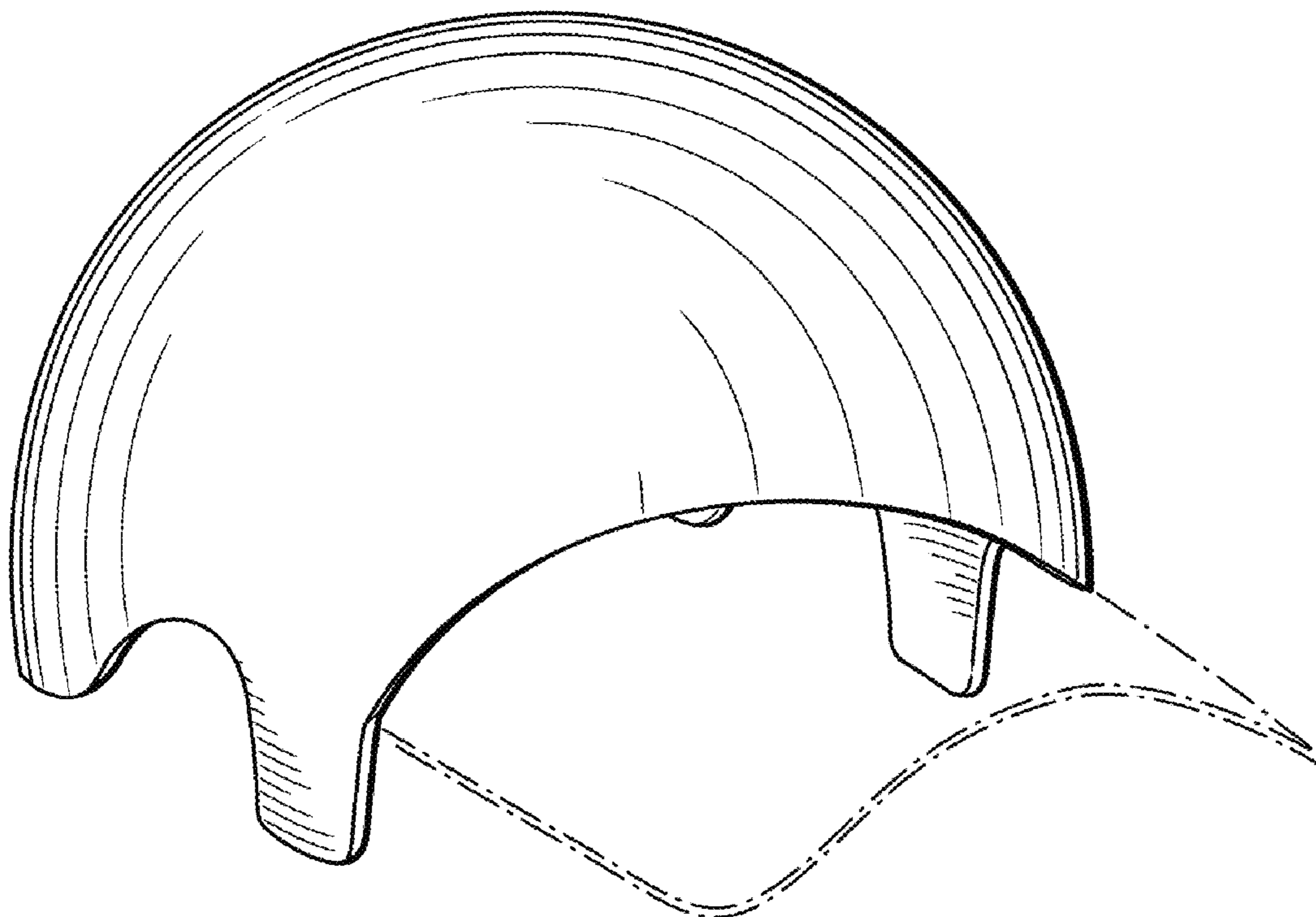
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pitching helmet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pitching helmet in accordance with one embodiment of the present invention. FIG. 2 is a side view of the helmet of FIG. 1. FIG. 3 is a front view of the helmet of FIGS. 1 and 2. FIG. 4 is a rear view of the helmet of FIGS. 1-3. FIG. 5 is a top view of the helmet of FIGS. 1-4. FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the helmet of FIGS. 1-5. FIG. 7 is a perspective view of another embodiment of the pitching helmet. FIG. 8 is a front view of the helmet of FIG. 7. FIG. 9 is a rear view of the helmet of FIG. 7; and, FIG. 10 is a top view of the helmet of FIG. 7. Any elements shown in broken lines form no part of the claimed invention, and are instead included to show environmental aspects of the claimed invention.

