FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof

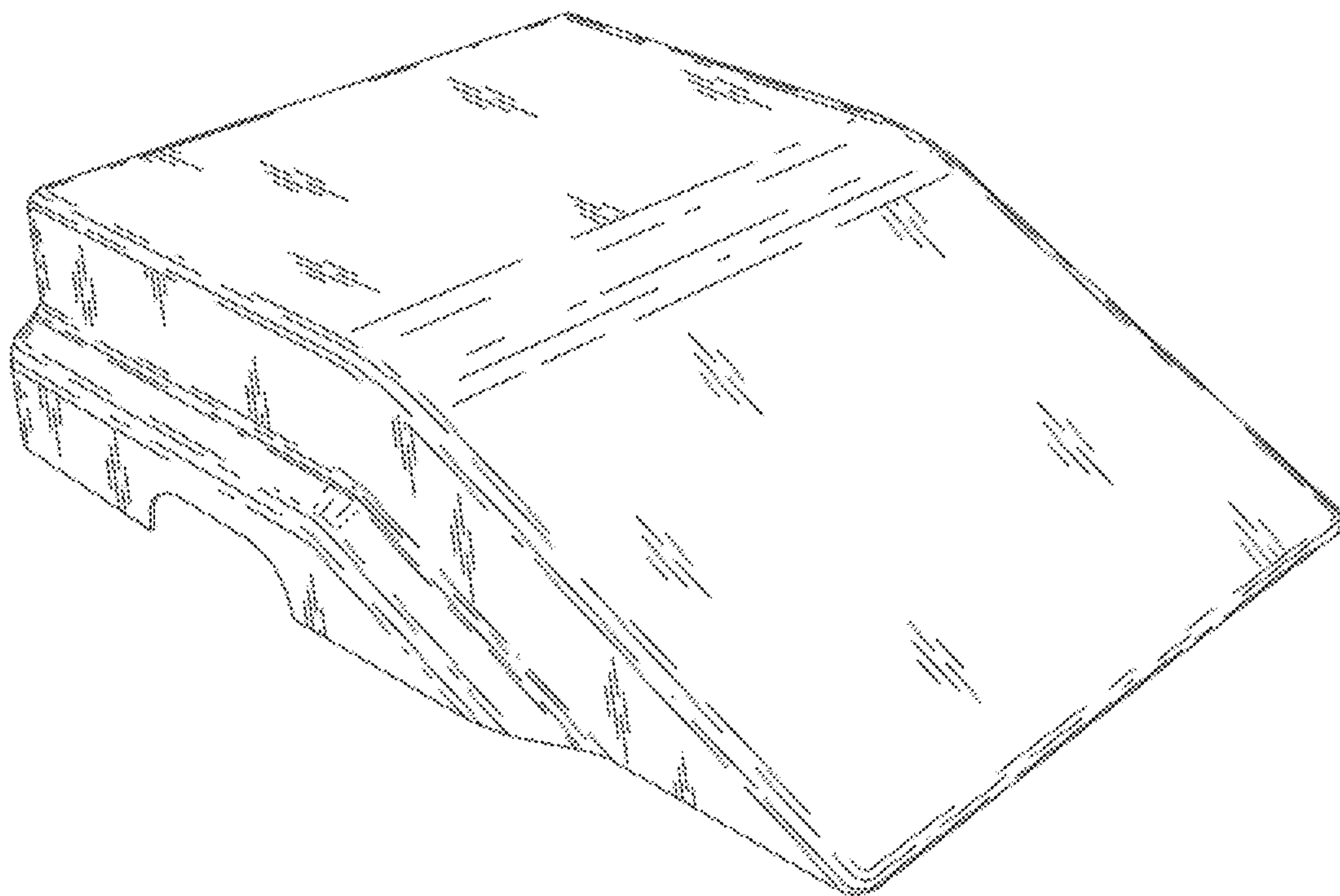
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

