**DESCRIPTION**

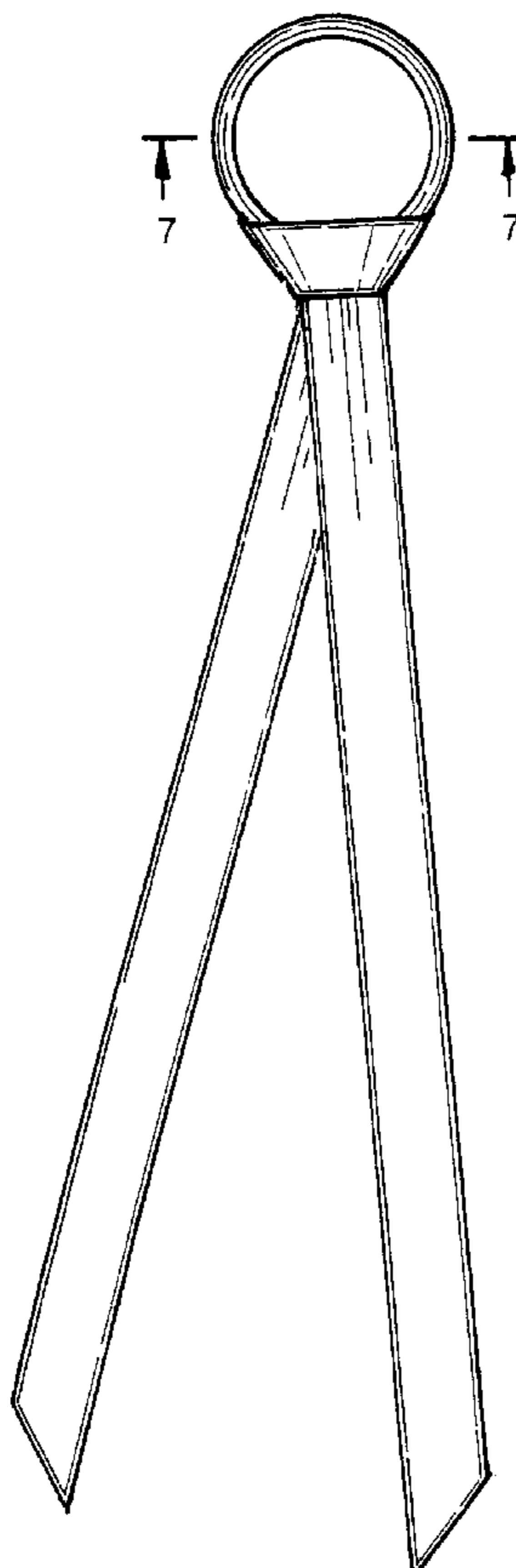
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a first embodiment of the ribbon ring bottle holder of my design;

