(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a combined travel pillow and cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined travel pillow and cover, showing my new design with the cover omitted for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 1, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof, illustrated with the cover over the pillow;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

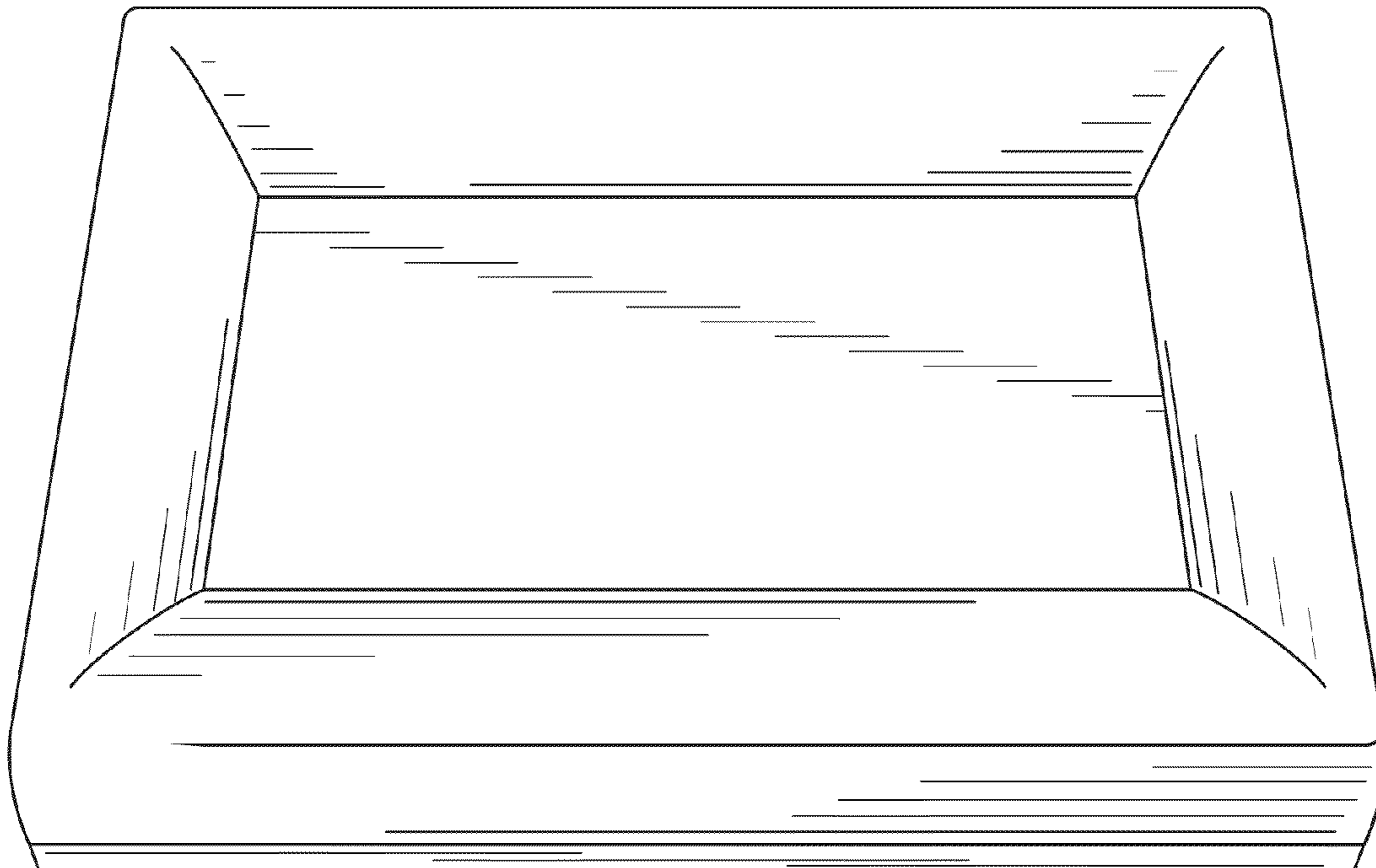
FIG. 9 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 7, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7.

