FIG. 2 is a front, elevational view thereof;

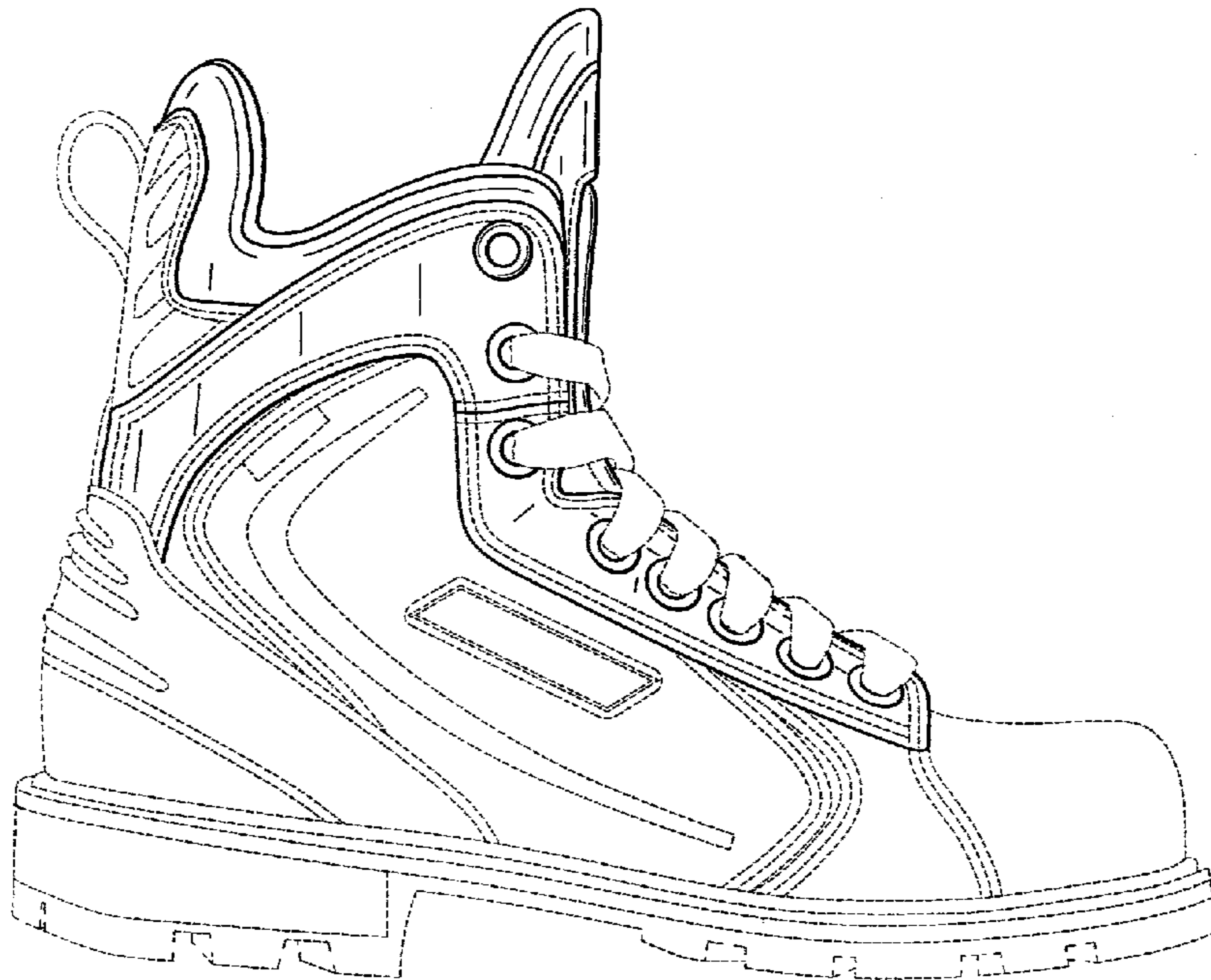