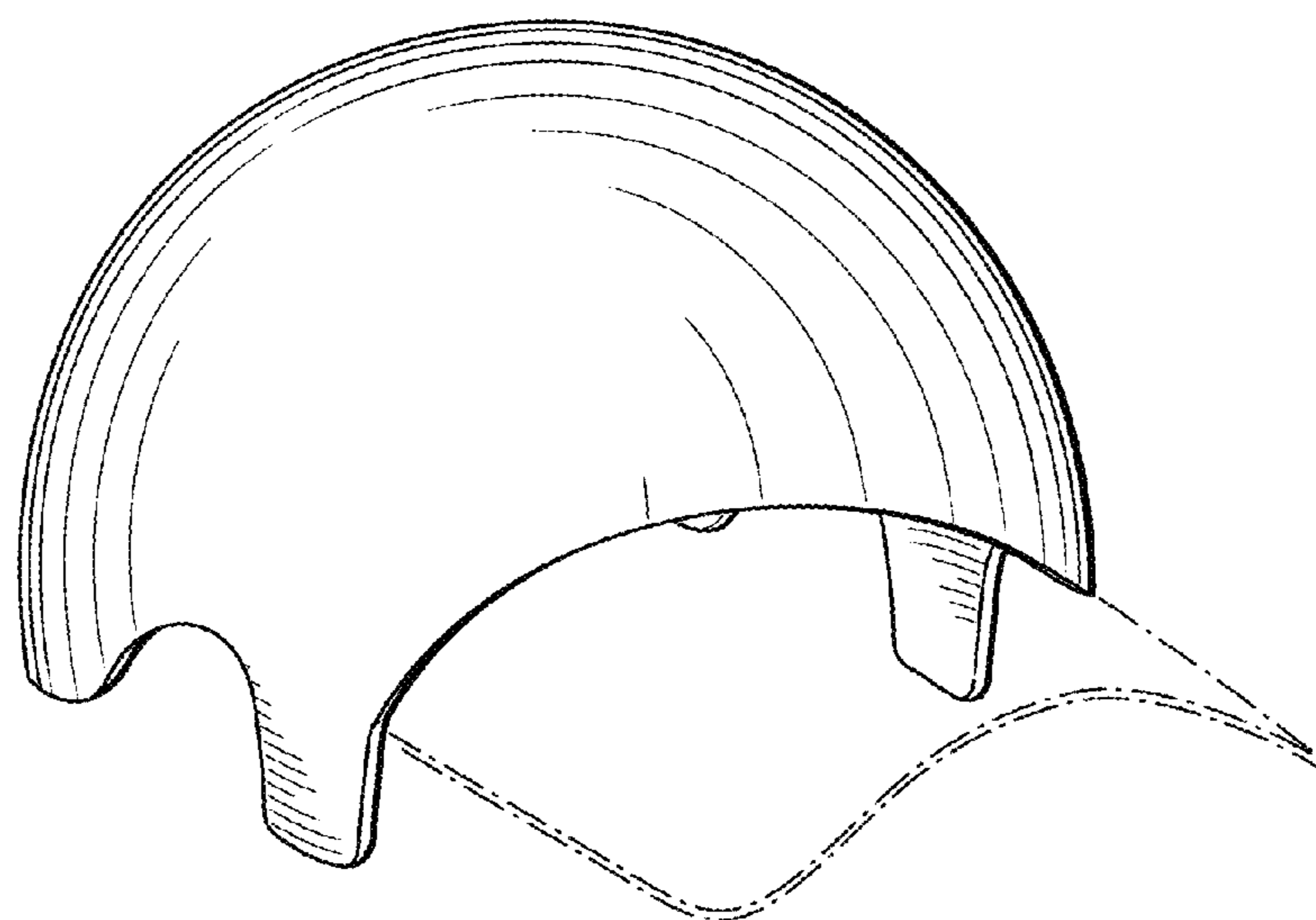