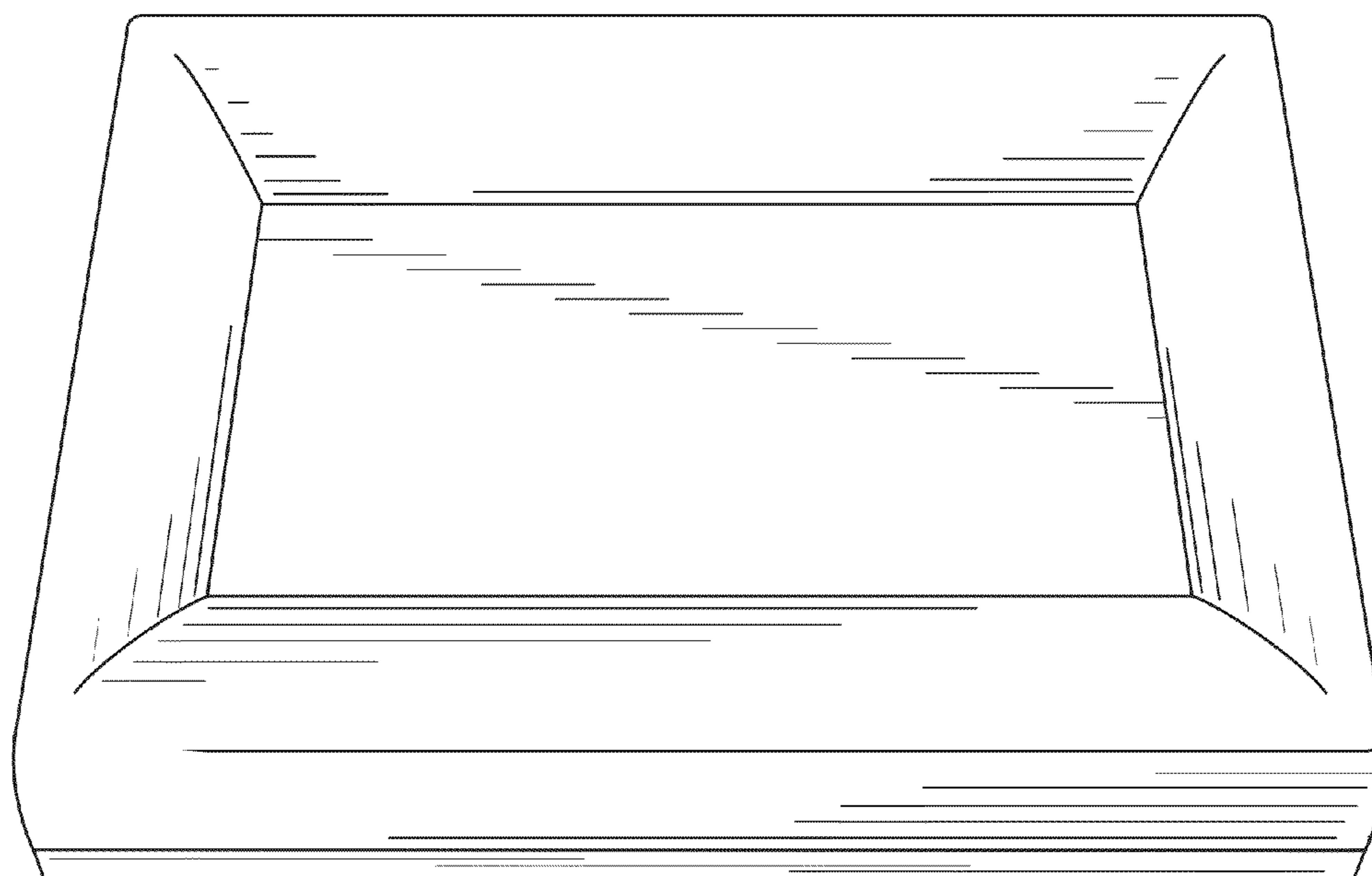

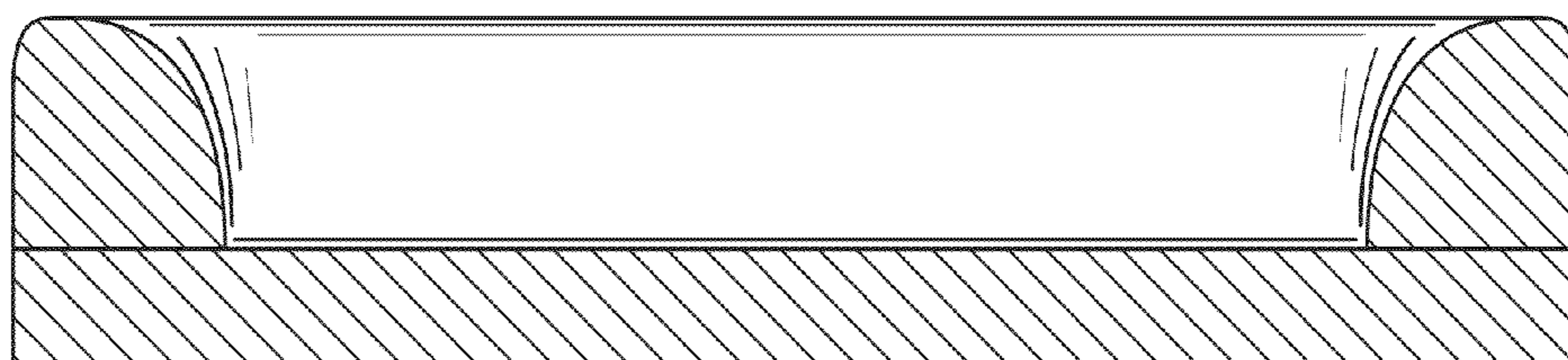

