FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a jewelry medallion showing my new design;

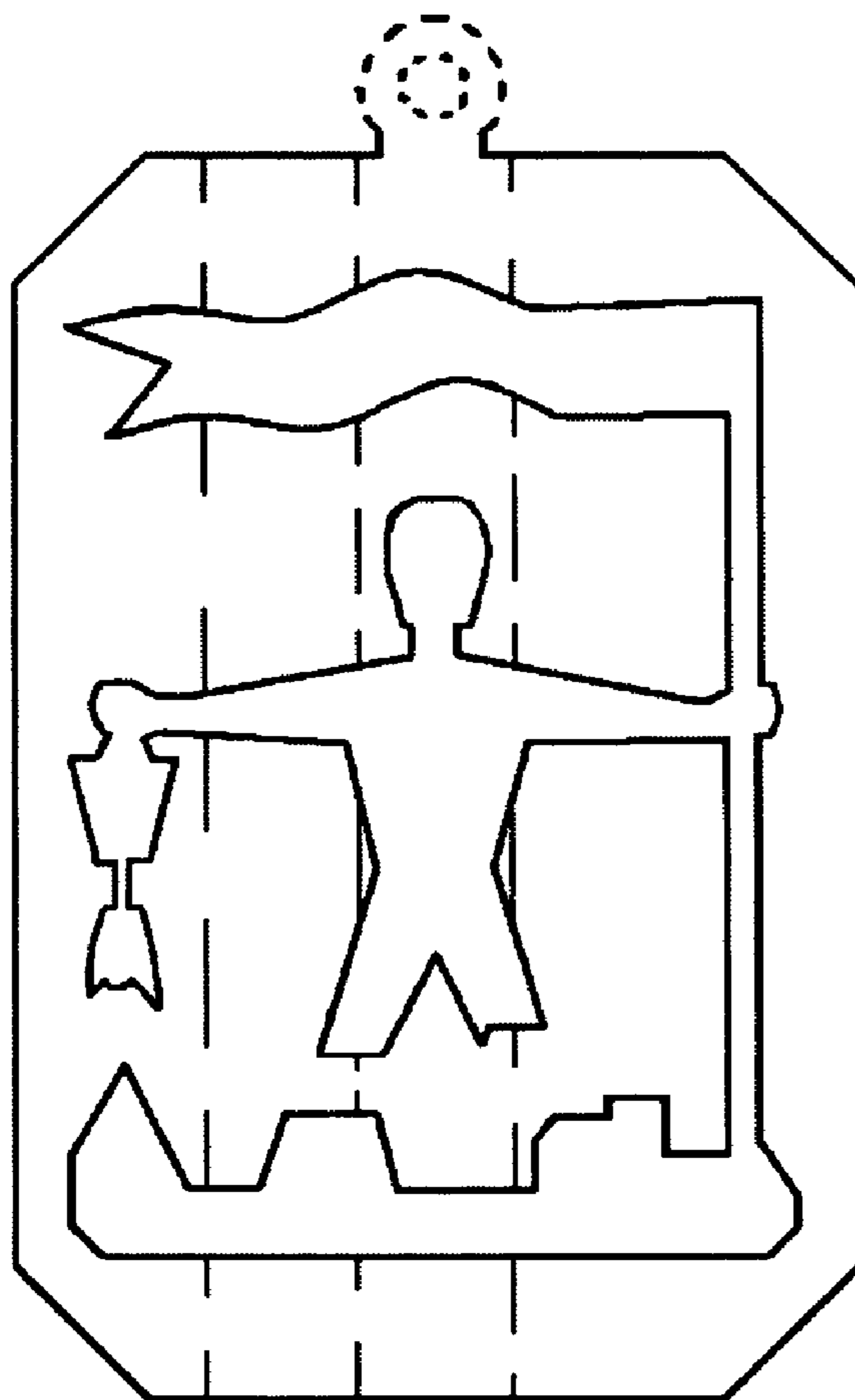
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

