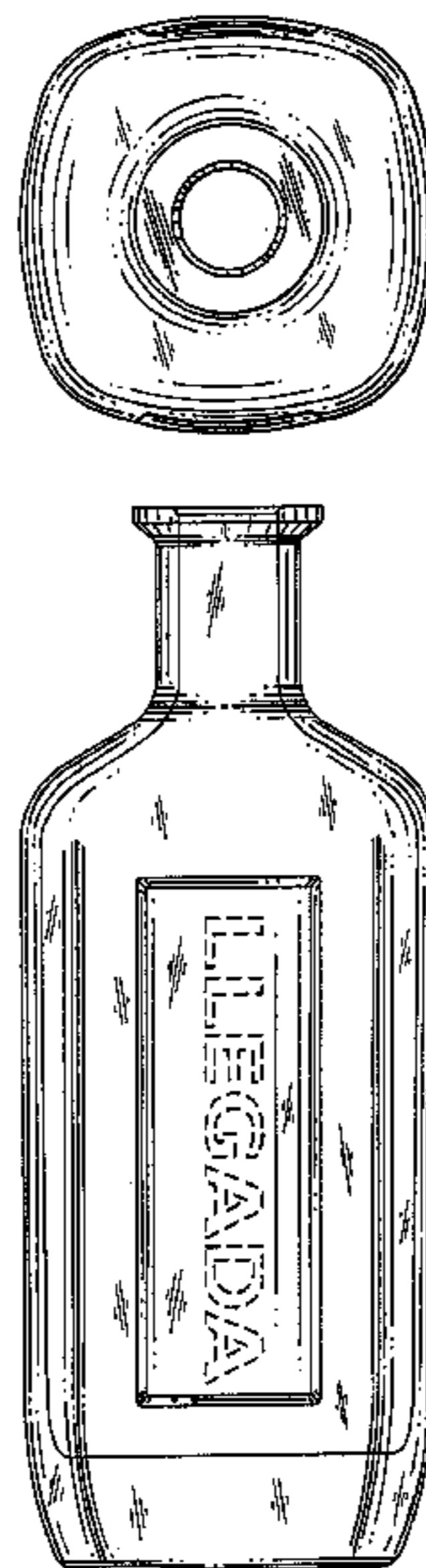

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bottle showing our