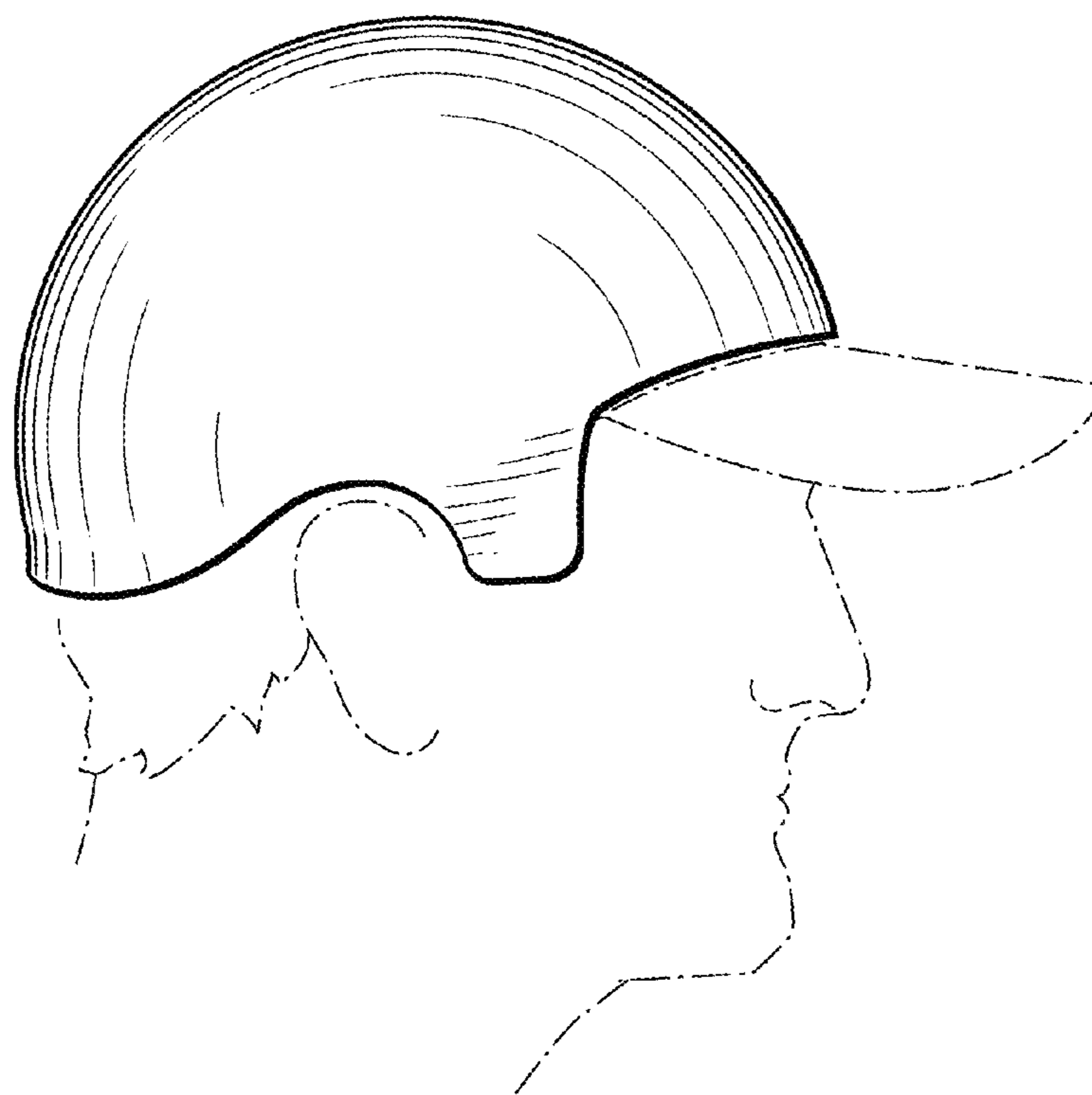

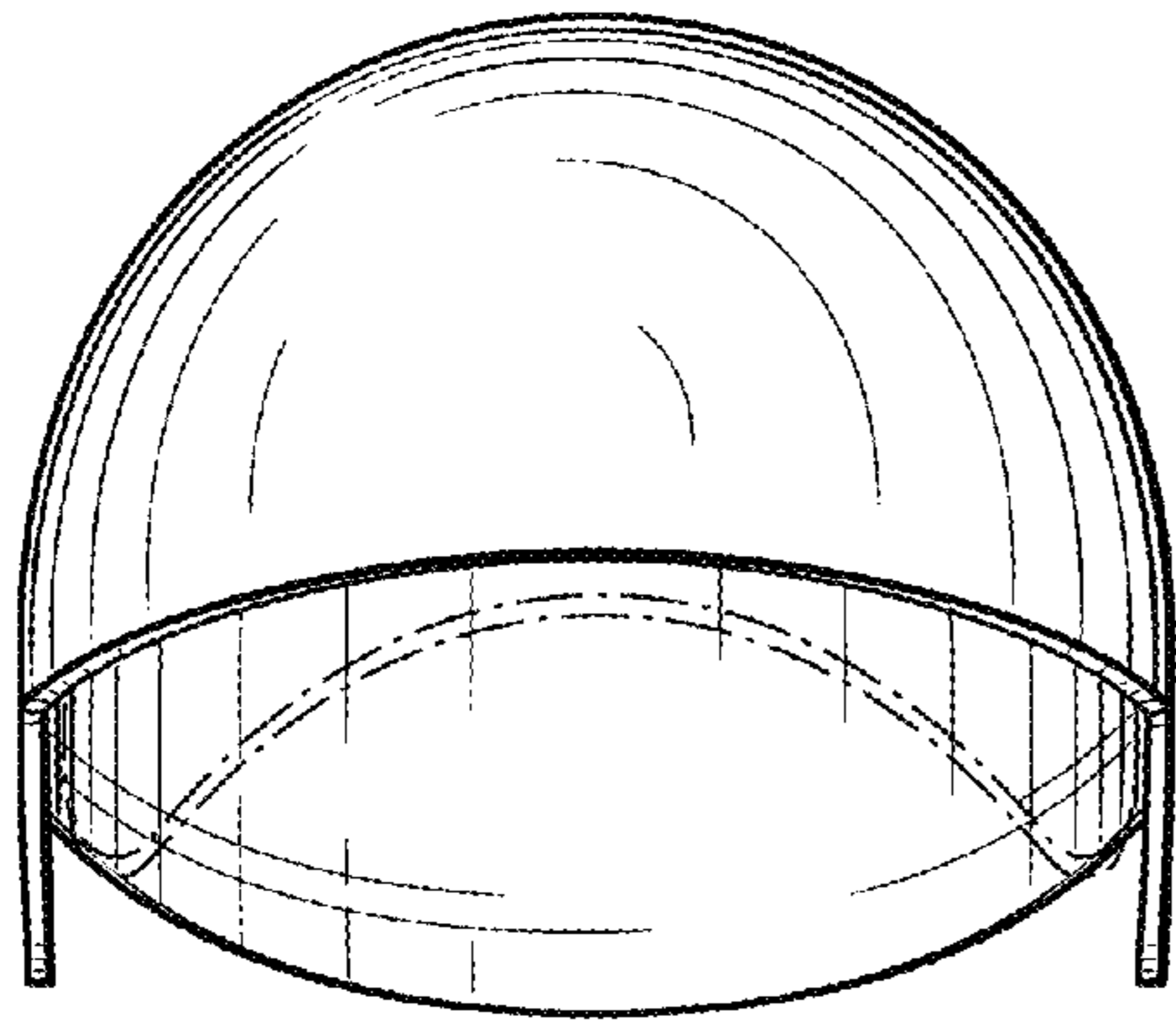

