(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe pouch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a shoe pouch showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;

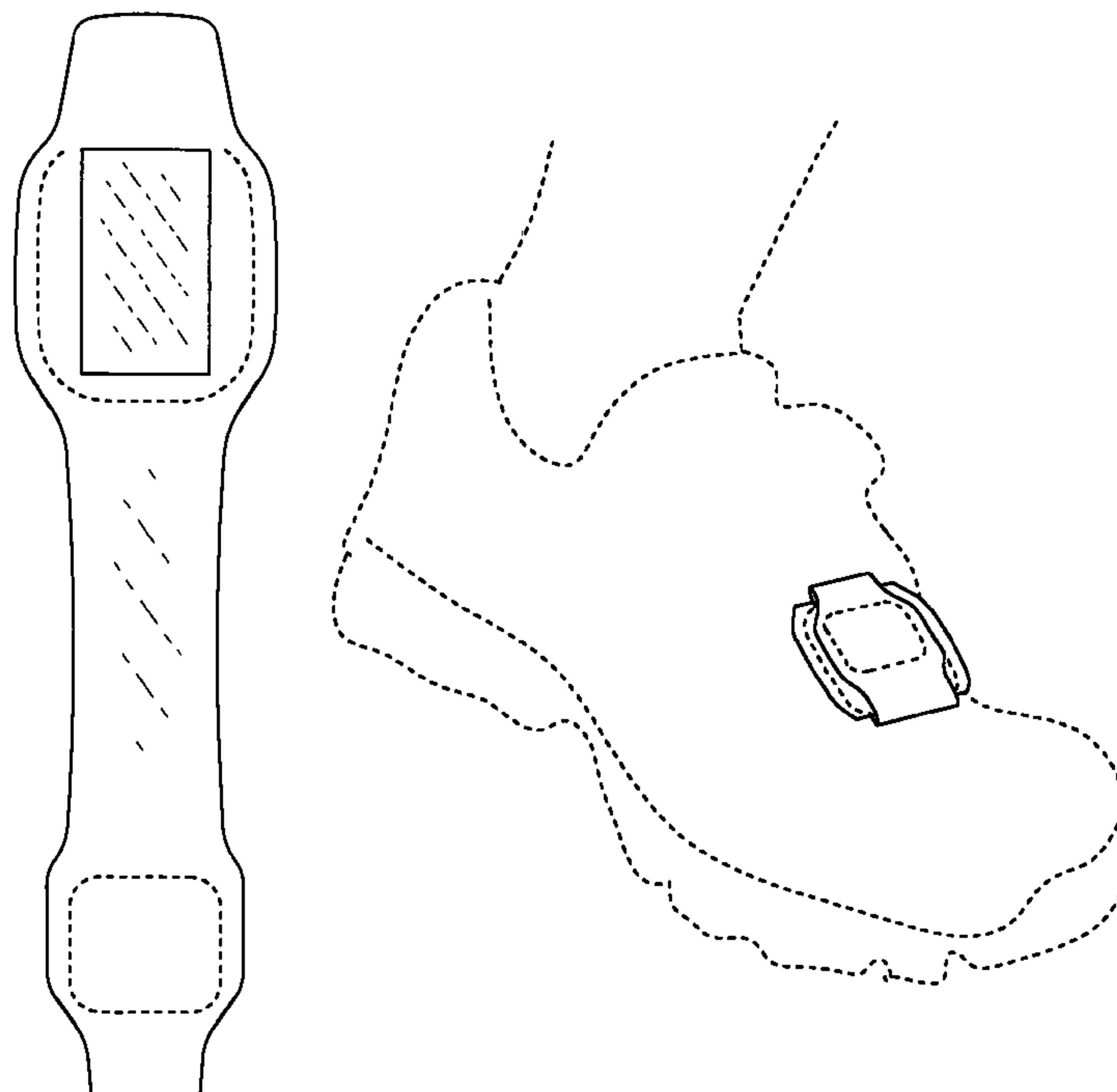
FIG. 7 is a front view, of a shoe pouch shown folded in a used condition;

FIG. 8 is a right side view, of a shoe pouch shown folded in a used condition, the left side view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 9 is a perspective view, of a shoe pouch shown folded in a used condition.

