(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a refrigerator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a refrigerator according to a first embodiment showing our ornamental design for a light array in a wall thereof; and,

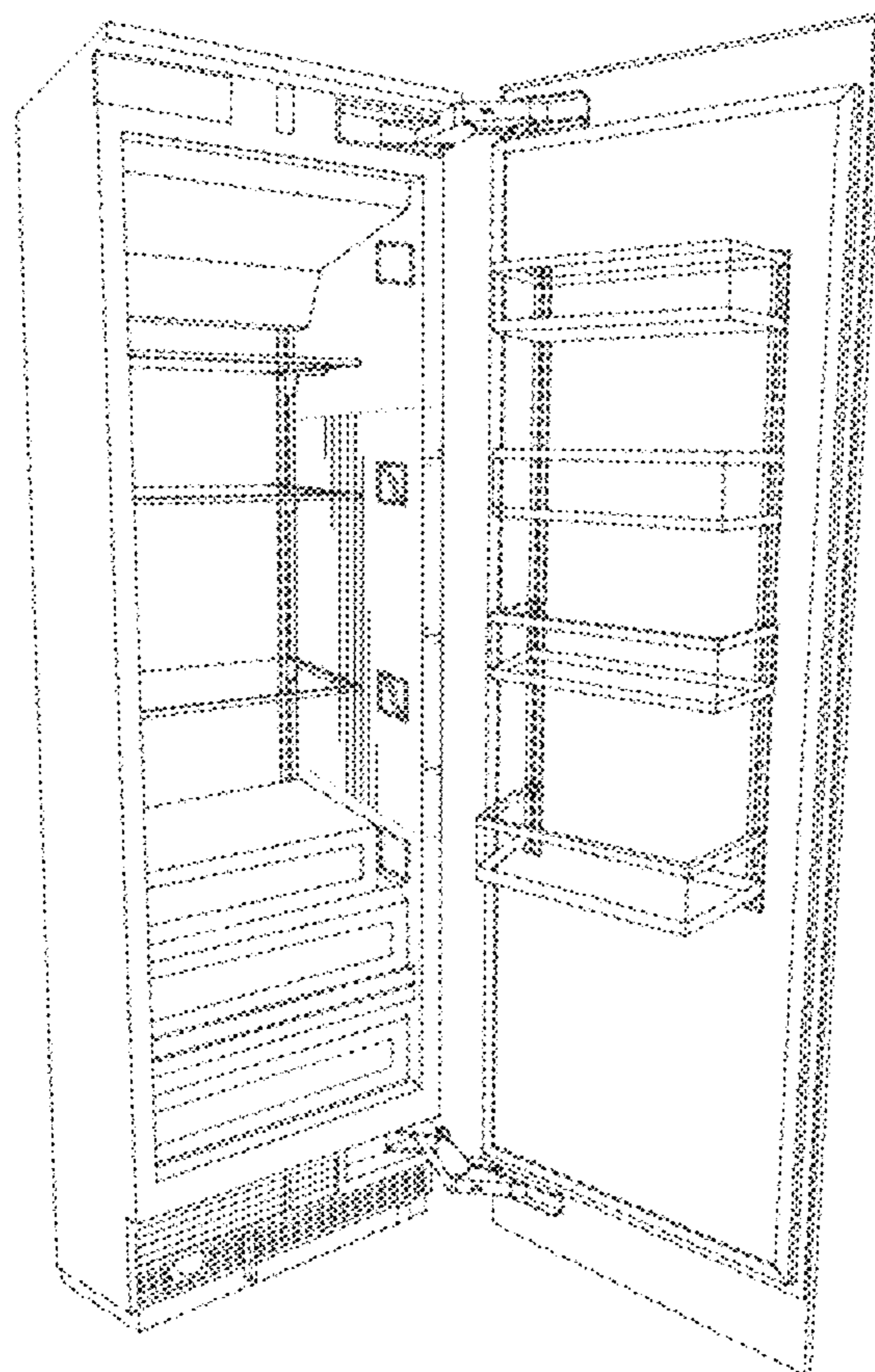
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a freezer-type refrigerator according to a second embodiment showing our ornamental design for a light array in a wall thereof.

