DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a prosthetic sock showing my new design;

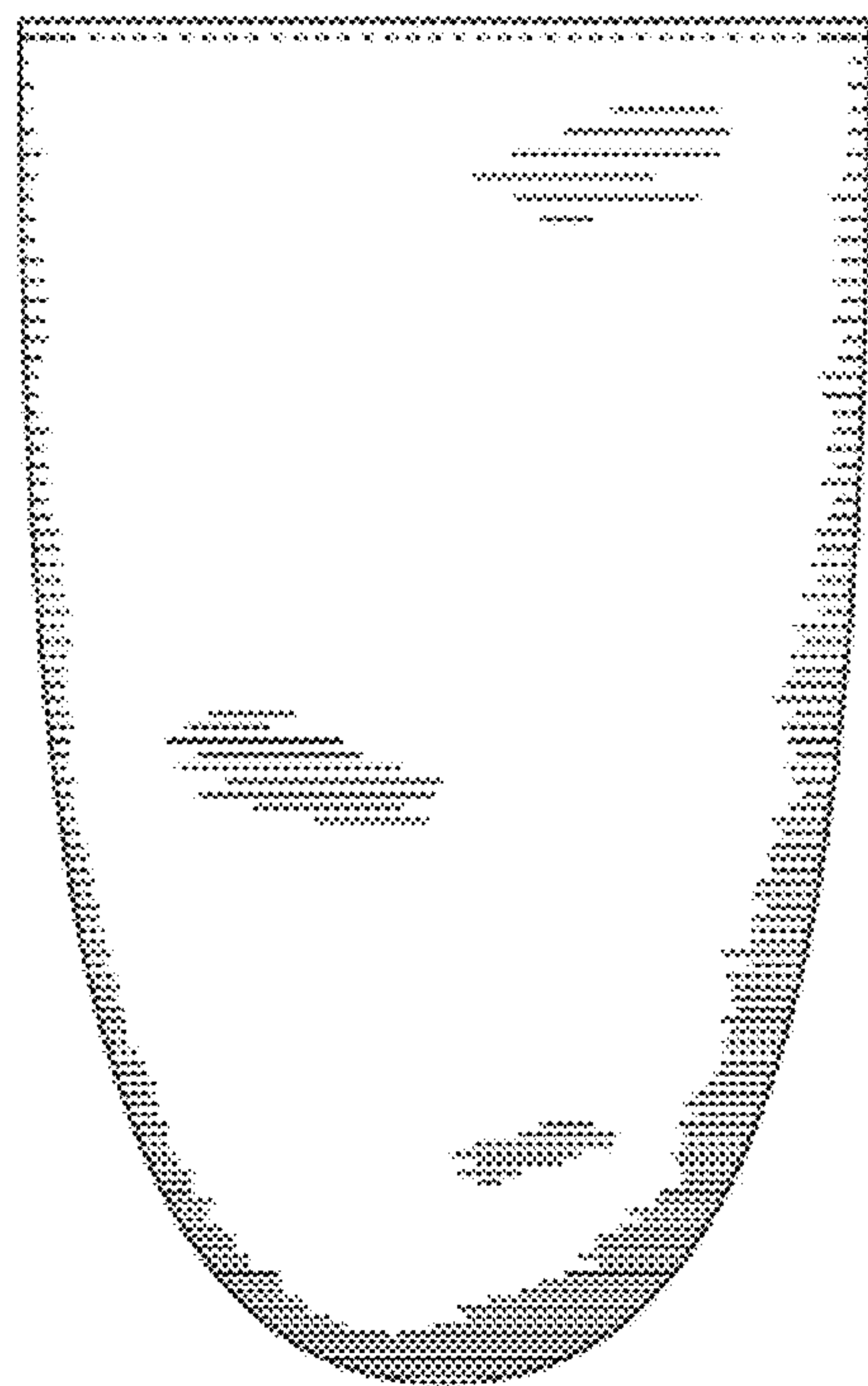

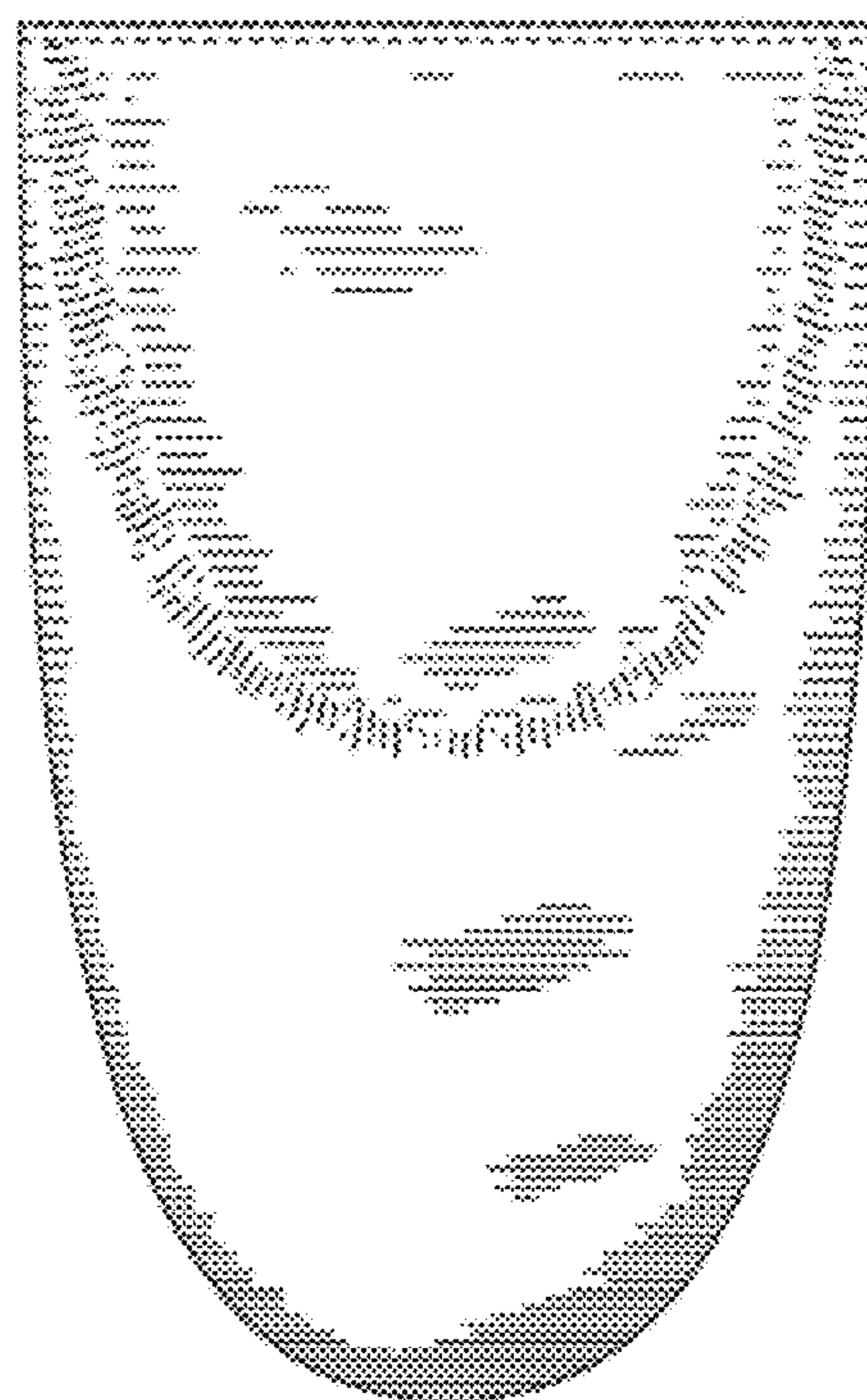