The broken lines shown on the shoe pouch in FIGS. 1-9 represent thread stitching. The broken lines showing a shoe and human ankle in FIG. 9 illustrate environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

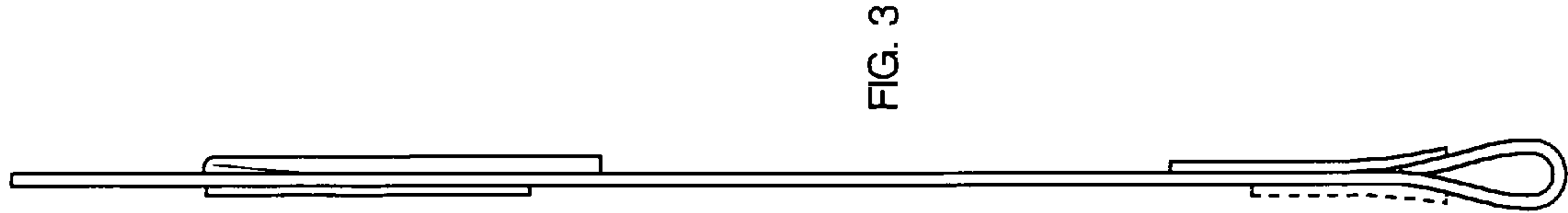

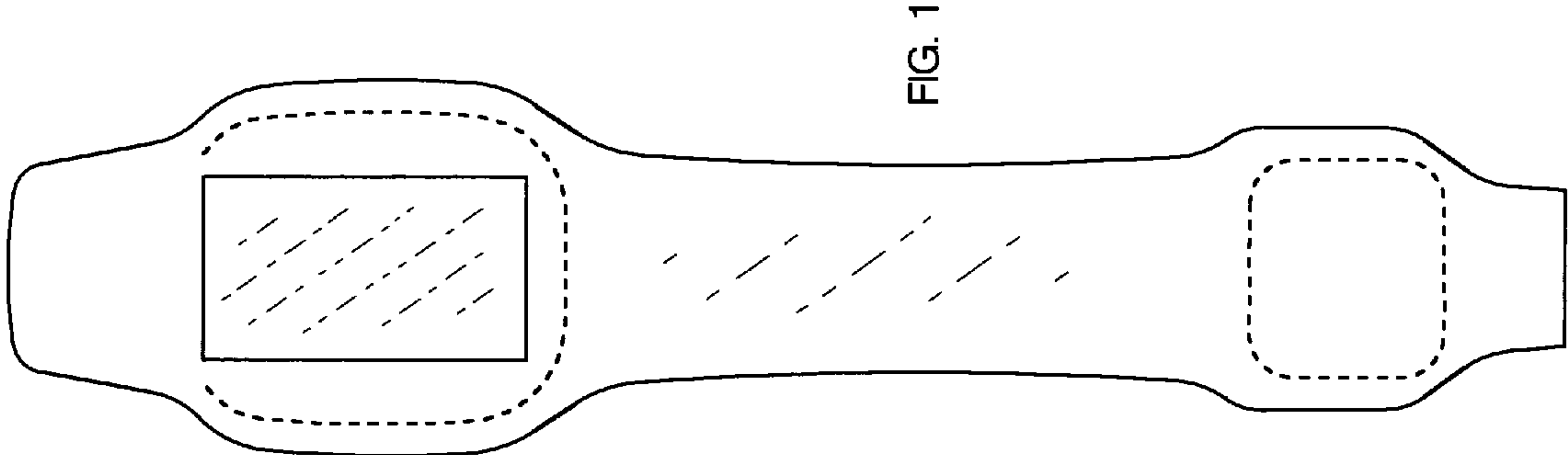

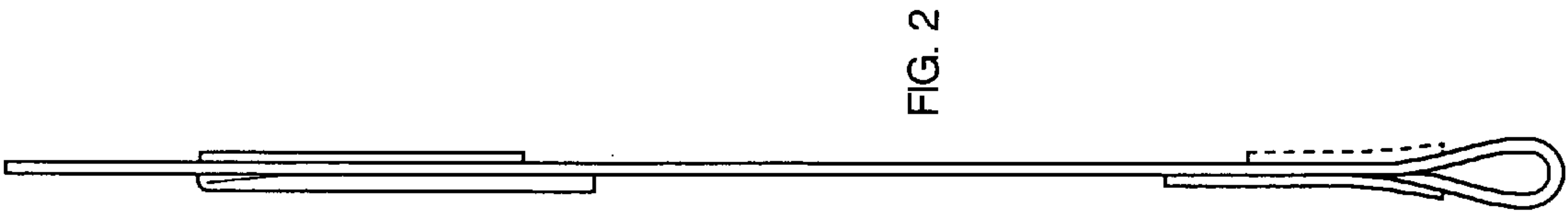
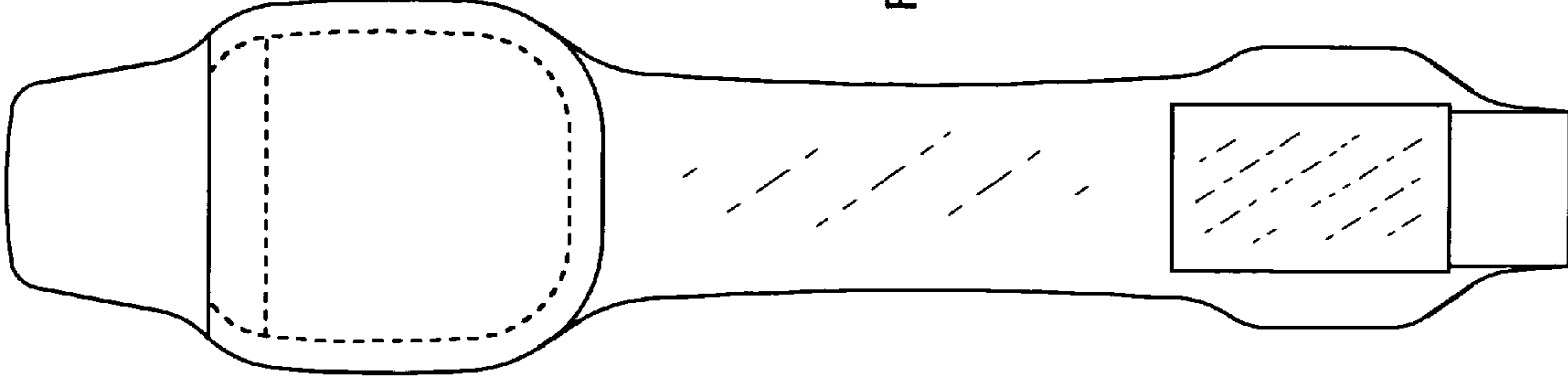

