The ornamental design for a case for electronic device, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front isometric view of a case for electronic device
showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear isometric view thereof;

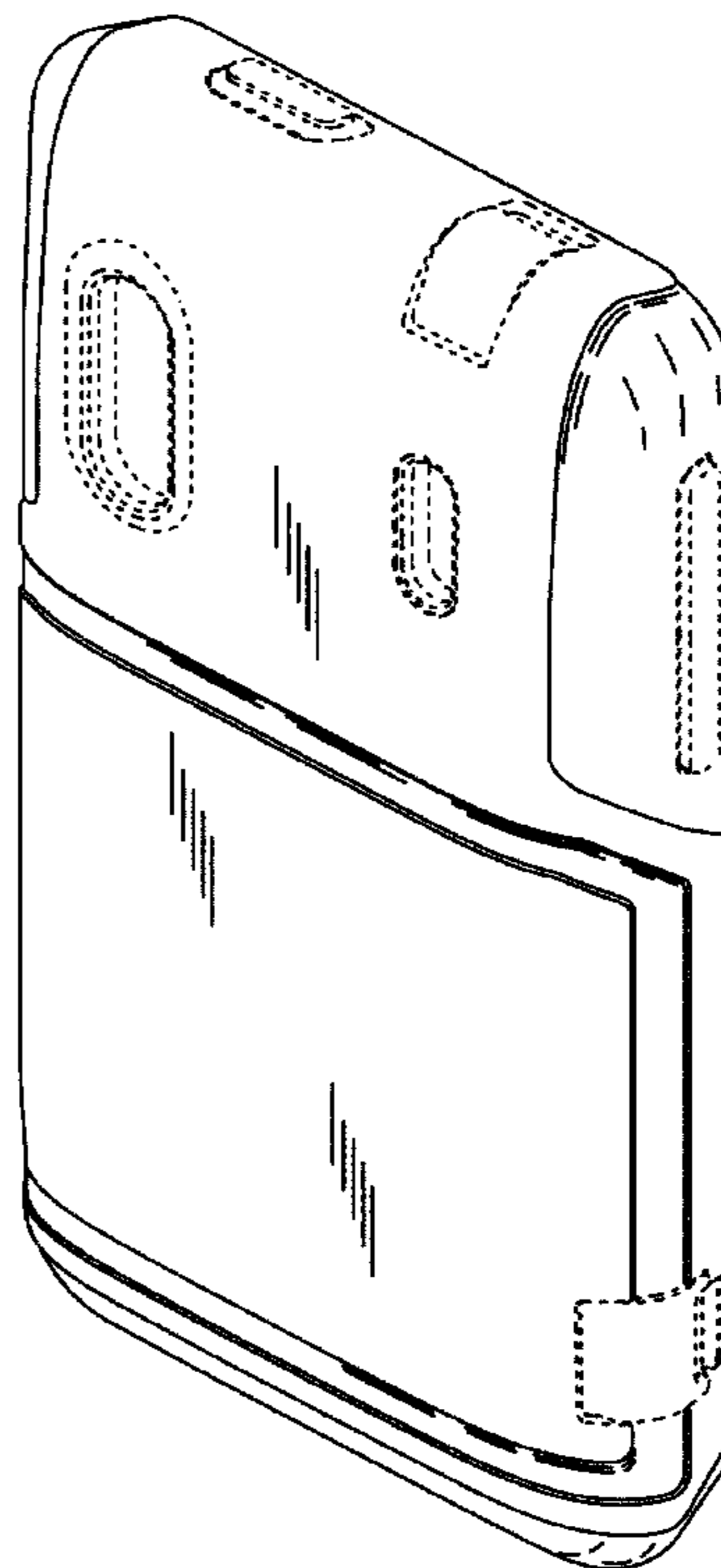
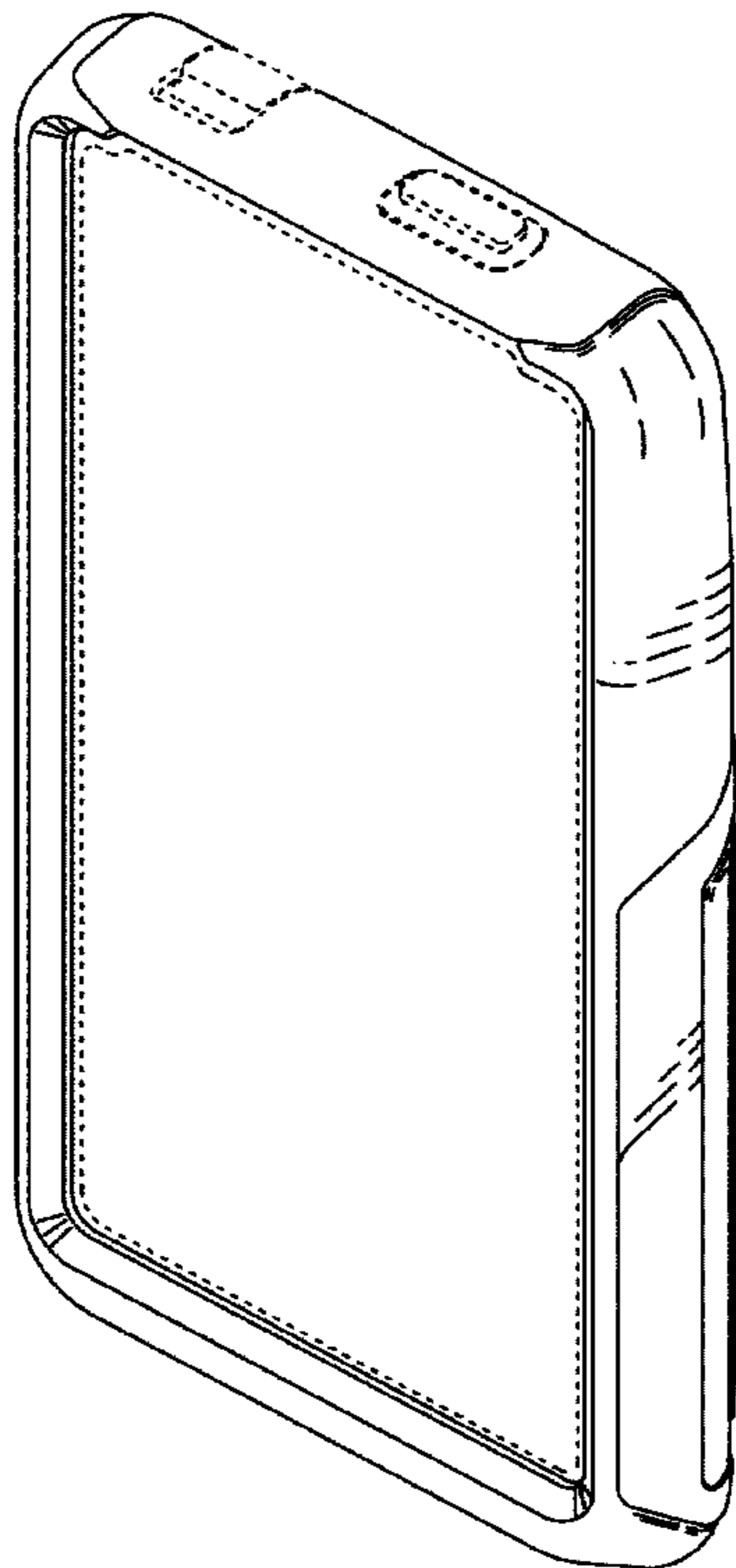
