FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof;

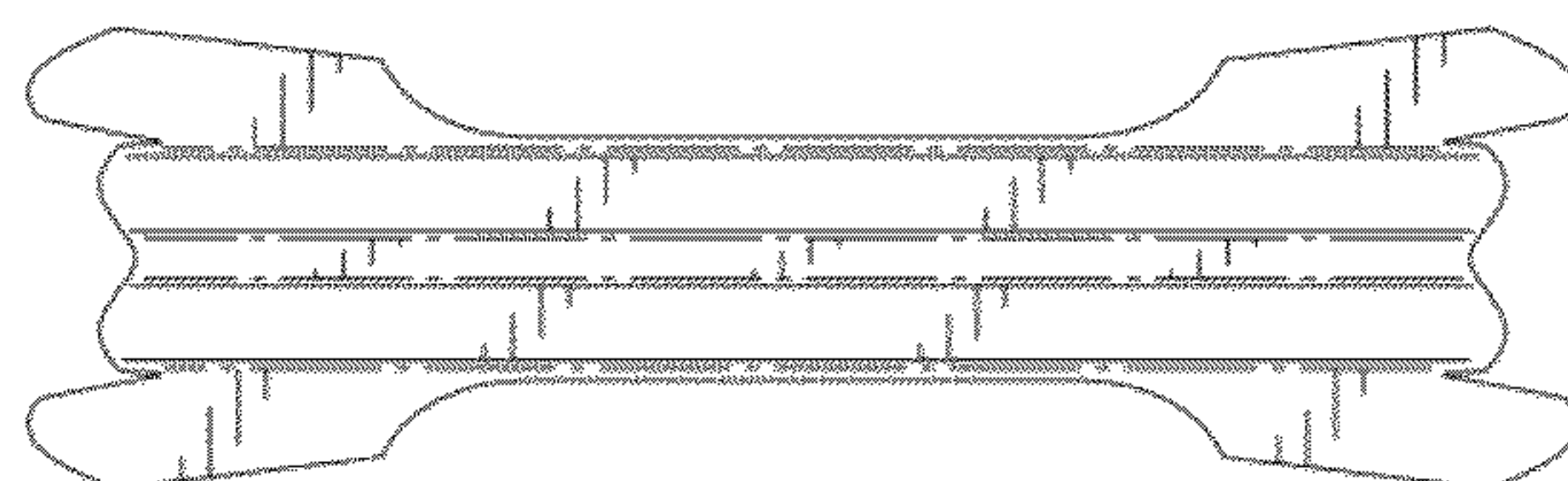