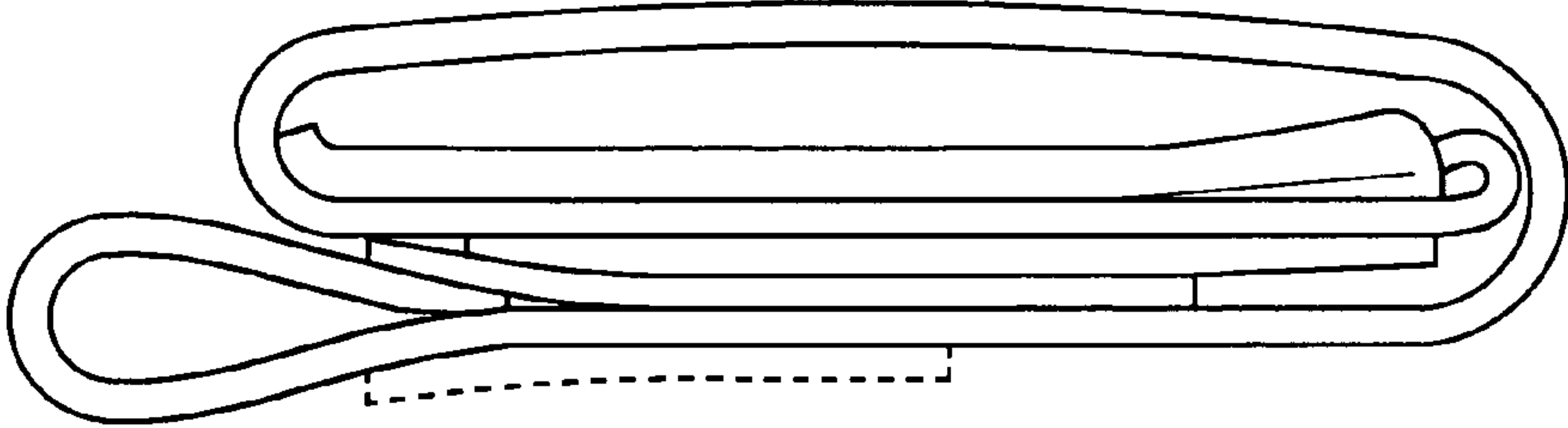

