(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a knife and fork, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective of a knife and fork as seen from the upper right showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the fork.

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged end view thereof as seen from the handle end of the fork;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged end view thereof as seen from the fork tines end of the fork;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the knife;

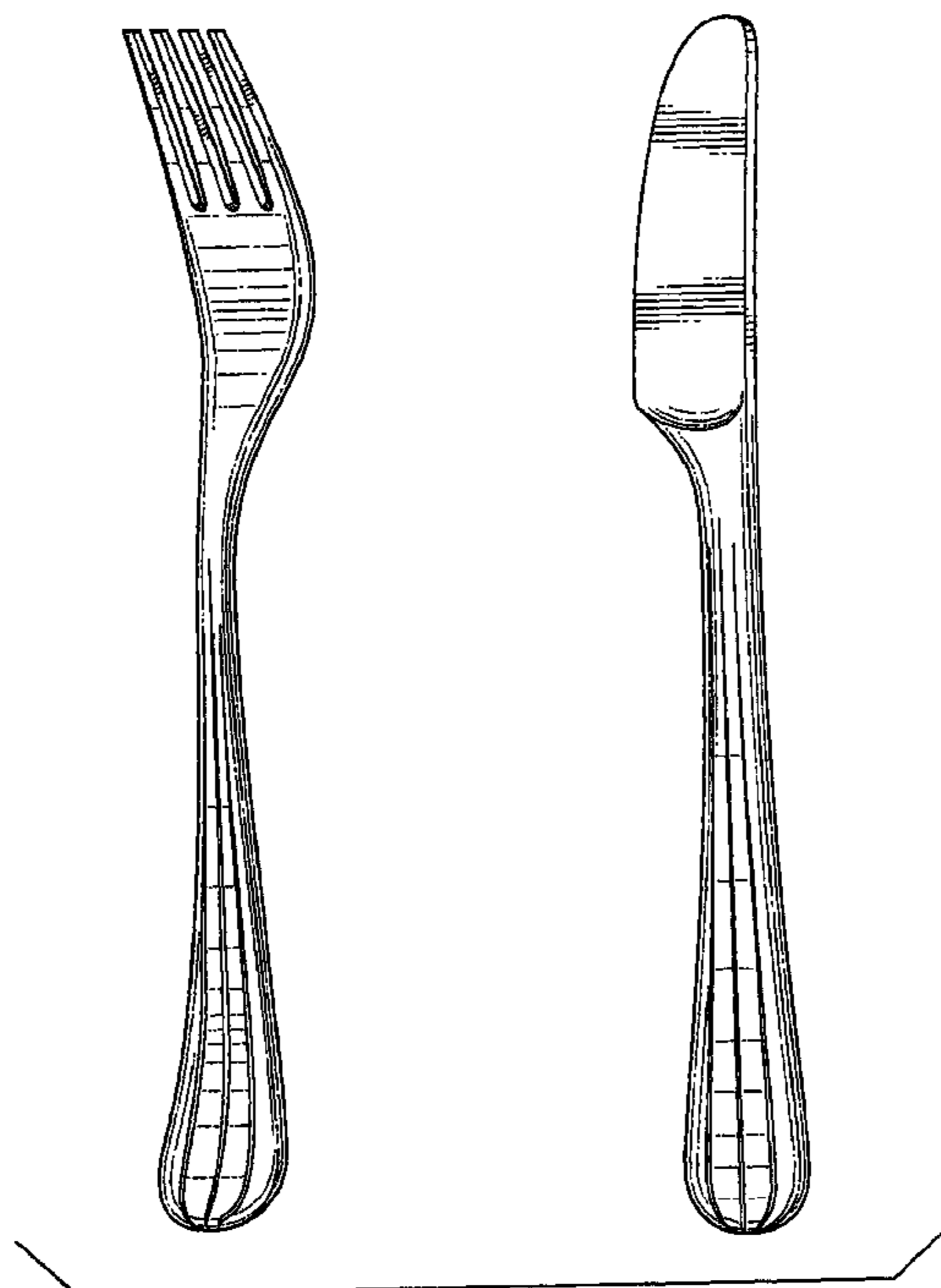
FIG. 8 is a left view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 9 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 10 is an end view thereof as seen from the handle end of the knife; and,

FIG. 11 is an end view thereof as seen from the blade end of the knife.