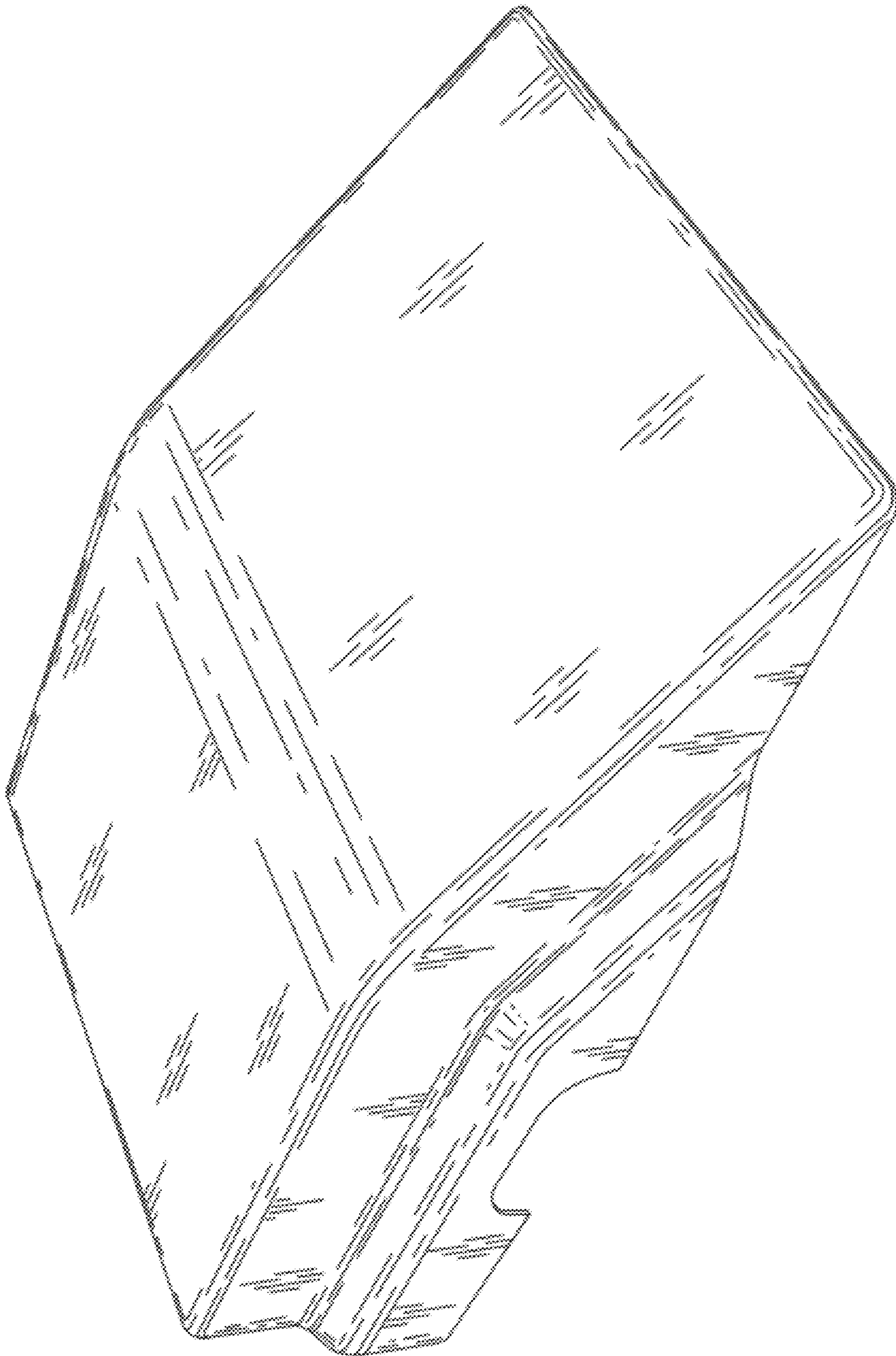

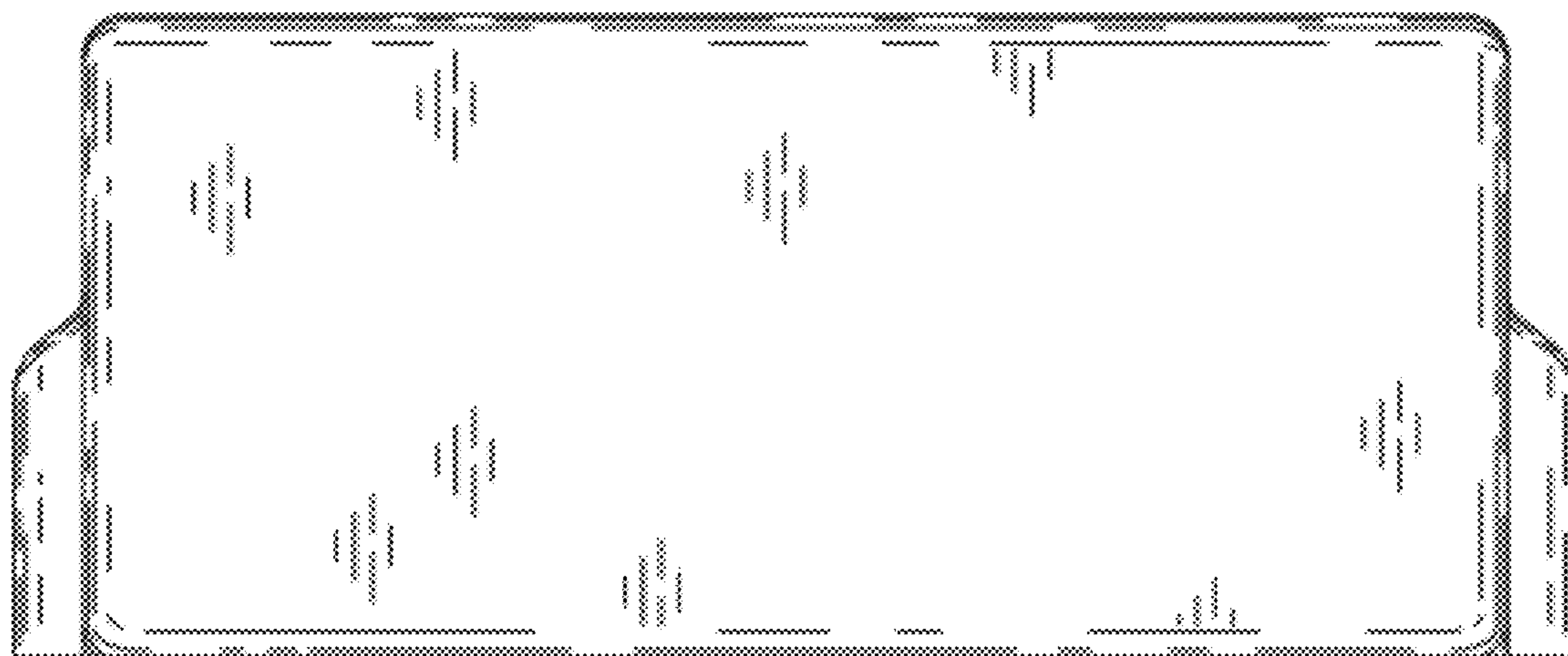