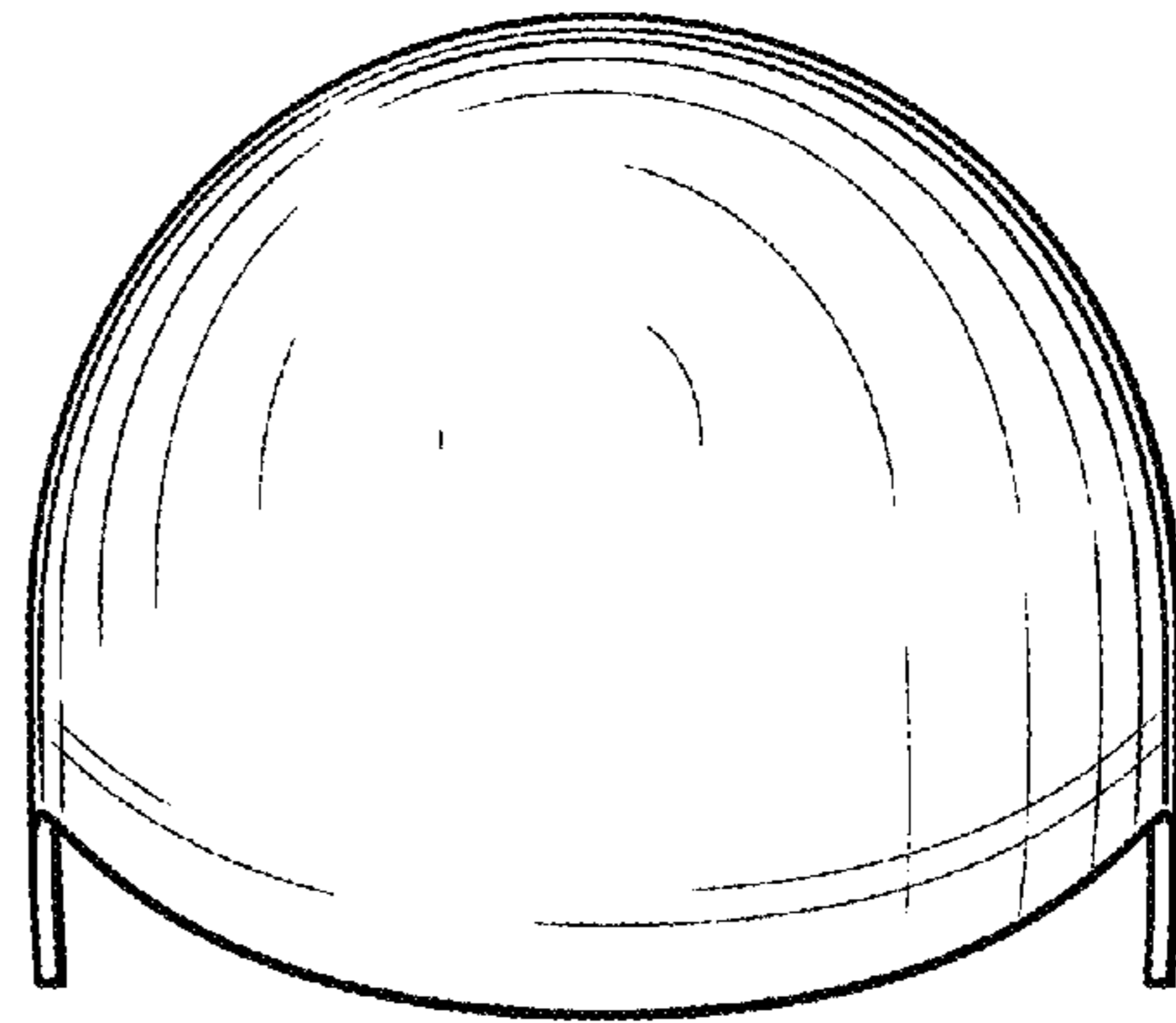

