The ornamental design for a scarf, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing a scarf of this design when in use being worn by a person;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the scarf of this design;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; the right side is a minor image of the left side;

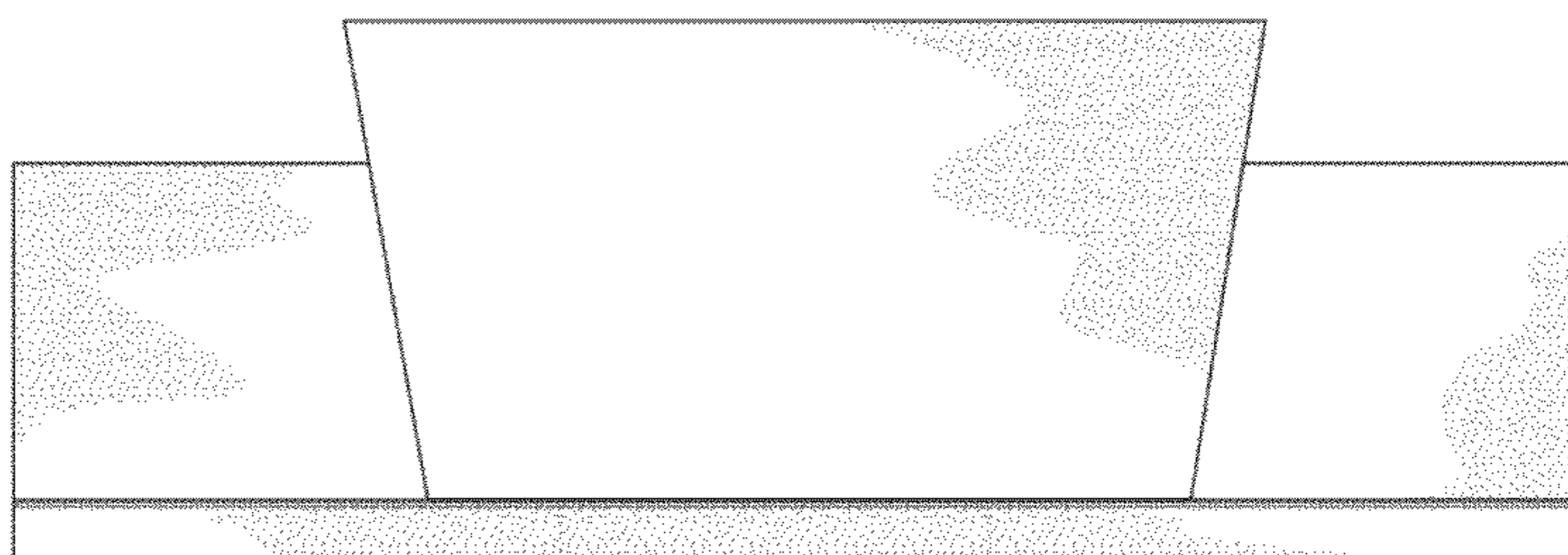
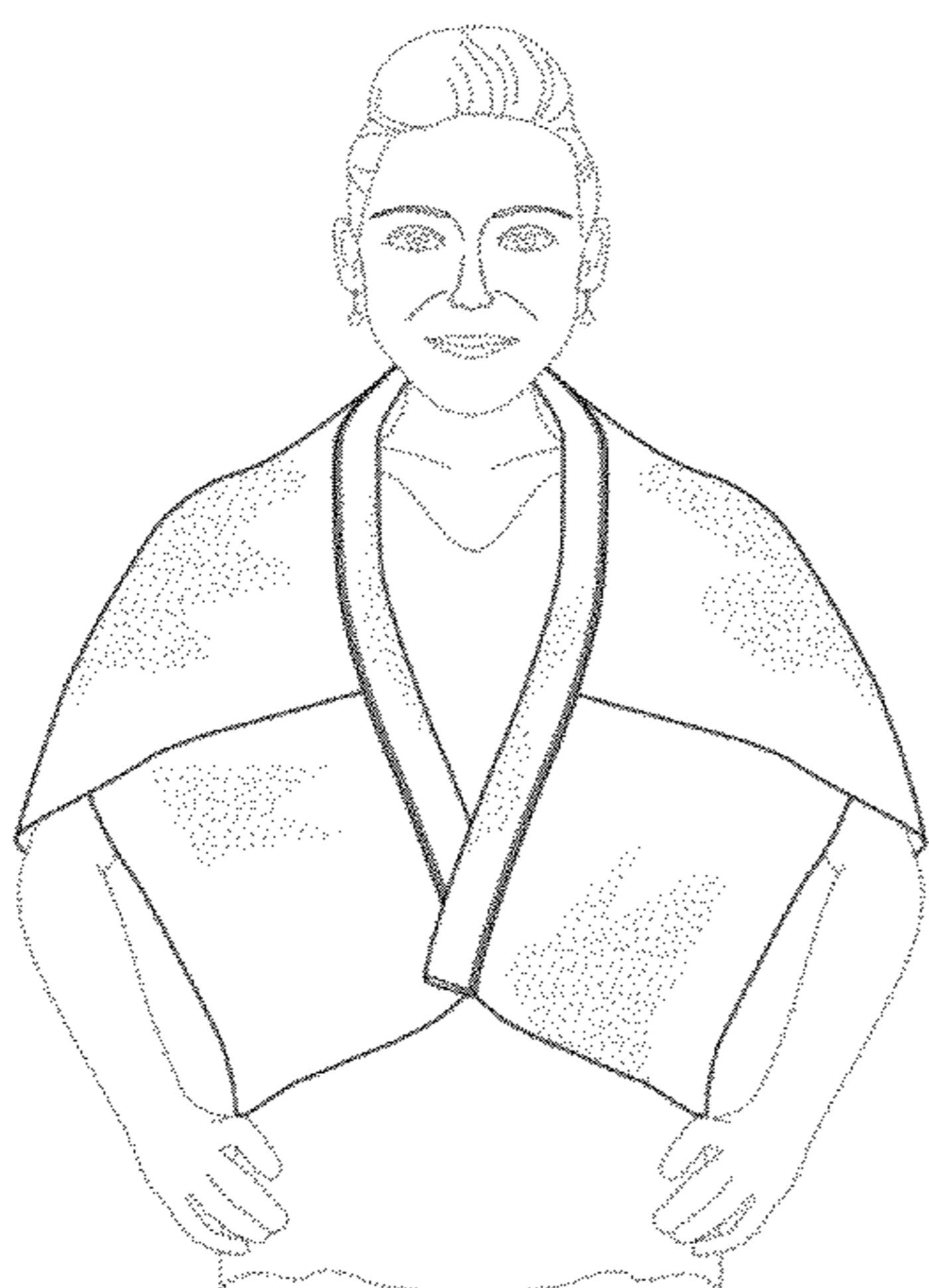
FIG. 5 is a bottom elevational view thereof; and,
