FIG. 4 is a side view of a first side of the stand shown in FIG. 1;

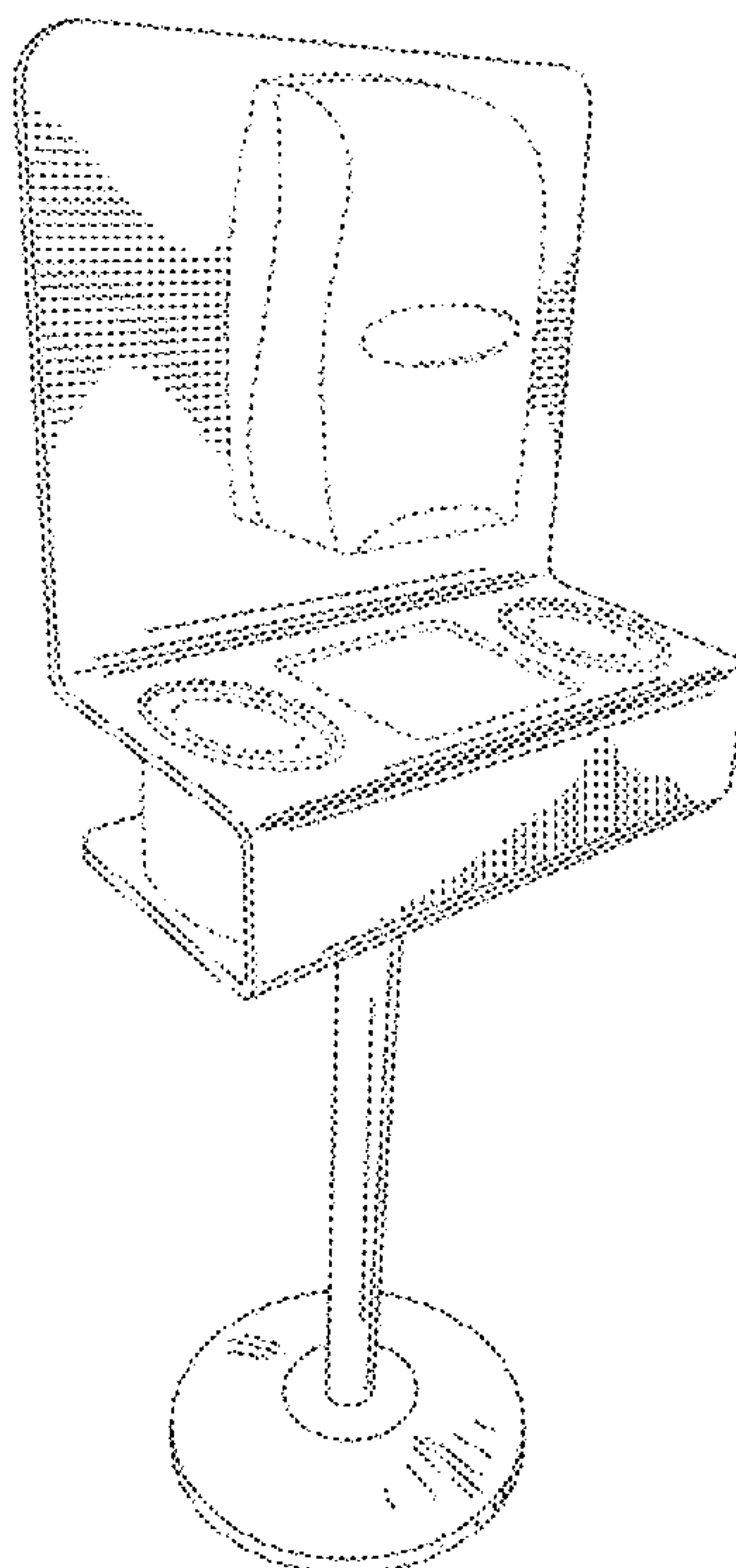
FIG. 5 is a side view of