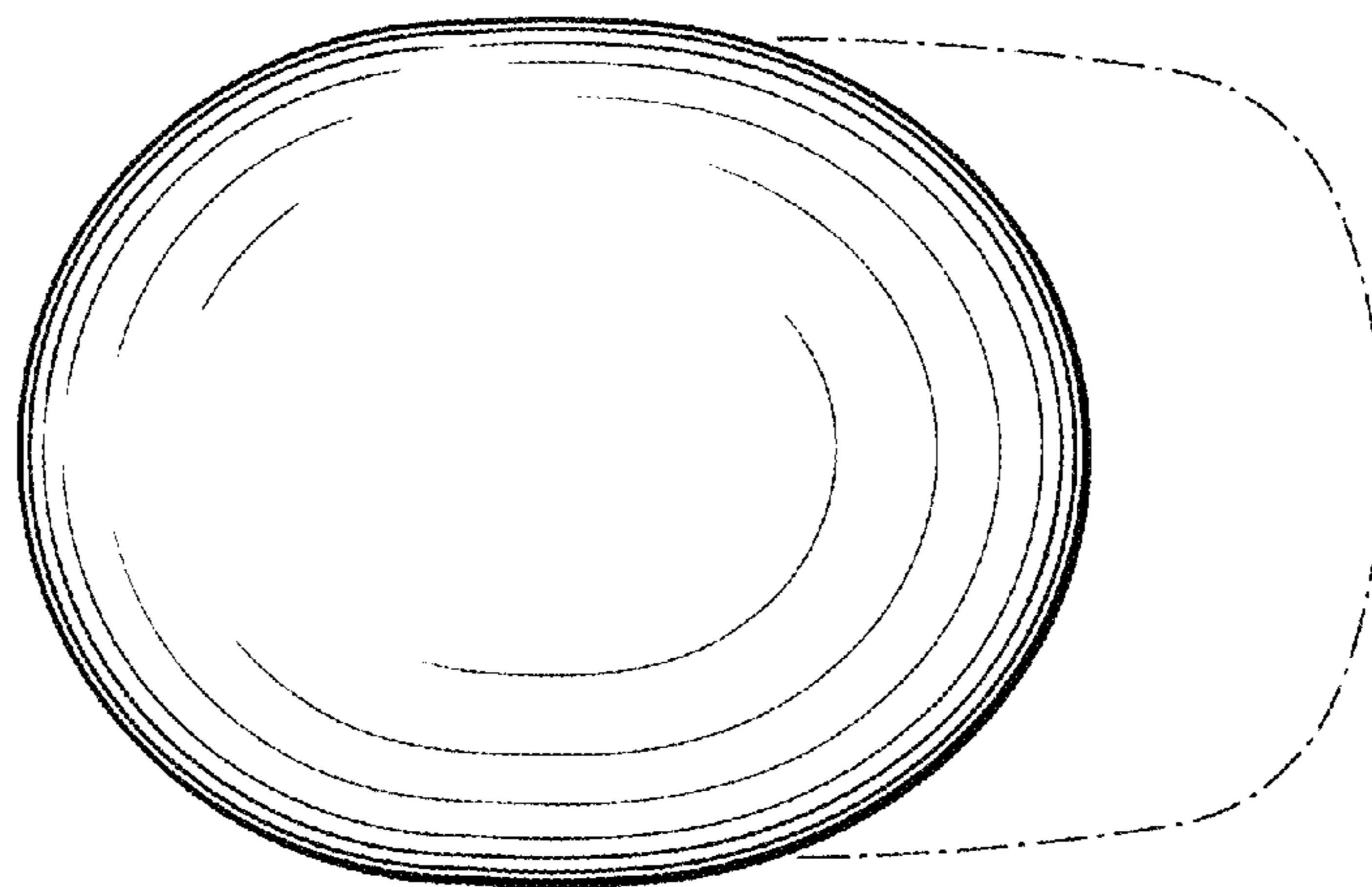

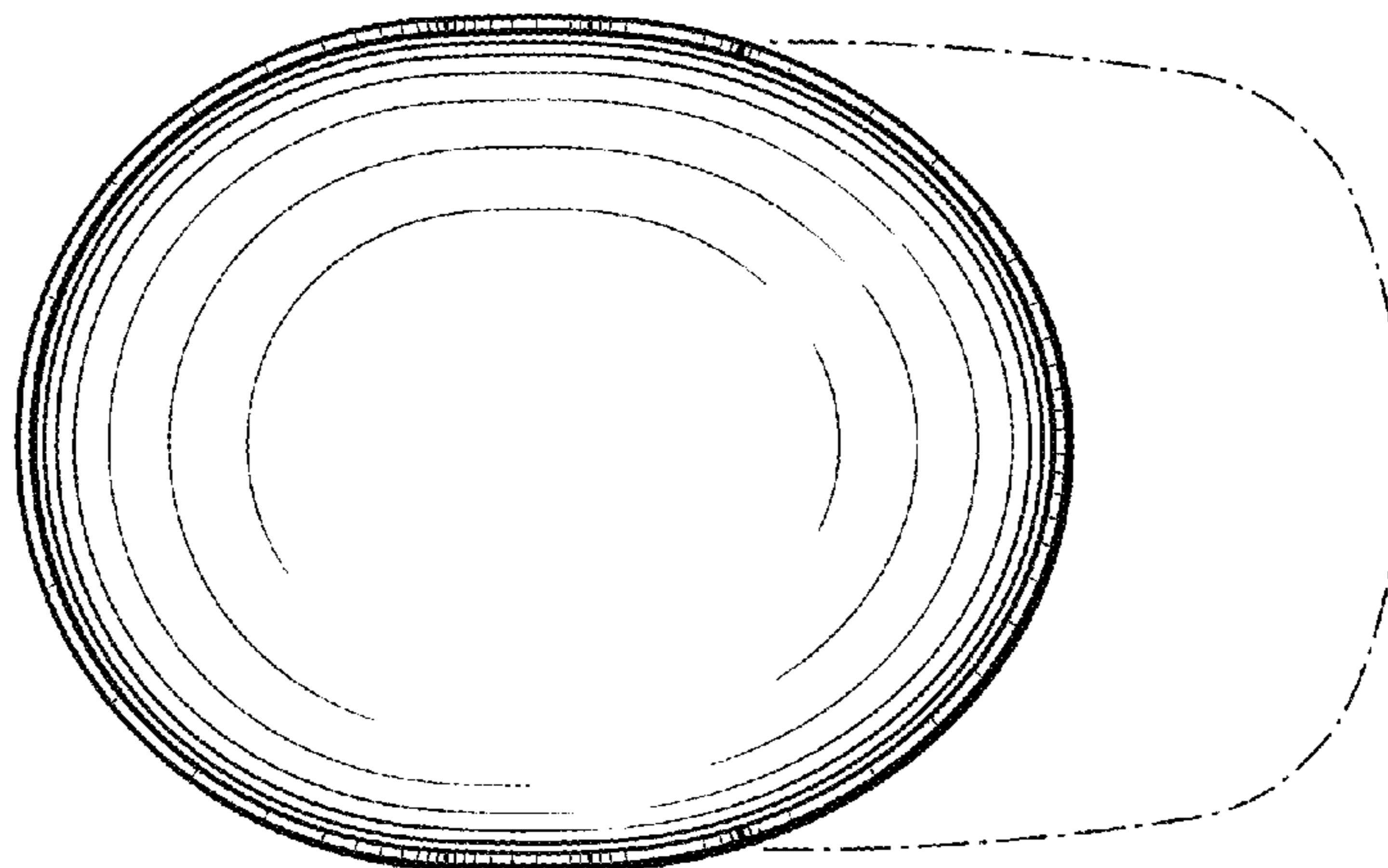