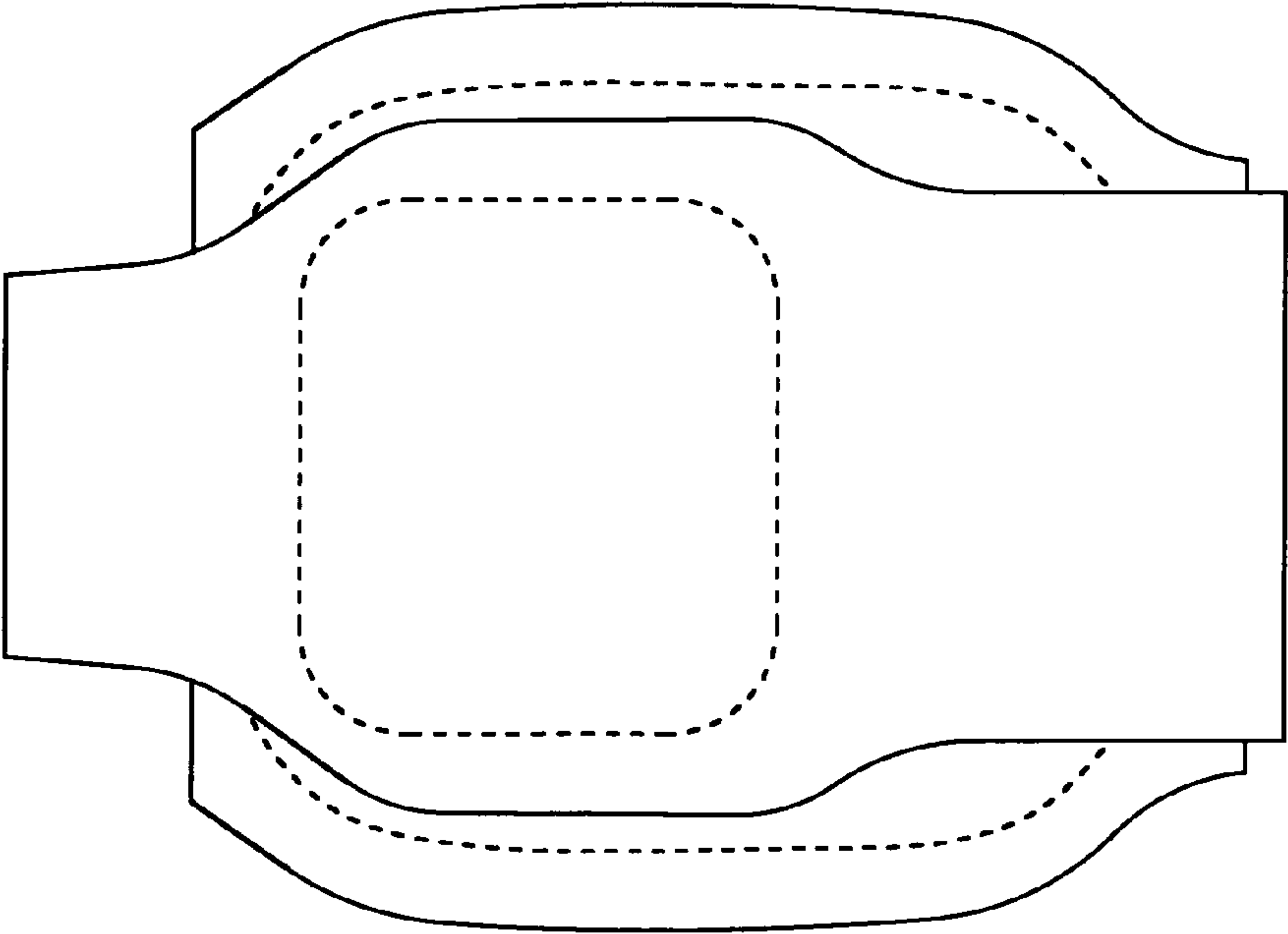

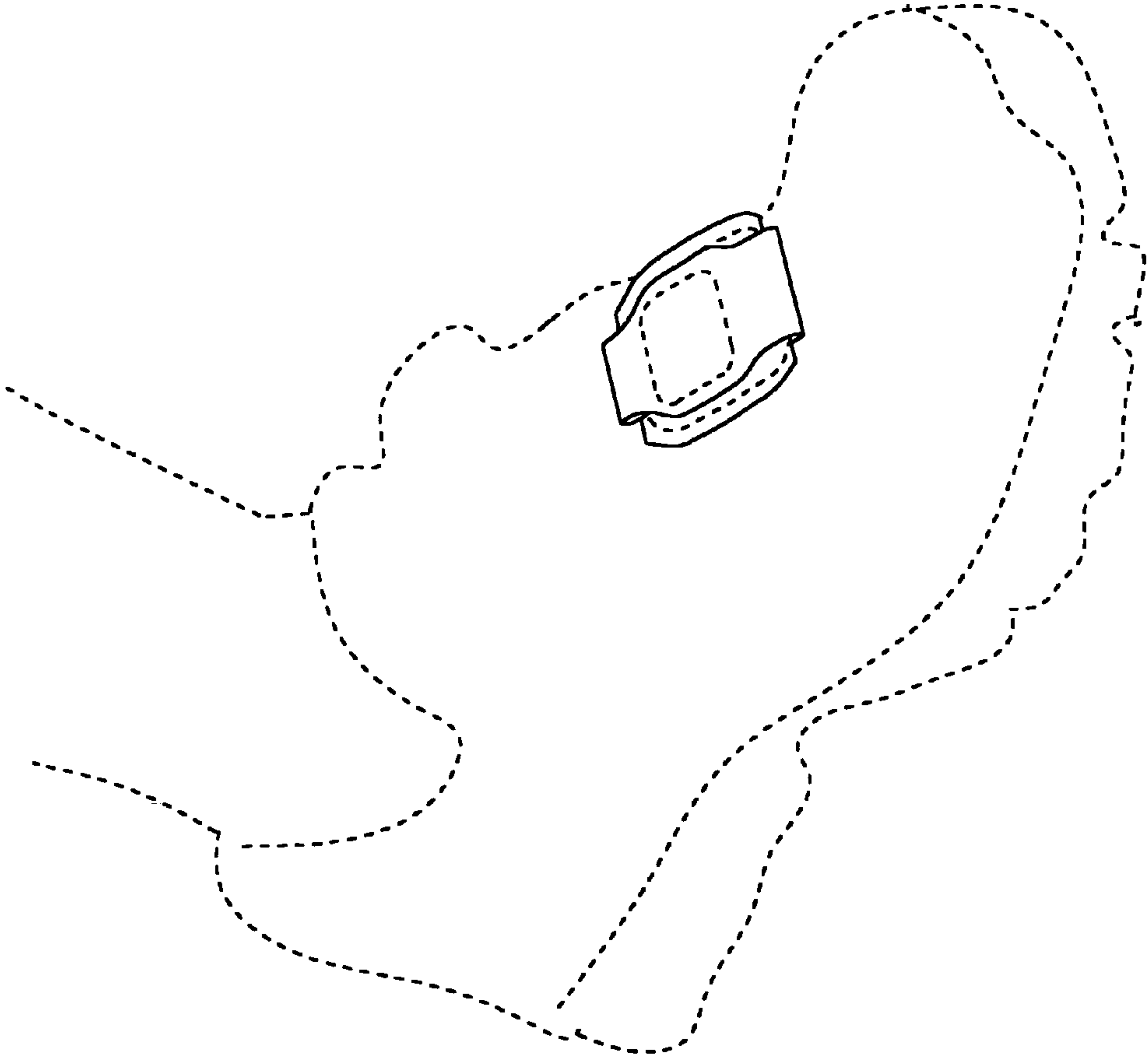
