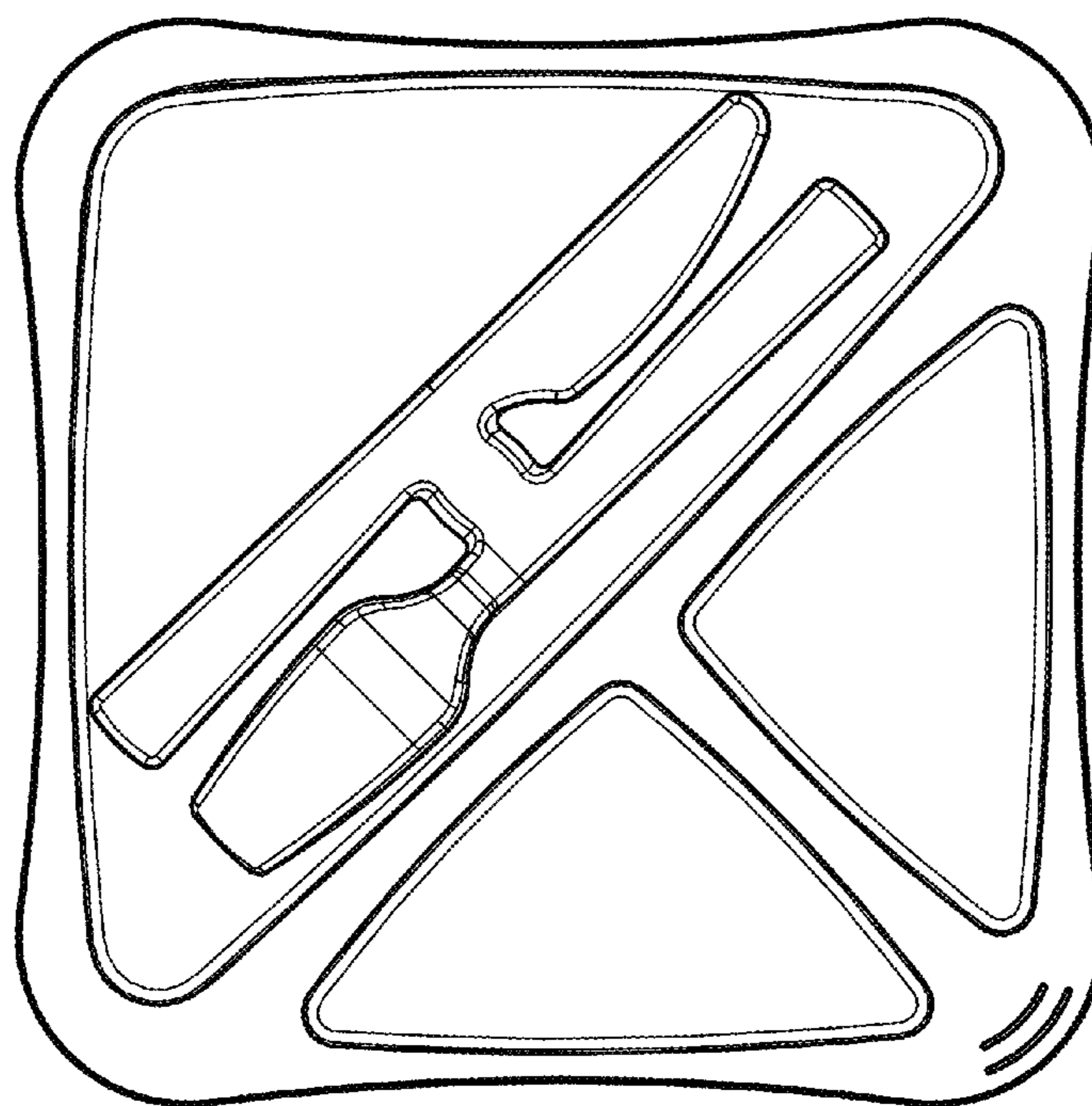
