FIG. 4 is the opposite side elevational view of that shown in FIG. 3;

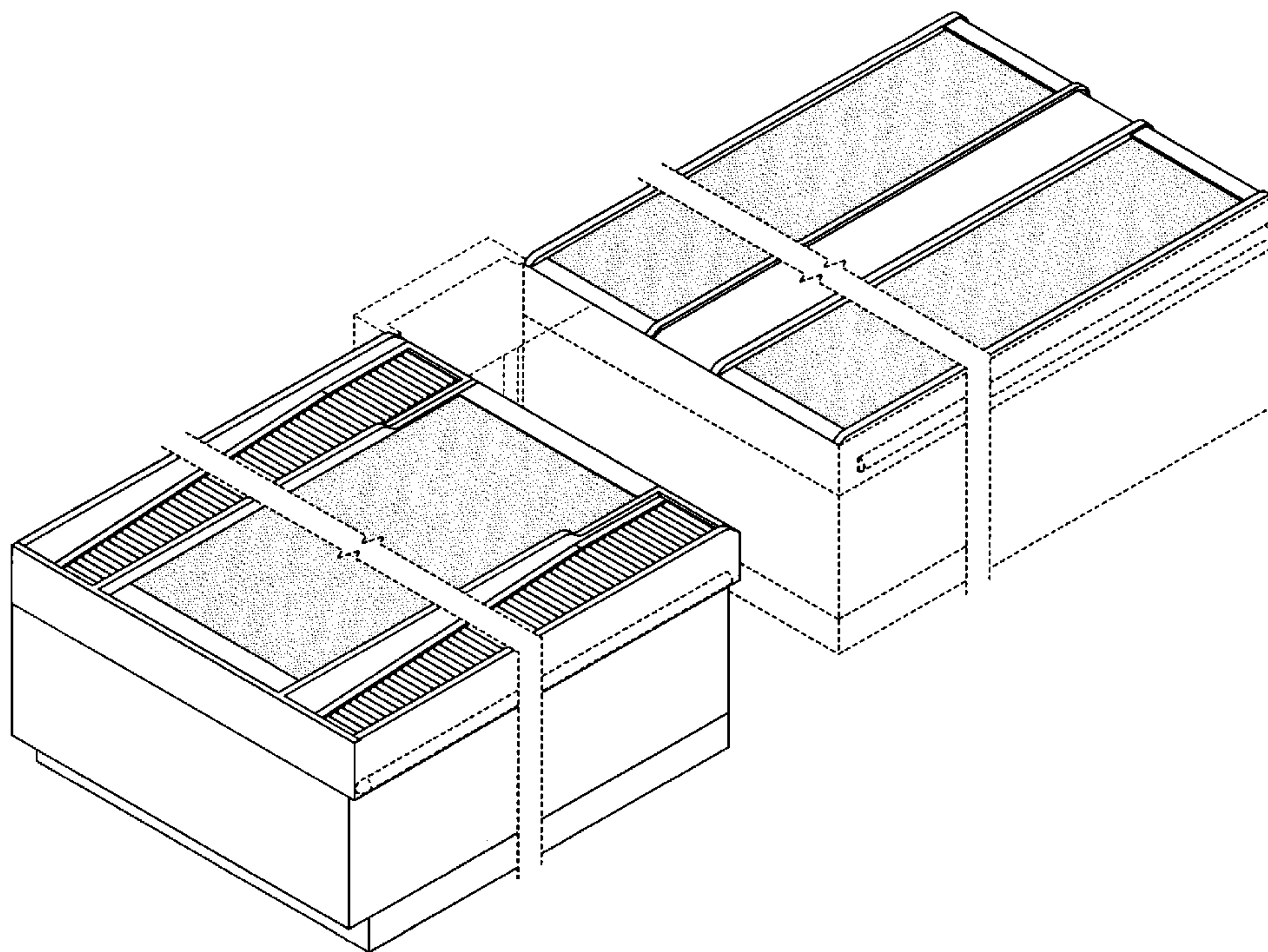
FIG. 5 is an end view of the