a second side of the stand shown in FIG. 1;

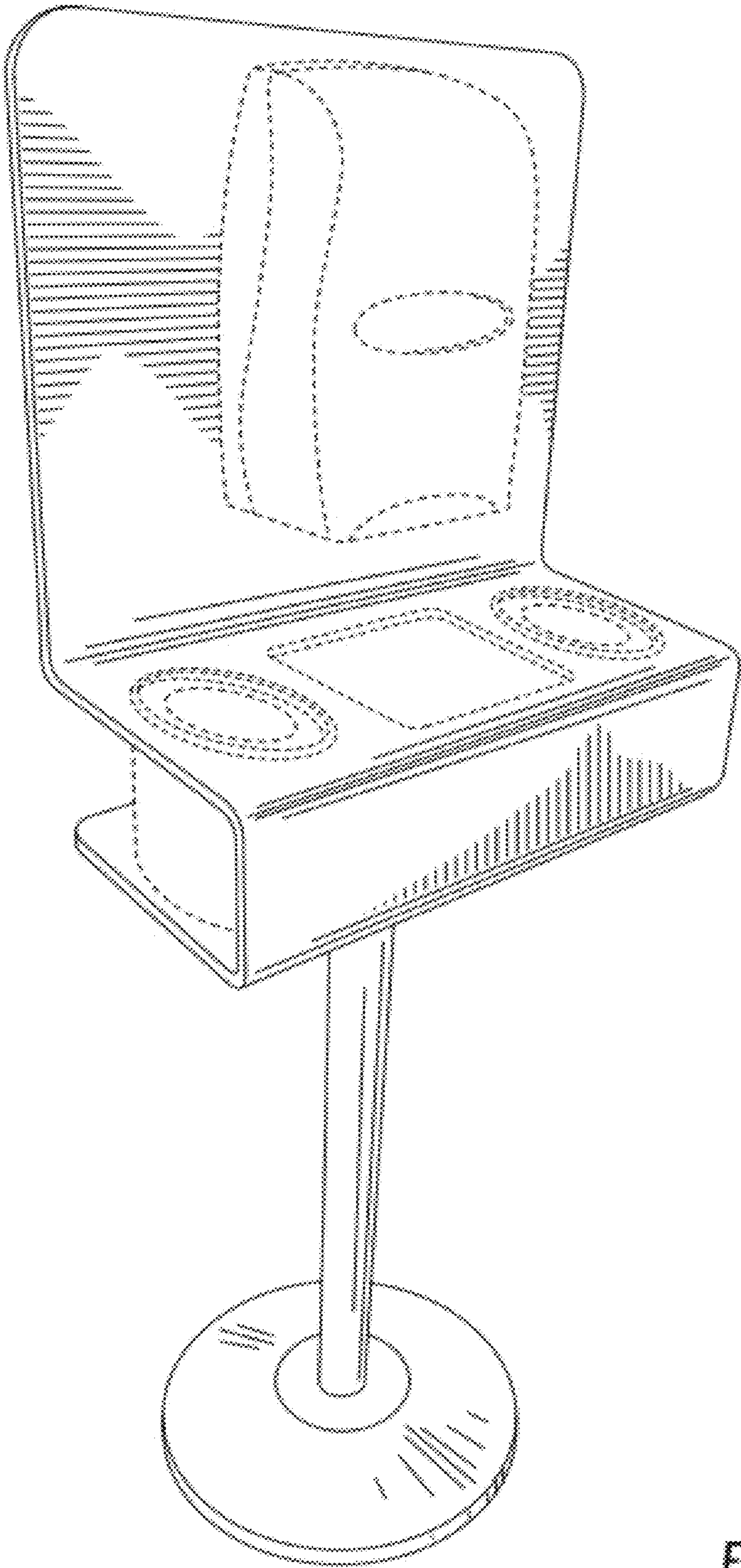

