The ornamental design for a utensil rest, as shown and described.

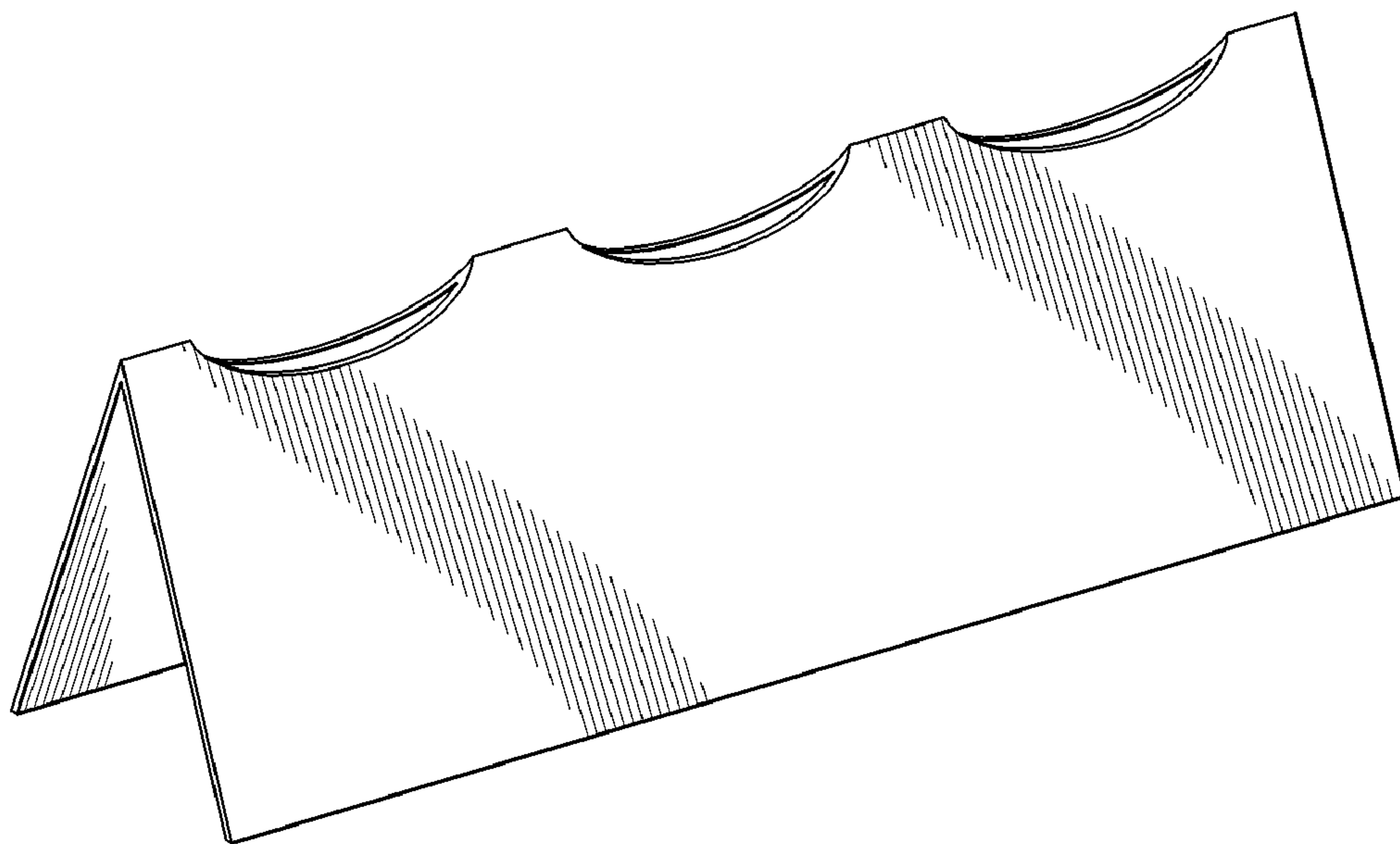
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a utensil rest;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the utensil rest of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

A rear elevational view is the same as the front elevational view shown in FIG. 2, and therefore is not shown. A left side elevational view is the same as the right side elevational view shown in FIG. 5, and therefore is not shown.

The ornamental design which is claimed is shown in solid lines in the drawings.