FIG. 3 is a left side, elevational view thereof;

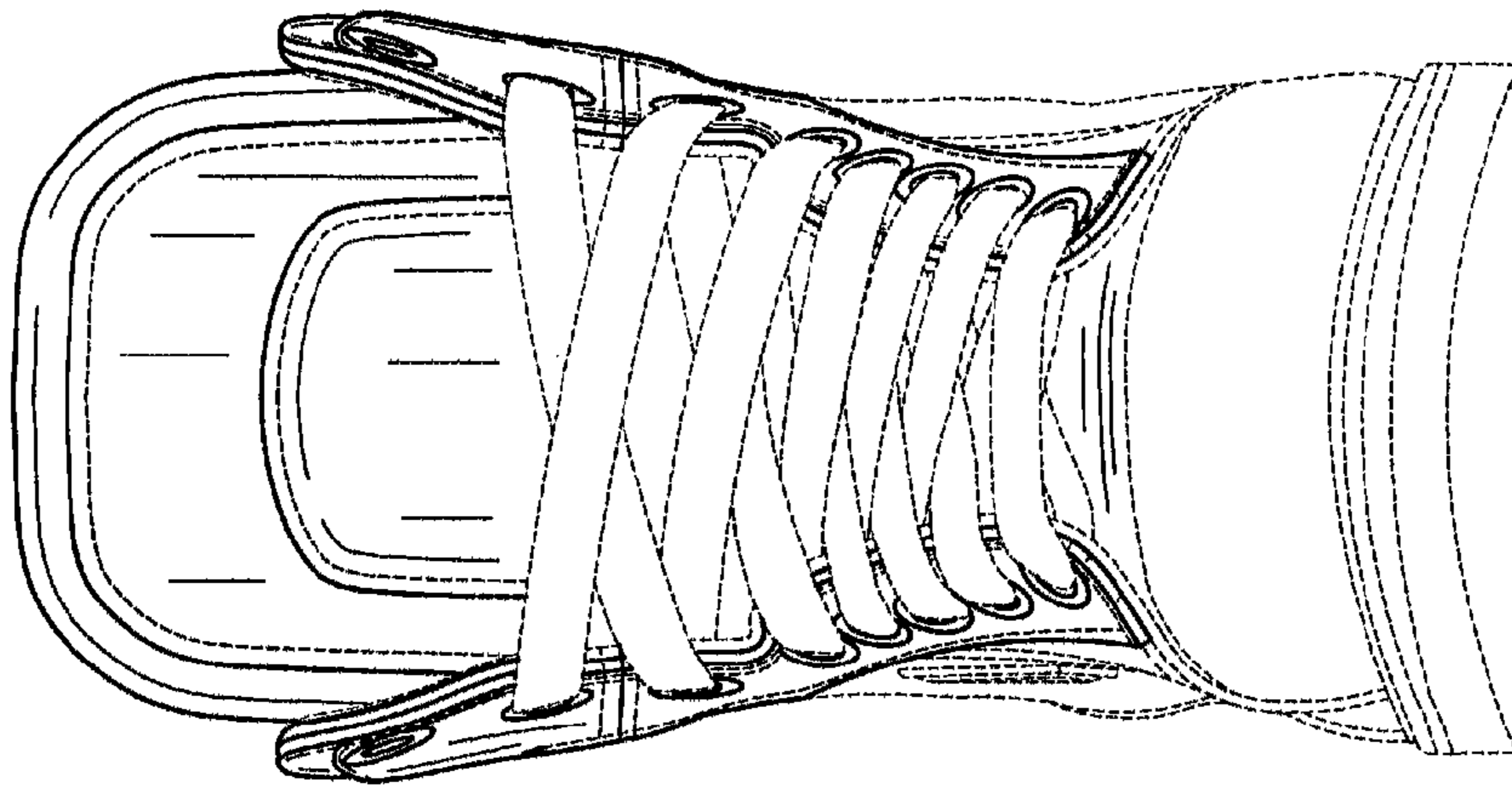

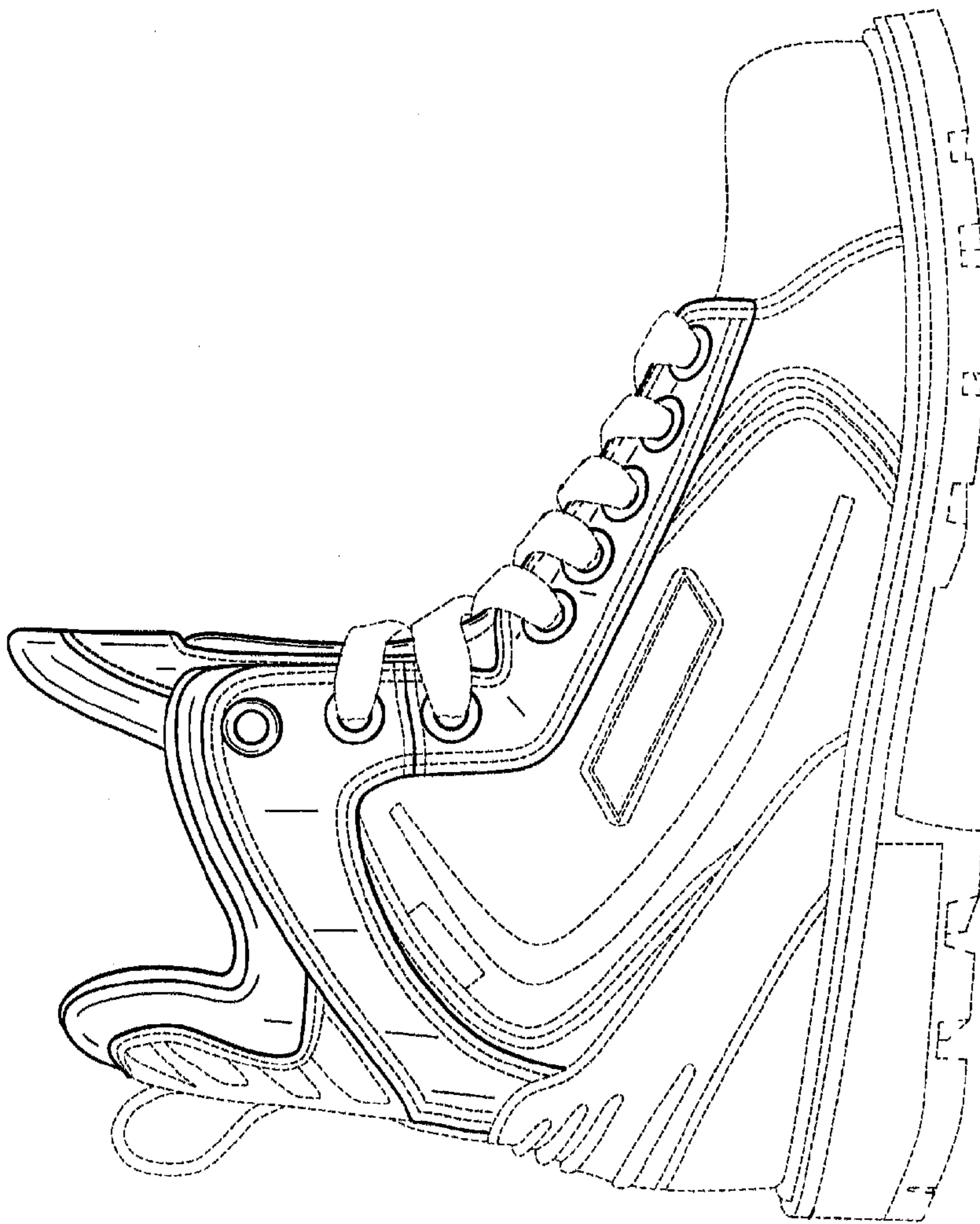