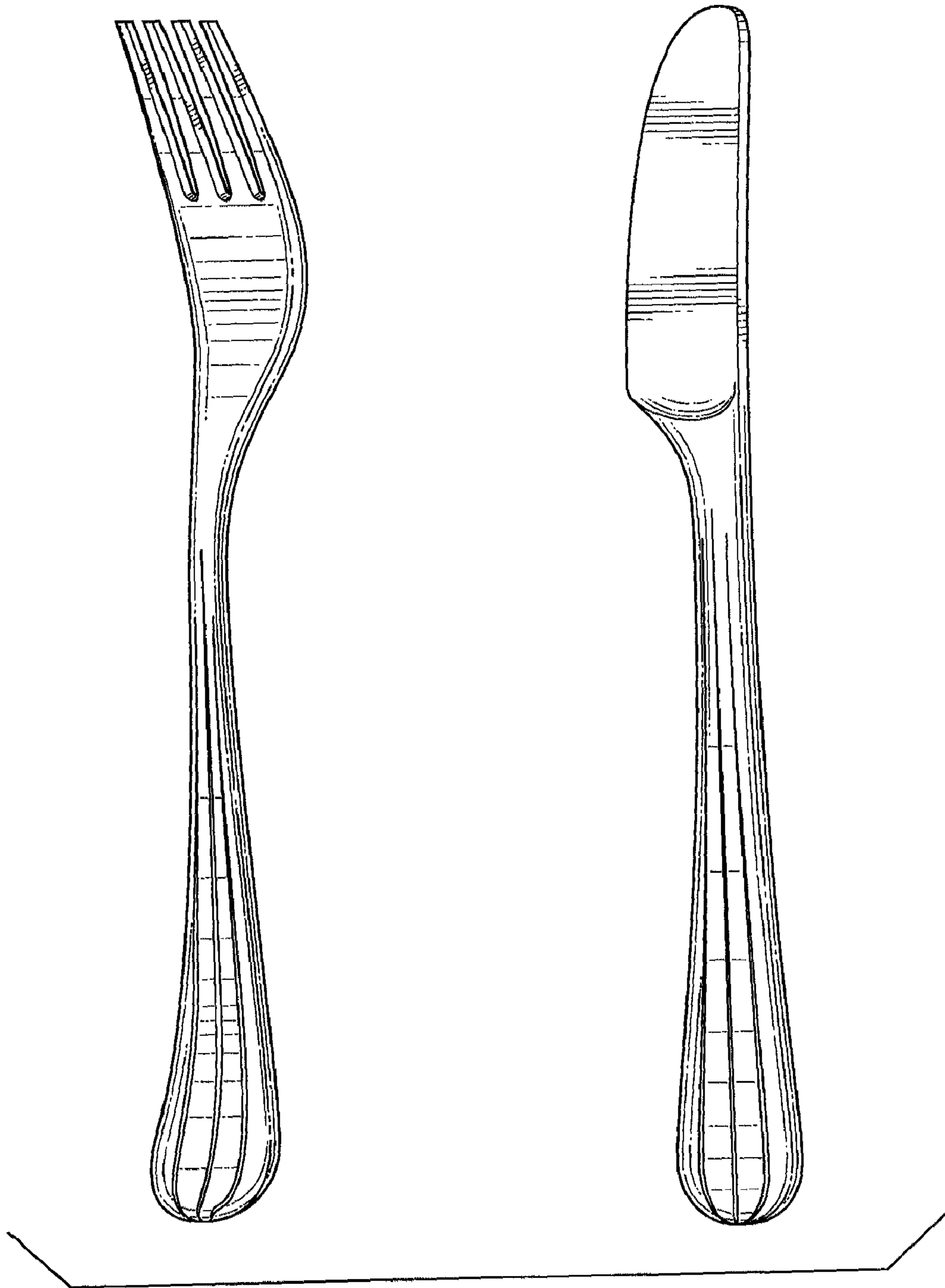

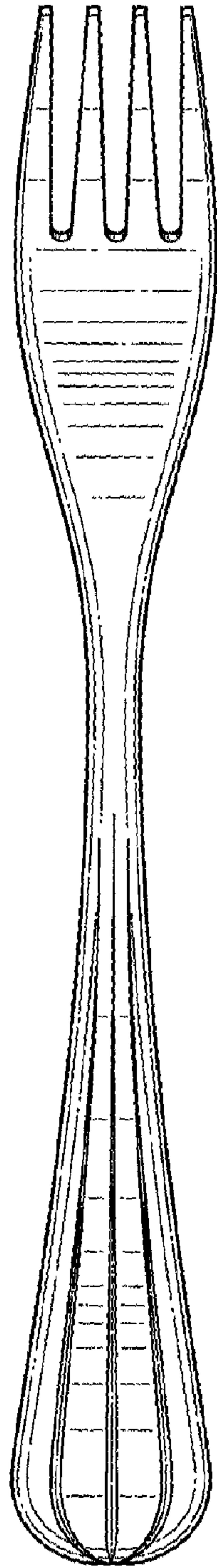