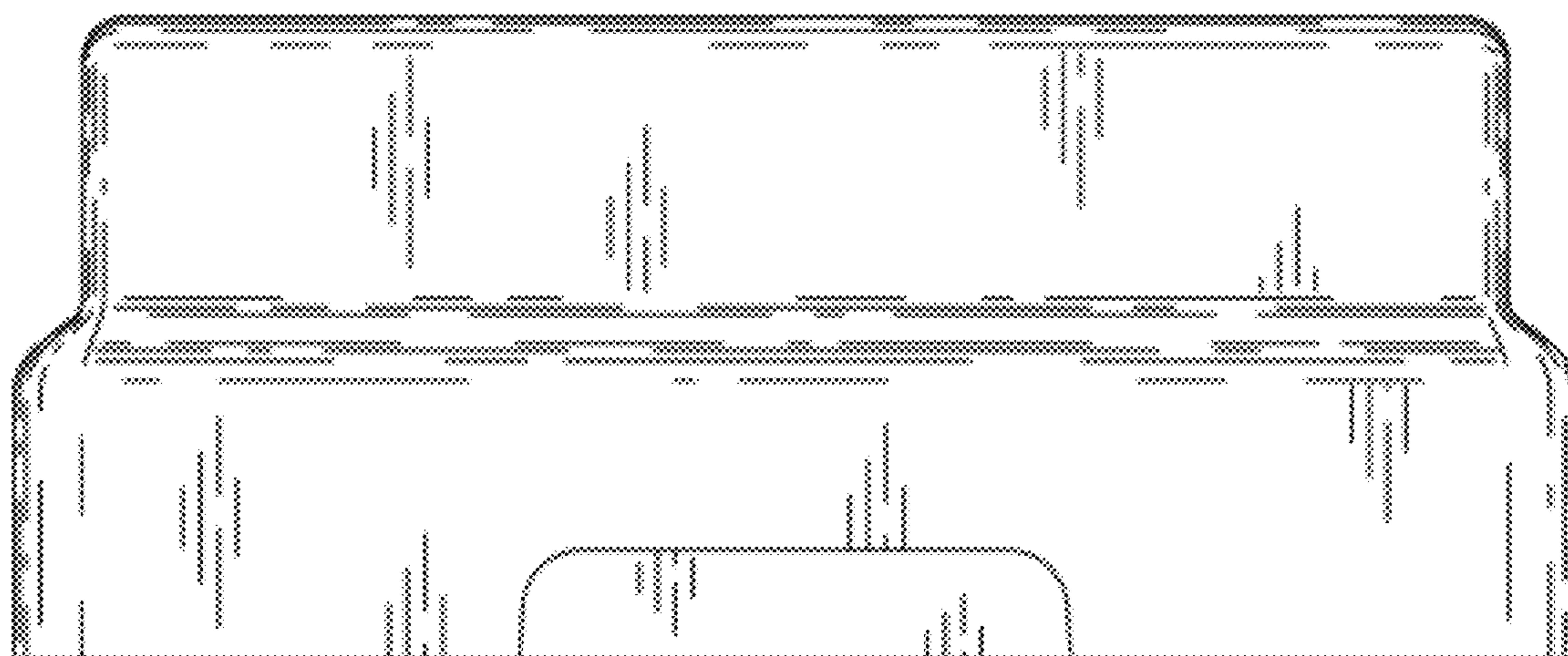

