FIG. 7 is a top, front, right side perspective view showing a second embodiment thereof.

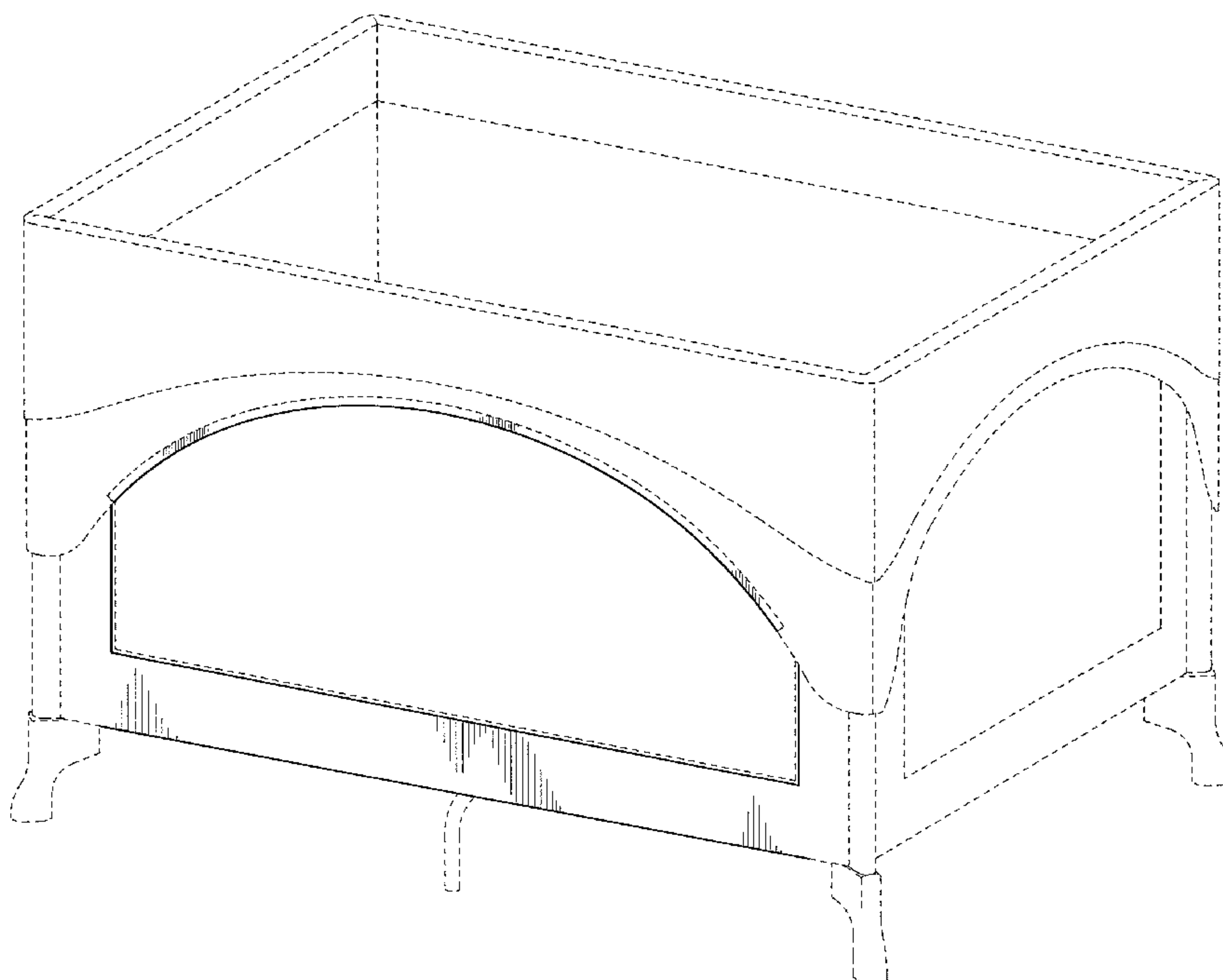
FIG. 8 is a front view thereof, the back thereof being a mirror image.

