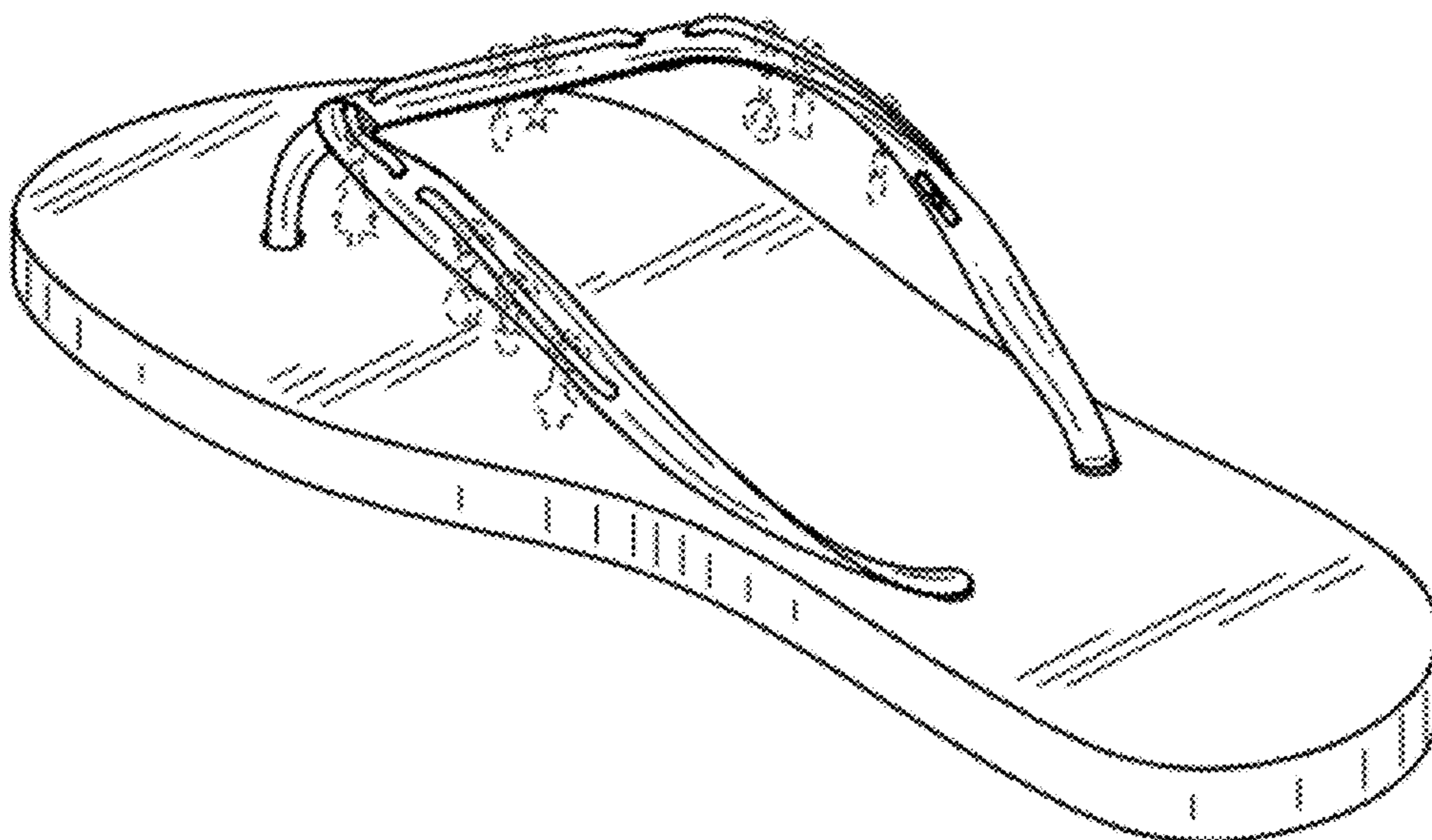
(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a sandal with a charm attachment, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sandal with a charm attachment, showing our new design with two charm cords each in a fastened position;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, illustrated with the charm cords each in an unfastened position.
The broken lines showing charms in FIG. 1 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.