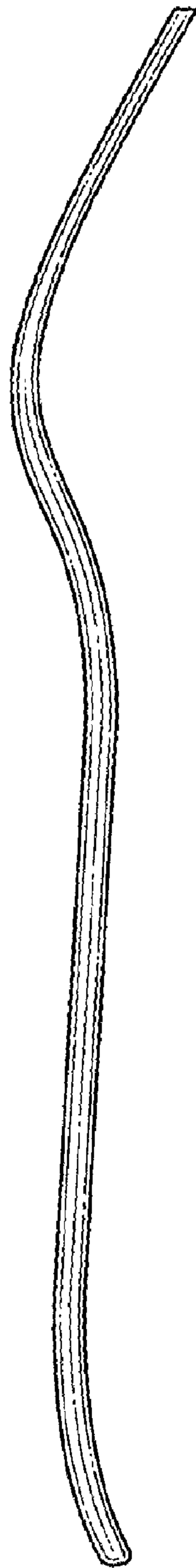

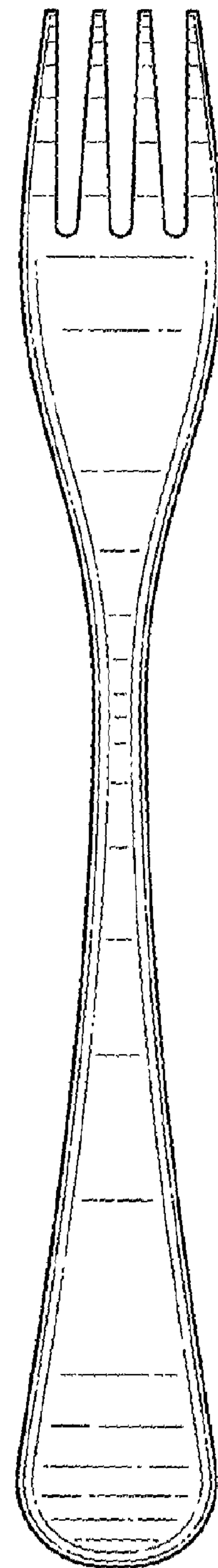