design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side
elevational view being a mirror image except for the
unclaimed text on the front and rear sidewalls;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

trating environmental structure and form no part of the
design.

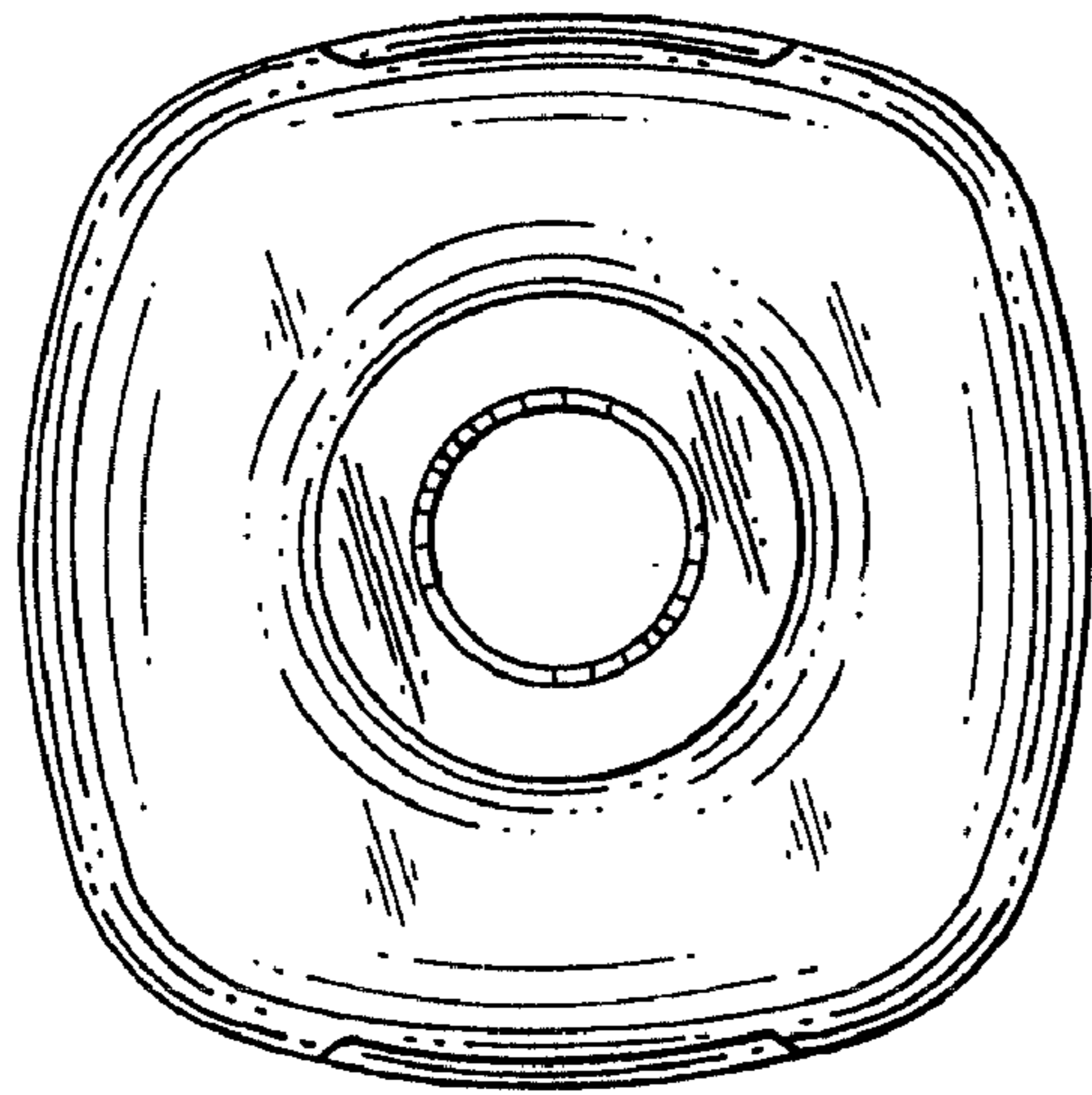

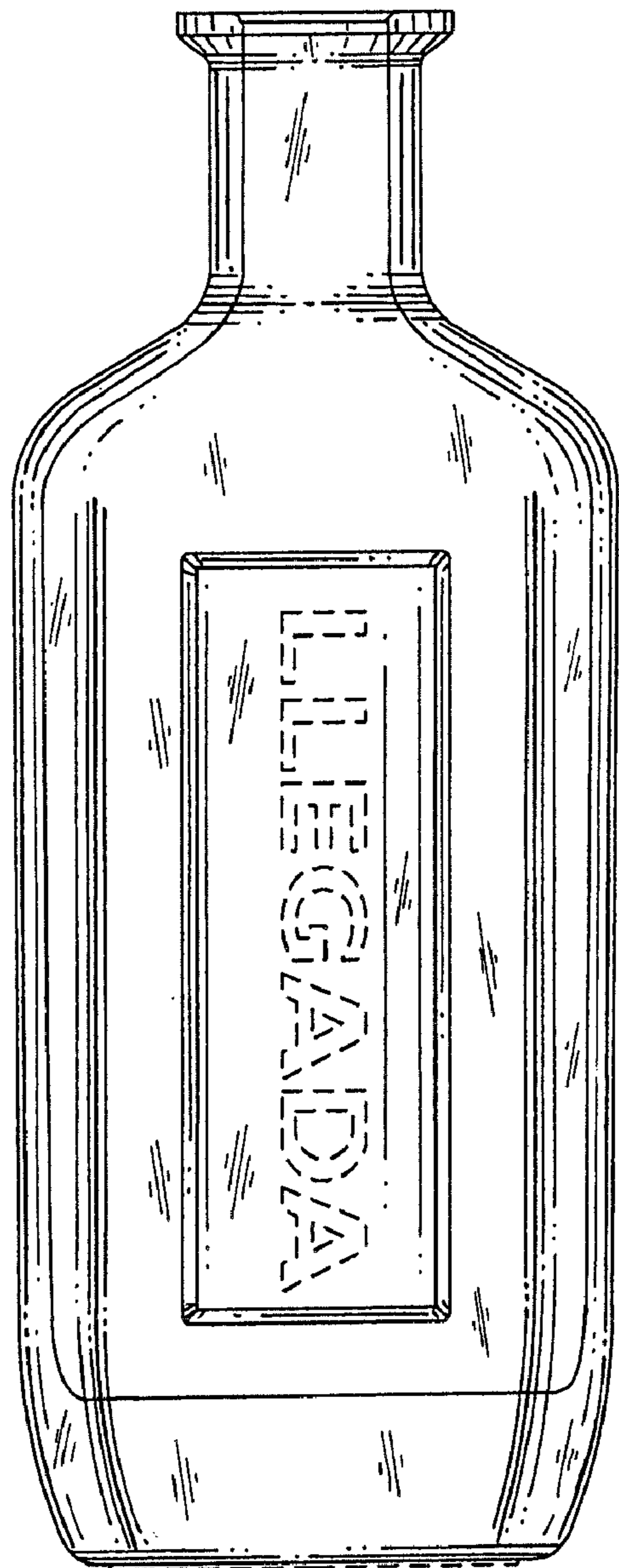