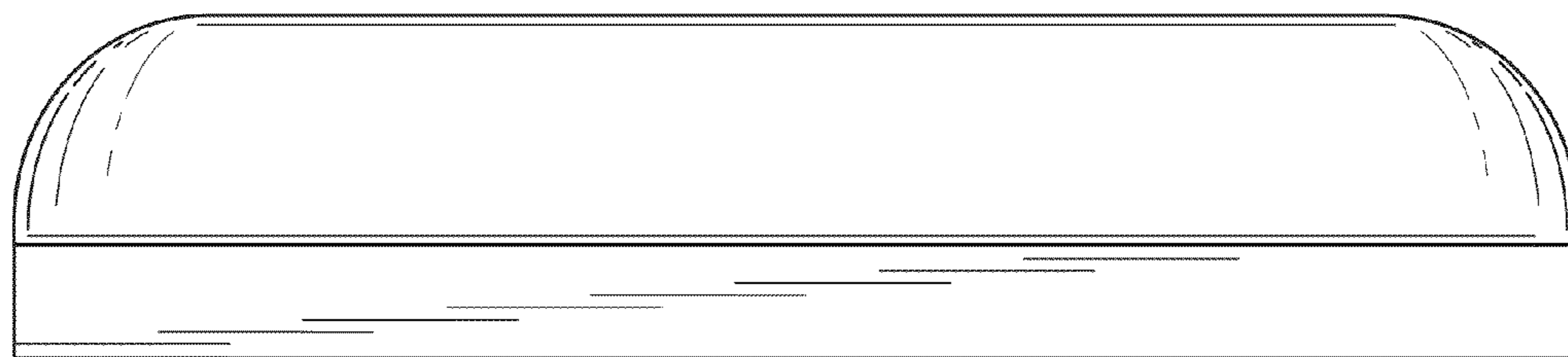

