(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental designs for a lighting fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lighting fixture having mirror image symmetry taken along a vertical imaginary plane that bisects the canopy. The lantern has four-way, ninety degree overall rotational symmetry.

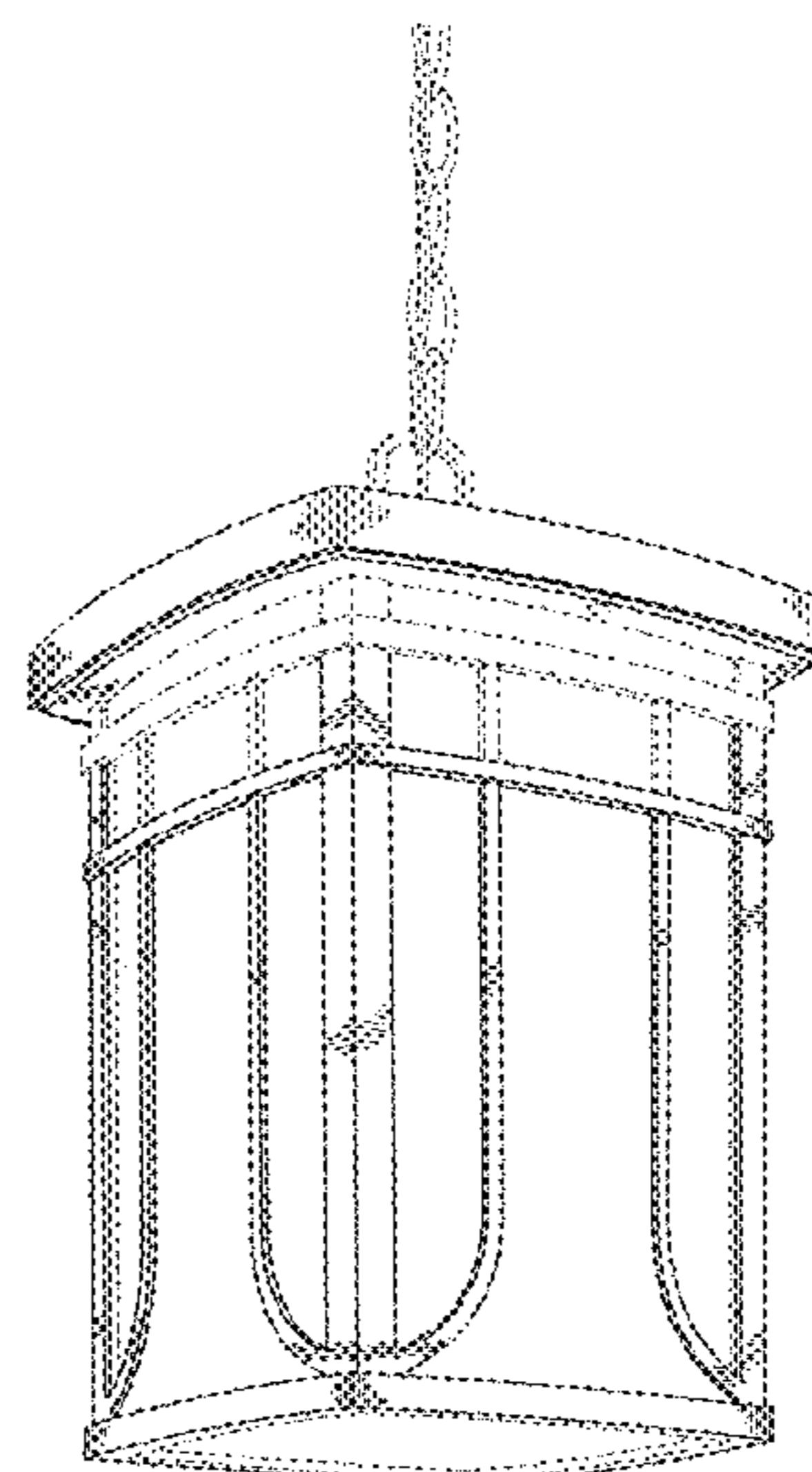
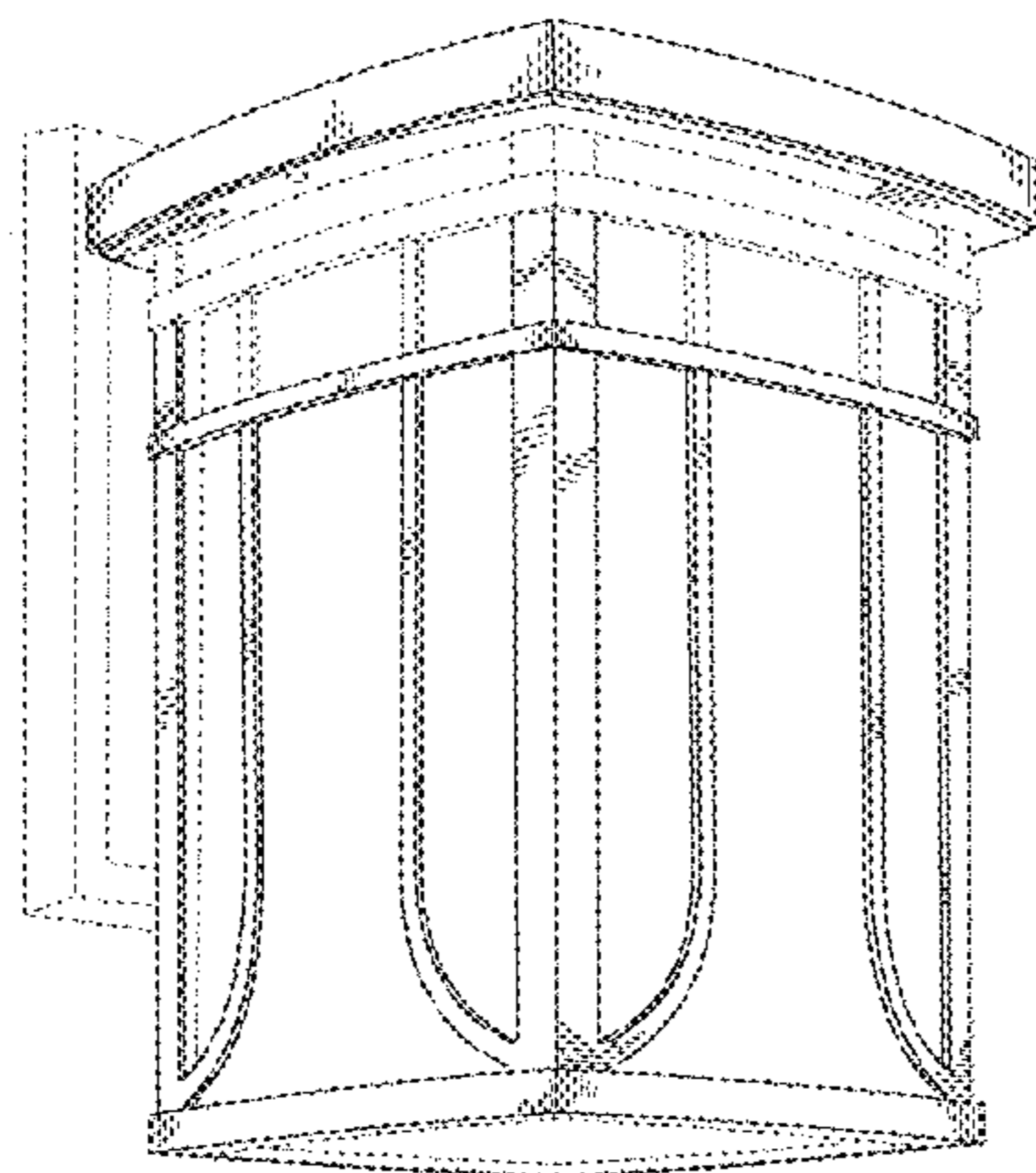