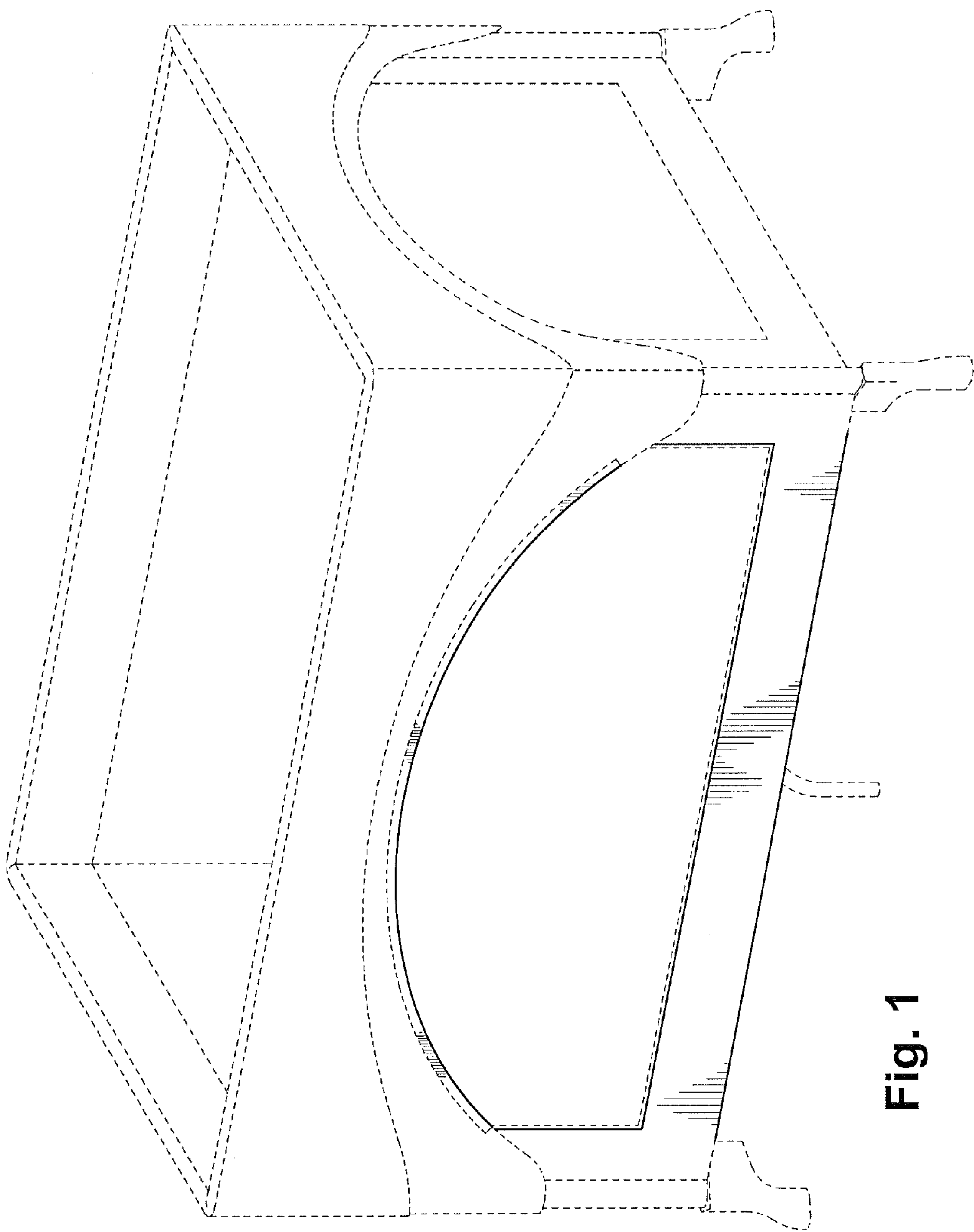