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

The broken line perimeter of the large unshaded rectangular

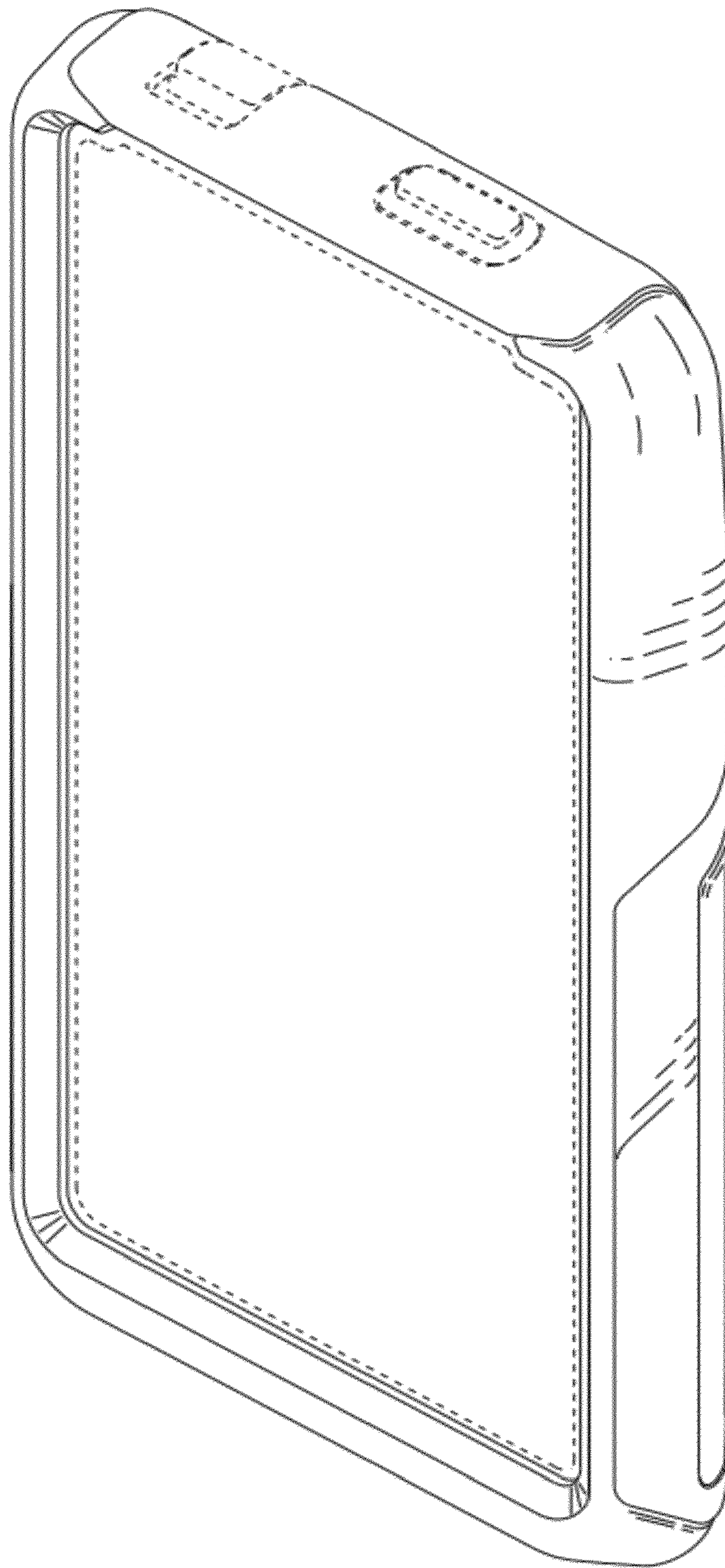

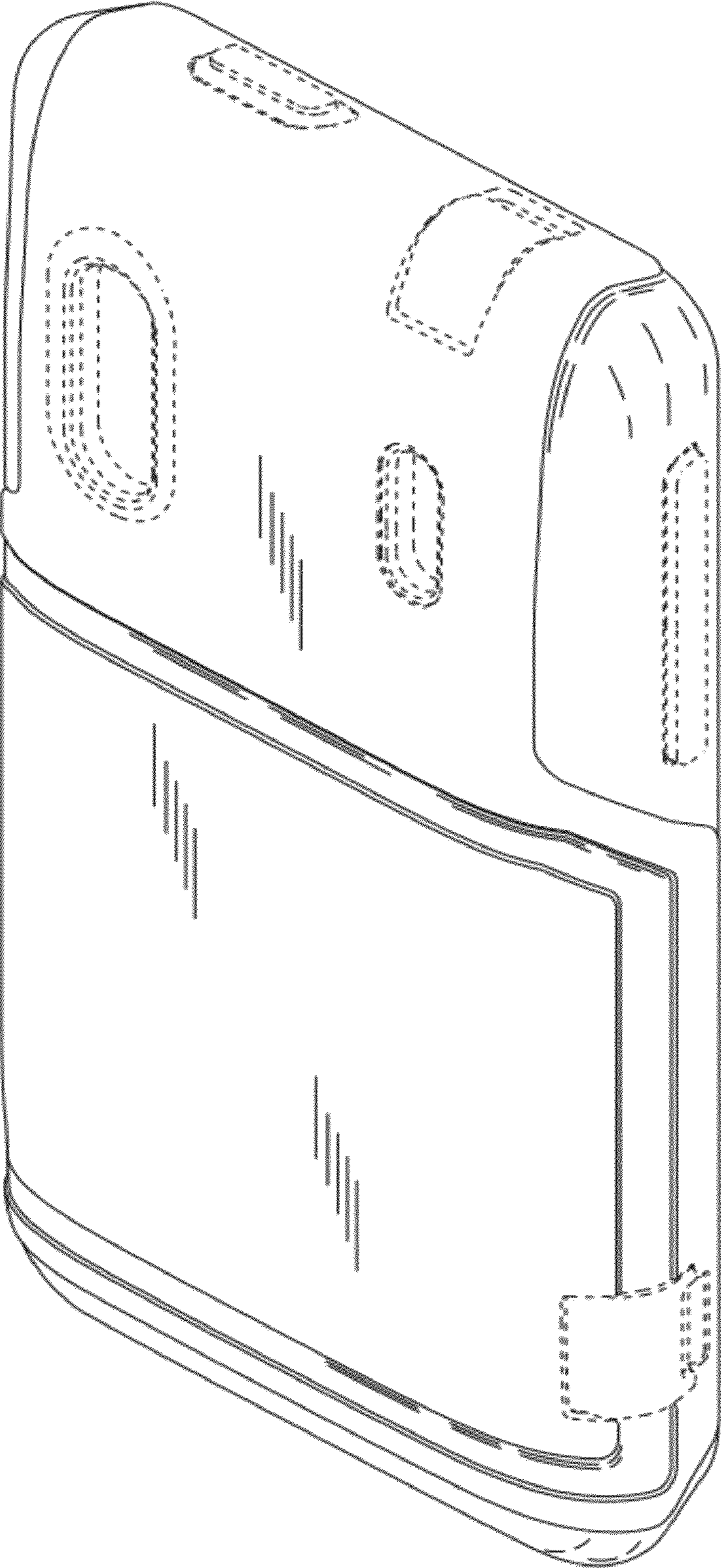