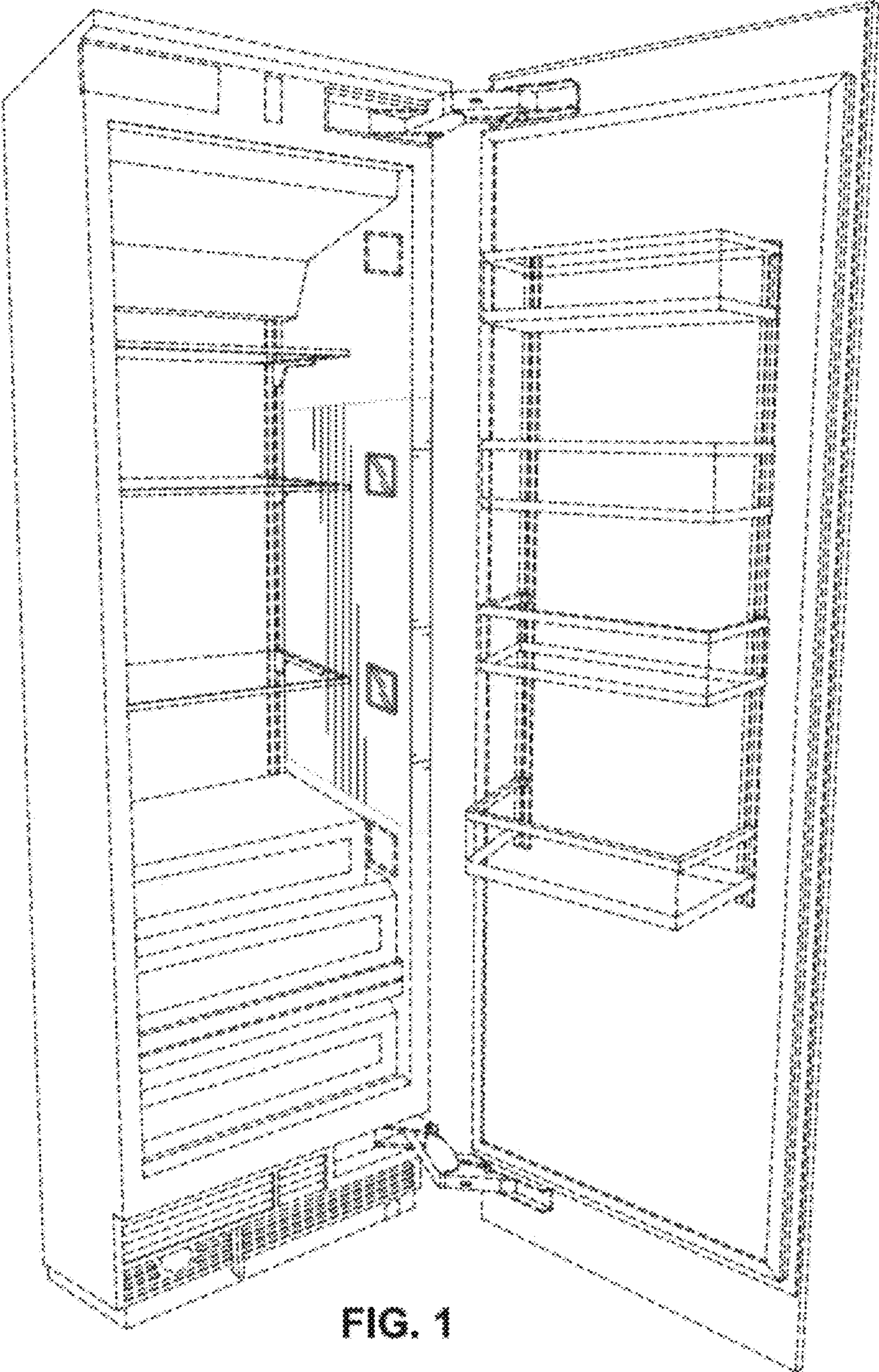