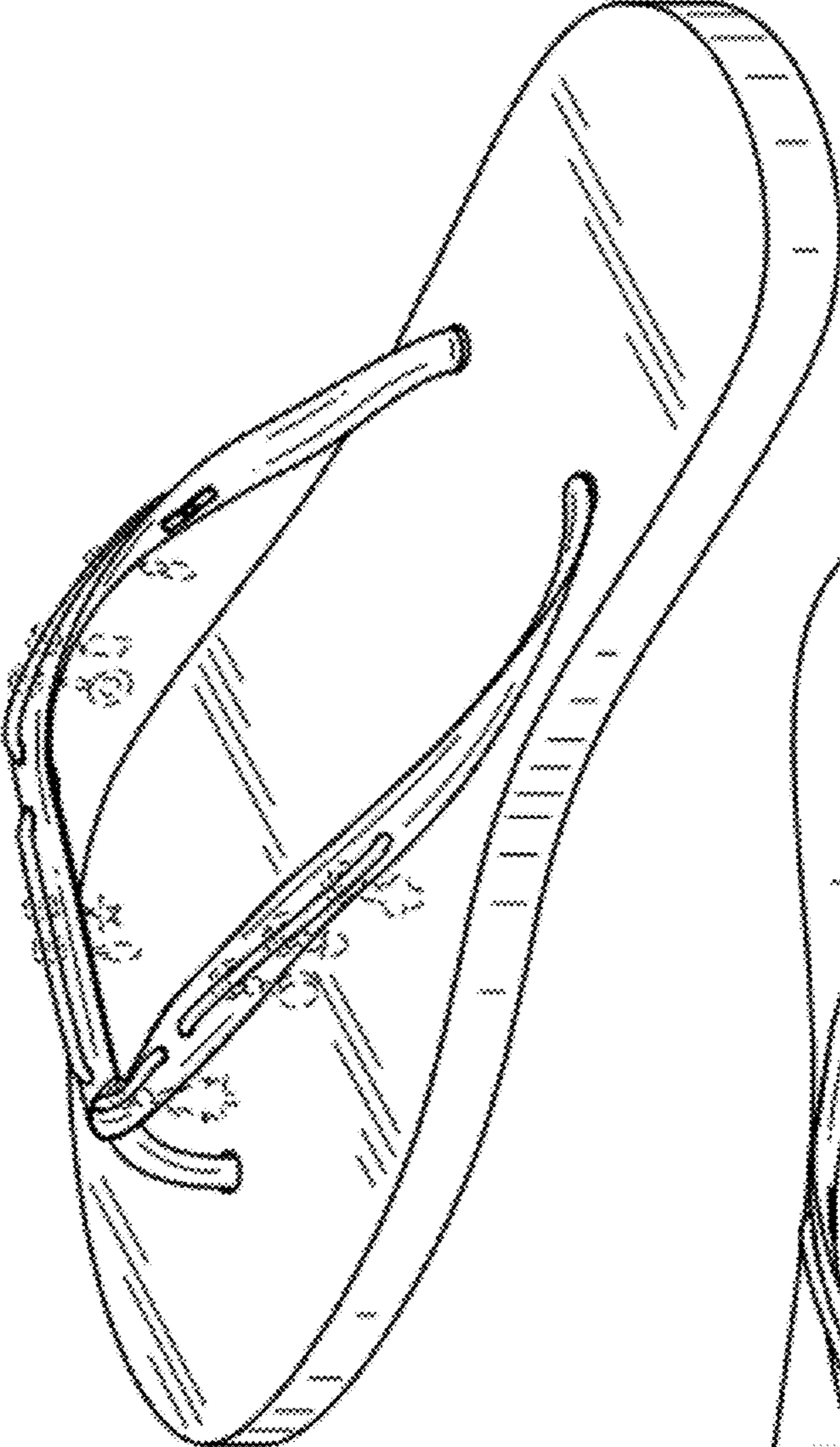