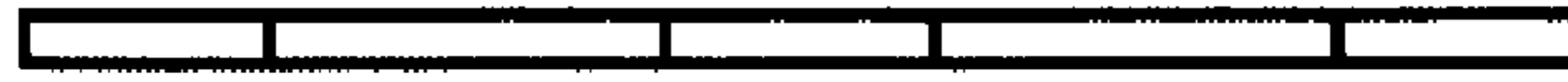

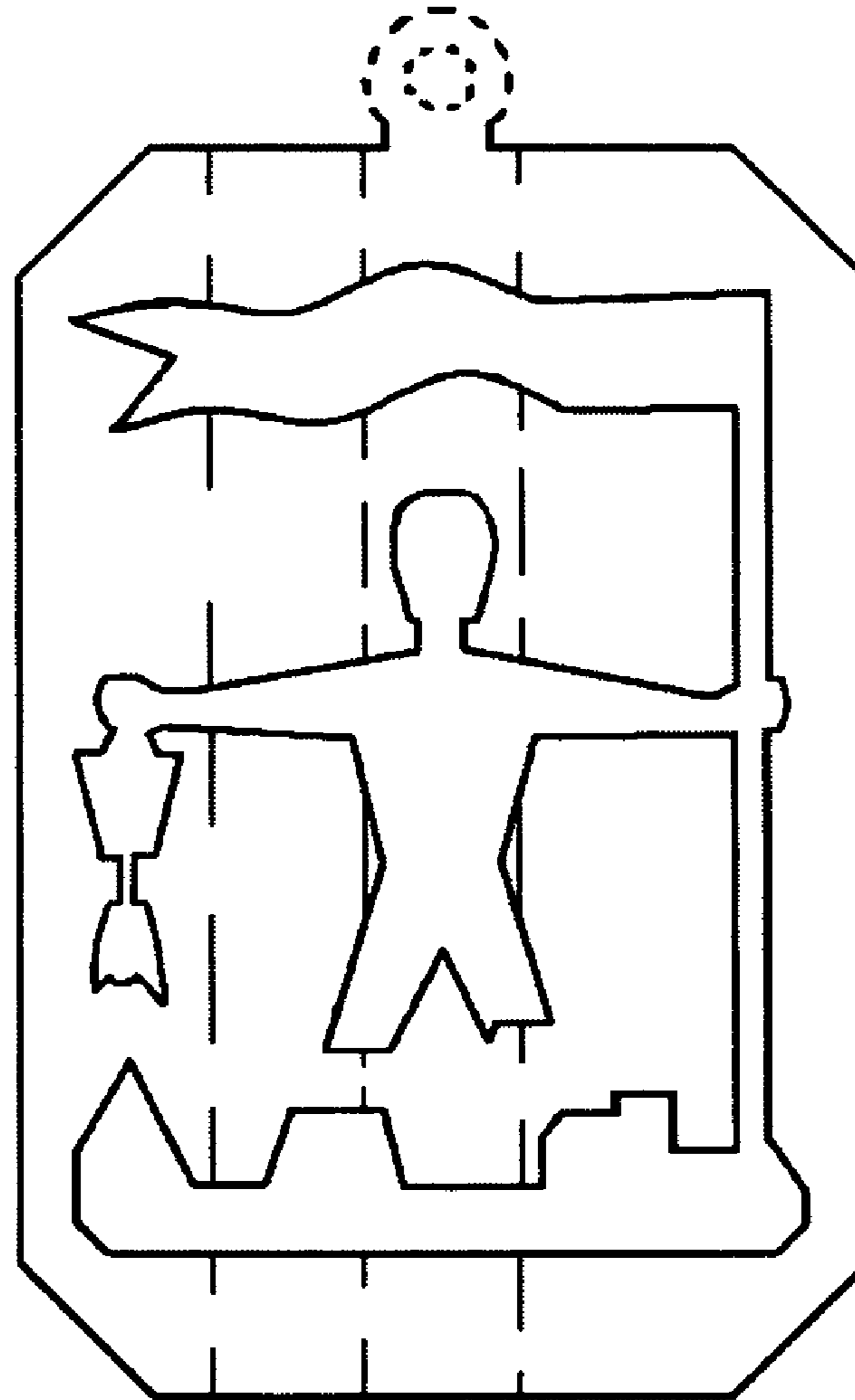