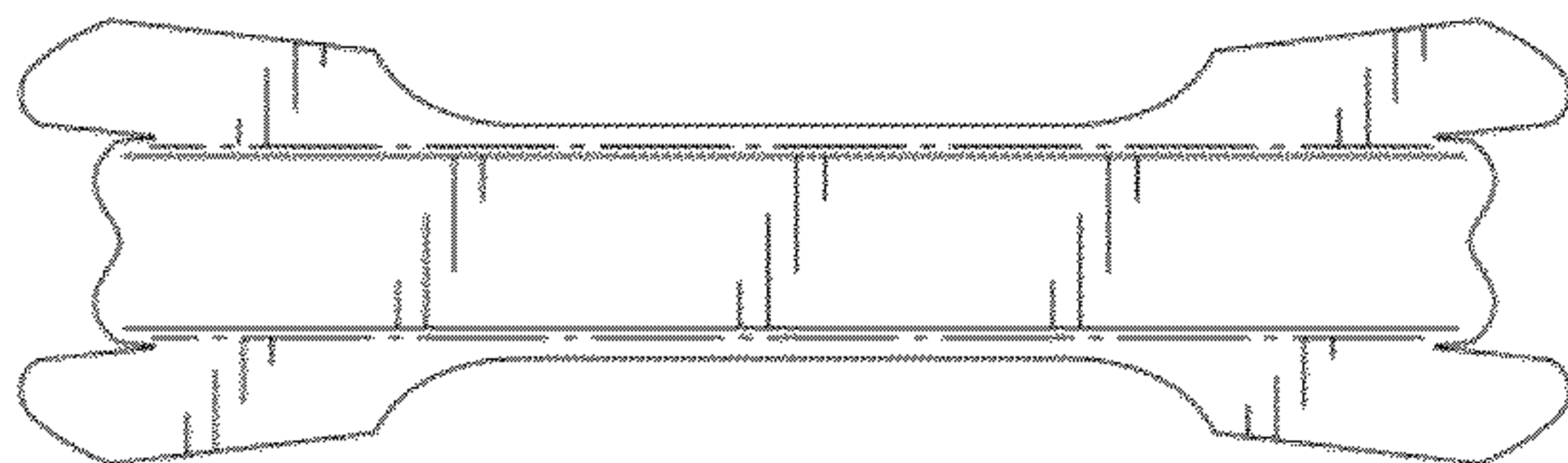
FIG. 14 is a front view