checkout stand shown in FIG. 1; and,

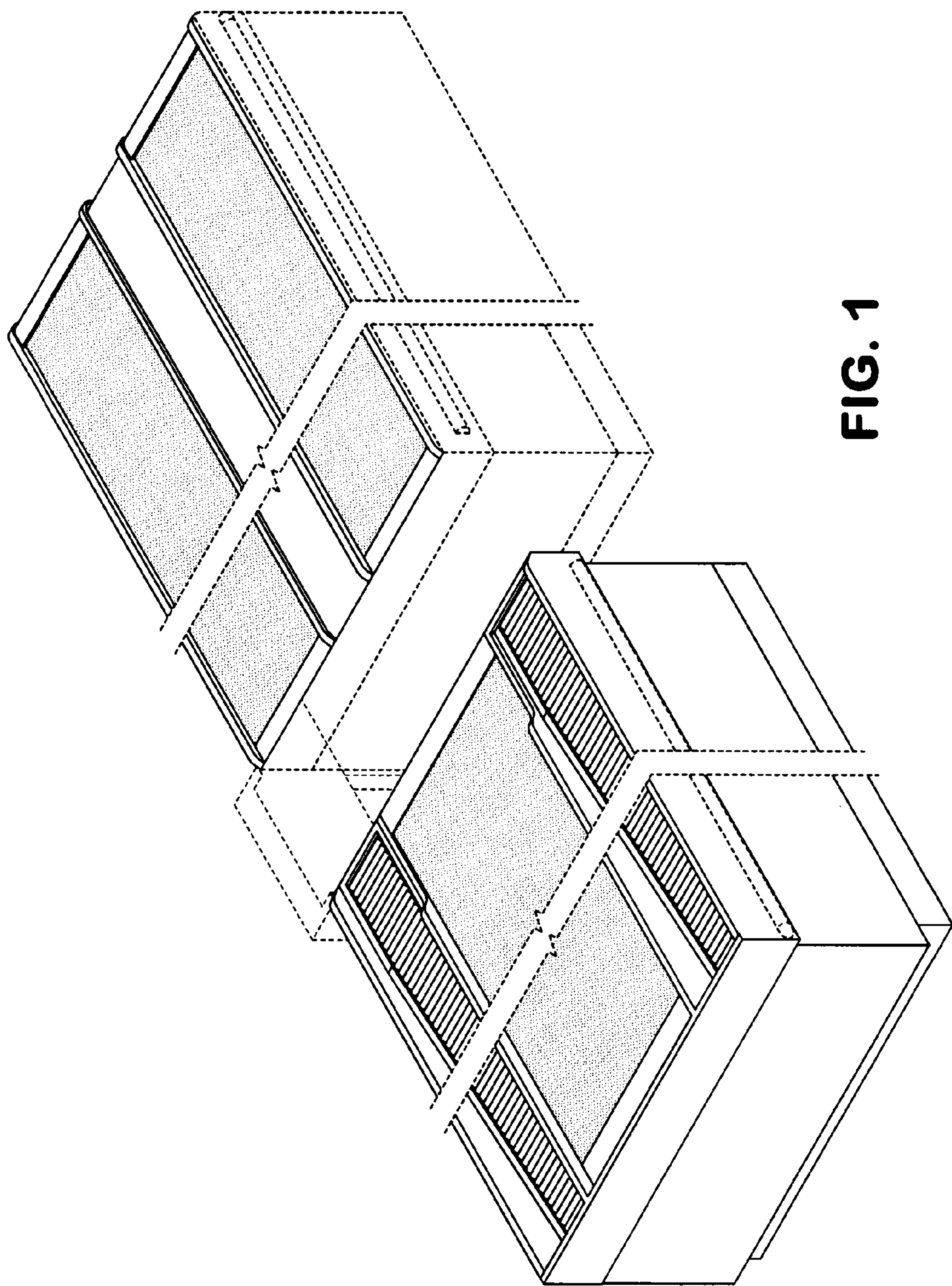

