FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

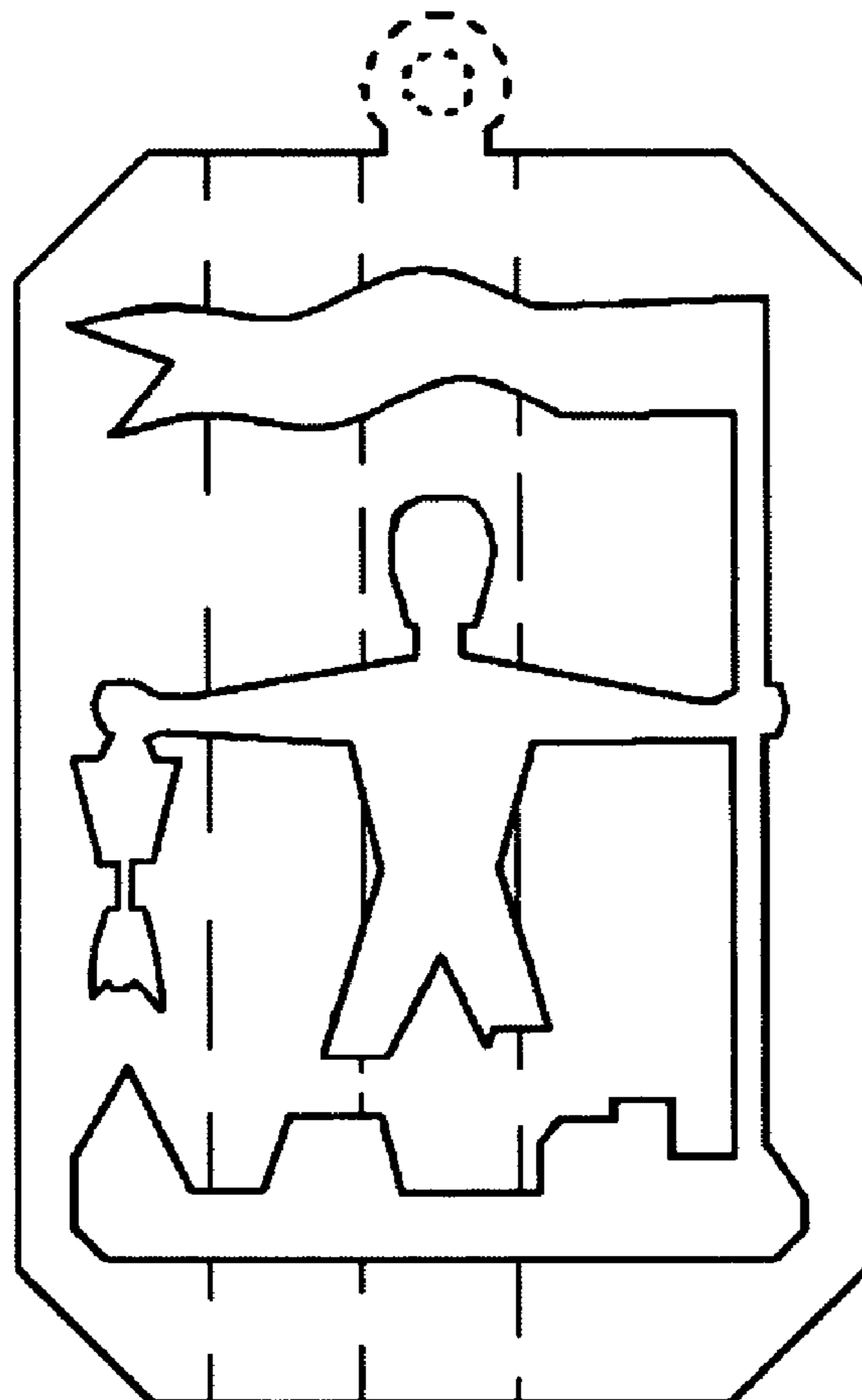
The broken lines shown in the drawings illustrate environmental matter and portions of the jewelry medallion and form no part of the claimed design.