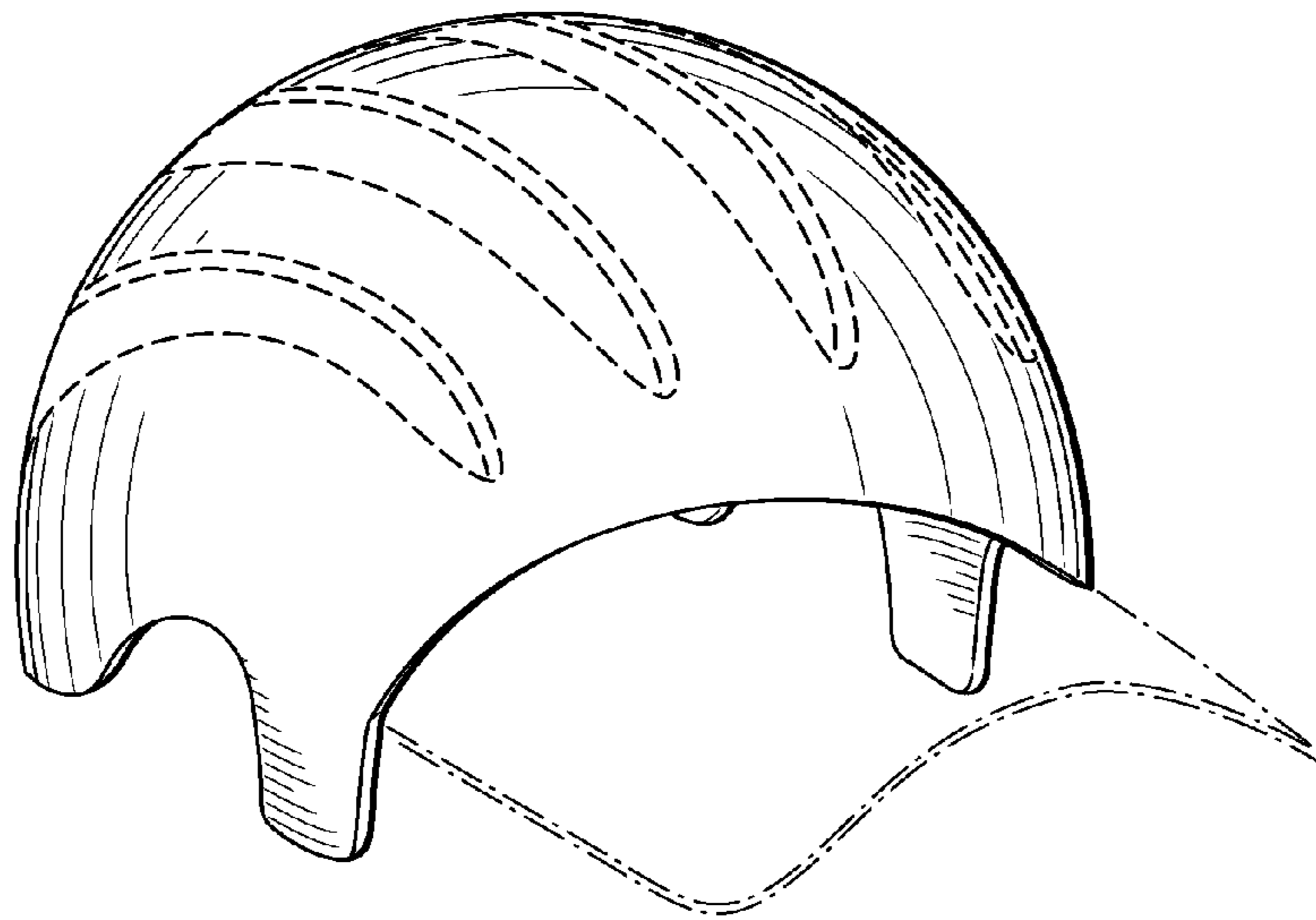