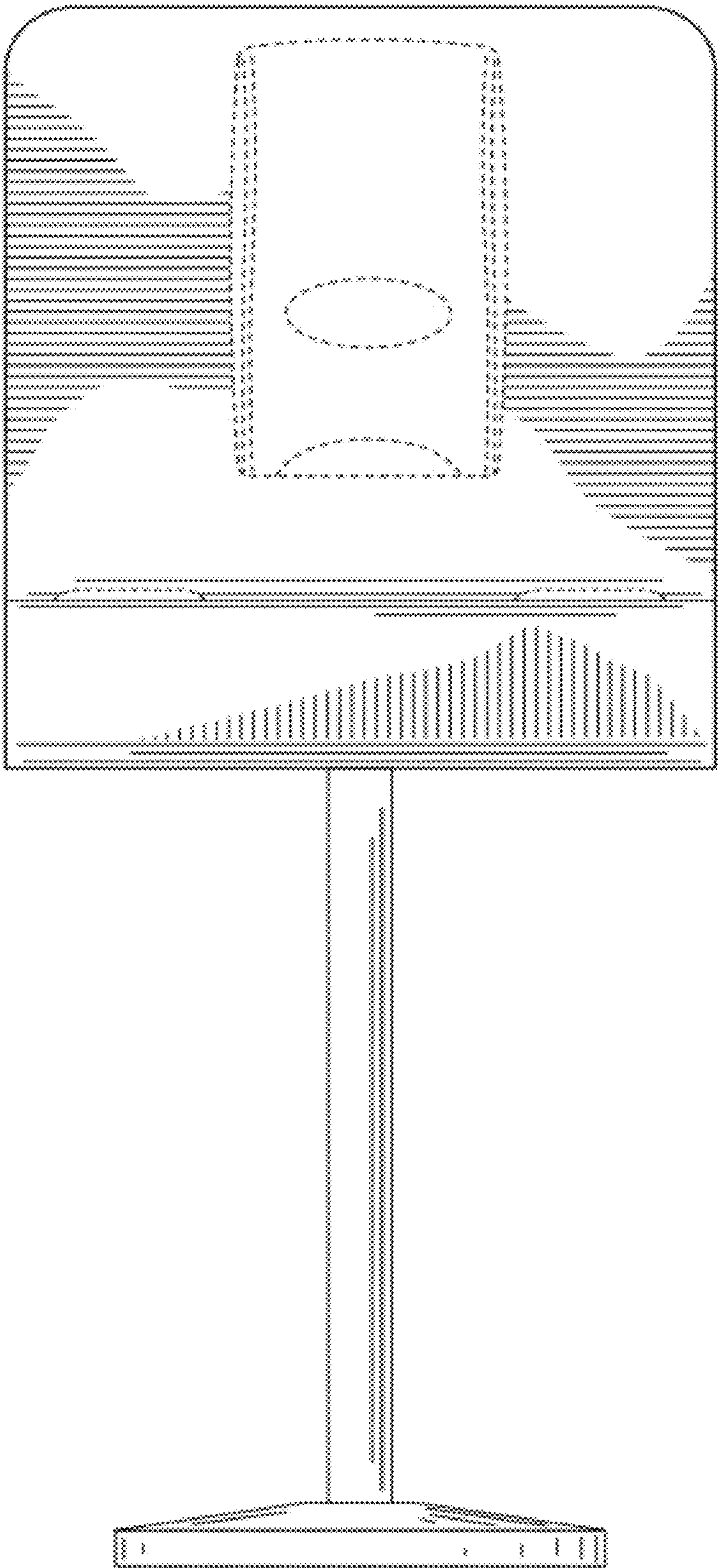