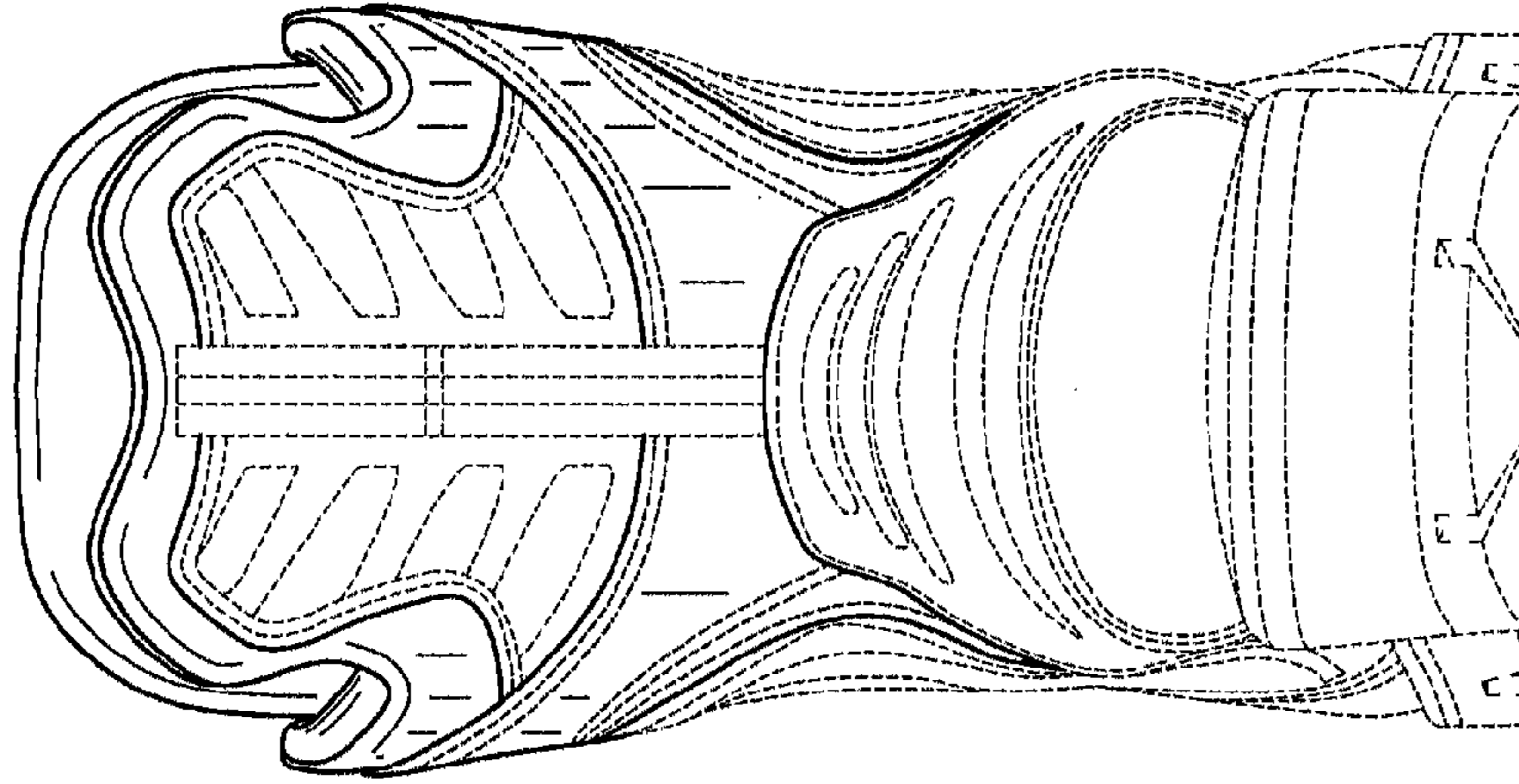