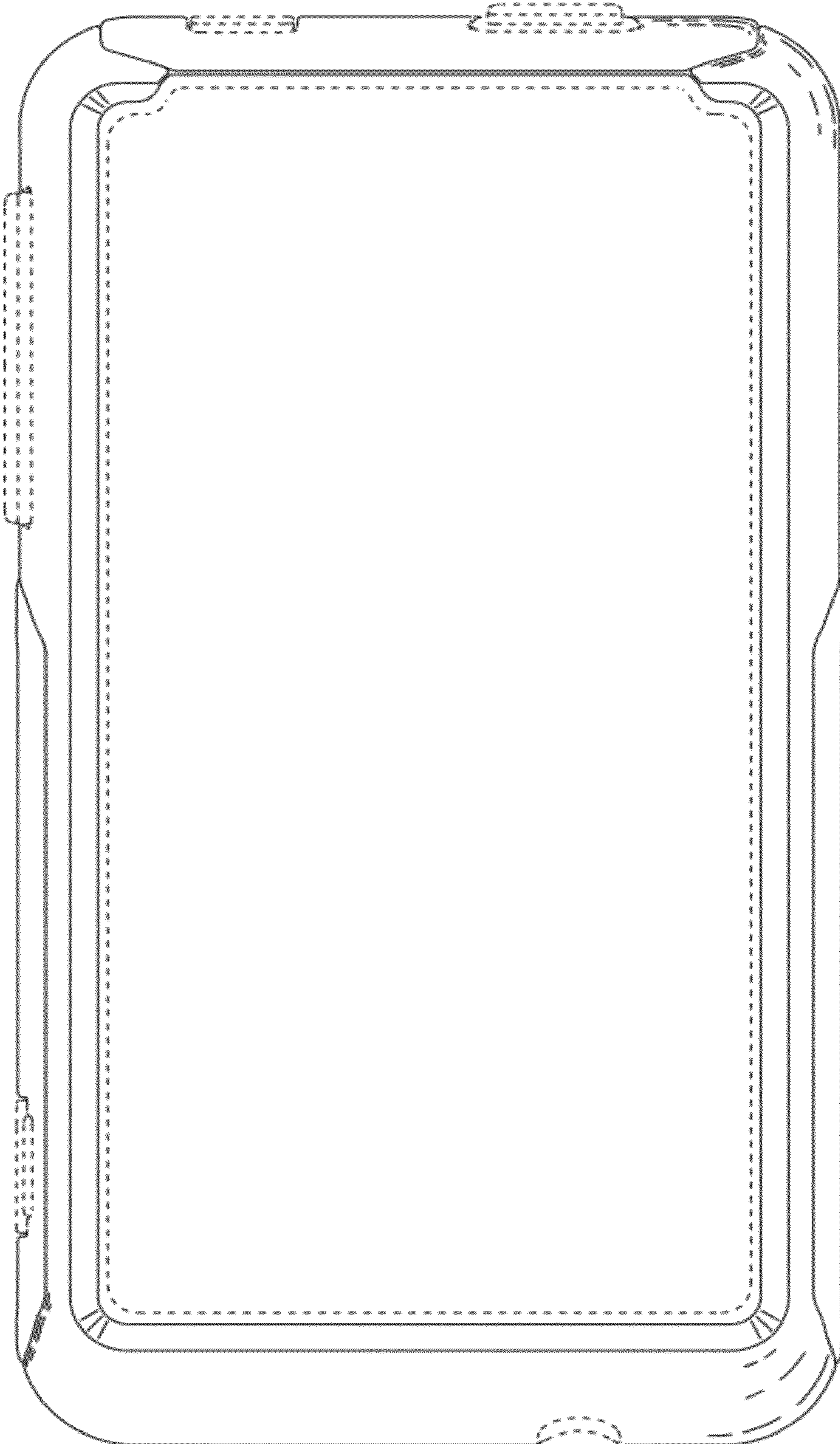

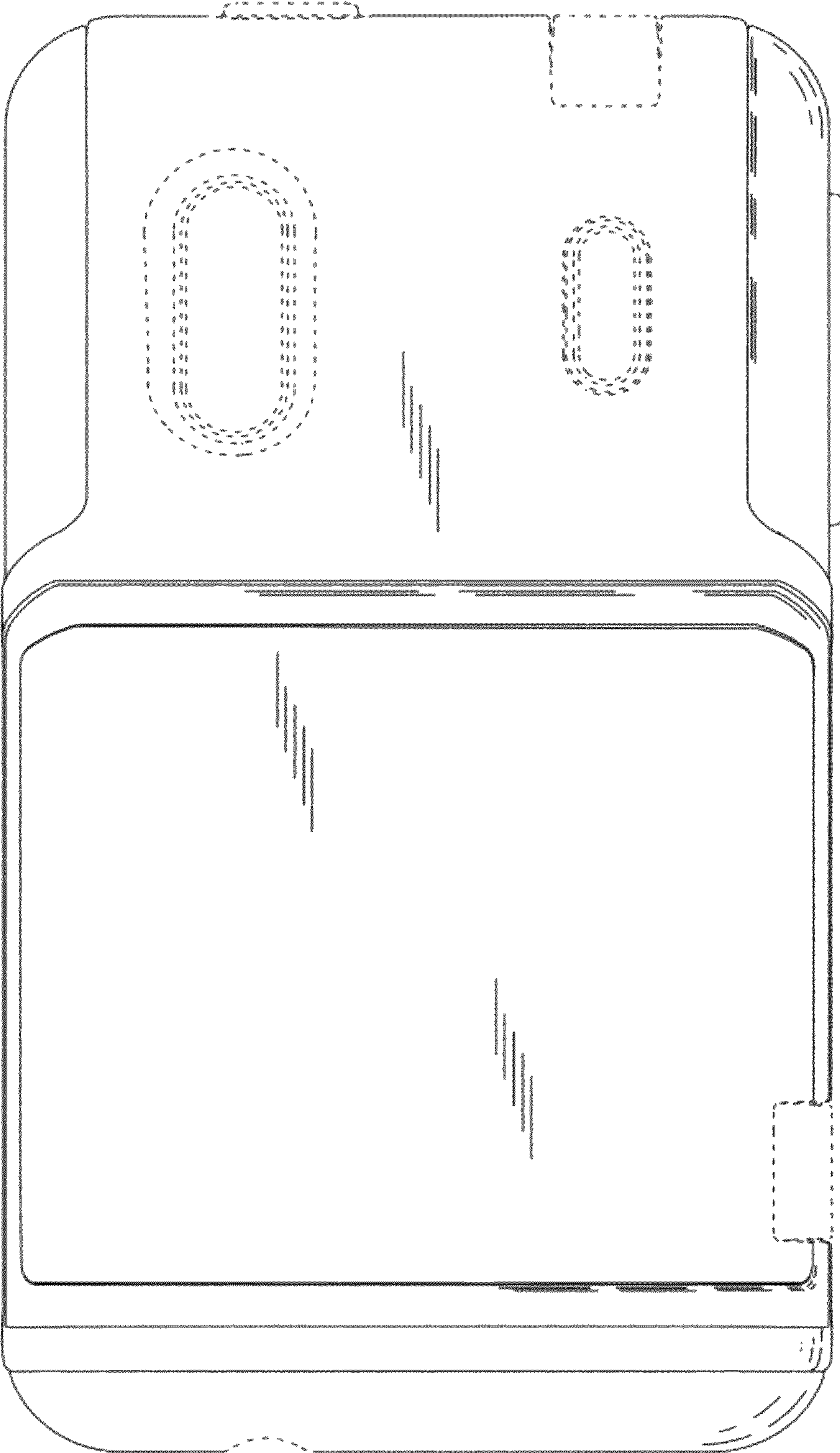

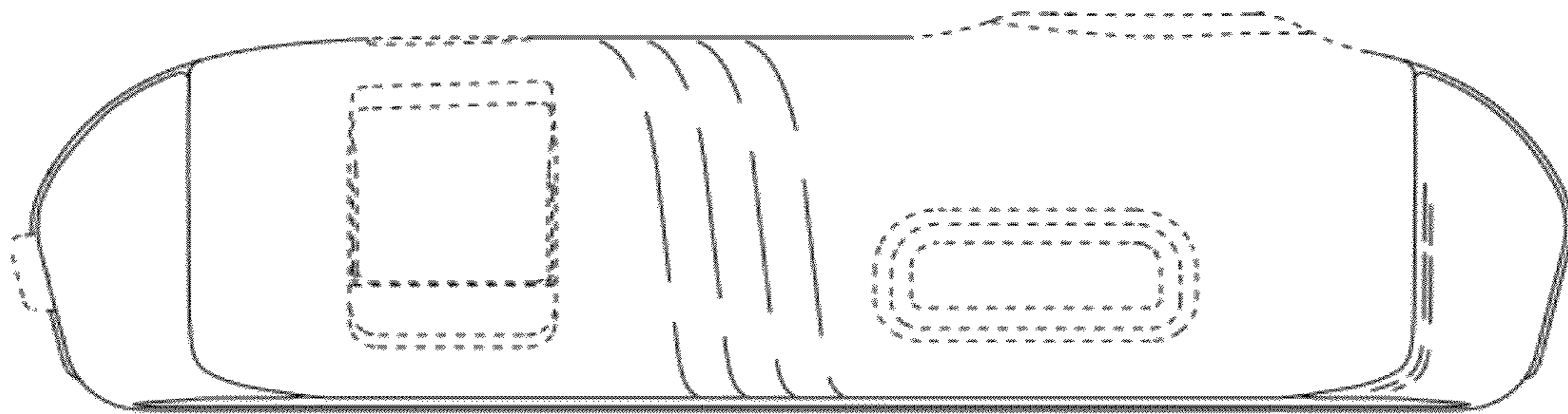