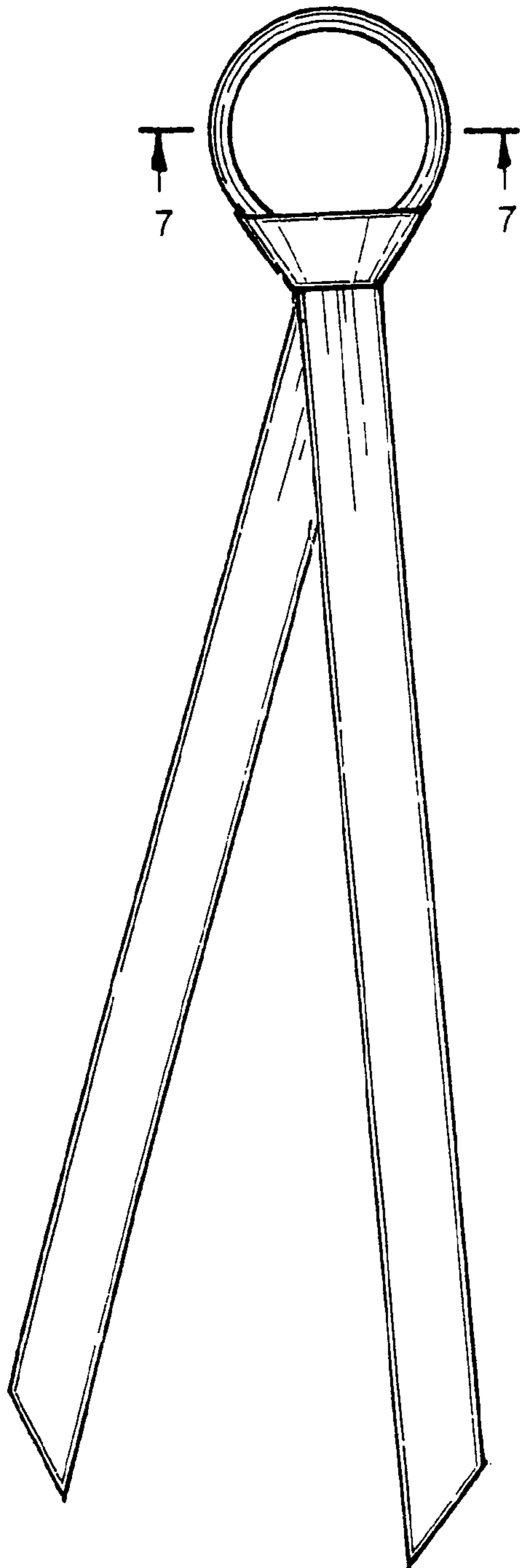

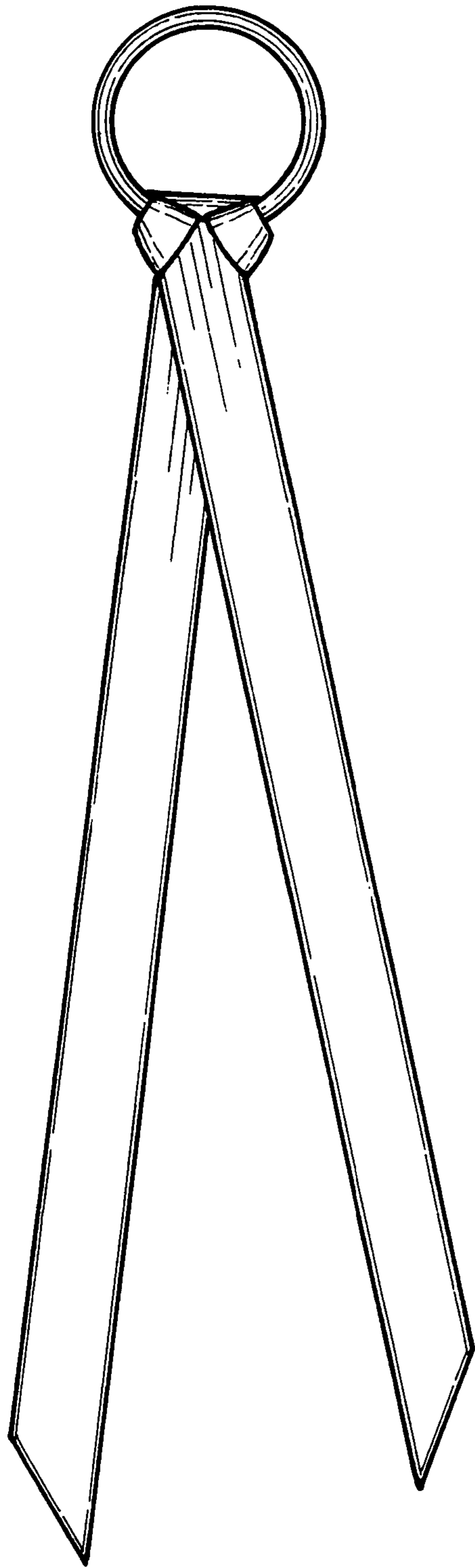

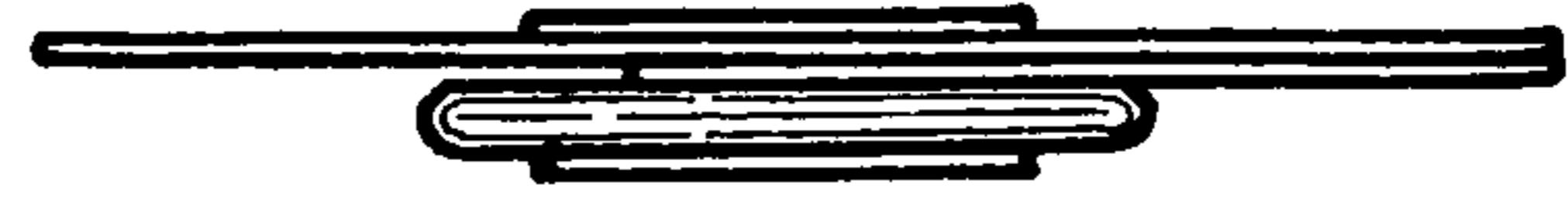