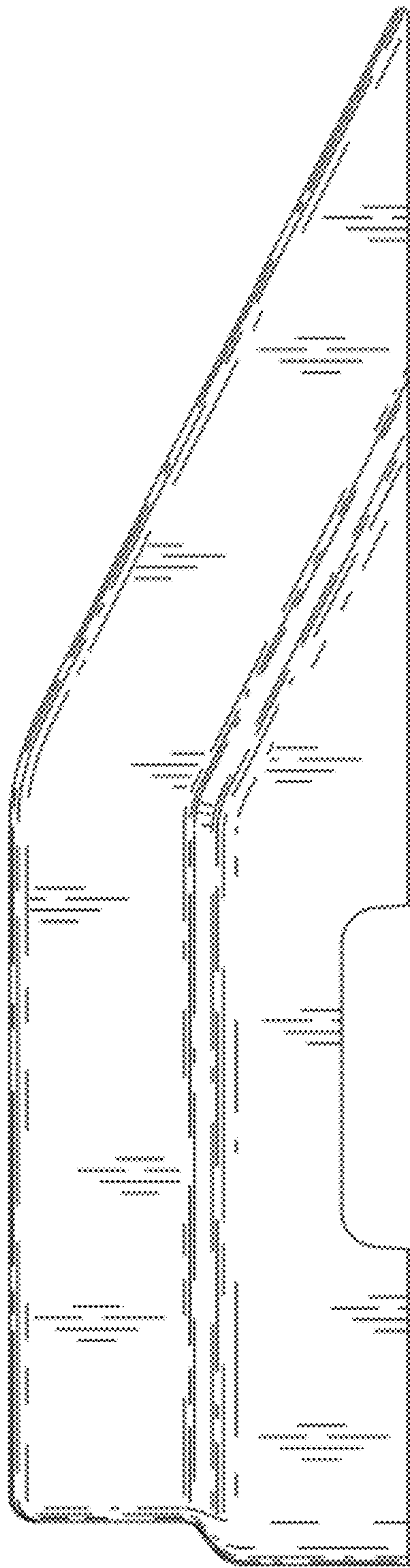

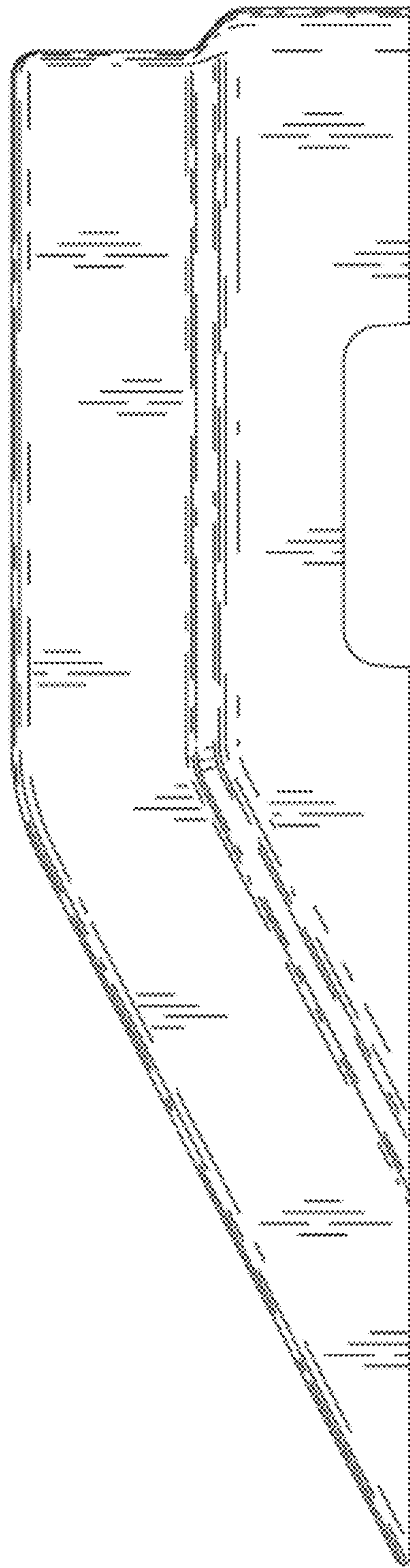