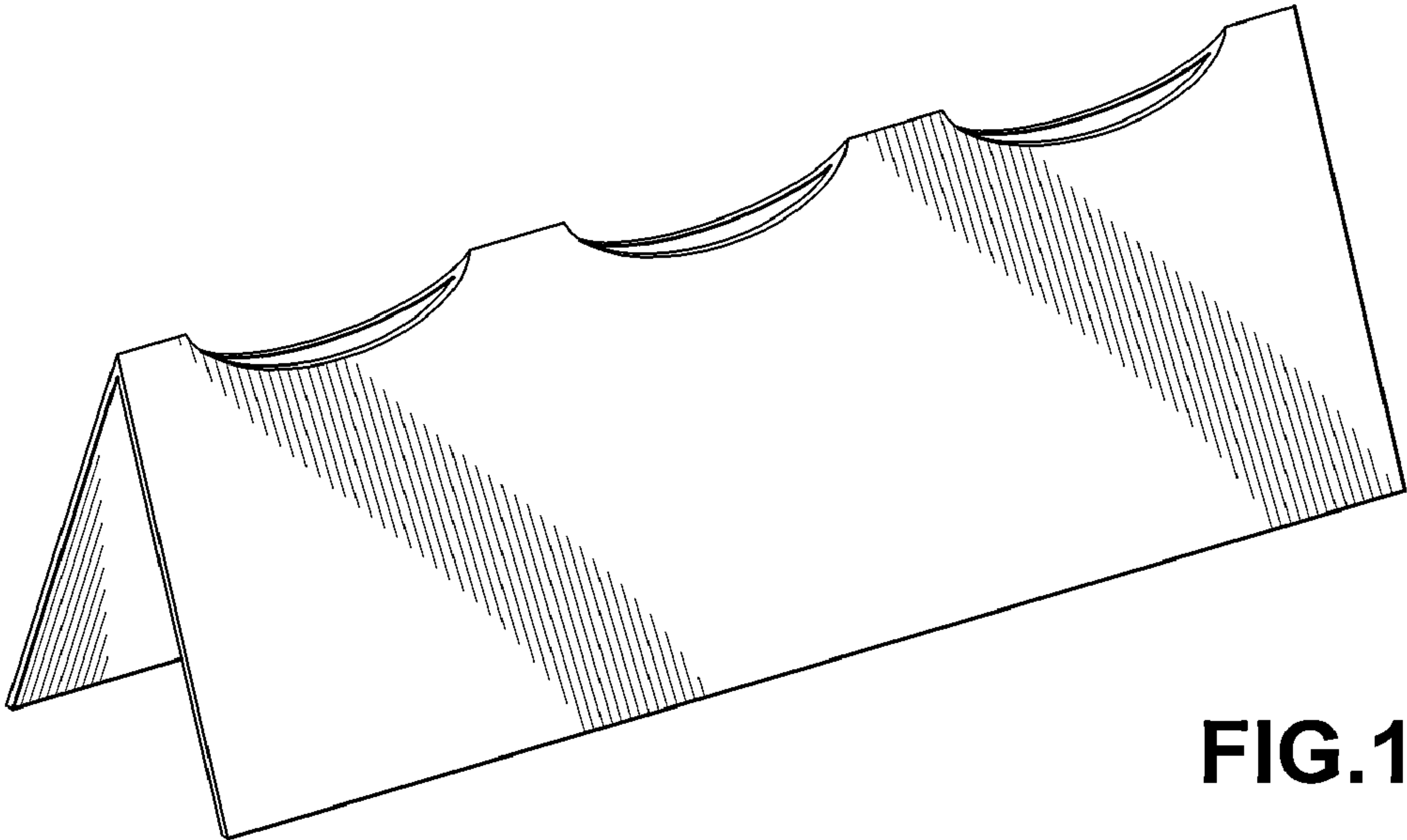

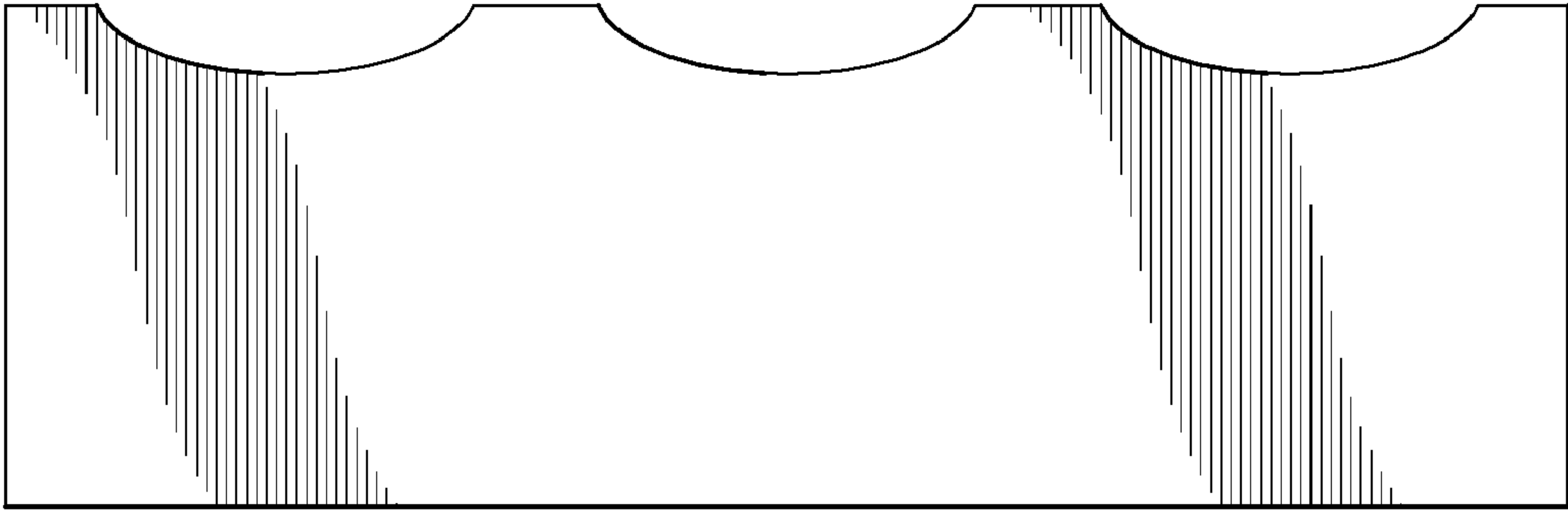