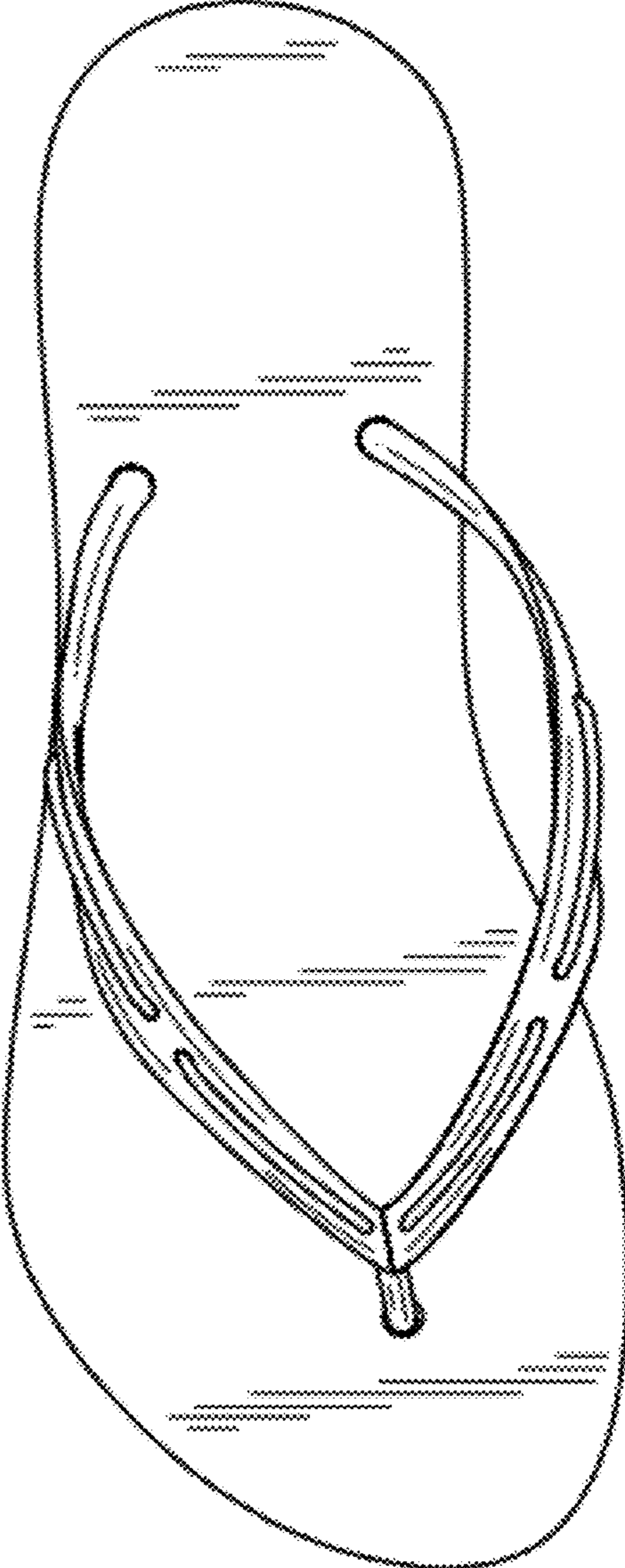

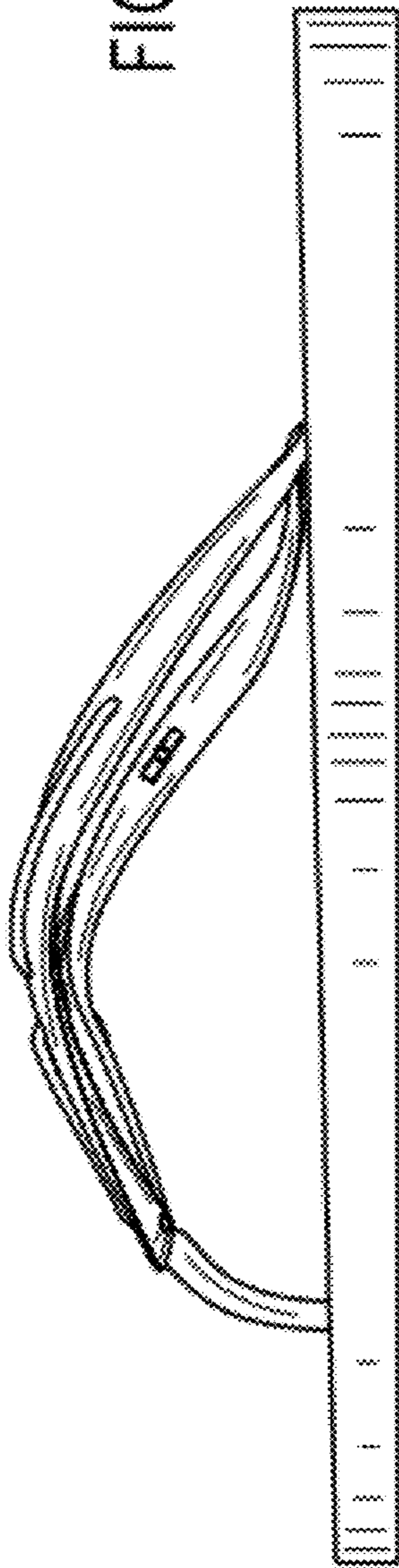