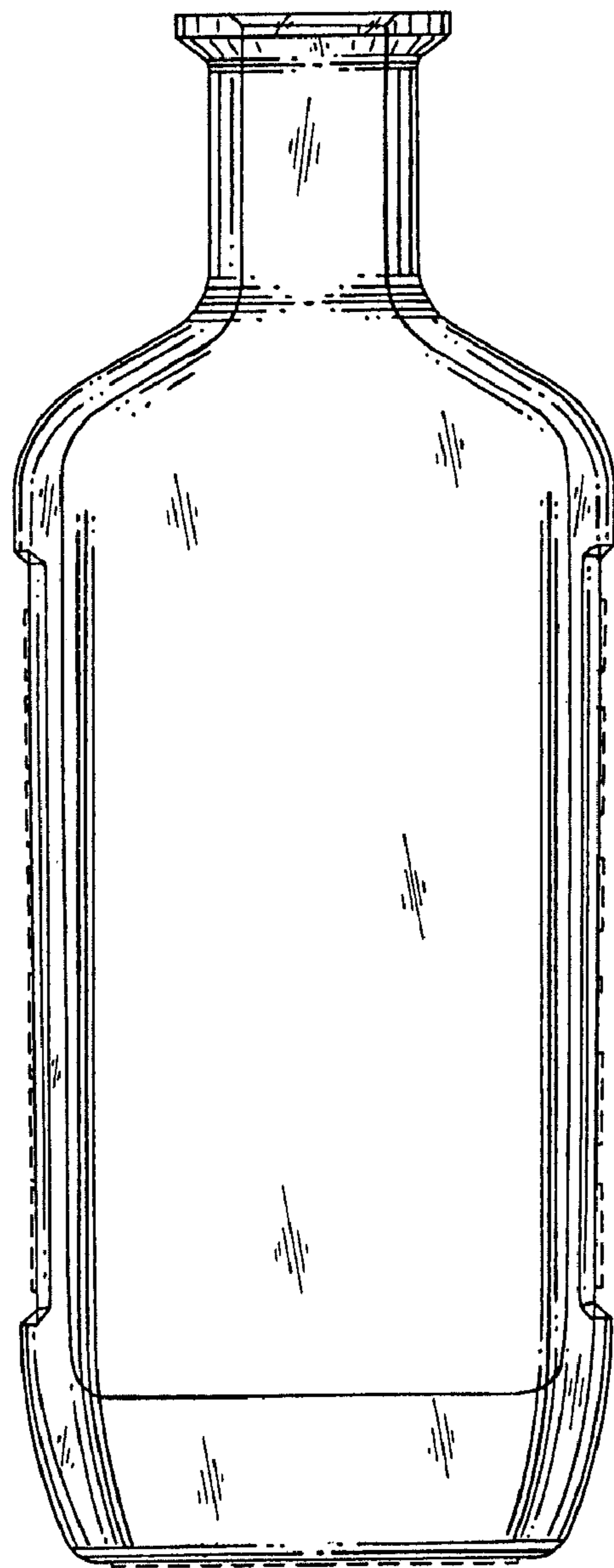

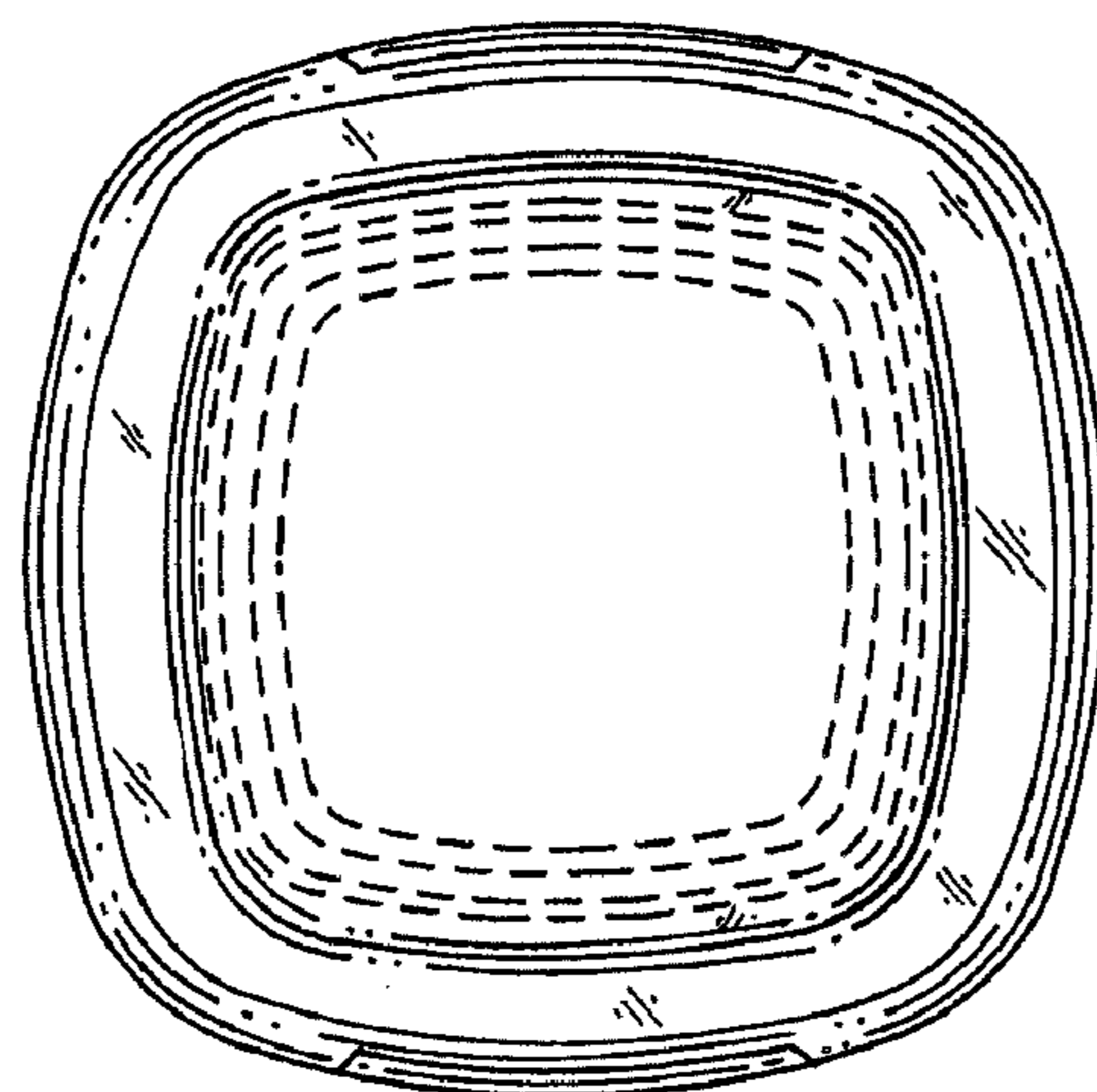

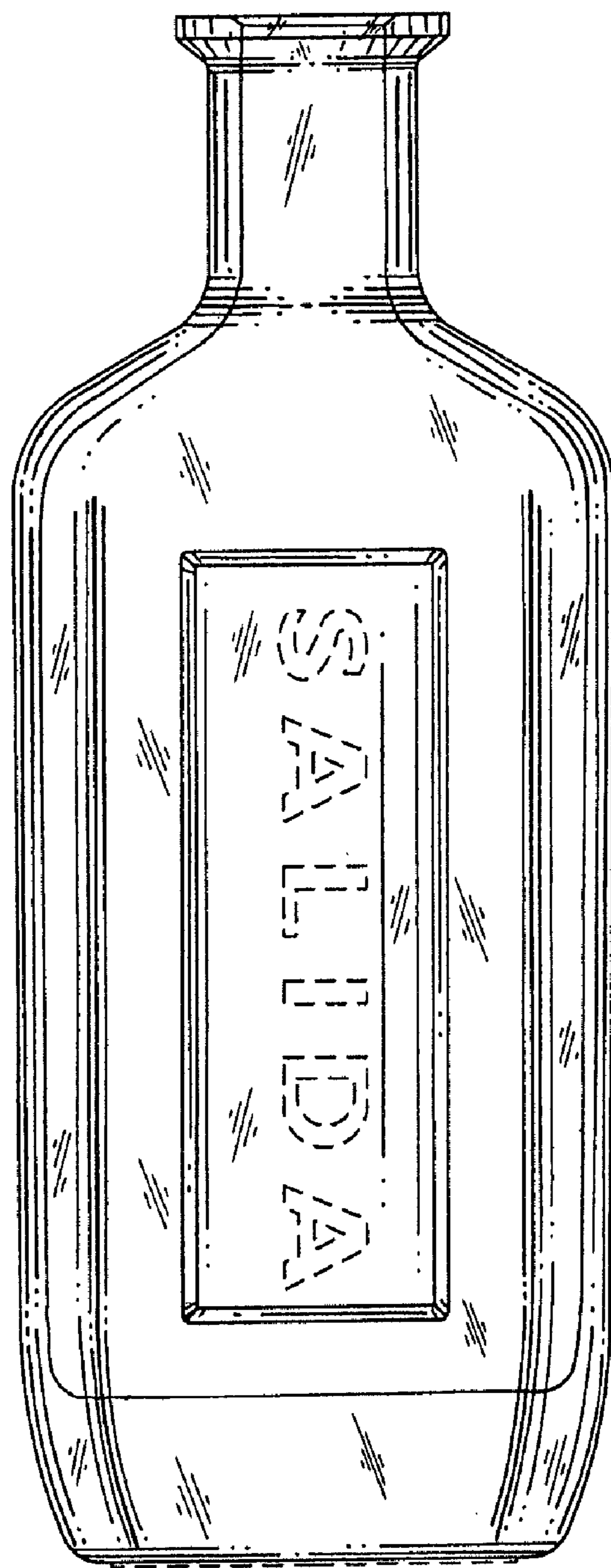