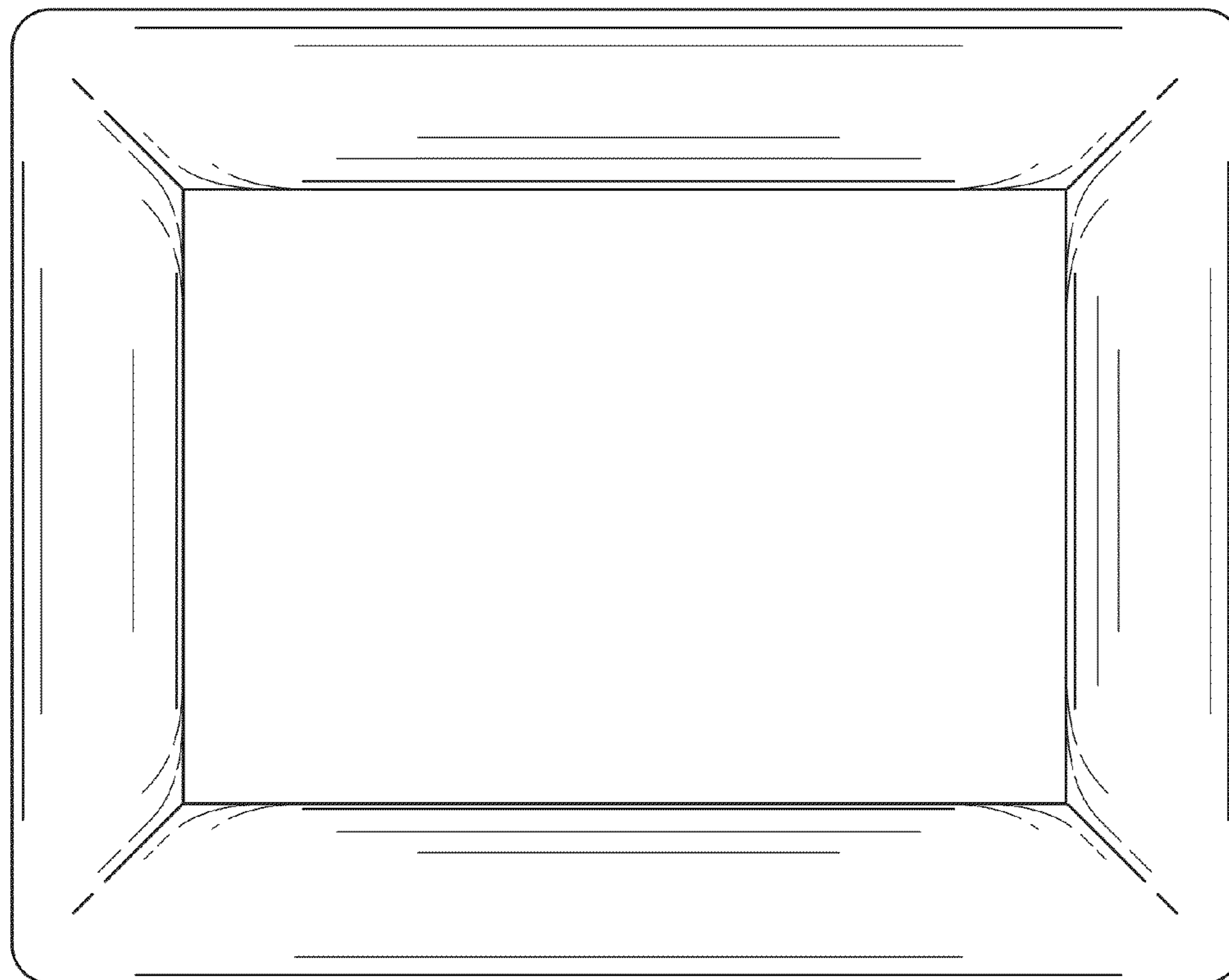

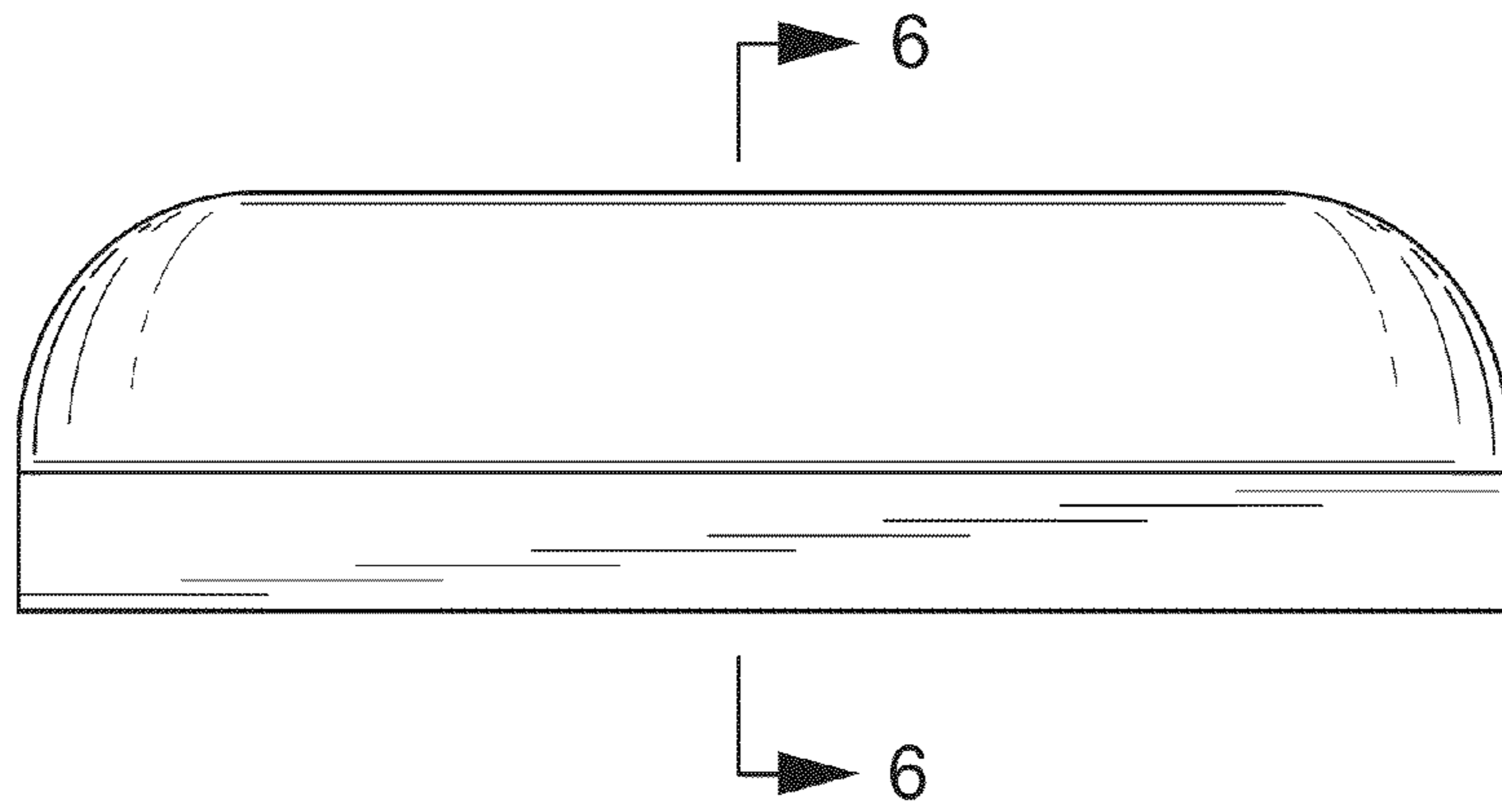