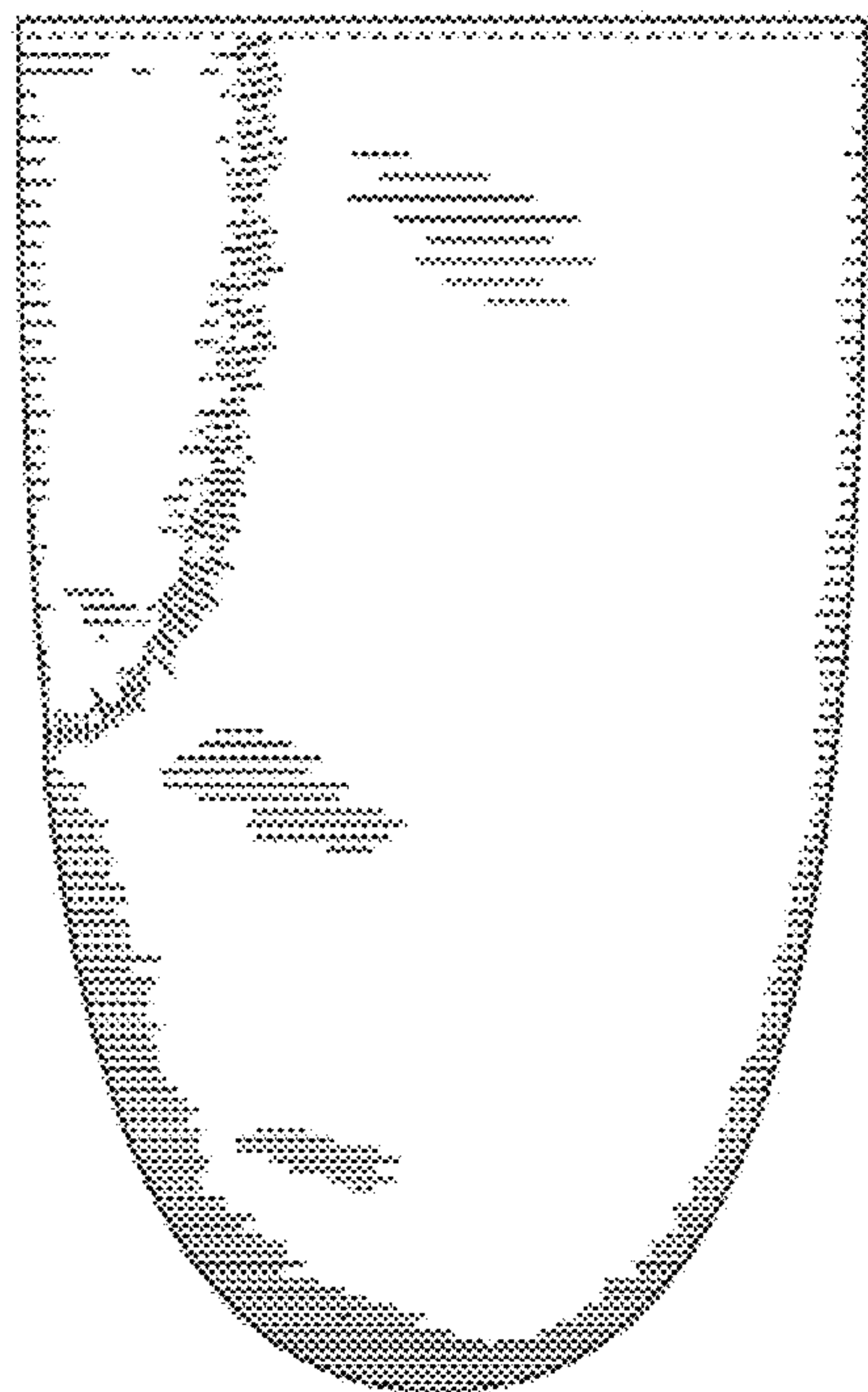