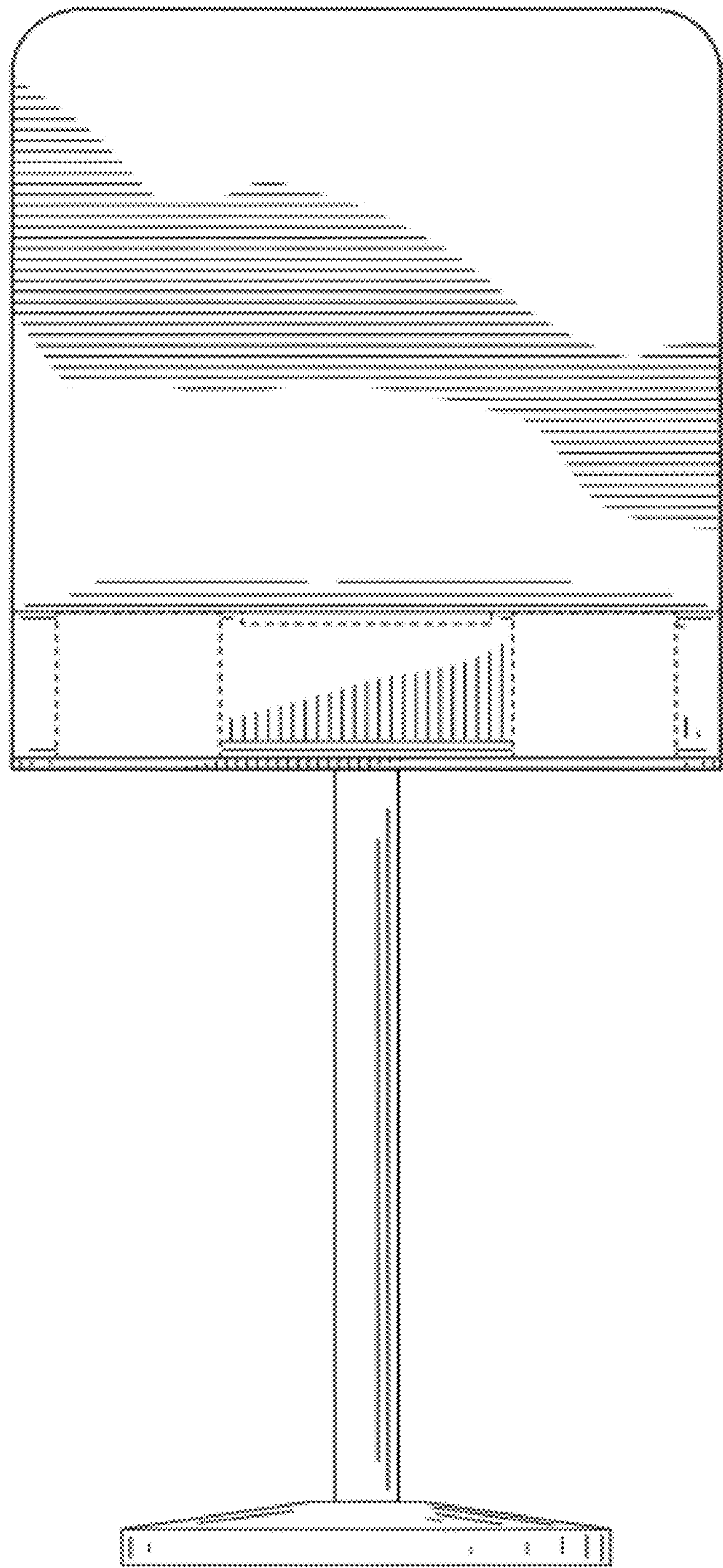

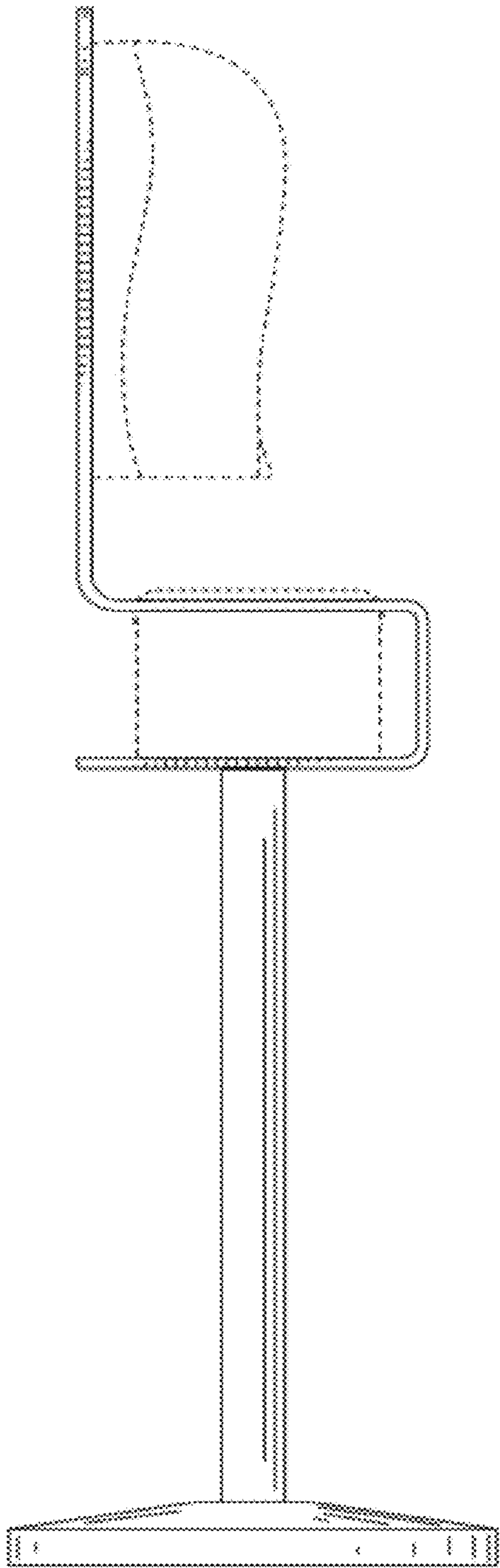