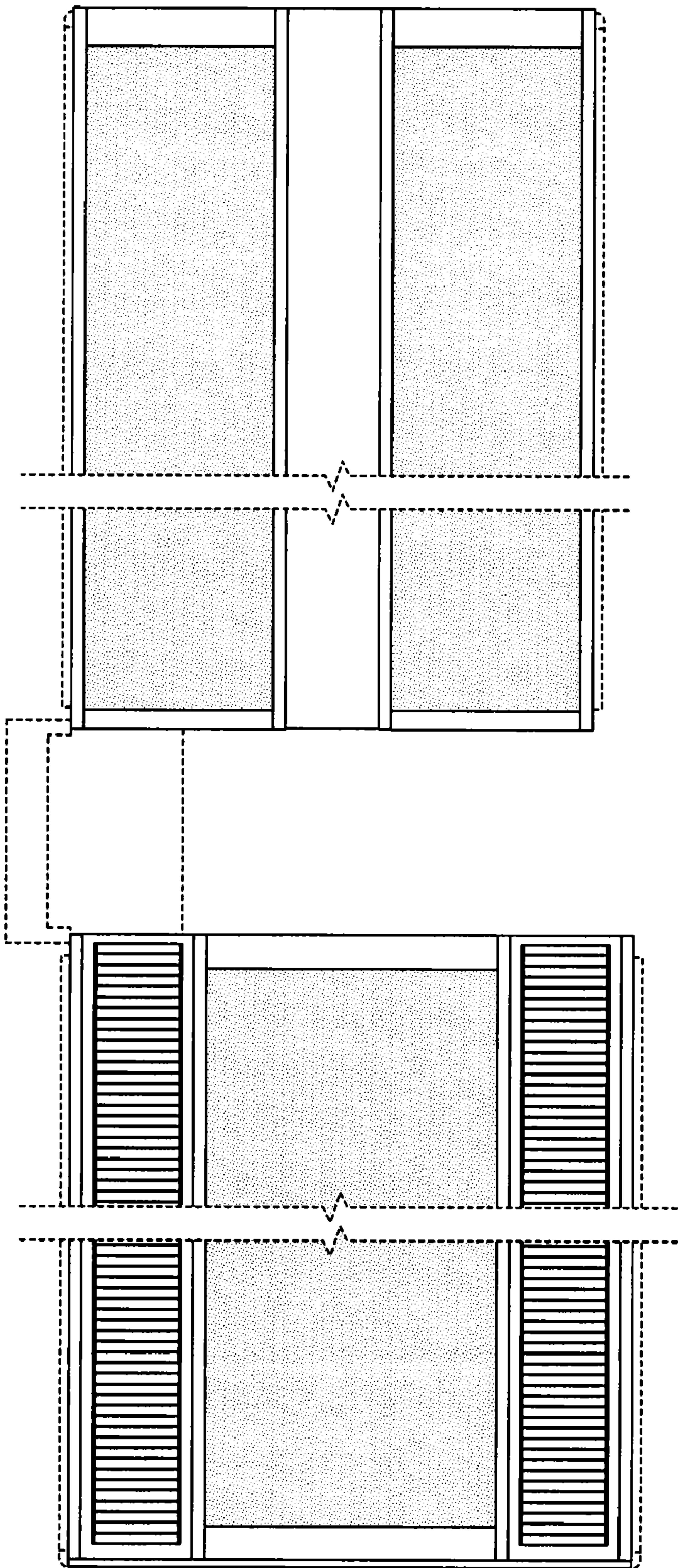

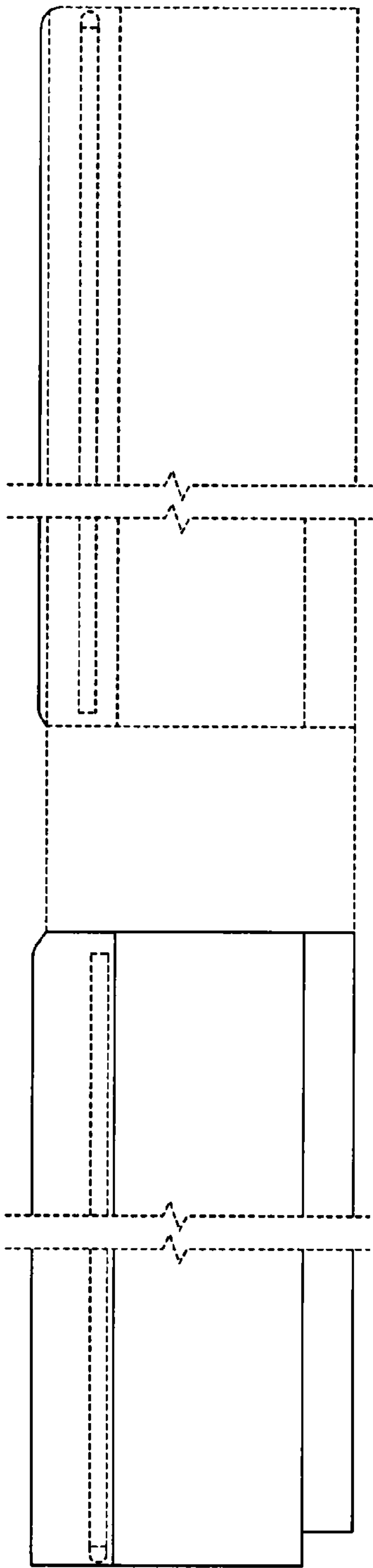