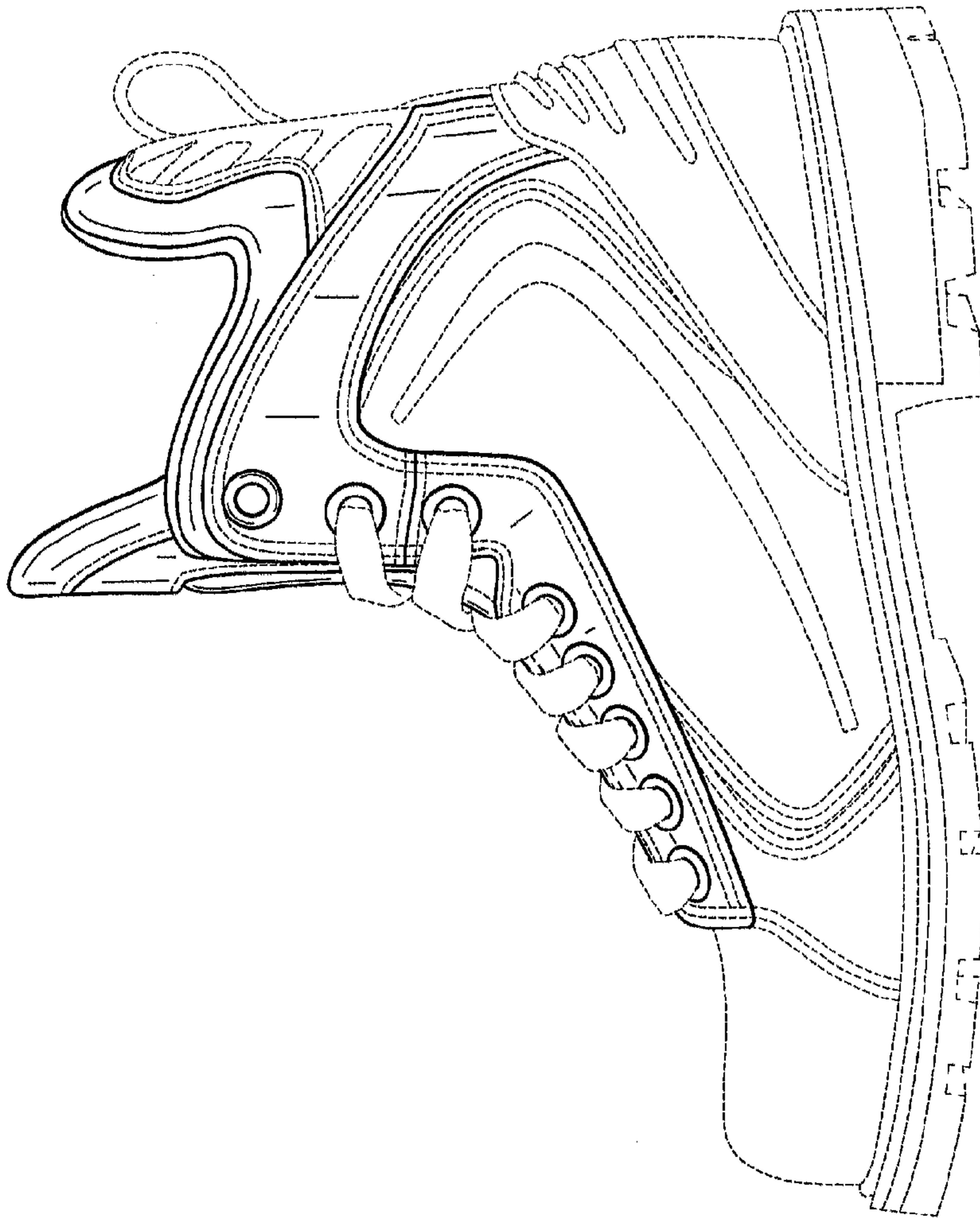

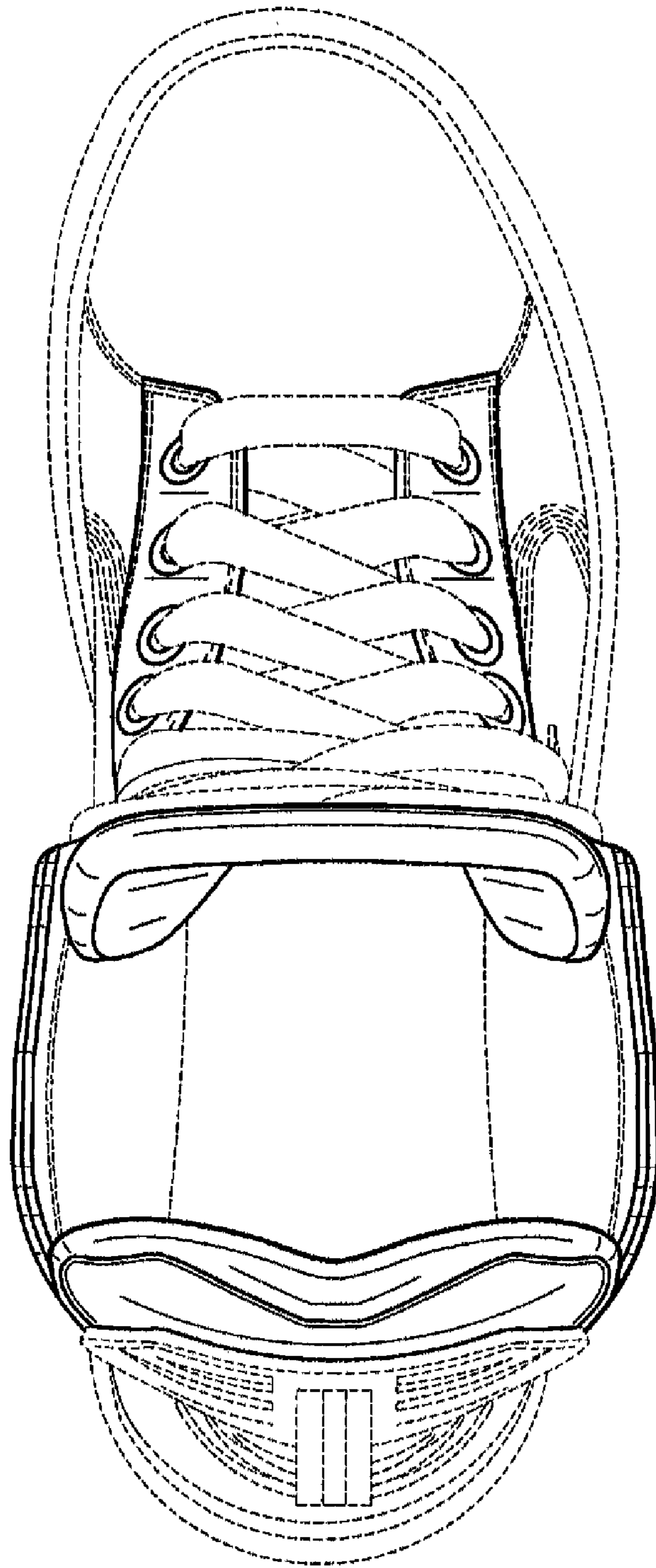