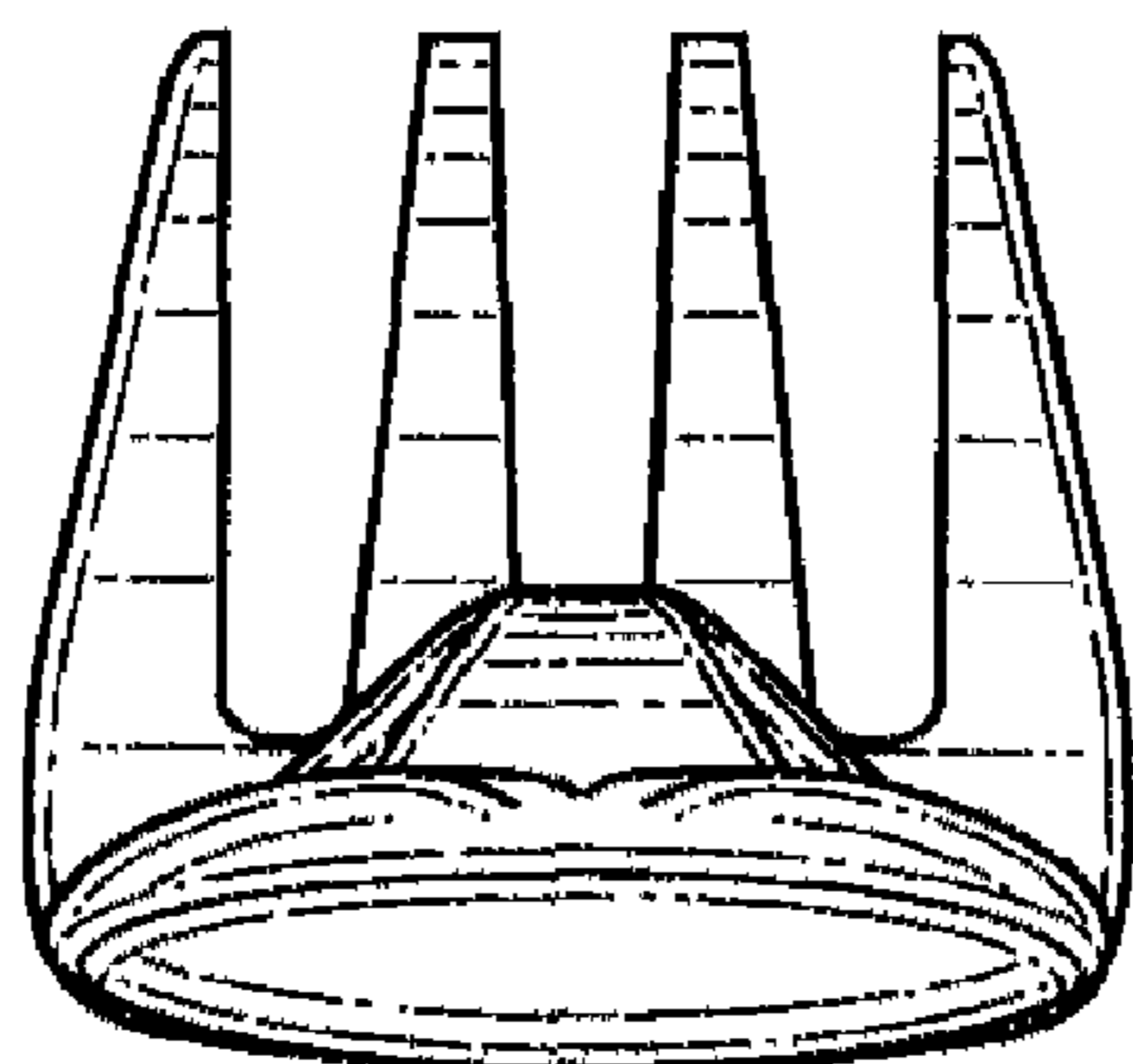

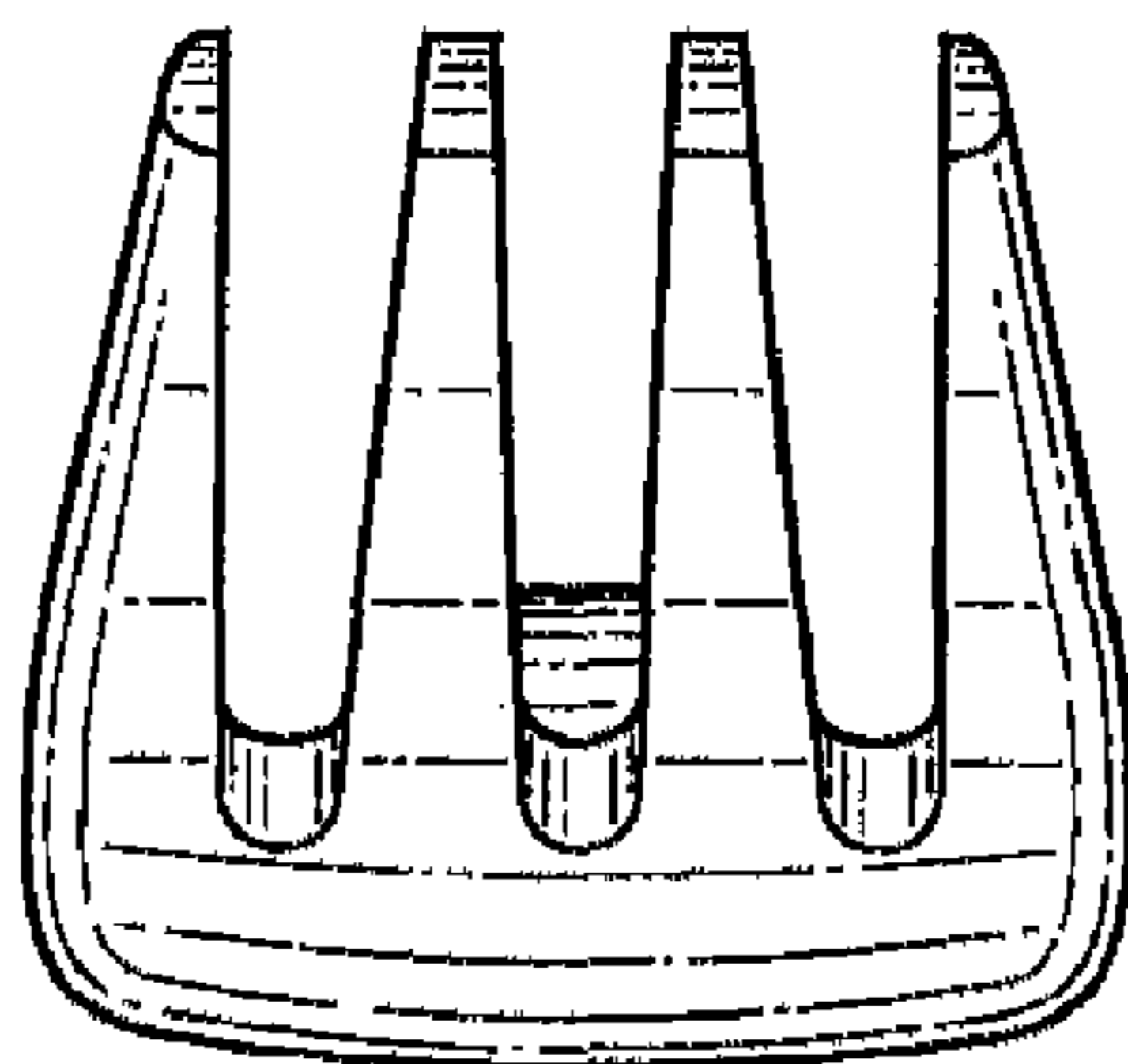