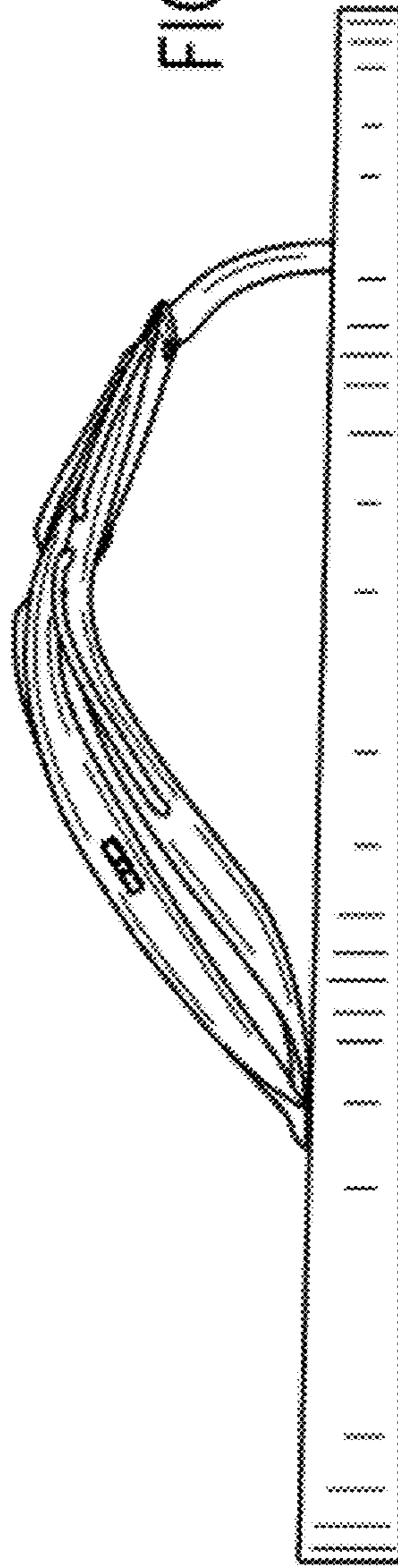