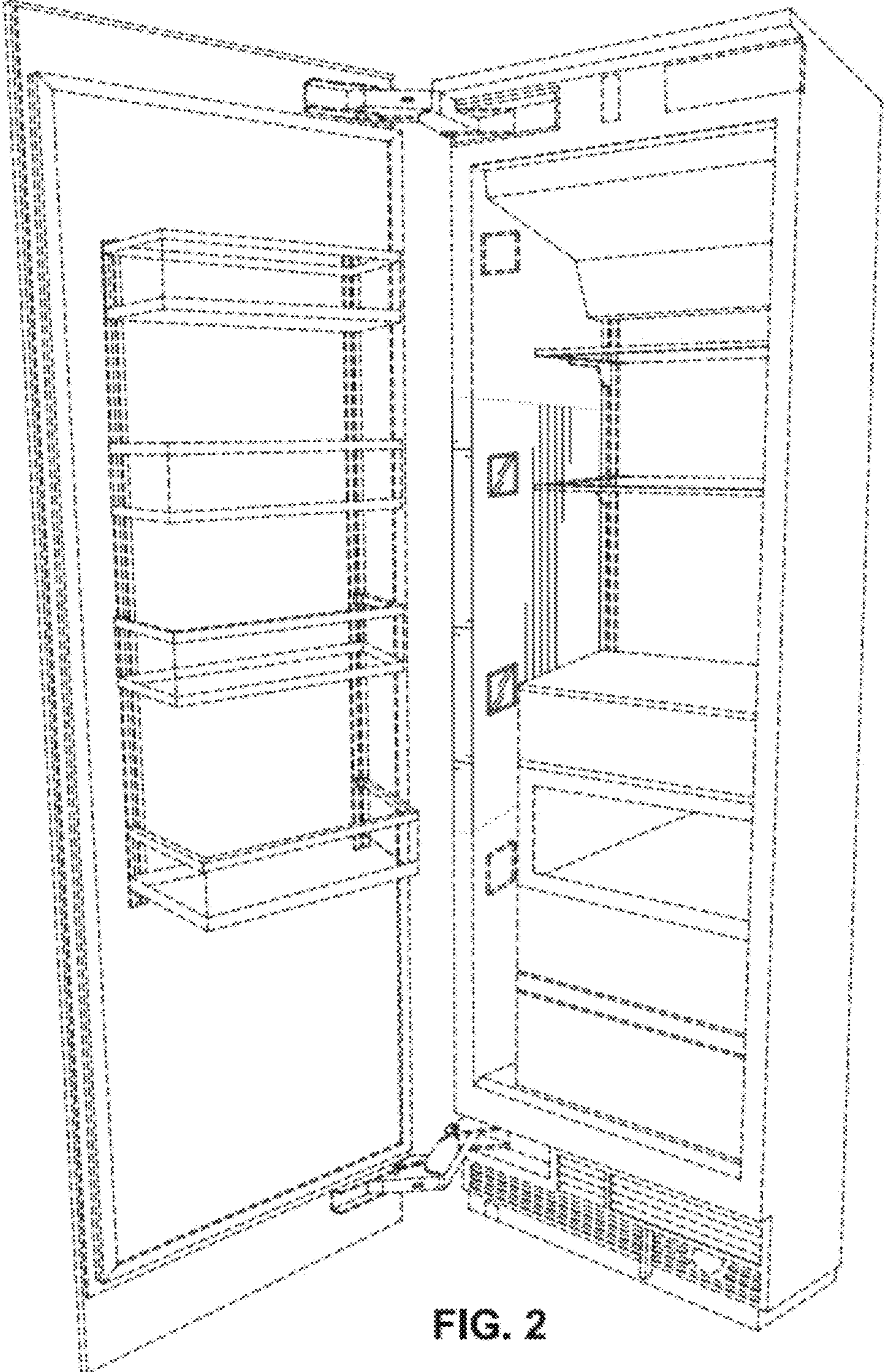