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image;

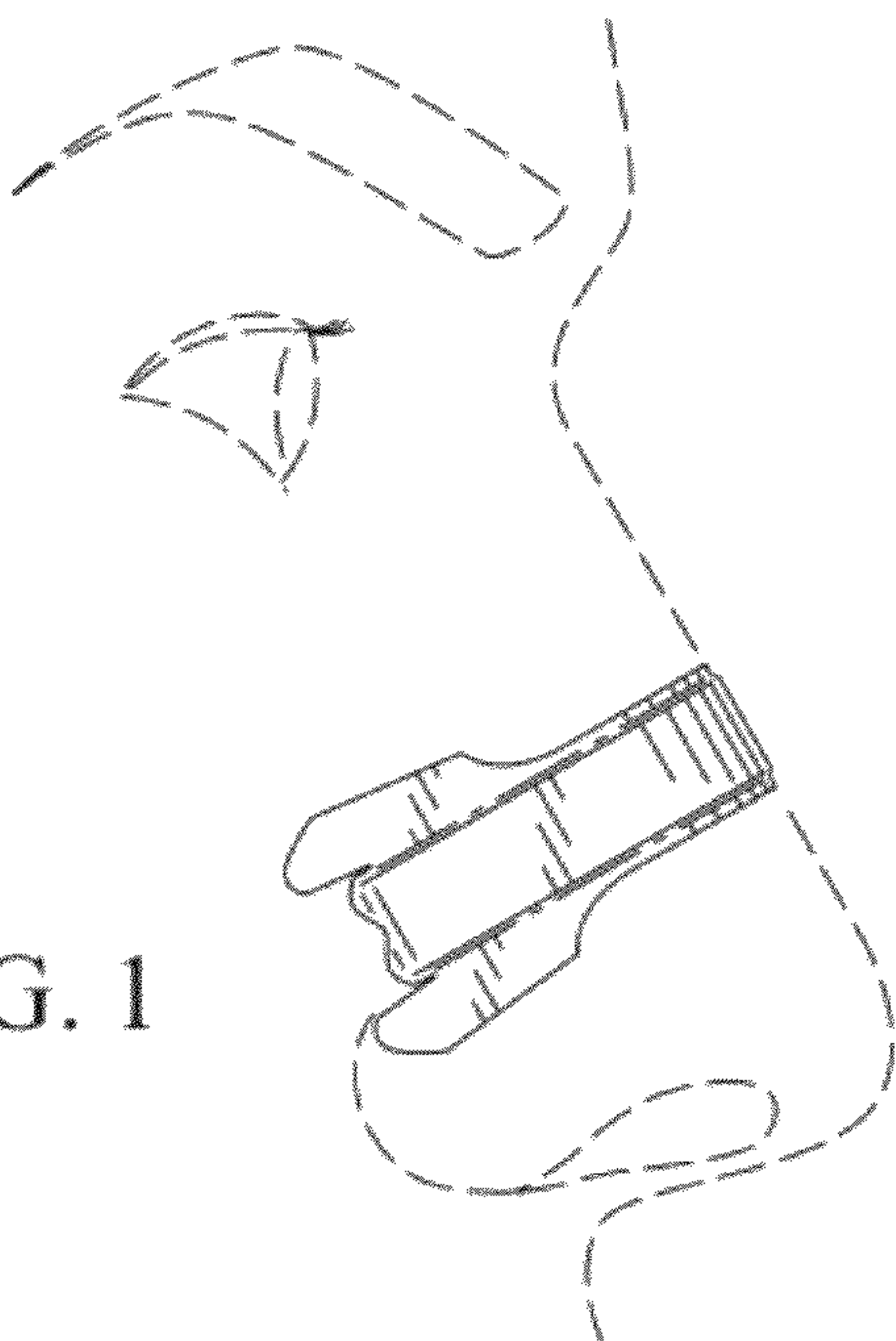