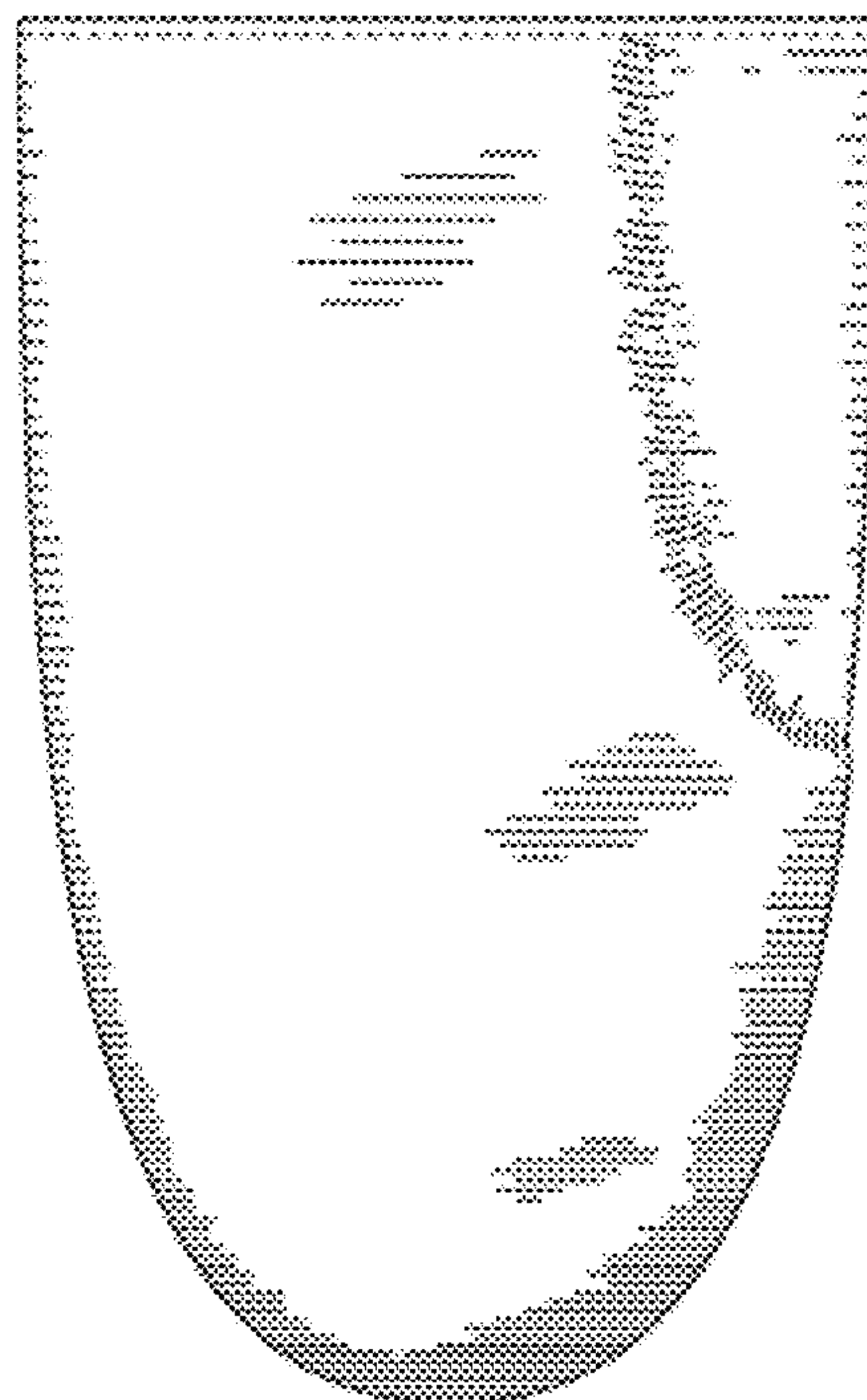