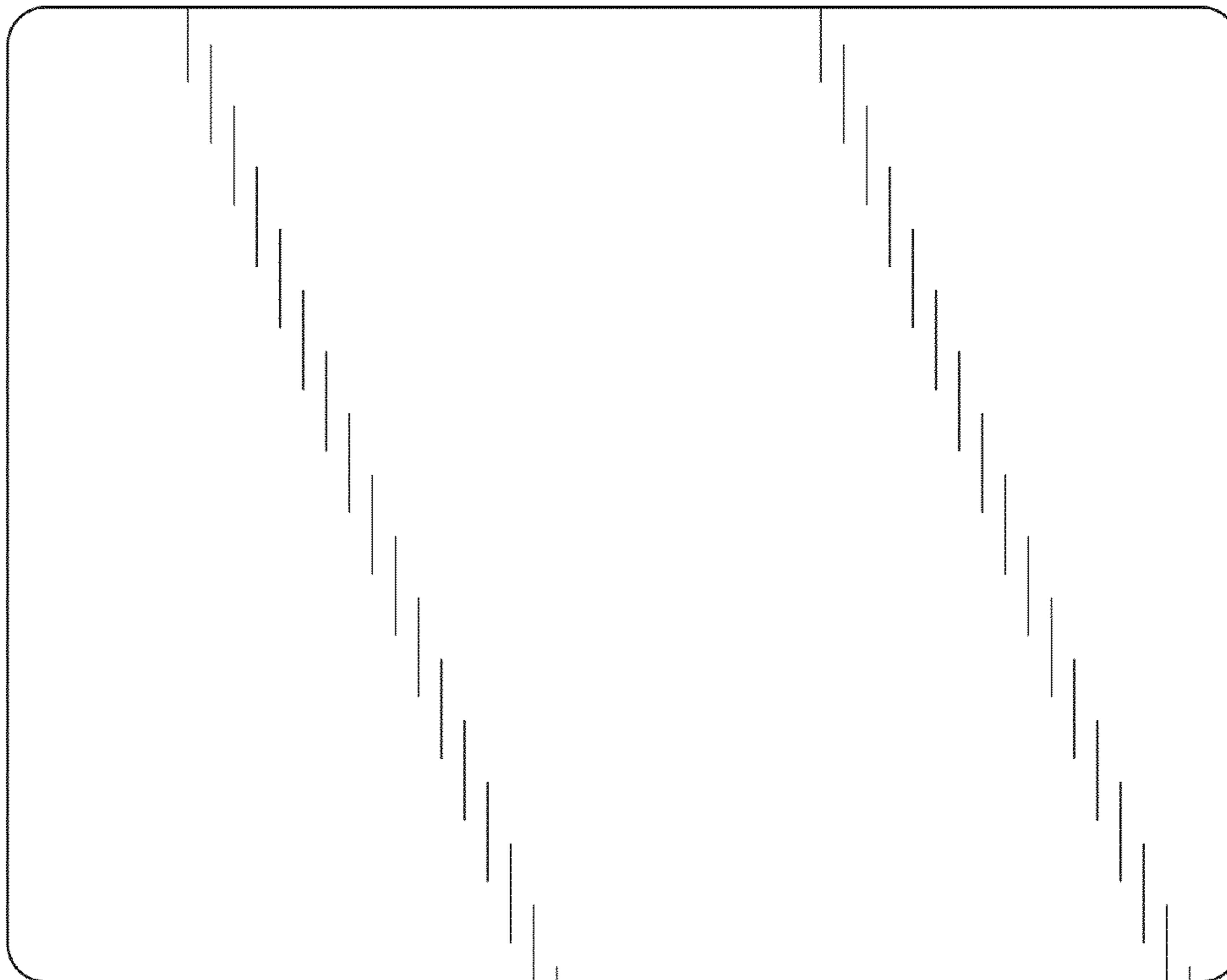