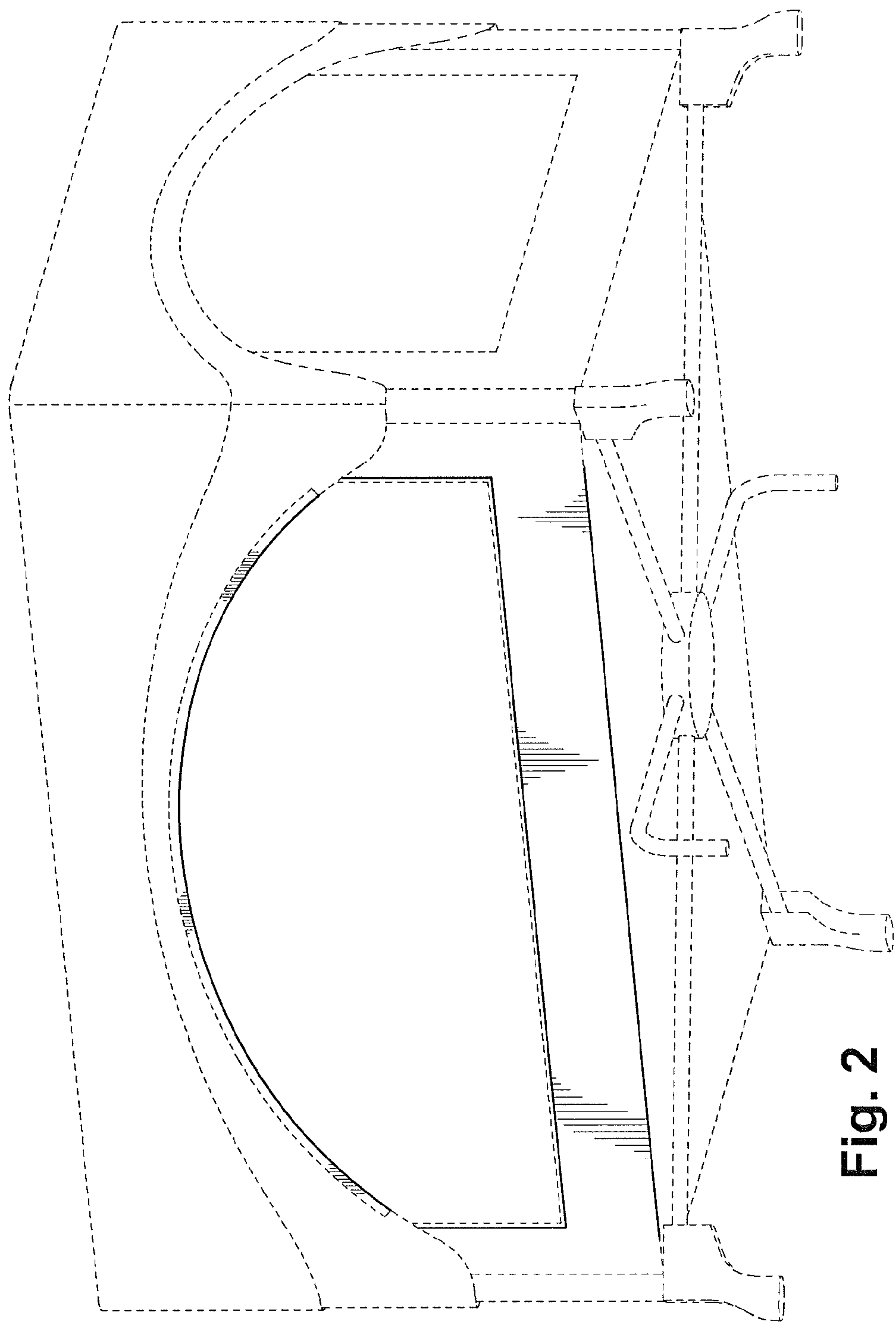

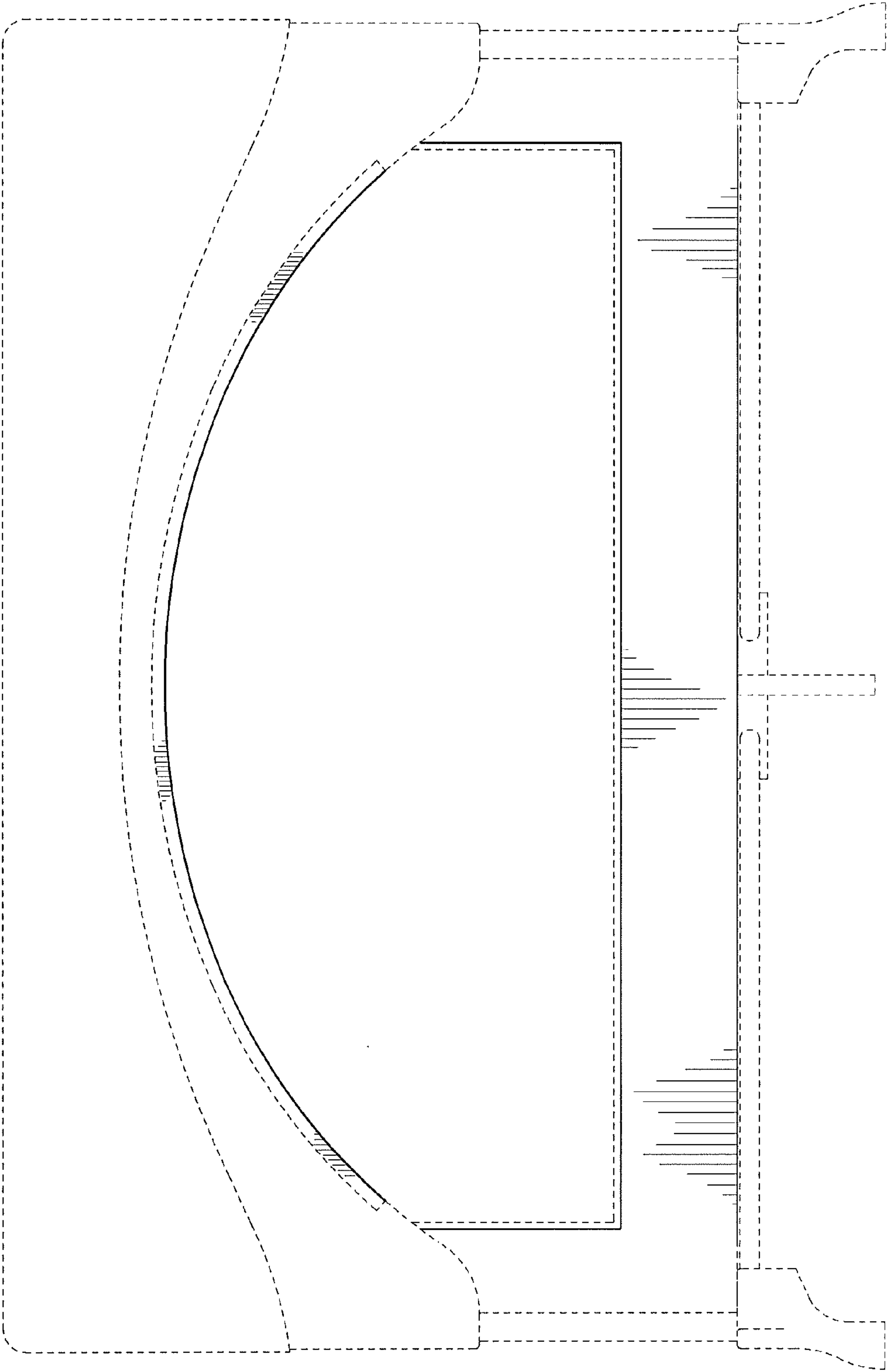

