(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a synthetic resin paper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a synthetic resin paper.
 FIG. 2 is a duplicate of FIG. 1 showing areas from where the details for FIGS. 3 and 4 are taken.
 FIG. 3 is an enlarged detail of the synthetic resin paper of FIG. 2; and,
 FIG. 4 is another enlarged detail of the synthetic resin paper of FIG. 2.
 The broken lines represent the boundaries of the details and form no part of the claim.
 The thickness of the synthetic resin paper forms no part of the claimed design.

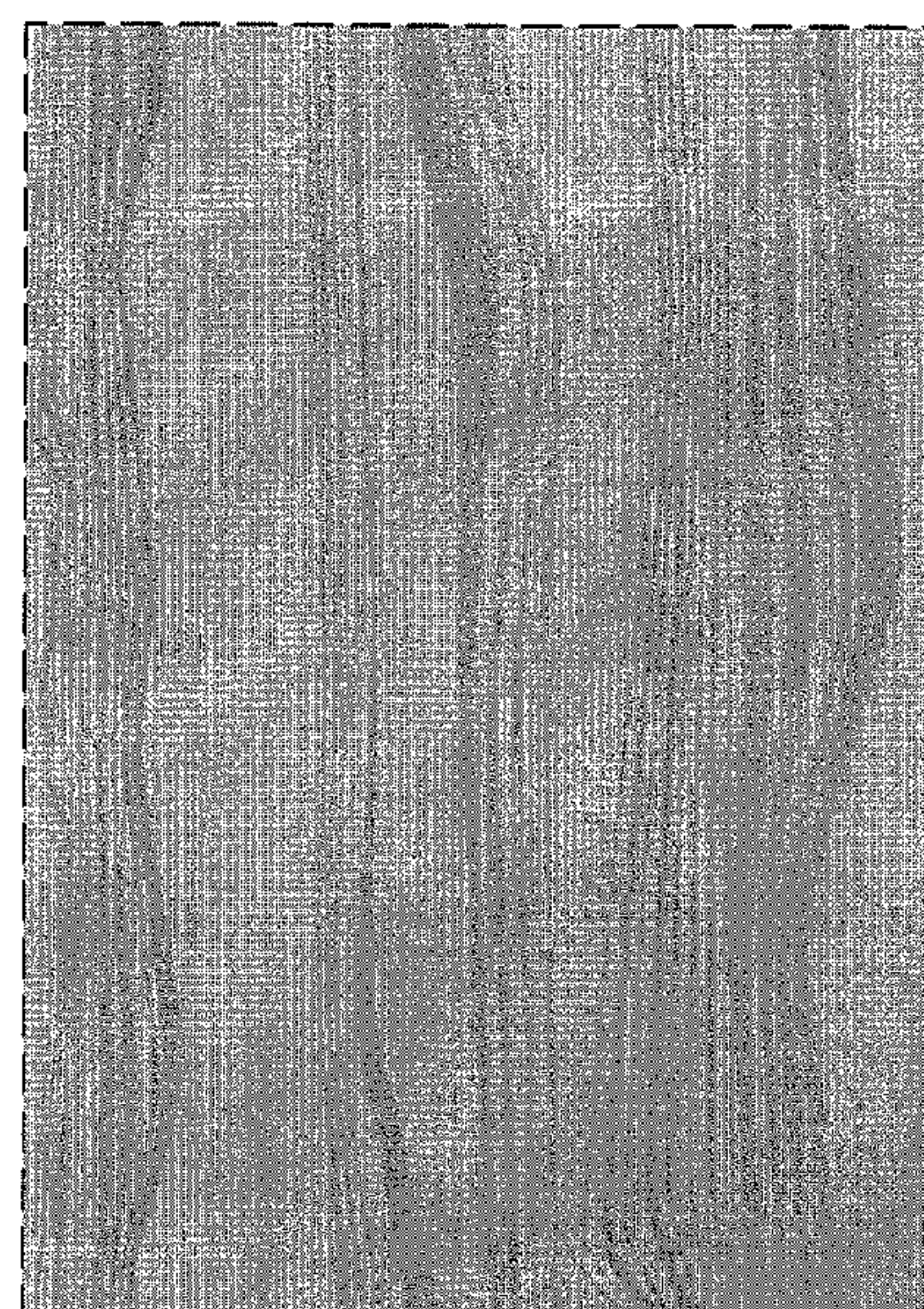