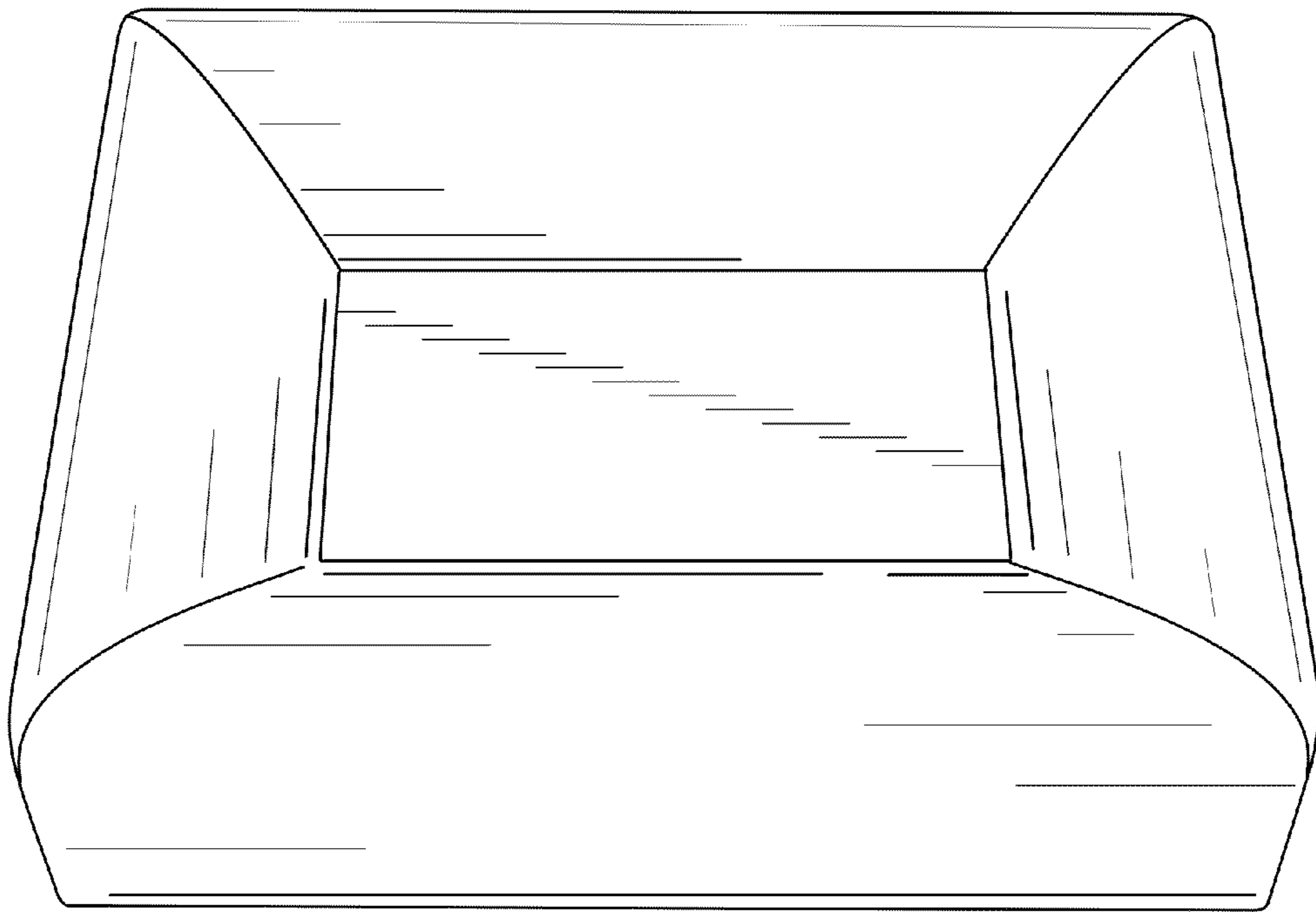

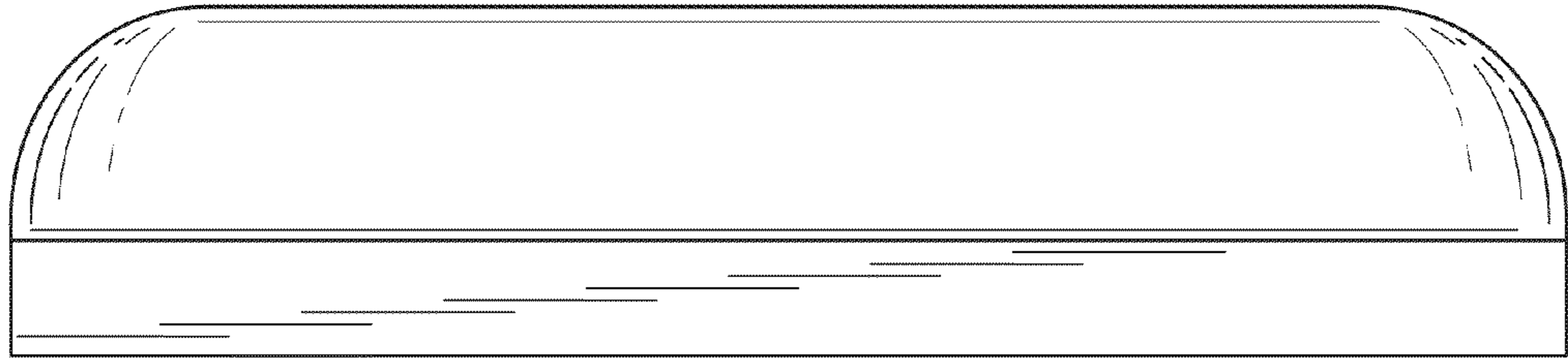