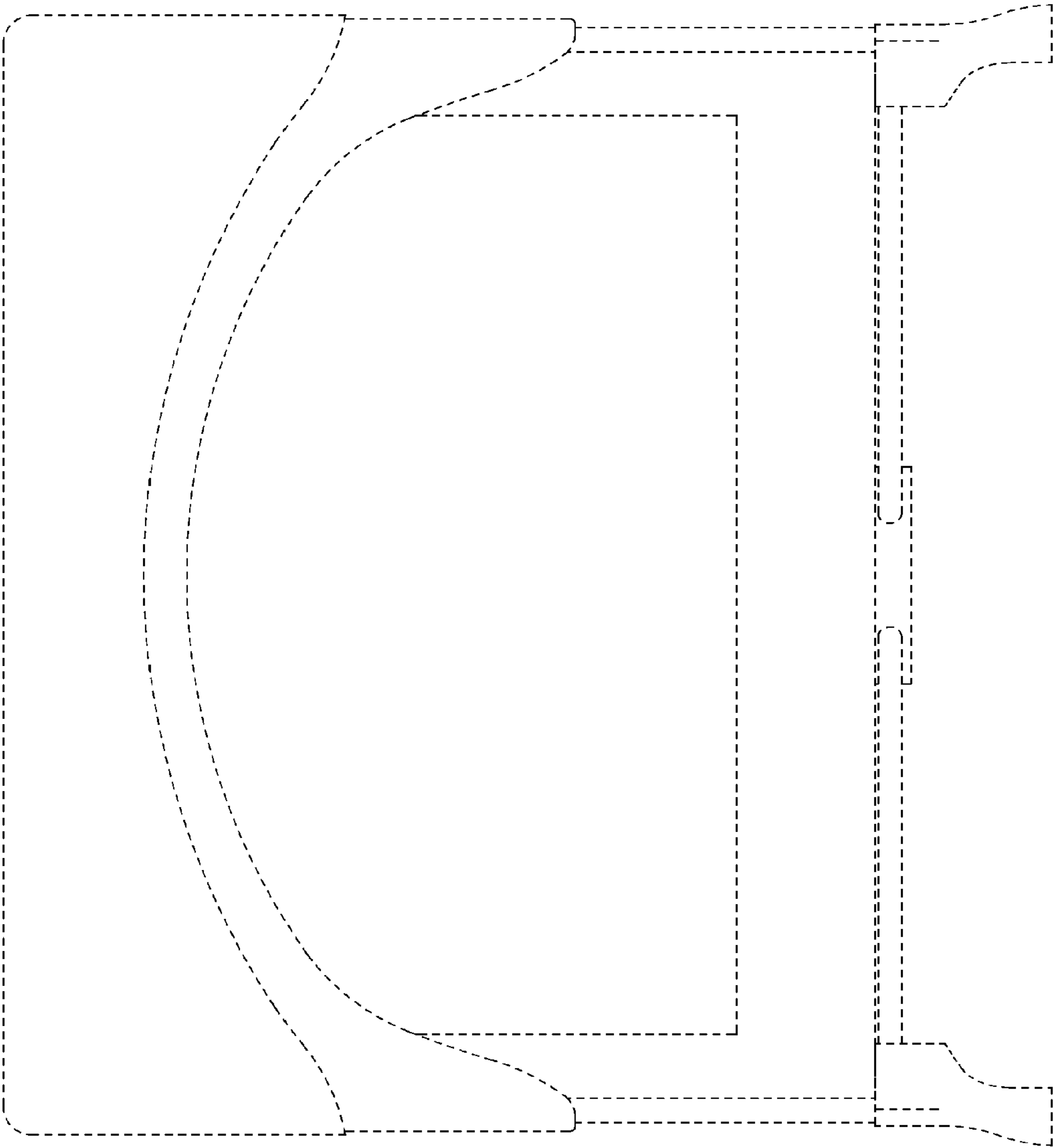