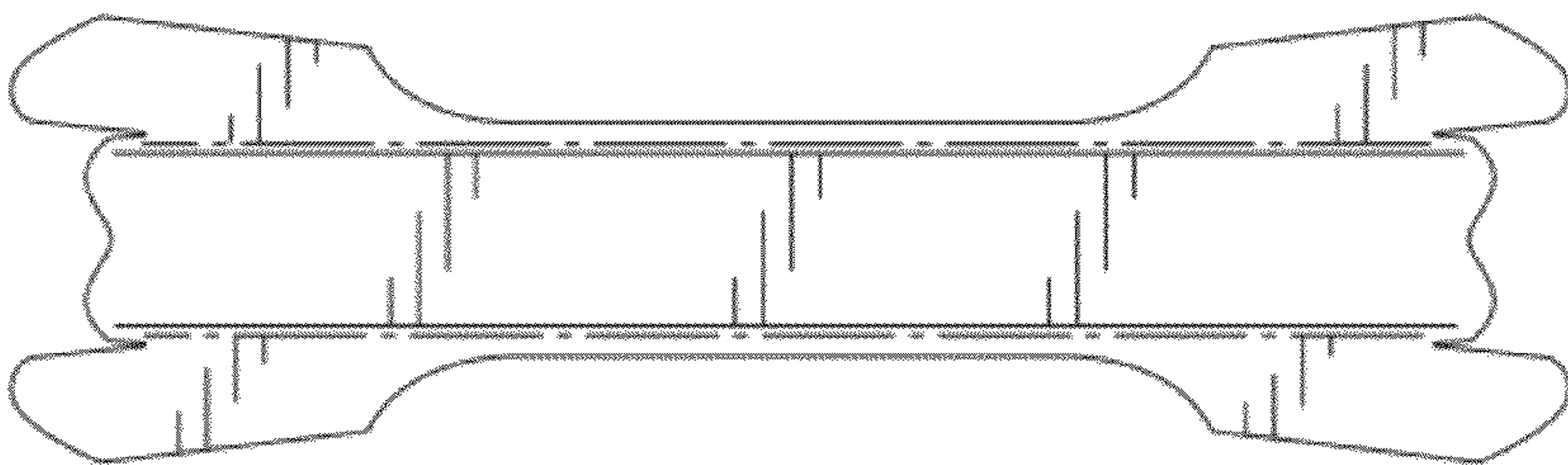

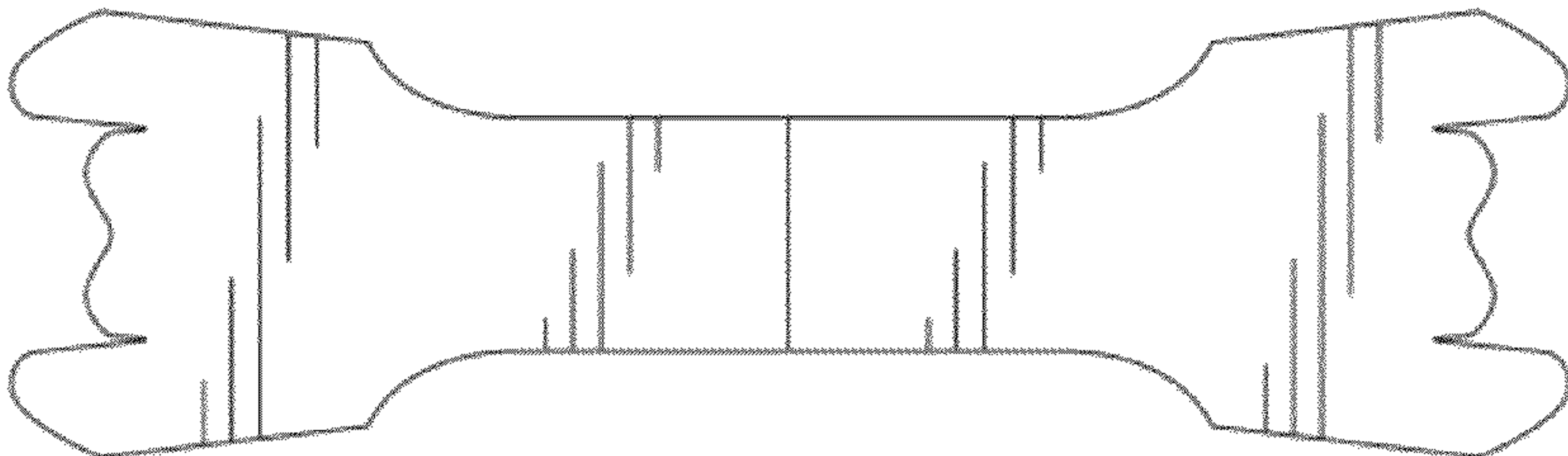

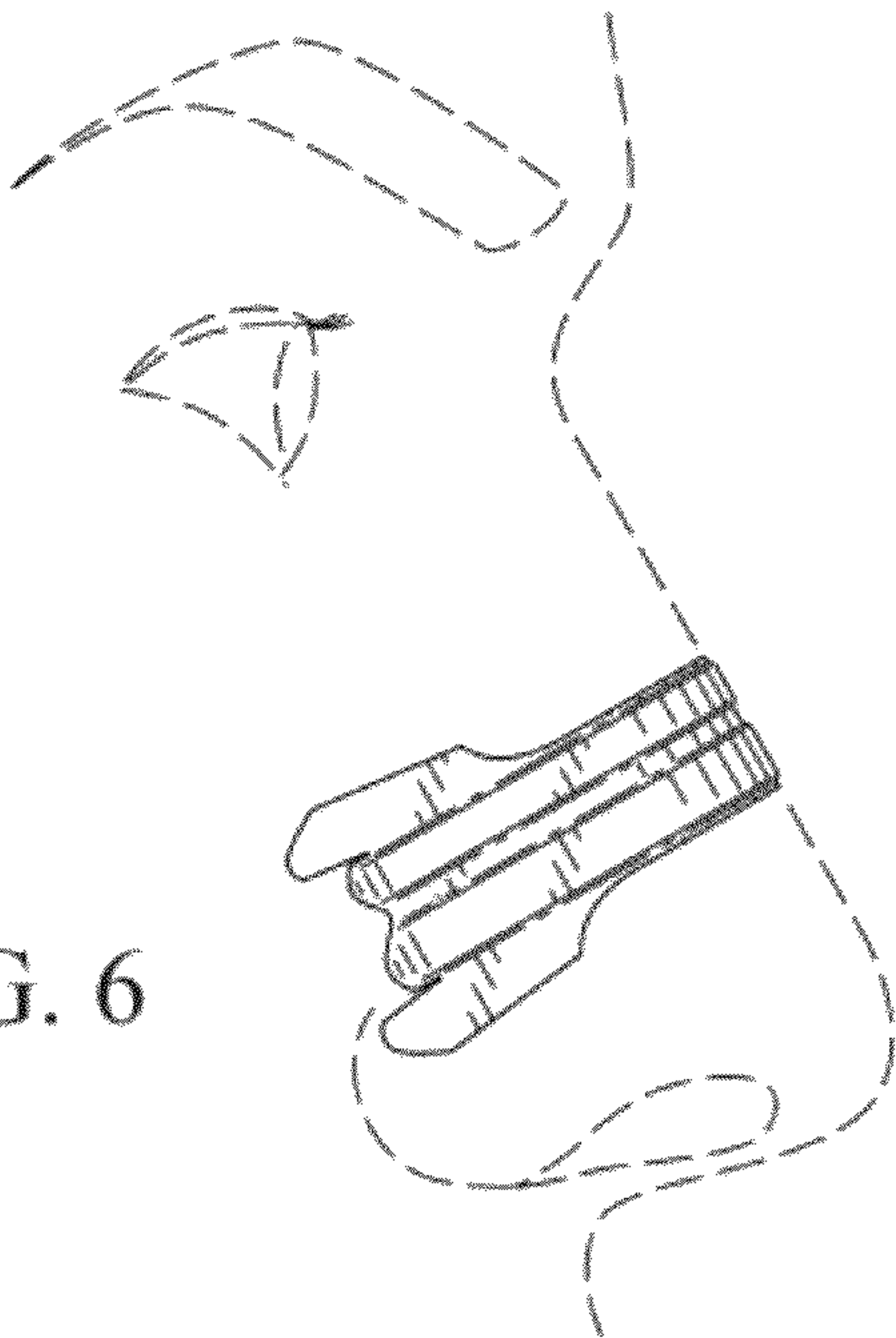