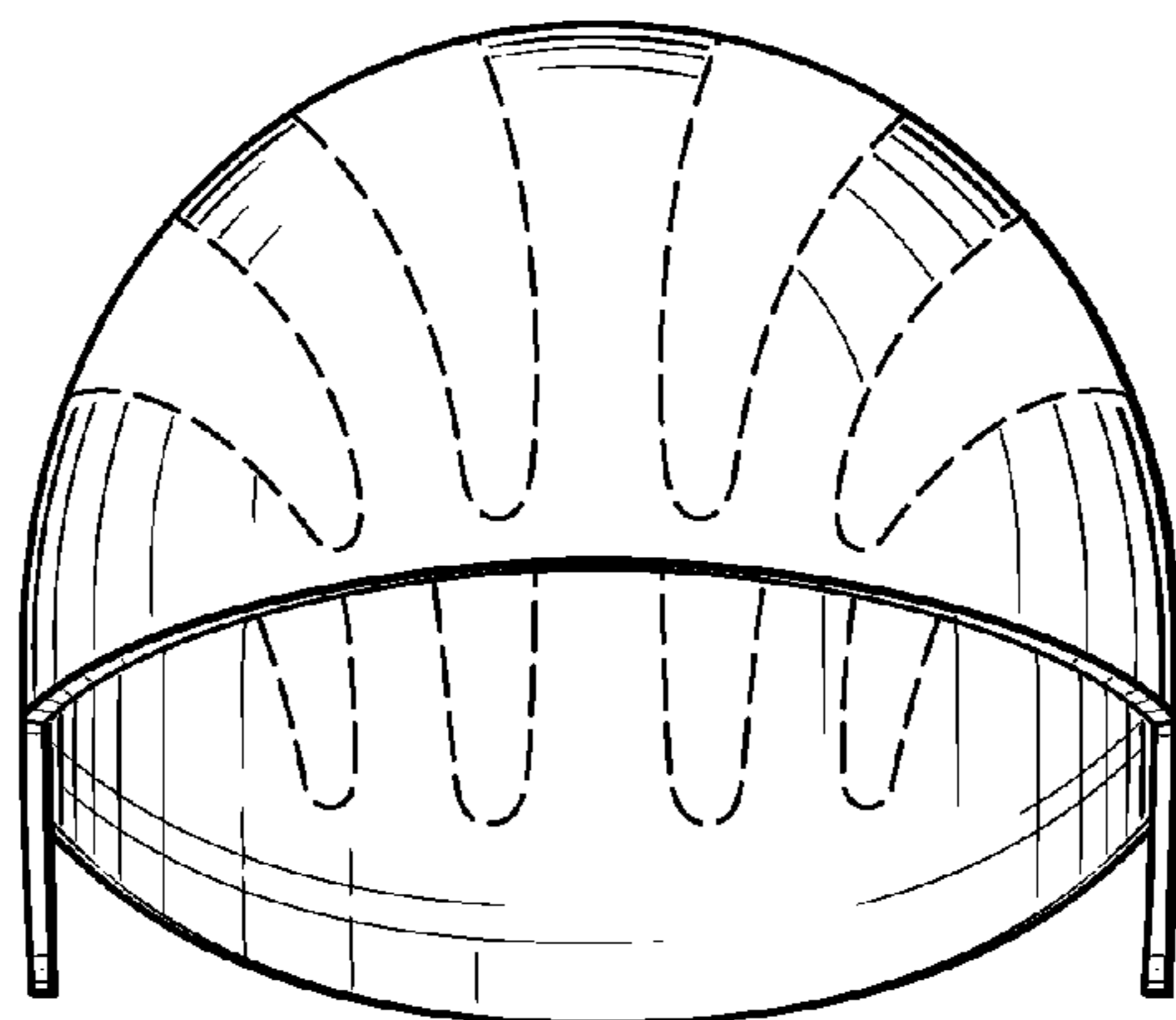

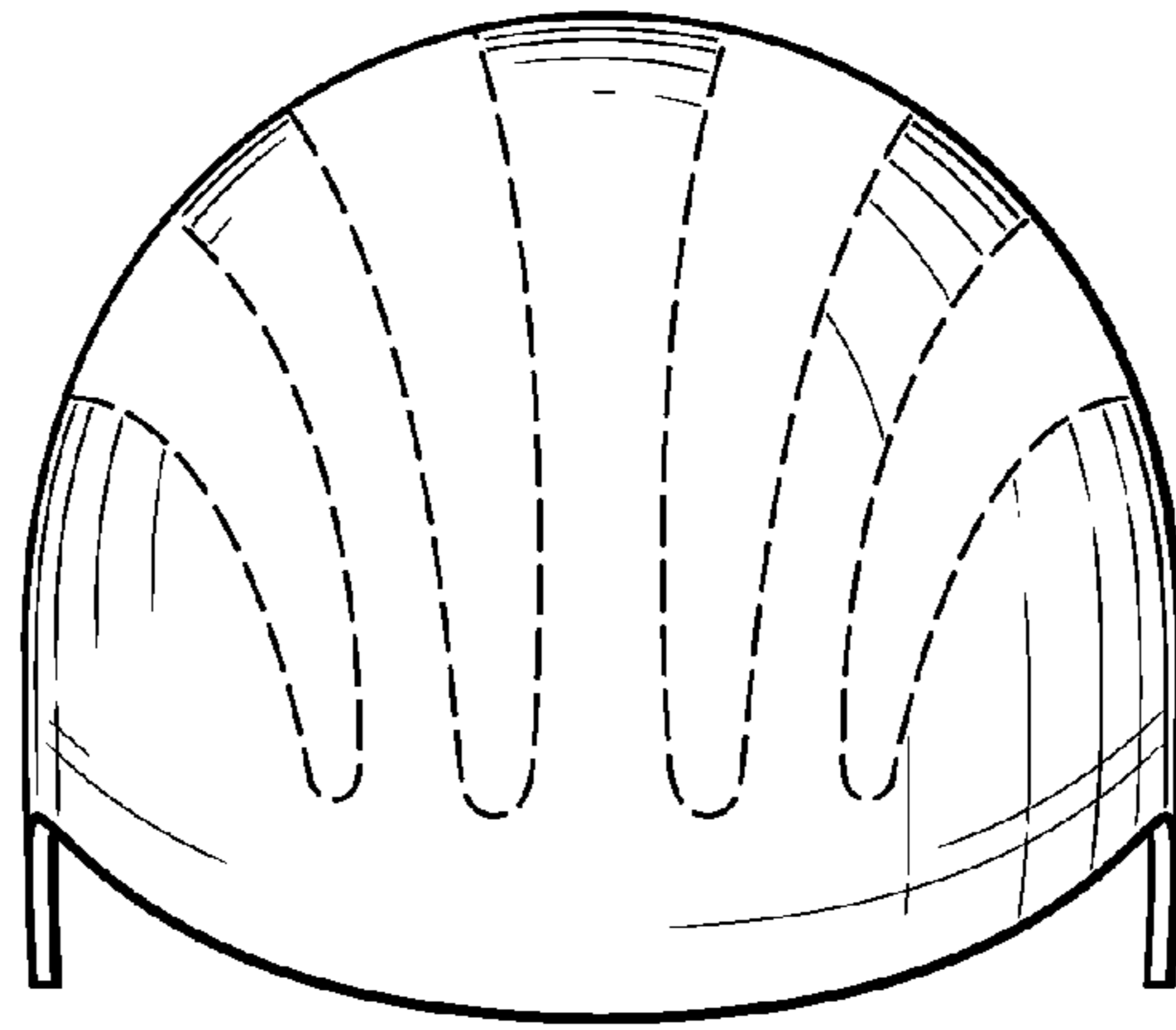