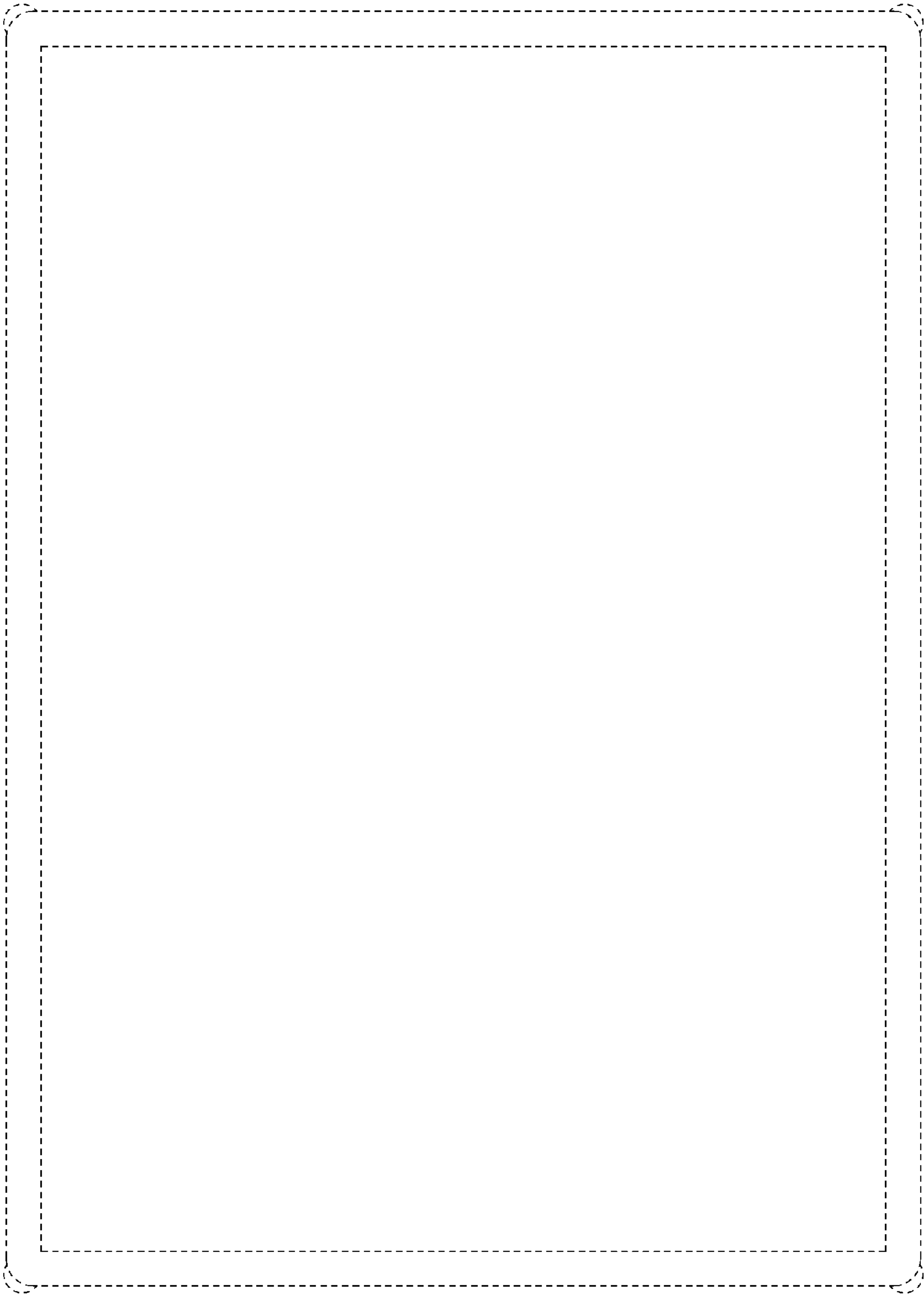

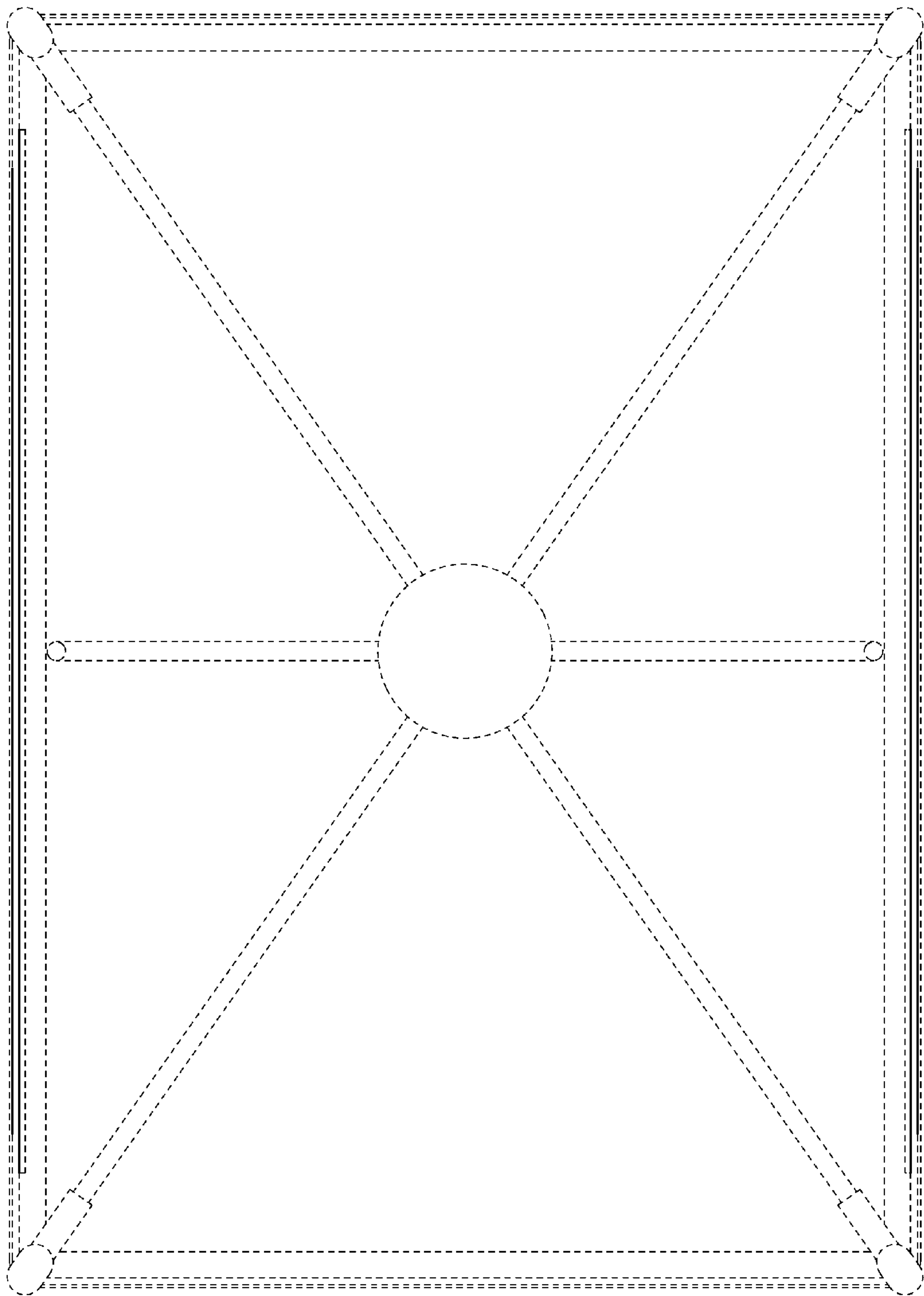