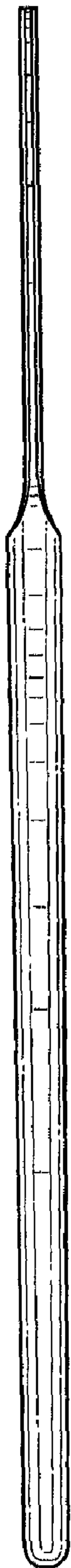

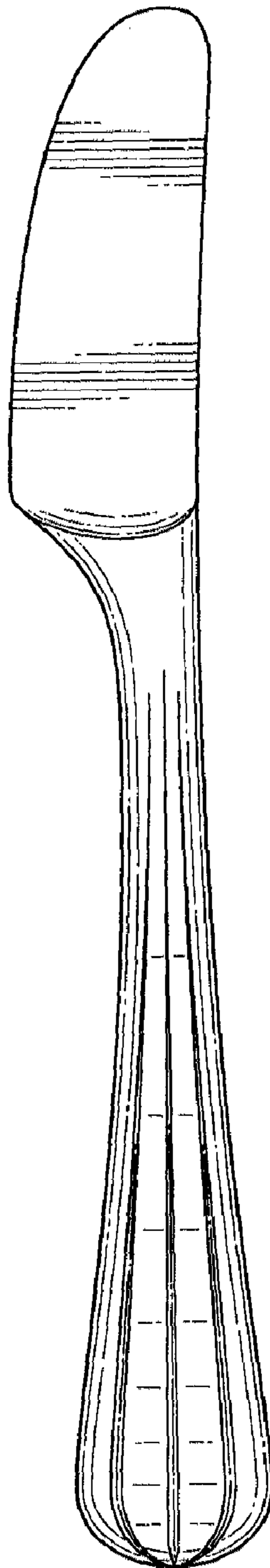