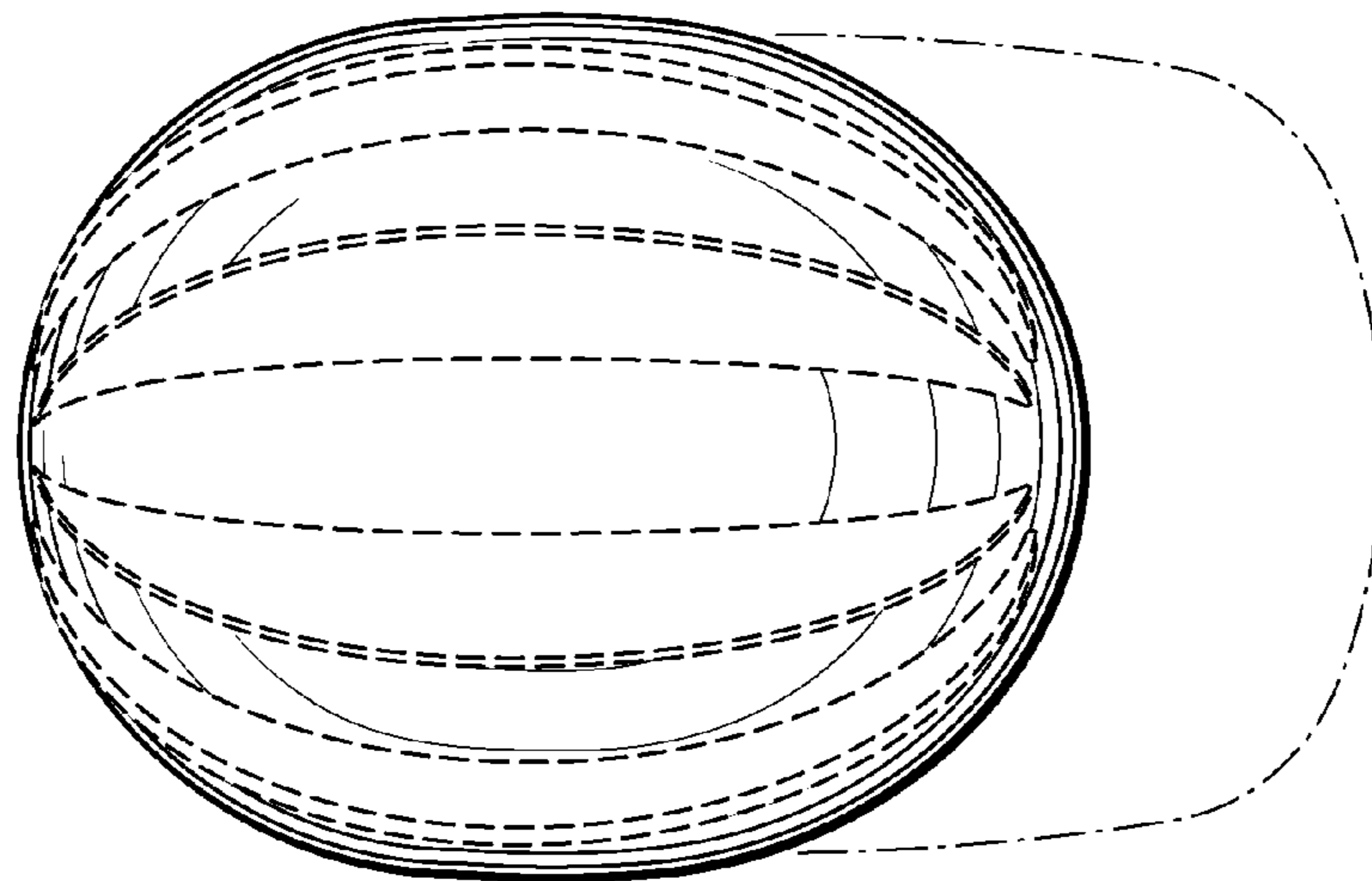