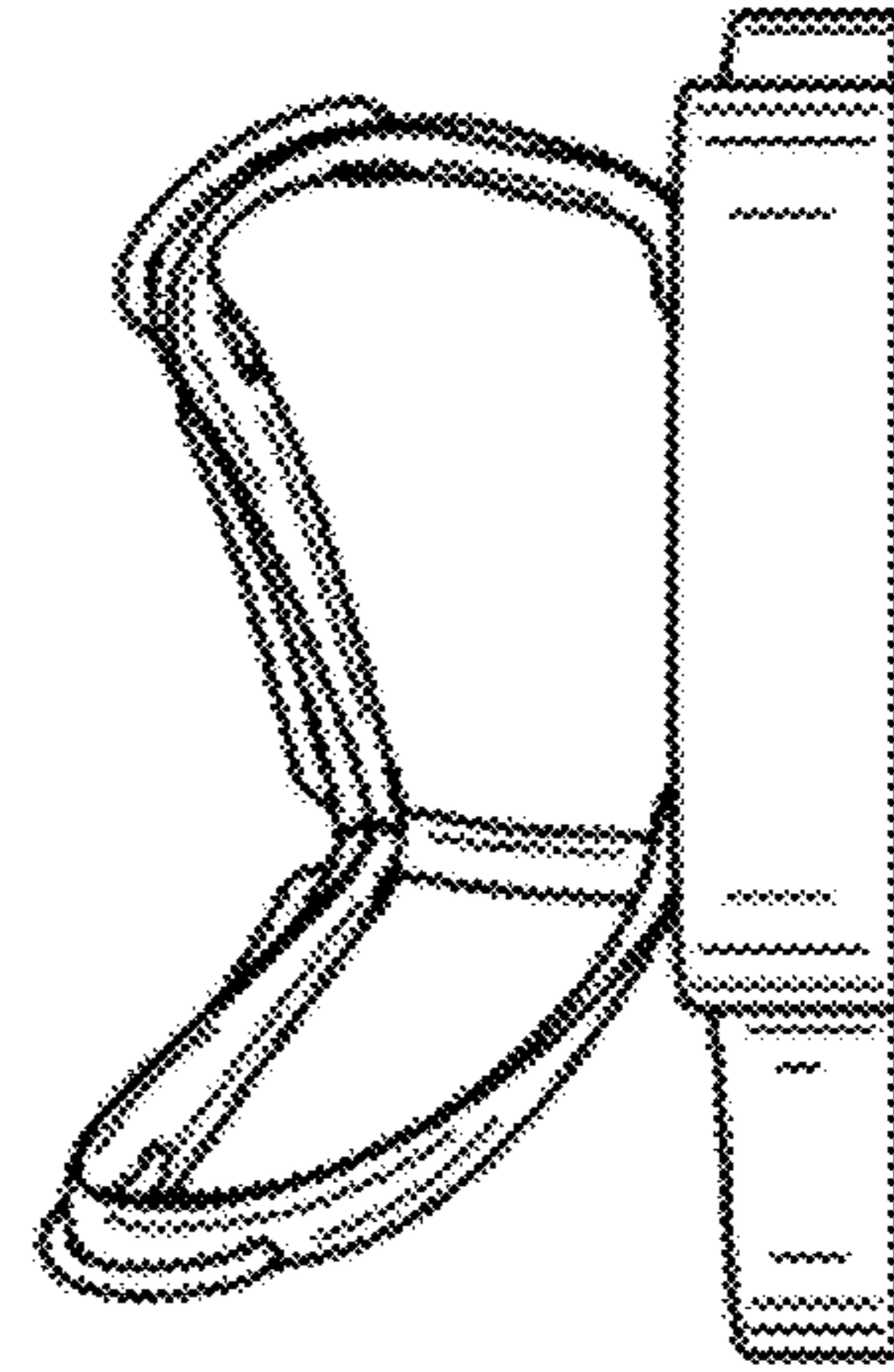