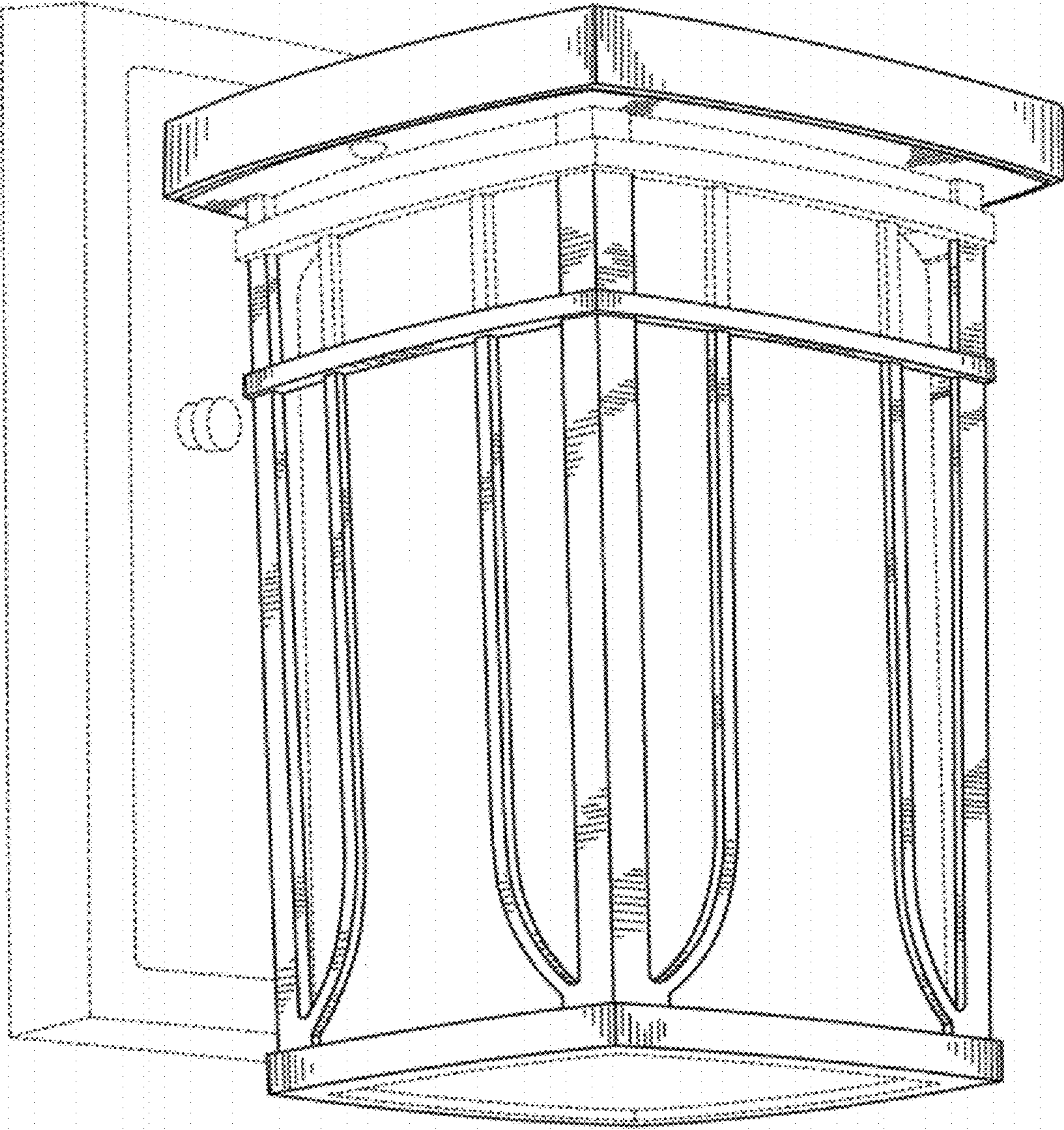

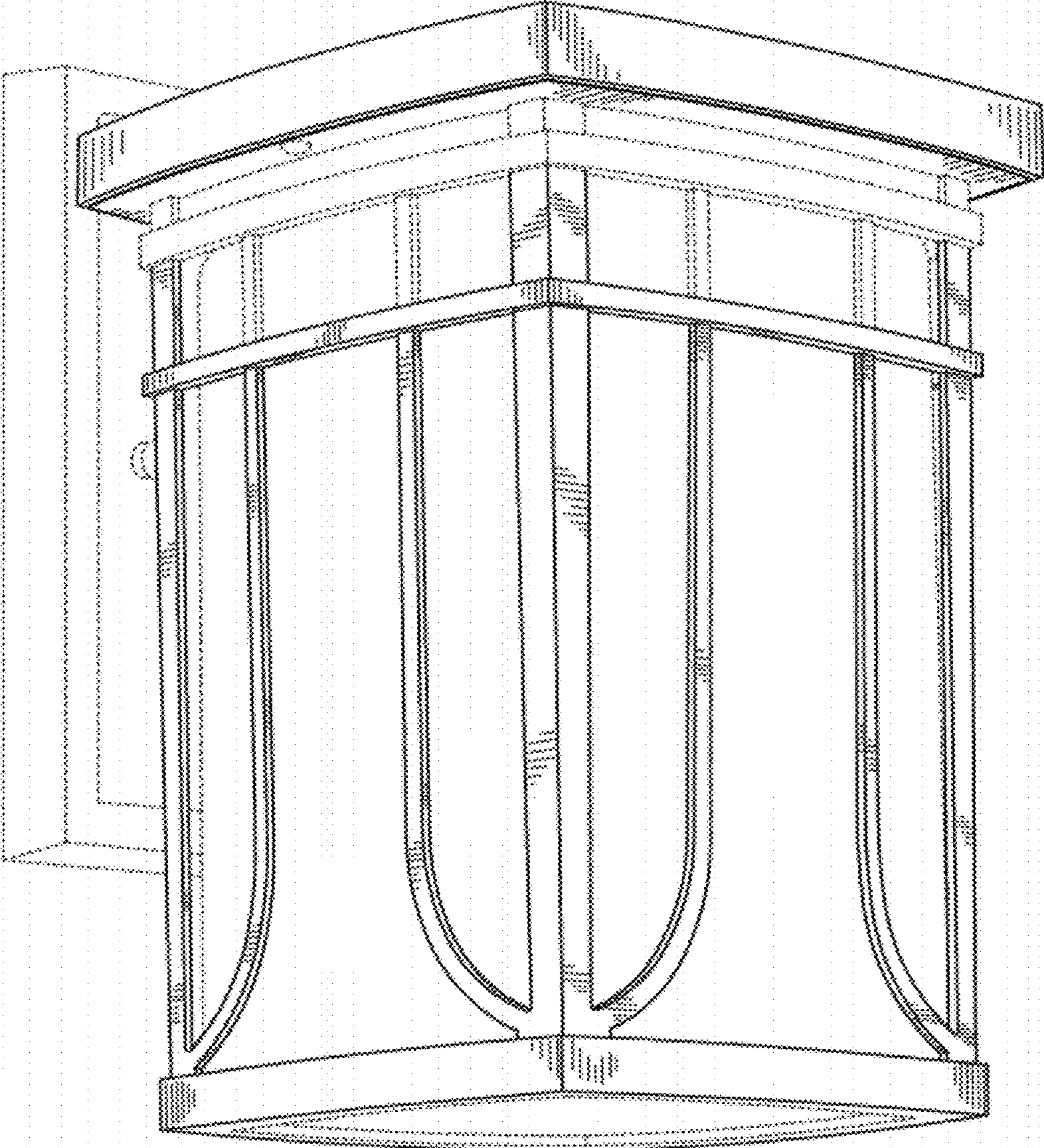