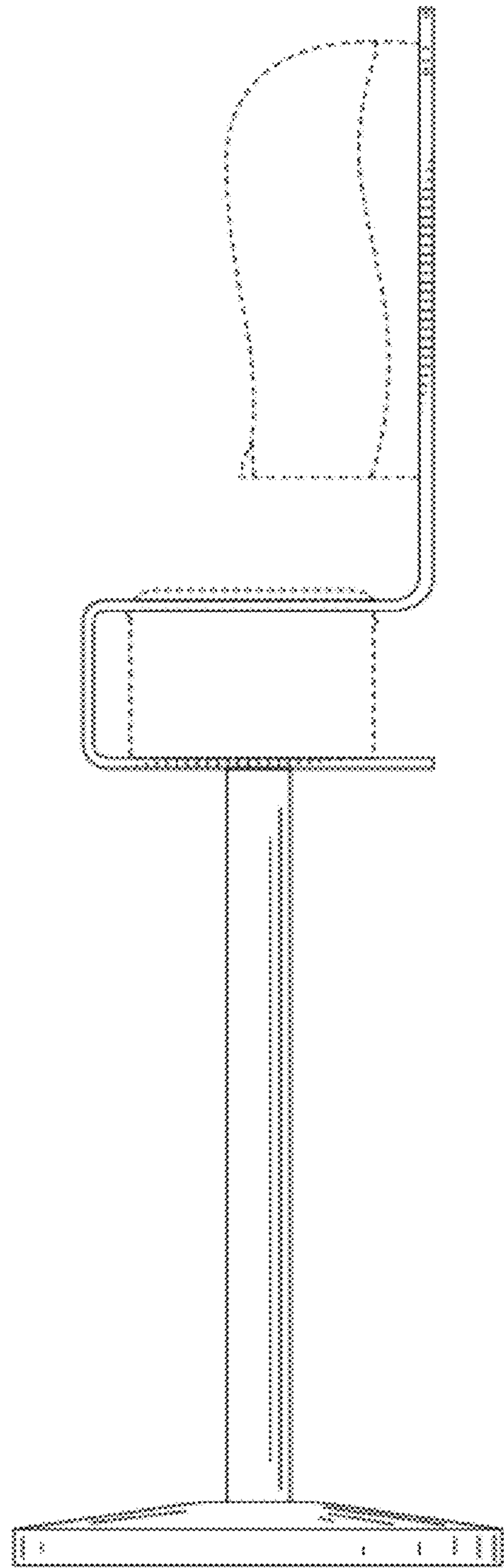

