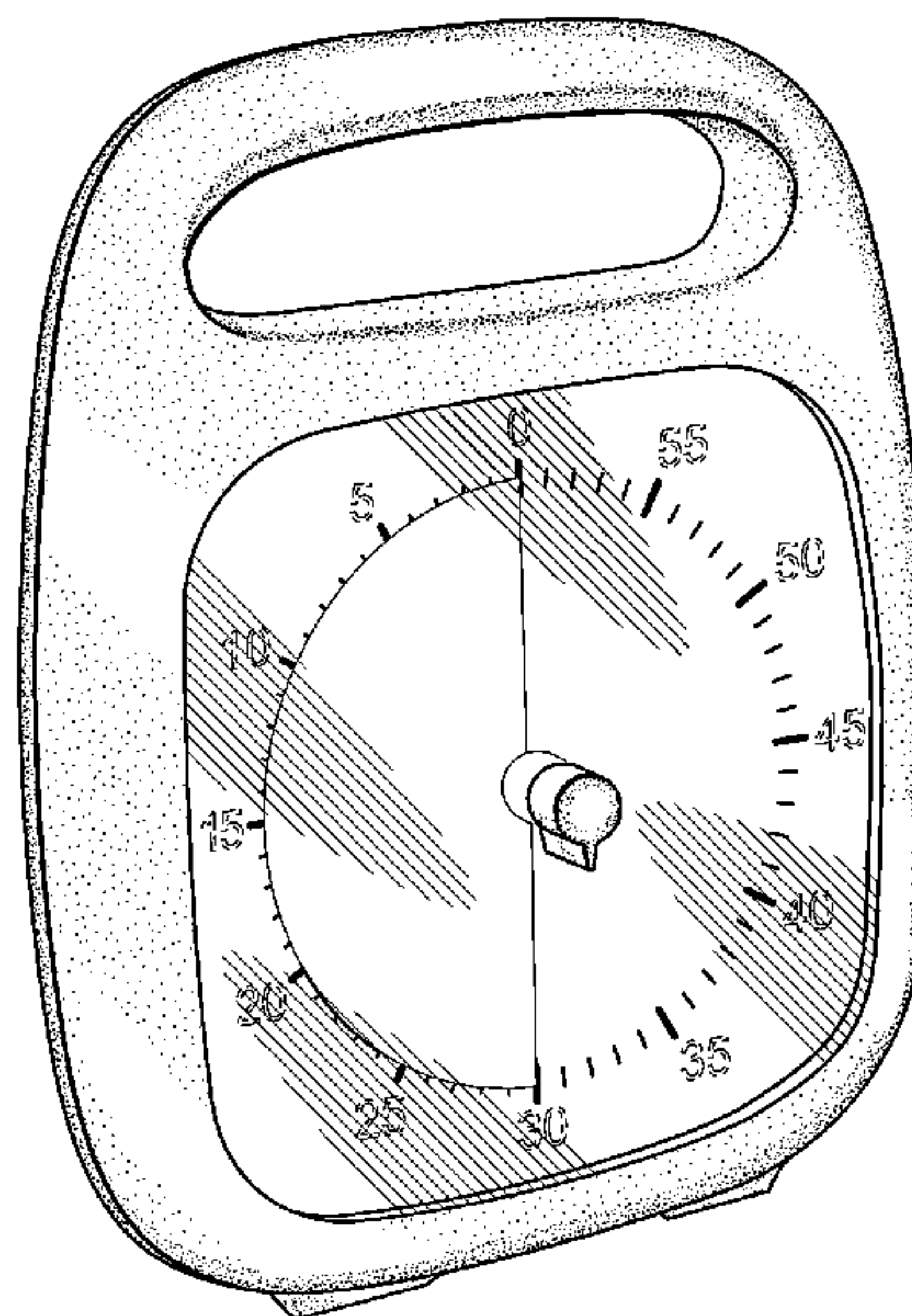