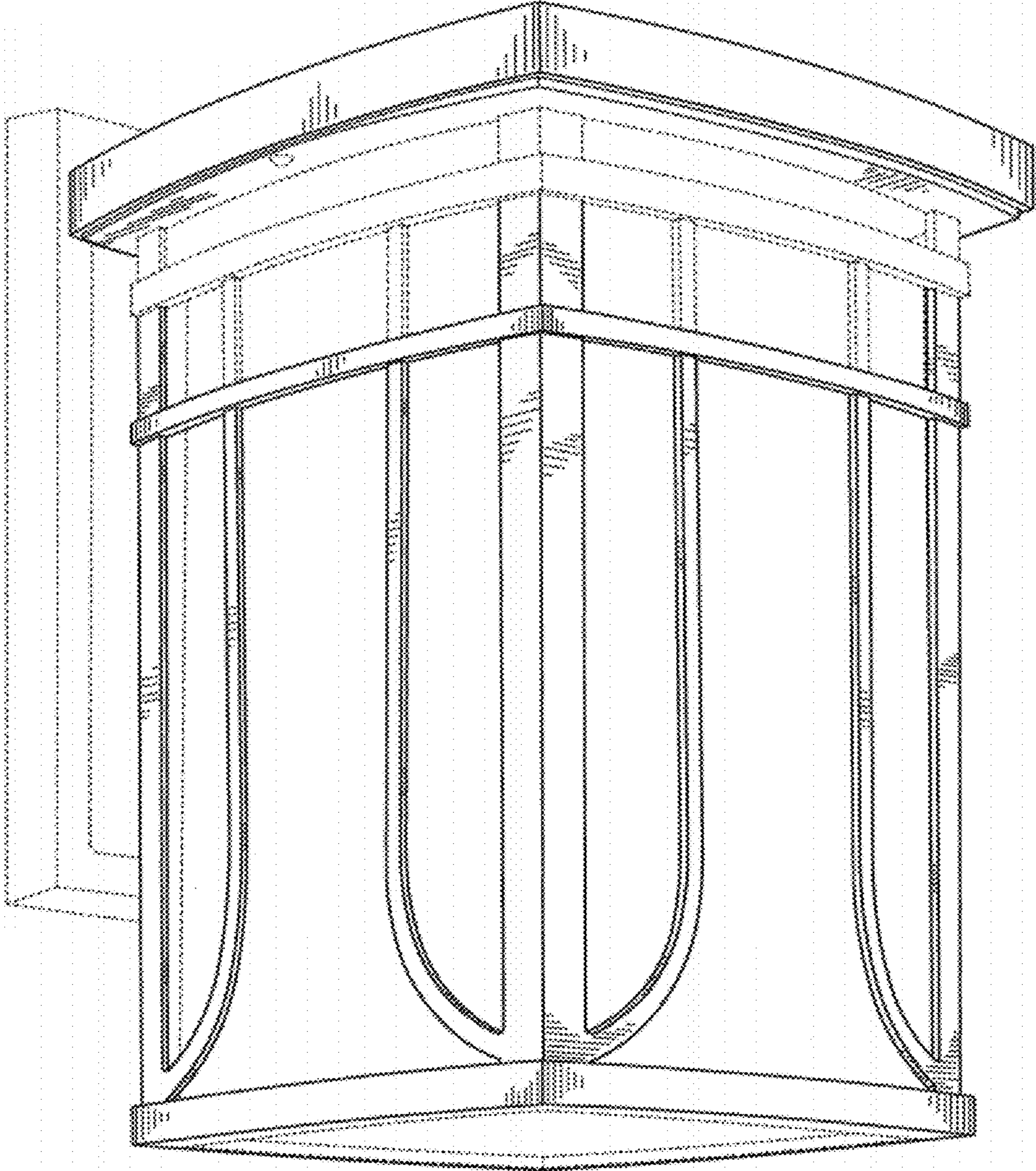

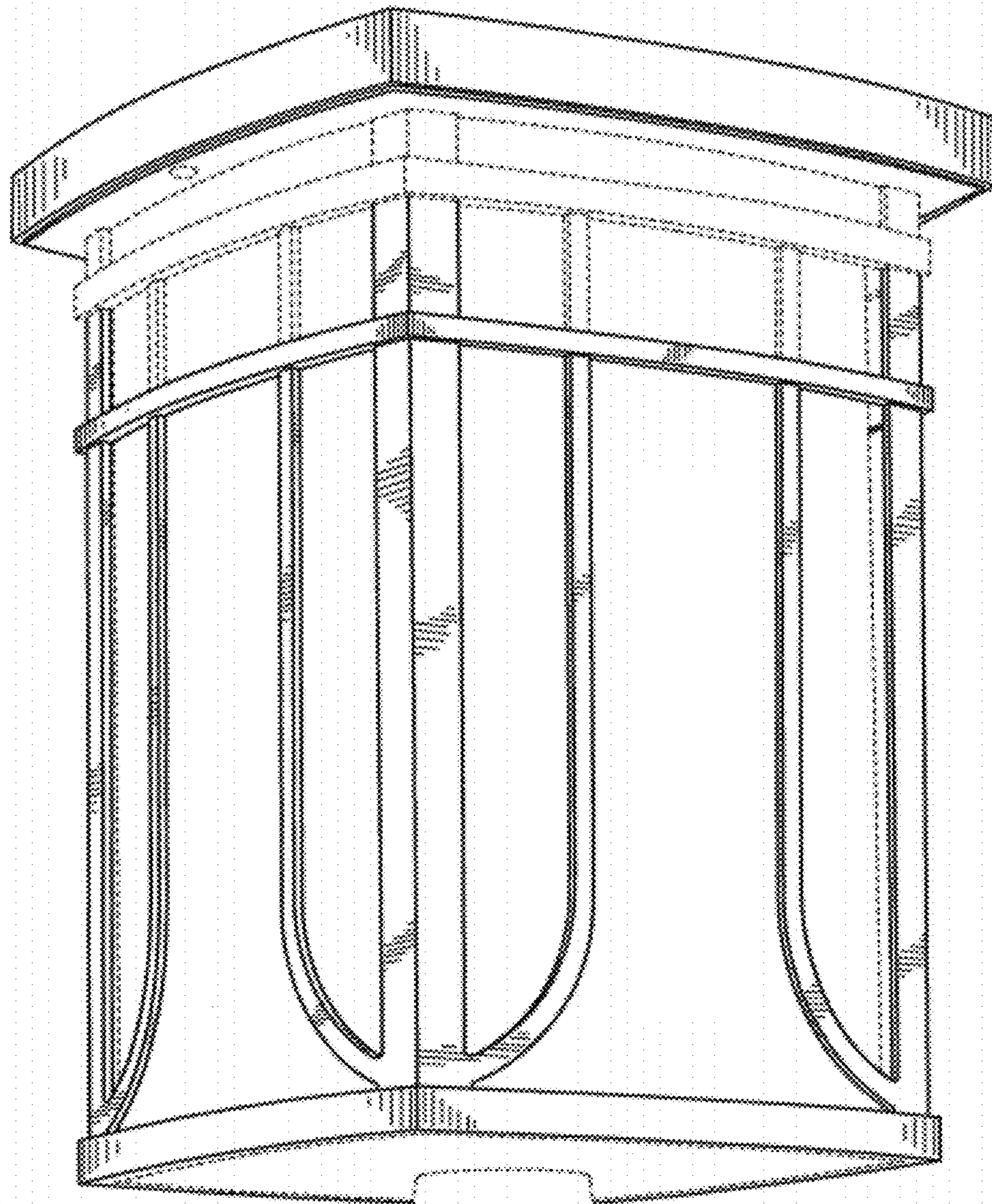