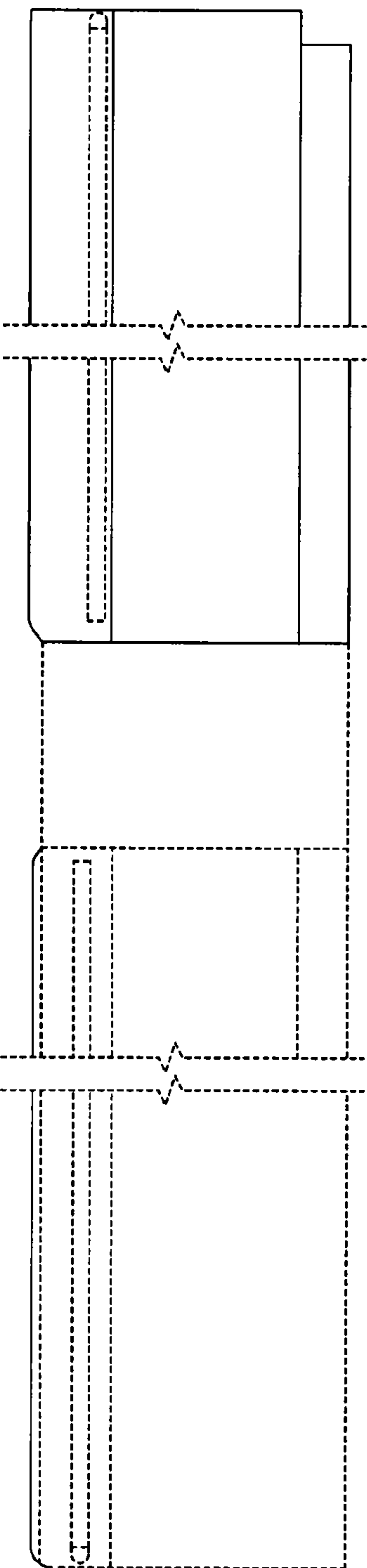