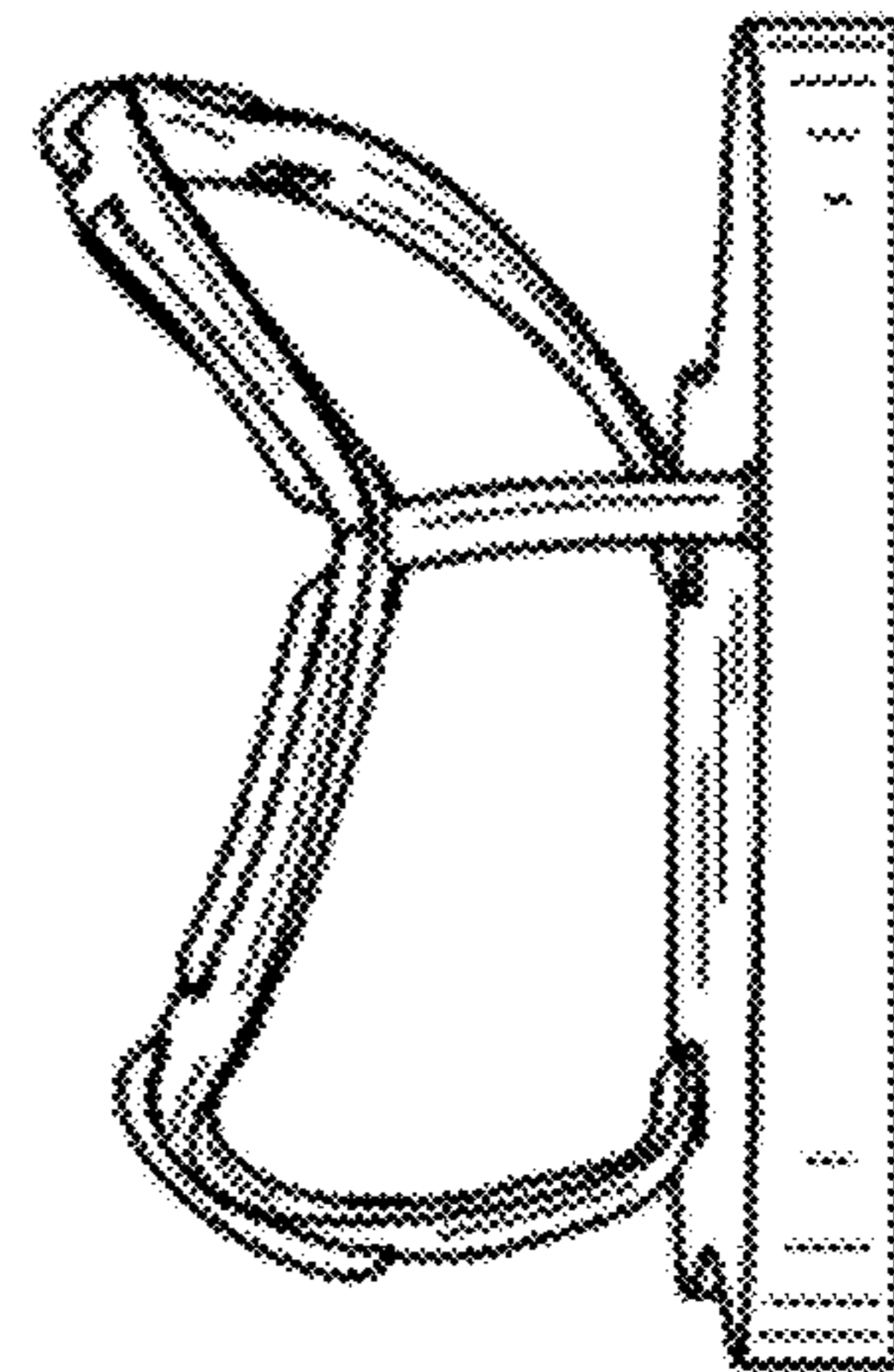

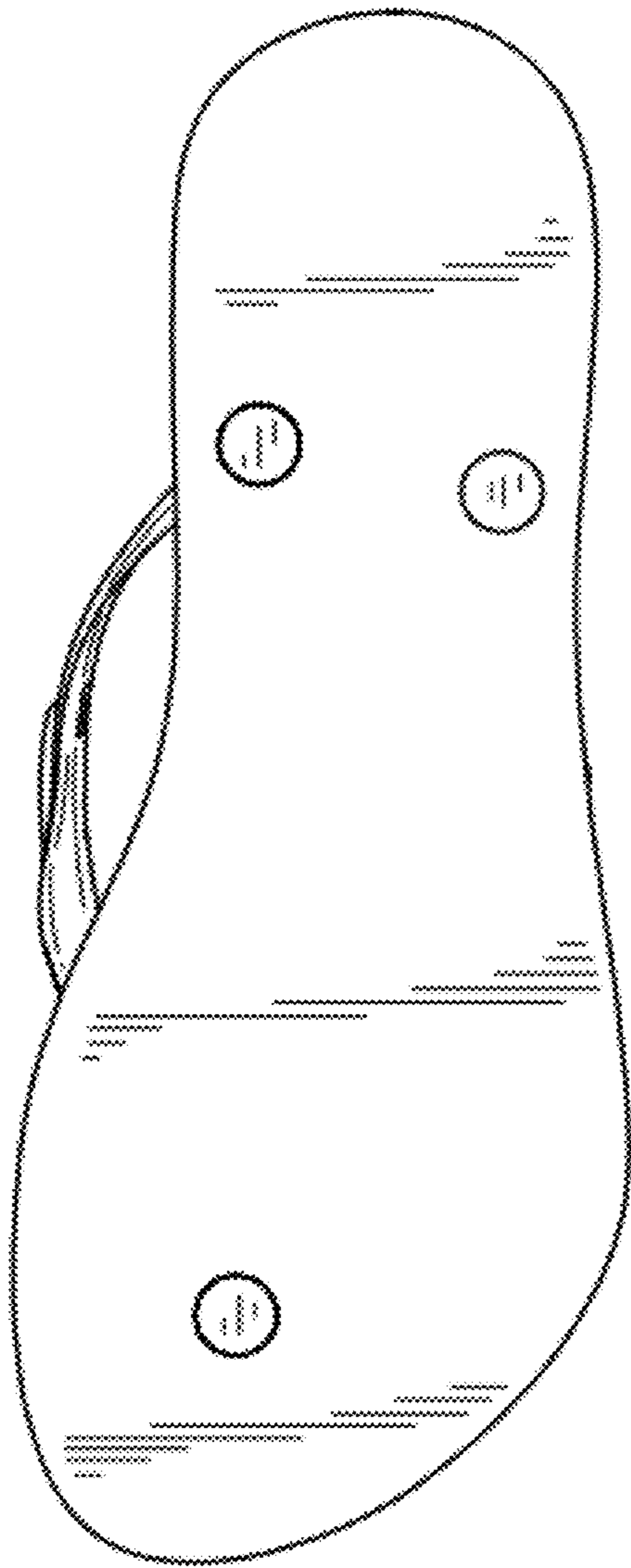