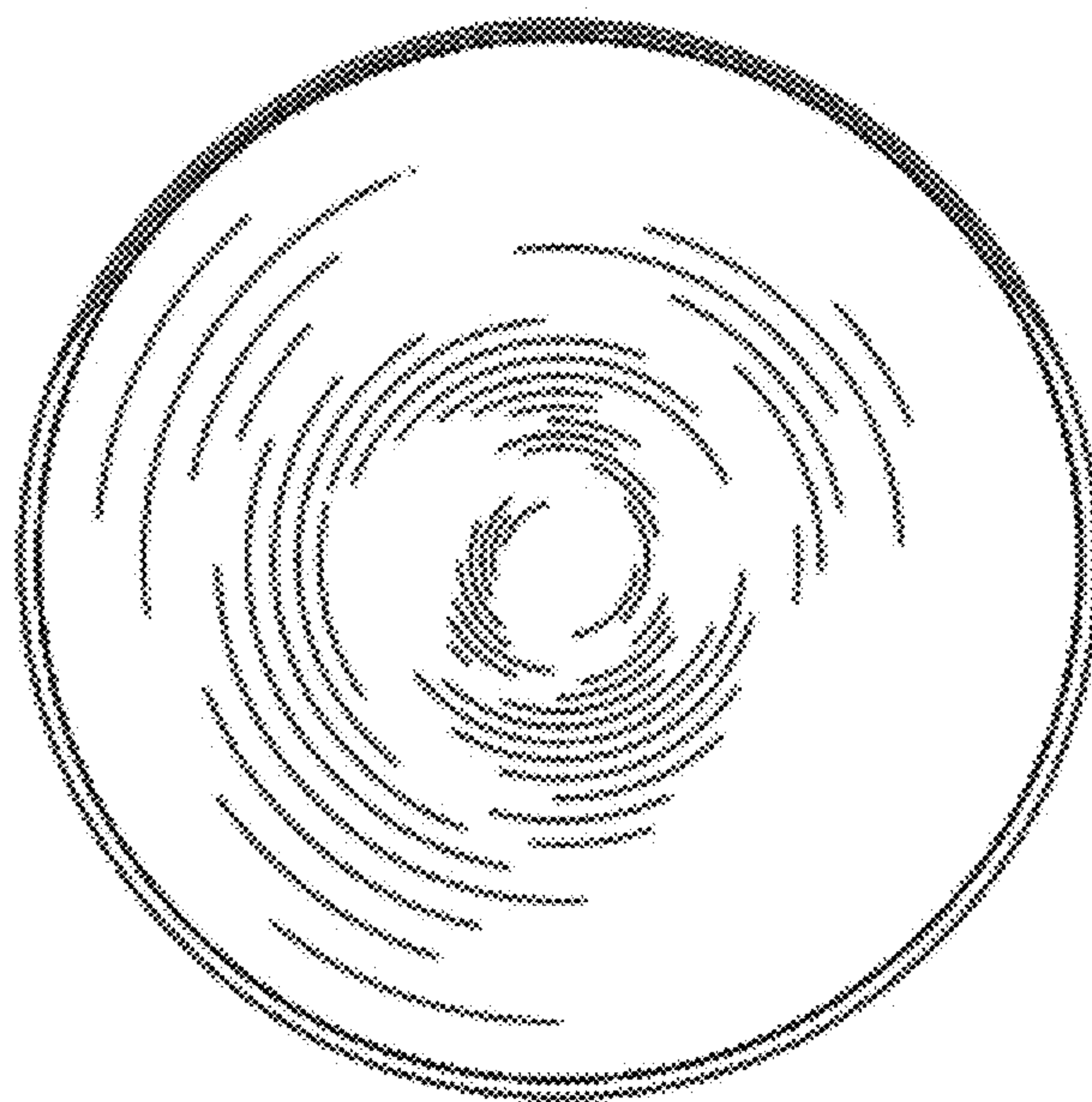

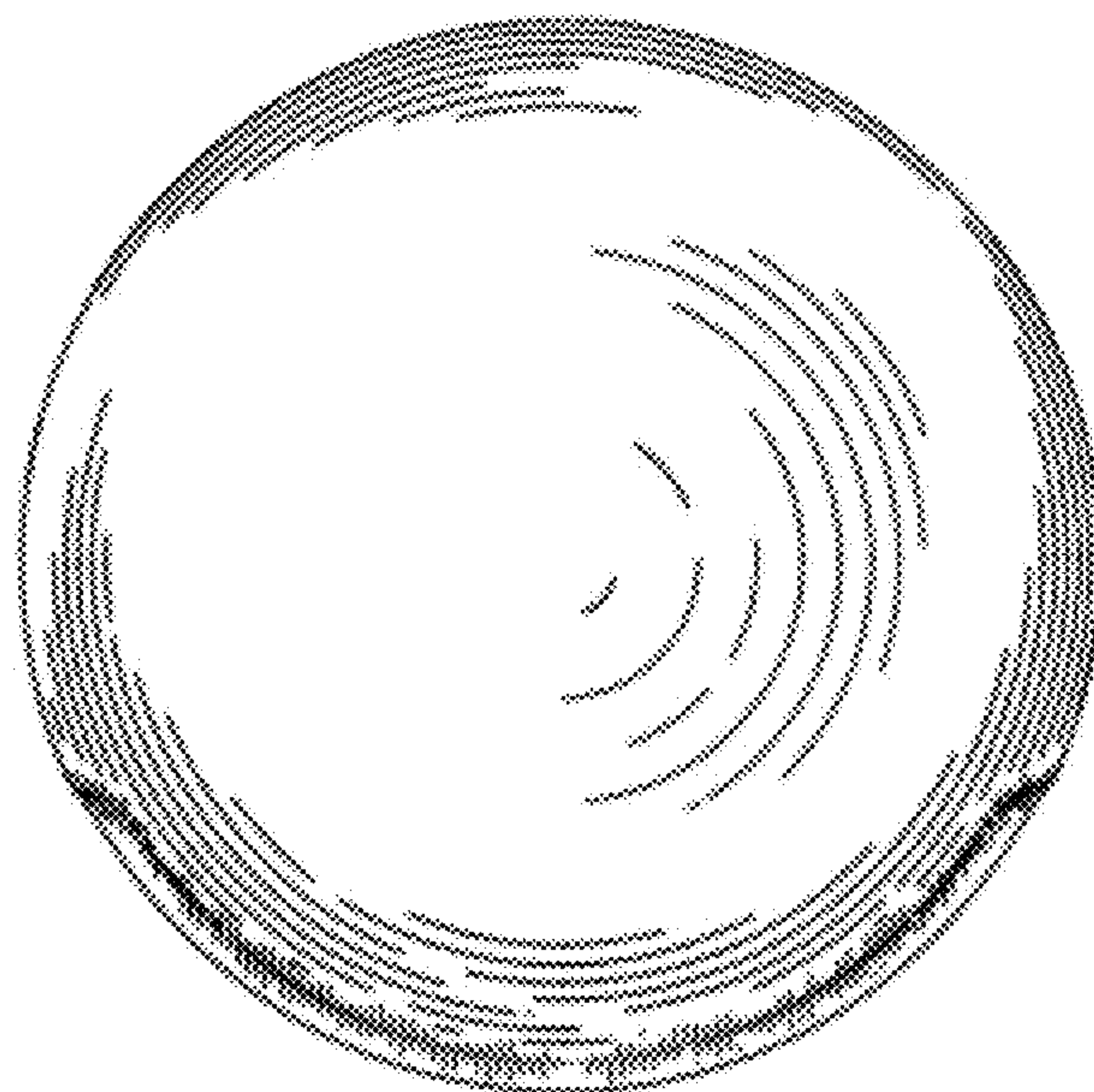

