shown and illustrated.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an electronic device
showing our new design;

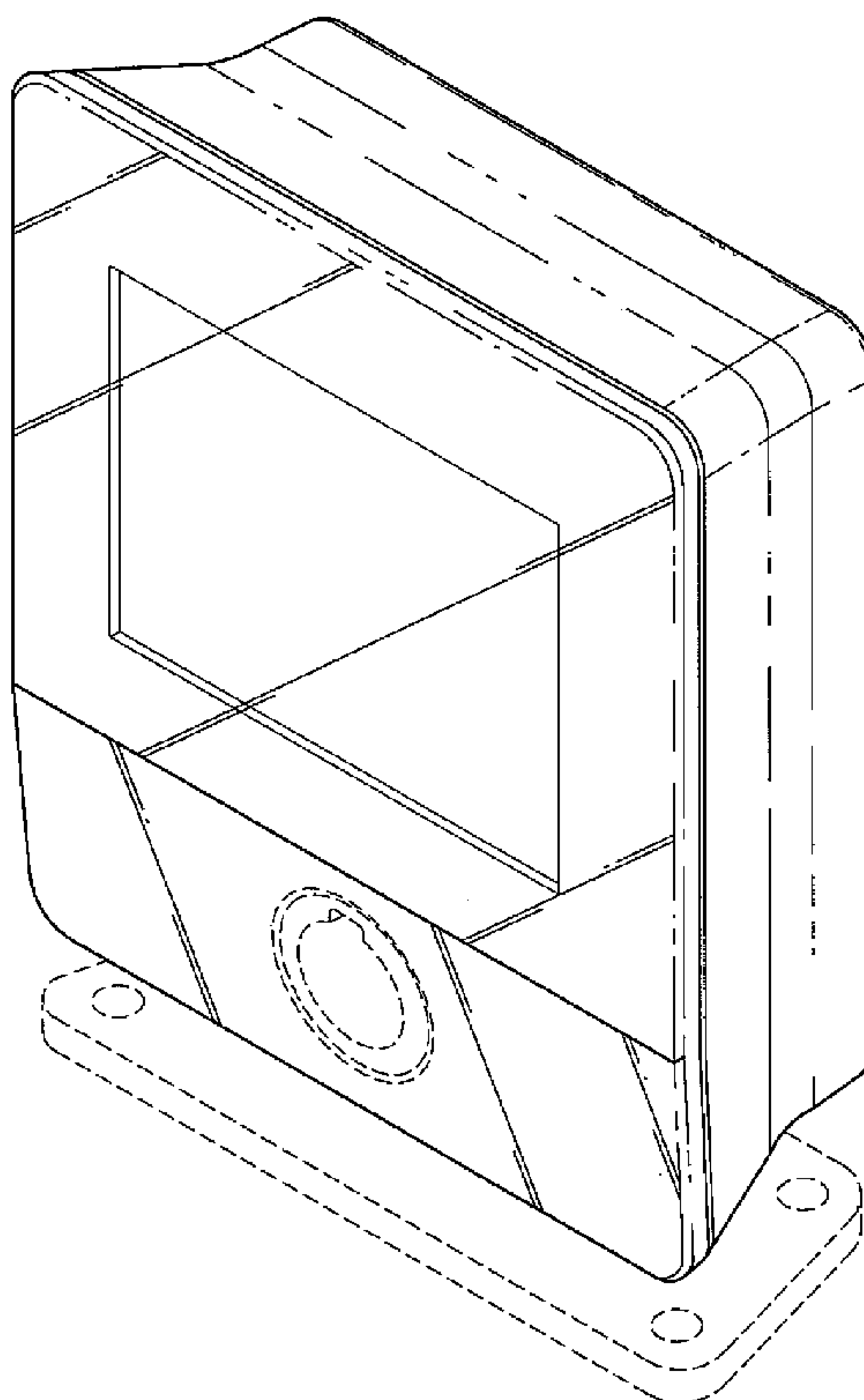

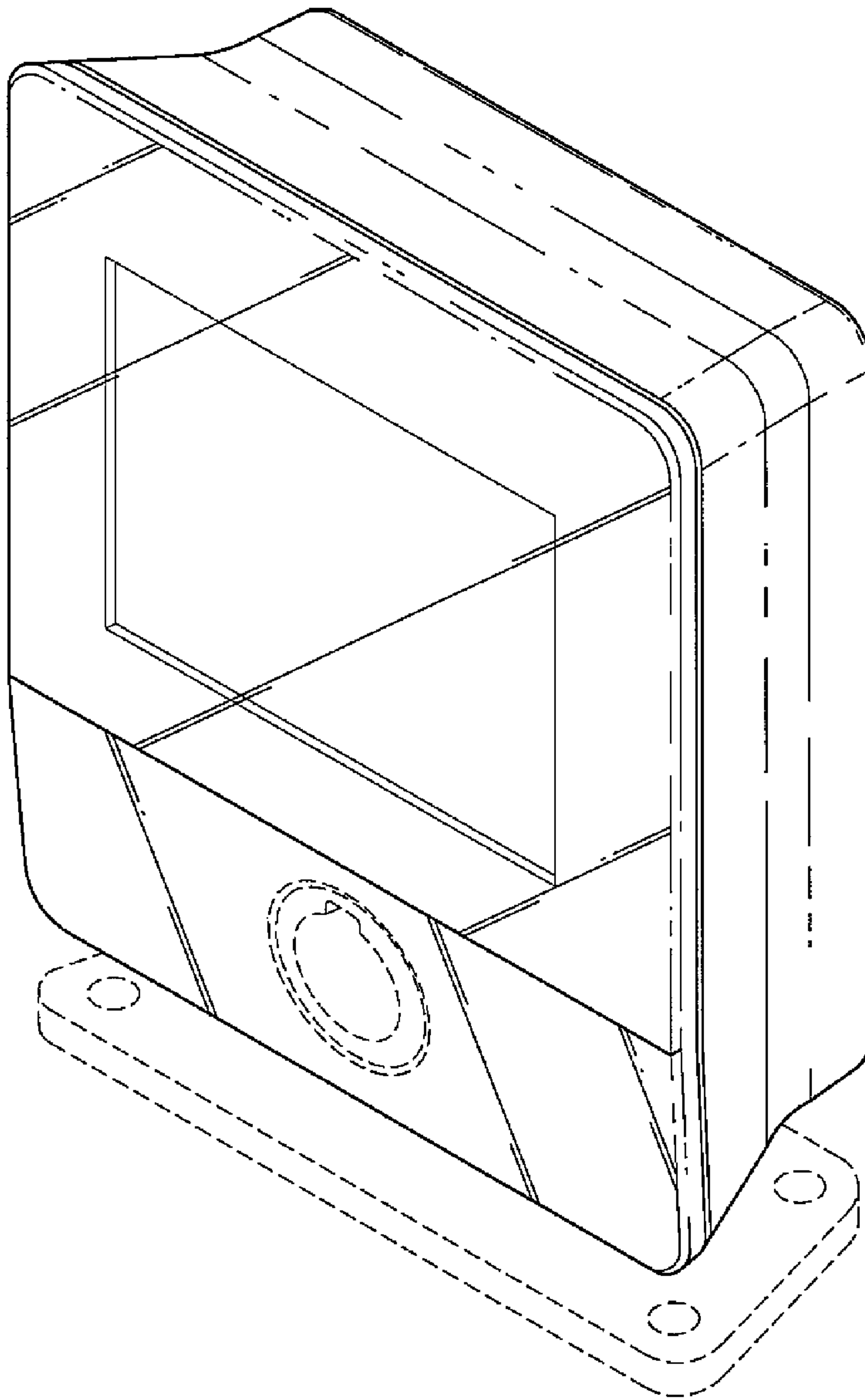