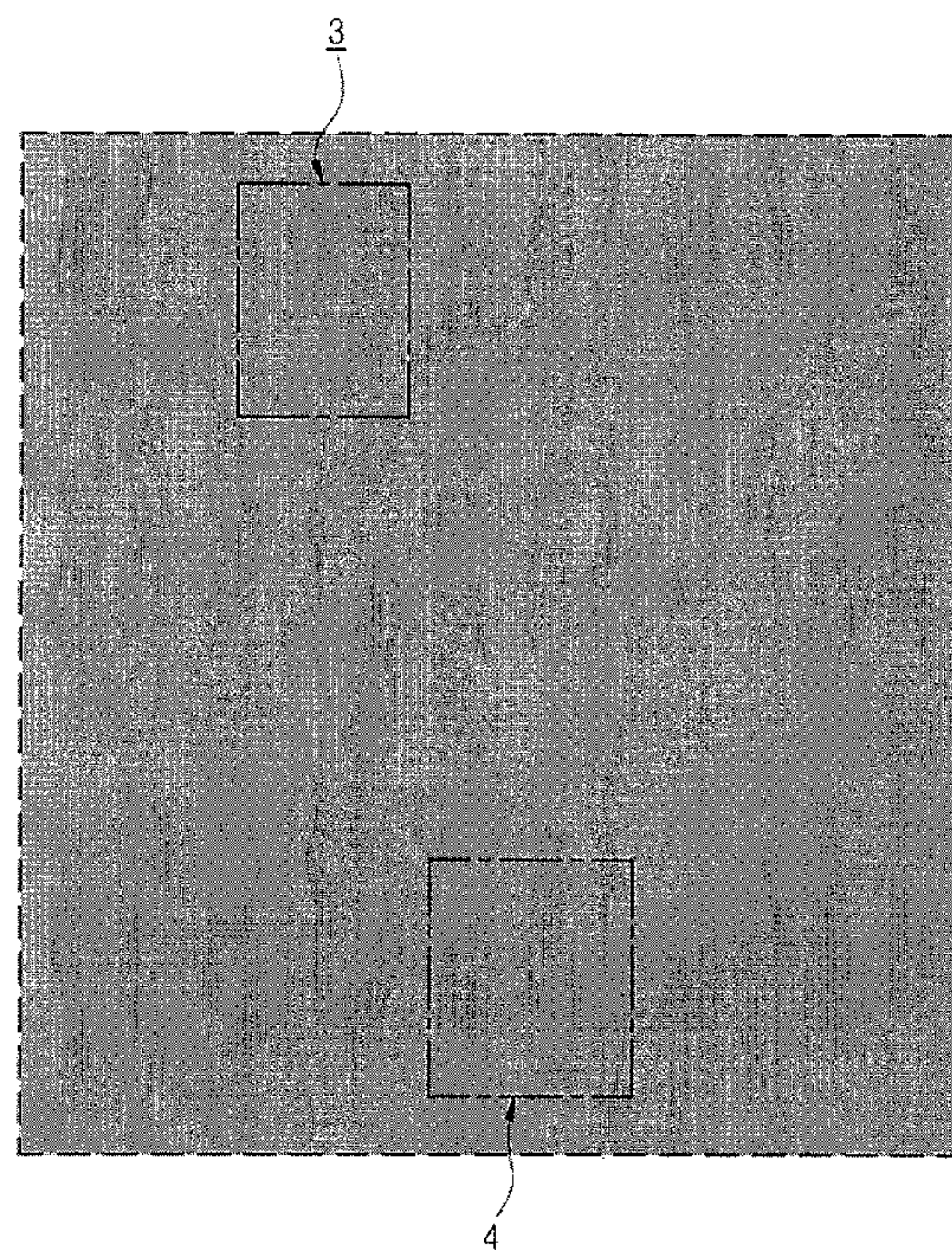

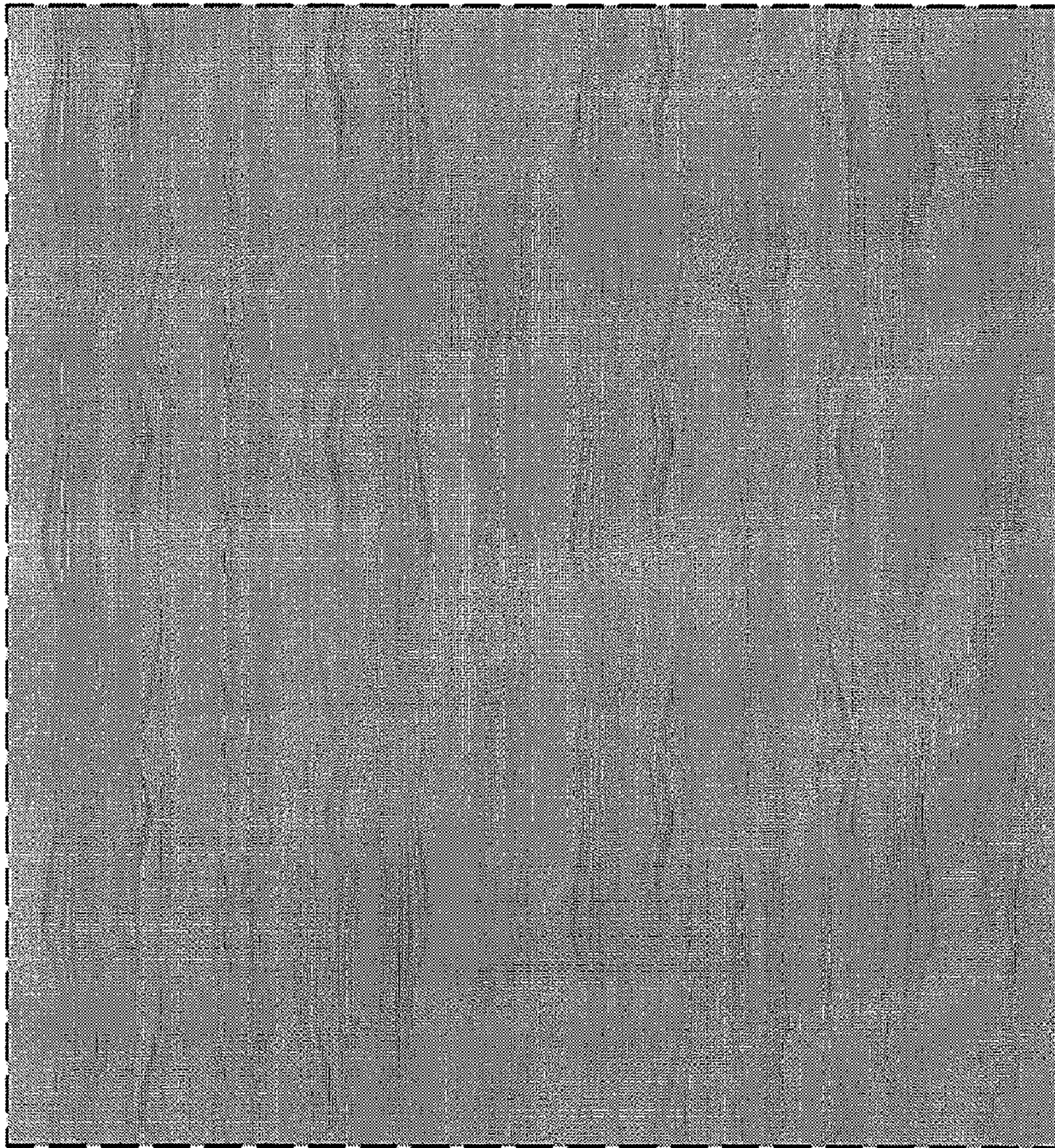

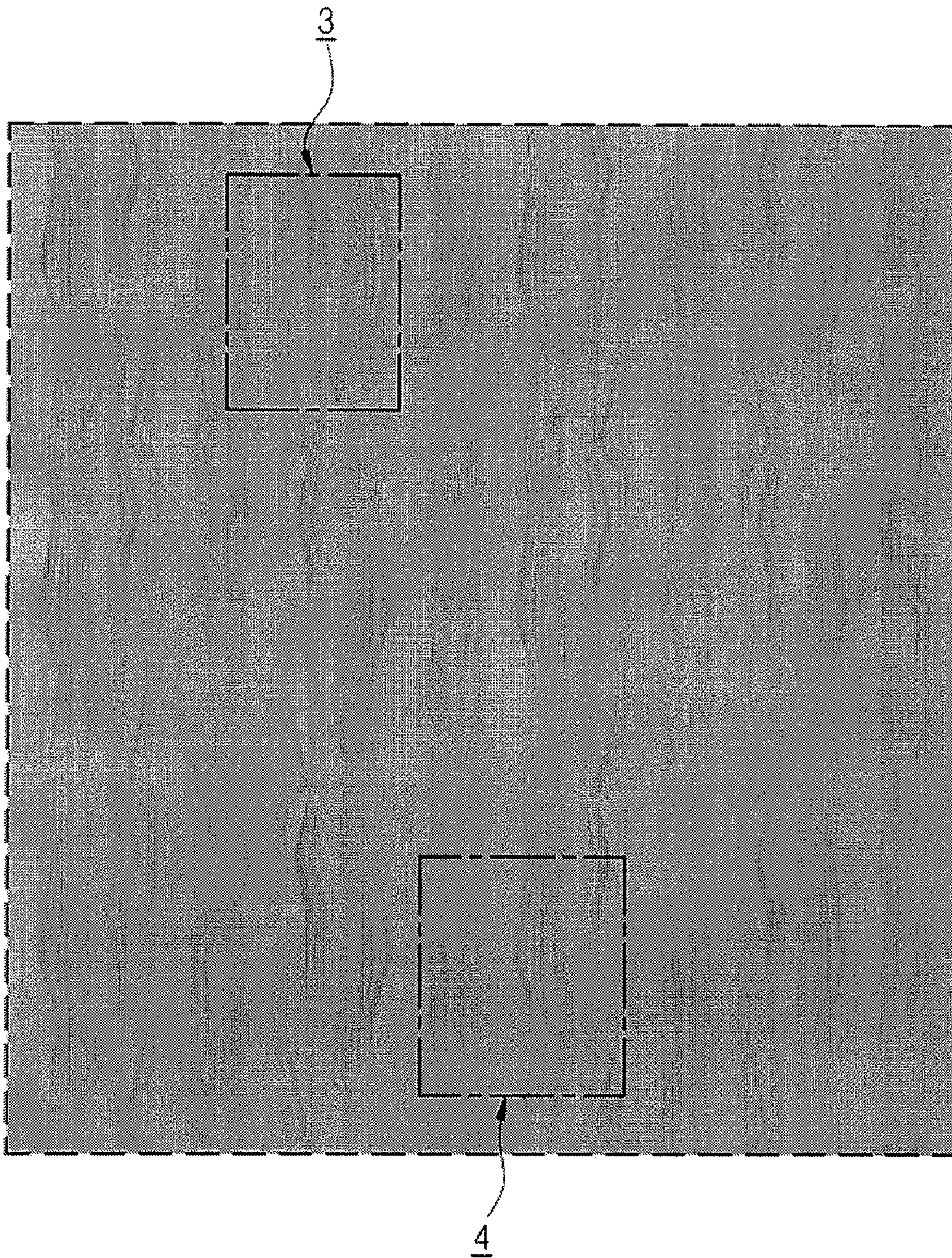

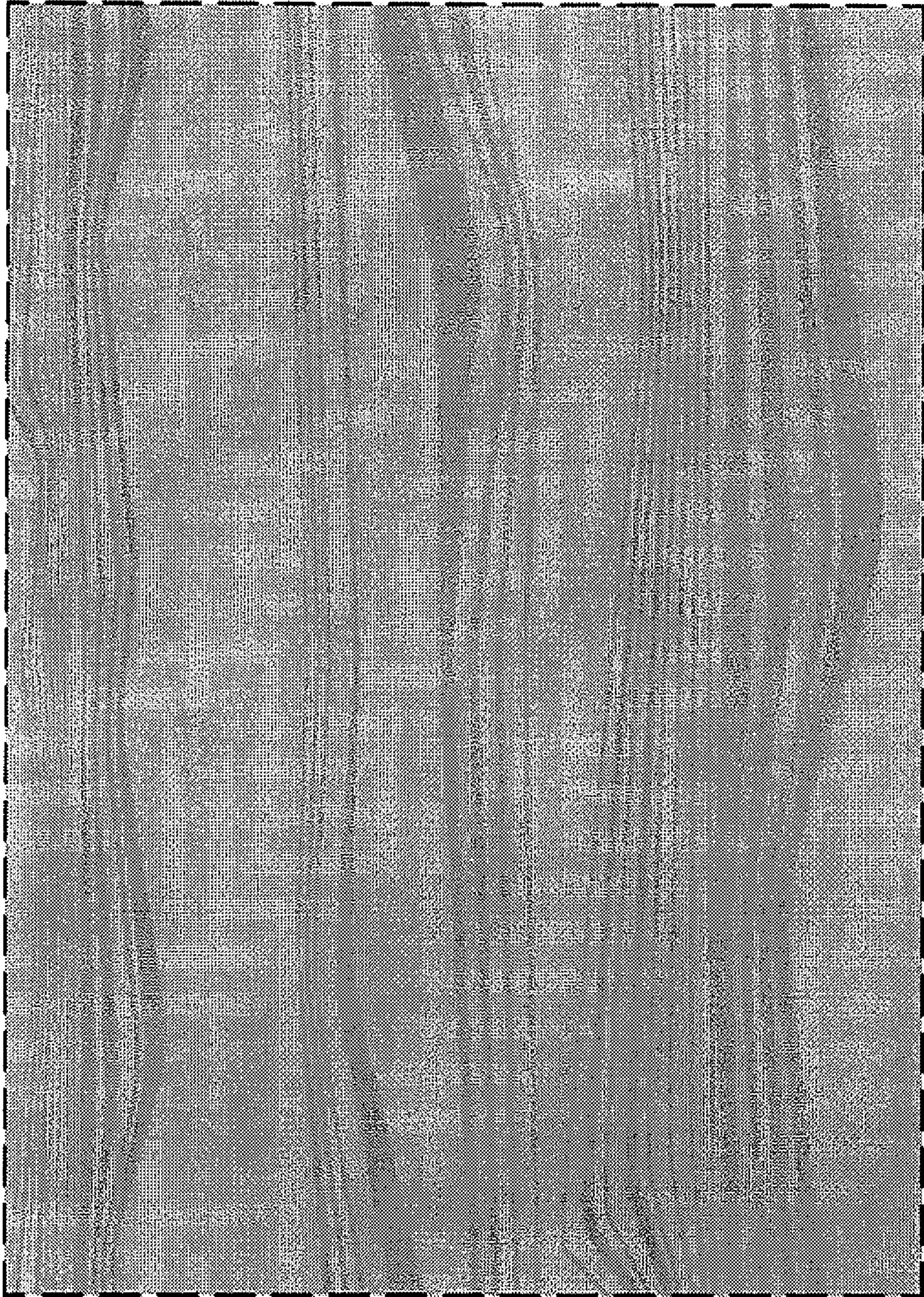