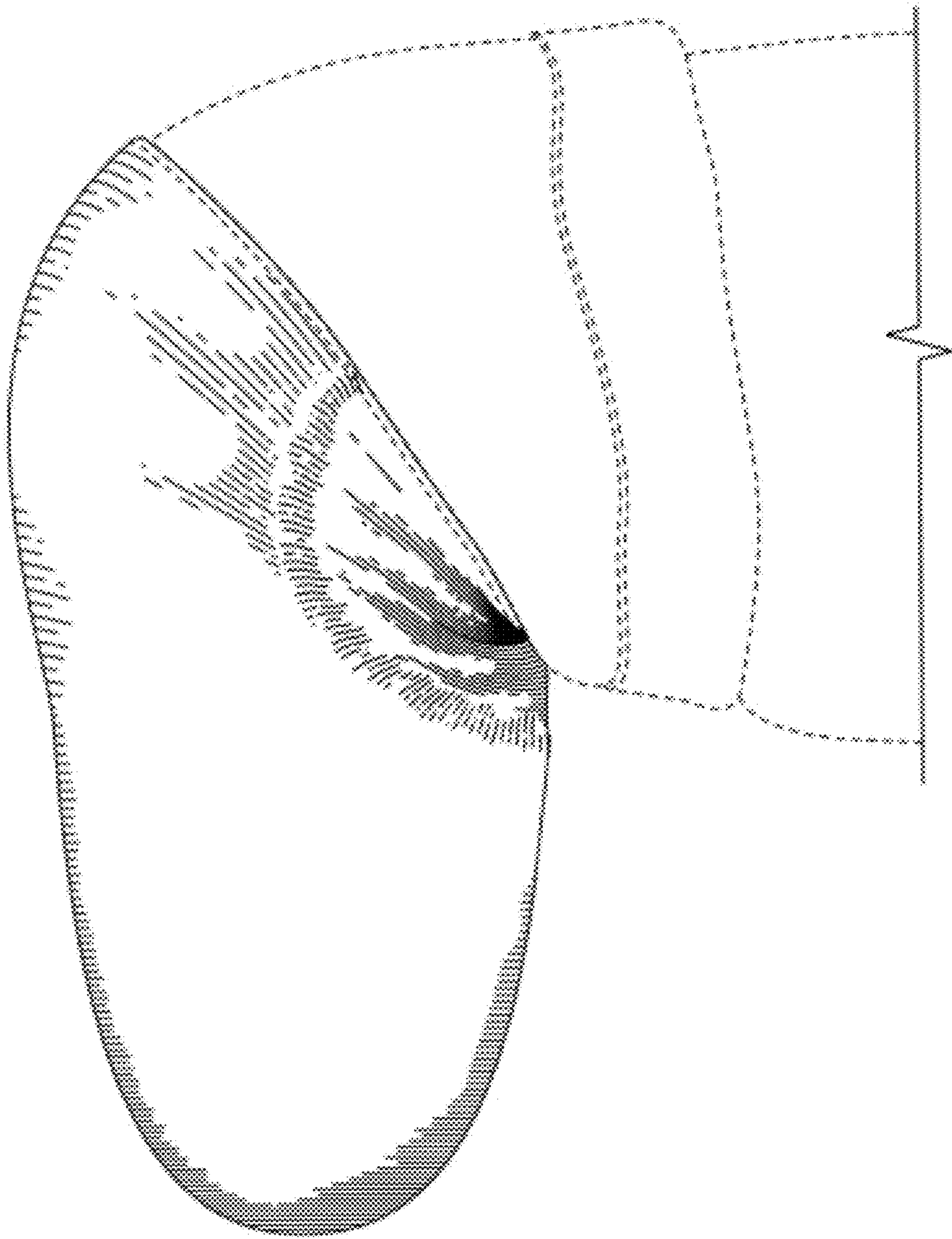