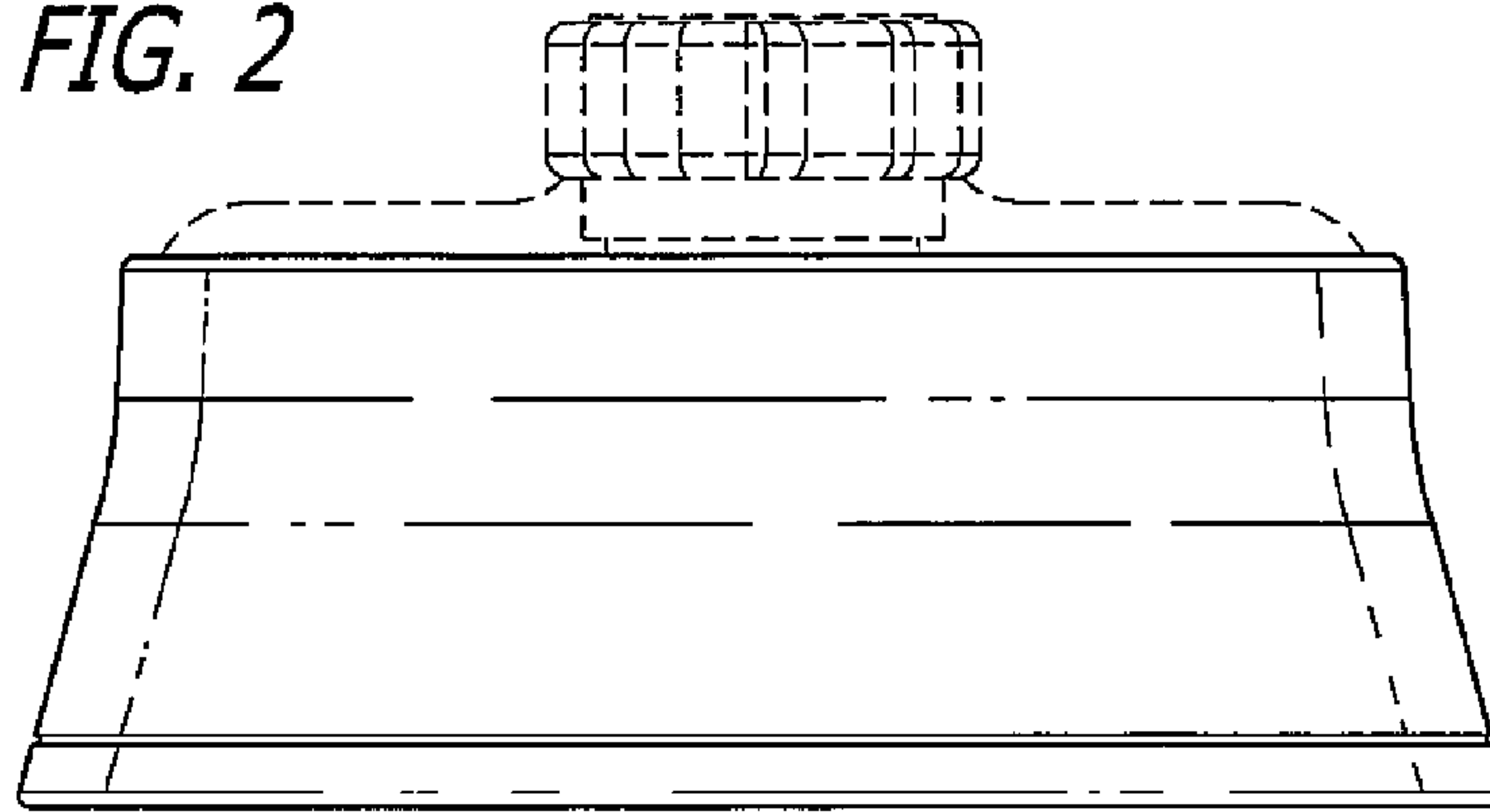