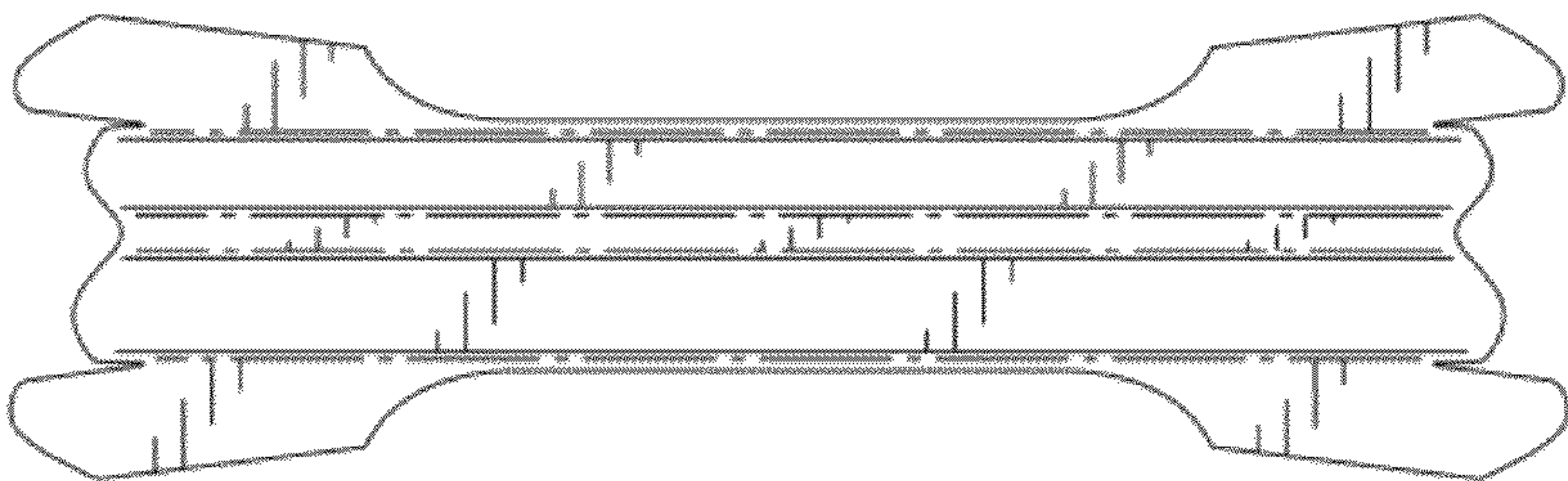

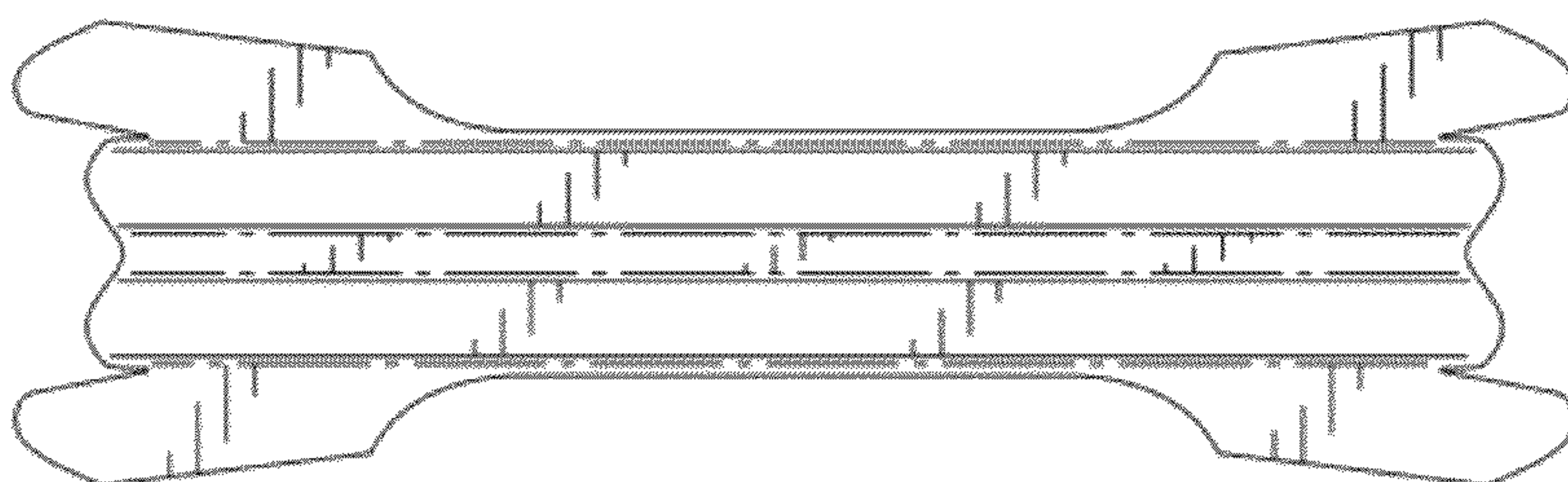