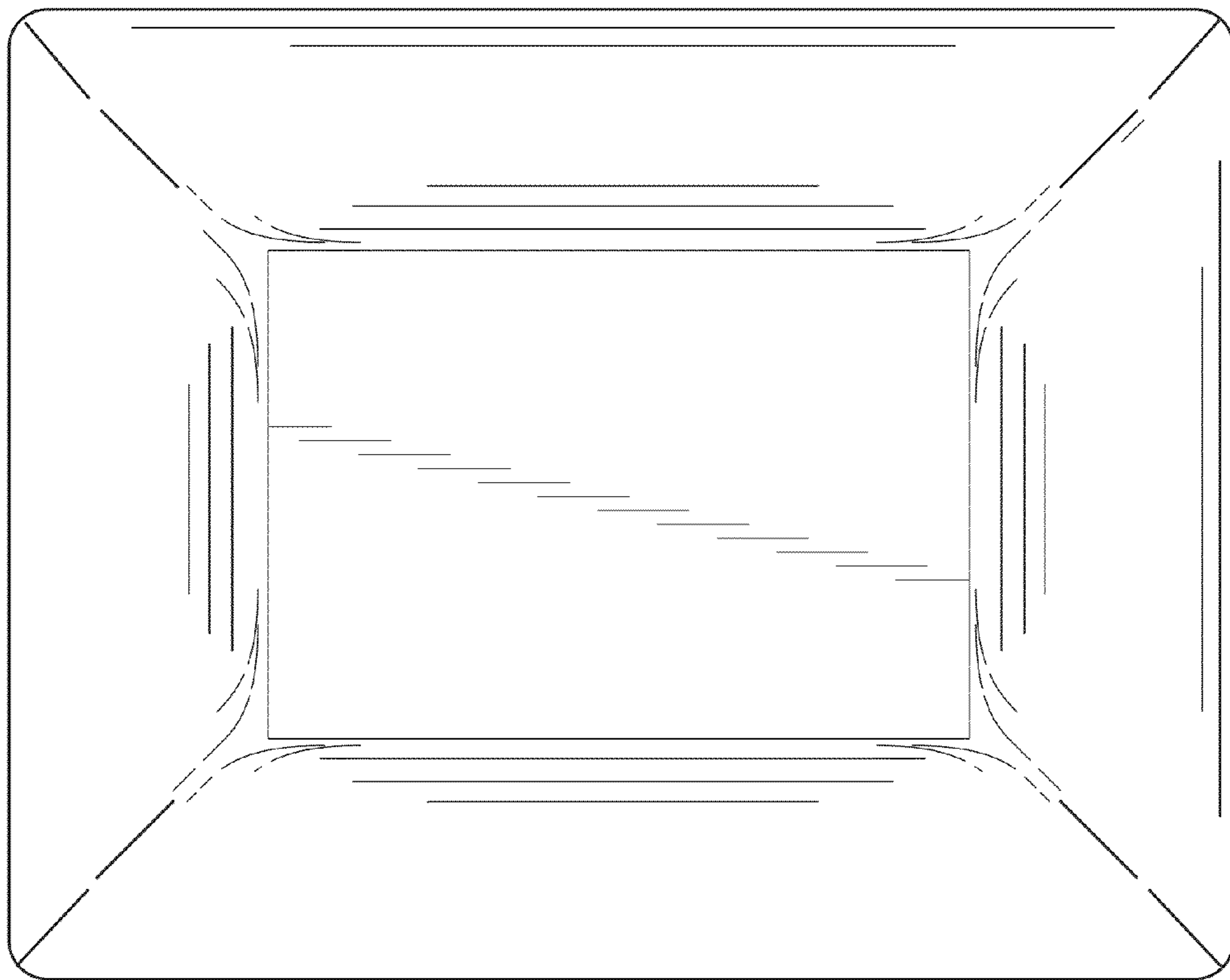