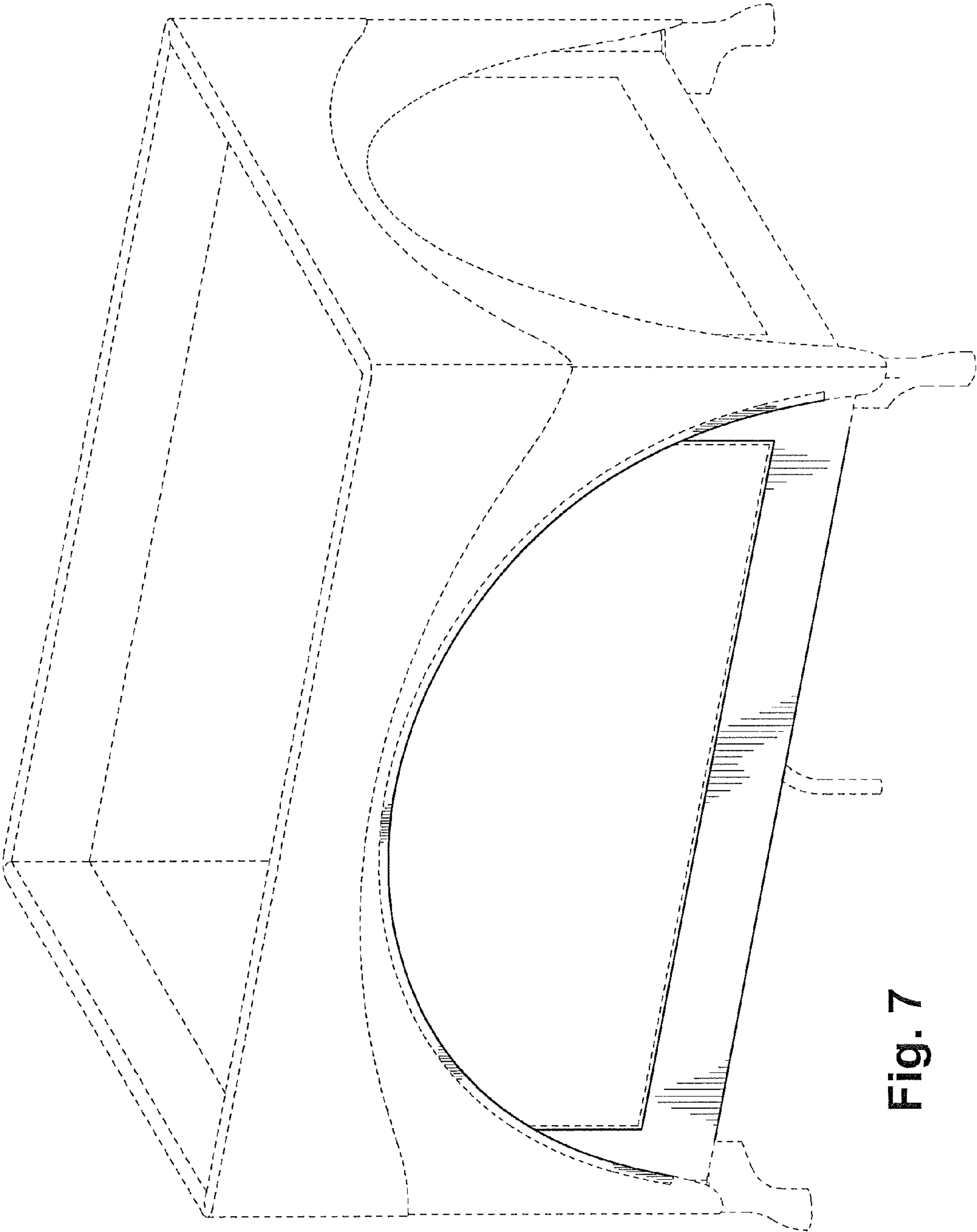