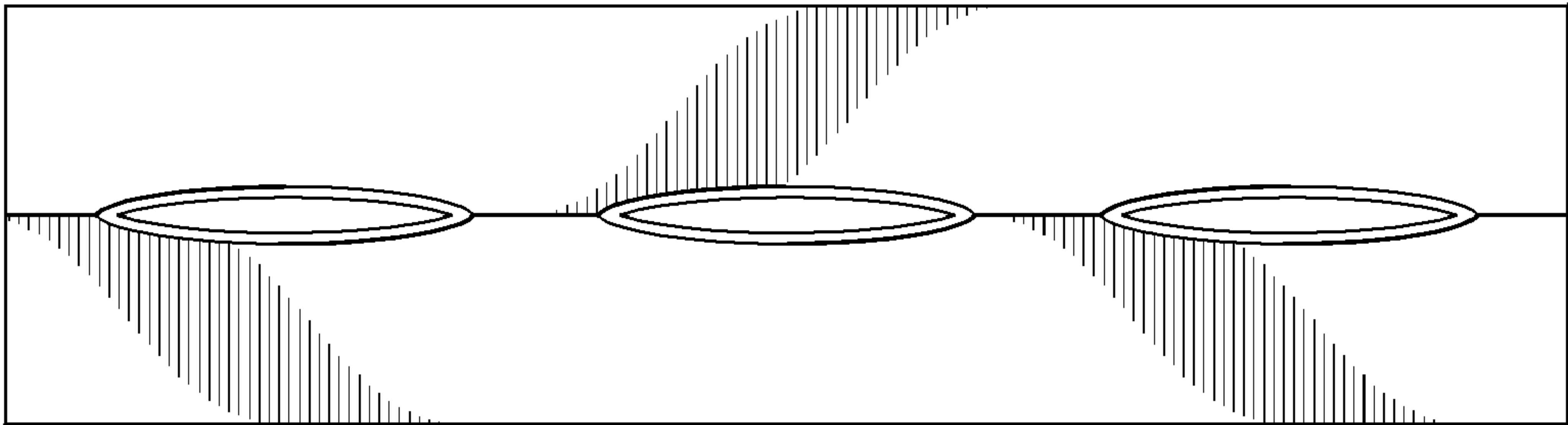