DESCRIPTION

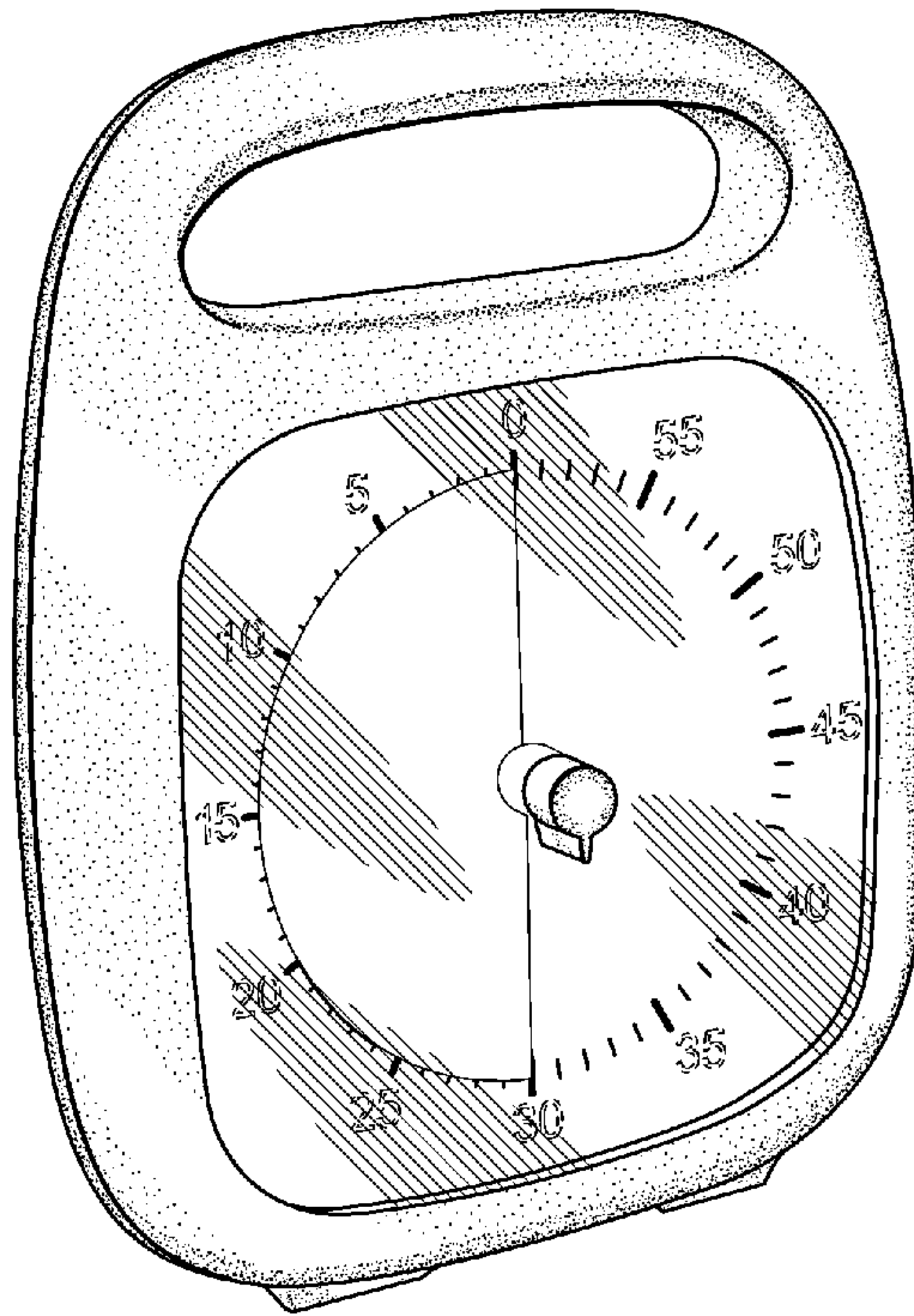