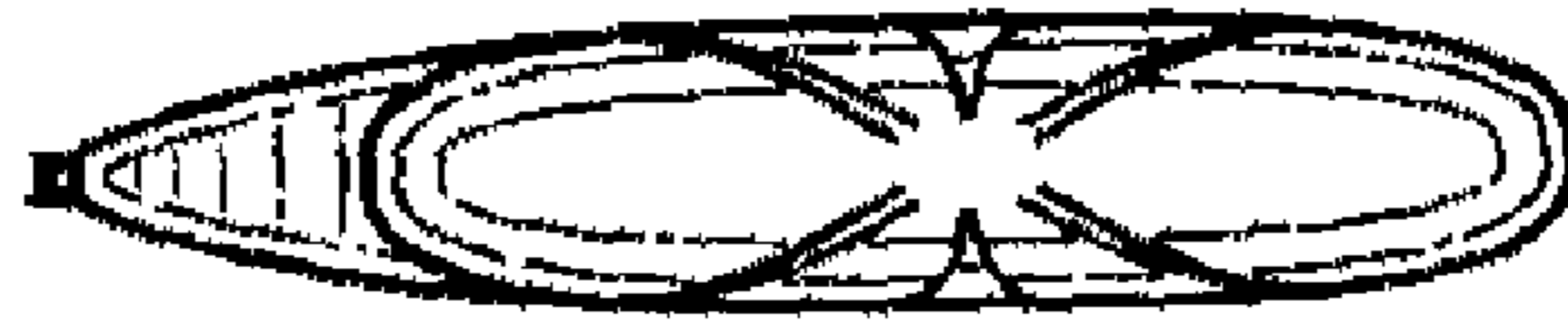

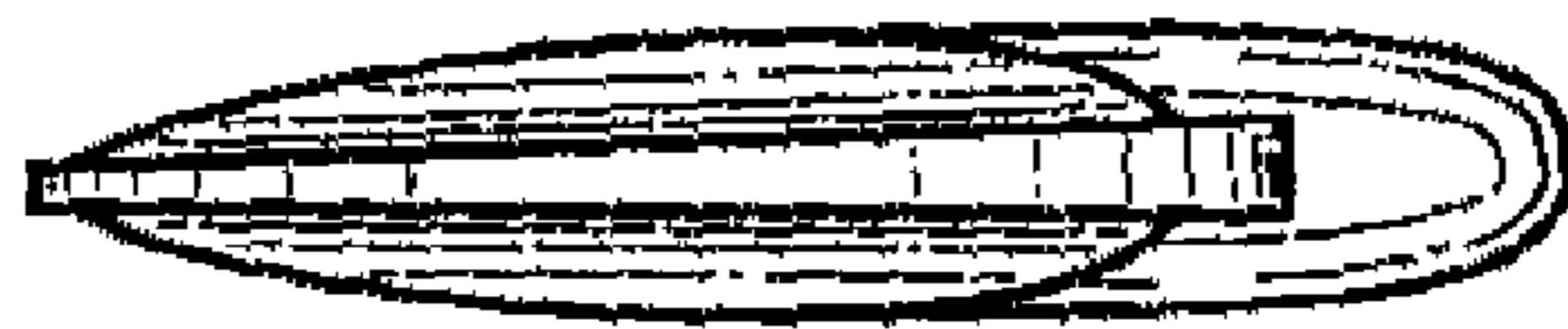