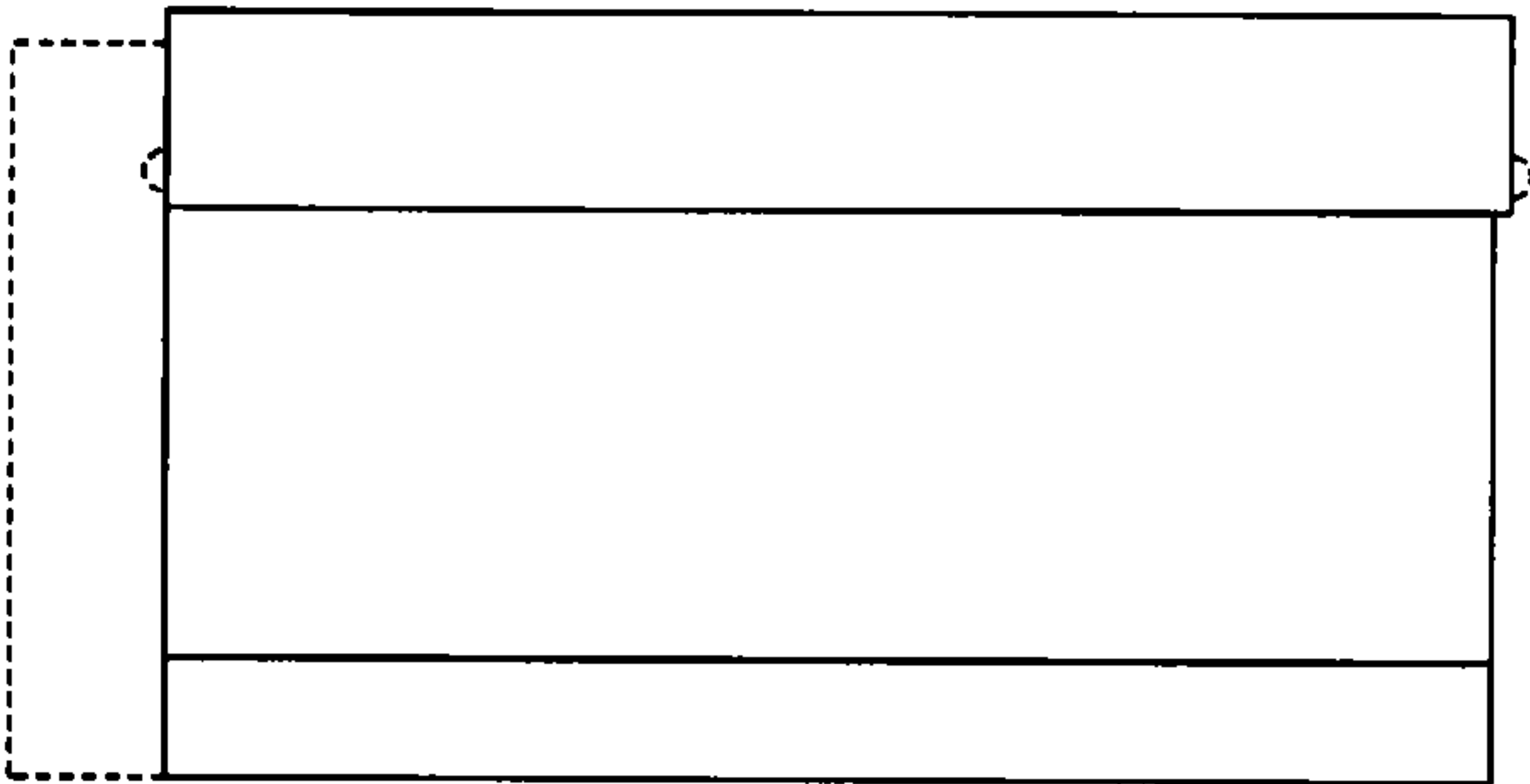

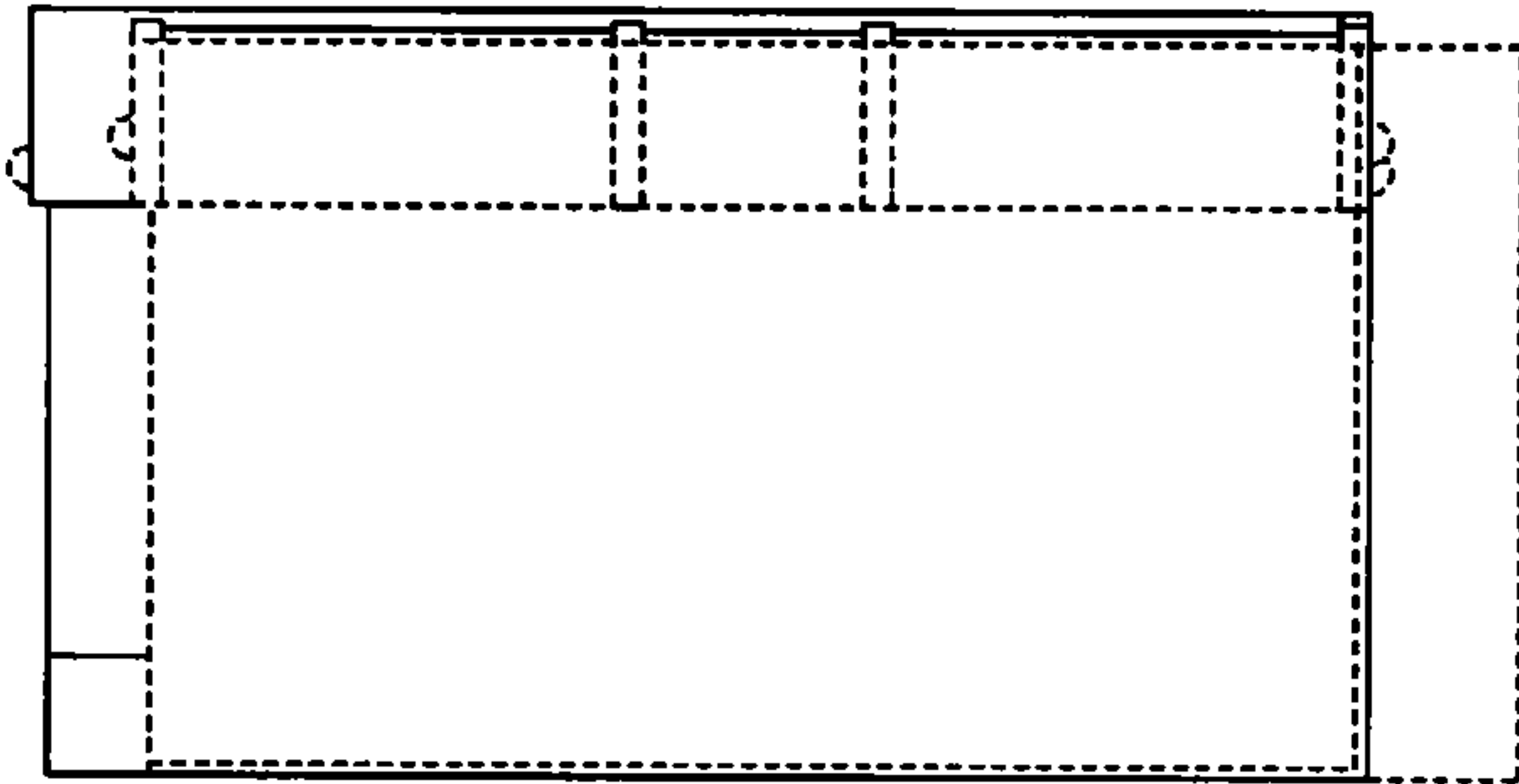