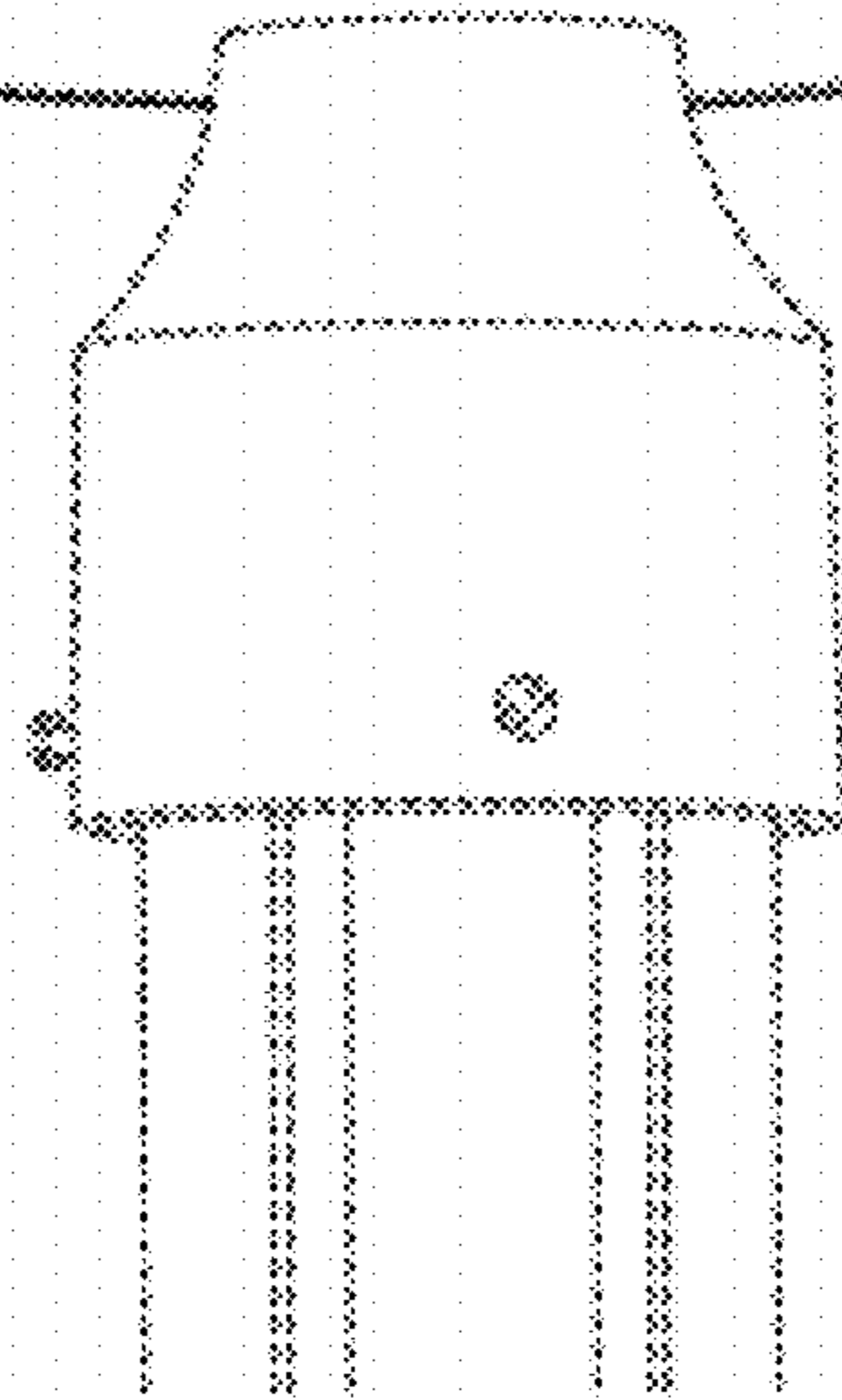

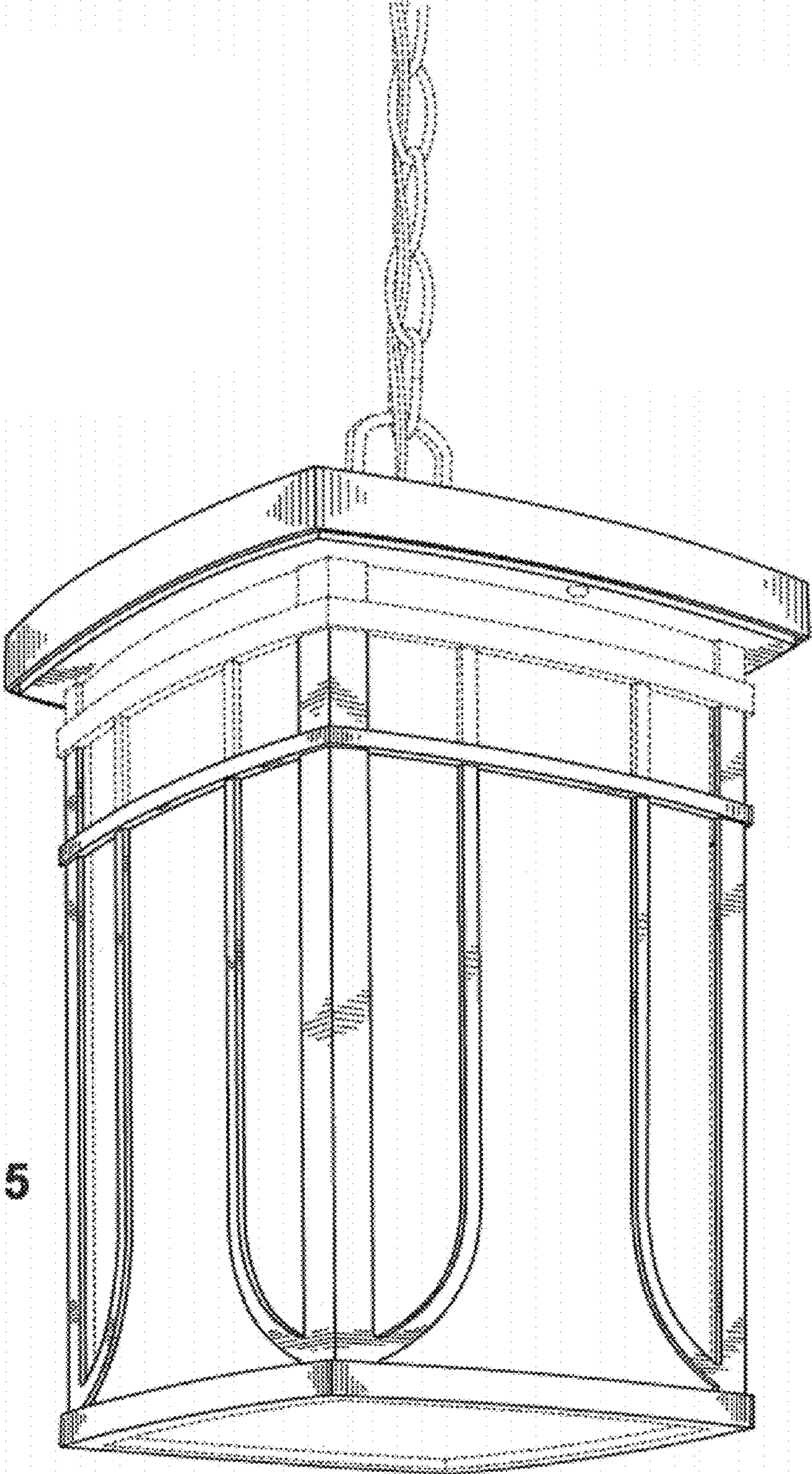