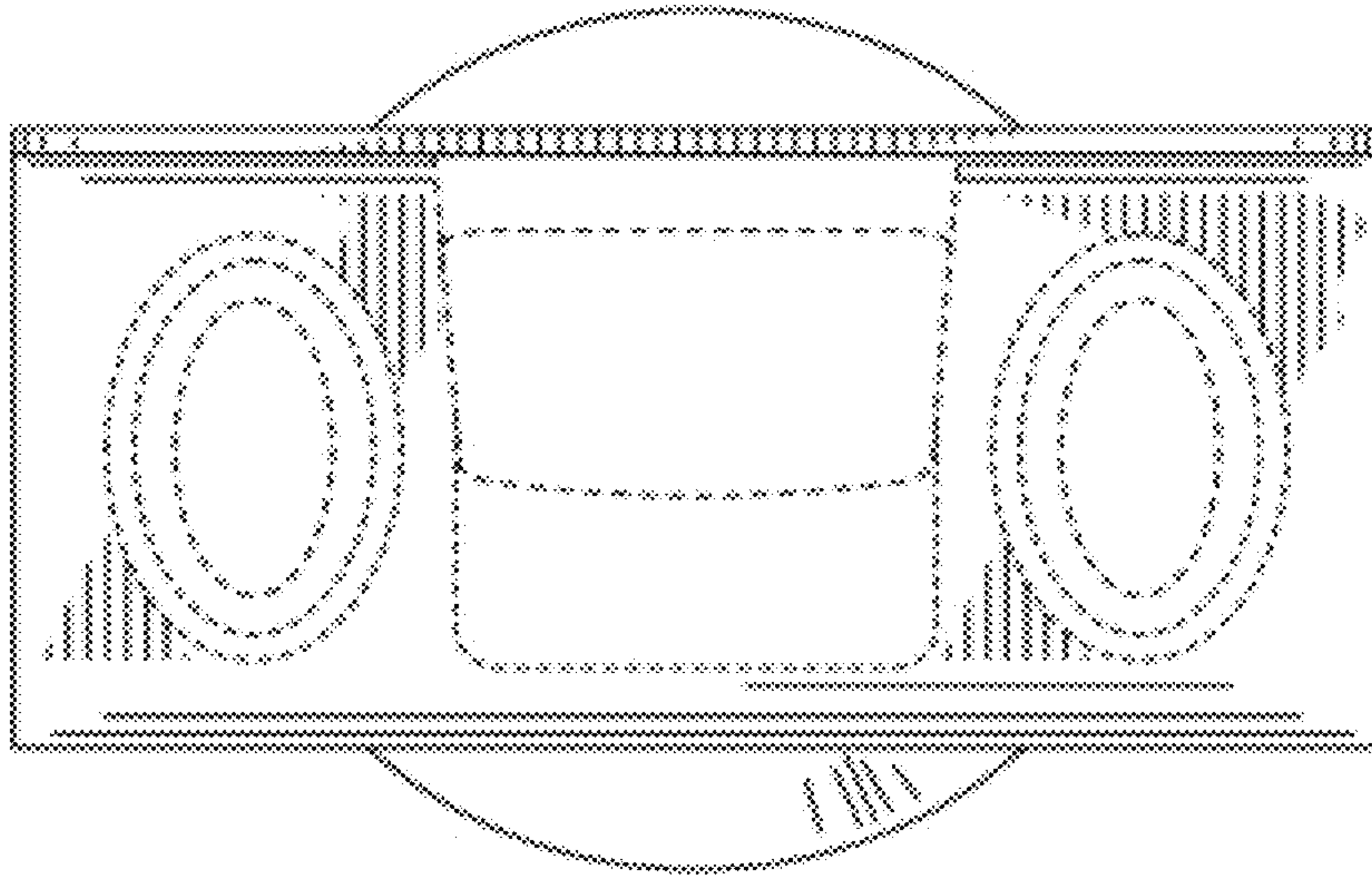

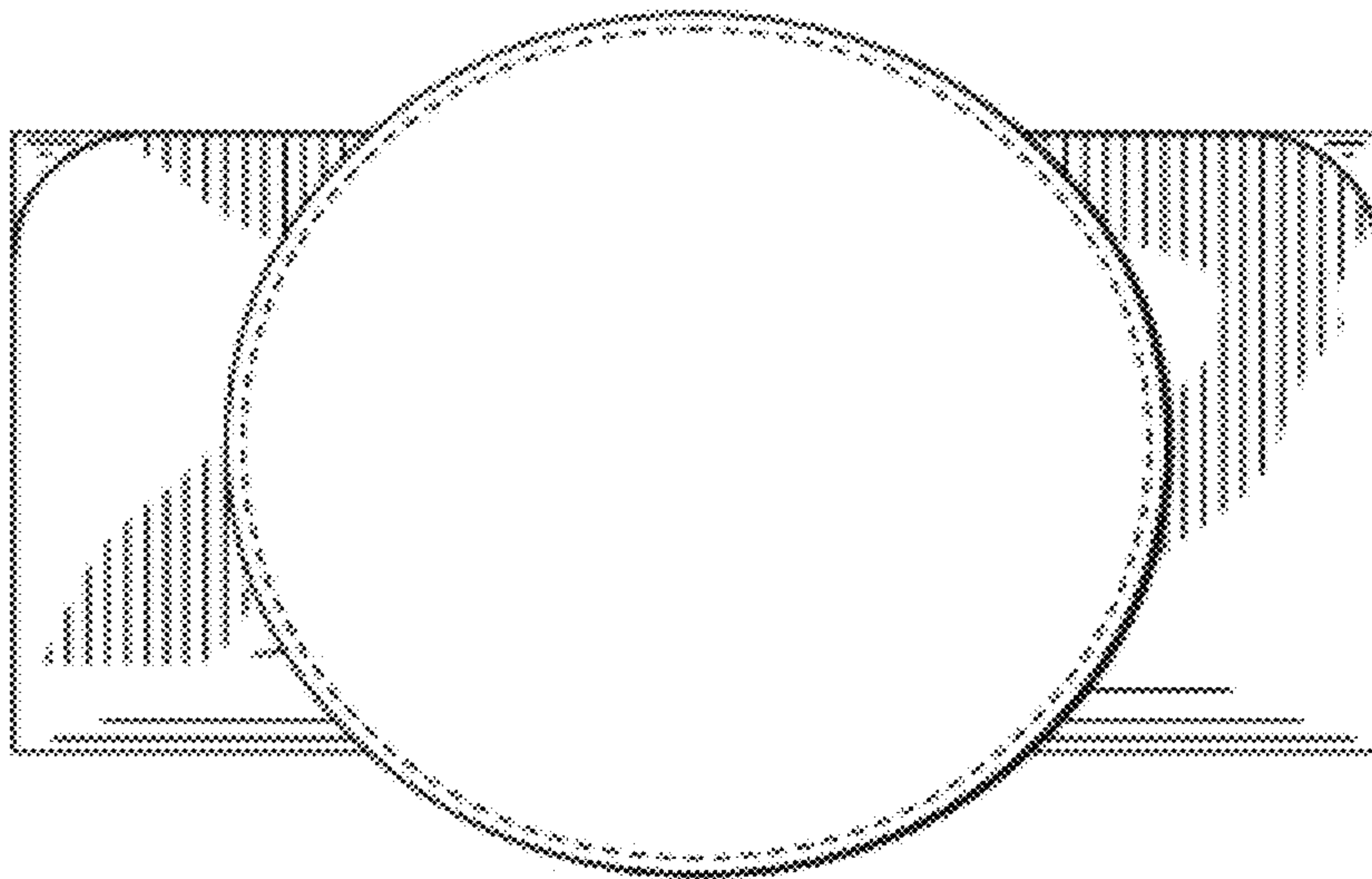