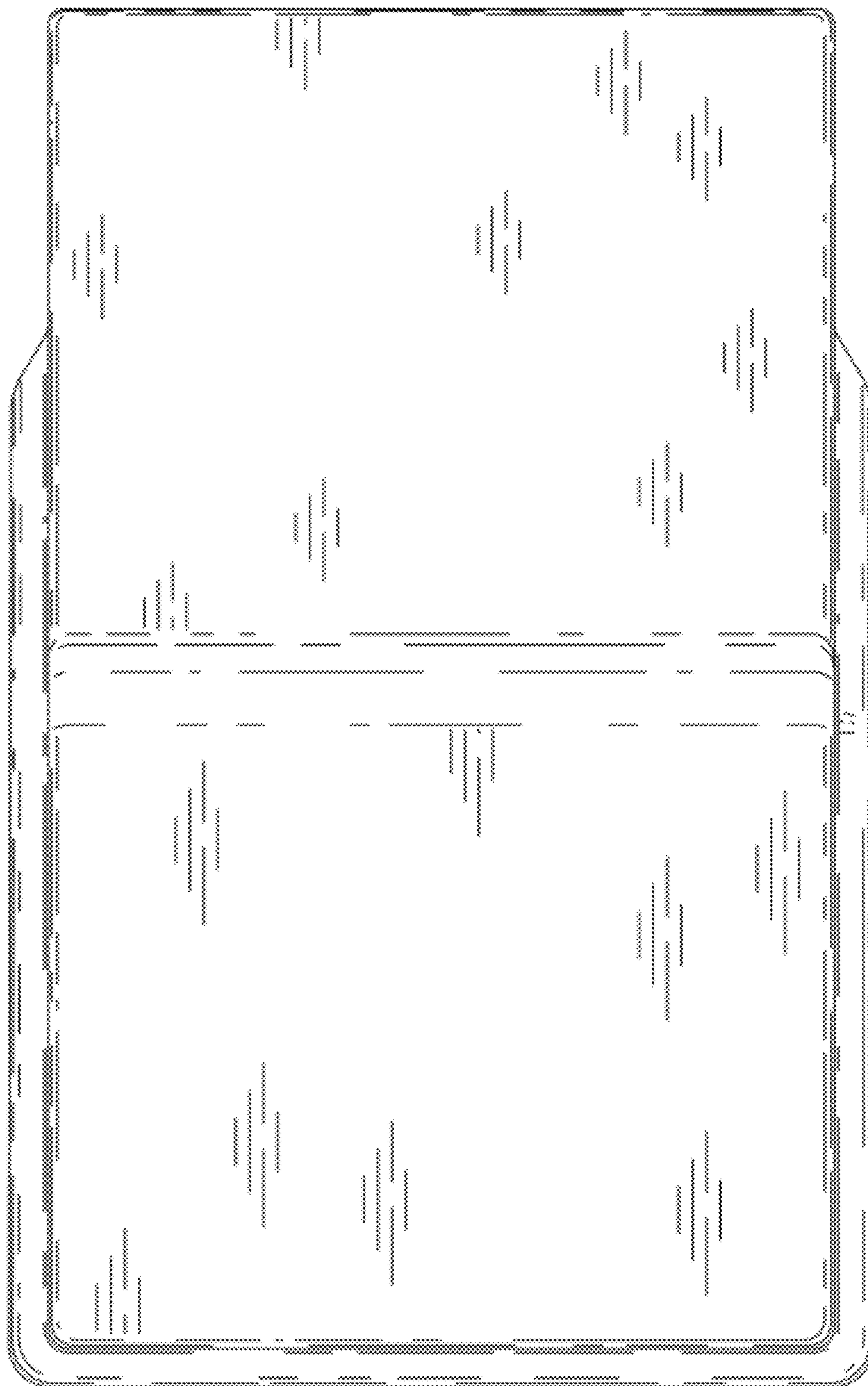

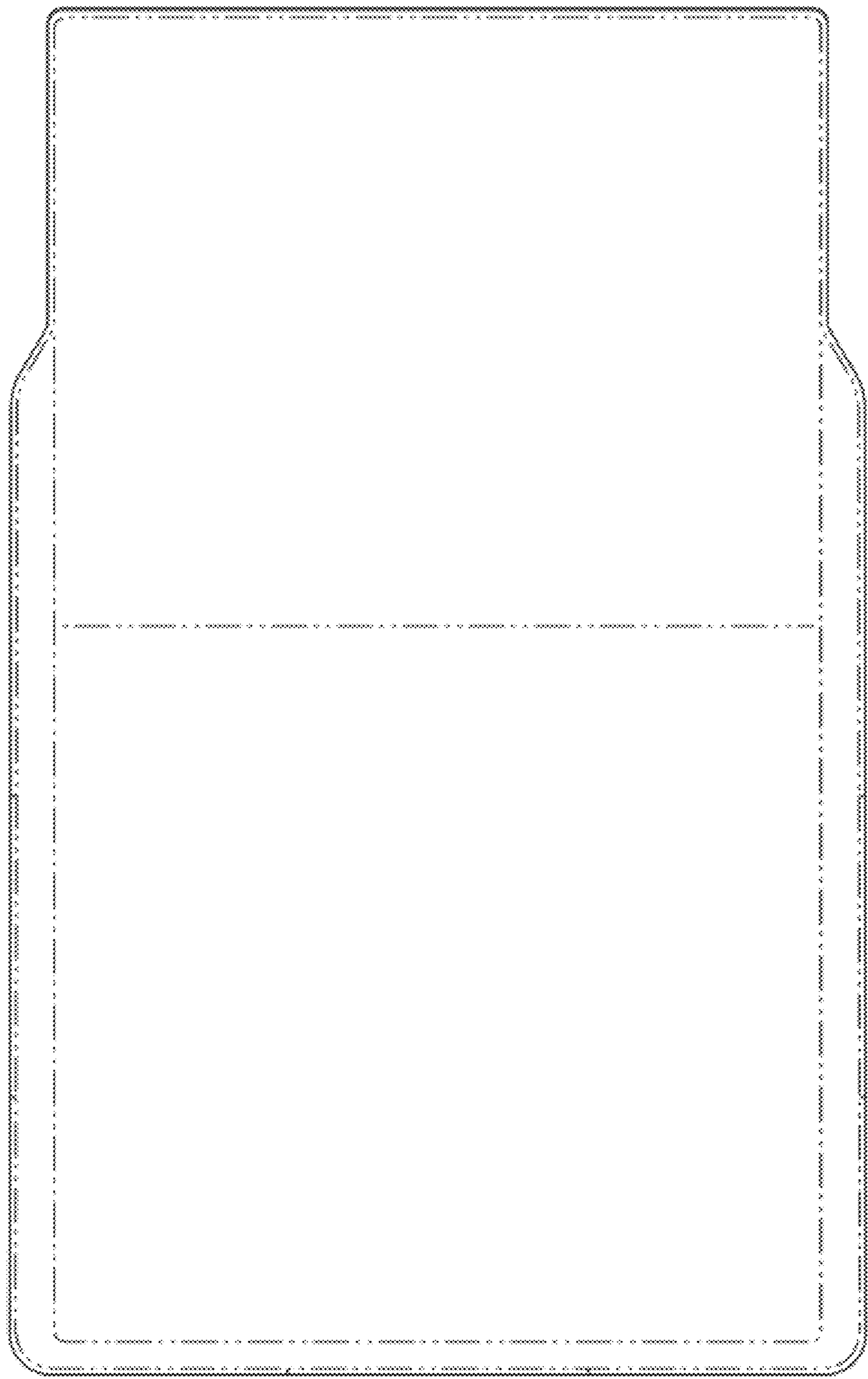