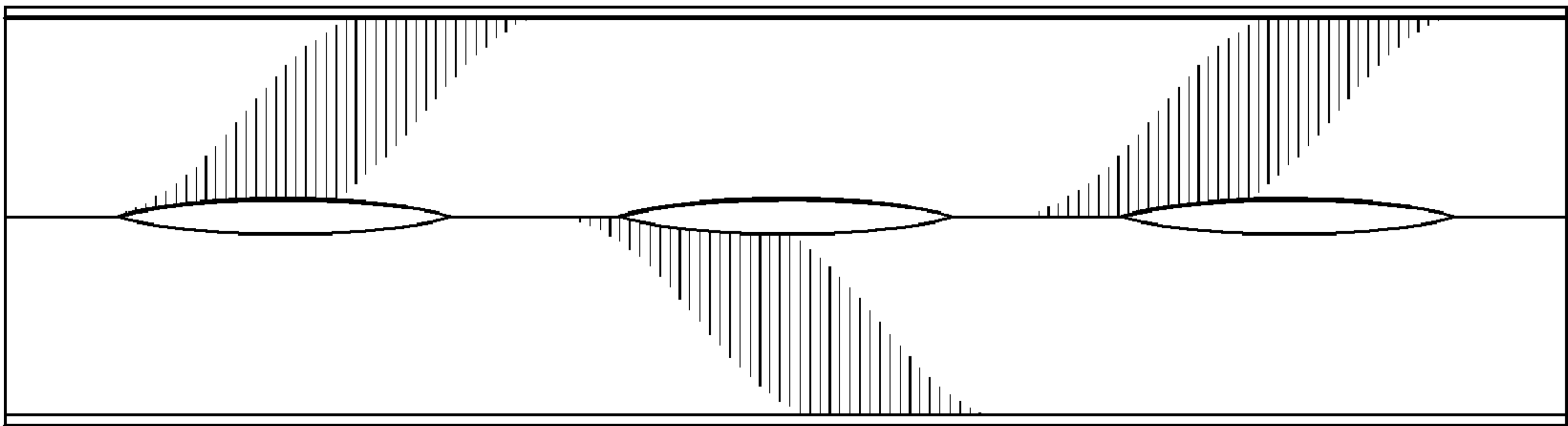

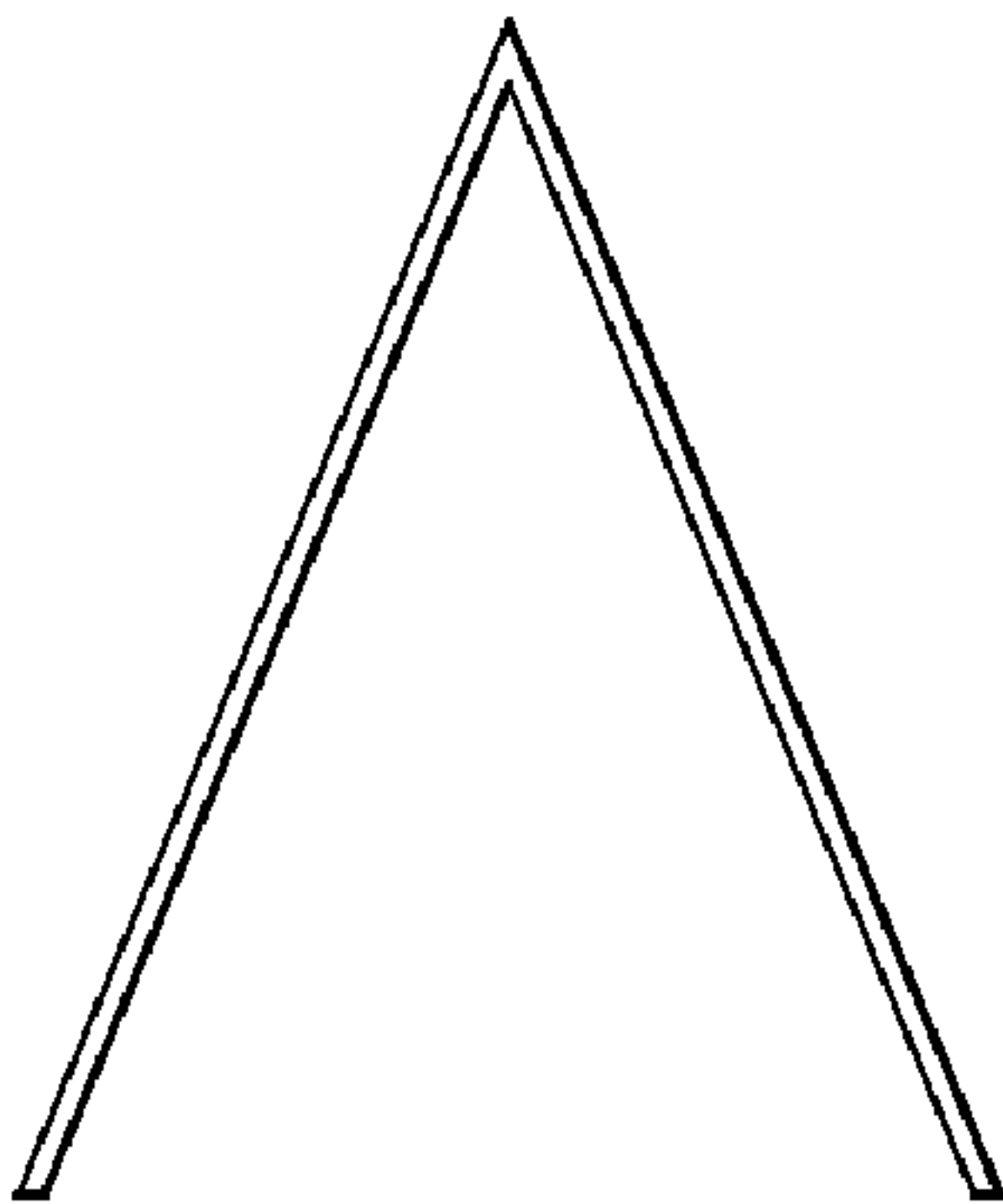