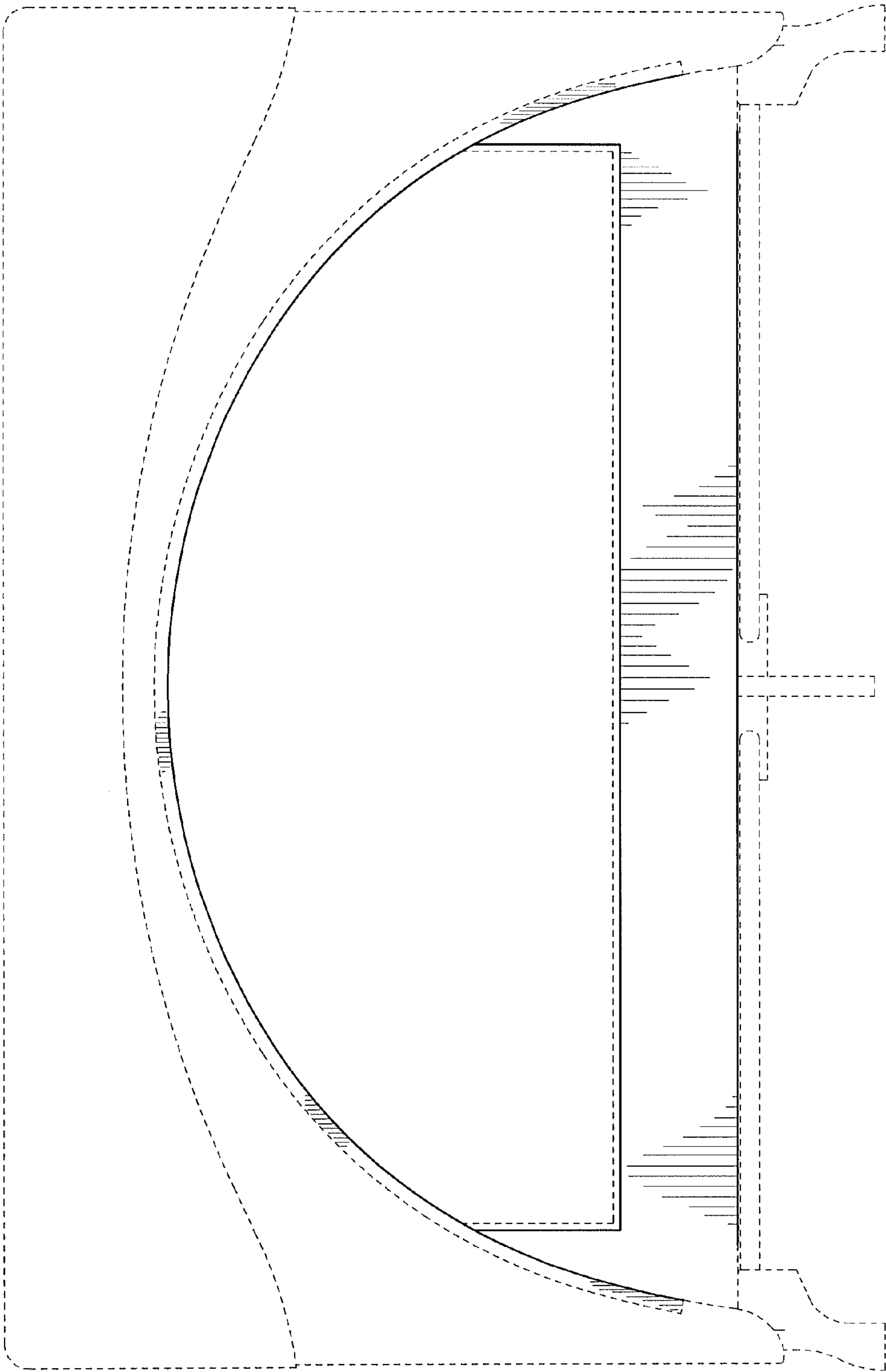

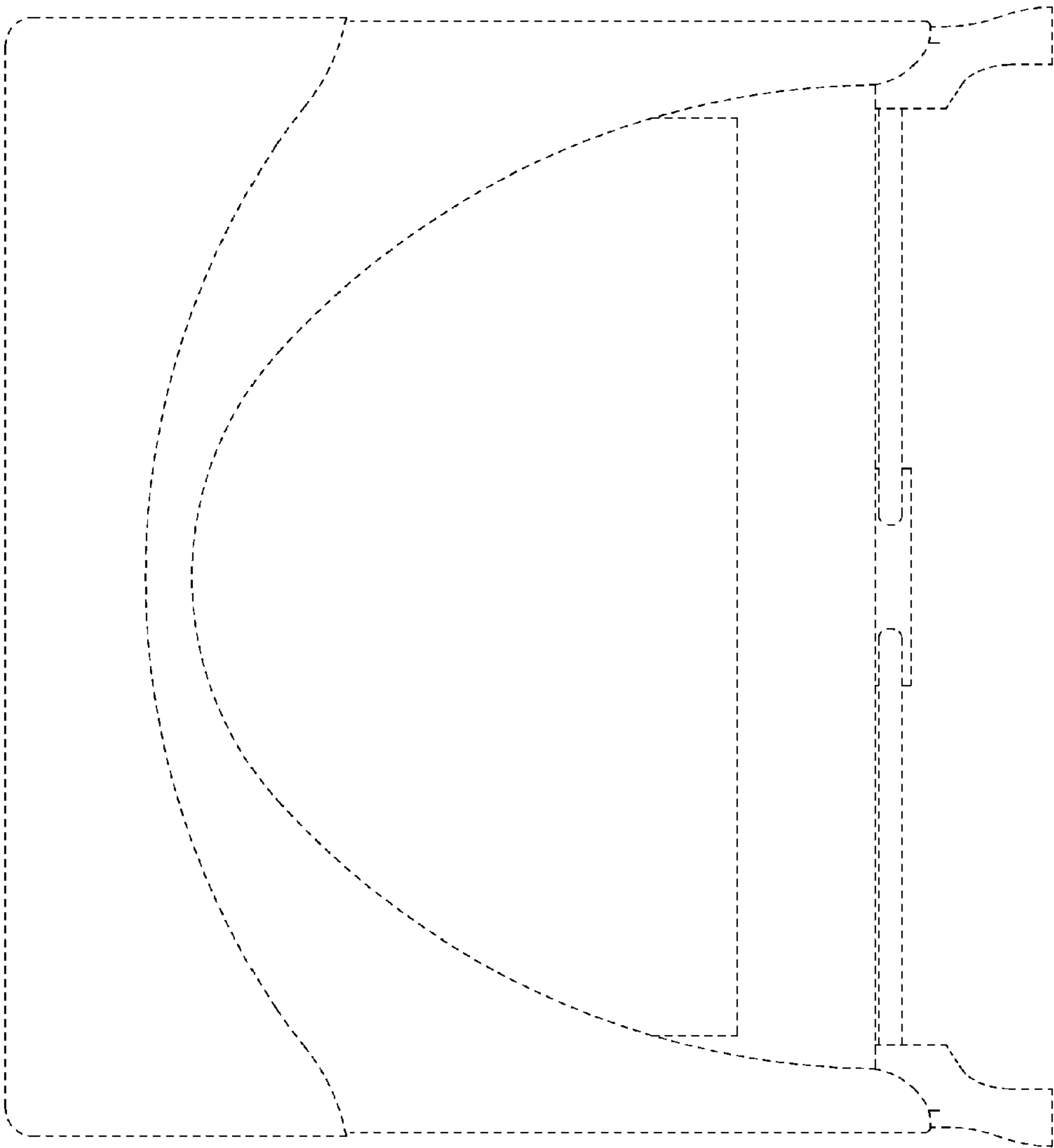