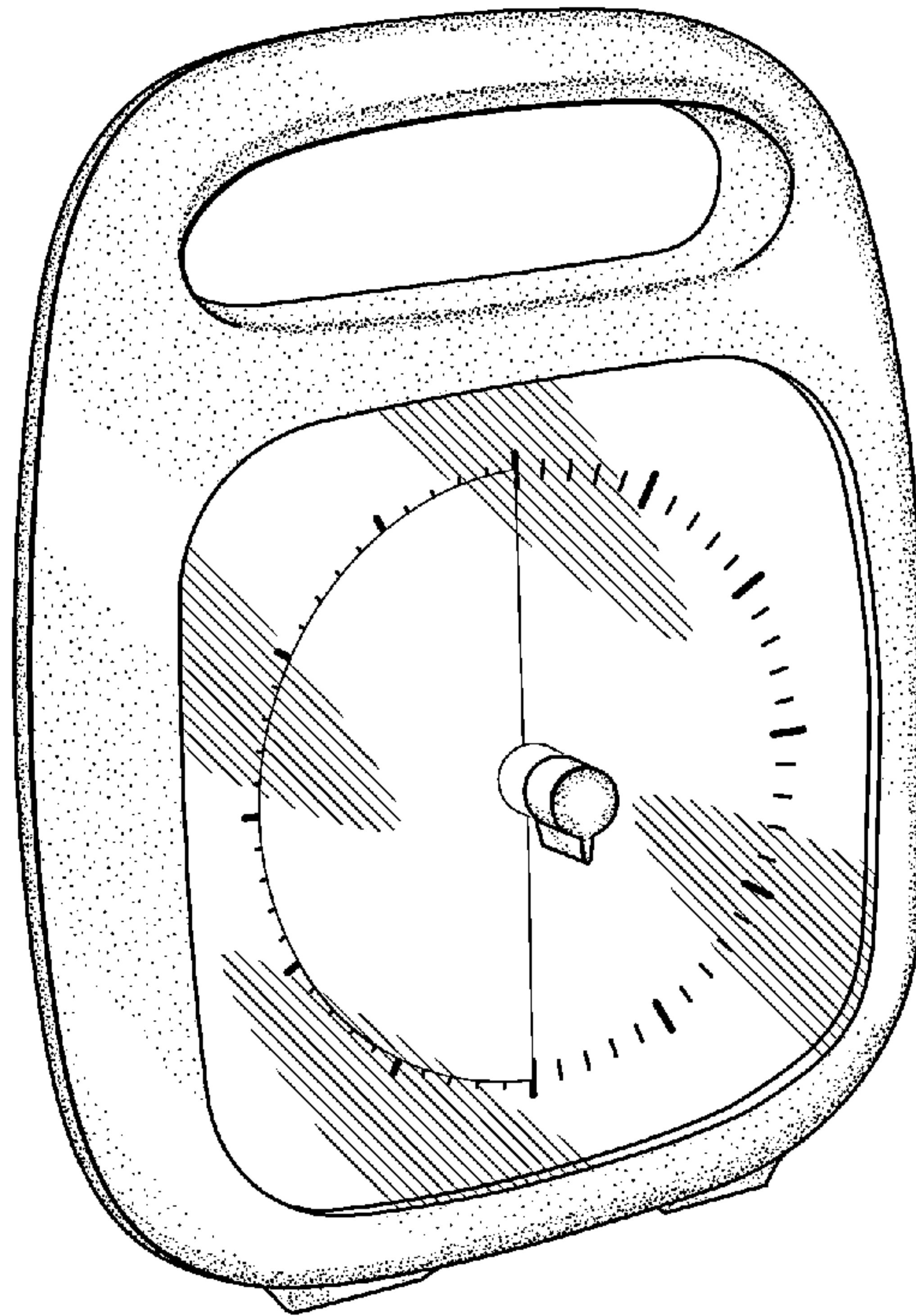