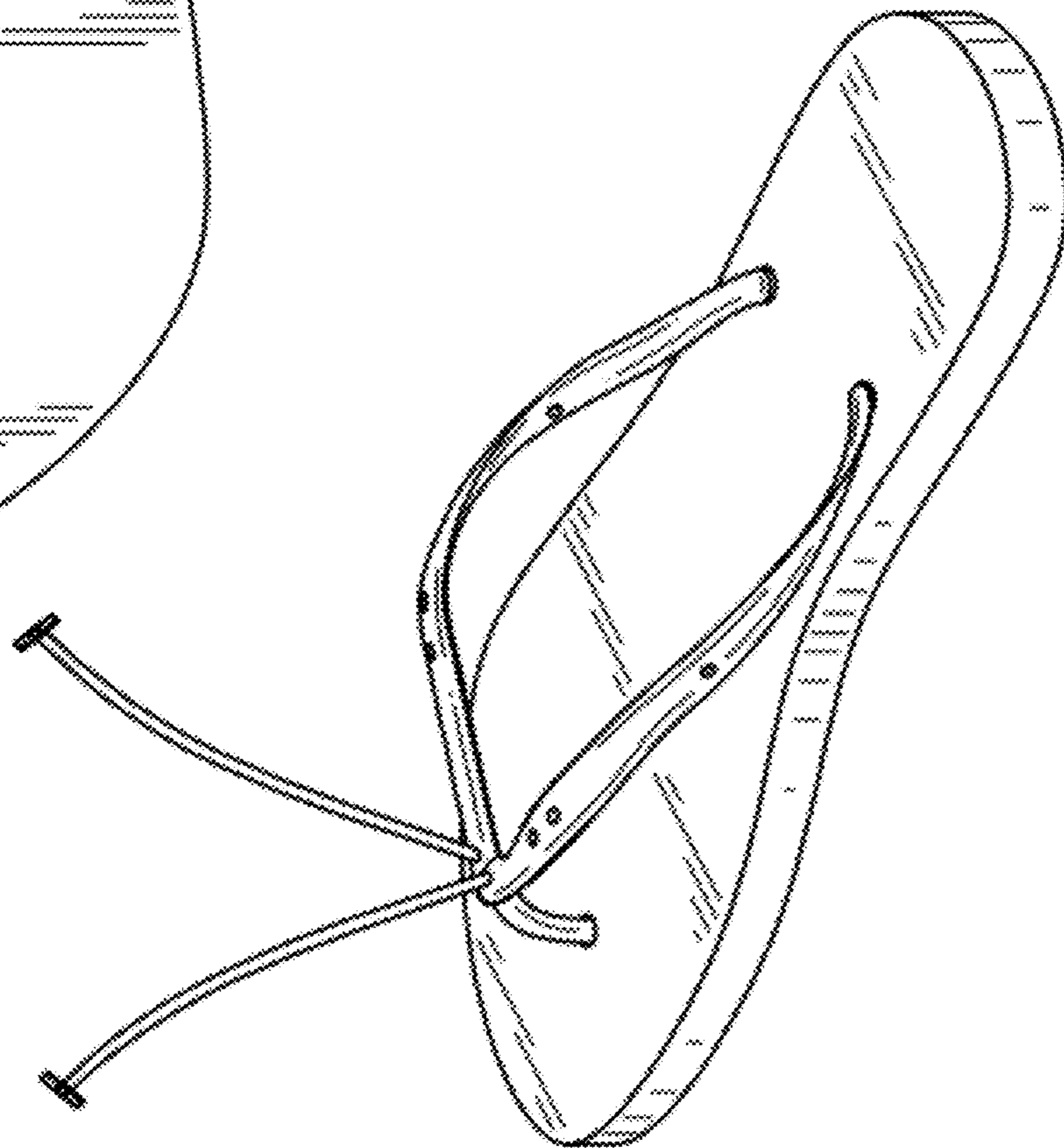