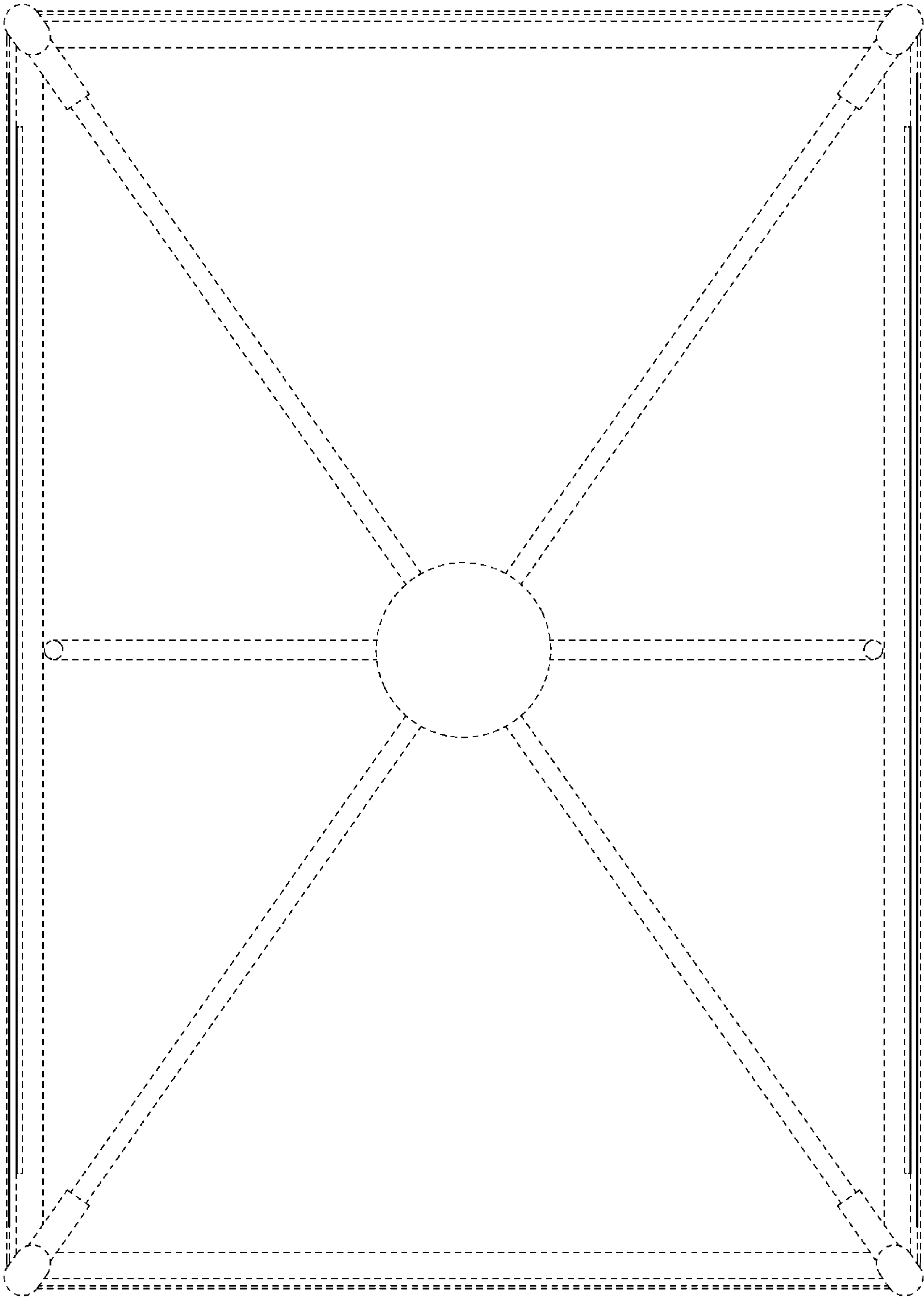