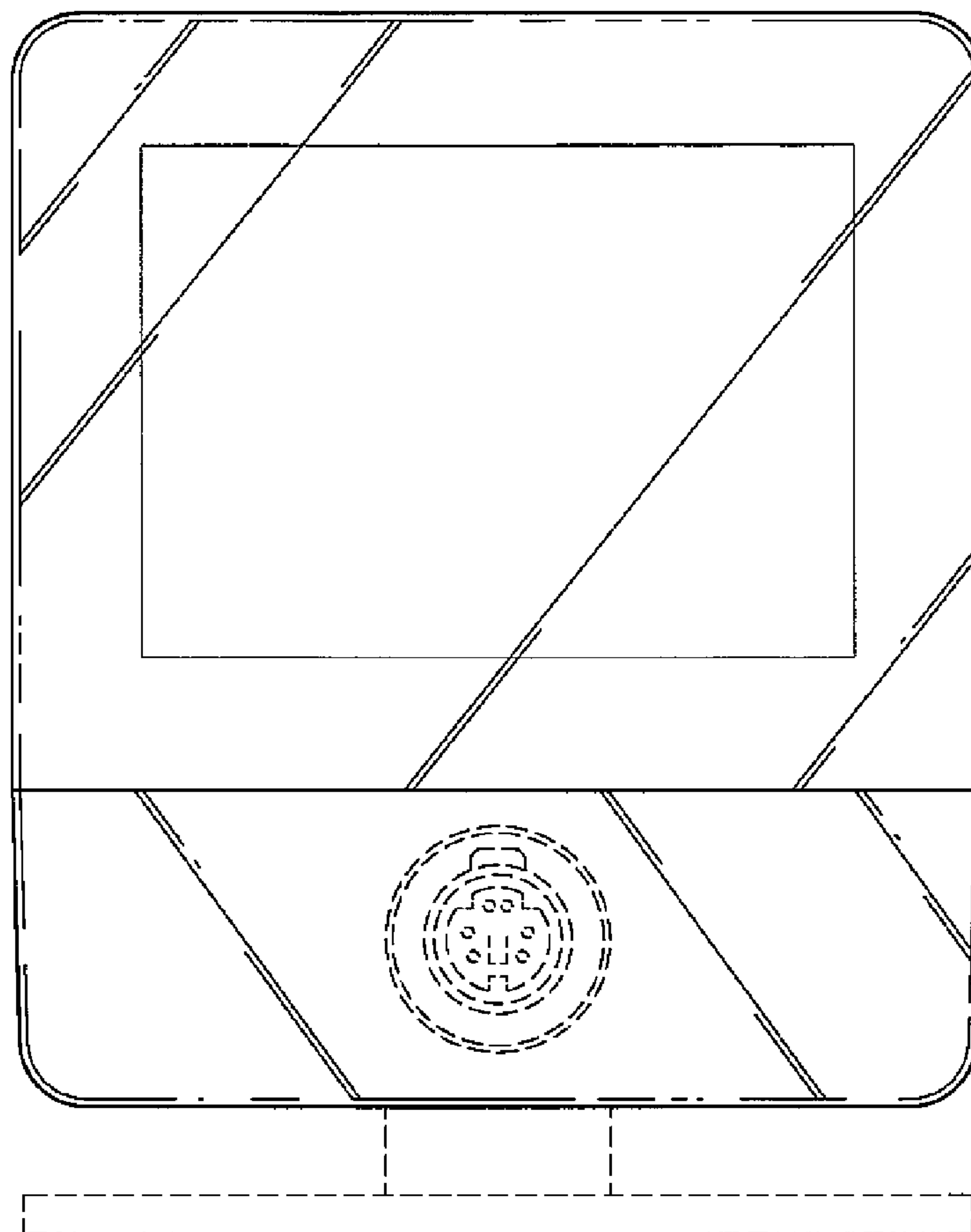

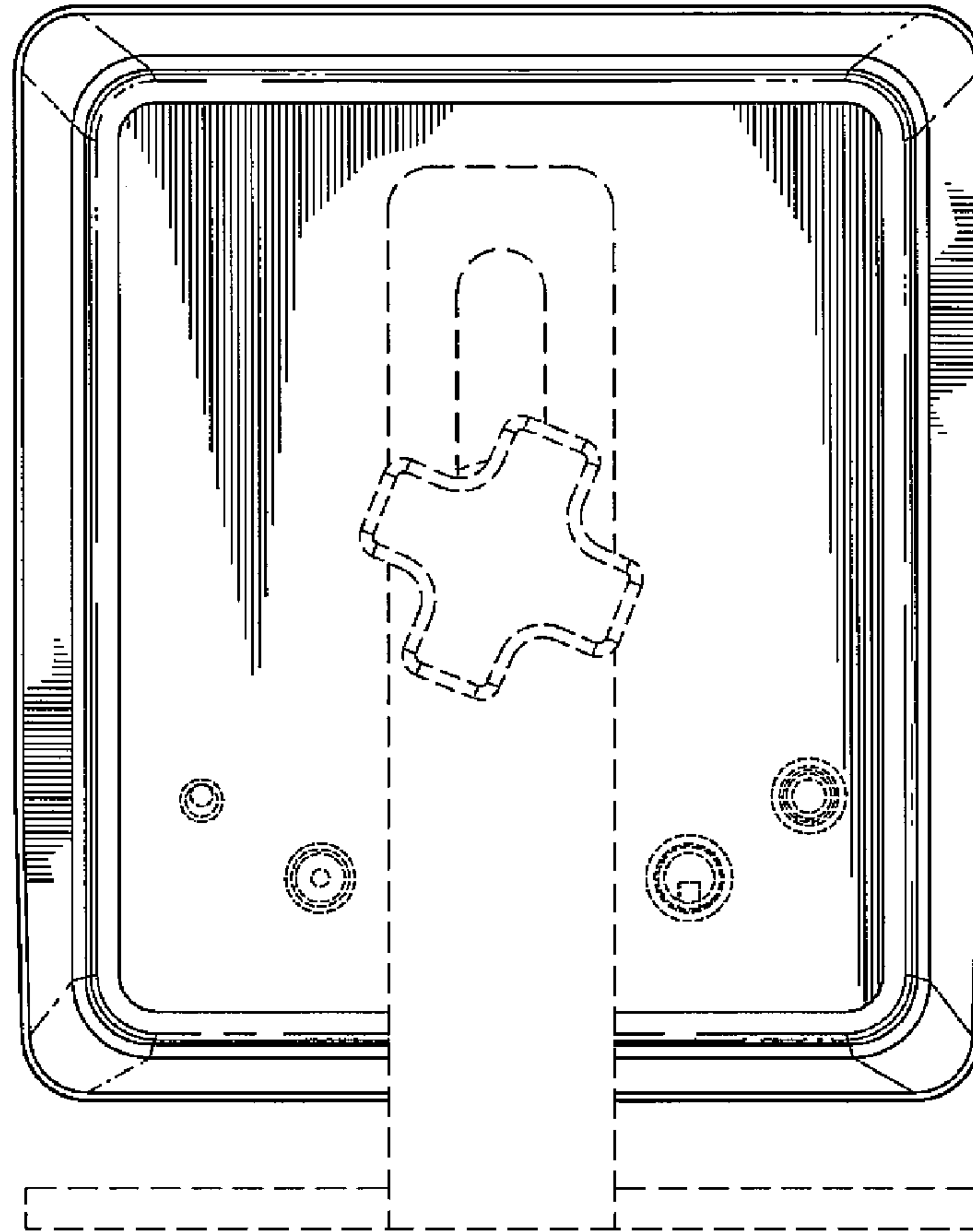