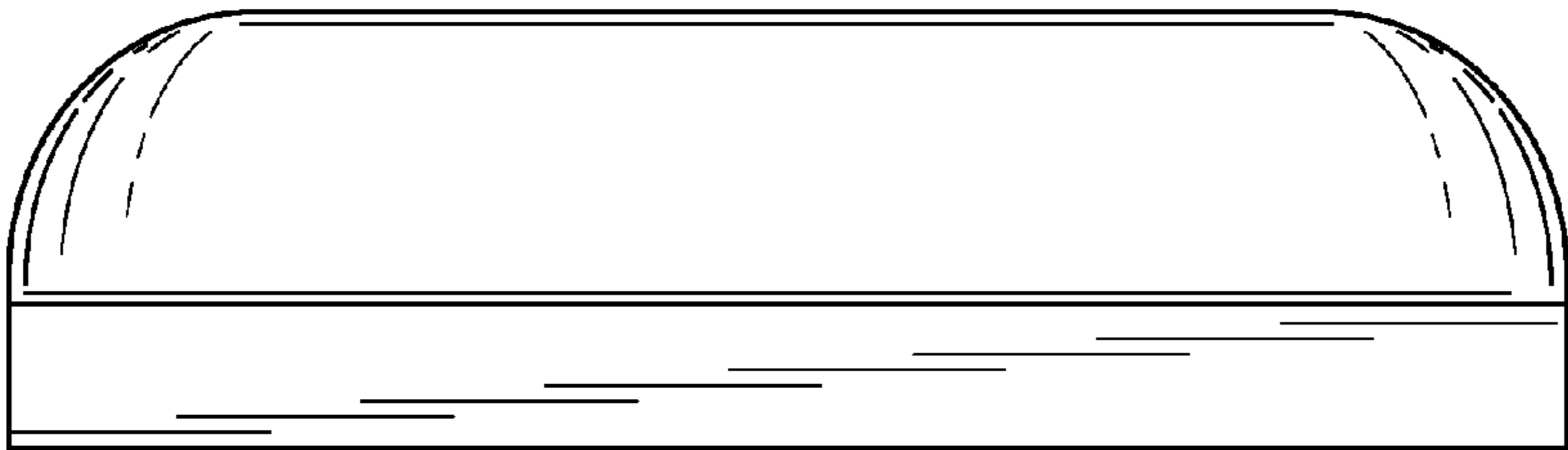

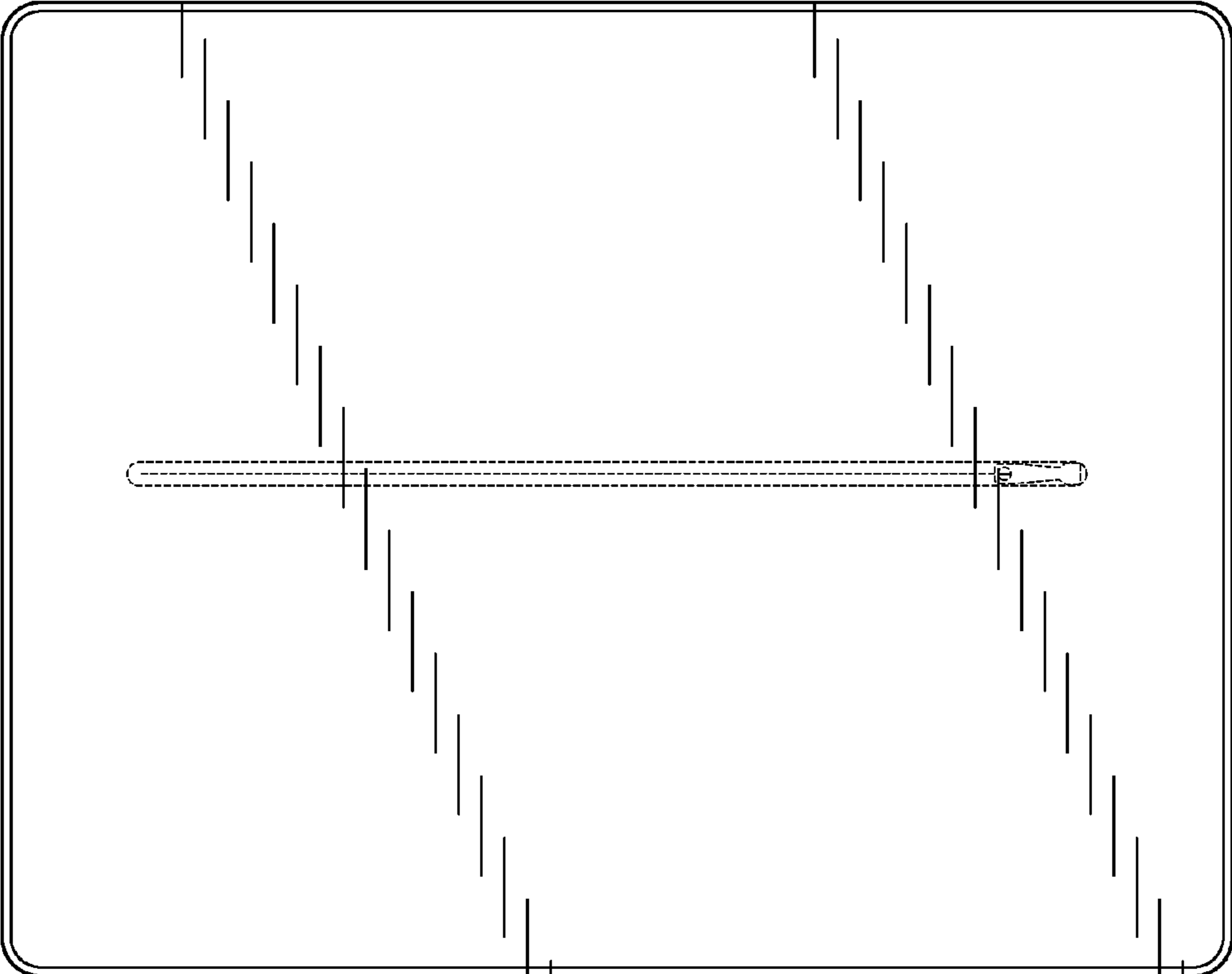