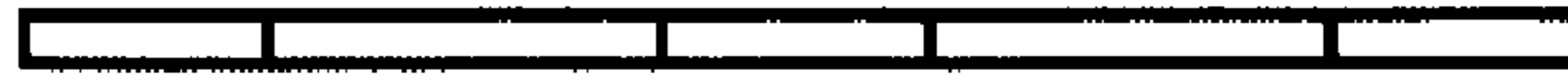

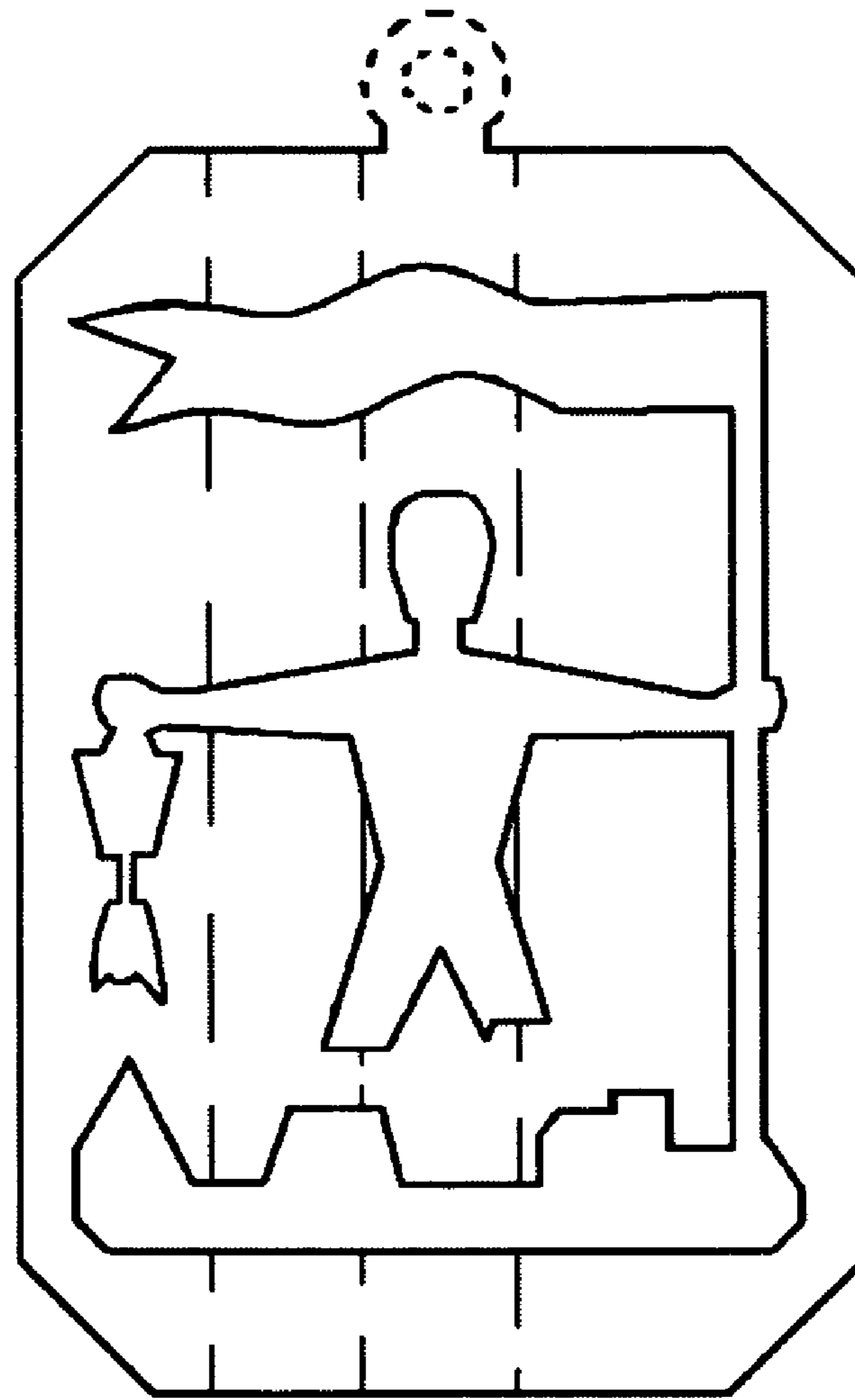
